
I claim the ornamental design for a magnetic device for treatment of fluids, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a top planar view of a first embodiment of the magnetic device for treatment of fluids of my present design;


- FIG. 2 is a planar view of a side of the device shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

- FIG. 7 is a top planar view of a fourth embodiment of the magnetic device for treatment of fluids of my present design;
- FIG. 8 is a planar view of a side of the device shown in FIG. 7, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
- FIG. 9 is a top planar view of a fifth embodiment of the magnetic device for treatment of fluids of my present design;
- FIG. 10 is a planar view of a side of the device shown in FIG. 9, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
- FIG. 11 is a top planar view of a sixth embodiment of the magnetic device for treatment of fluids of my present design; and,
- FIG. 12 is a planar view of a side of the device shown in FIG. 11, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.
























