FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the postpartum pad.

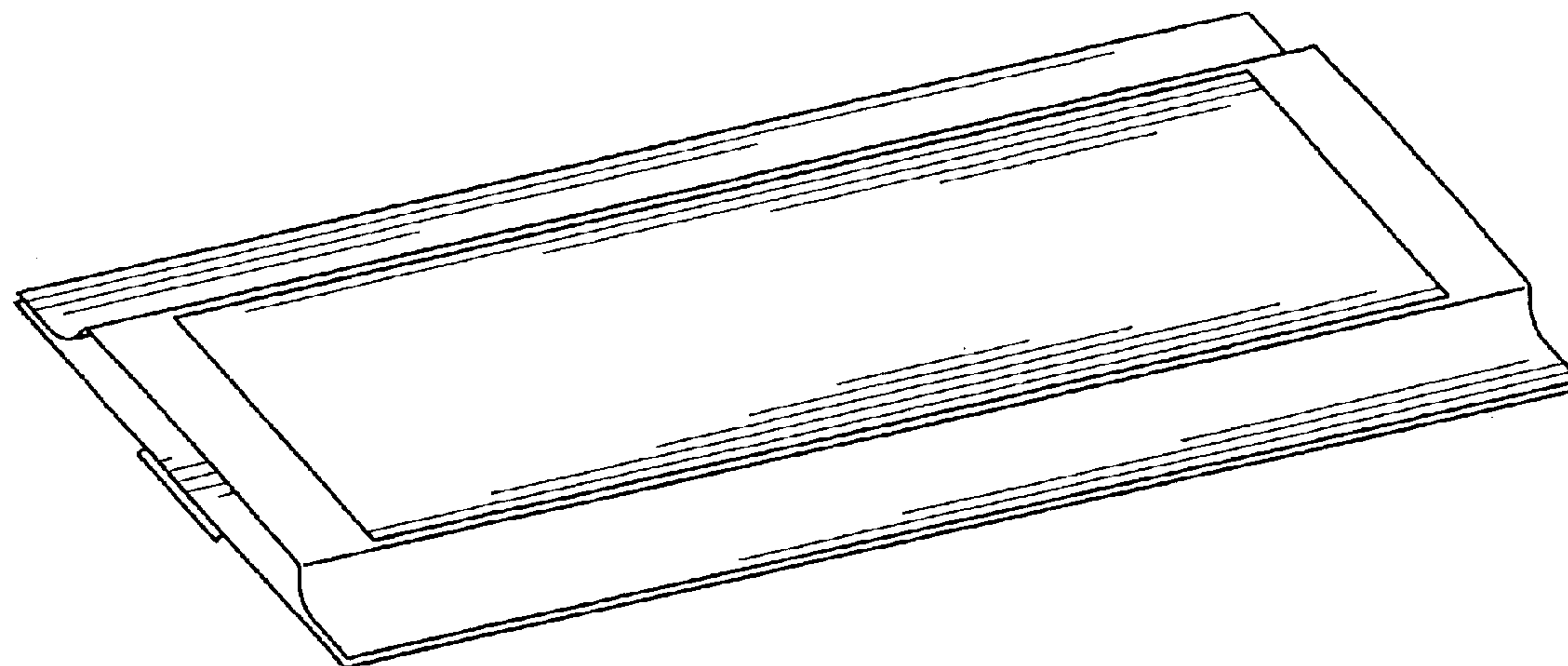
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of the top of the postpartum pad.

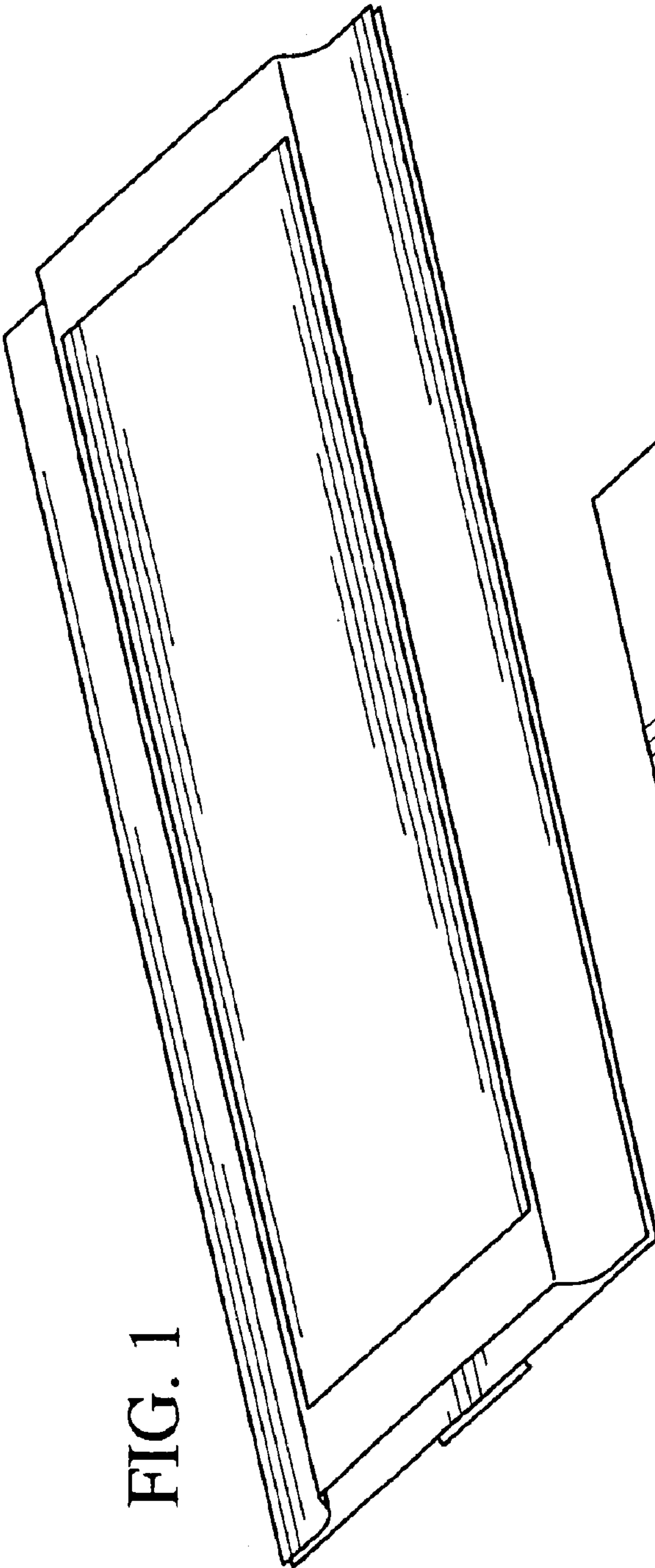

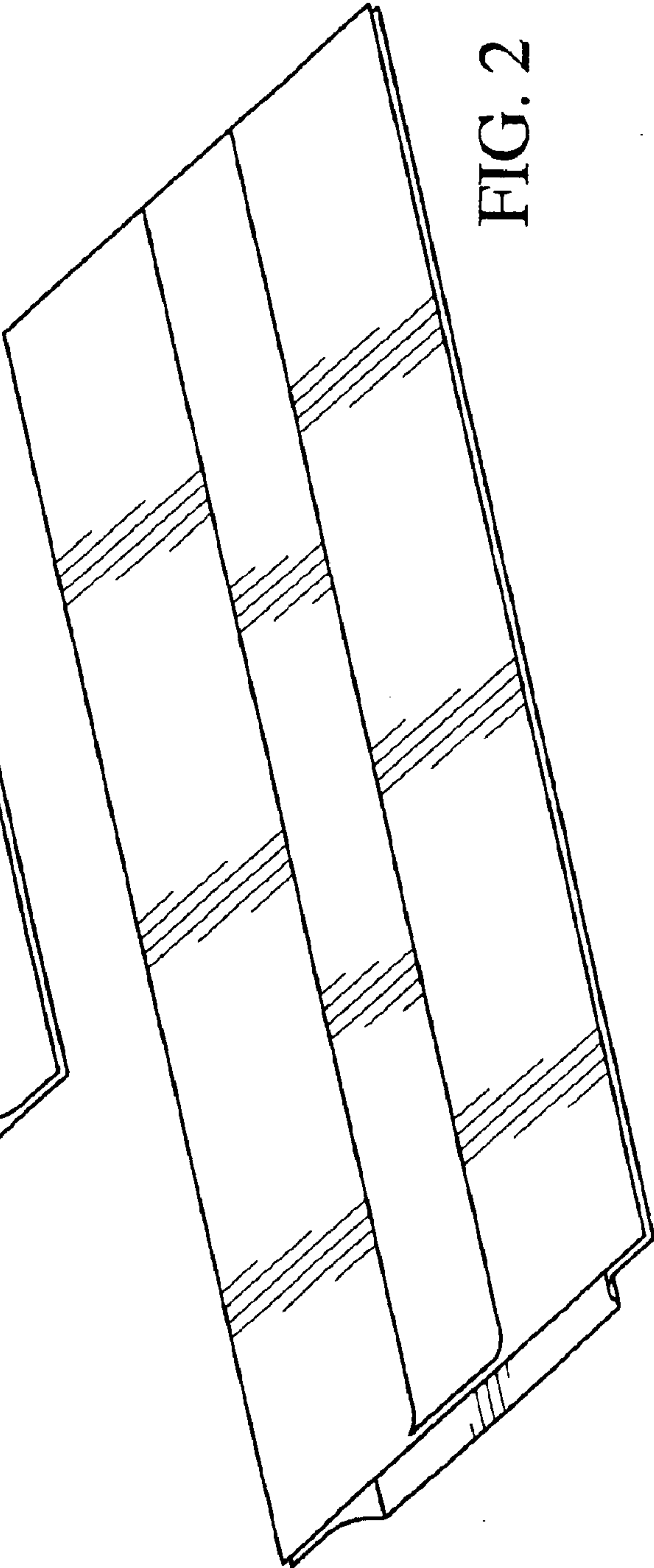

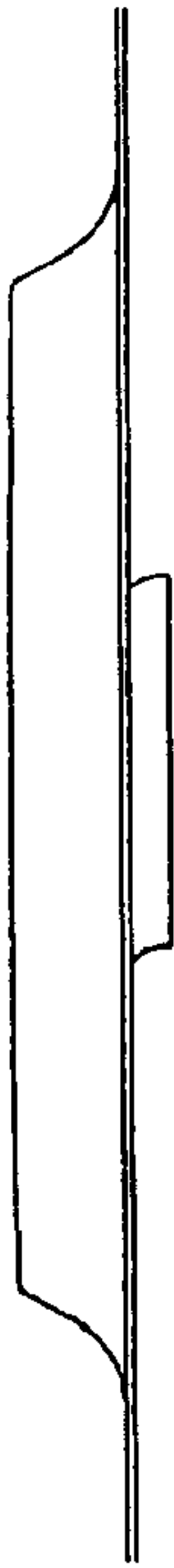

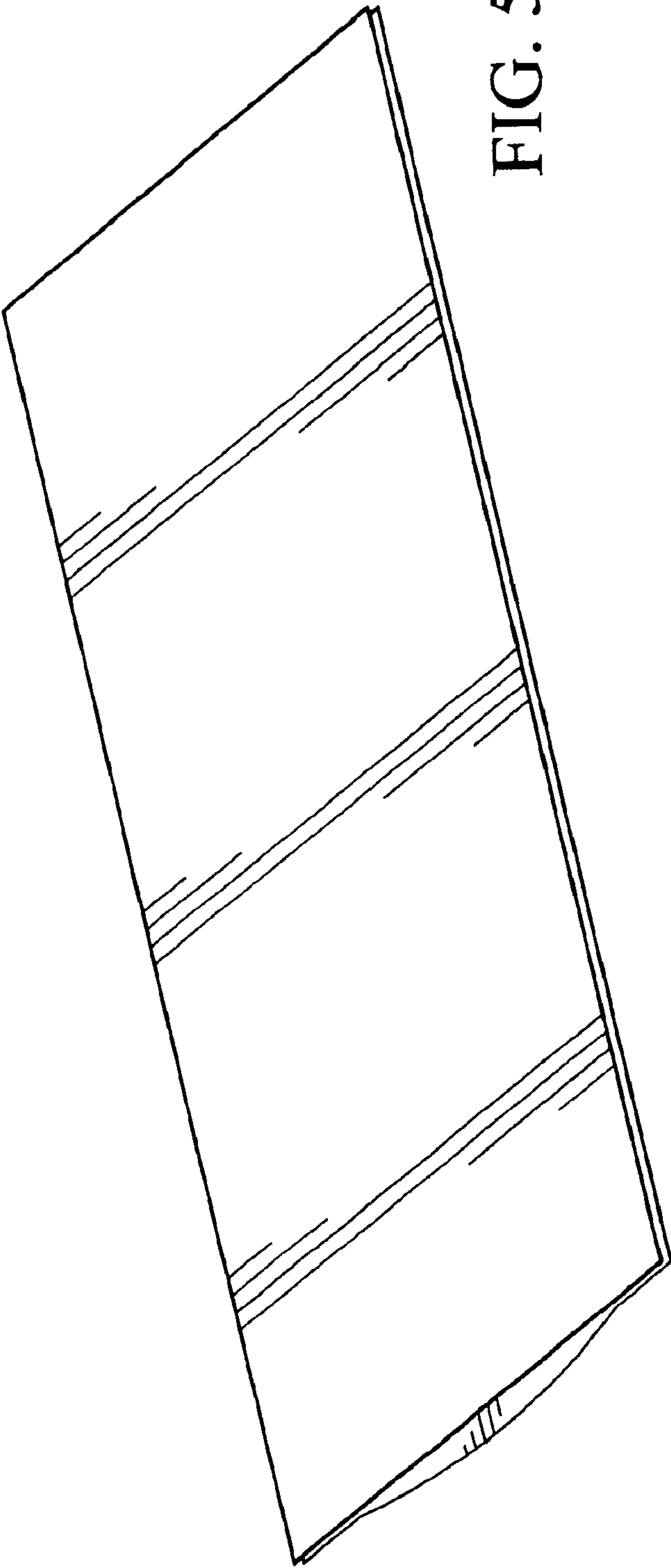
