(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a heart-shaped floral card holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is front view of a heart-shaped floral card holder according to the present invention; the back view of the card holder is a mirror image of the front view;

FIG. 2 is a left side view of the heart-shaped floral card holder according to the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of the heart-shaped floral card holder according to the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a top view of the heart-shaped floral card holder according to the present invention; and,

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the heart-shaped floral card holder according to the present invention.

The shaft of the heart-shaped floral card holder has been shown broken away to indicate indeterminate length.

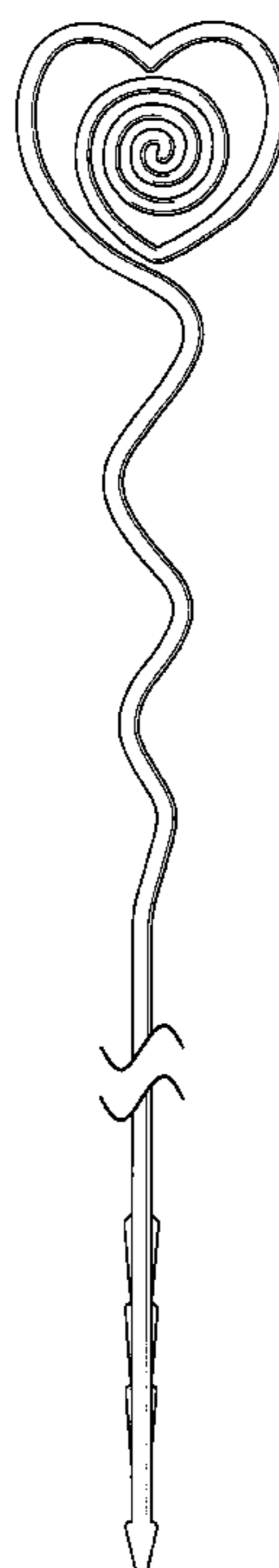

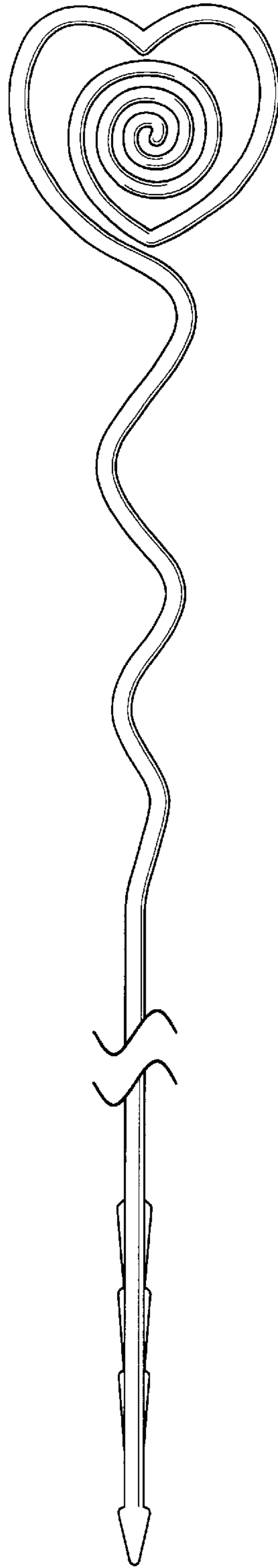

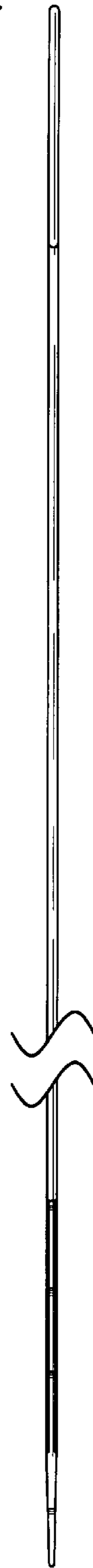

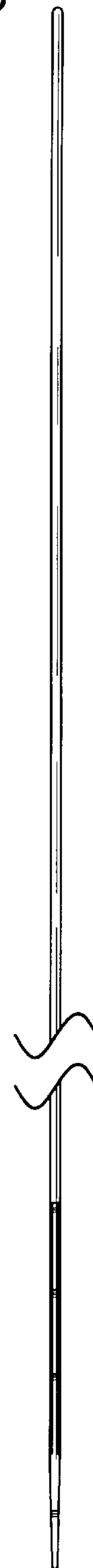

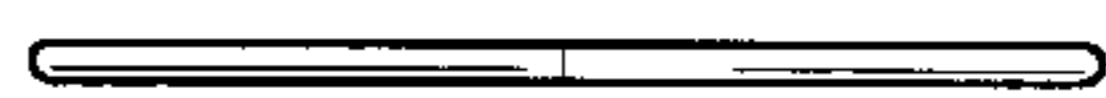
