being a mirror image.

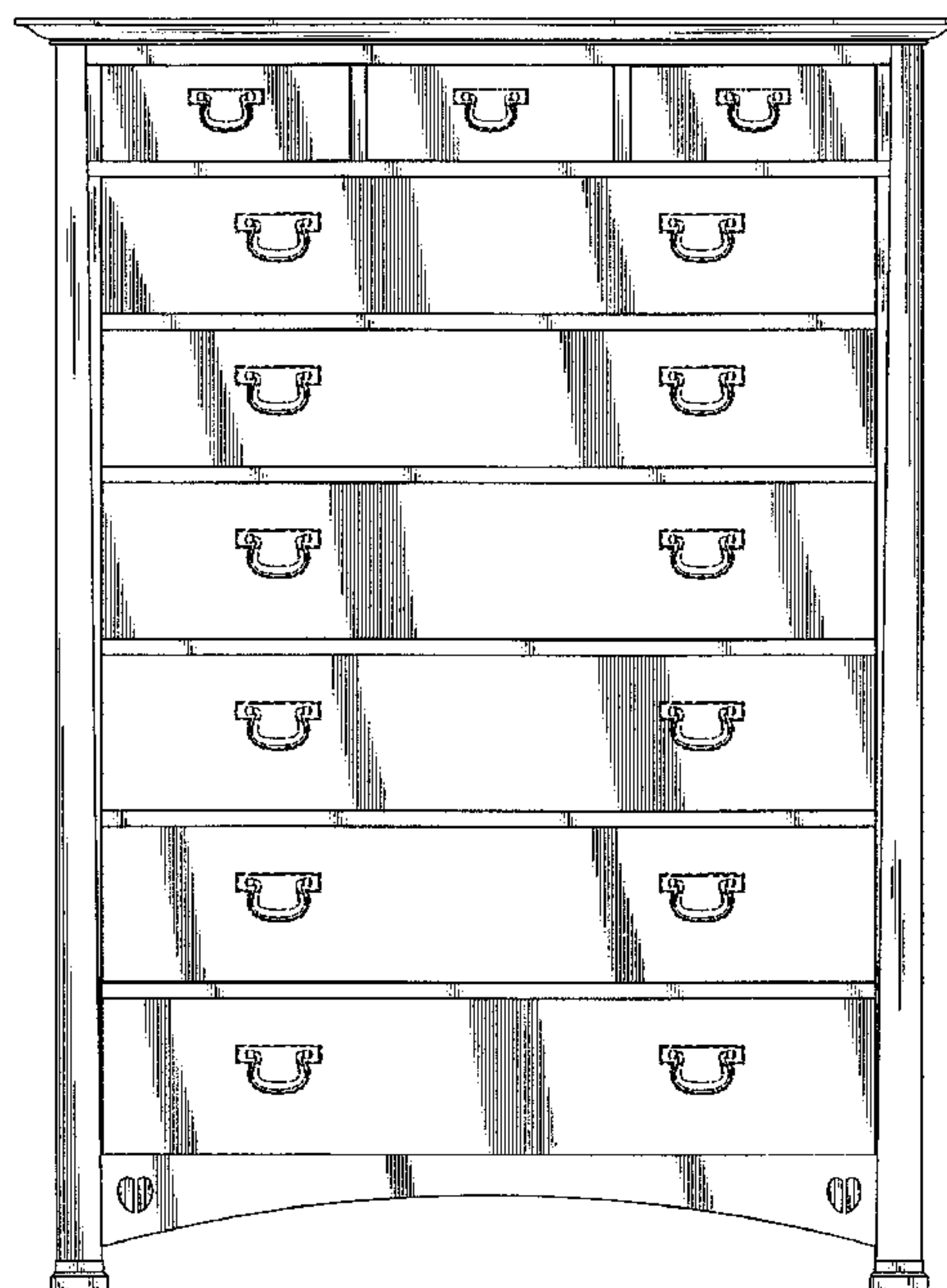
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and,

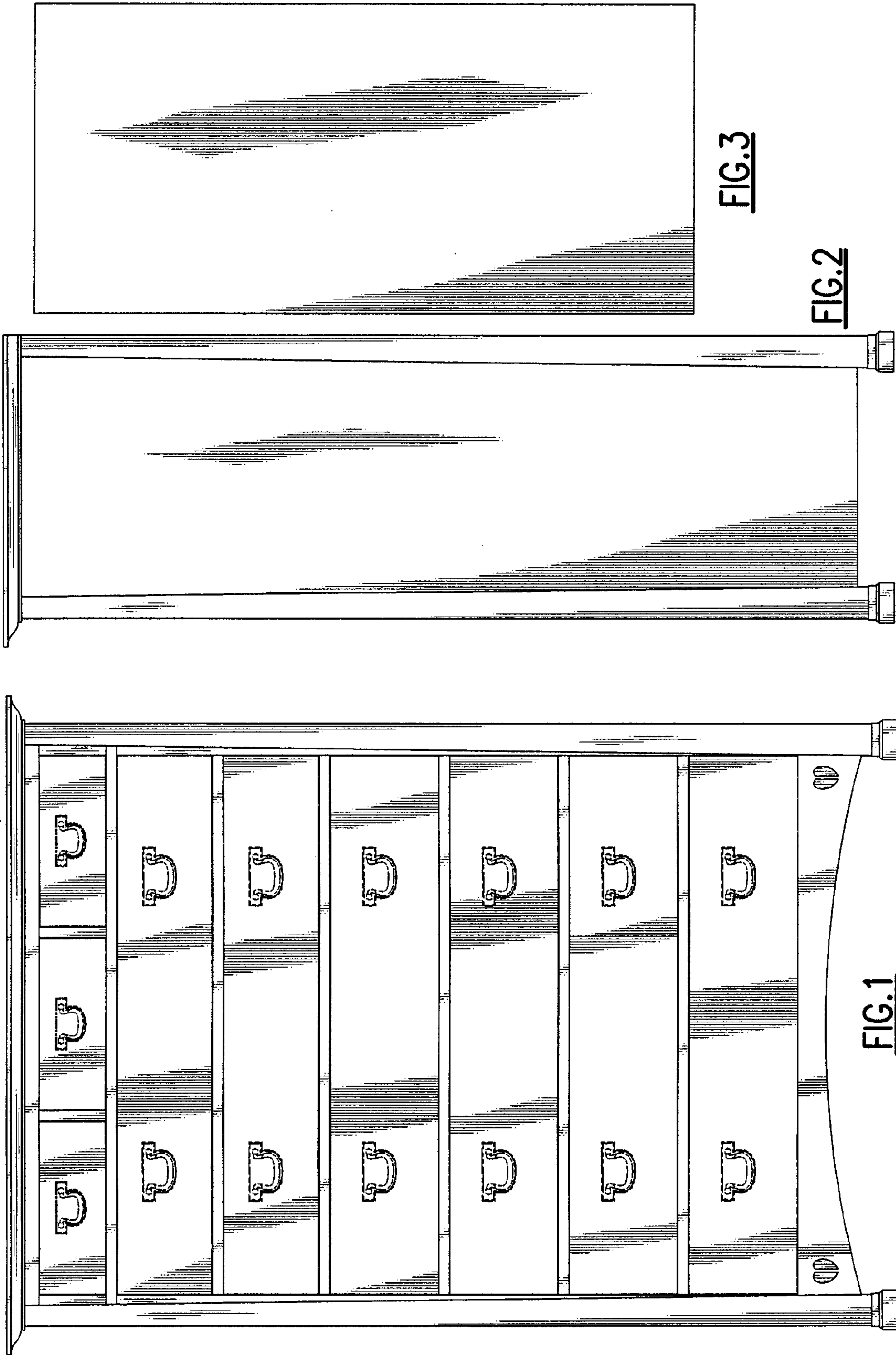
FIG. 4 is an front elevation of another embodiment with

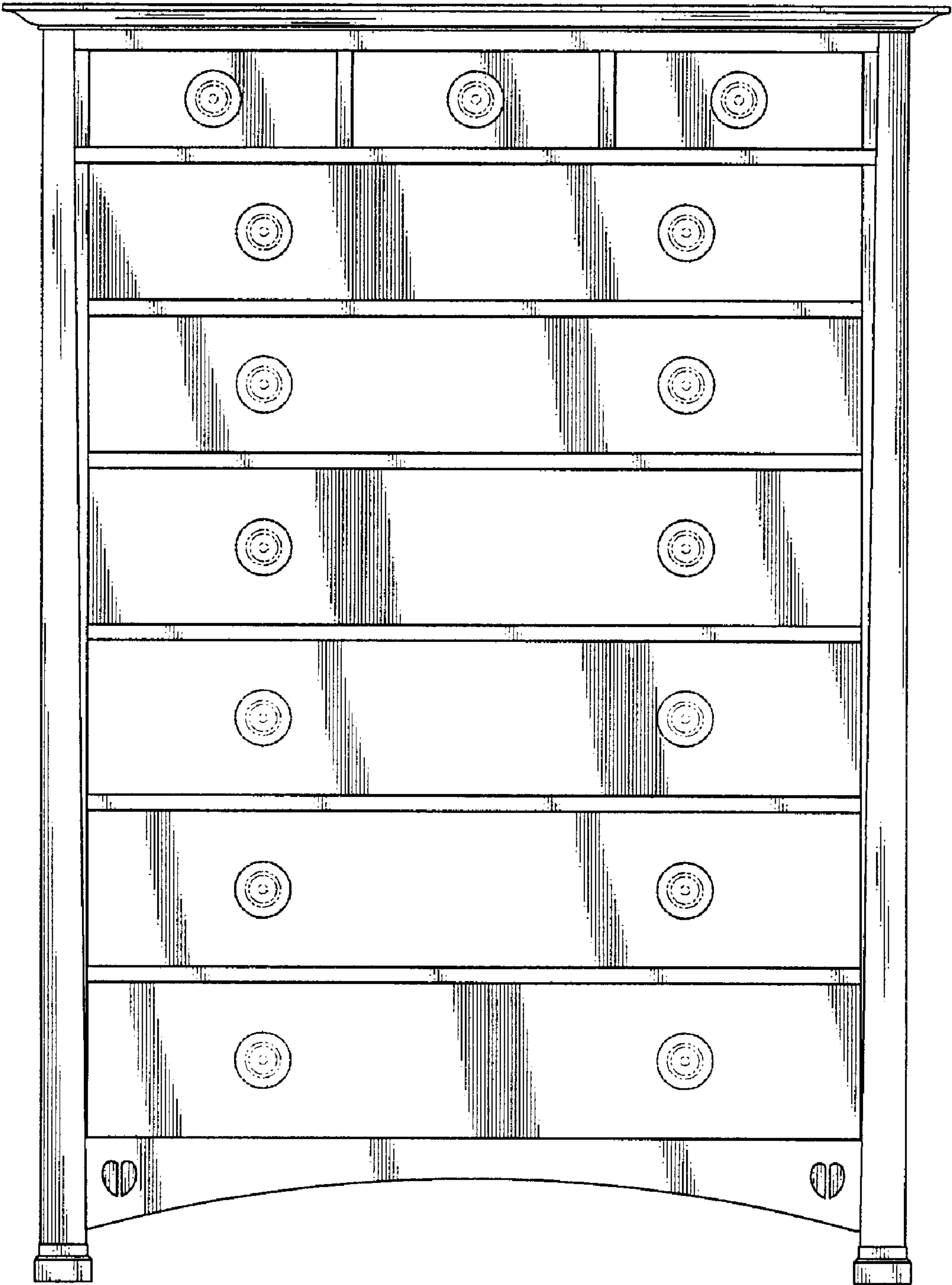
