The ornamental design for a faucet body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is perspective view of a faucet body incorporating my new design, viewed from in front of, above, and from the left side of the faucet body and shown in combination with the remainder of a faucet with which it is usable;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

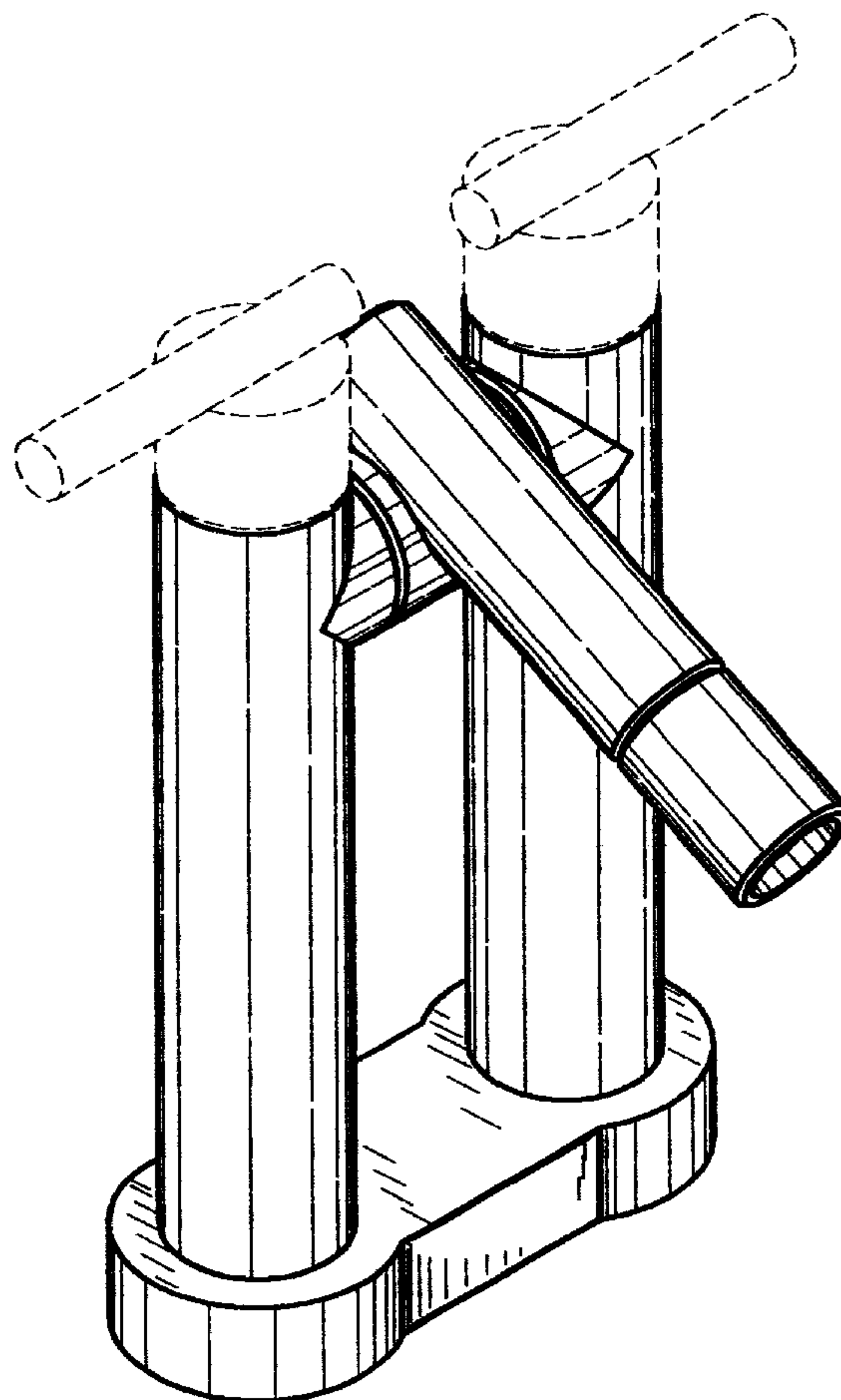
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

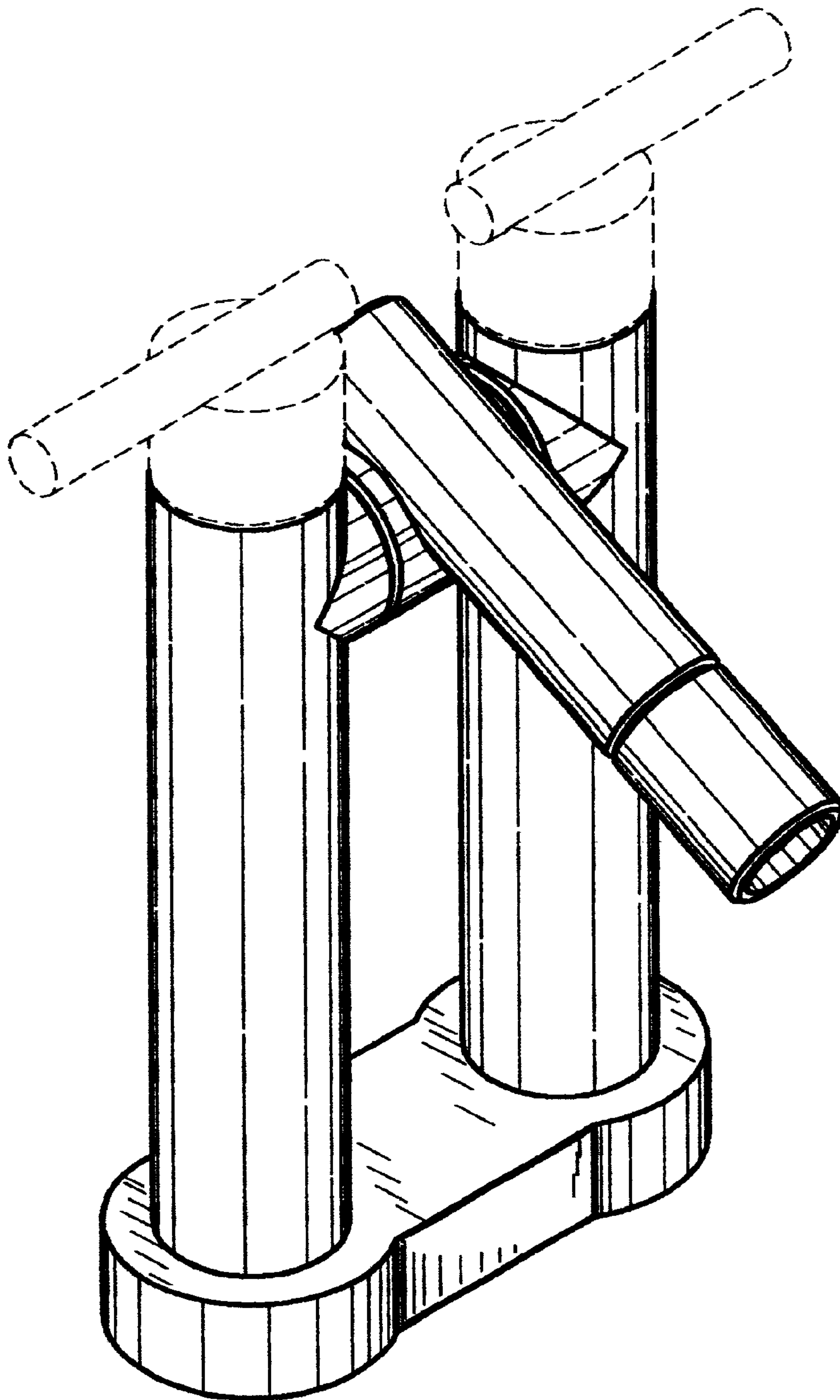

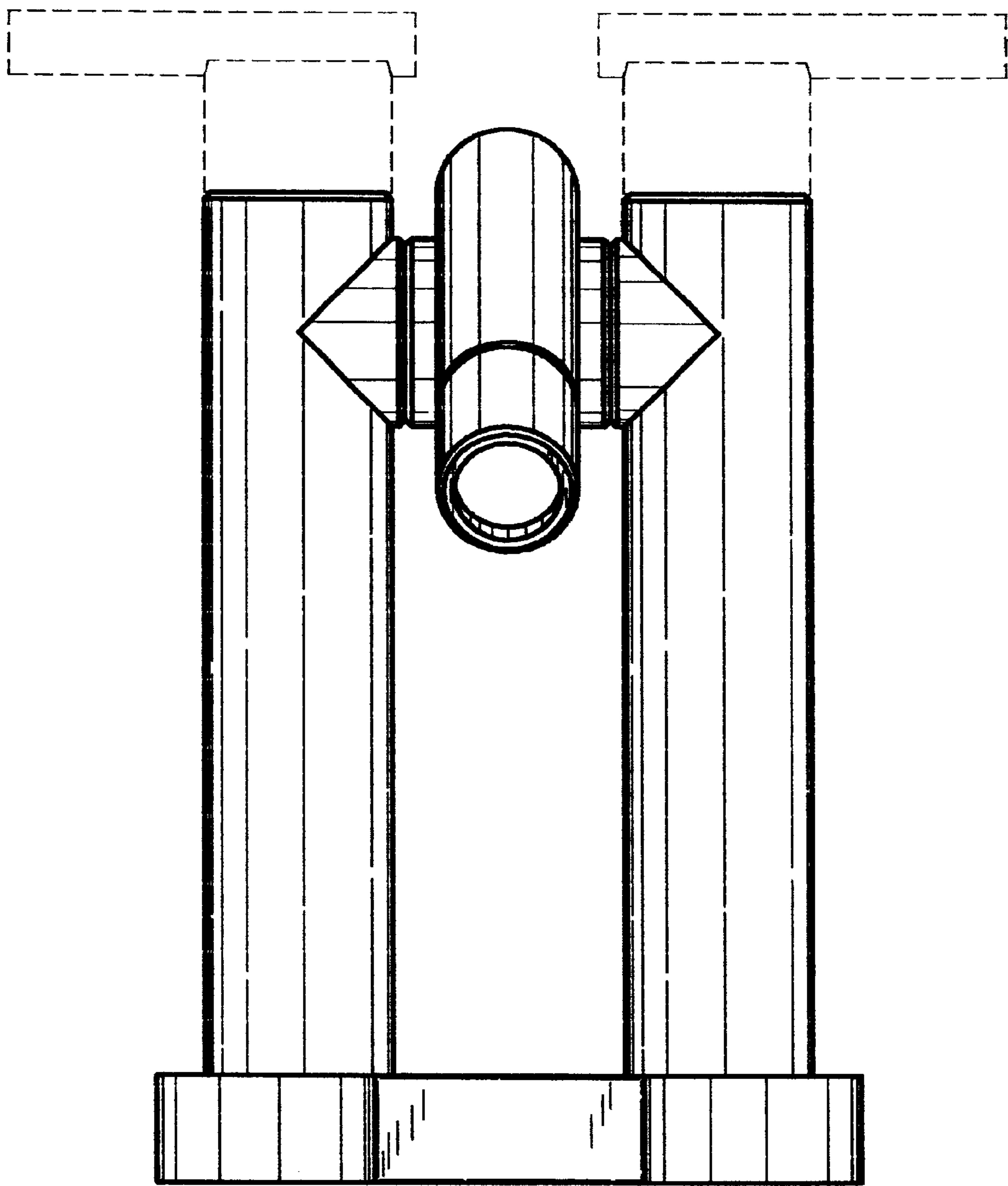

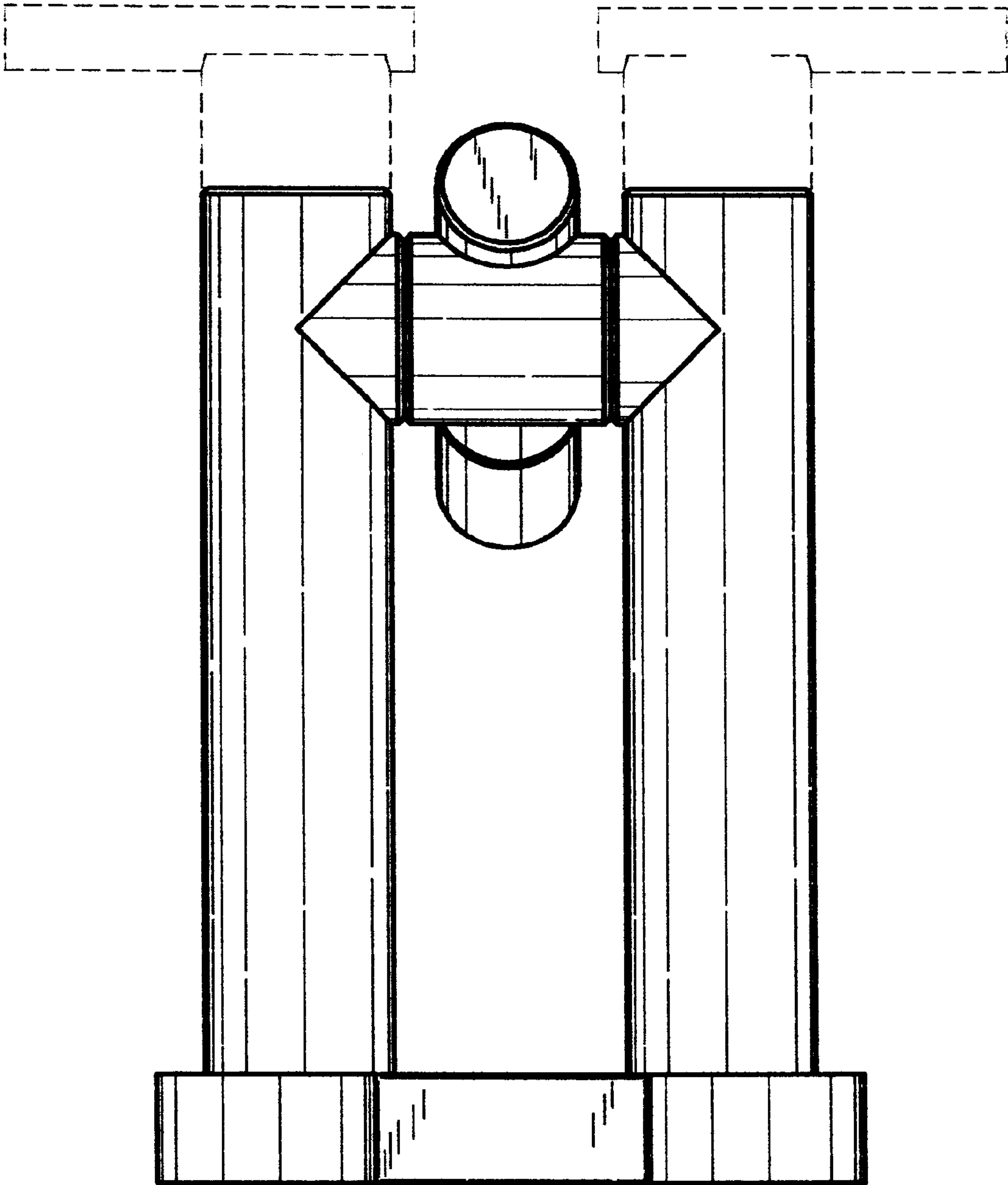

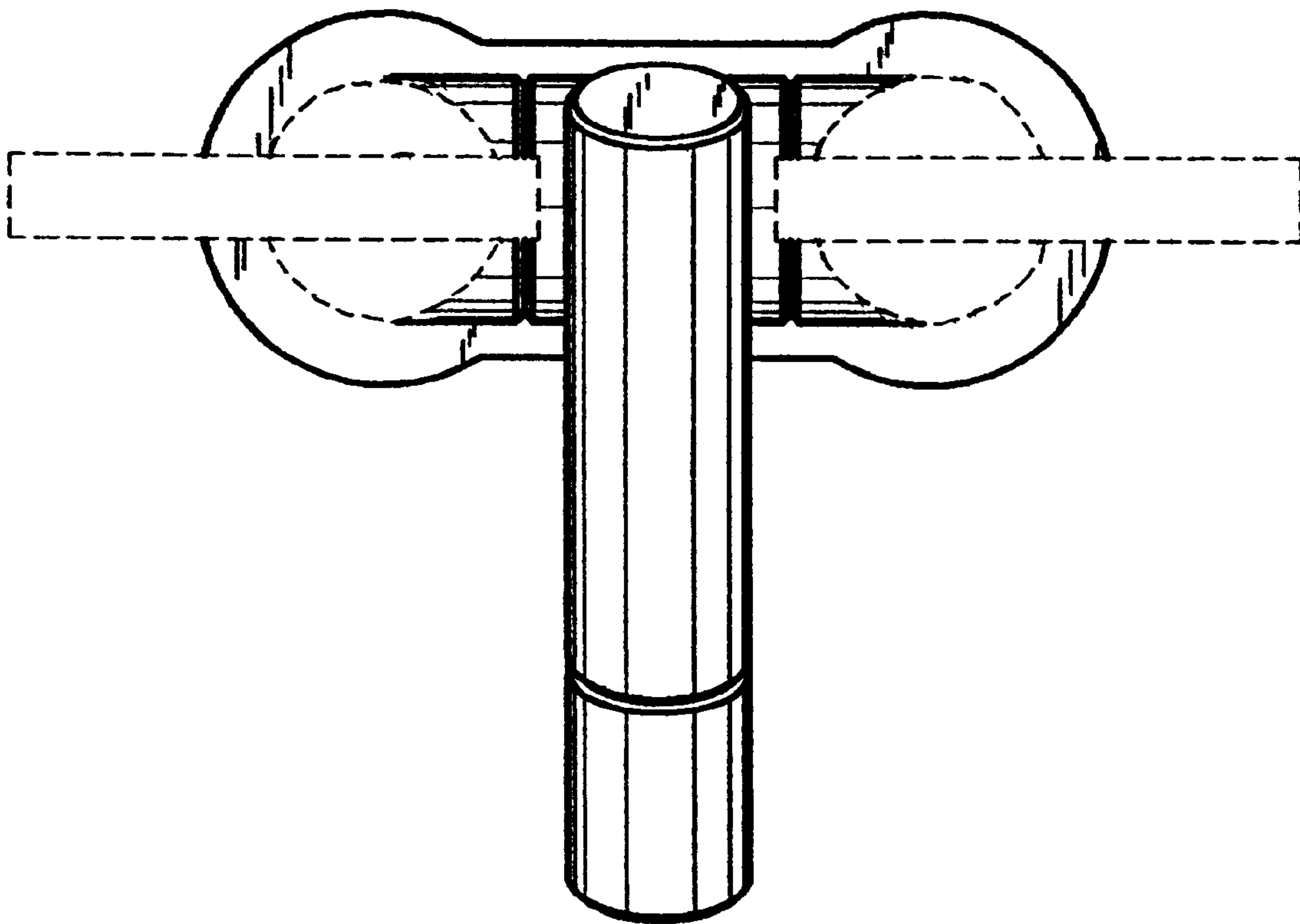

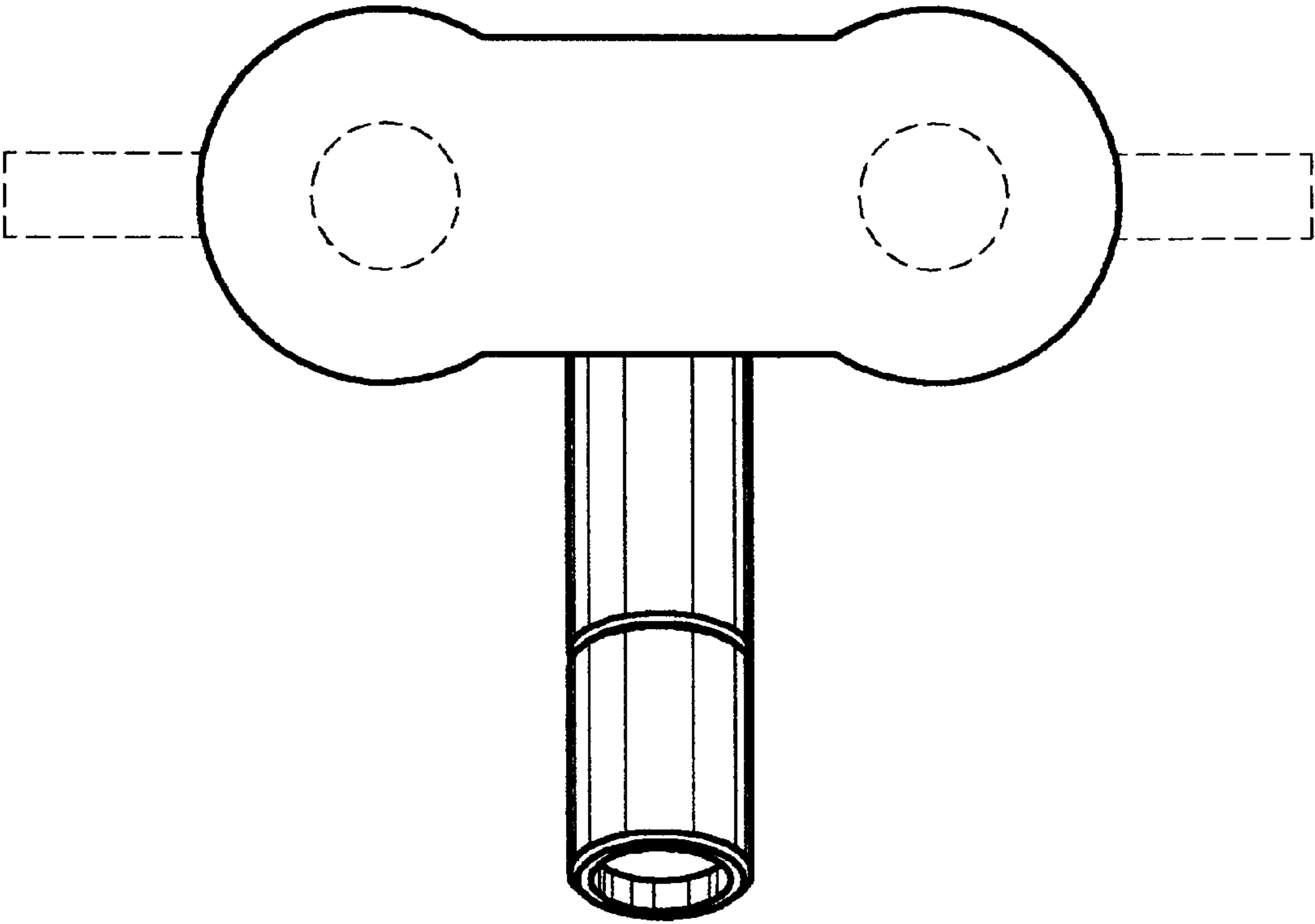

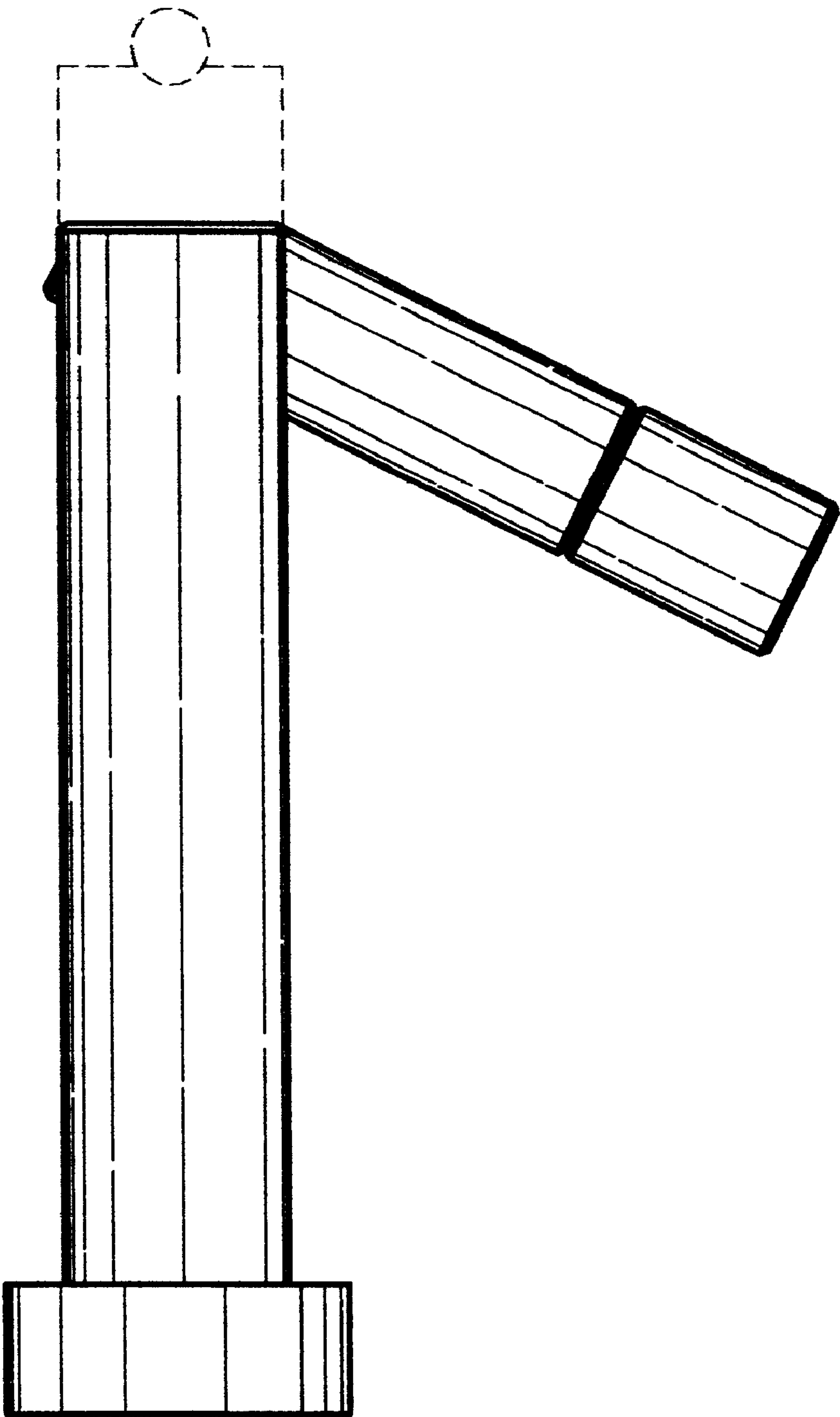
