DESCRIPTION

The nature of this product is as a bottle for liquids primarily used for cleaning and sanitizing solutions.

FIG. 1 is a right, front, perspective view of a bottle embodying our new design;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevation view thereof;

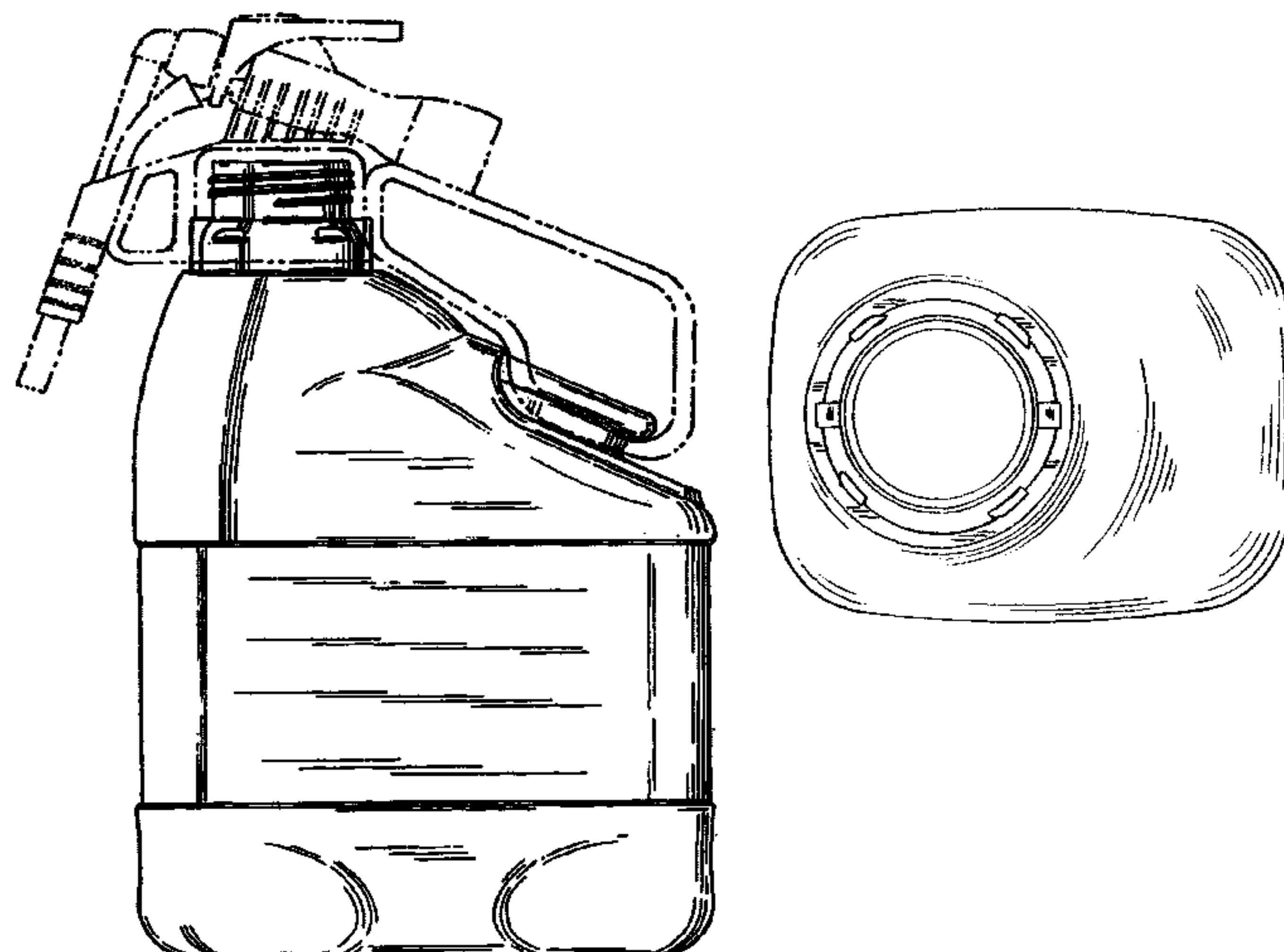
FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view thereof;

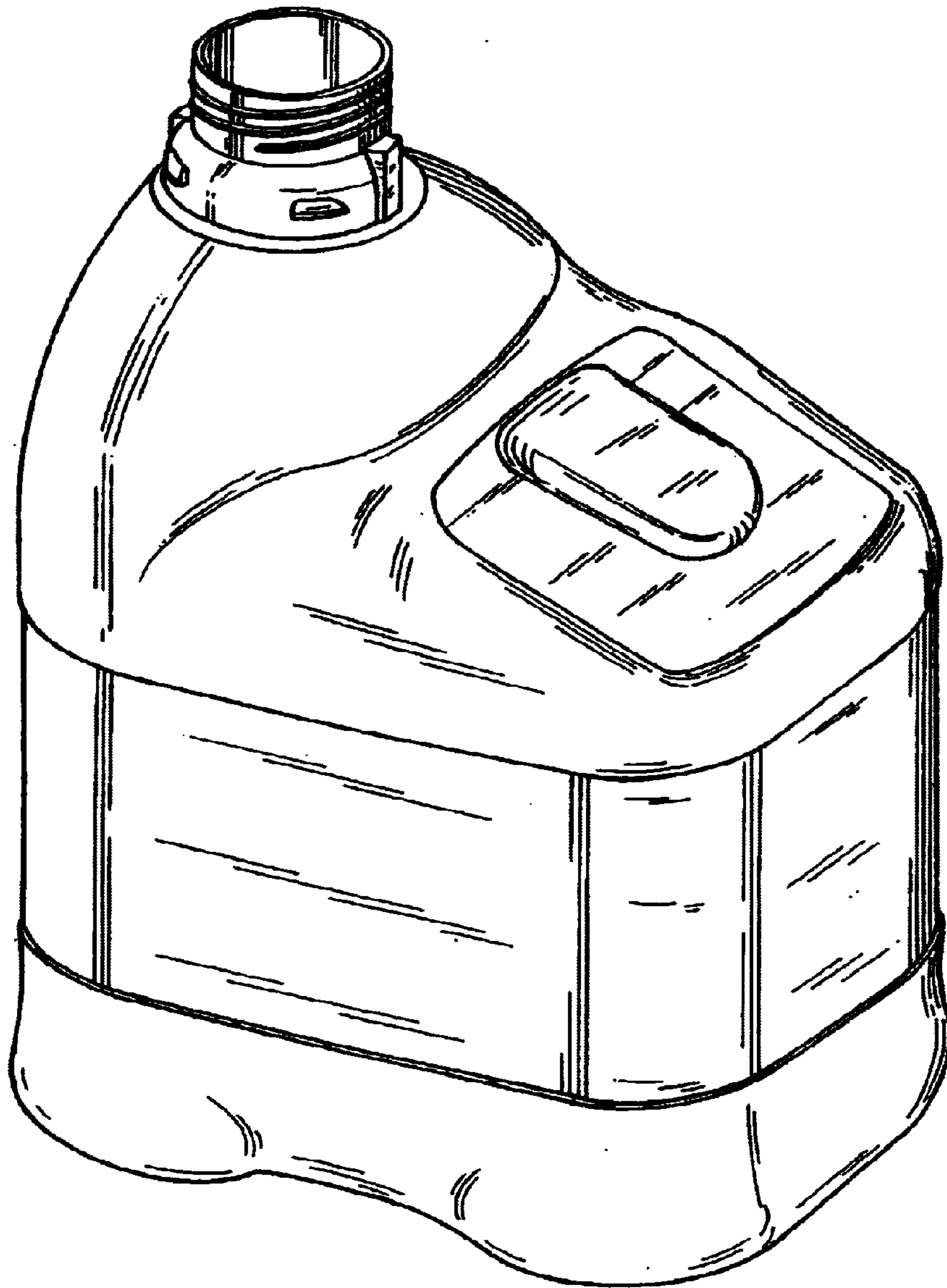

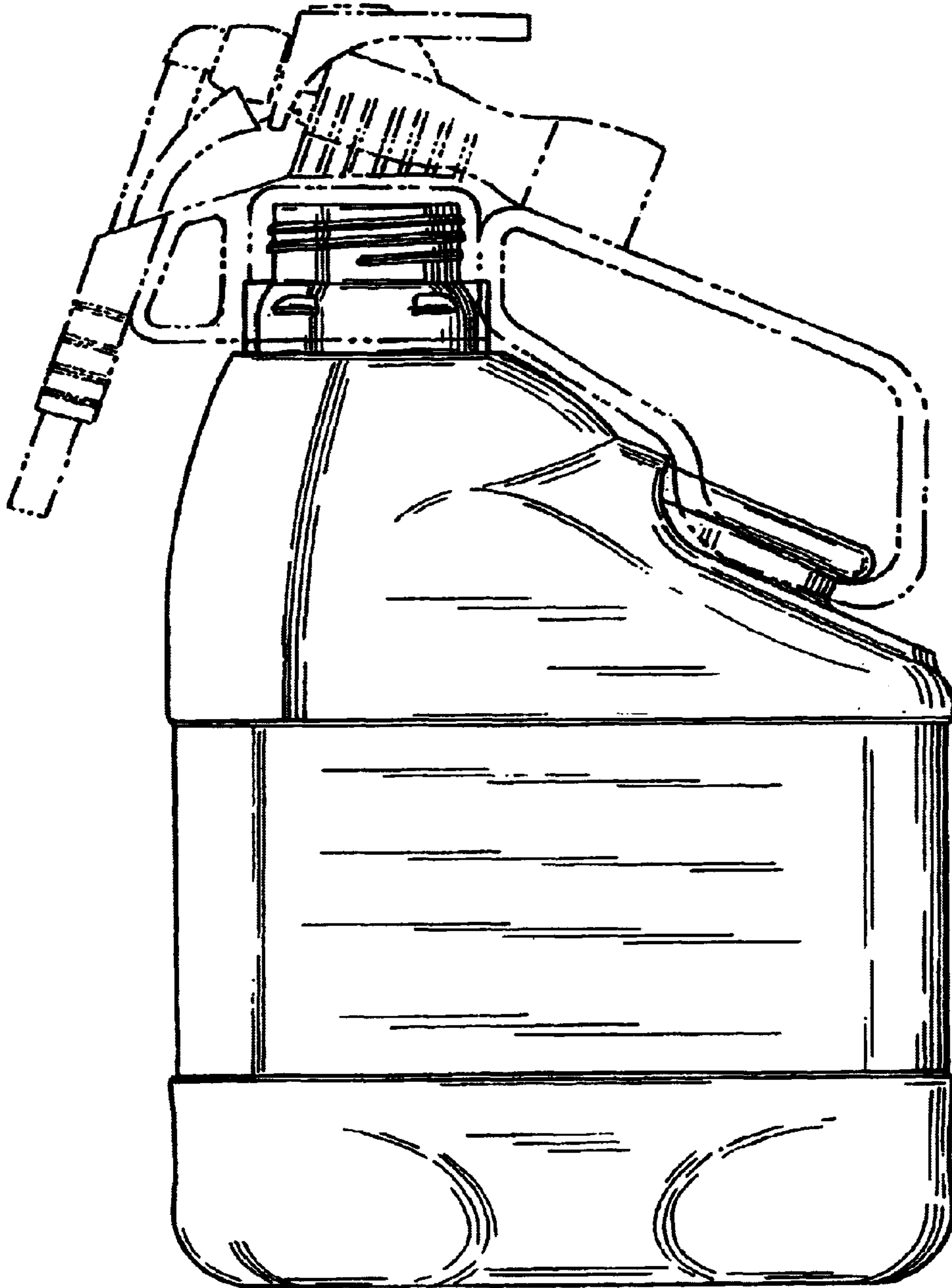

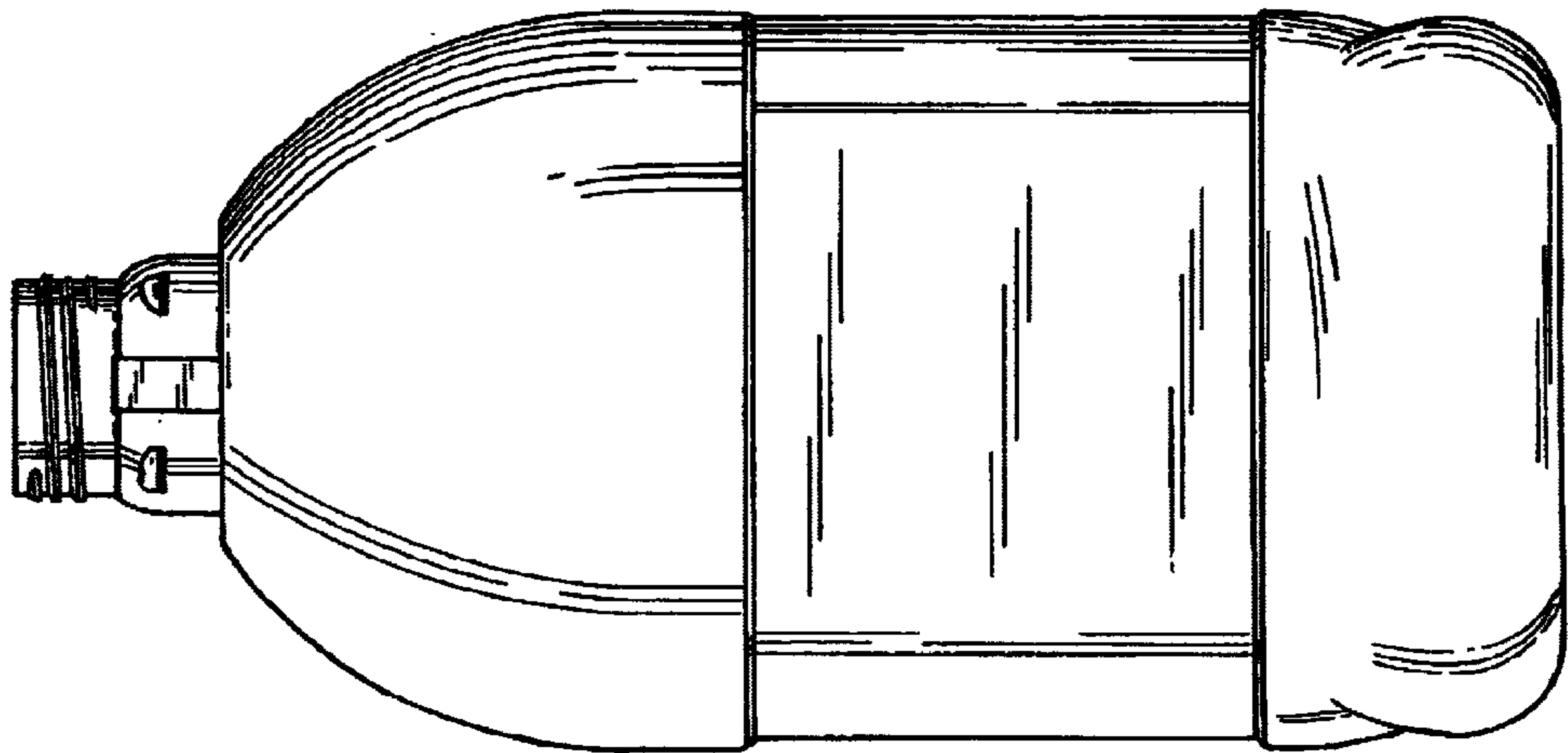

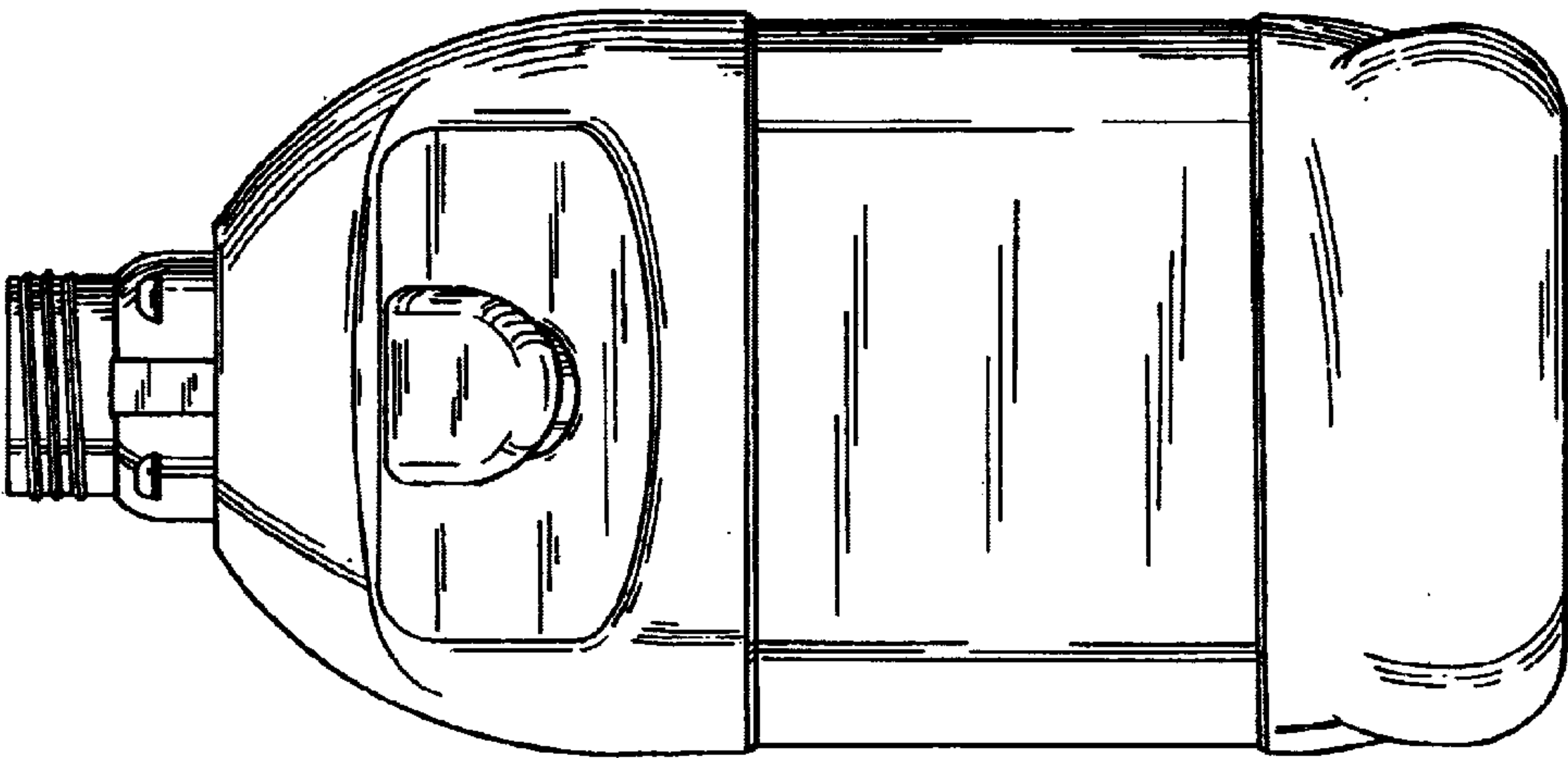

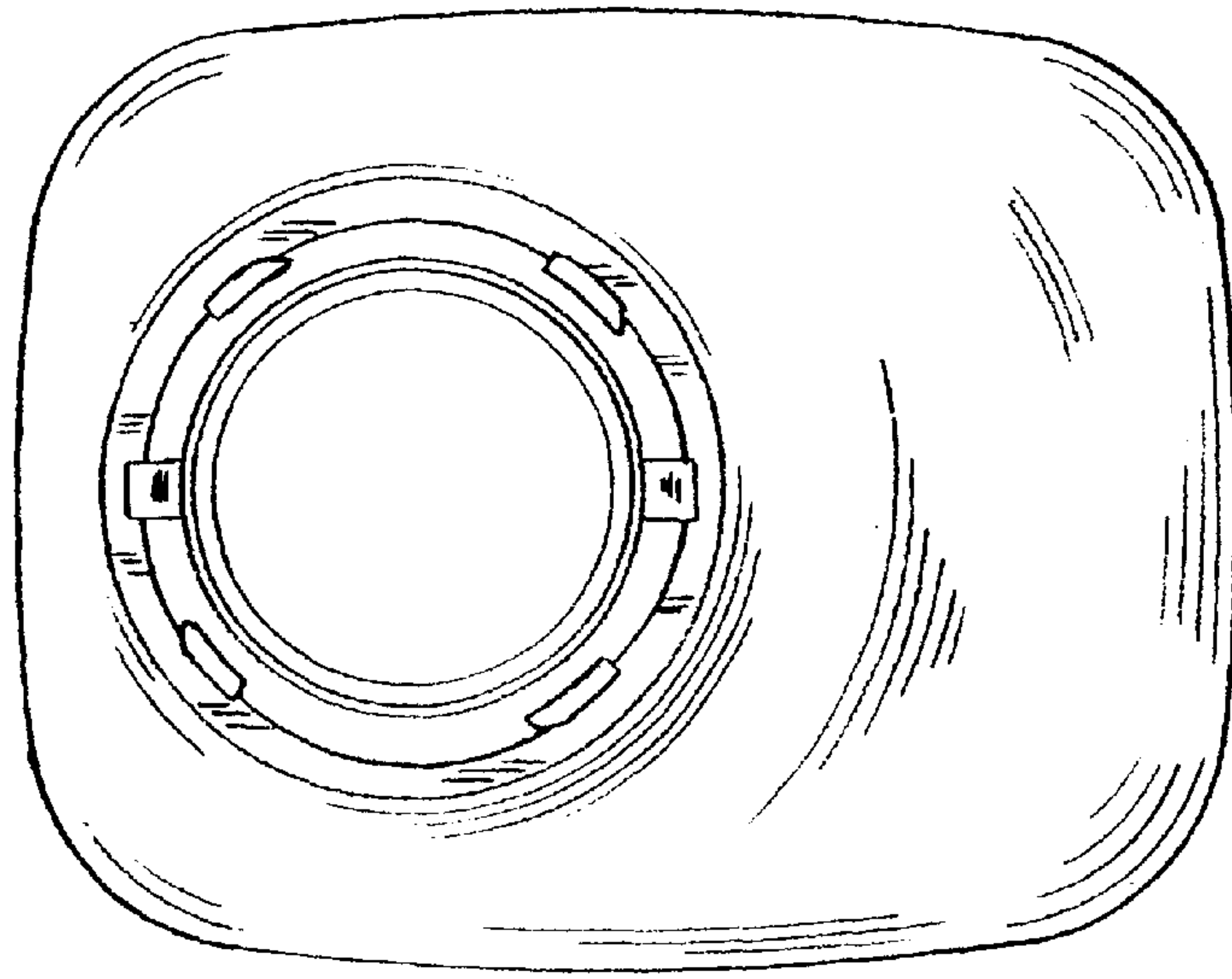

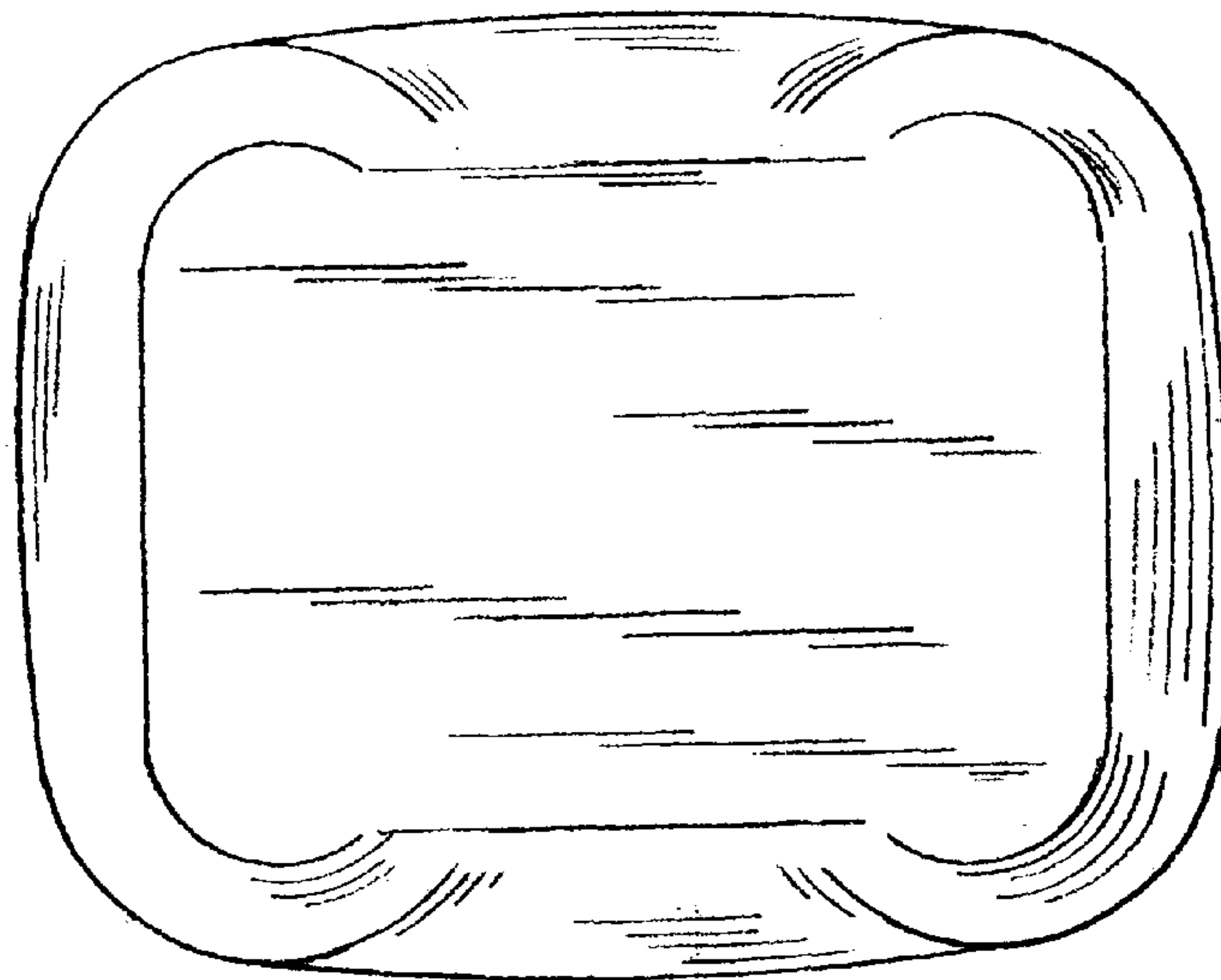
