The ornamental design for a display stand assembly, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a display stand assembly, showing the display panel portion removed from the assembly for clarity of disclosure;

FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a side view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side view showing the side opposite to FIG. 4 thereof;

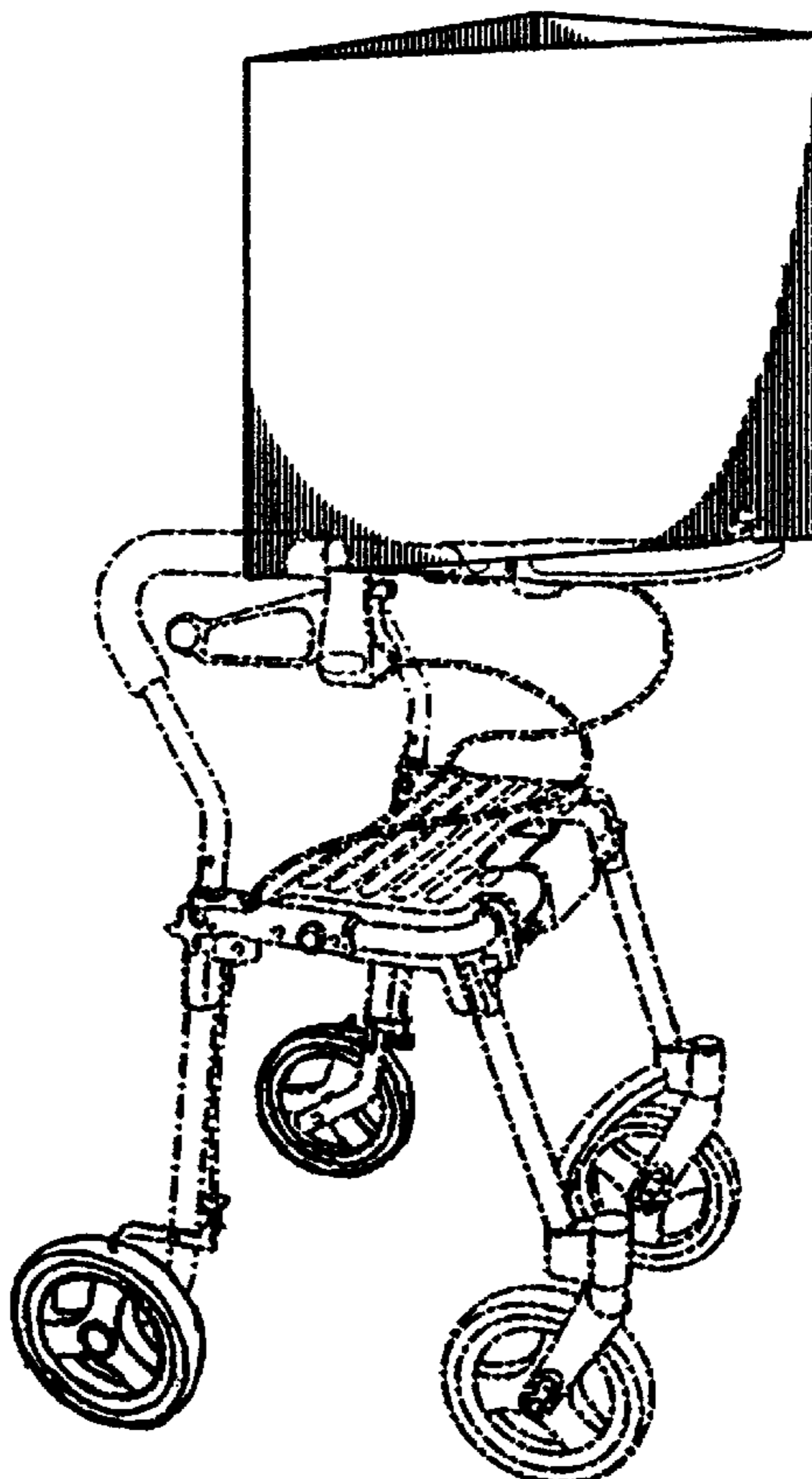
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof;

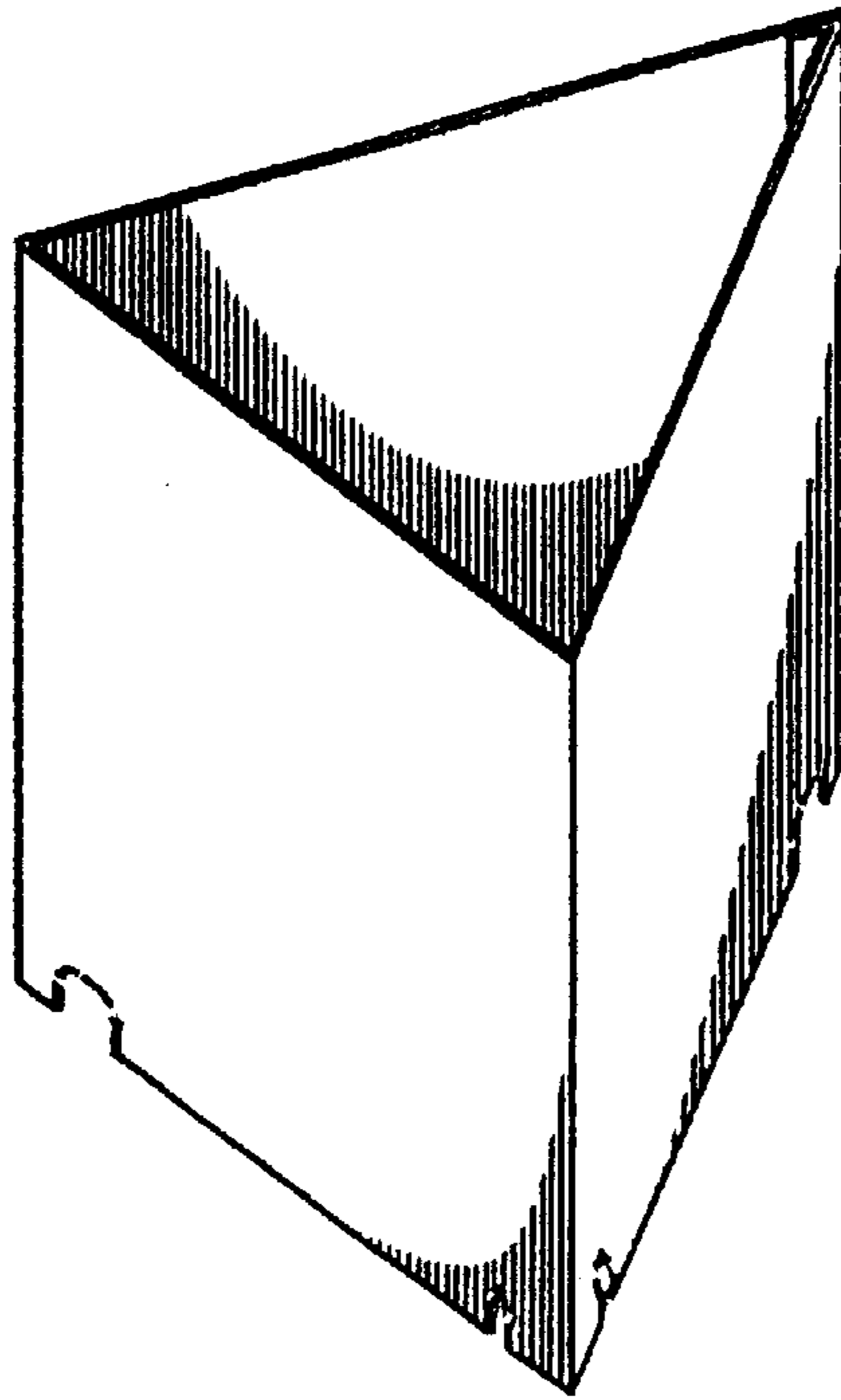
FIG. 7 is a bottom view opposite to FIG. 6 thereof; and,

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of the display stand assembly showing my new design.

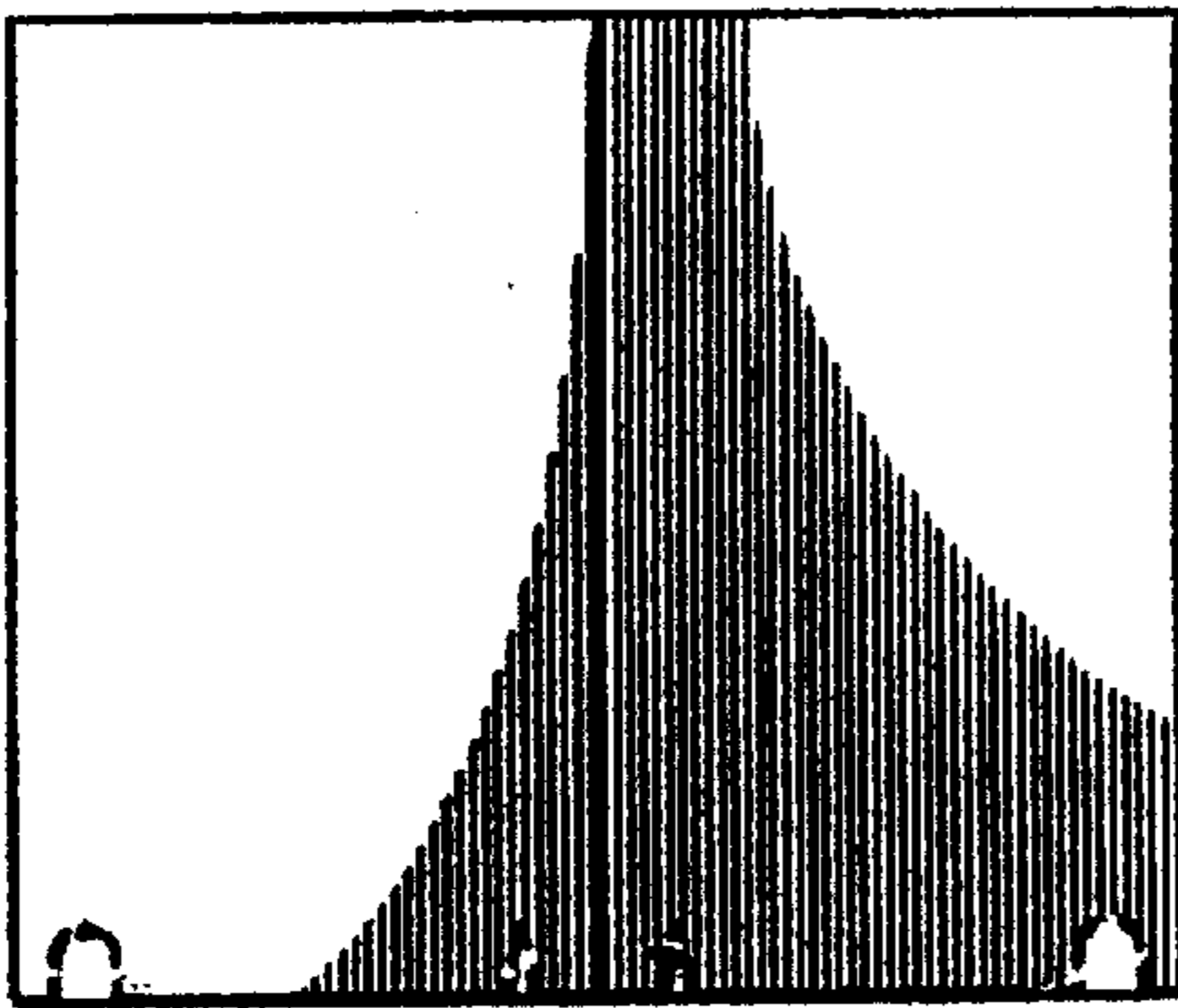

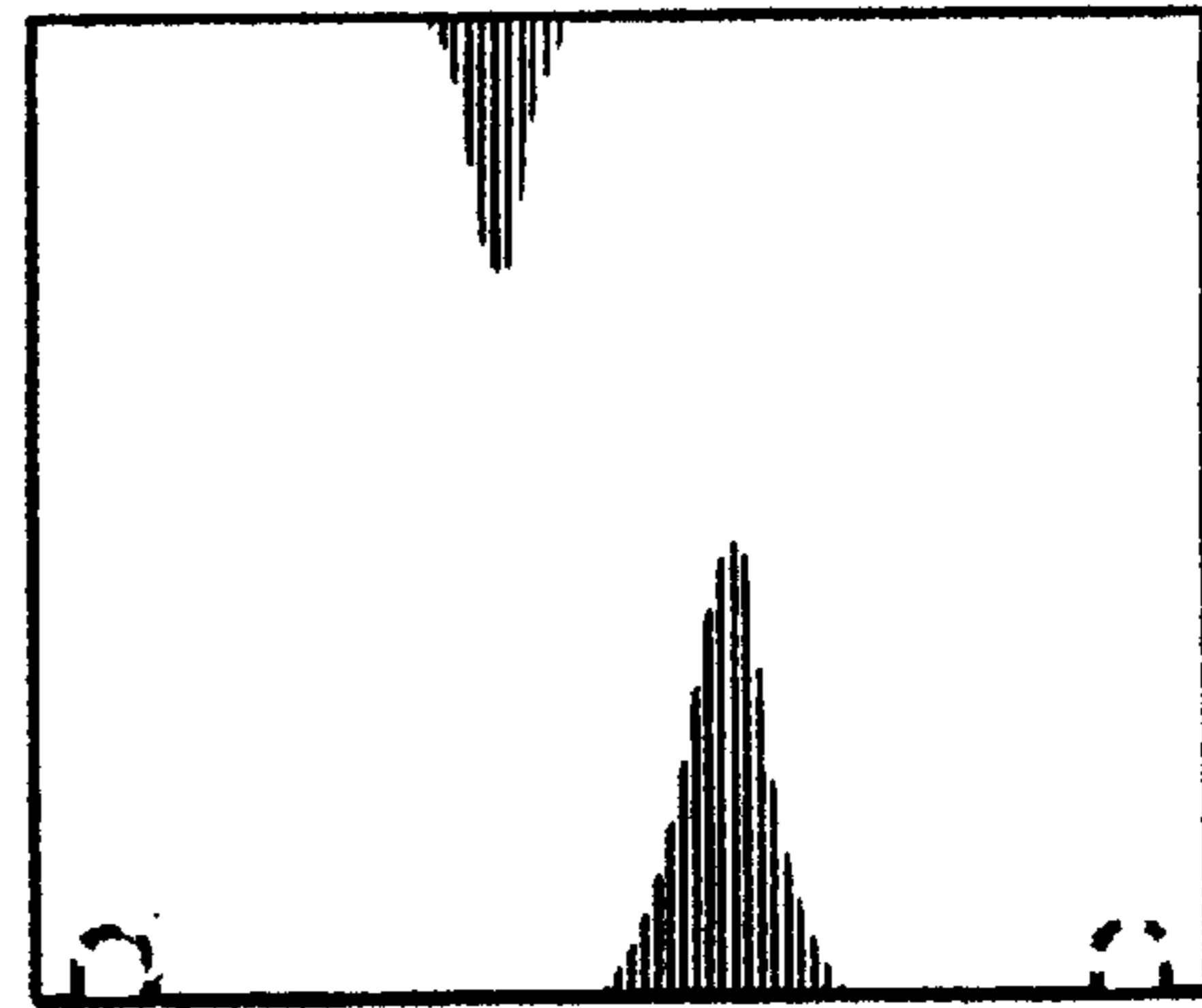




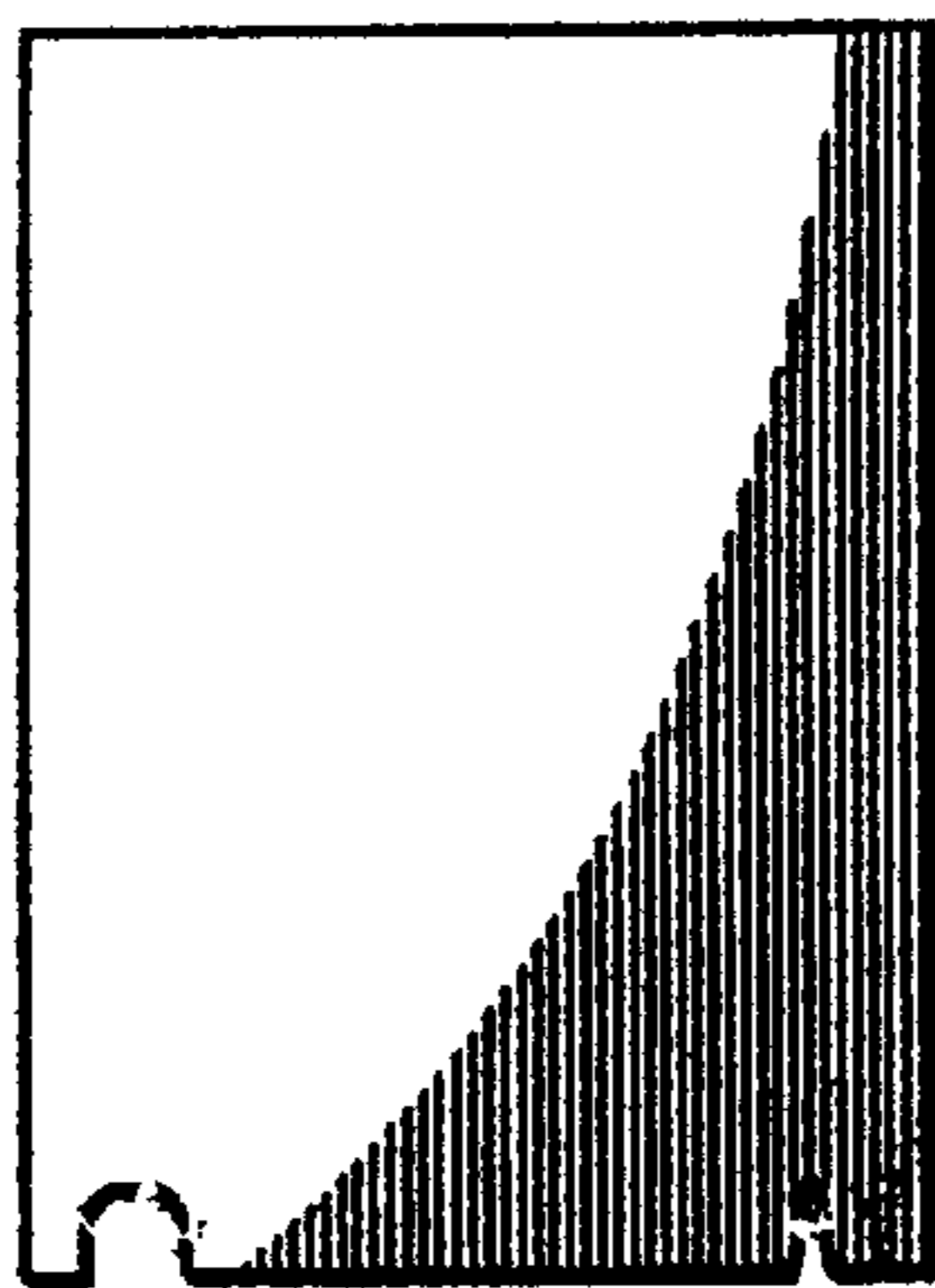

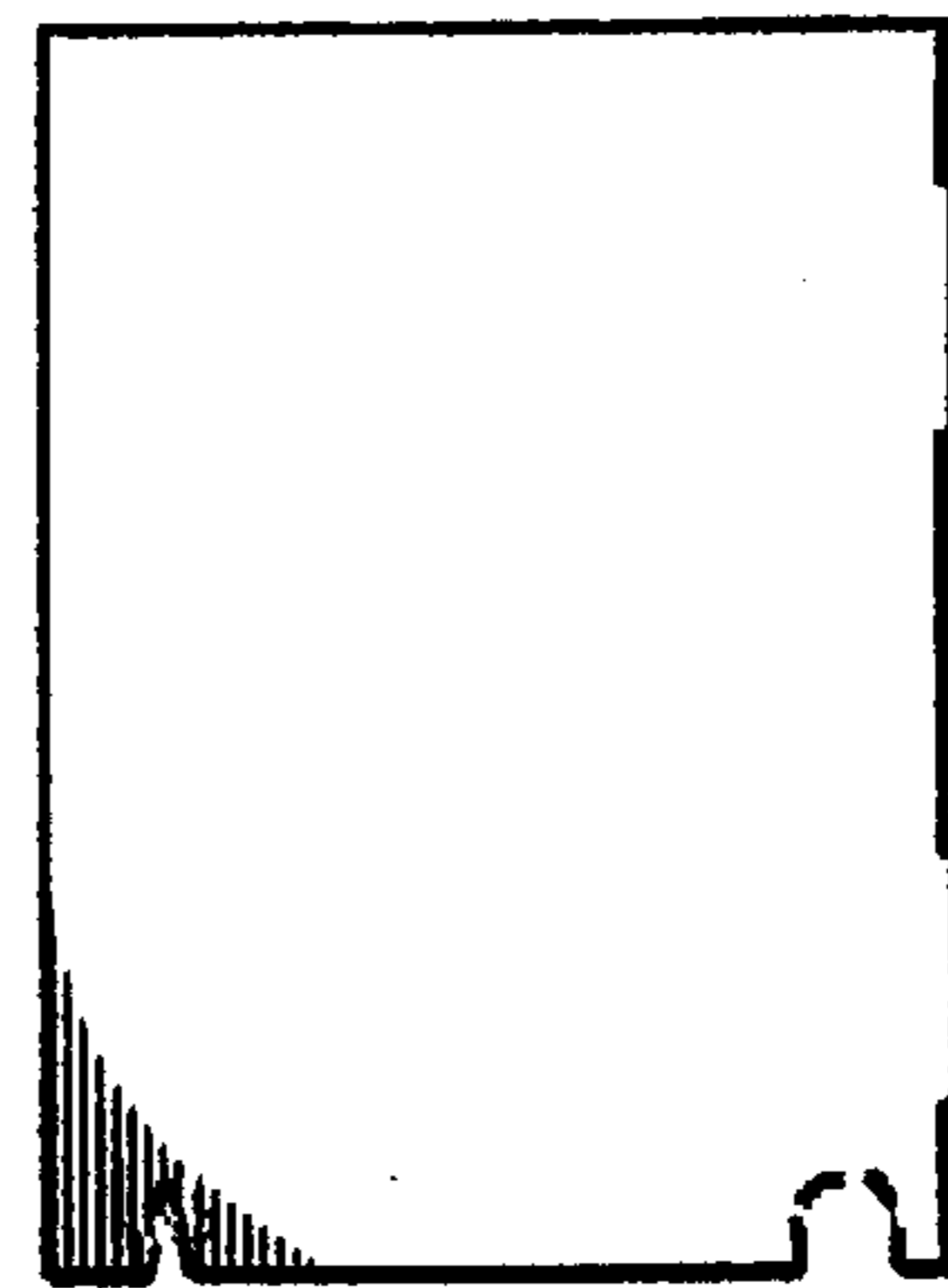

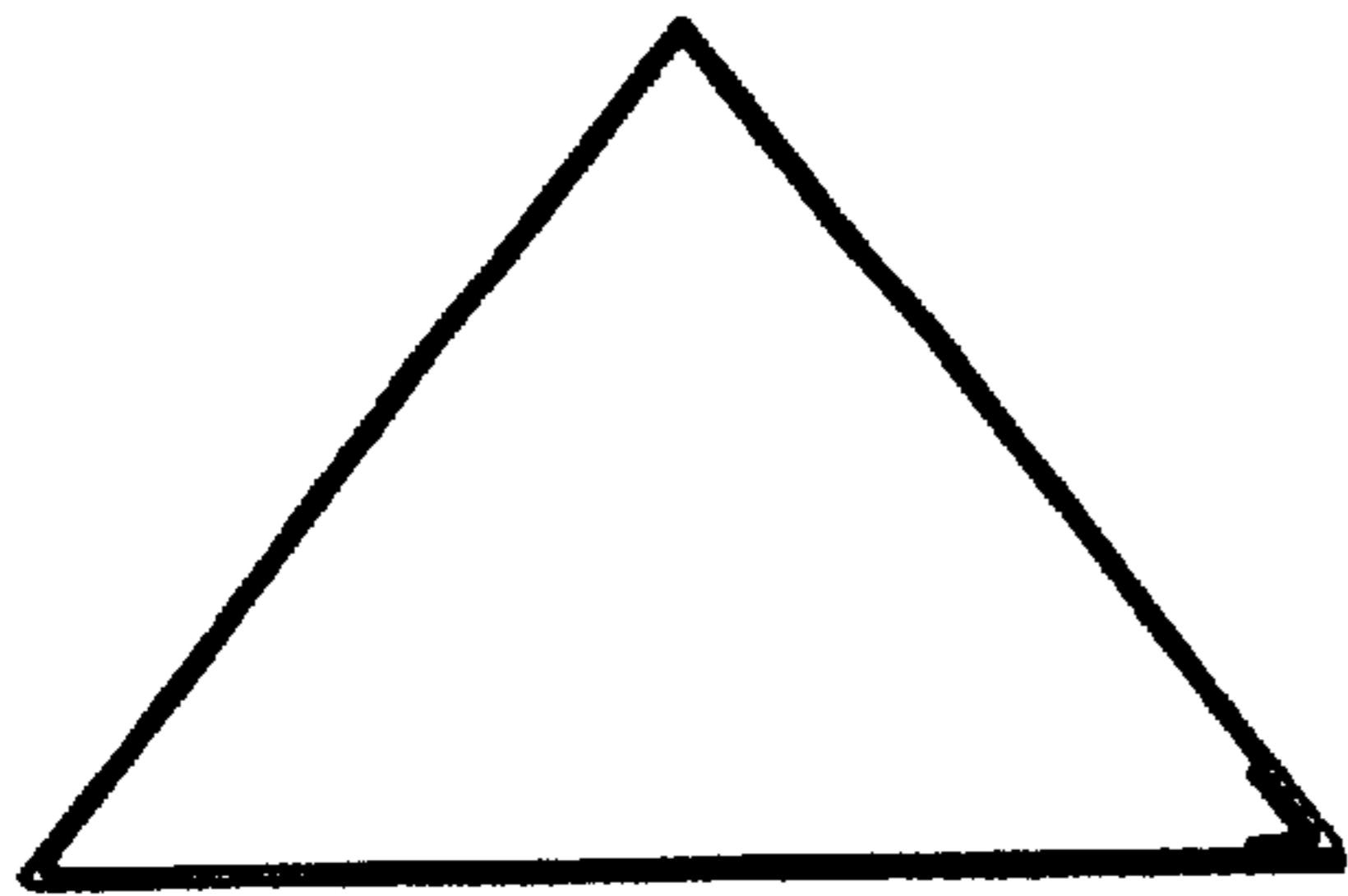

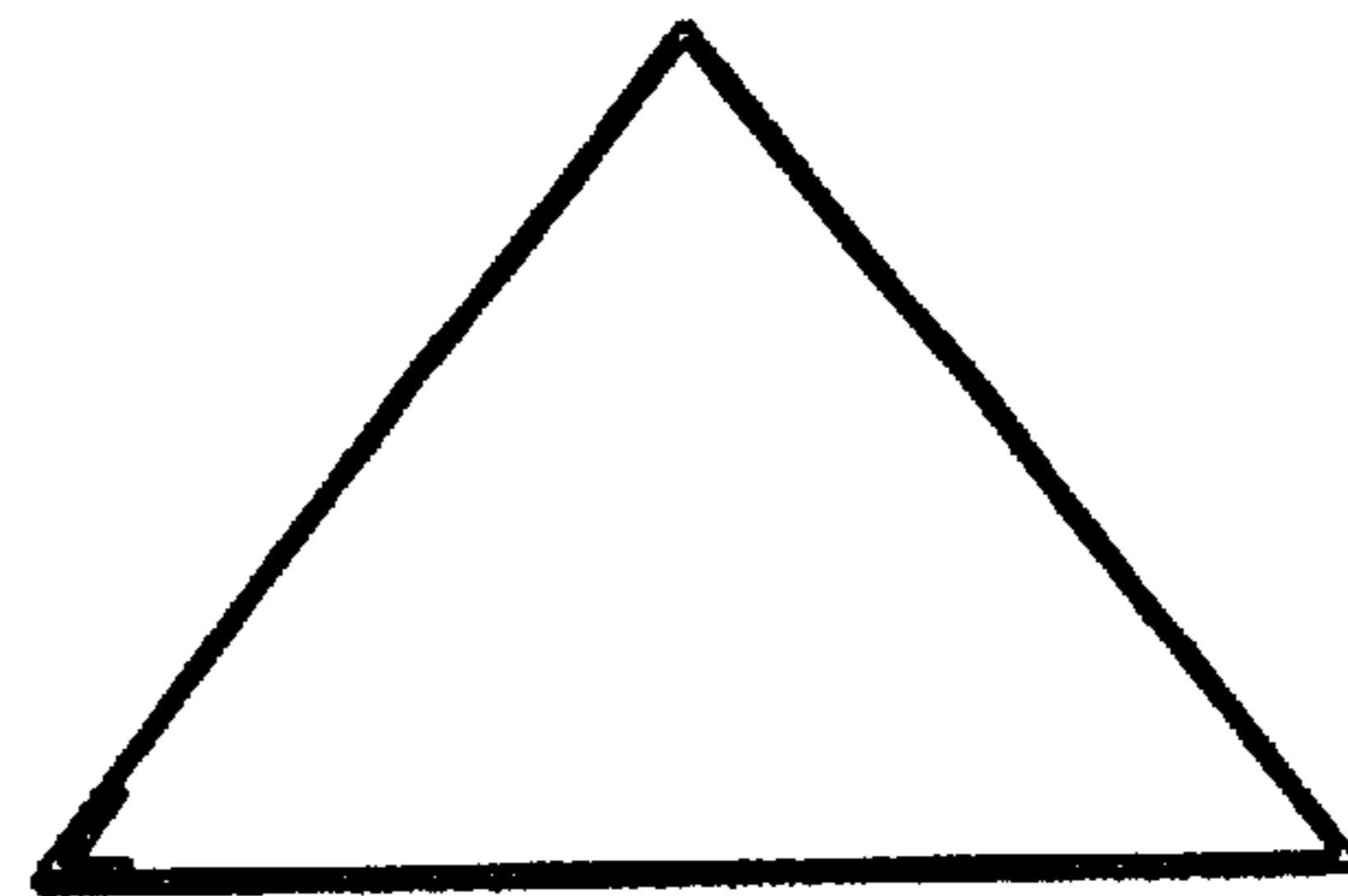

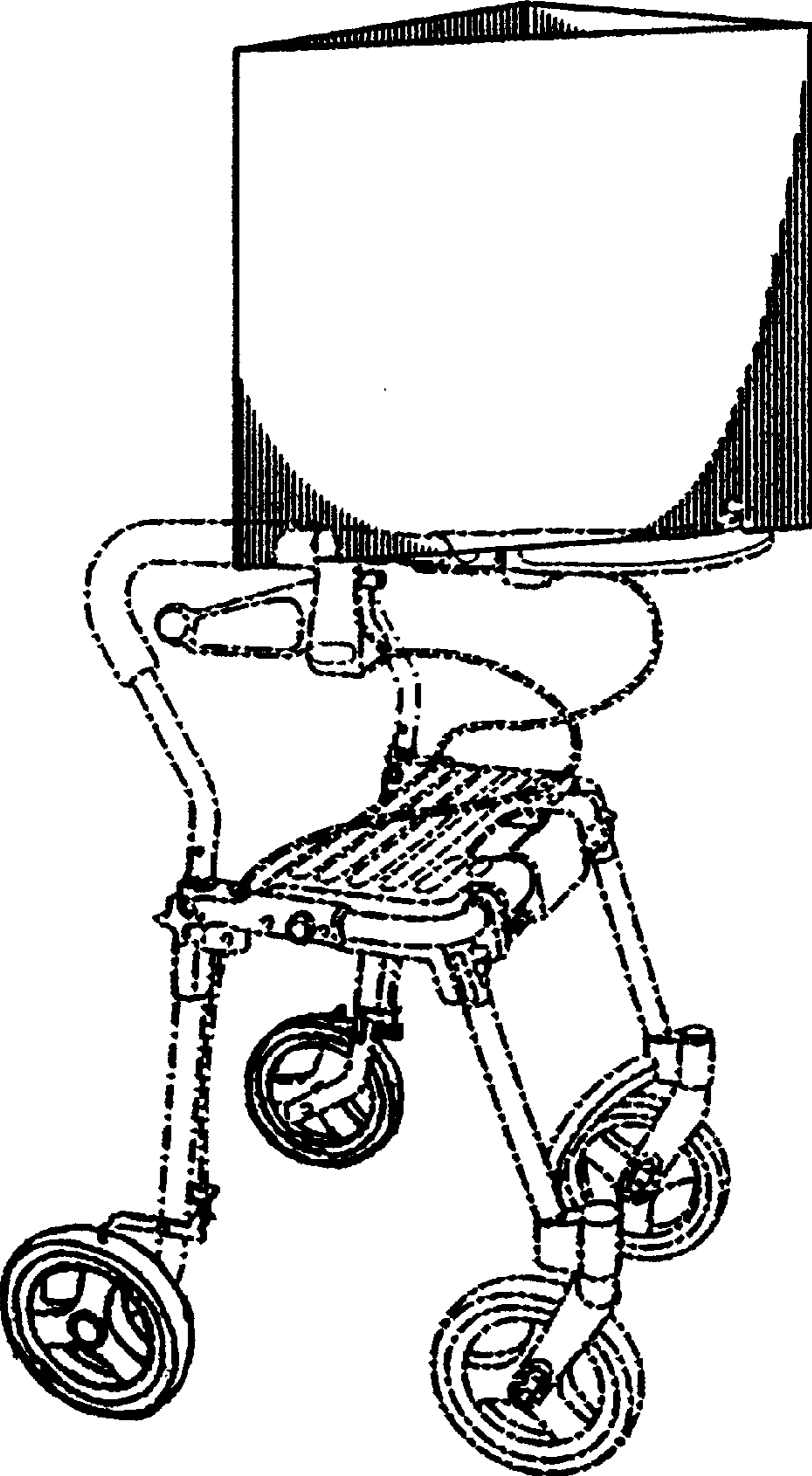
