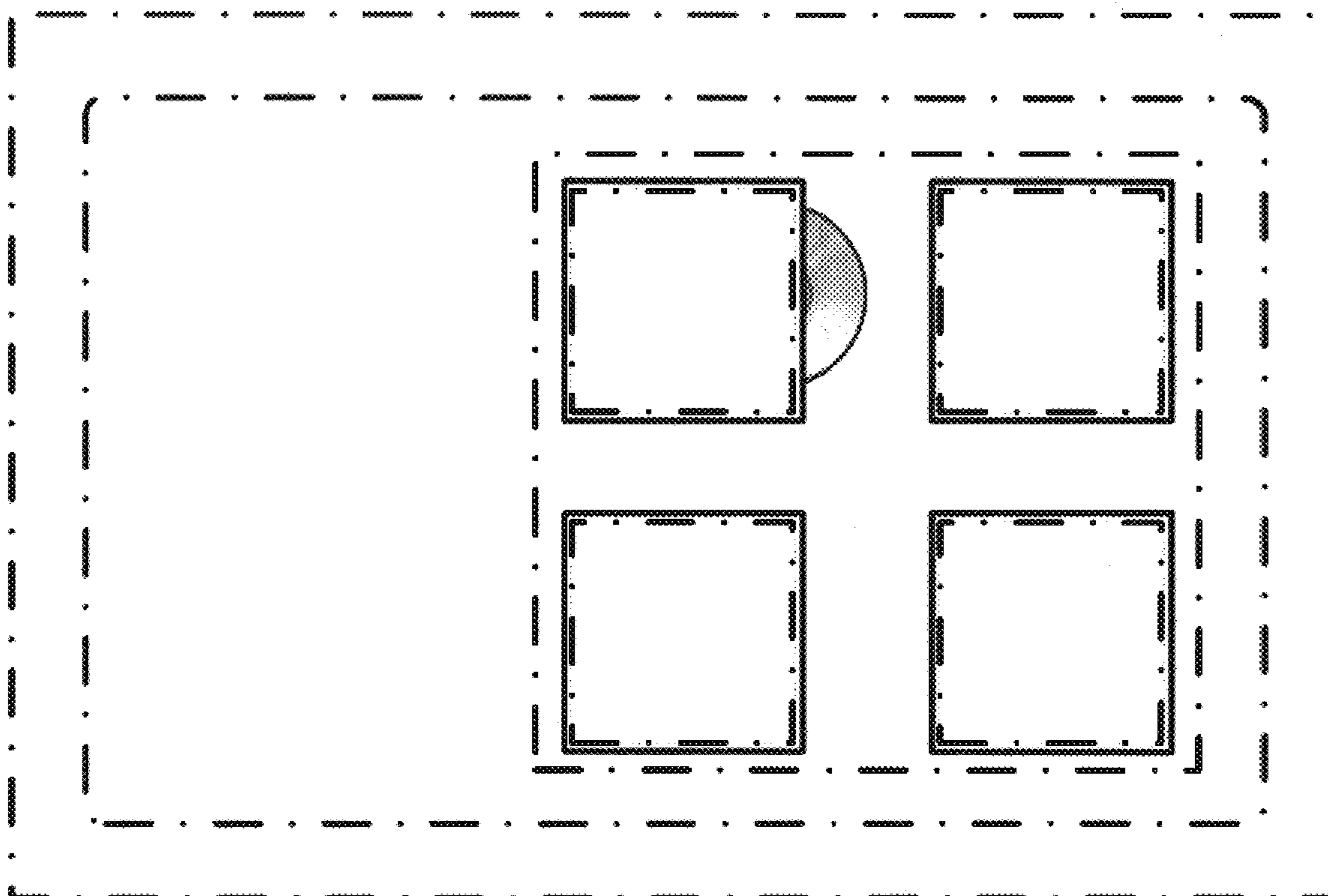
The FIGURE is a front view of a icon for a display screen showing my new design.

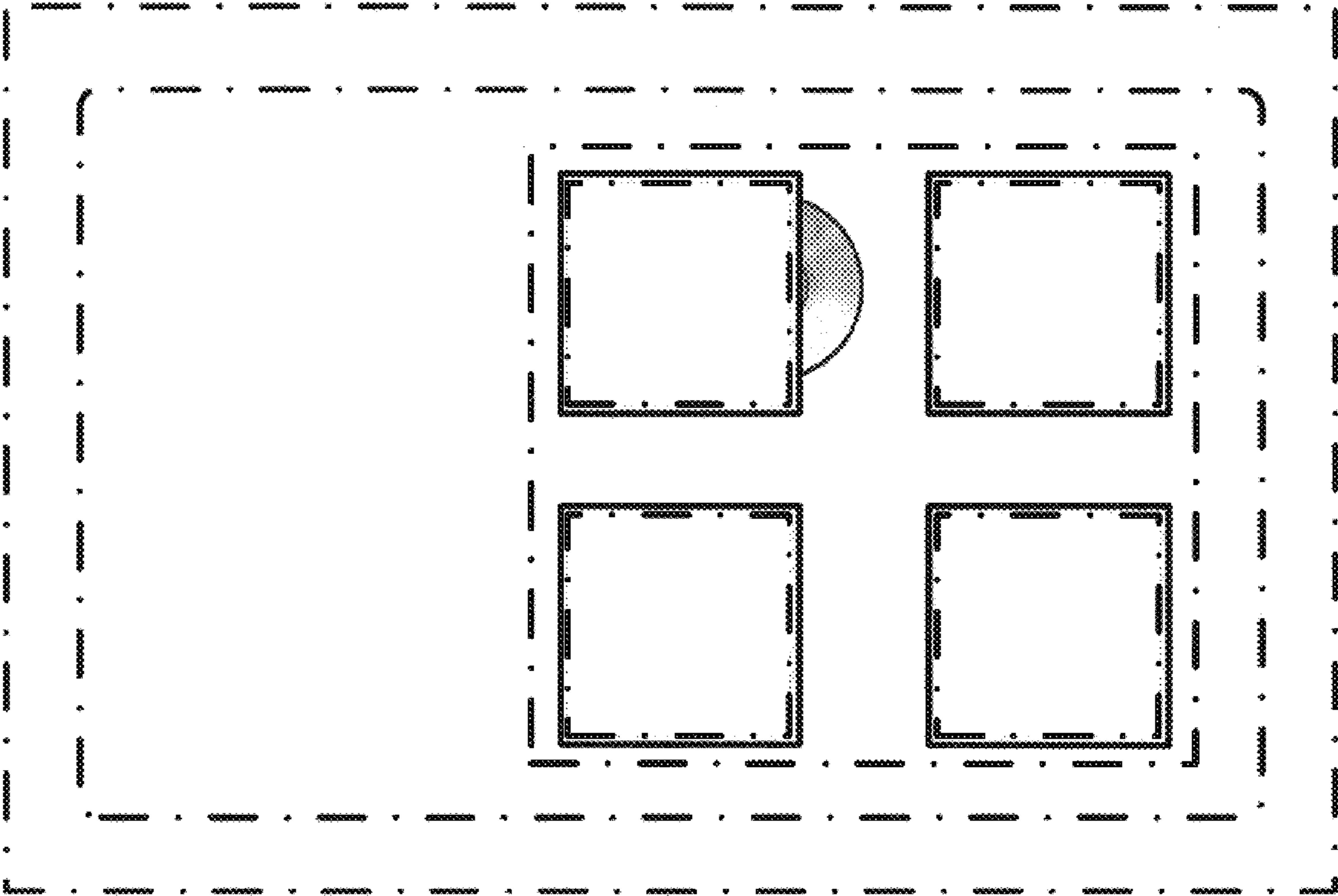
