(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a head portion of a racquet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a head portion of a racquet of the present invention.

FIG. 2 is a side view of the head portion shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a side perspective view of the head portion of the racquet shown in FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of the head portion shown in FIG. 1.

The ornamental design that is claimed is shown in solid lines in the drawings. The broken (dashed) lines shown in FIGS. 1 through 4 are included for the purpose of illustrating environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design. Additionally, the break lines shown in FIGS. 1 through 4 define transition points between the claimed design and the environmental elements, and form no part of the claimed design.

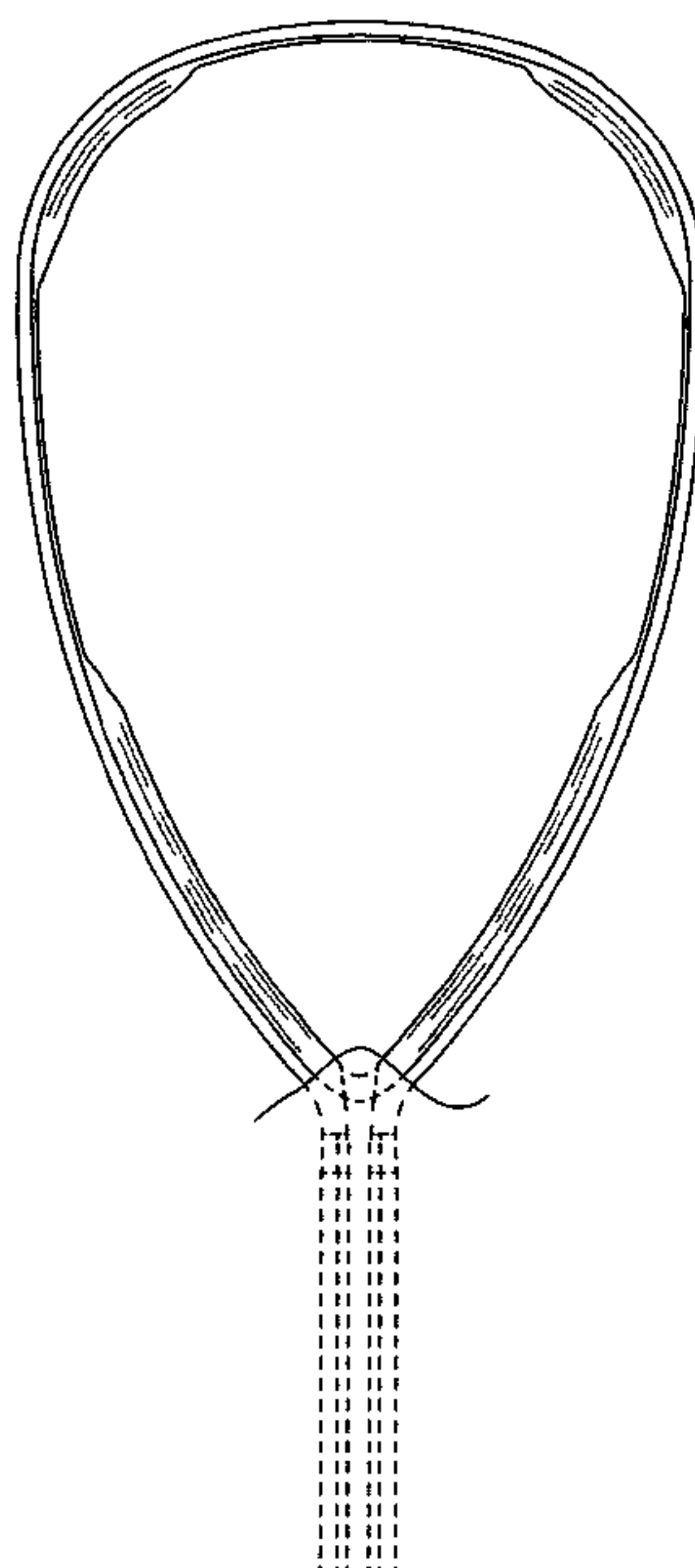

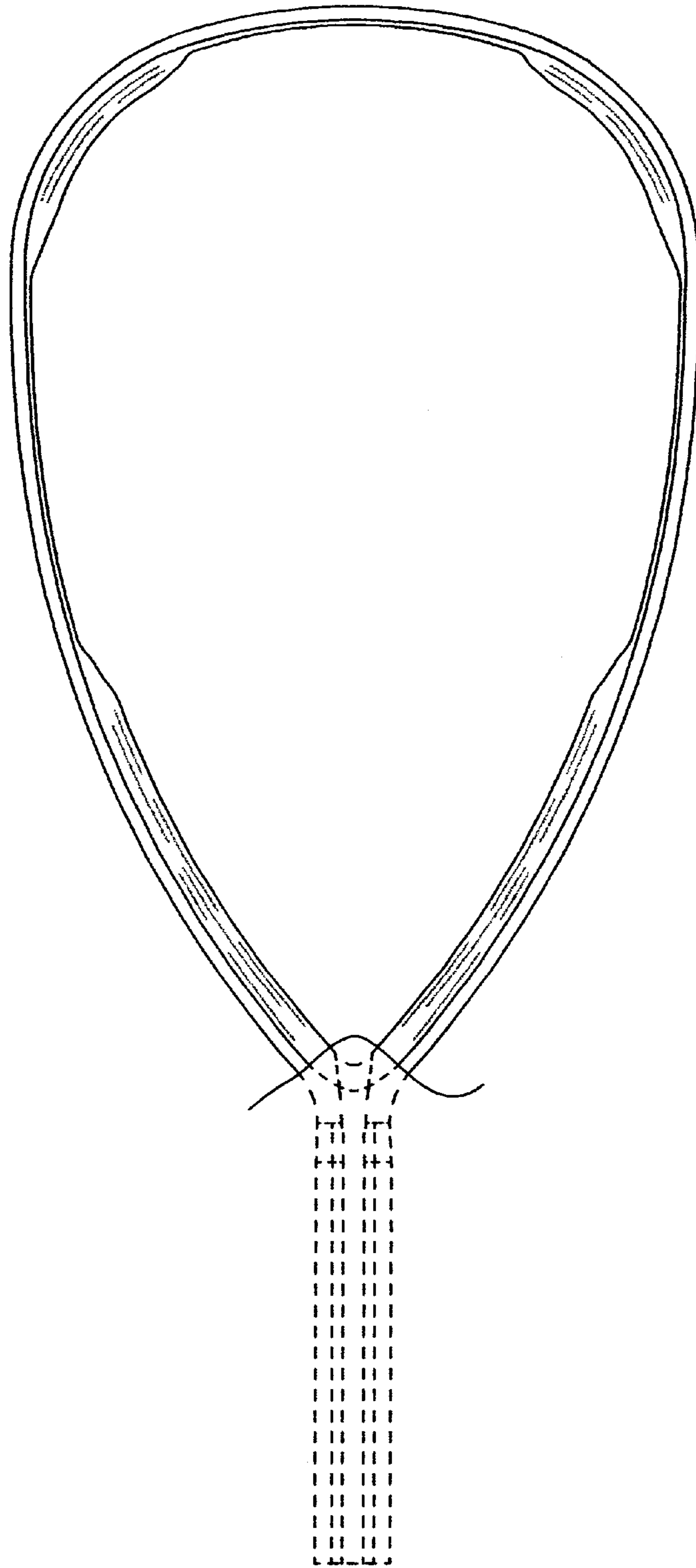

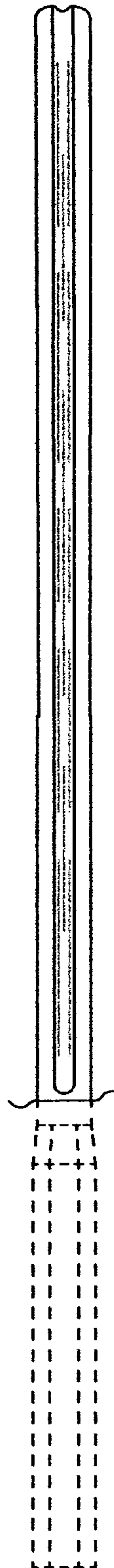

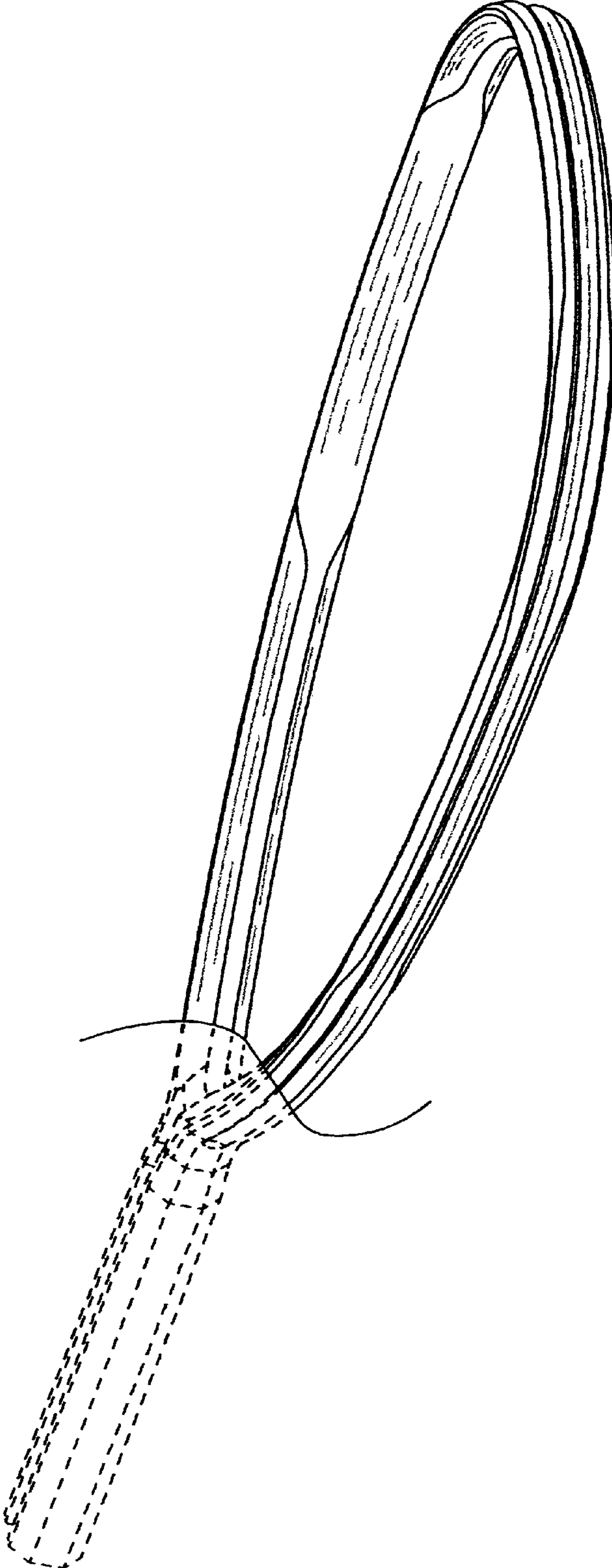
