DESCRIPTION

FIG. 2 is a top elevation of a bicycle frame according to of our new design;

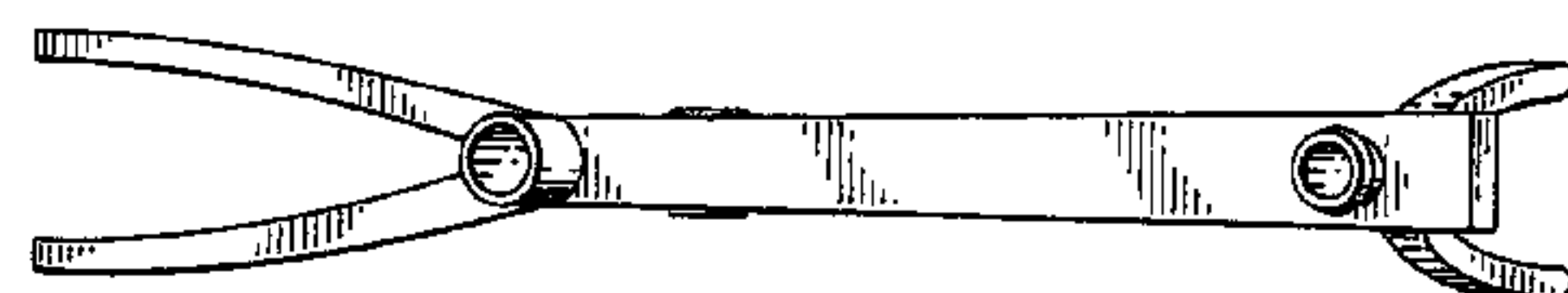
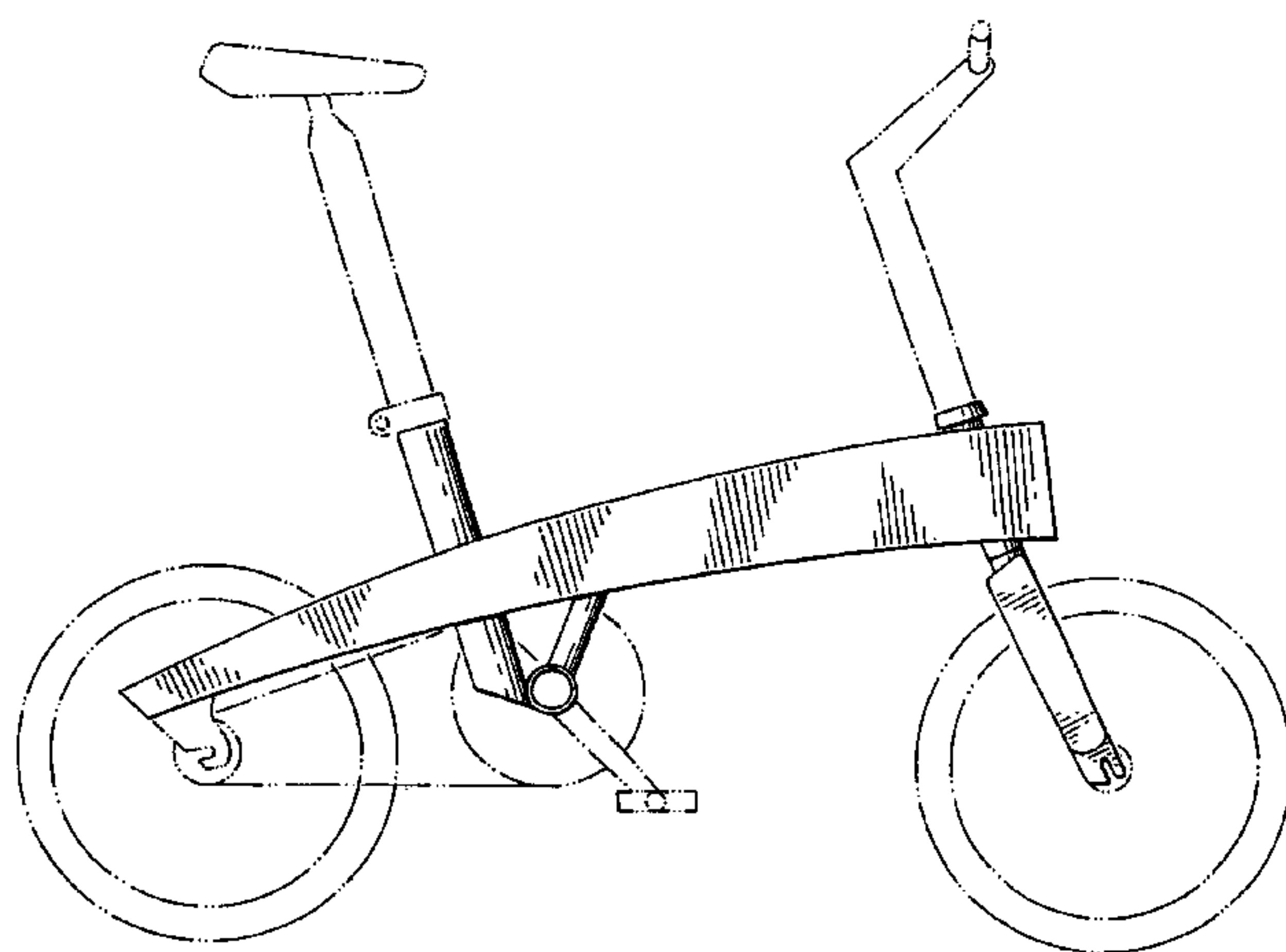
FIG. 3 is a bottom elevation thereof;

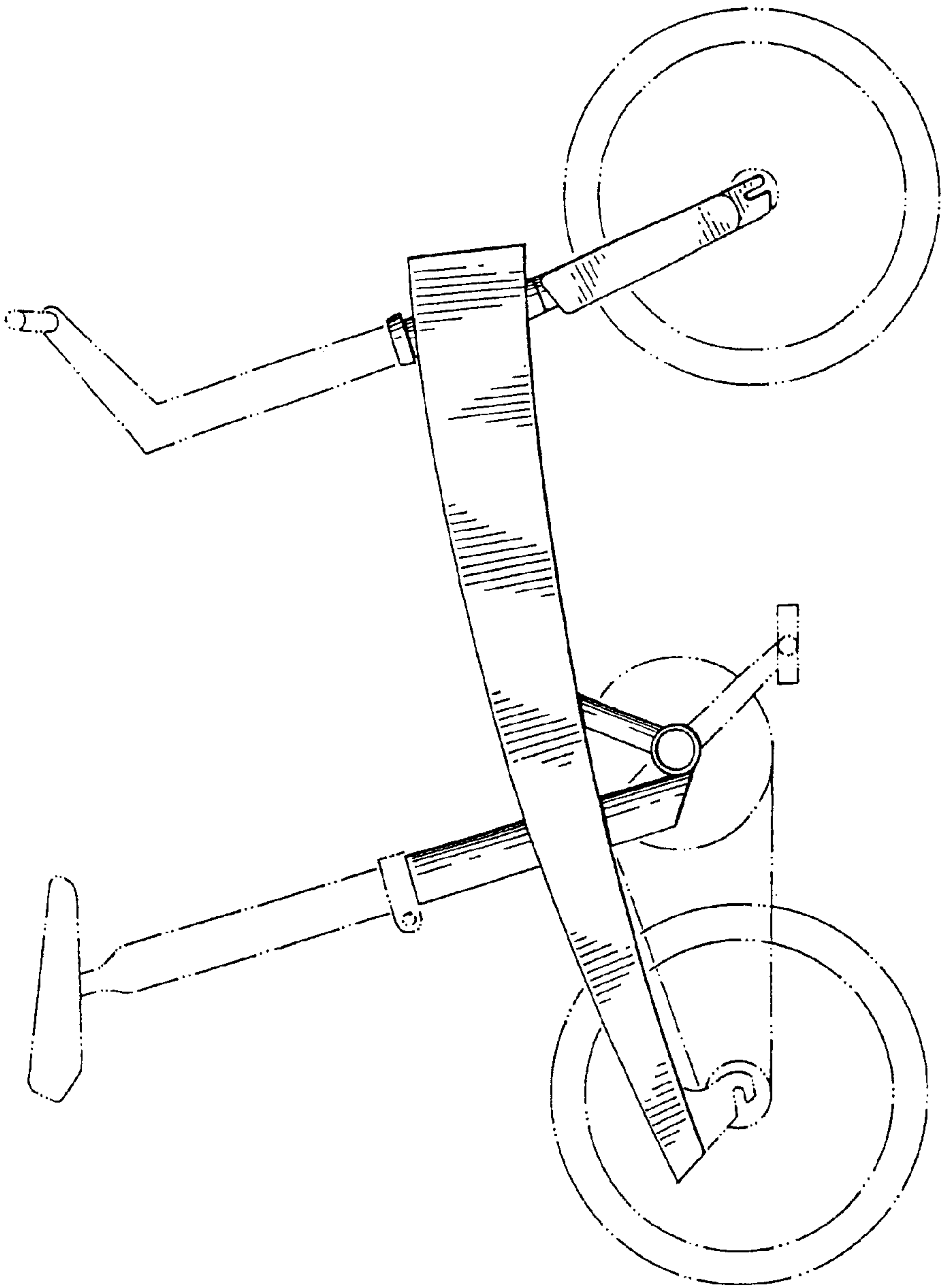

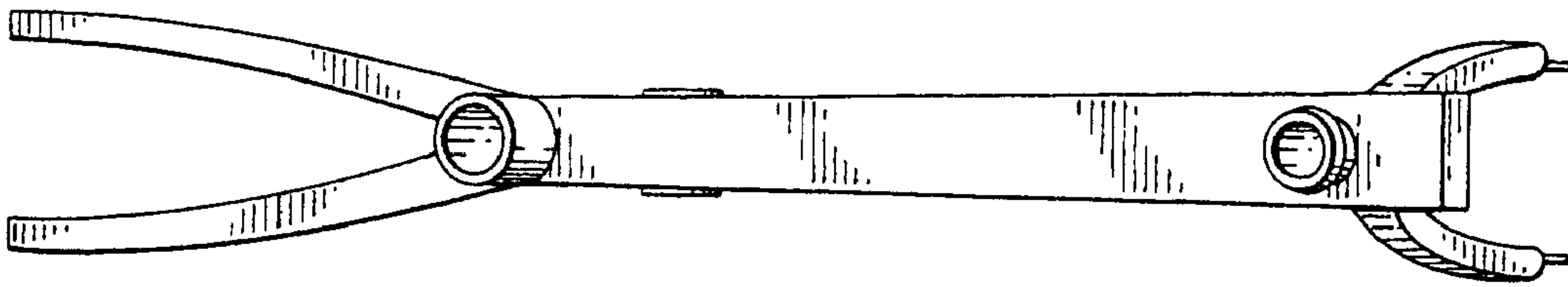

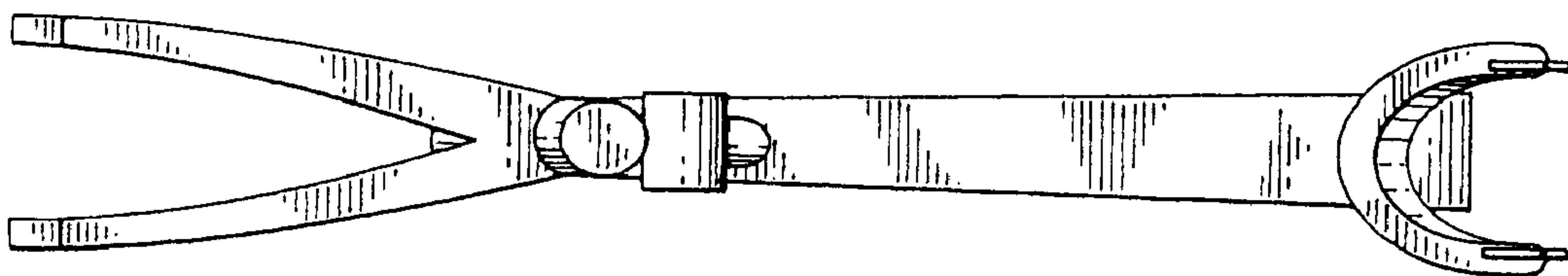

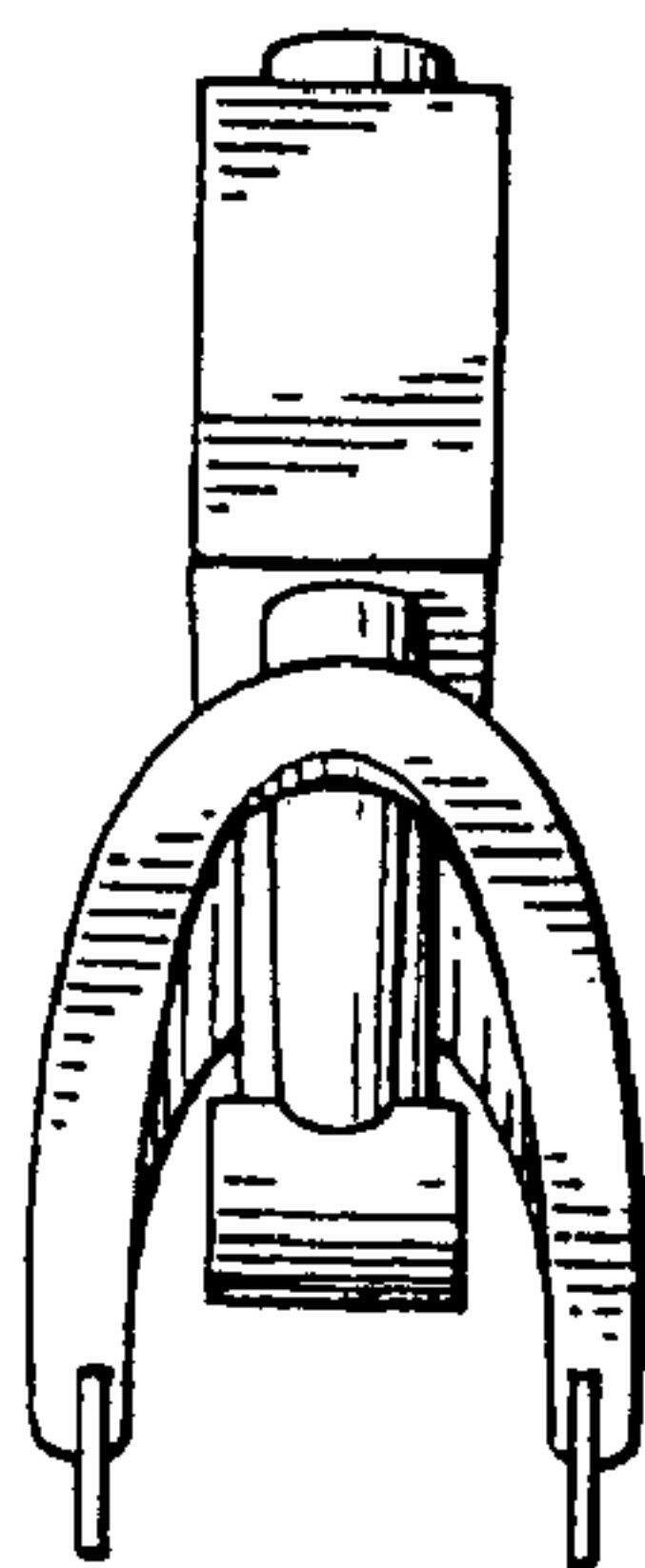

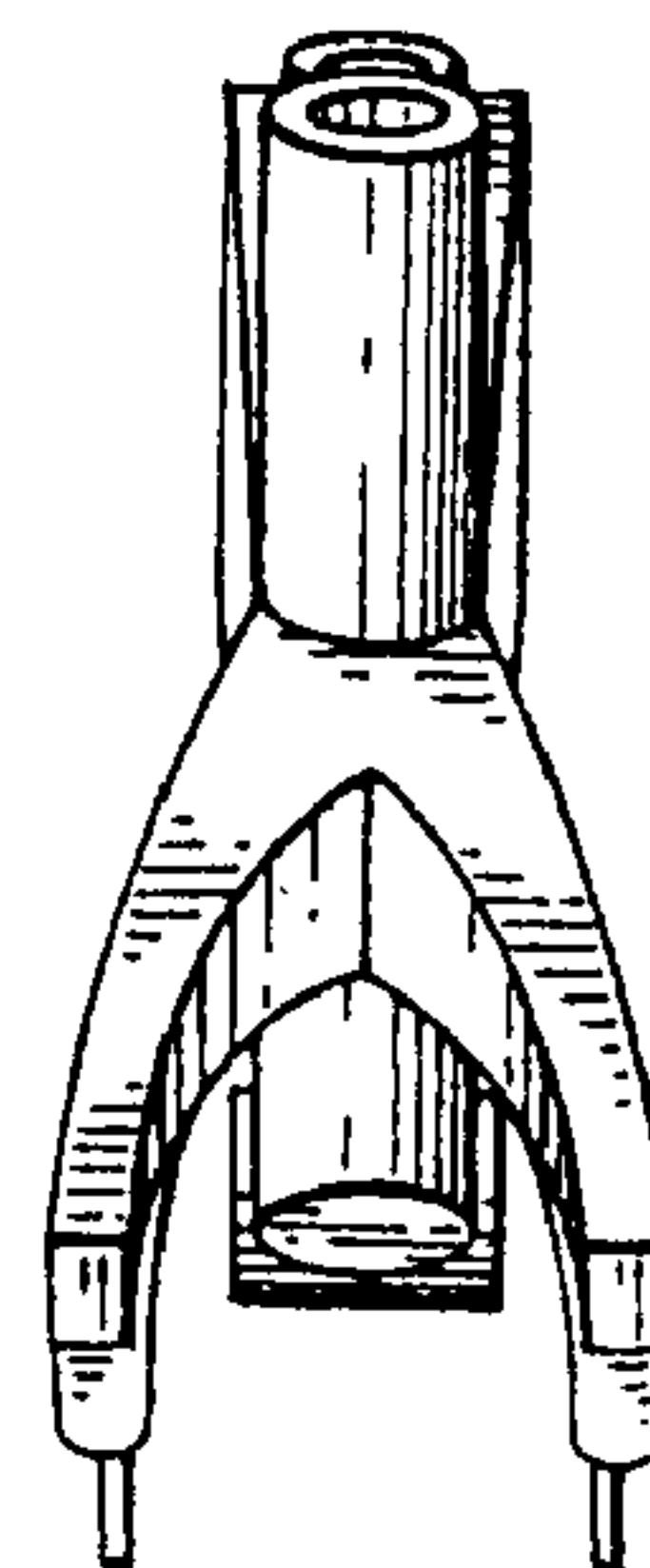
