DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a power tool housing according to my new design, the broken lines of the power tool housing are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the power tool housing of FIG. 1, the broken lines of the power tool housing are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

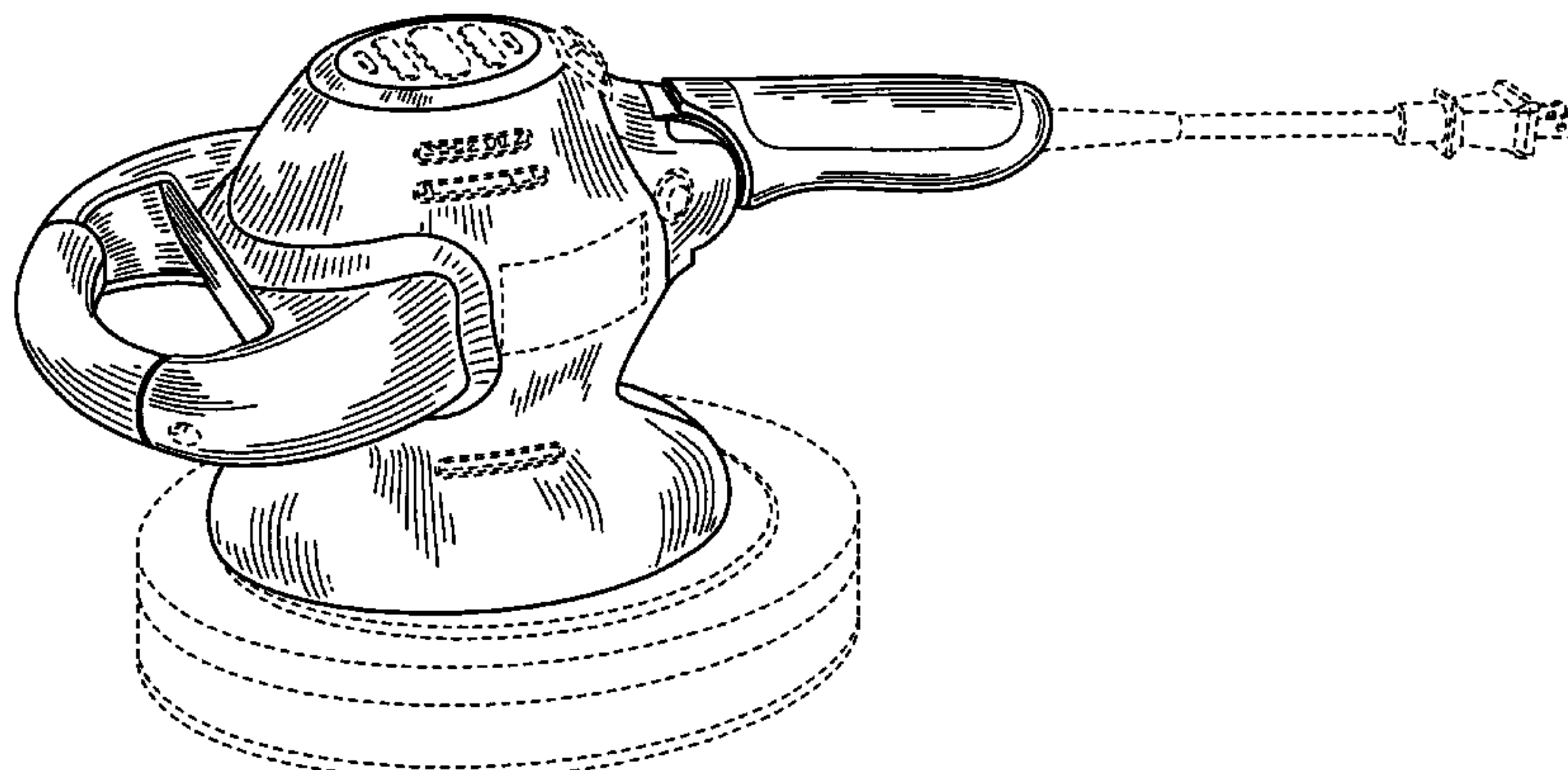
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the power tool housing of FIG. 1, the broken lines of the power tool housing are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

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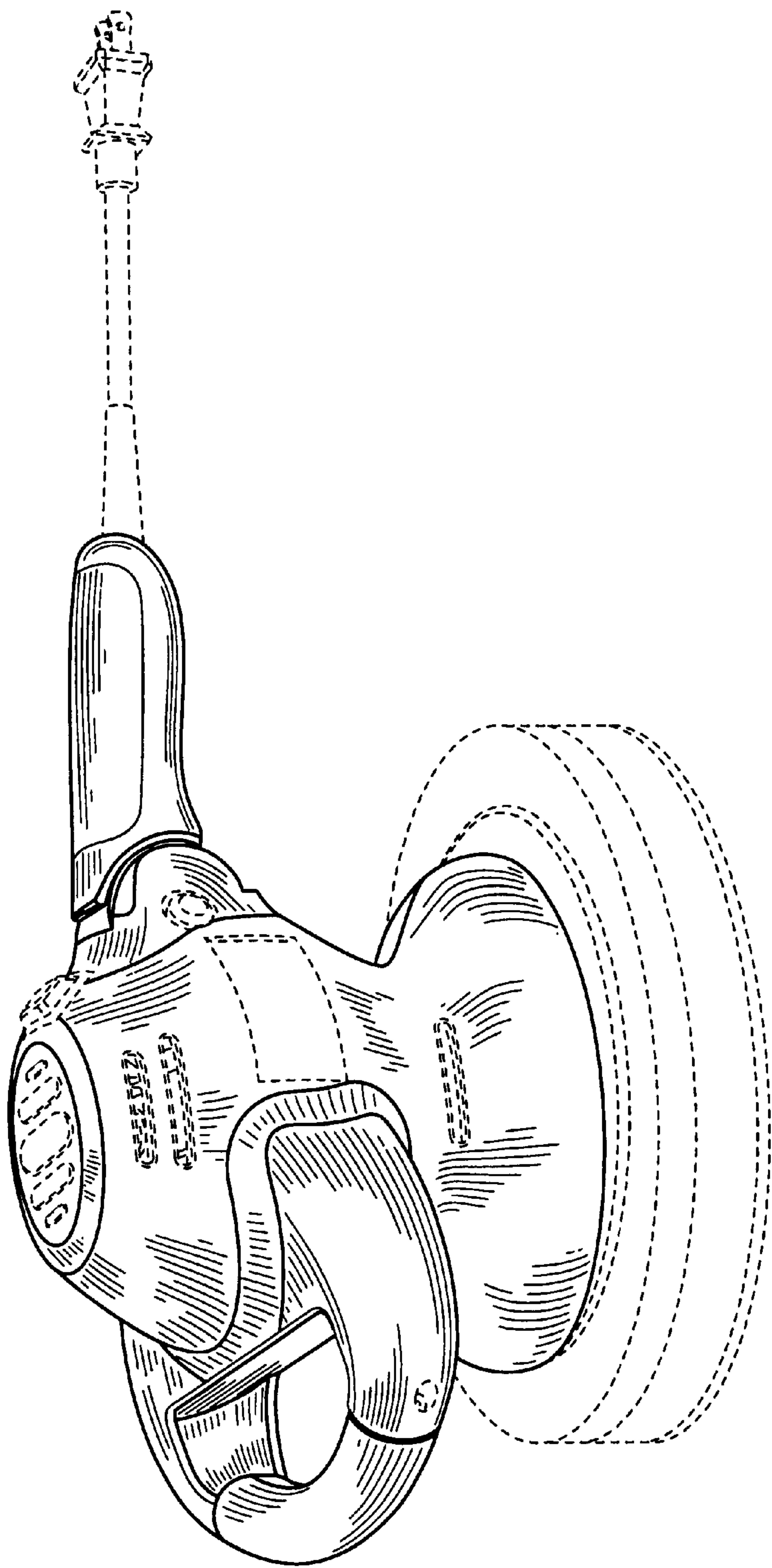

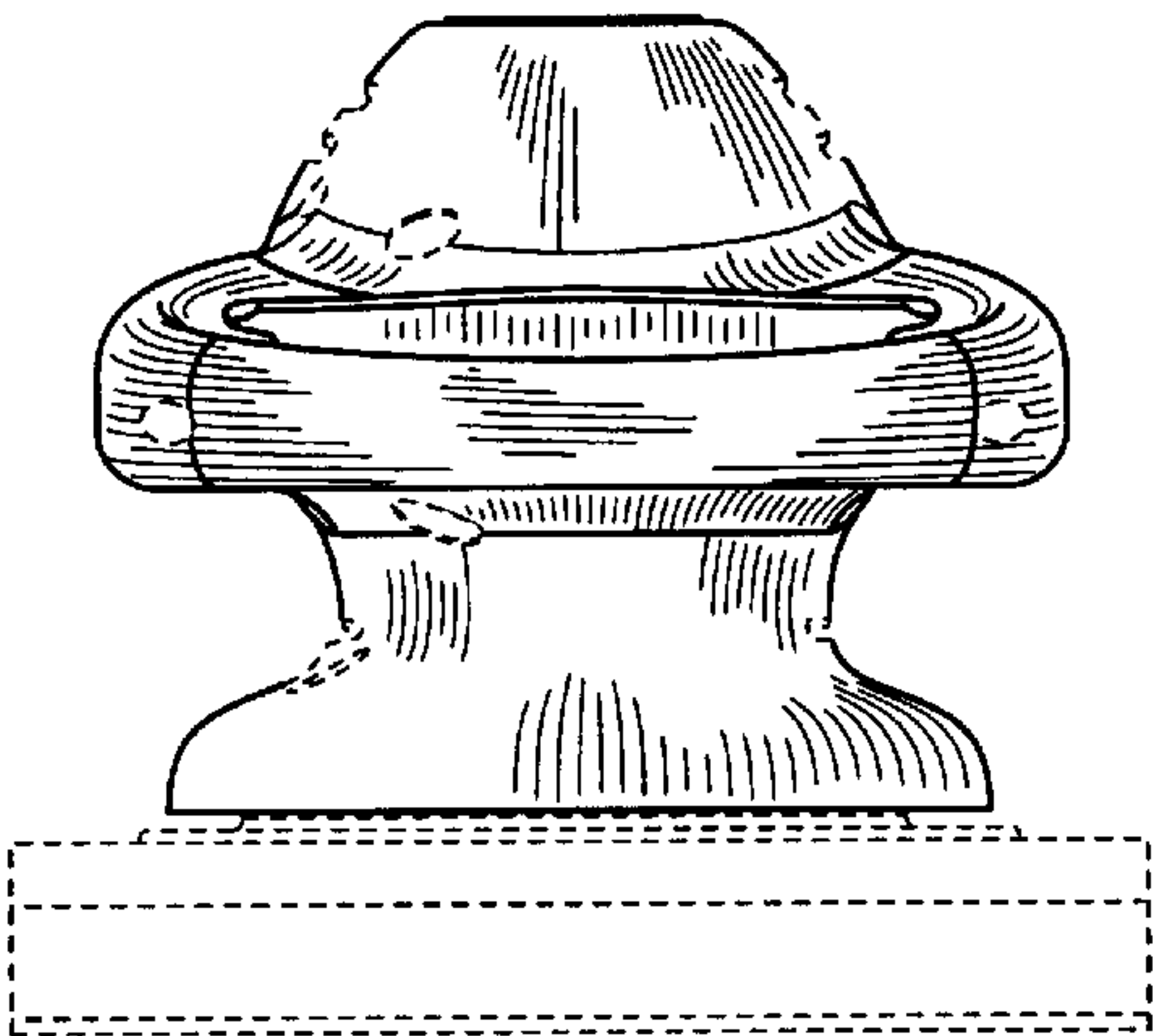

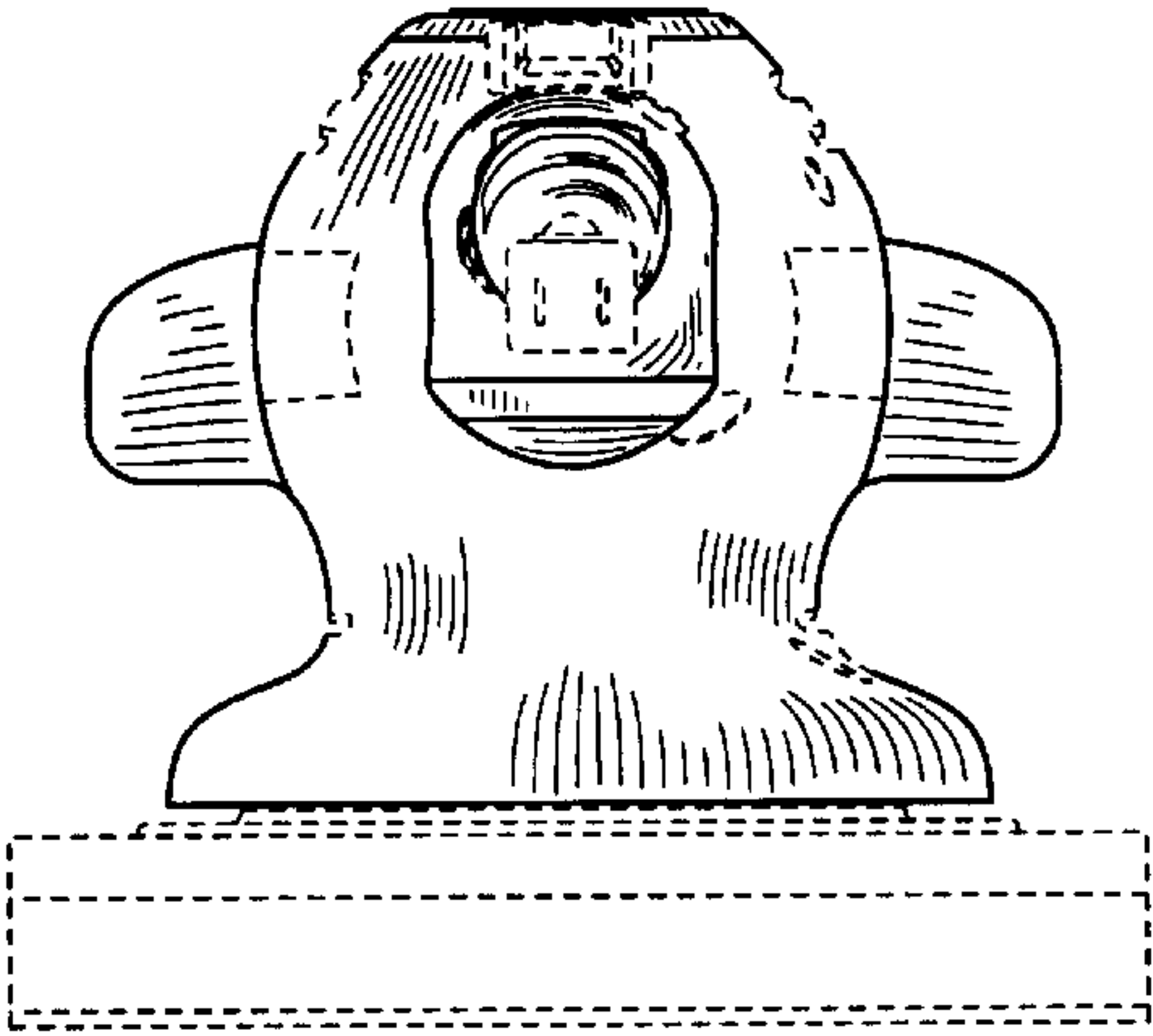

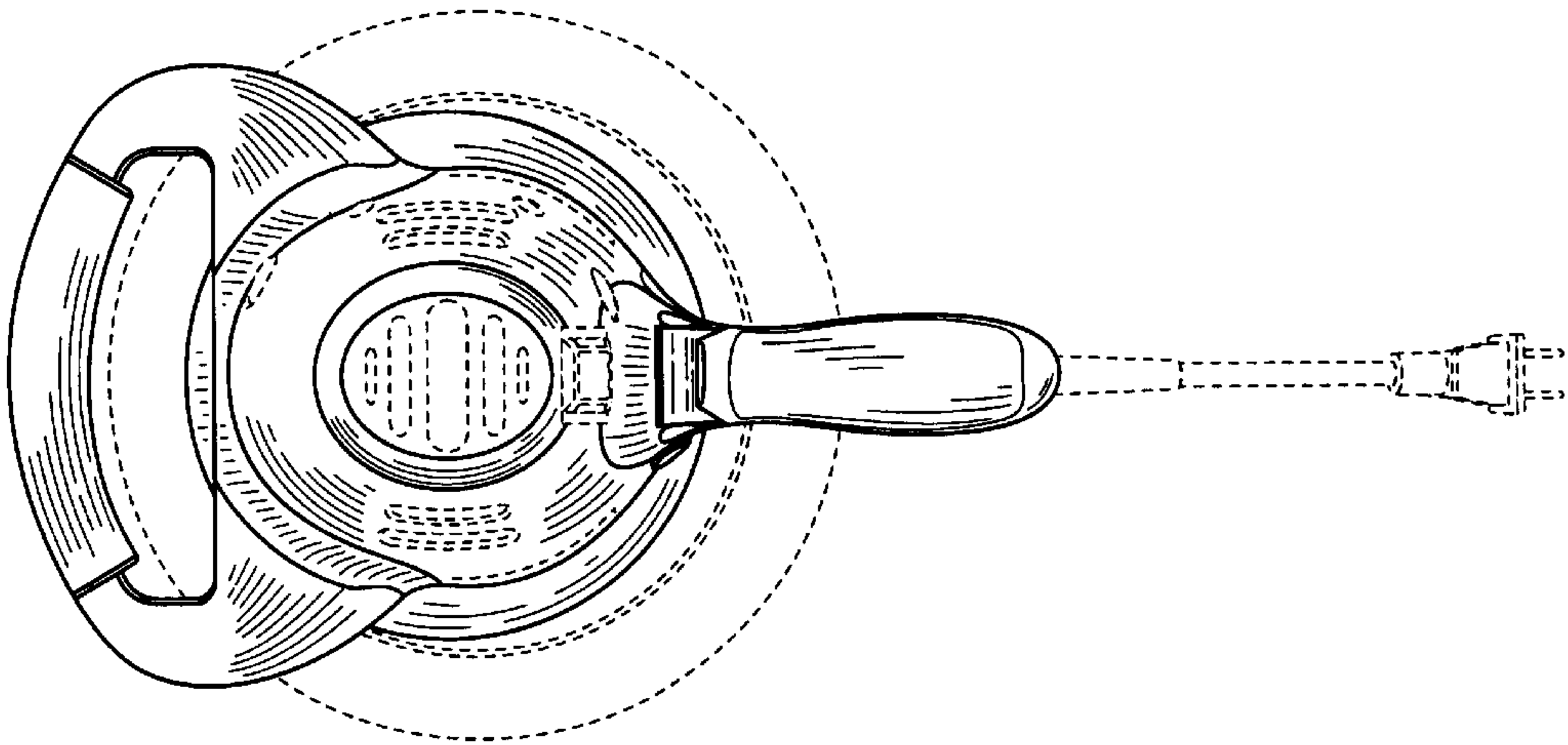

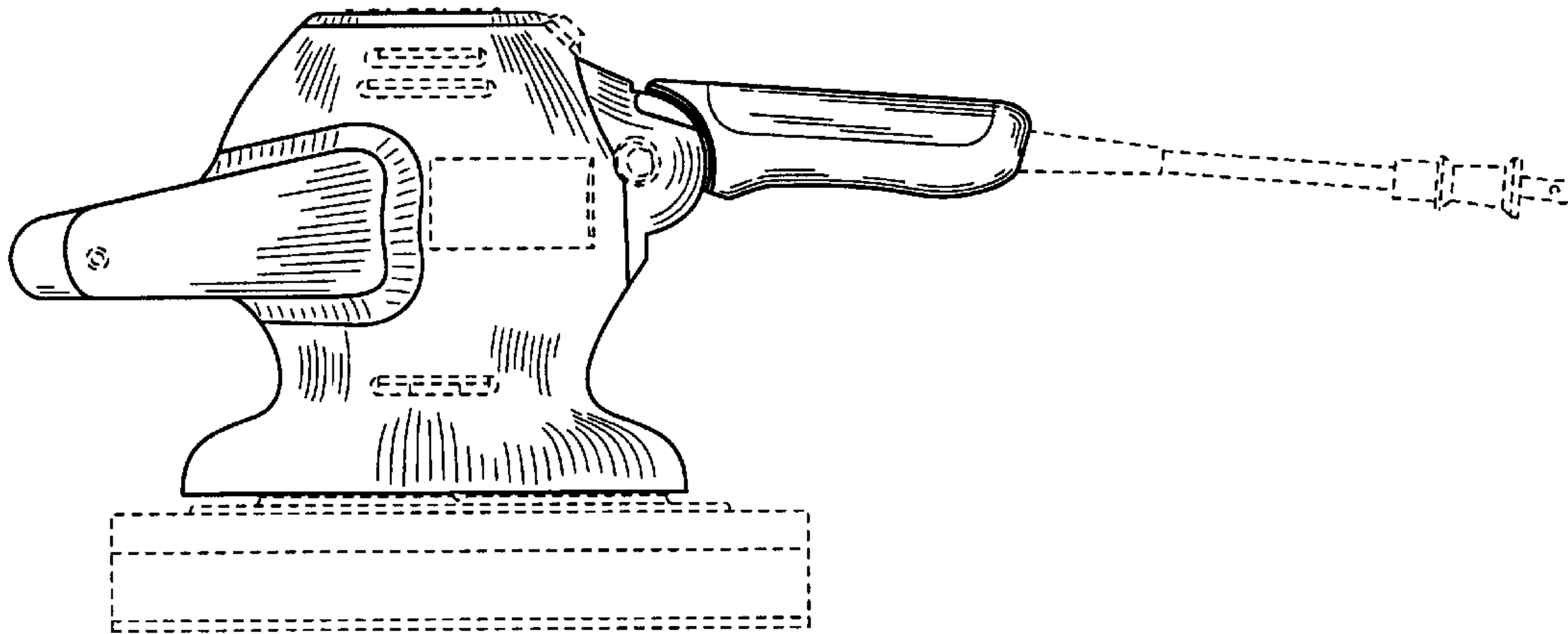

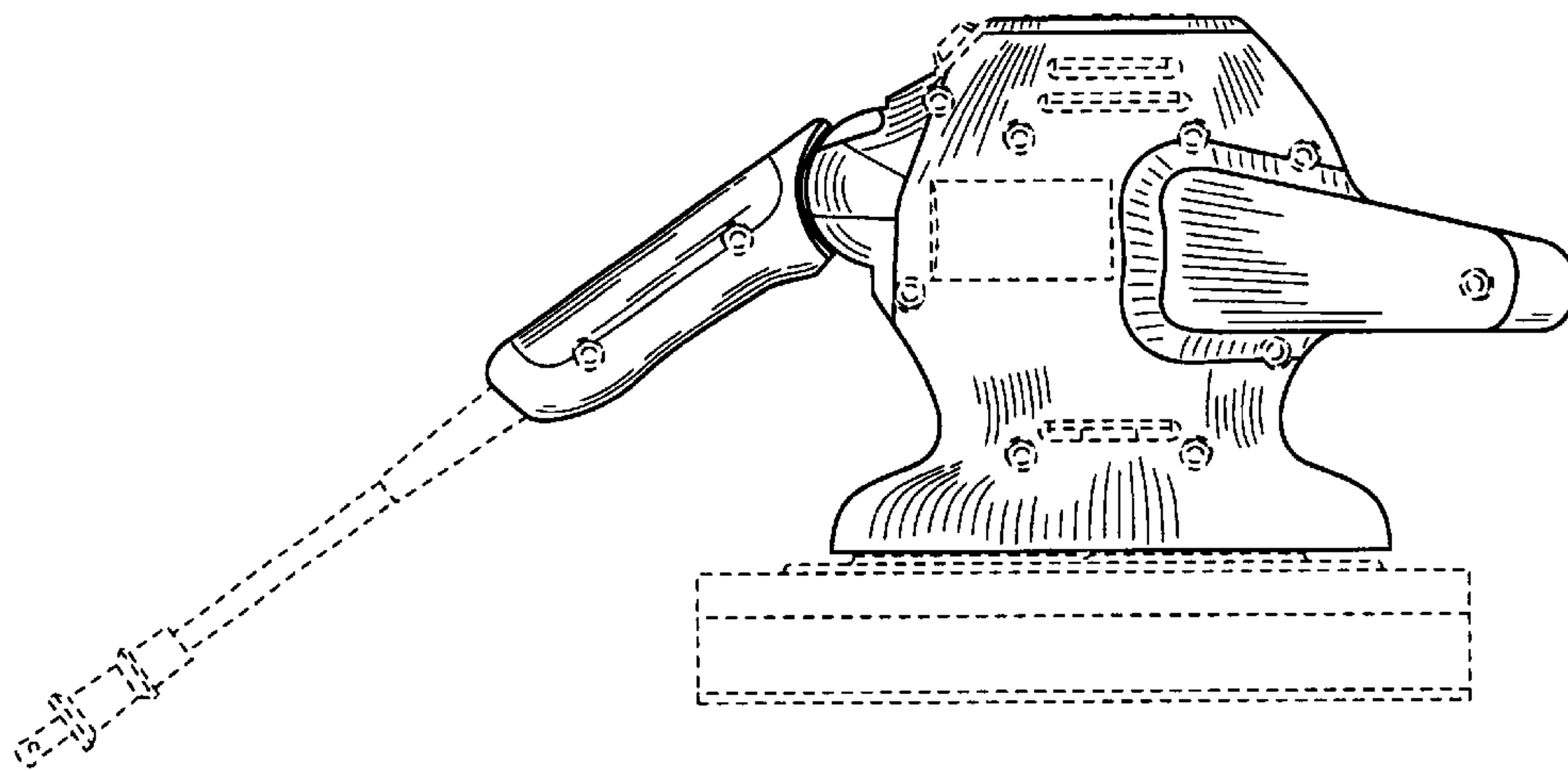
