The ornamental design for a shoe, as shown and described.

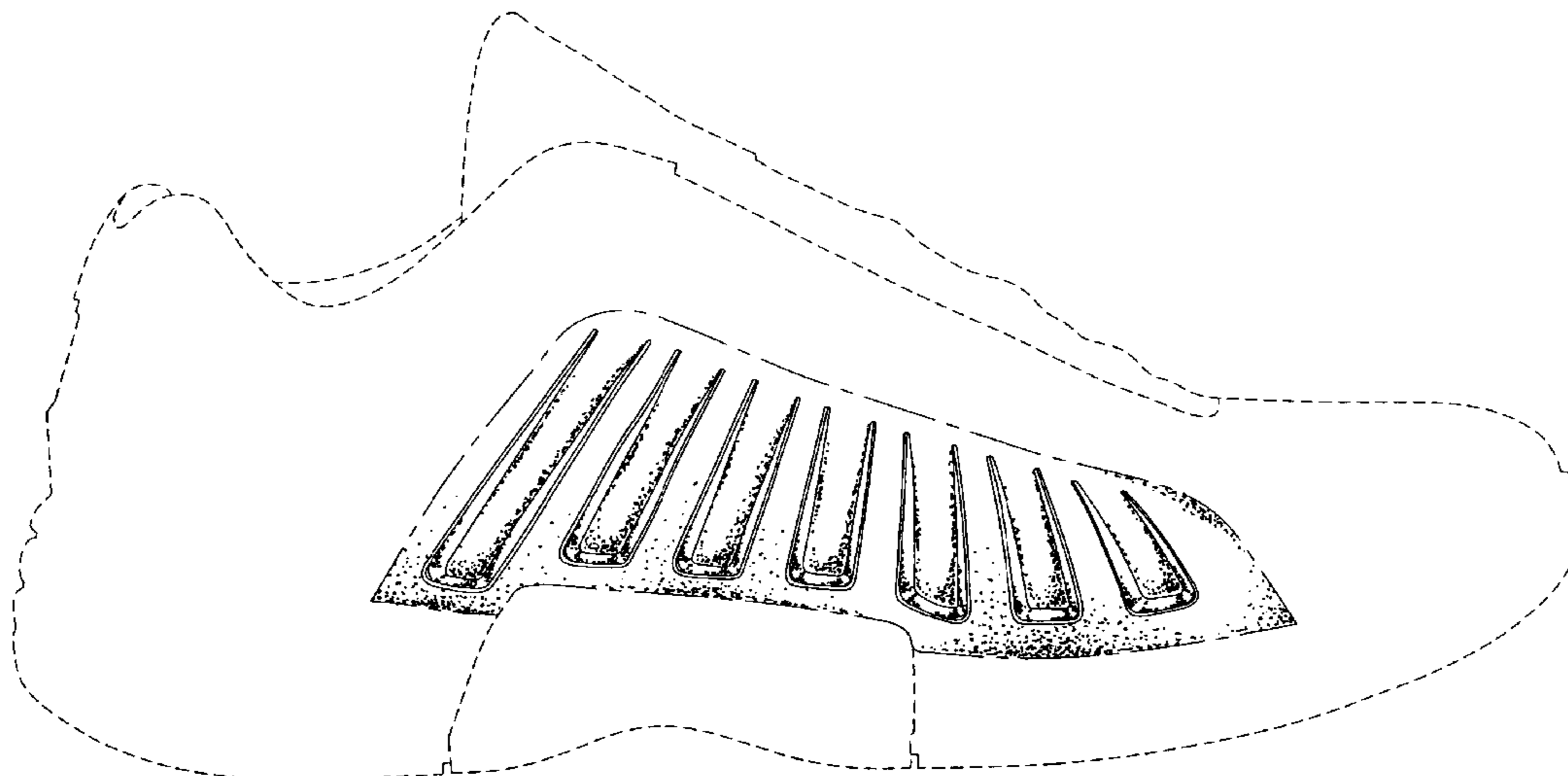
DESCRIPTION

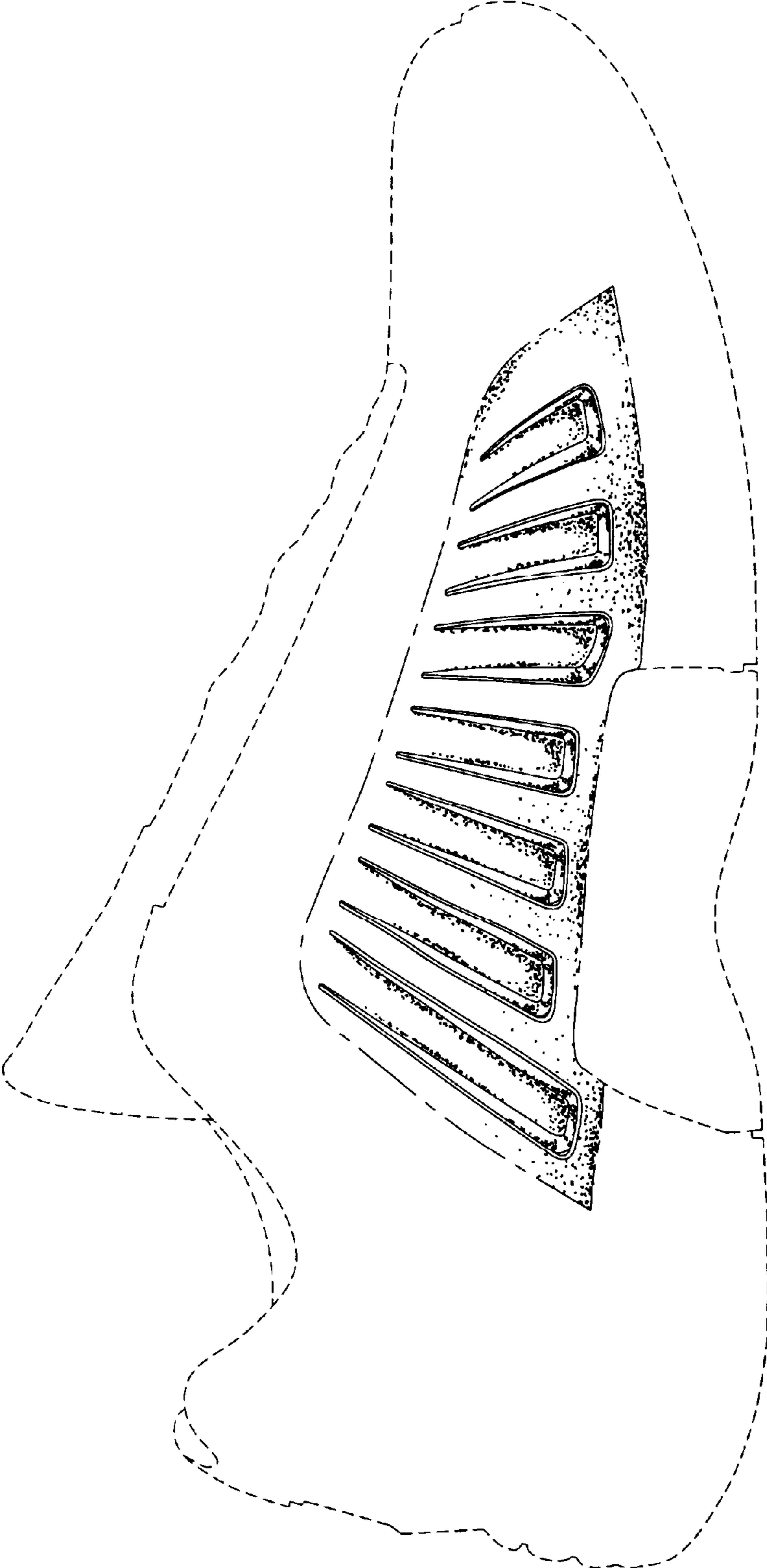

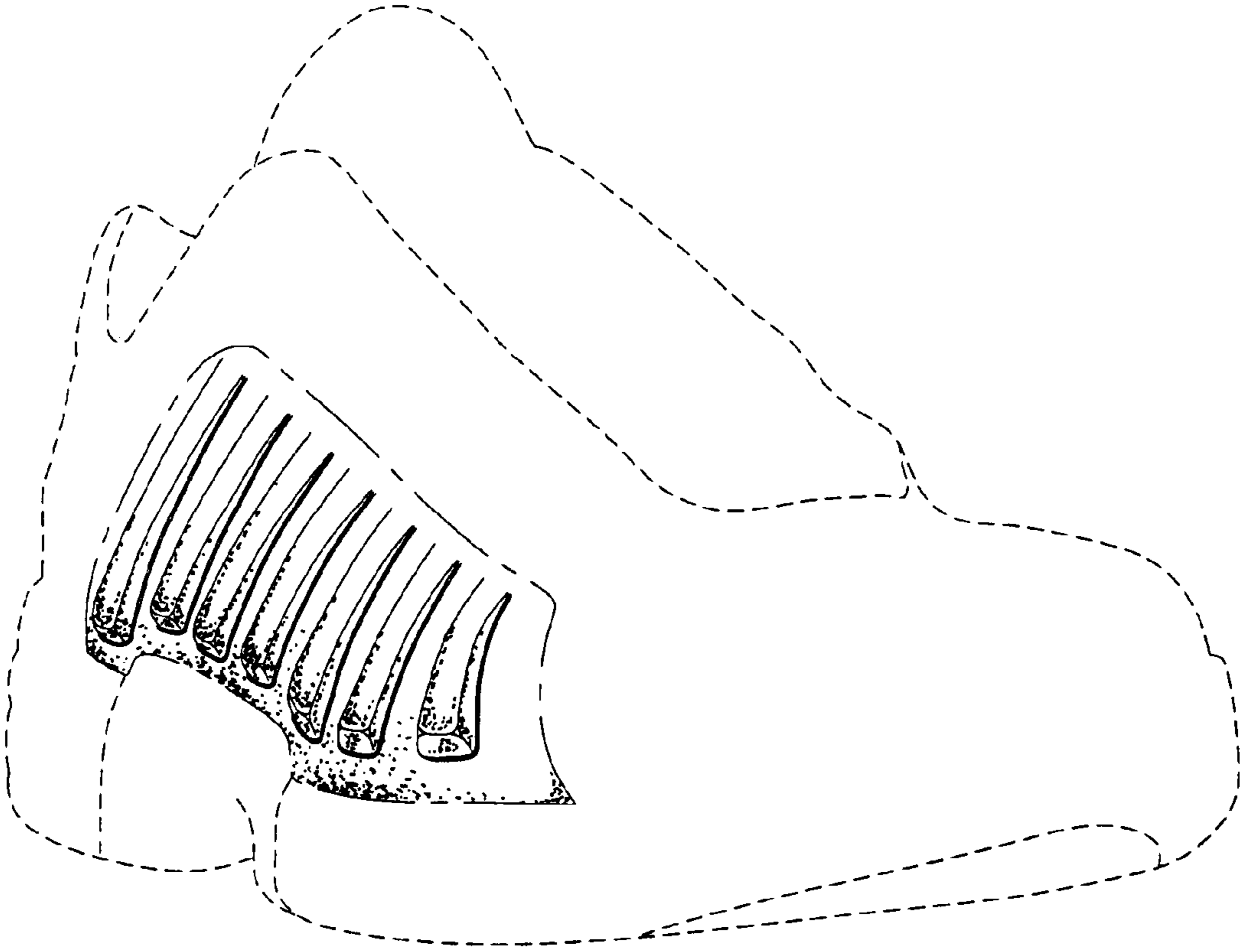
