DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a firearm sling showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the firearm sling in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the firearm sling in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the firearm sling in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 right side view of the firearm sling in FIG. 1;

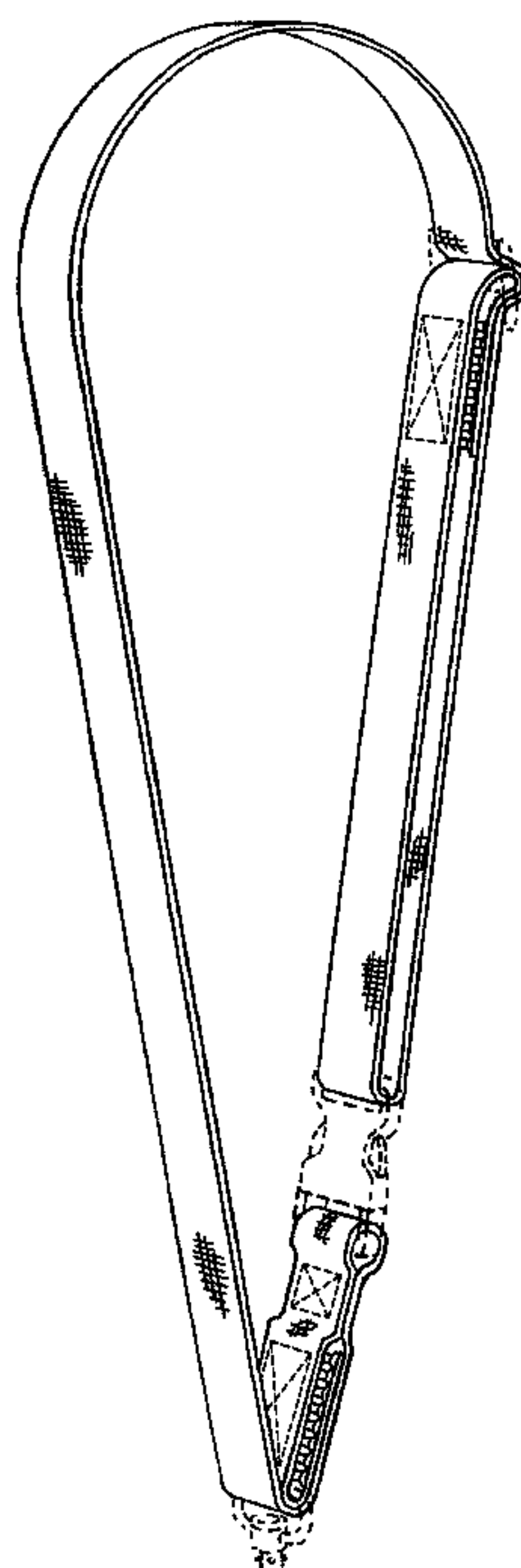
FIG. 6 is an enlarged top plan view of the firearm sling in FIG. 1; and,

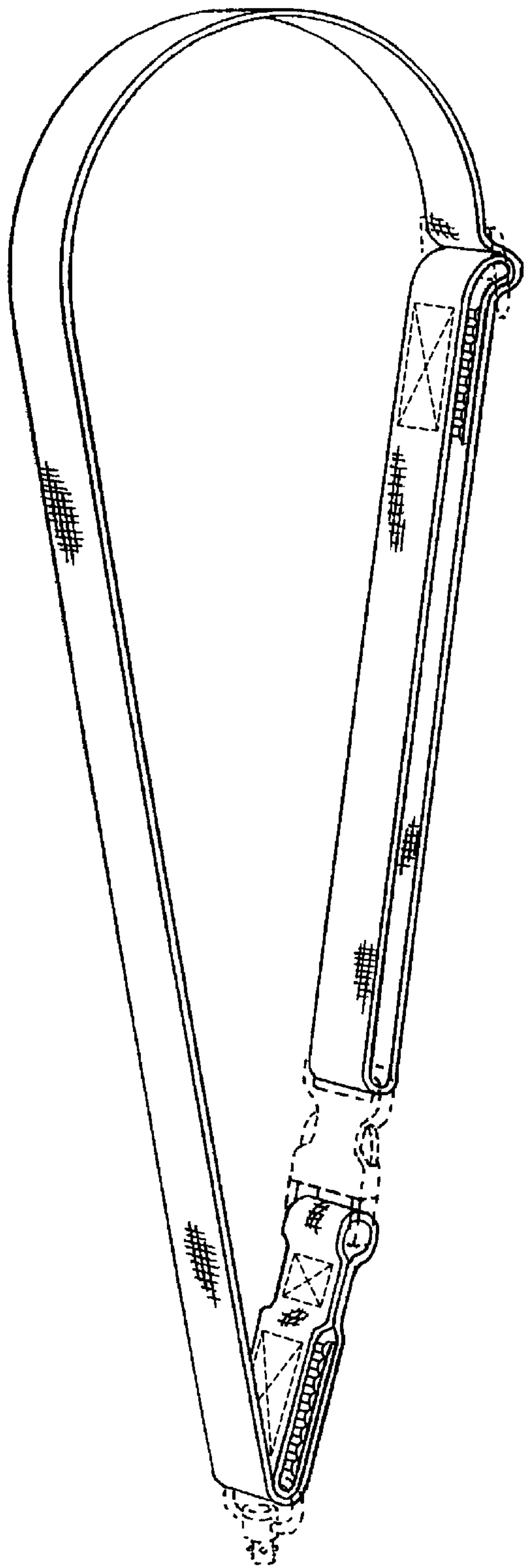

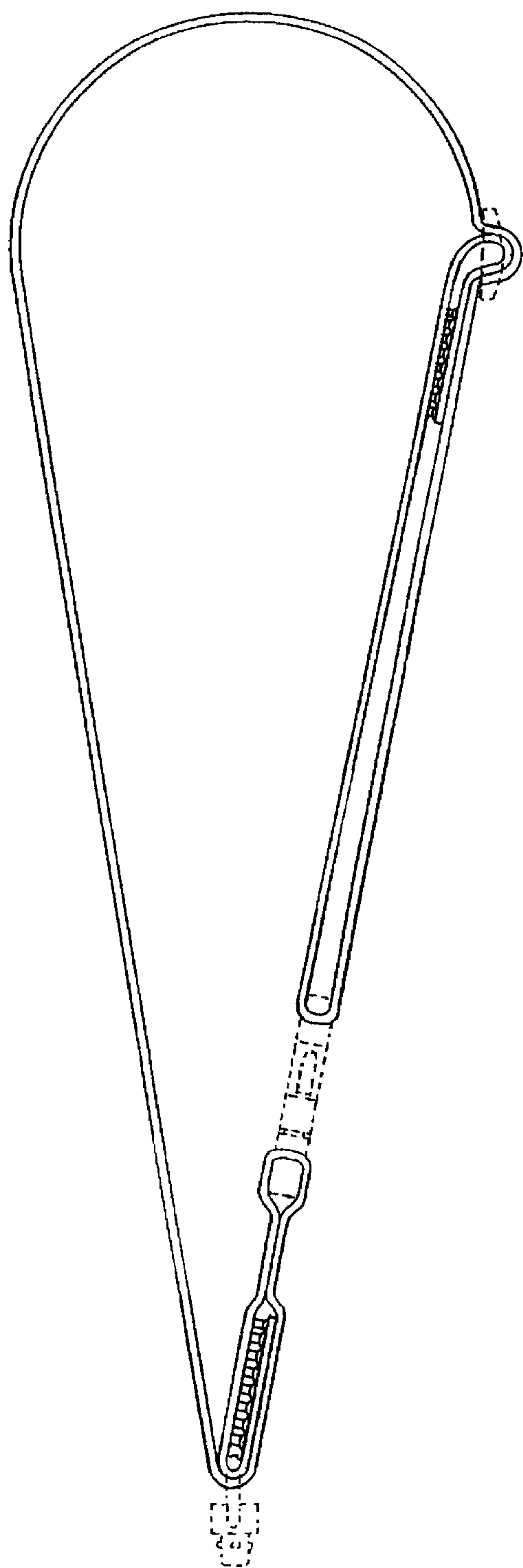

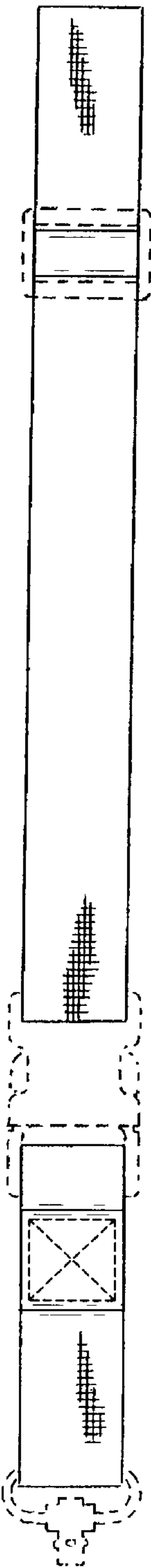

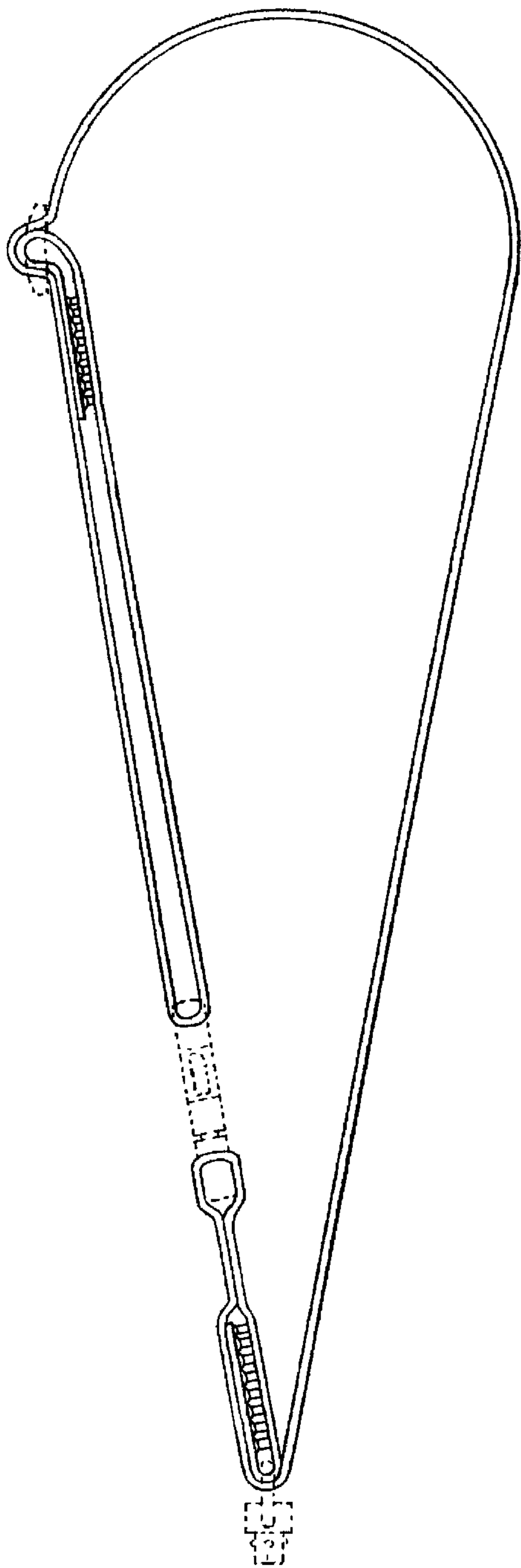

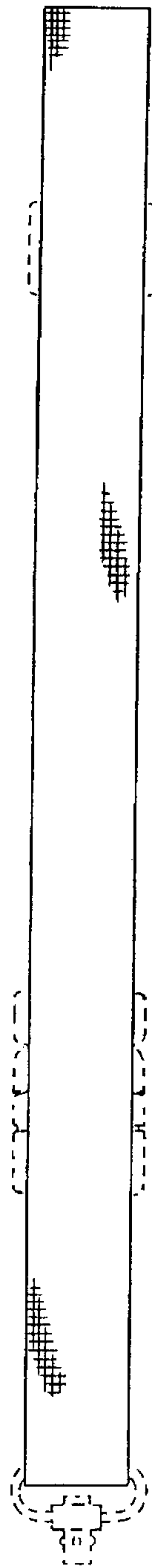

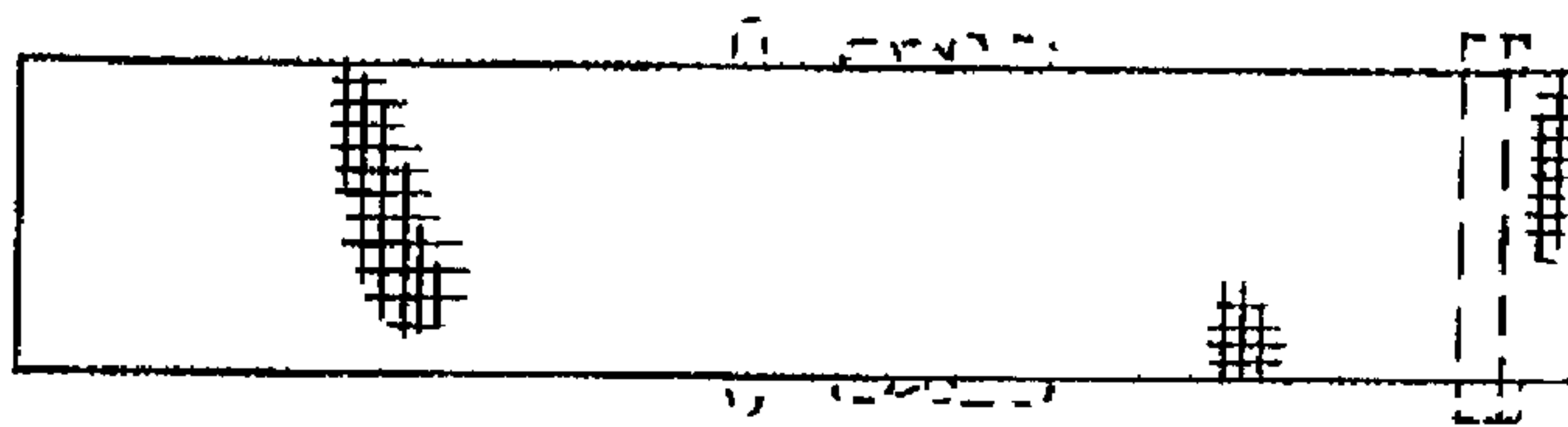

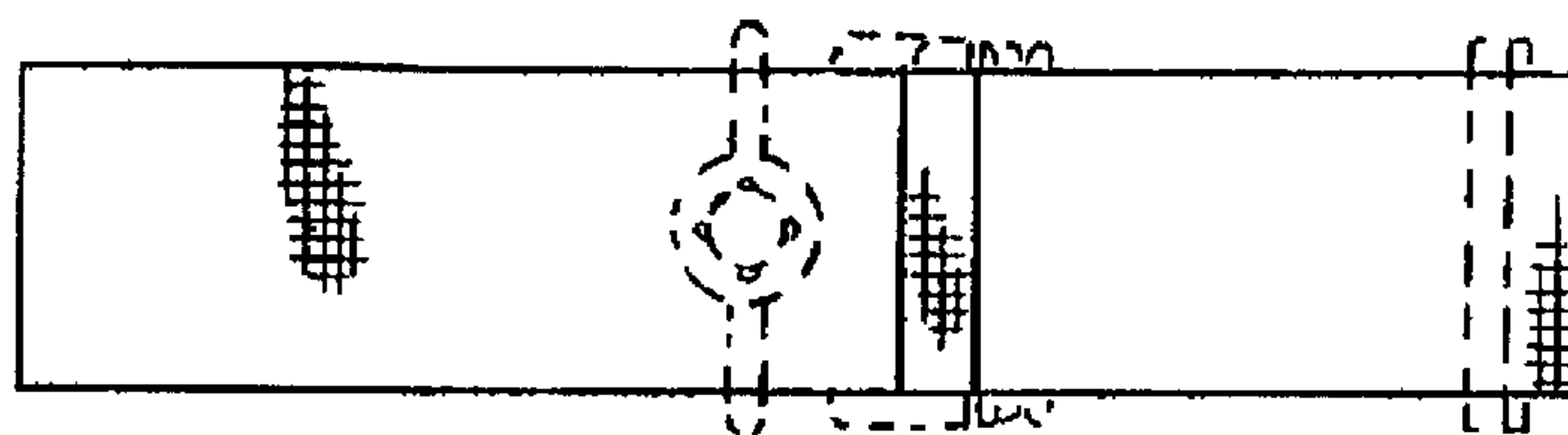
