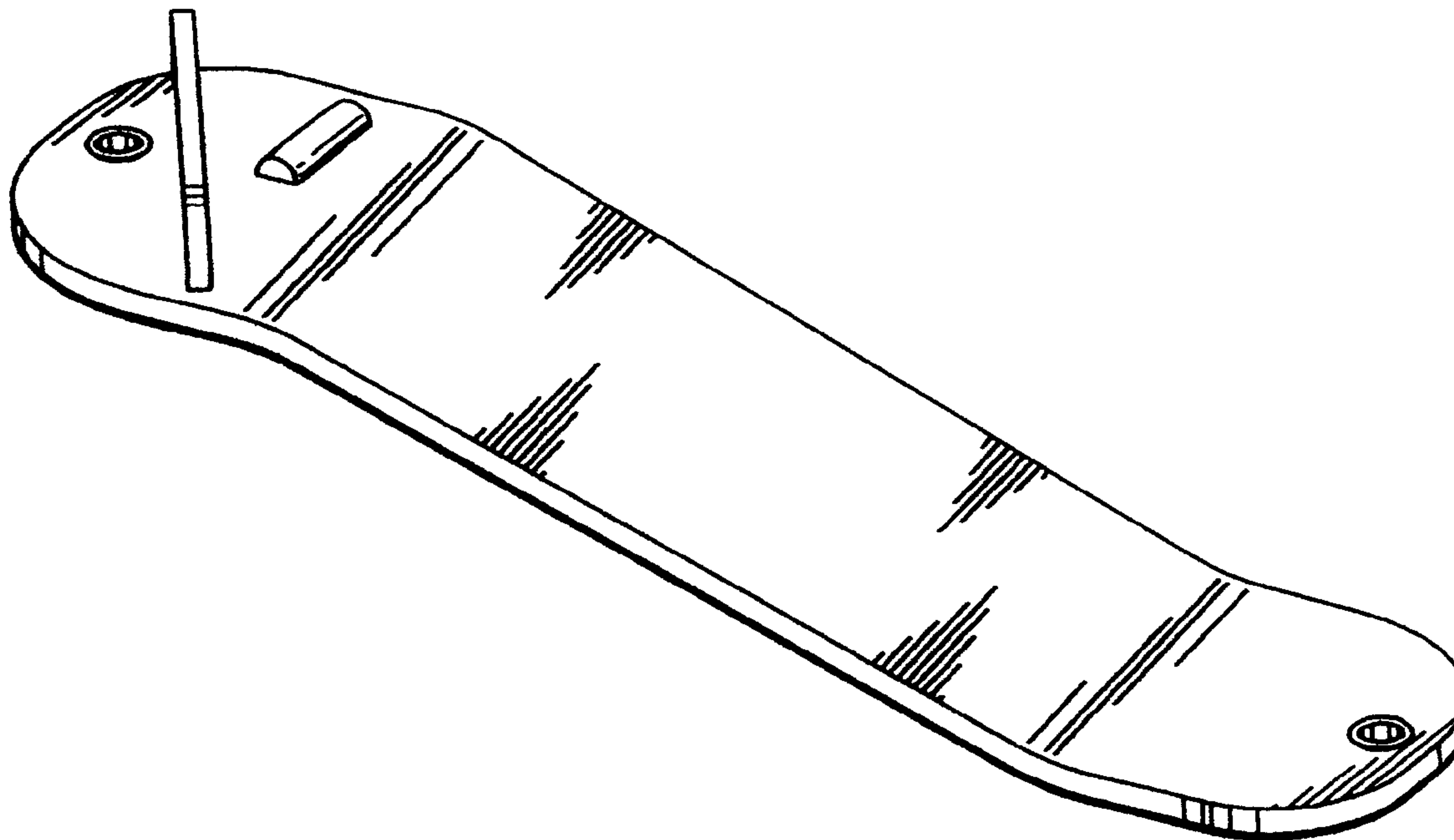

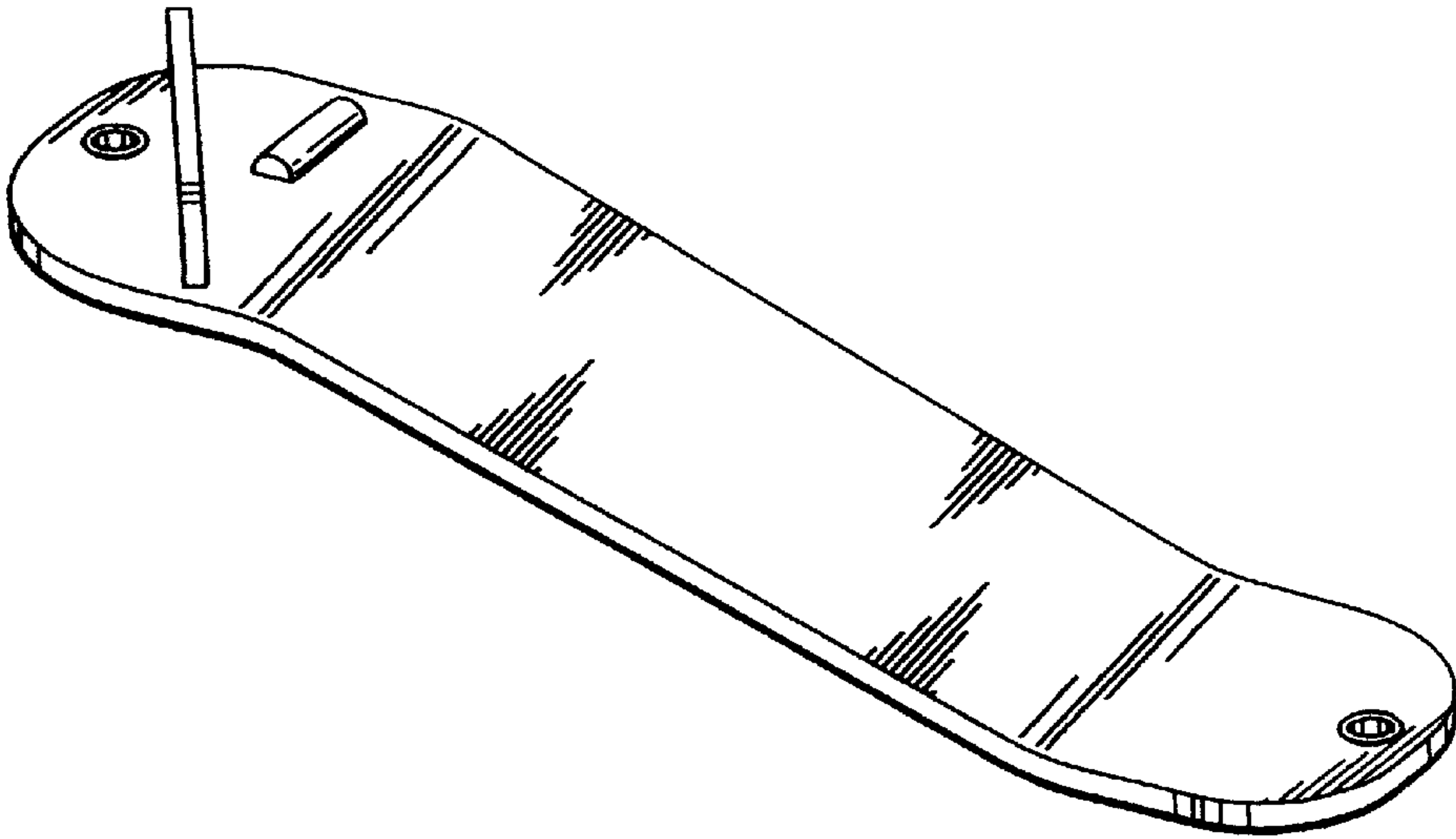
The ornamental design for a fishing lure, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

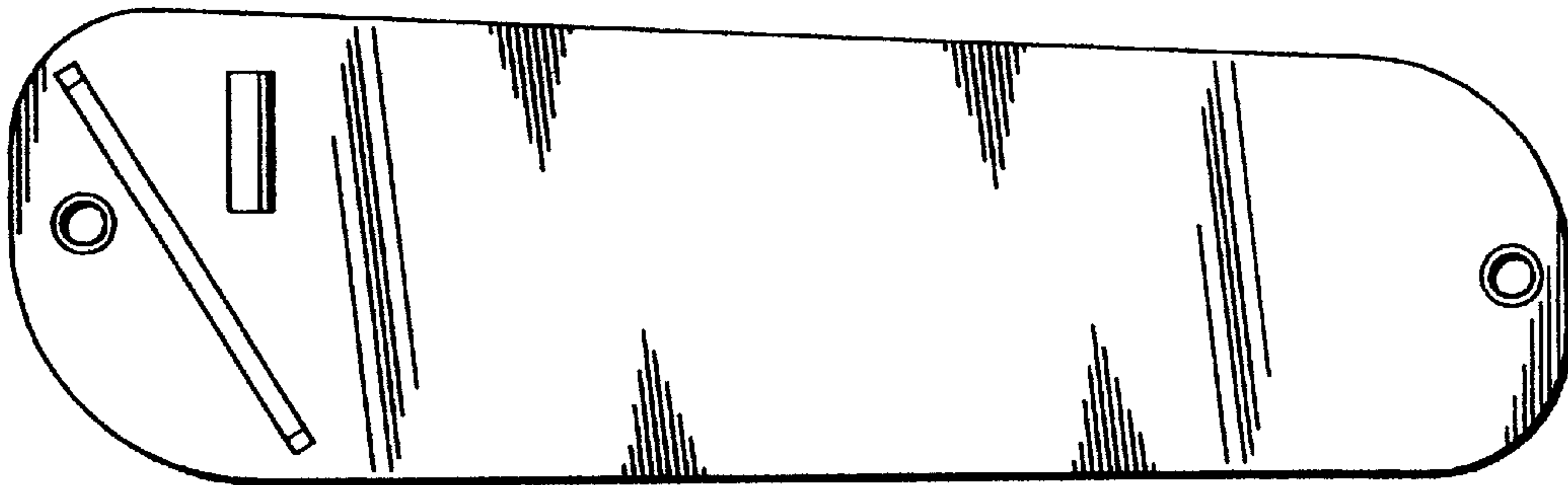
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view showing my new design;

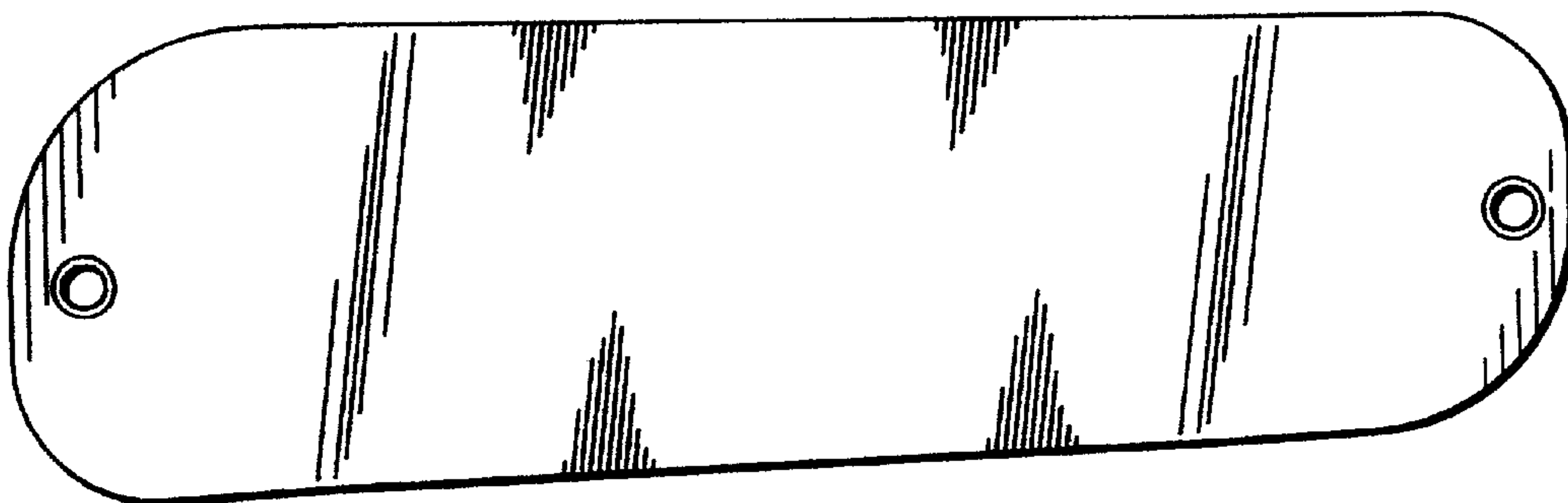




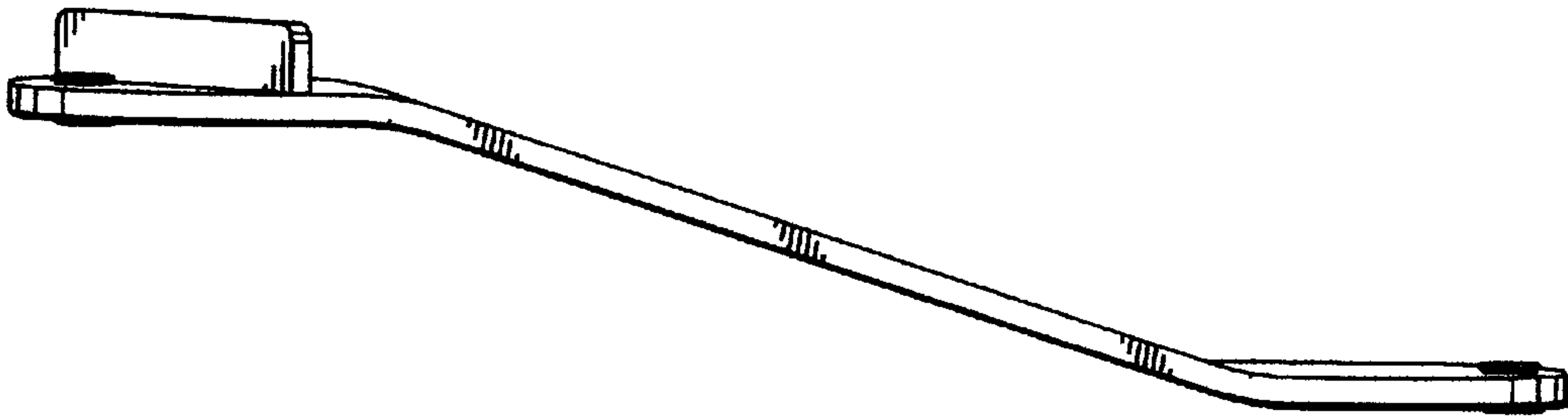

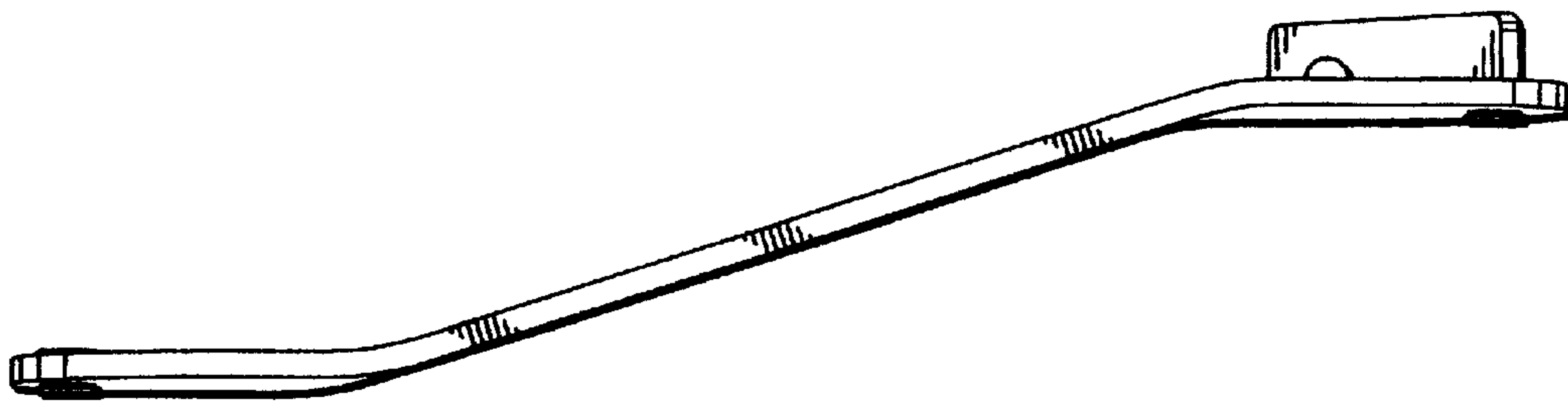

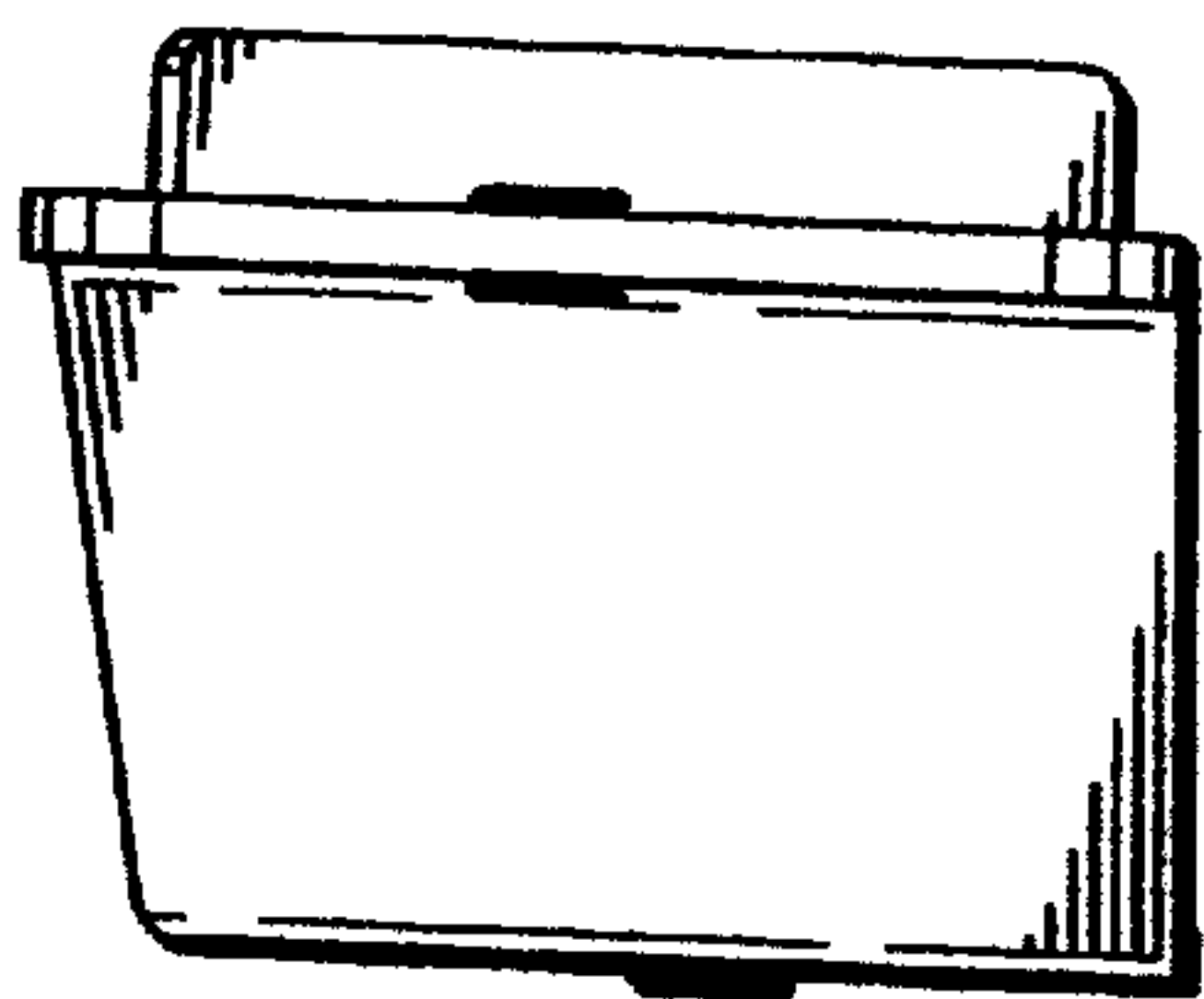

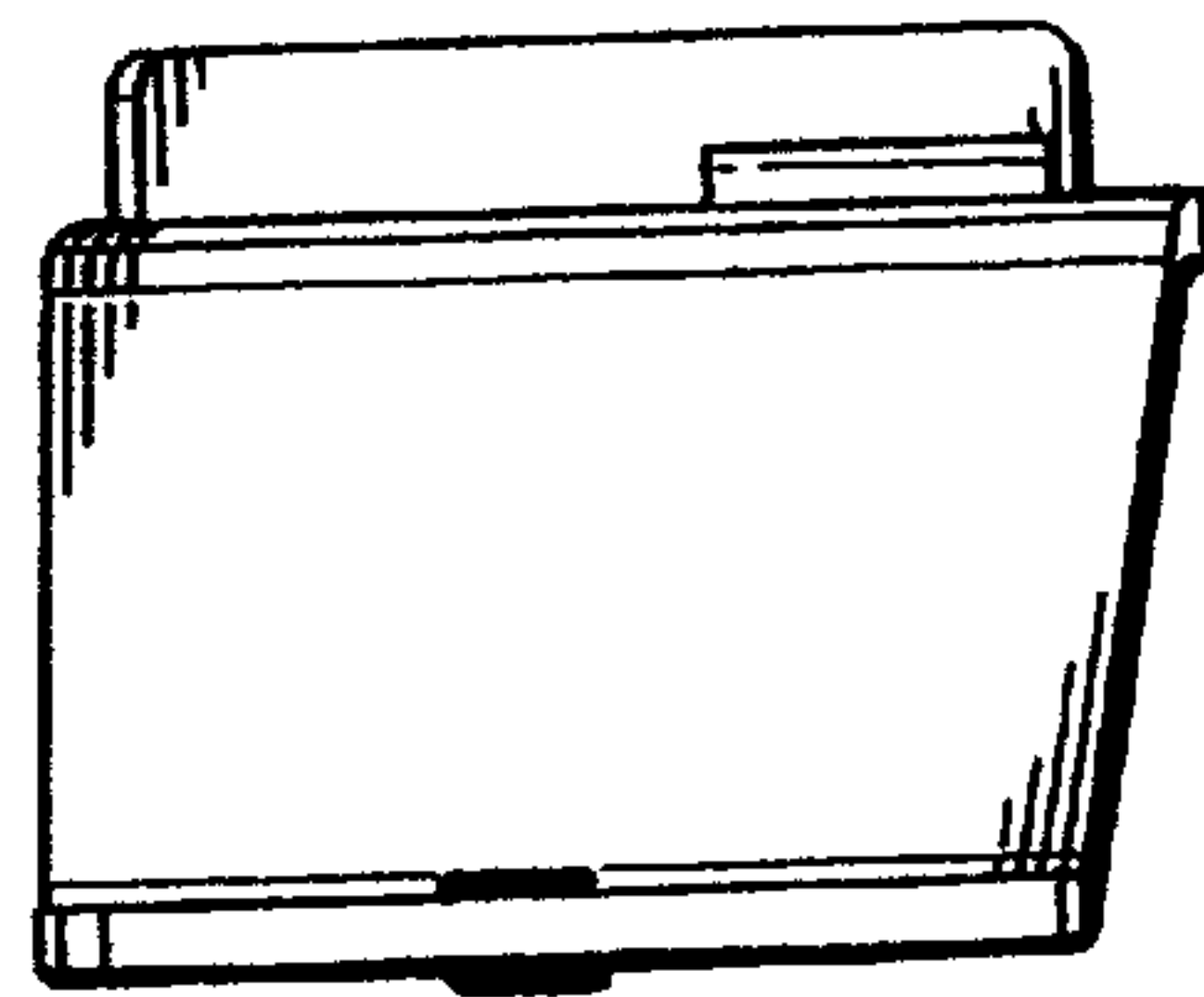
