FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1;

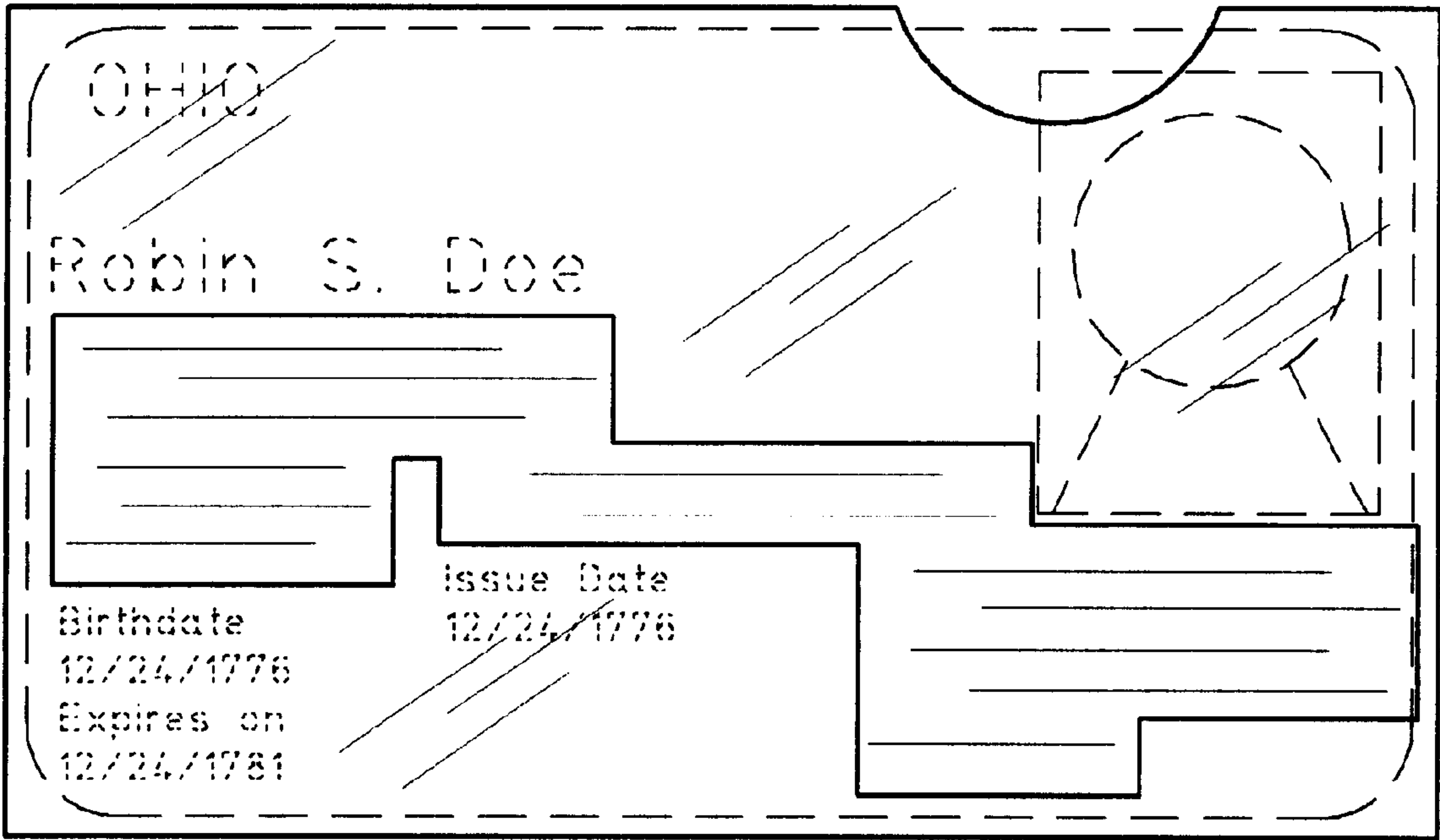
FIG. 3 is a side view of FIG. 1; and,

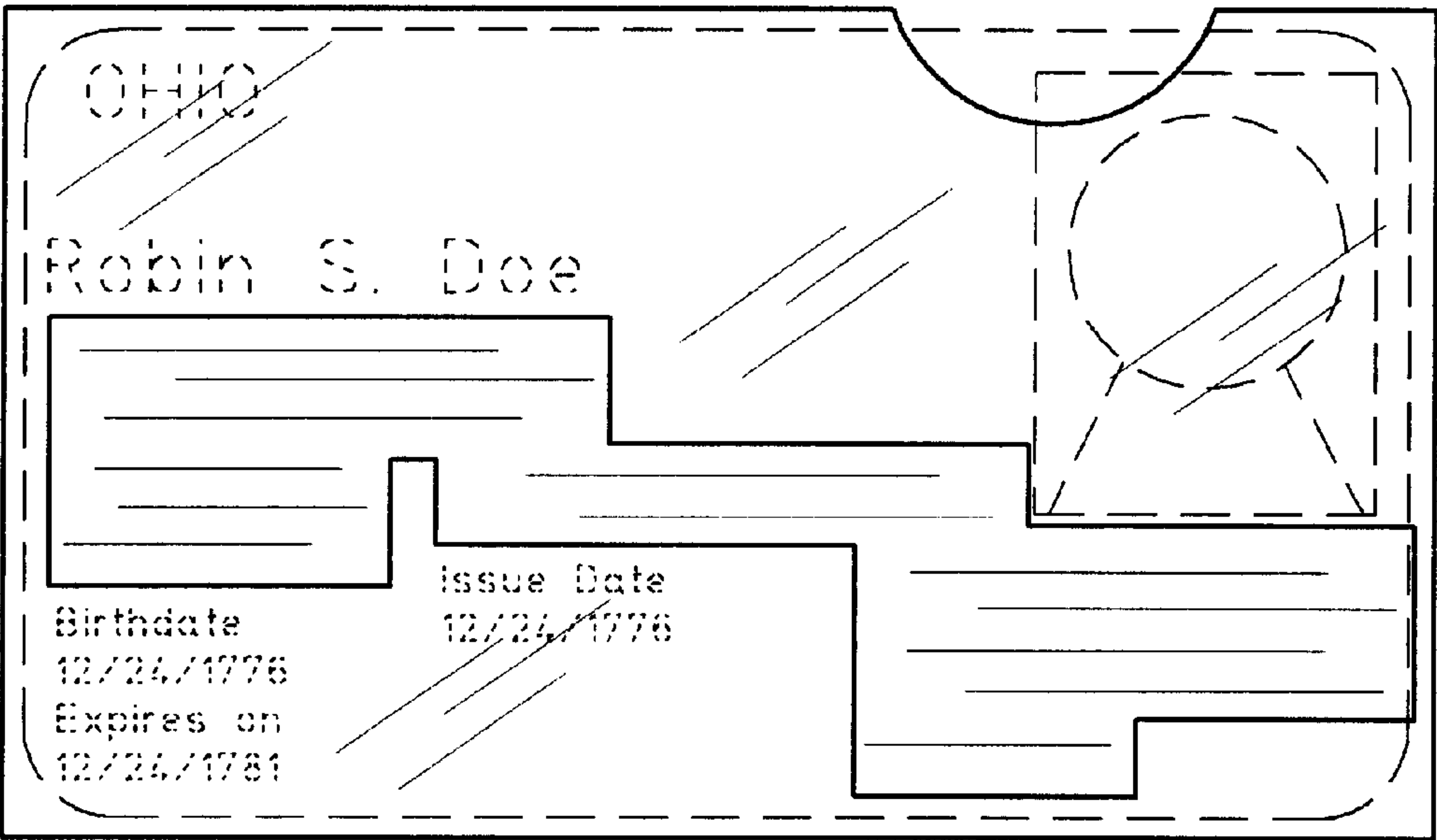

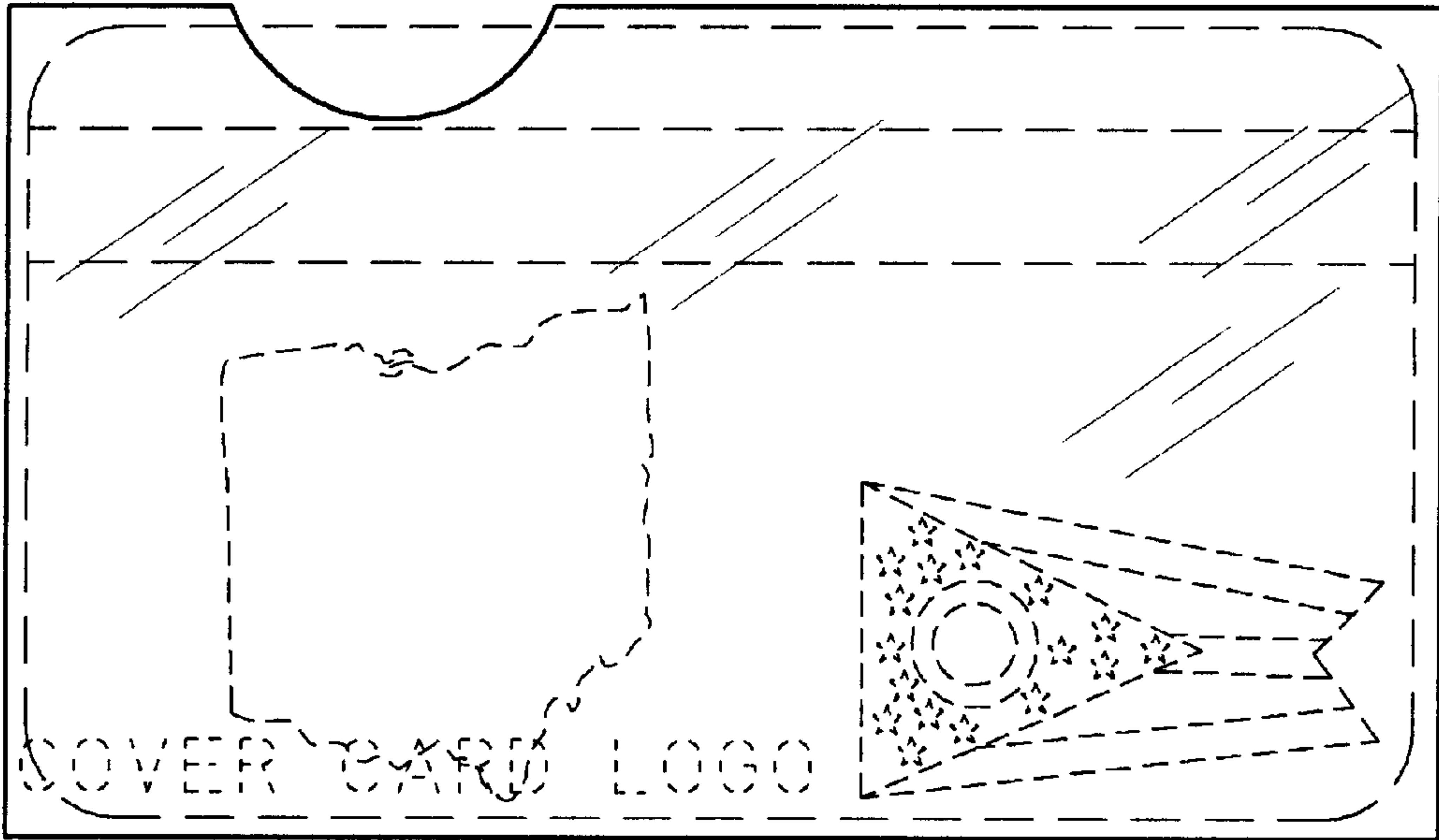
