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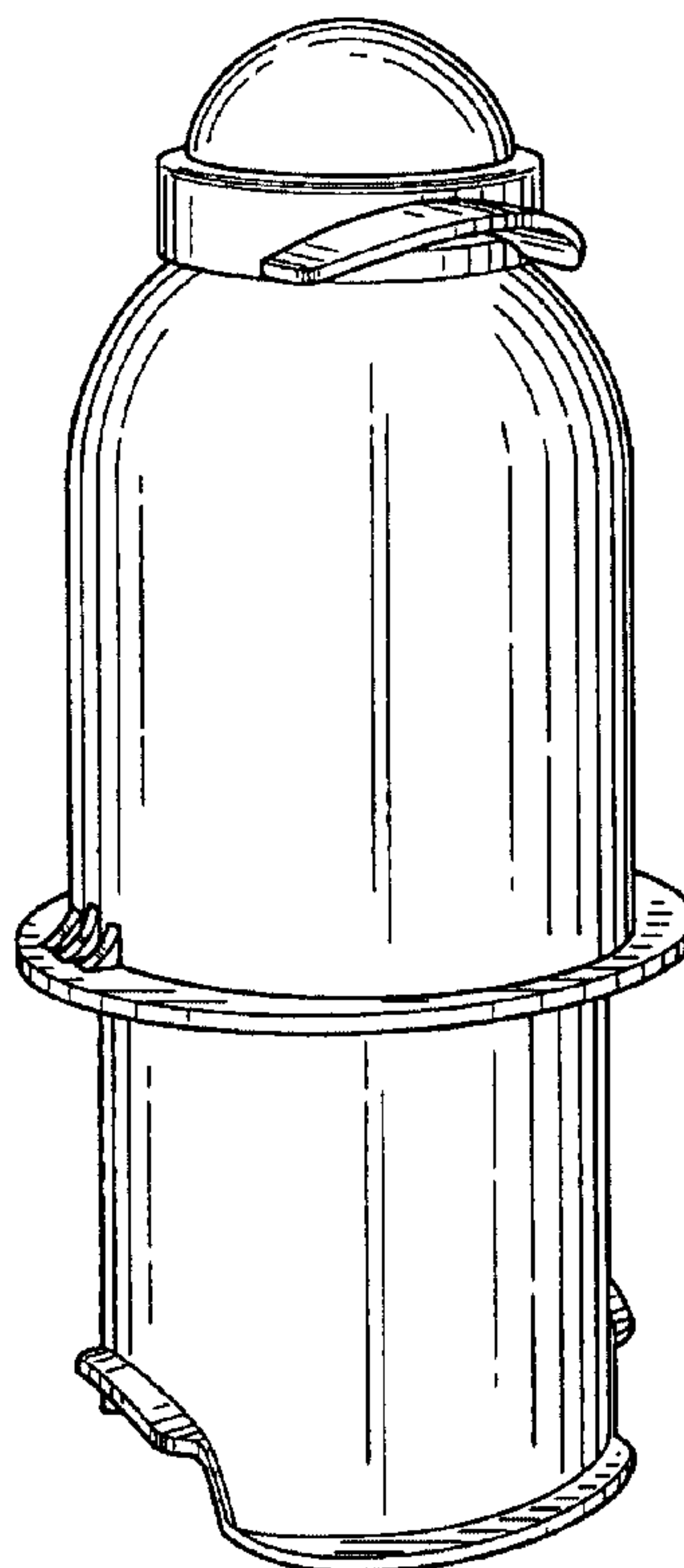
(57) **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a container for semi-liquid candy, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left elevation view thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a back elevation view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof. 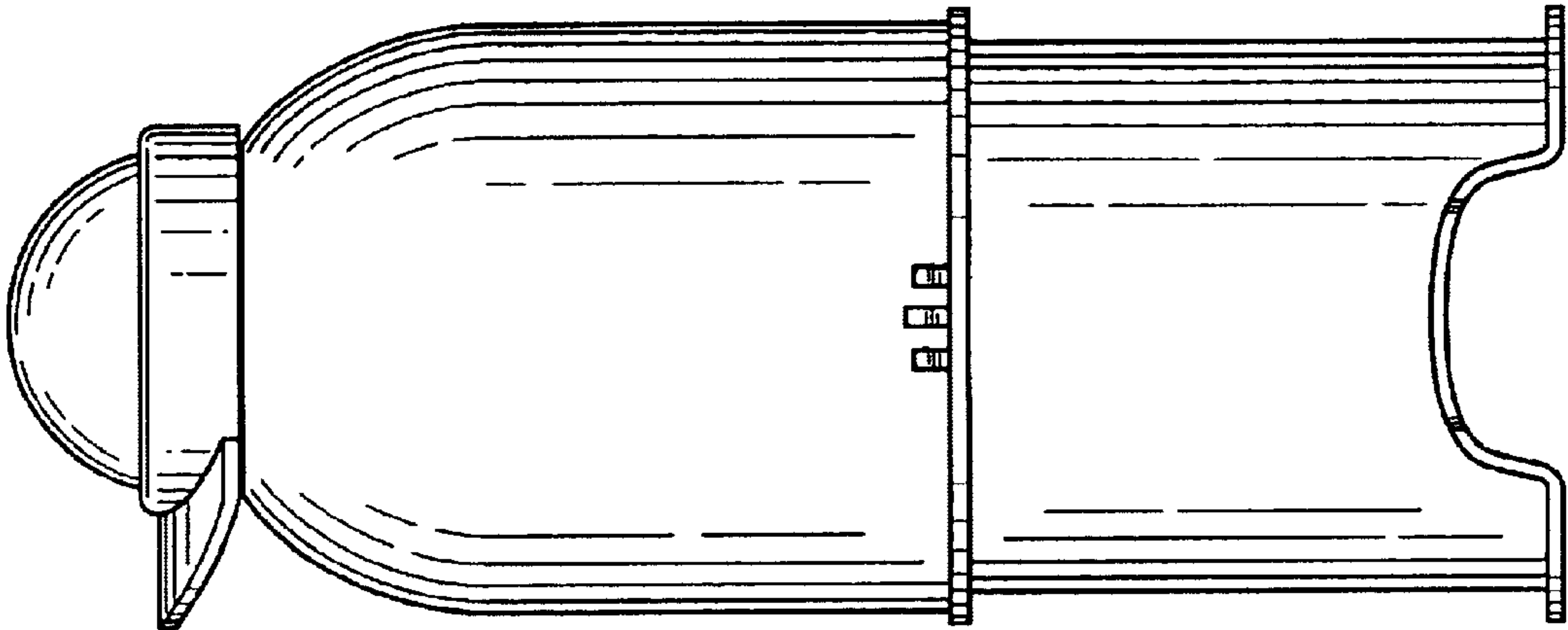

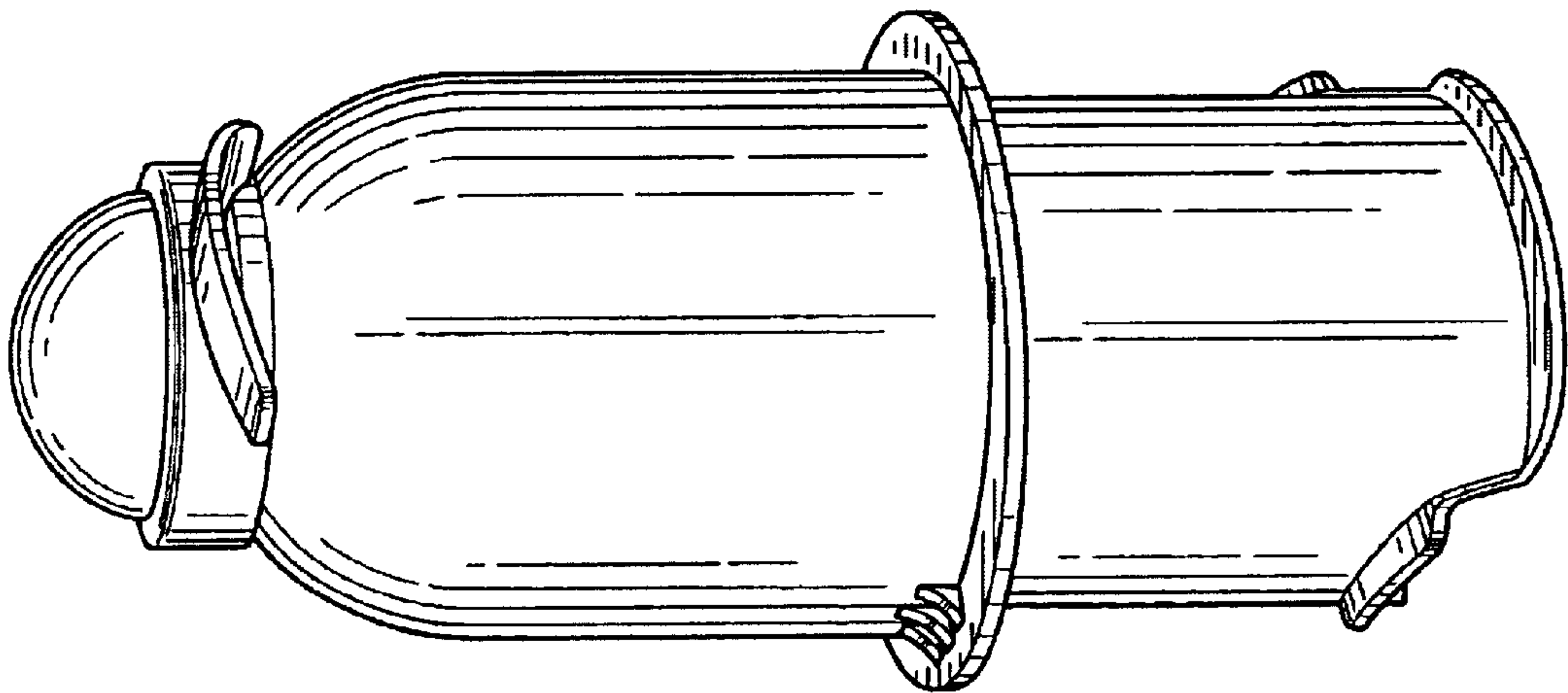

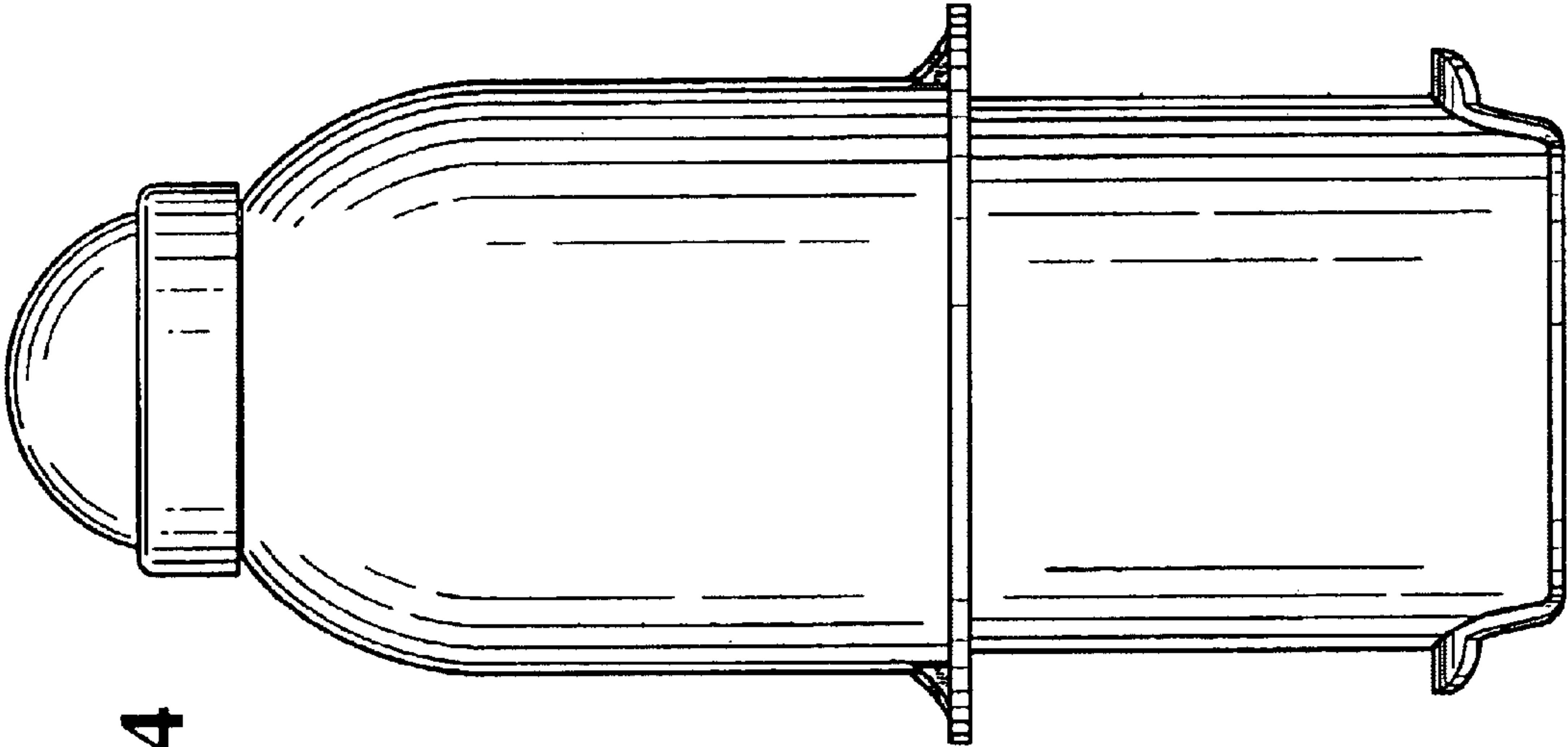

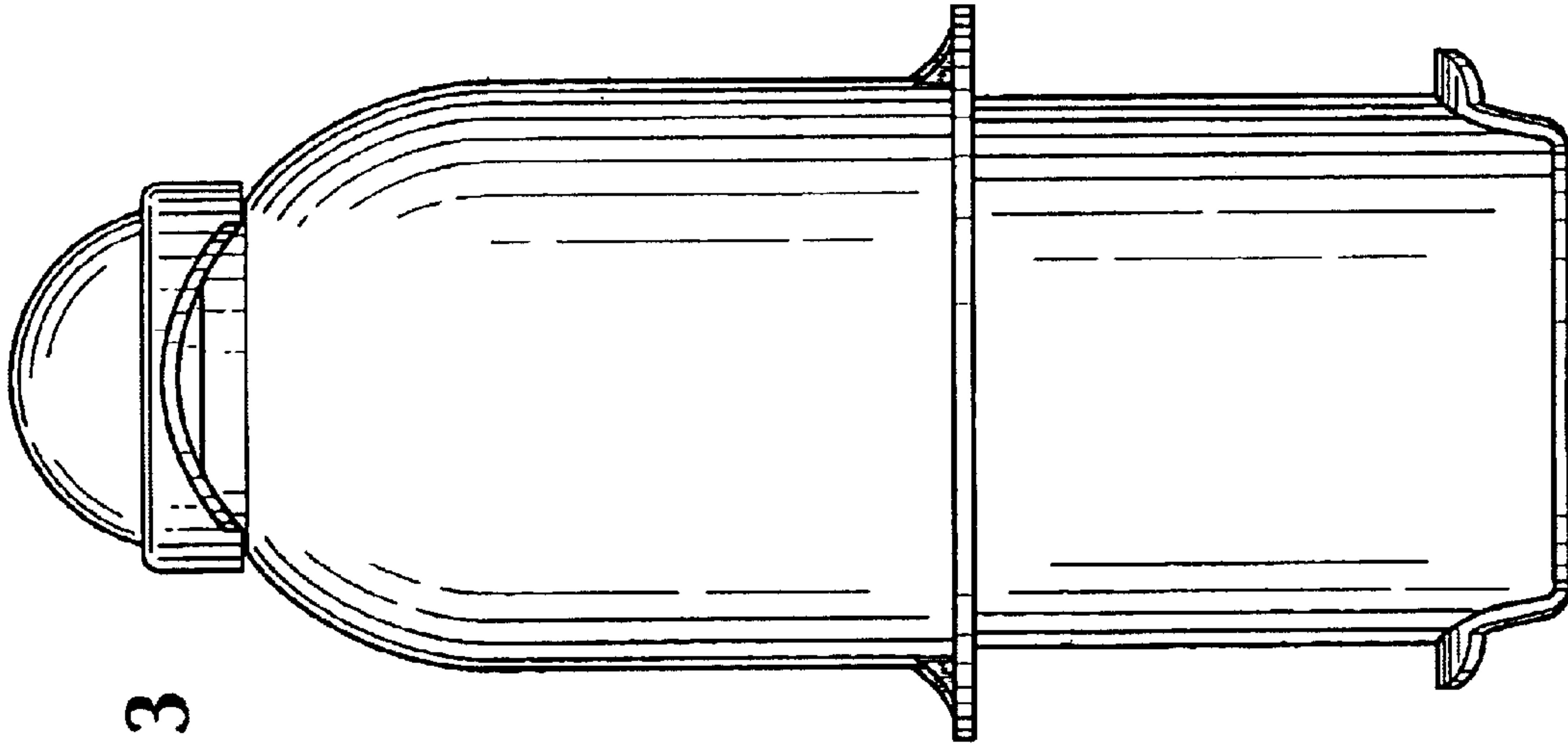
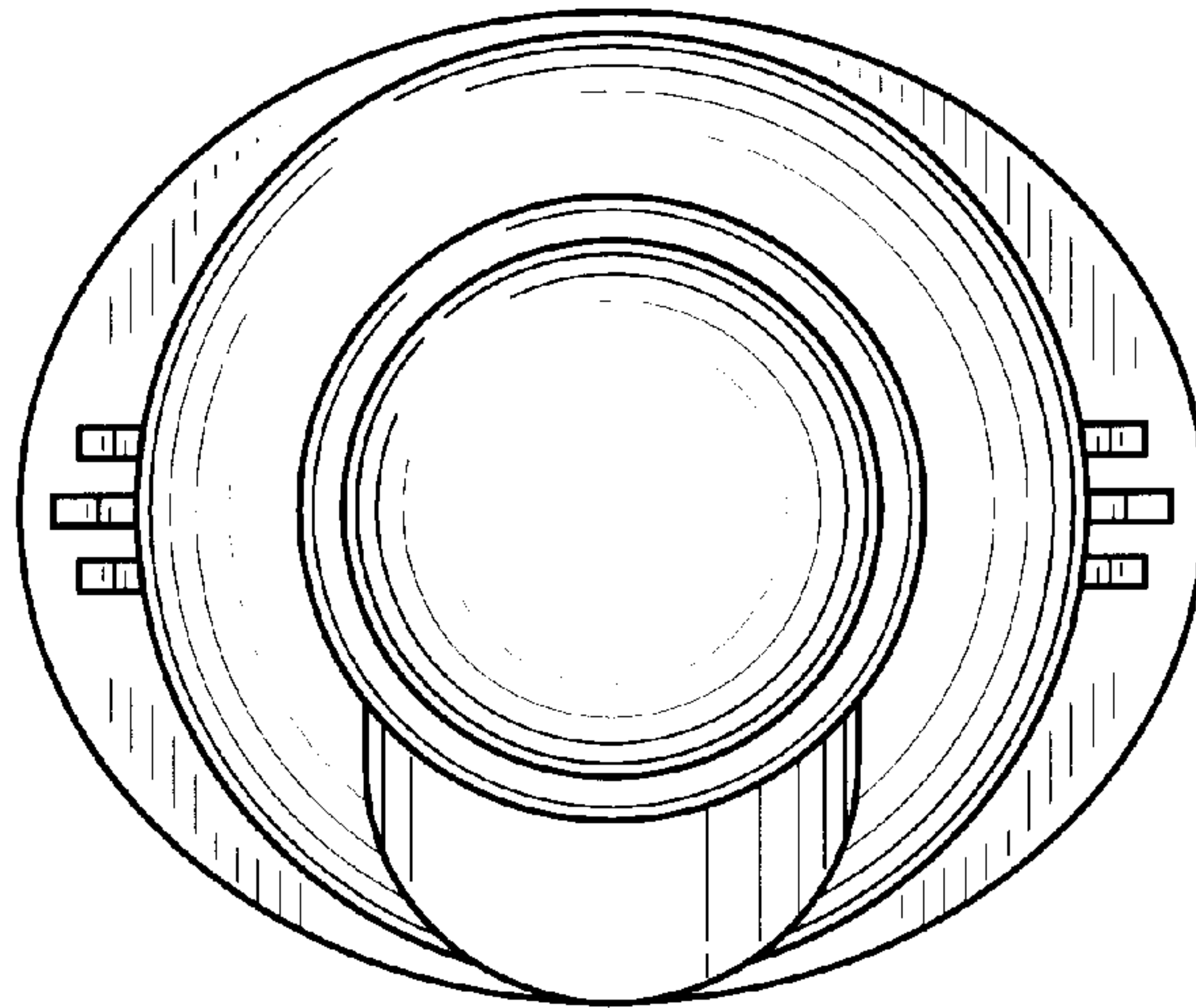
