FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a papaya scoop showing our new design.

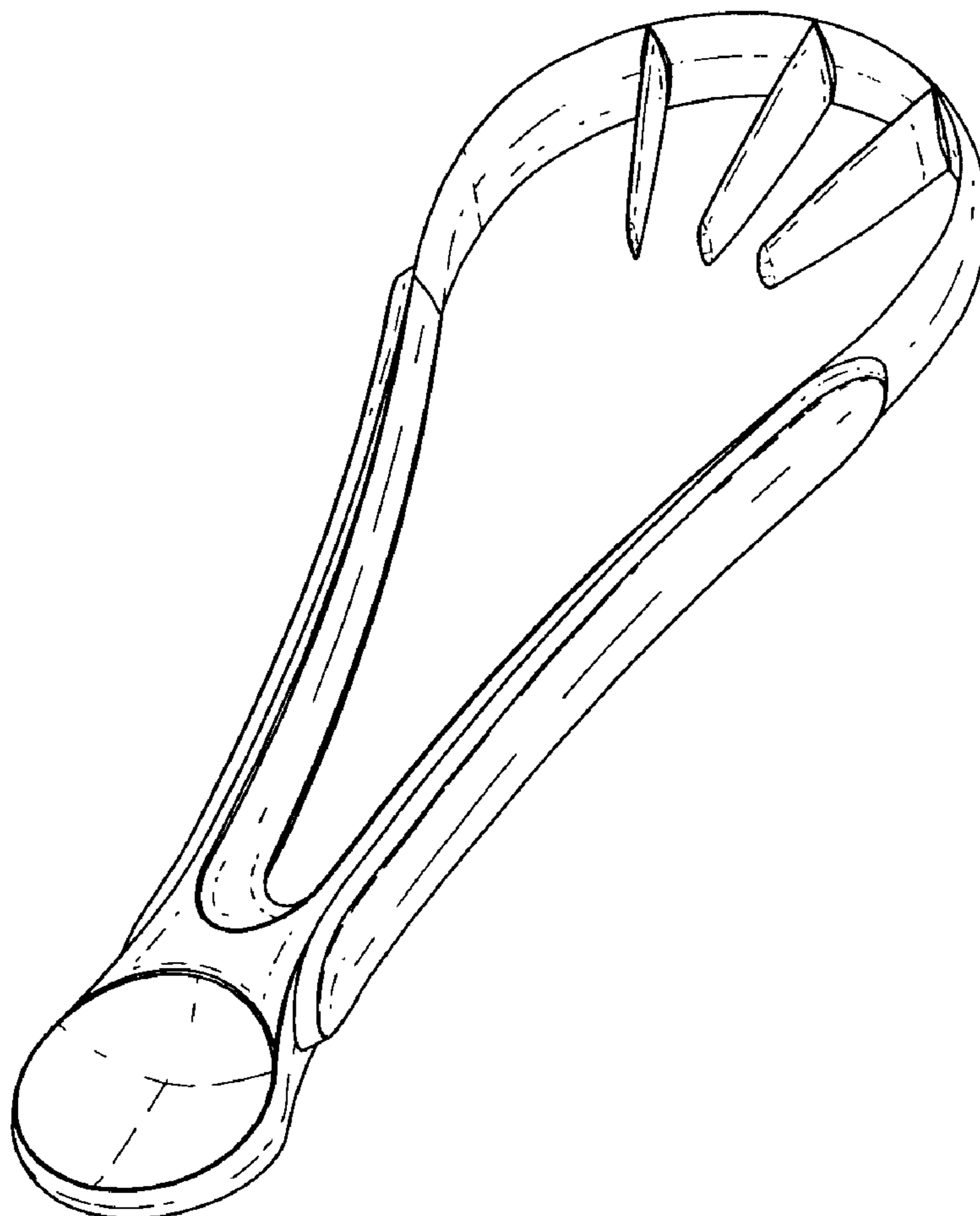
FIG. 2 is a plan view thereof.

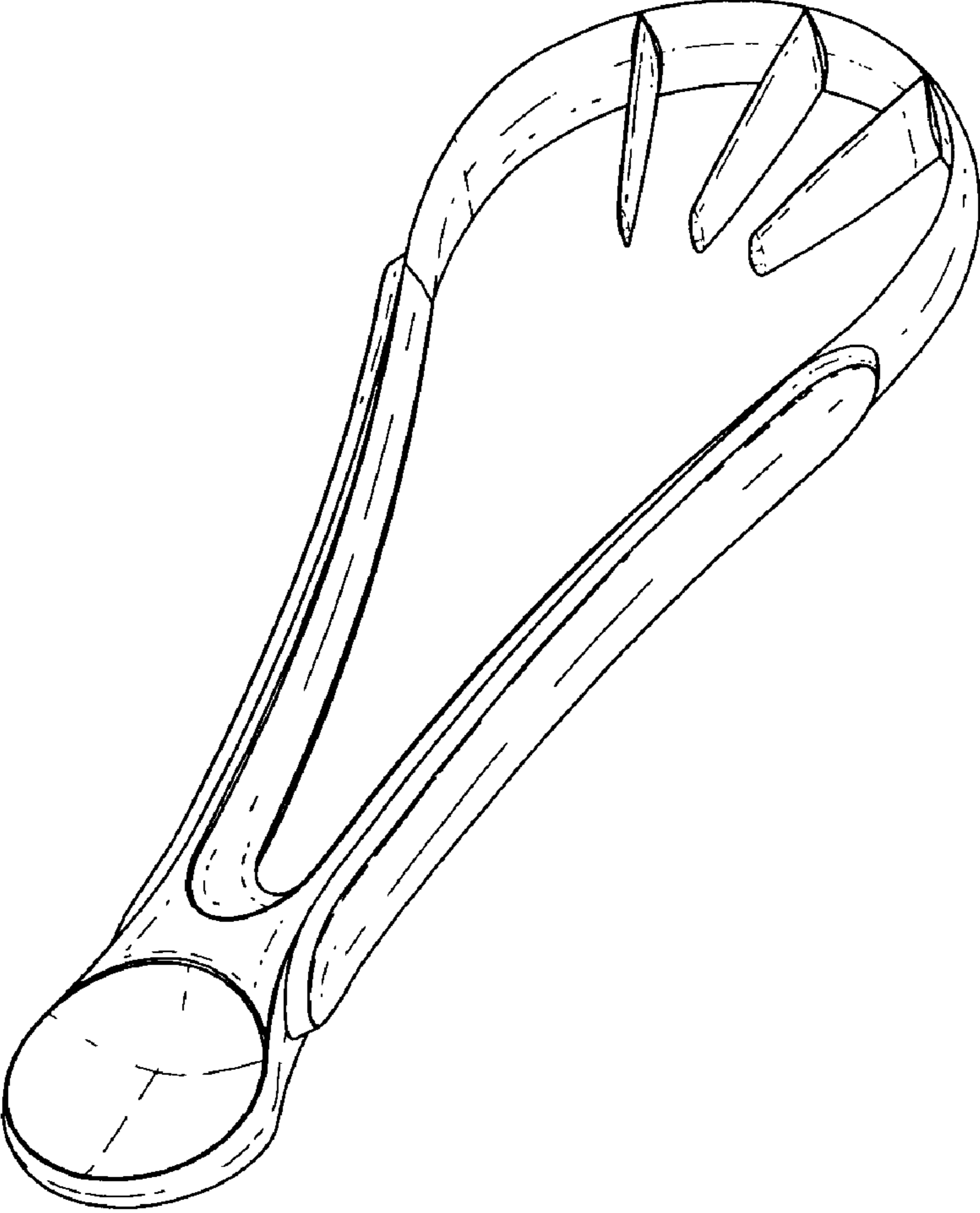

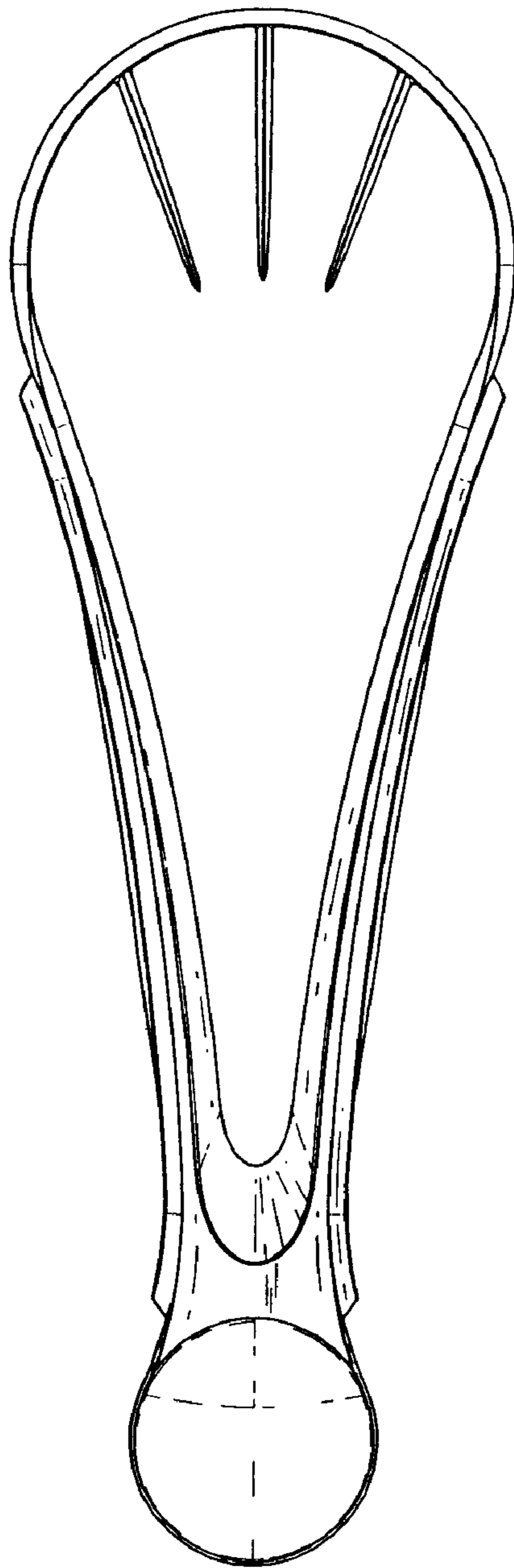

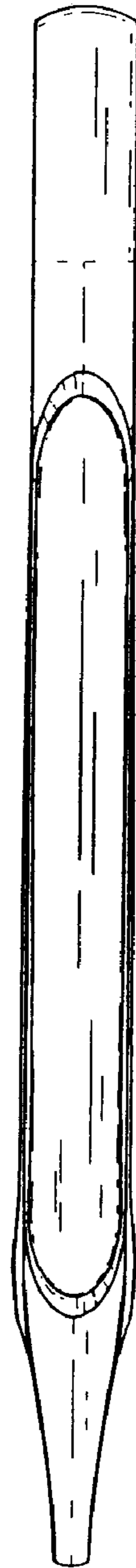

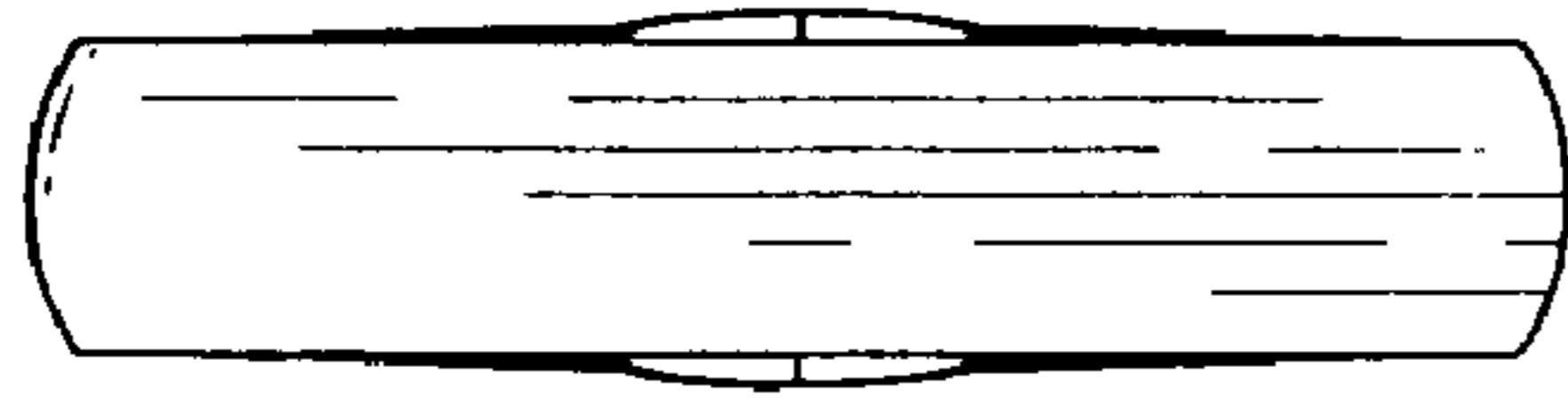

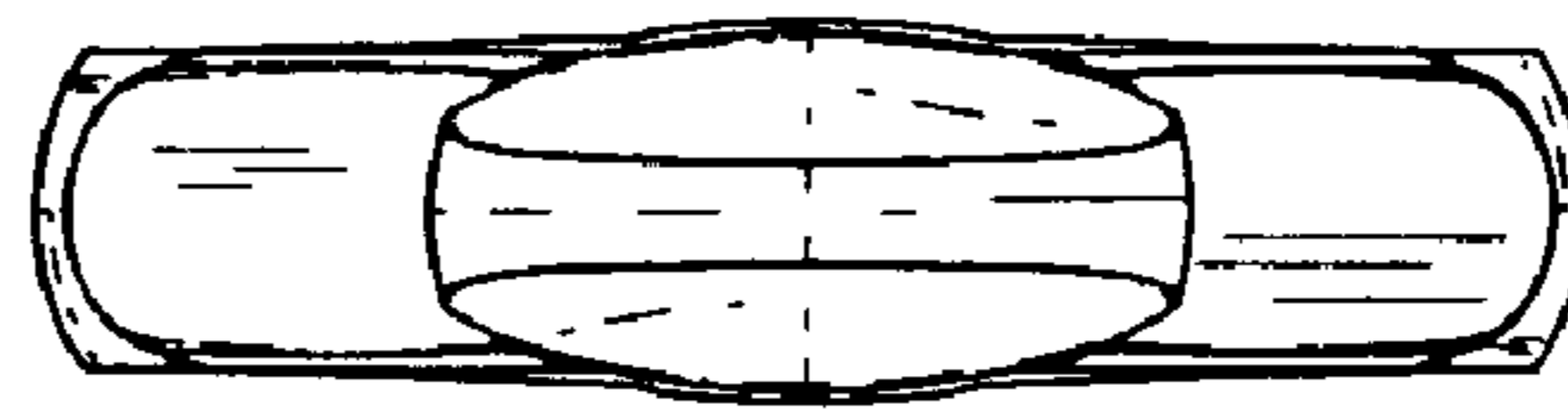
