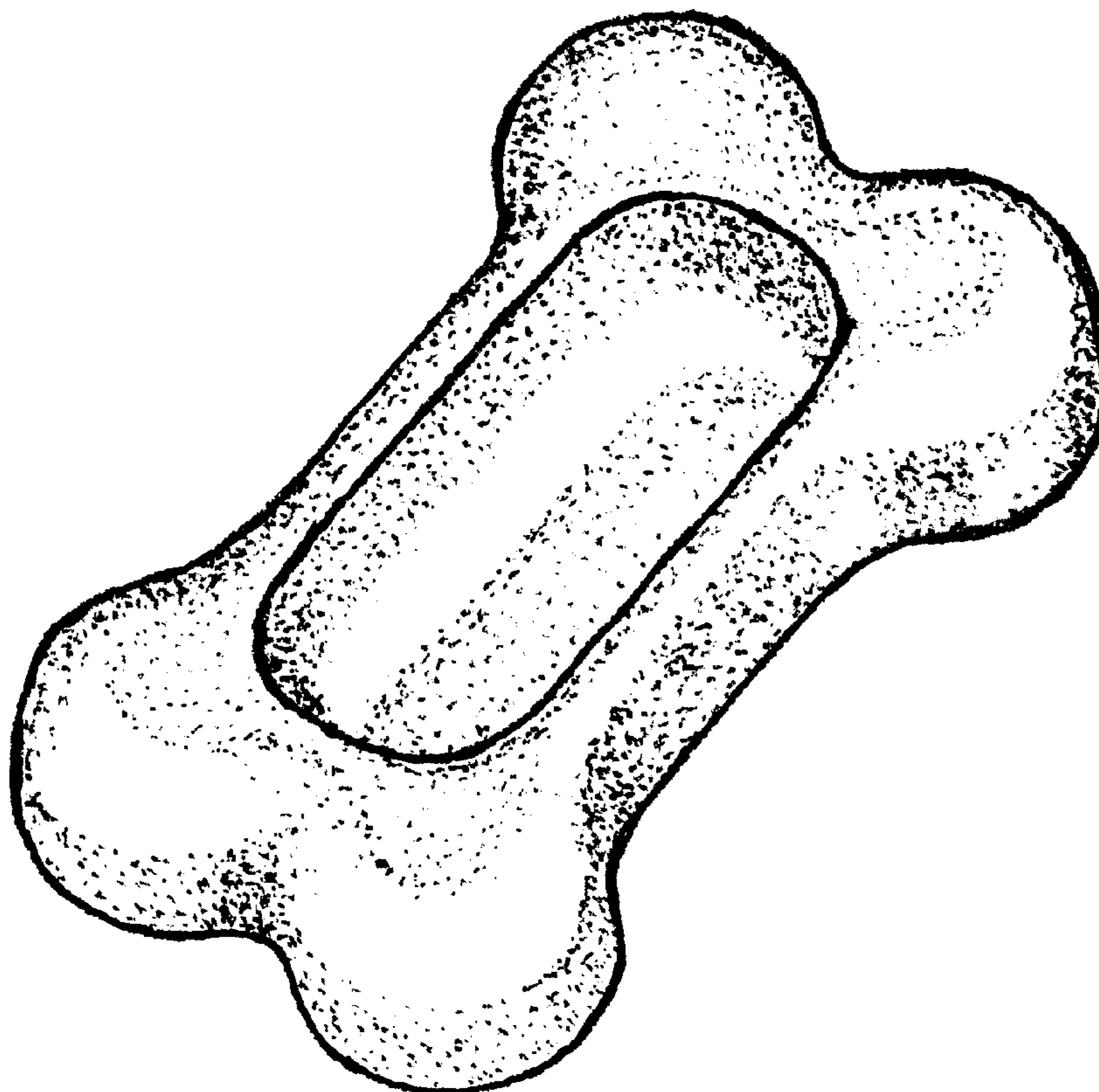
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a animal feeding dish, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top elevational view of our new animal feeding dish  
FIG. 2 is a left side view of the animal feeding dish, right side view is a mirror image  
FIG. 3 is an isometric view of the animal feeding dish; and, FIG. 4 is a front view of the animal feeding dish, rear view is a mirror image.  
The bottom of the dish is unornamented.  
Our animal feeding dish is characterized by its bone-shaped design.

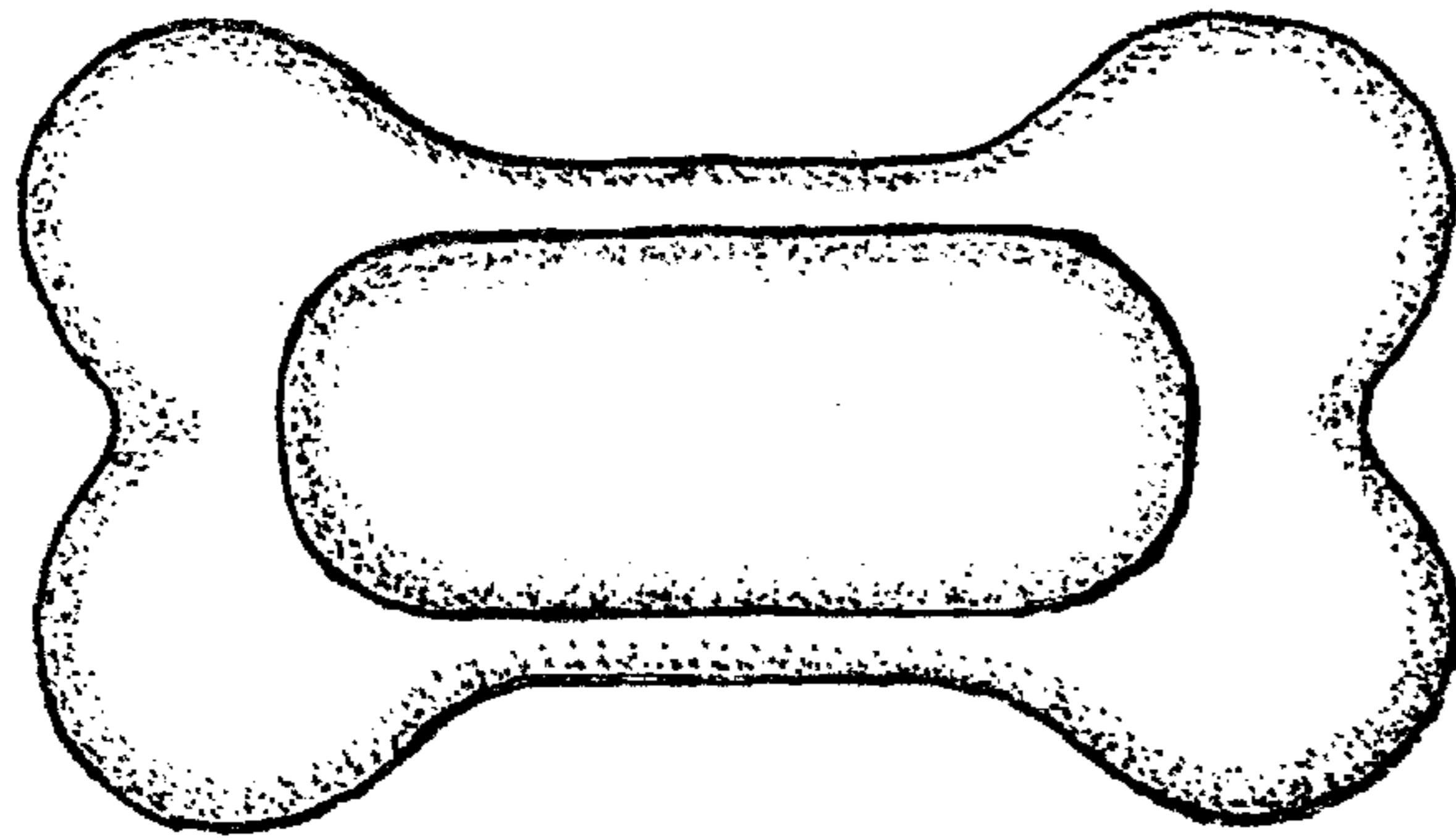

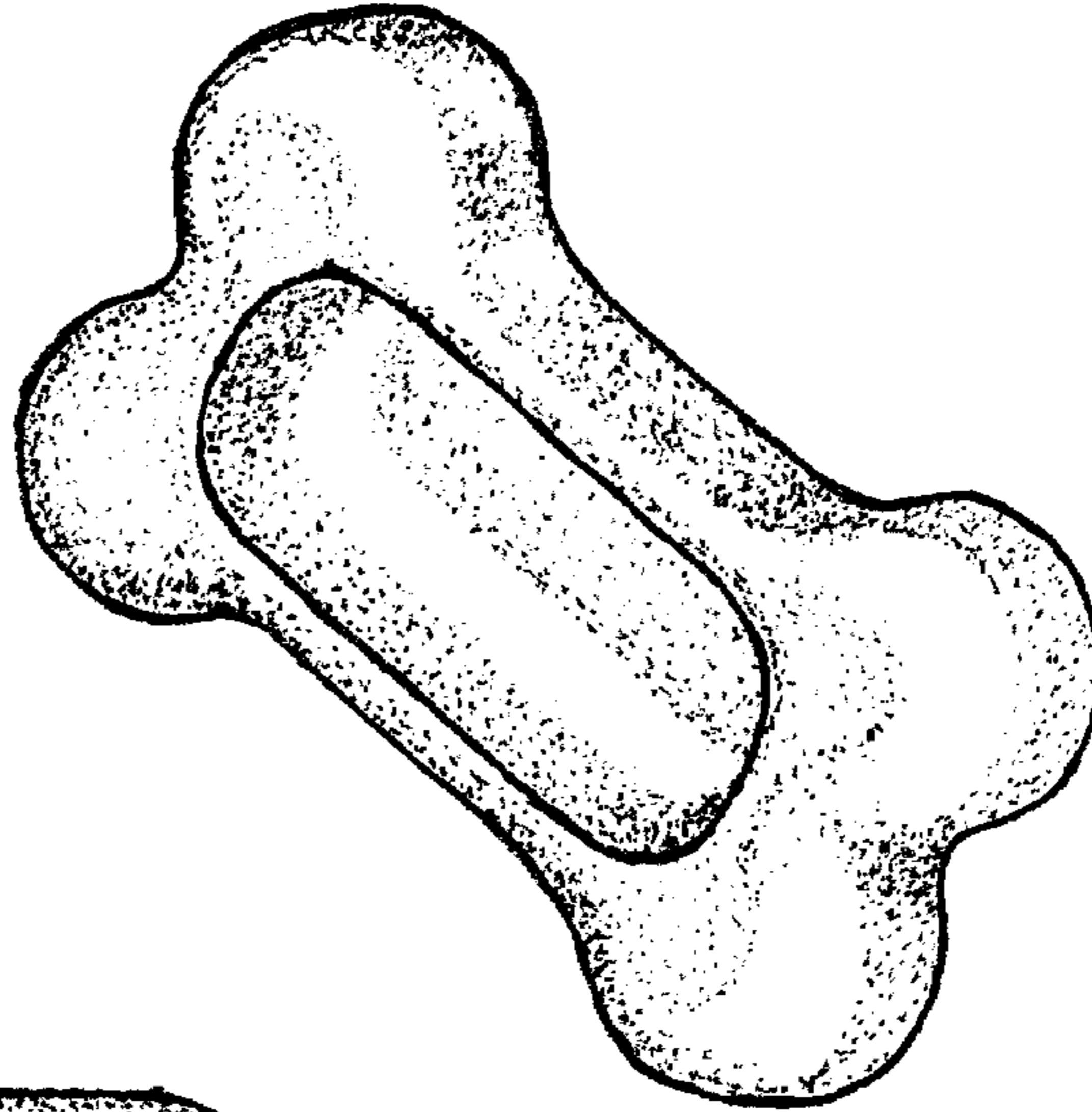
