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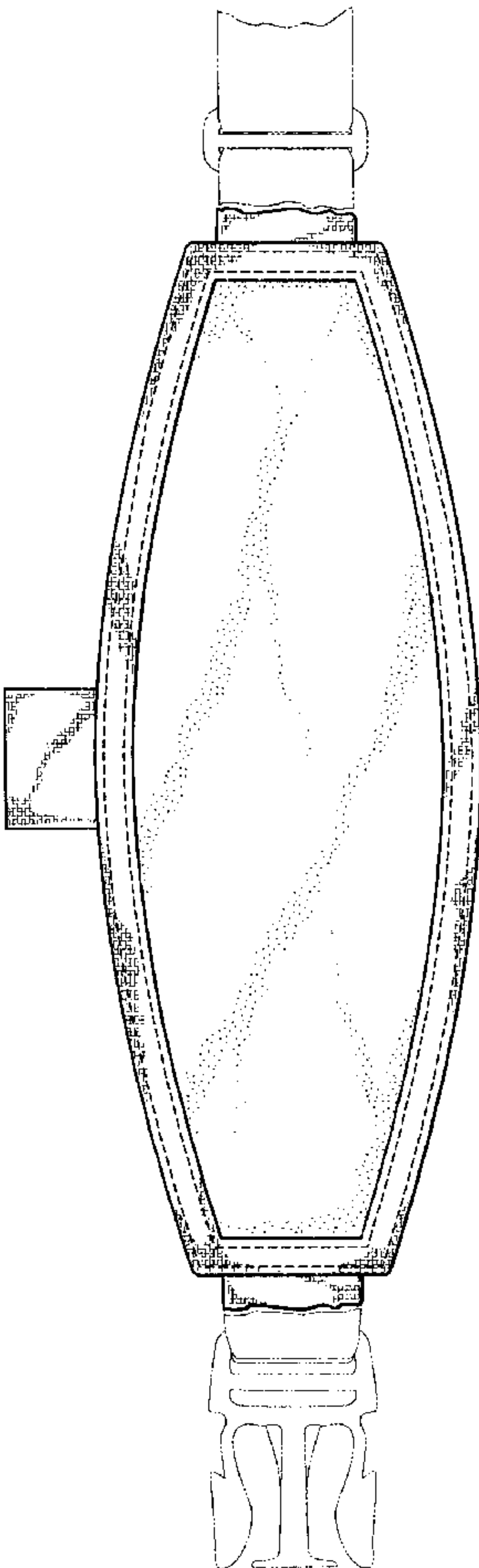
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a holder for a chest positioned article showing my new design;
FIG. 2, a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 3, a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4, a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5, an elevation view of one end thereof; and,
FIG. 6, an elevation view of the opposite end thereof.

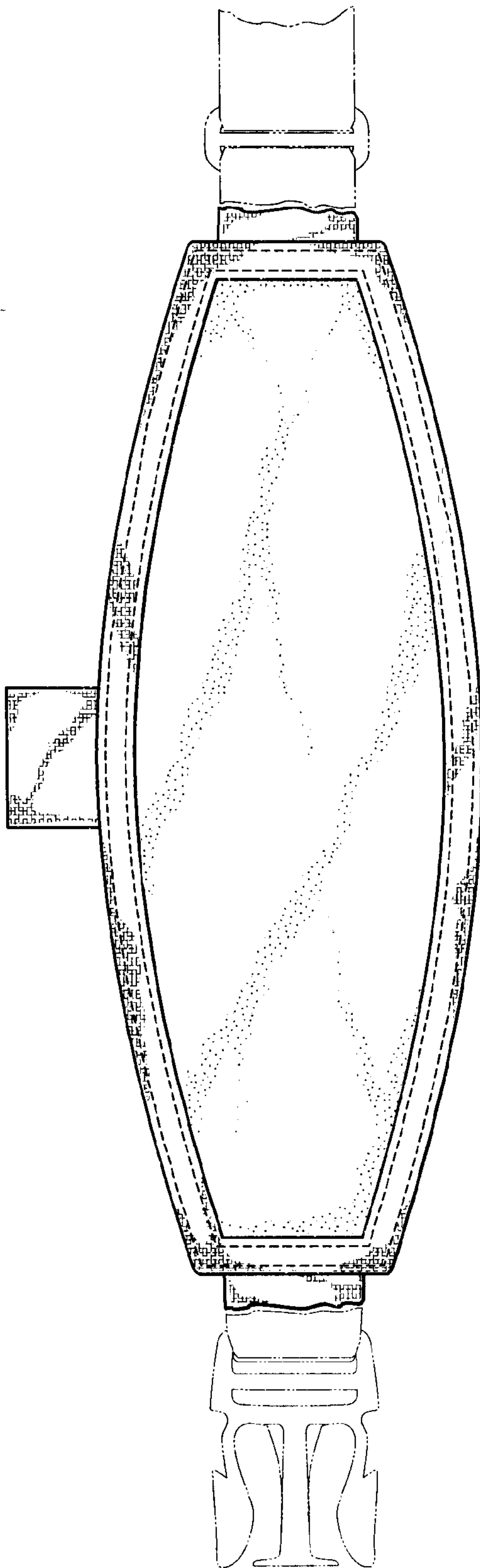

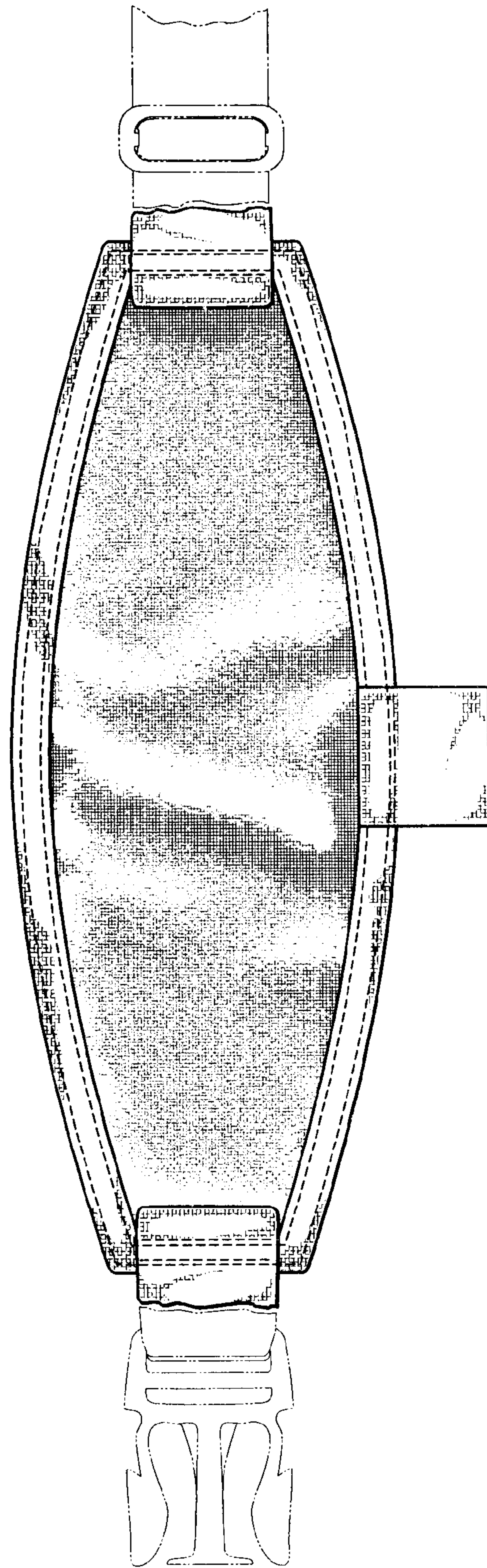

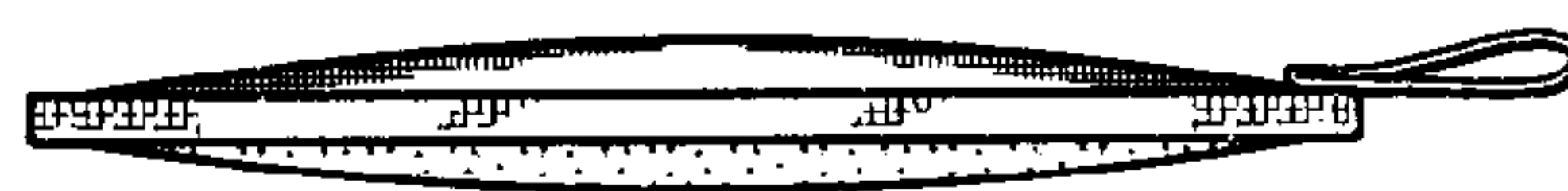

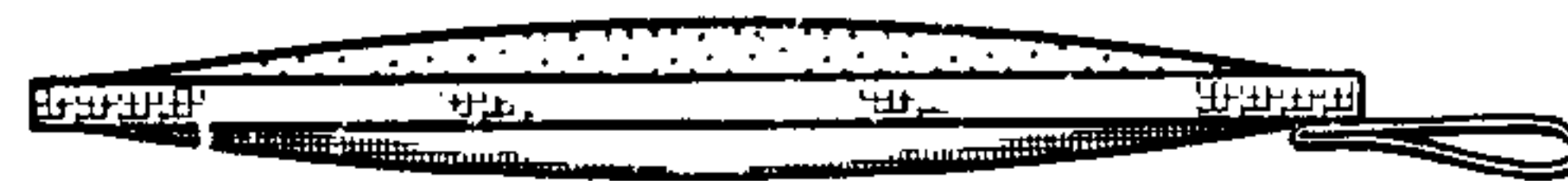
