FIG. 3 is a right side view of the game piece stack as shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.

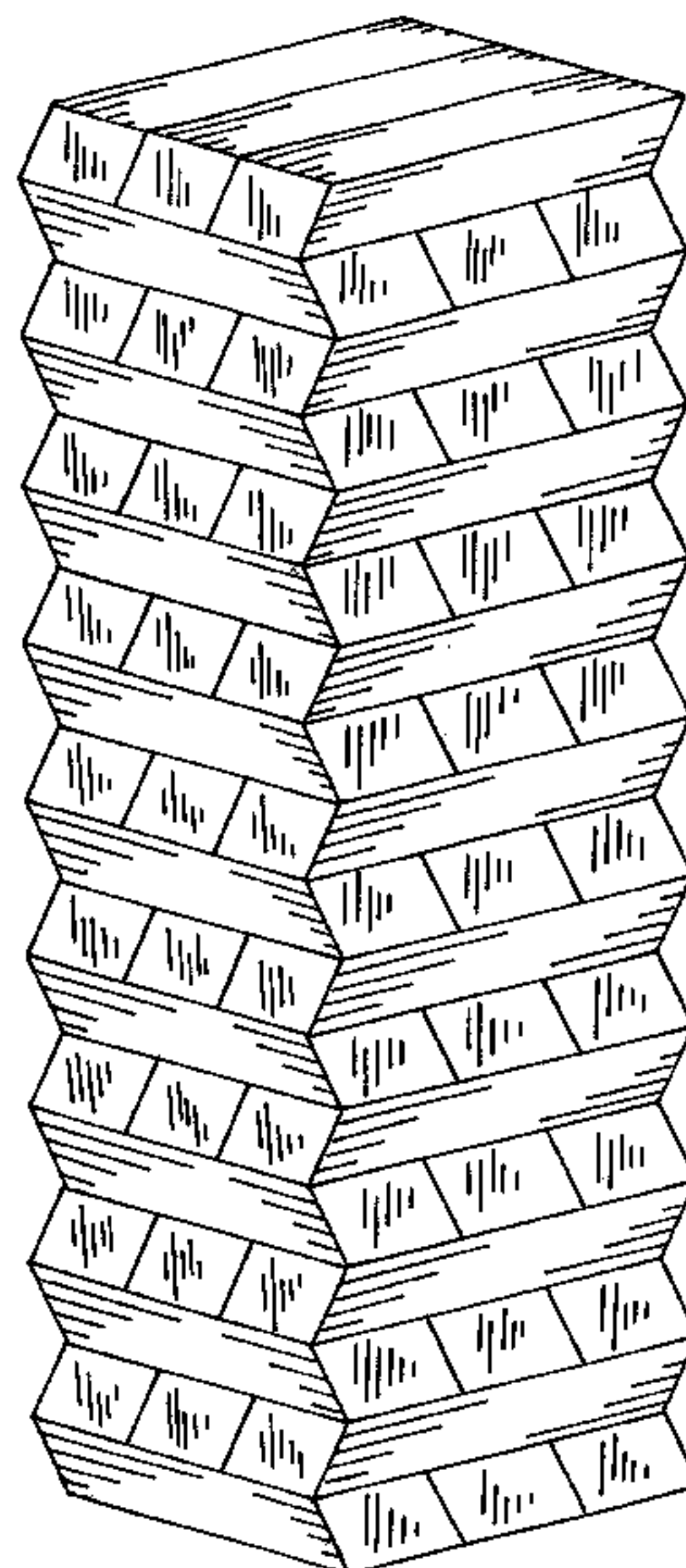
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the game piece stack as shown in FIGS. 1 and 2.

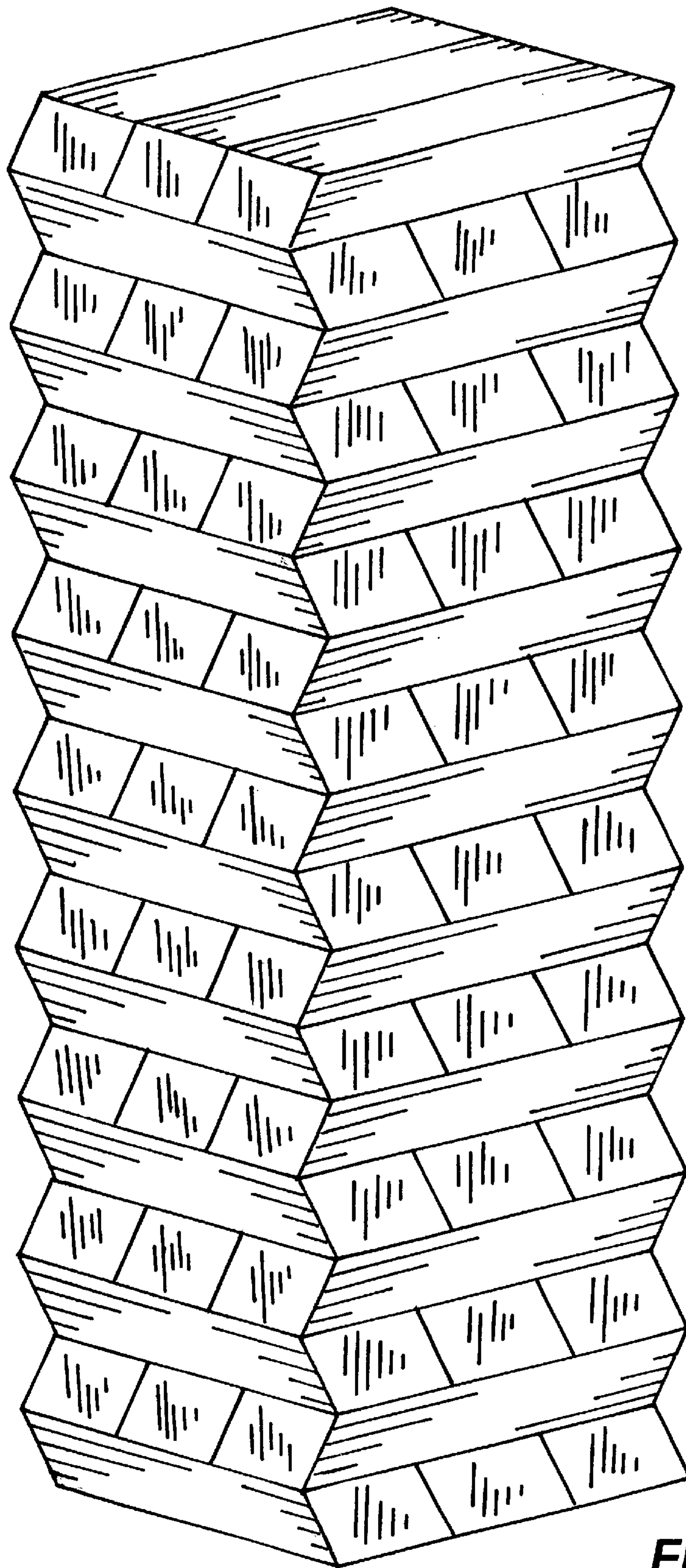

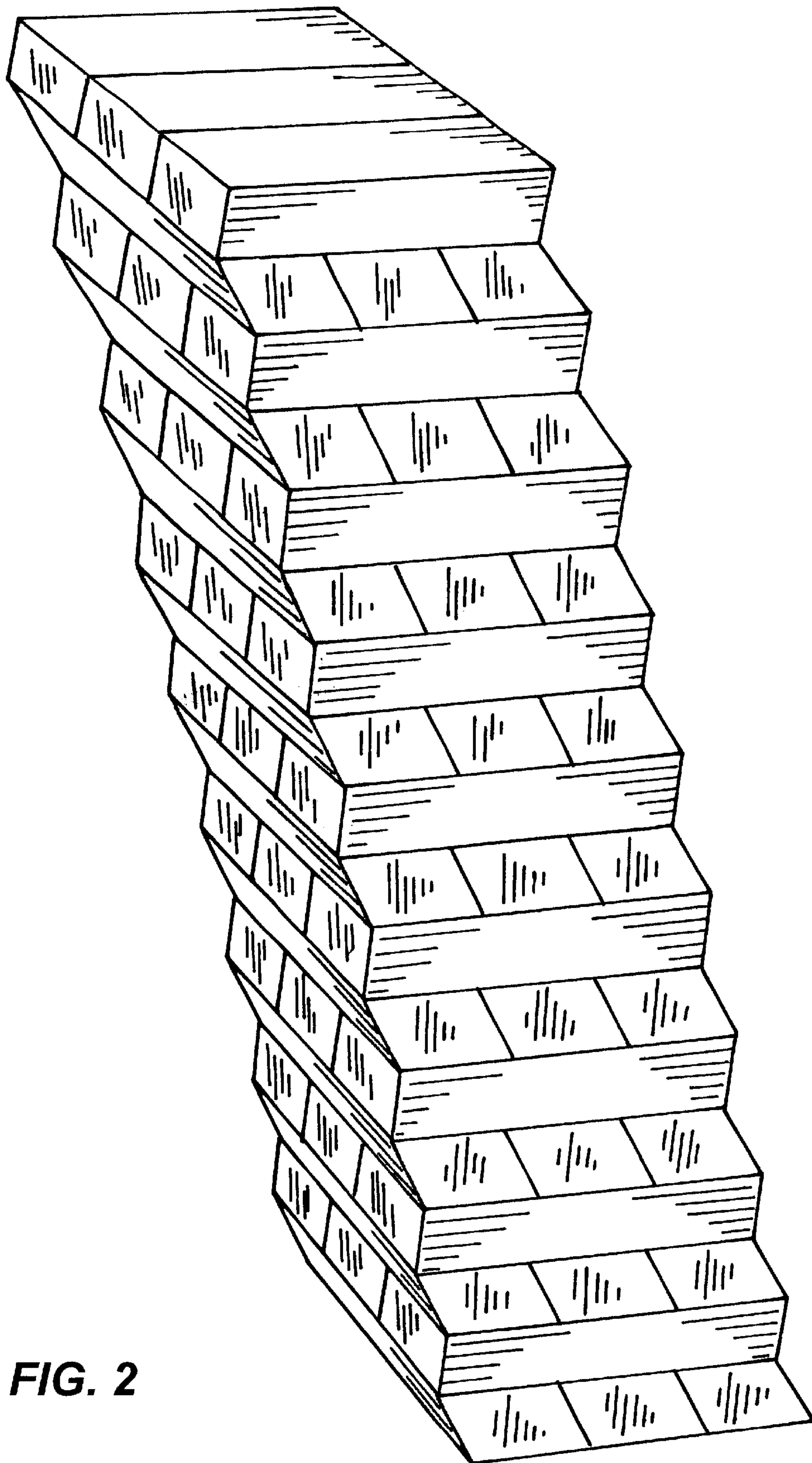

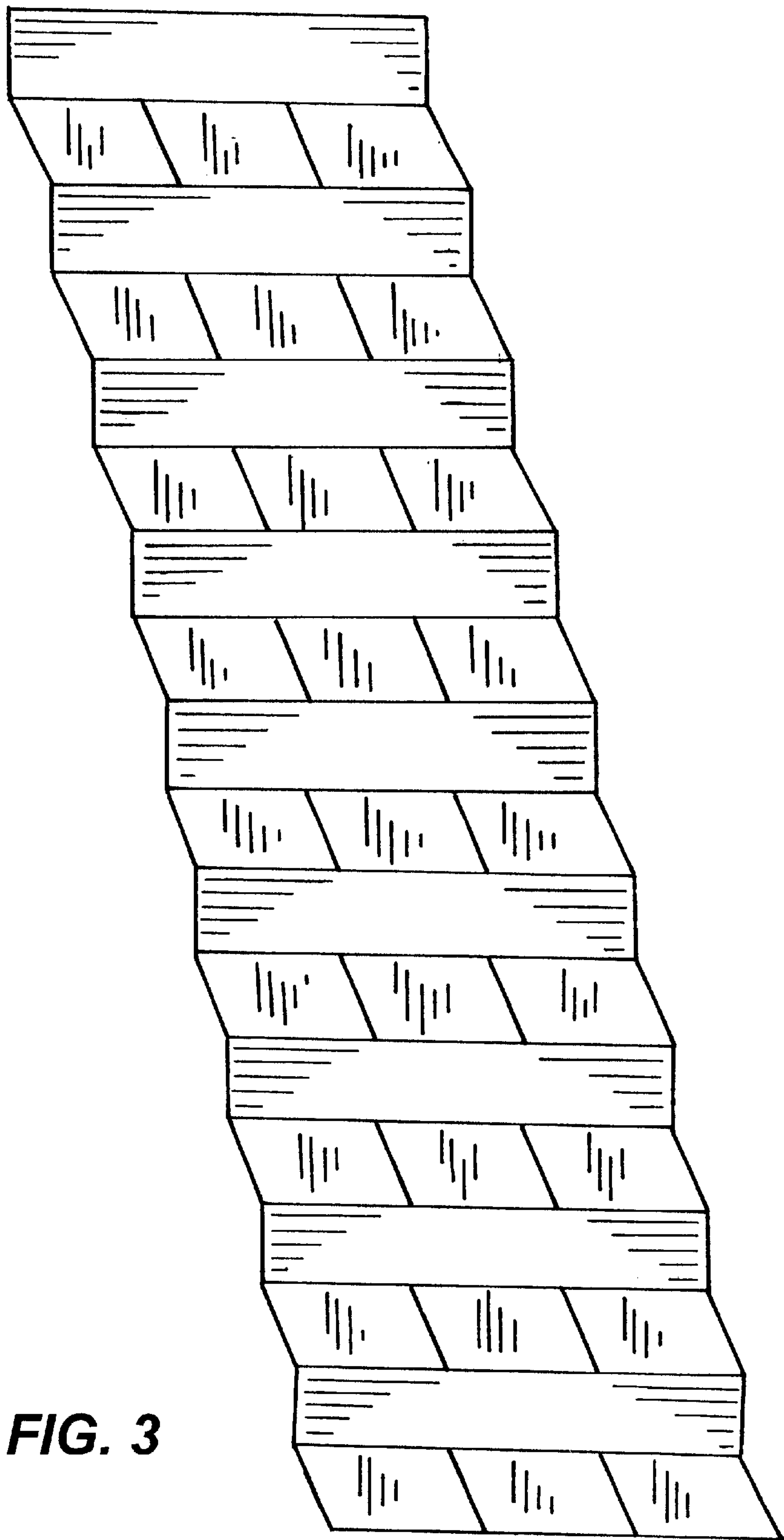

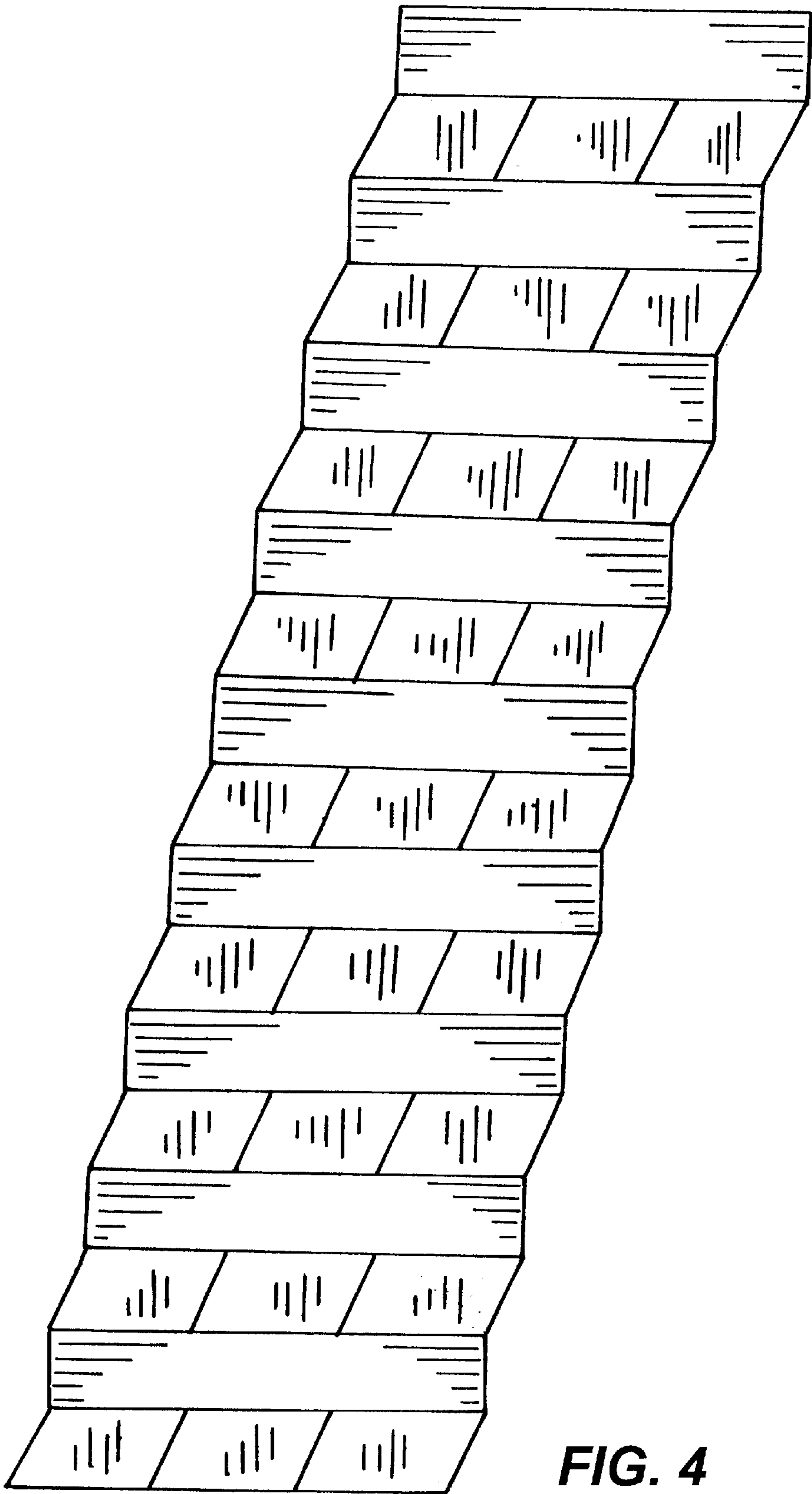

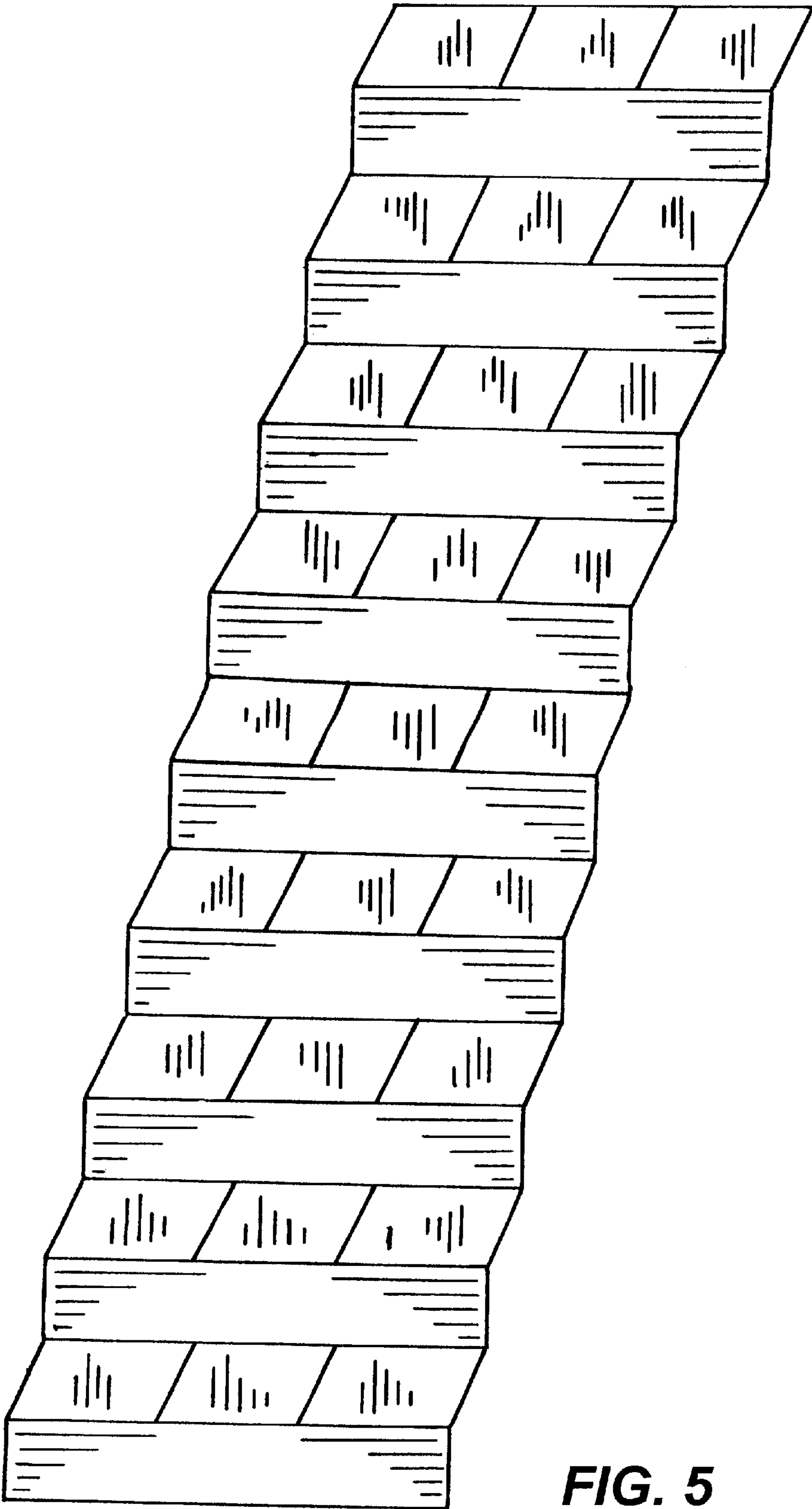

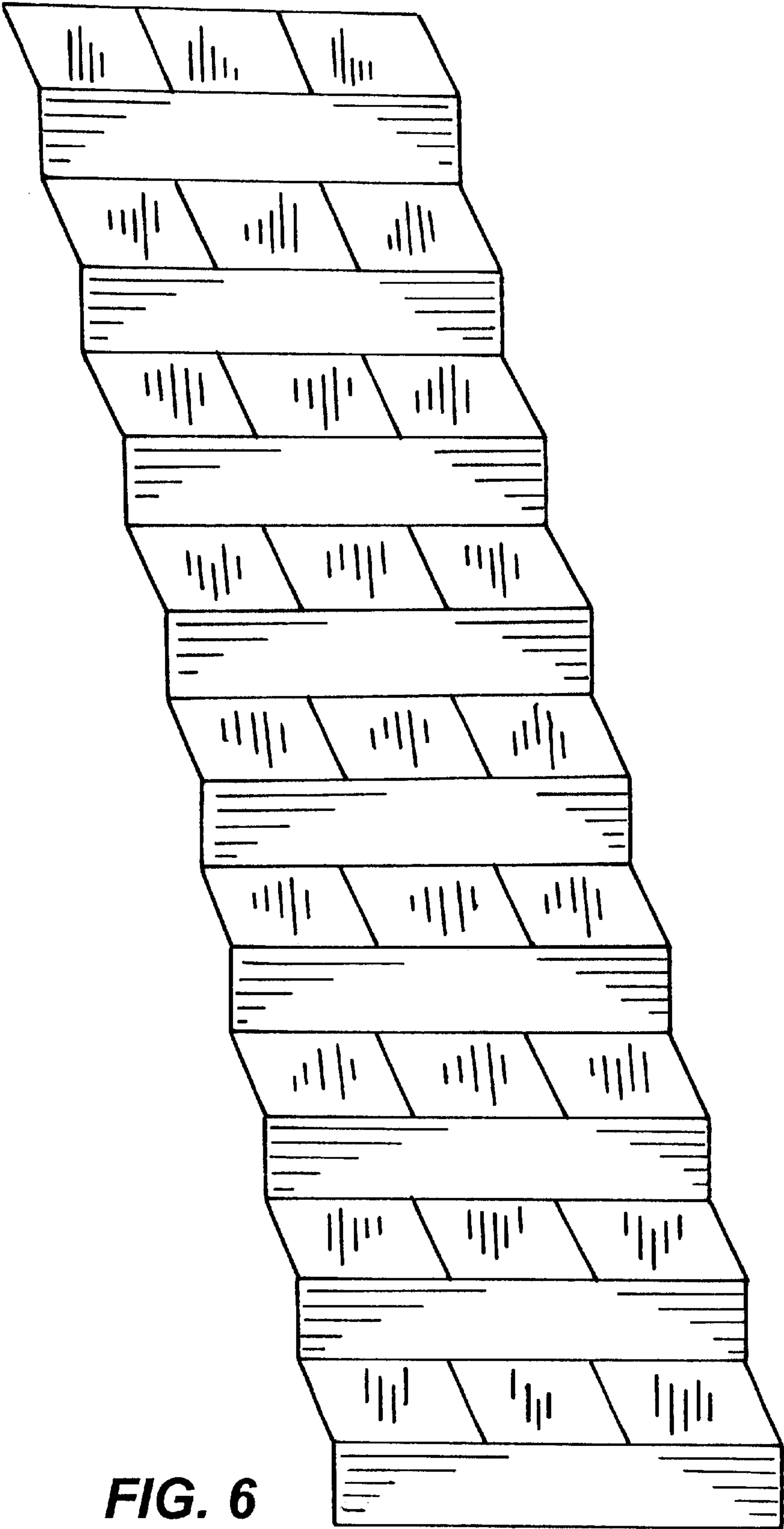

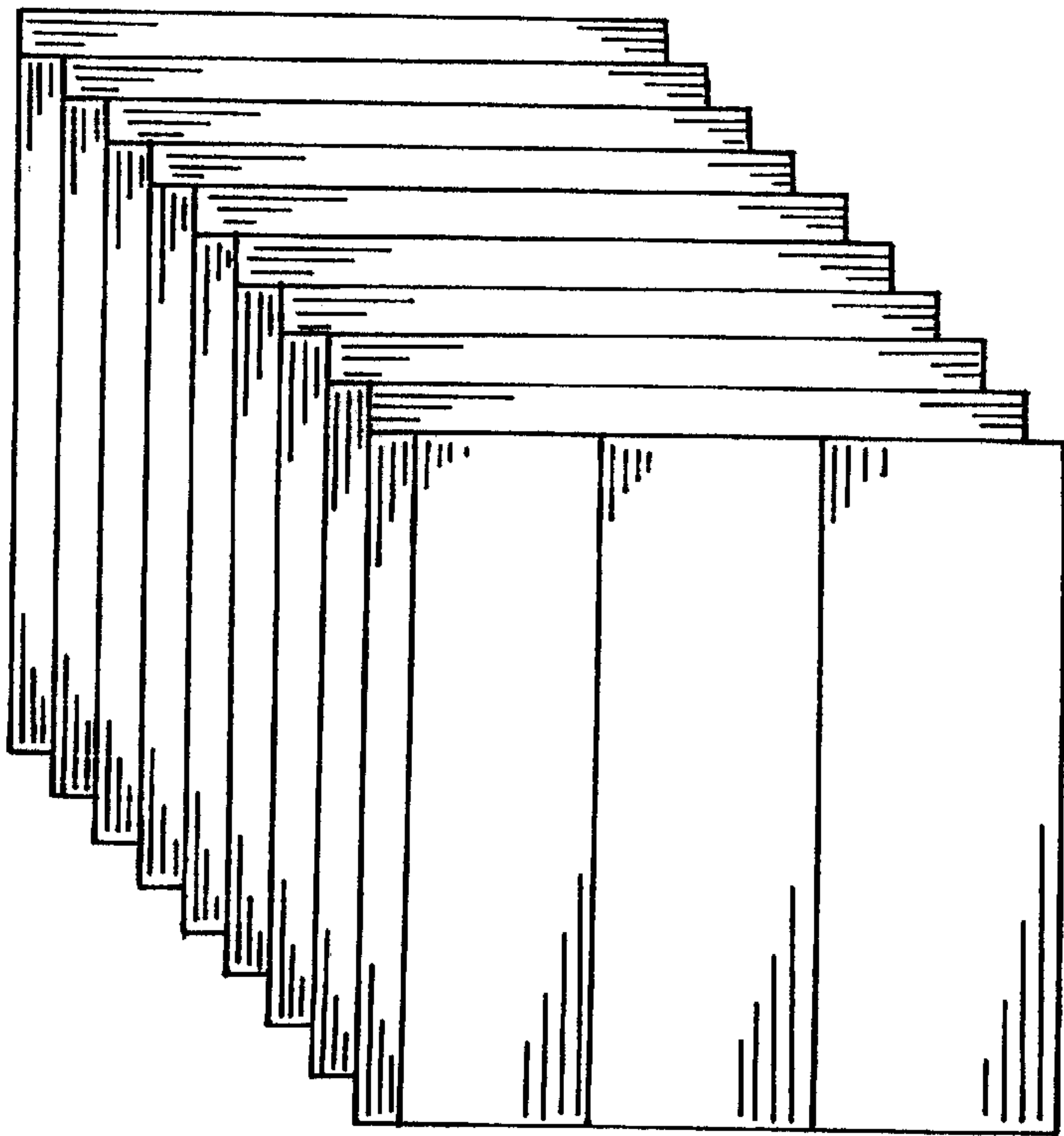
