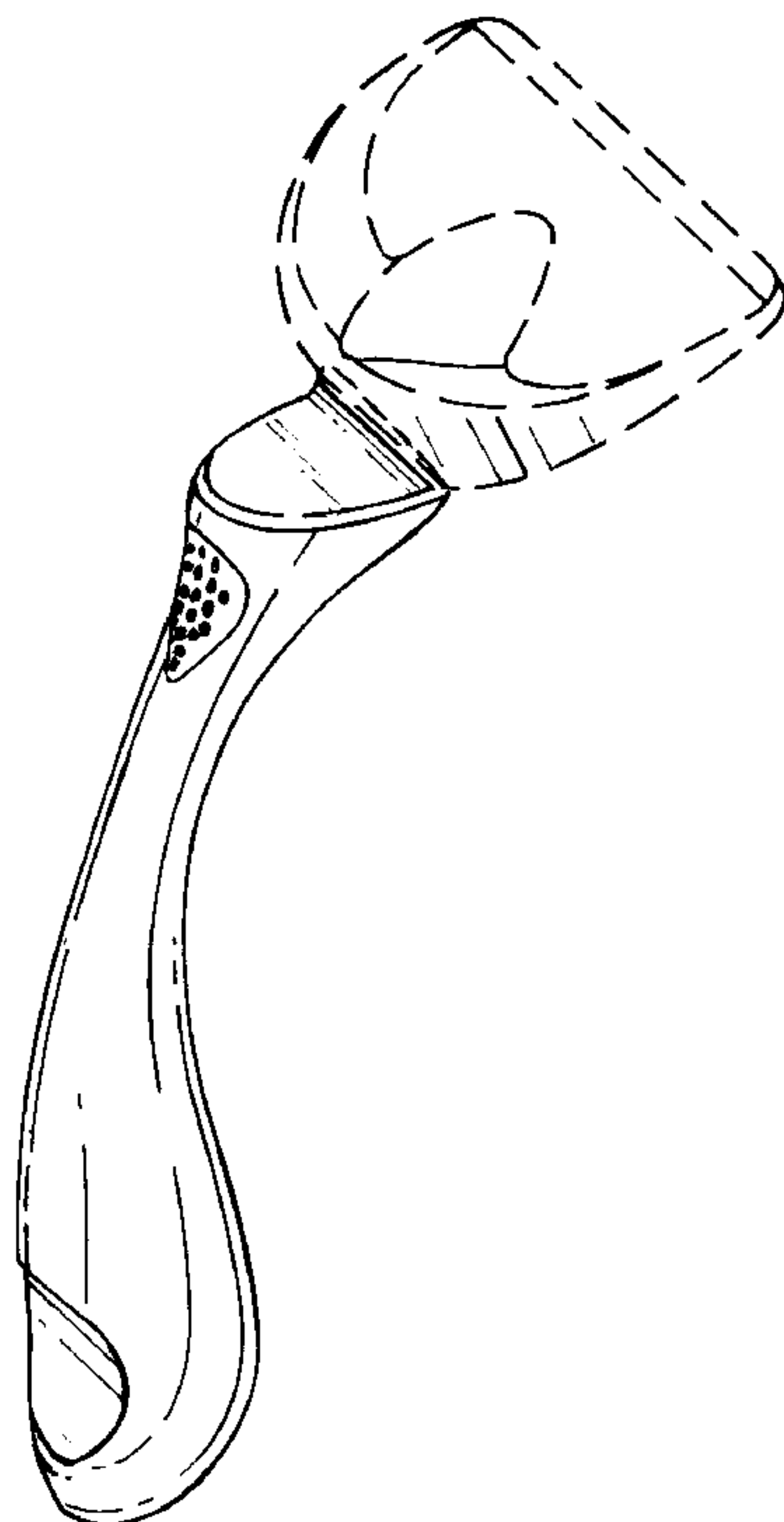
The broken line showing the spatula handle coupled with the

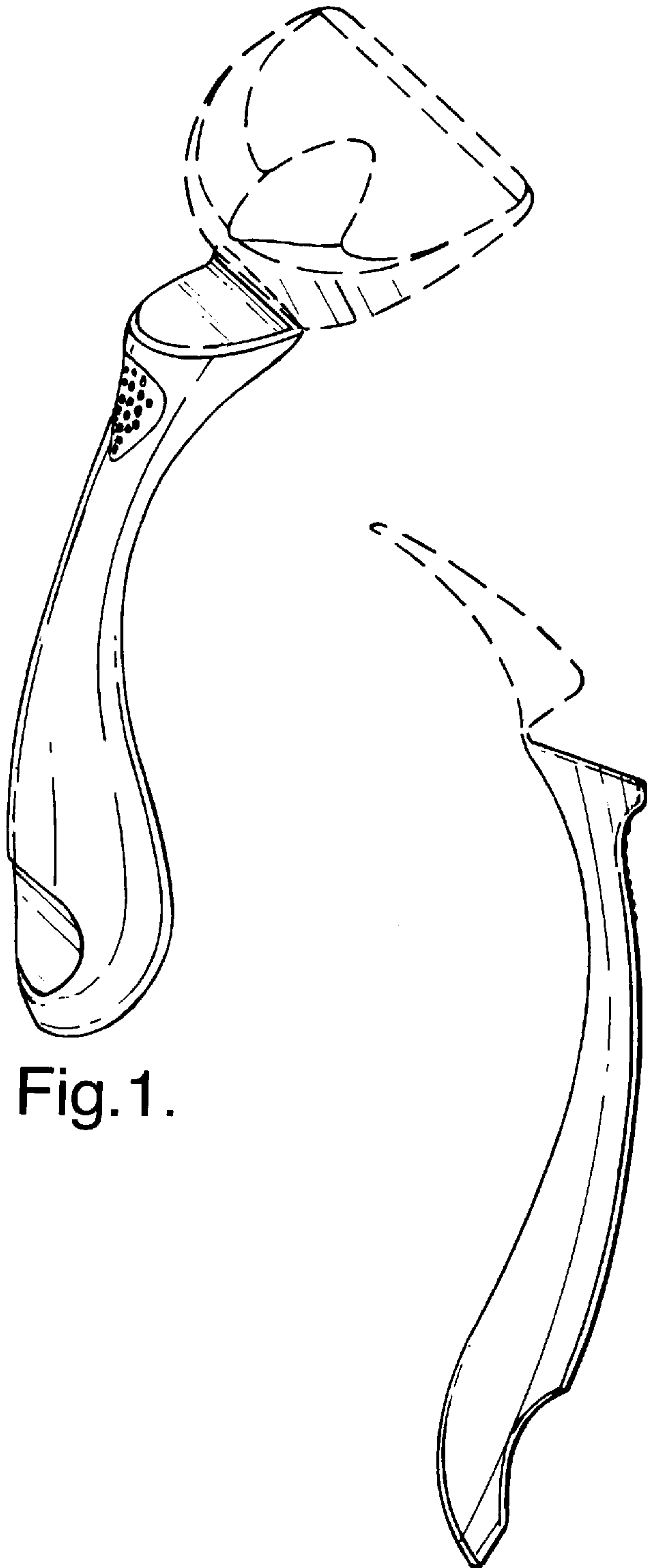

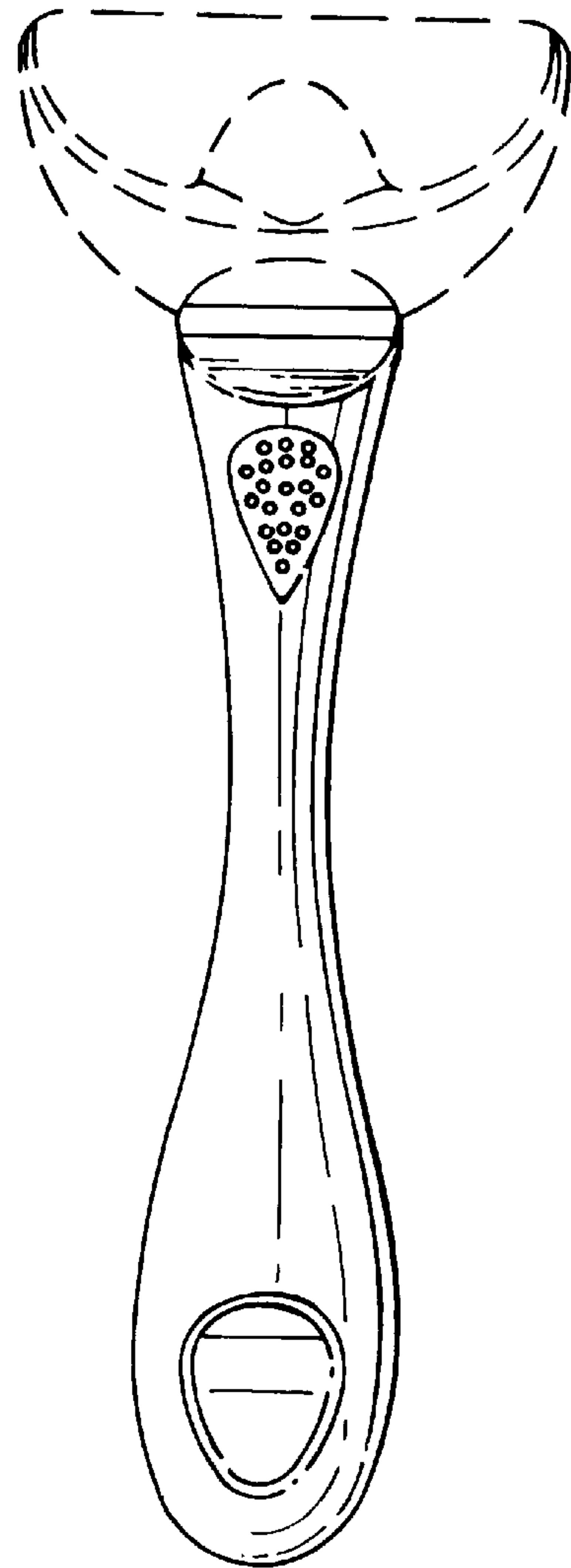

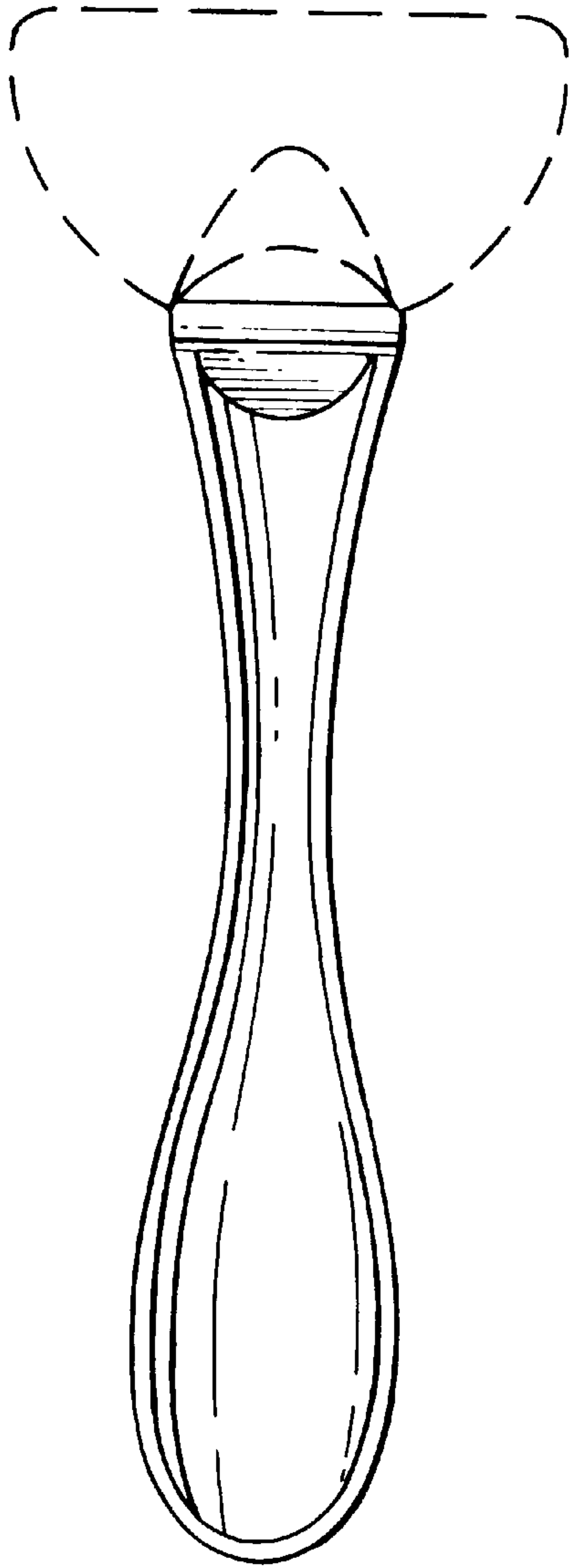

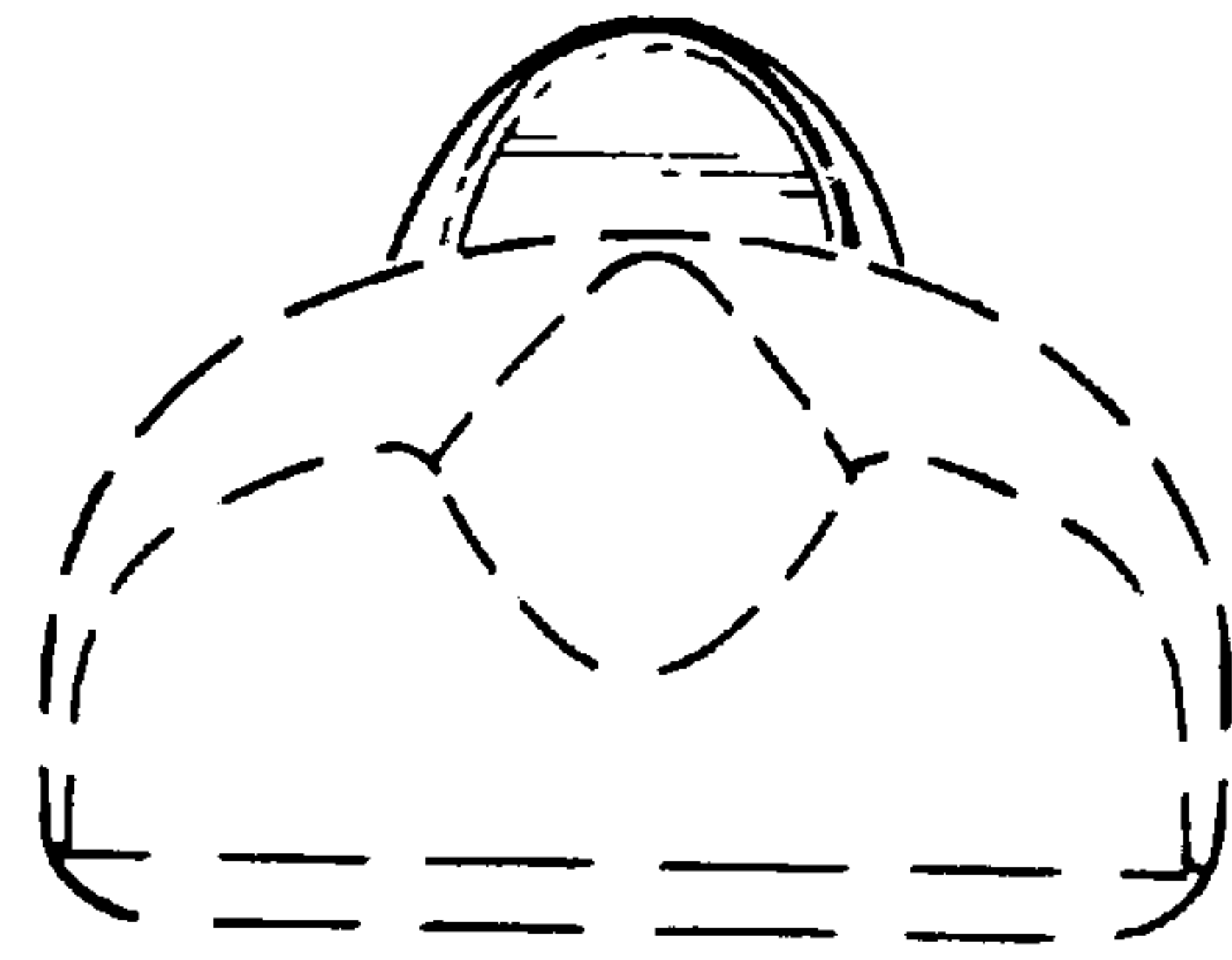

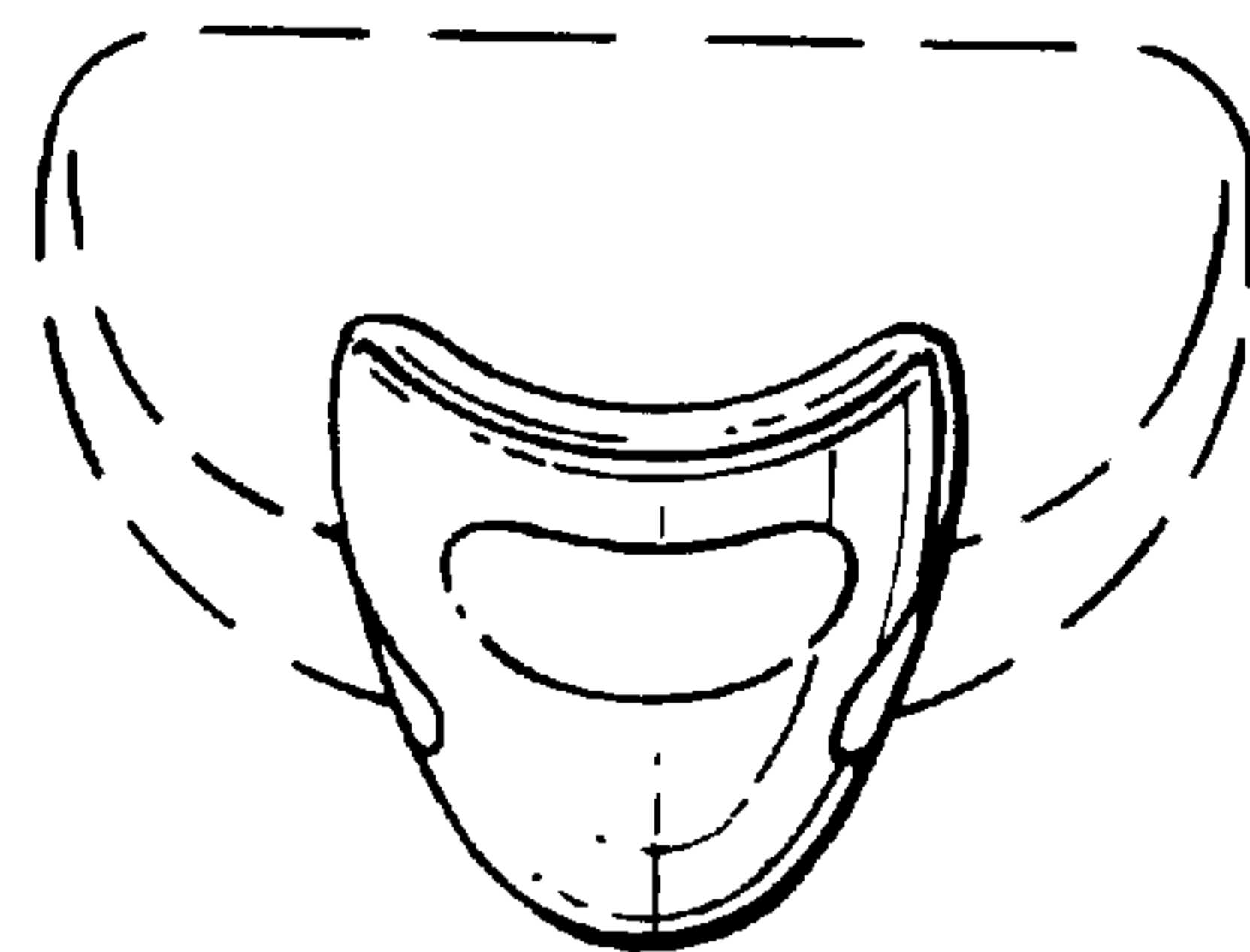
