FIG. 3 is a front view of the flash pan;

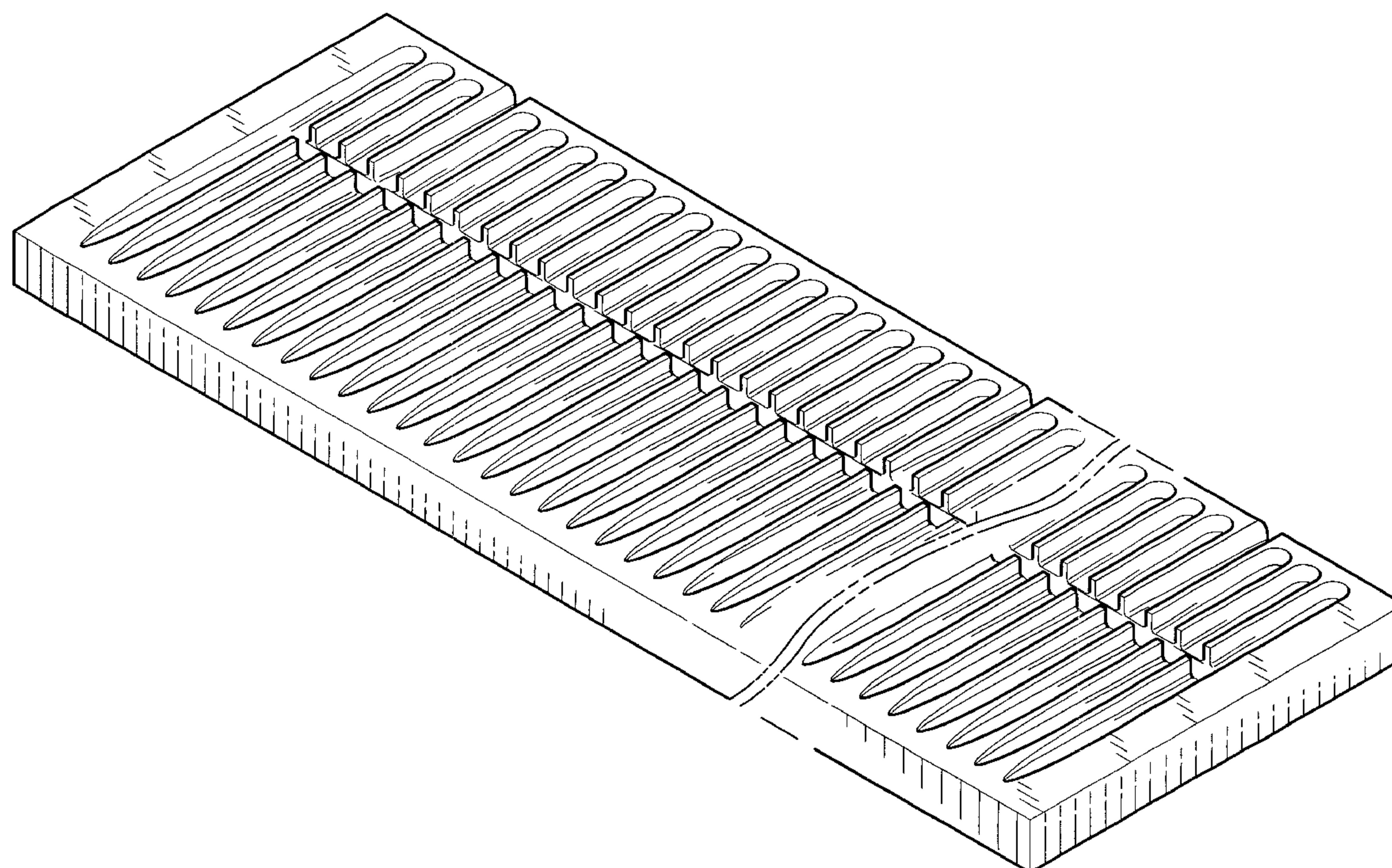
FIG. 4 is a top view of the flash pan;

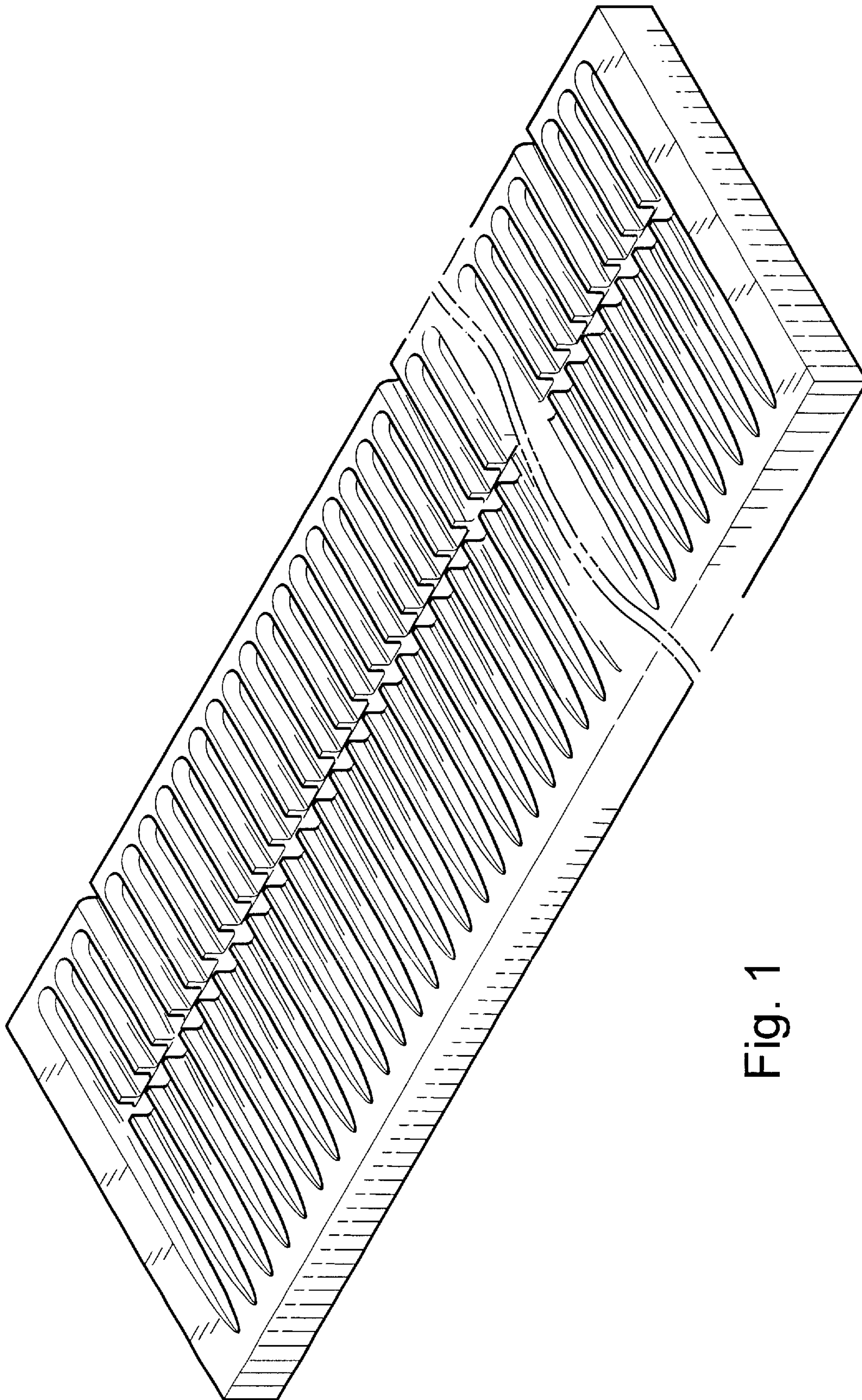

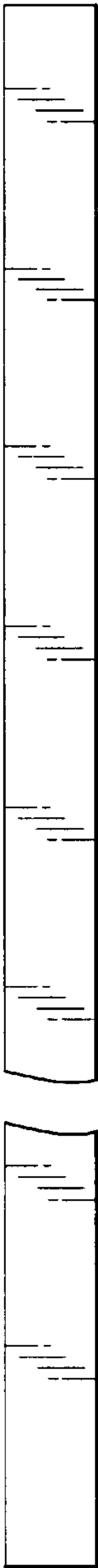

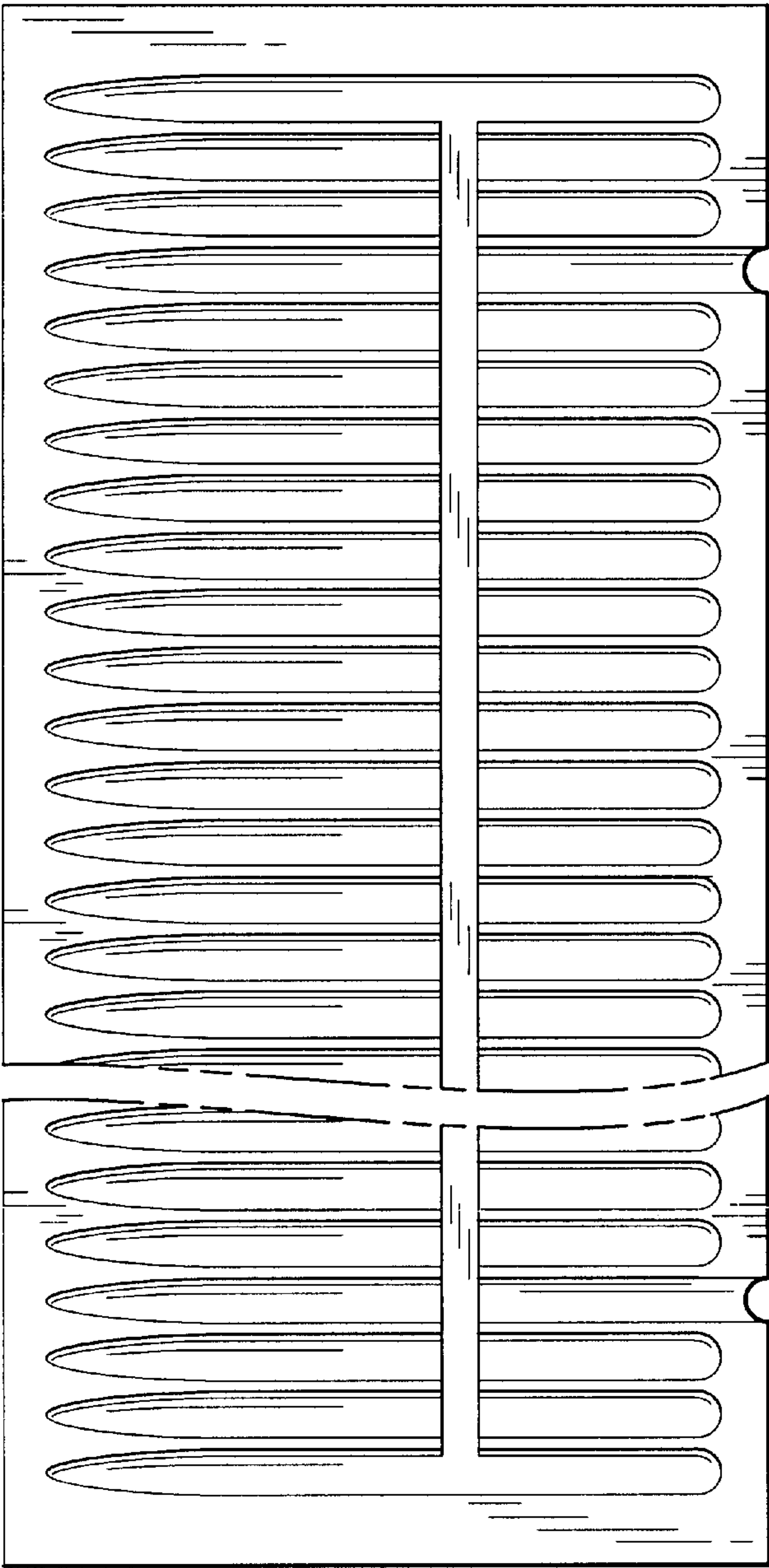

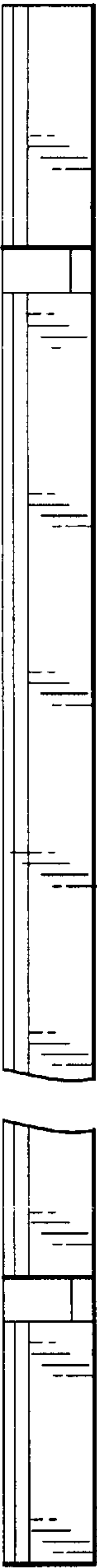

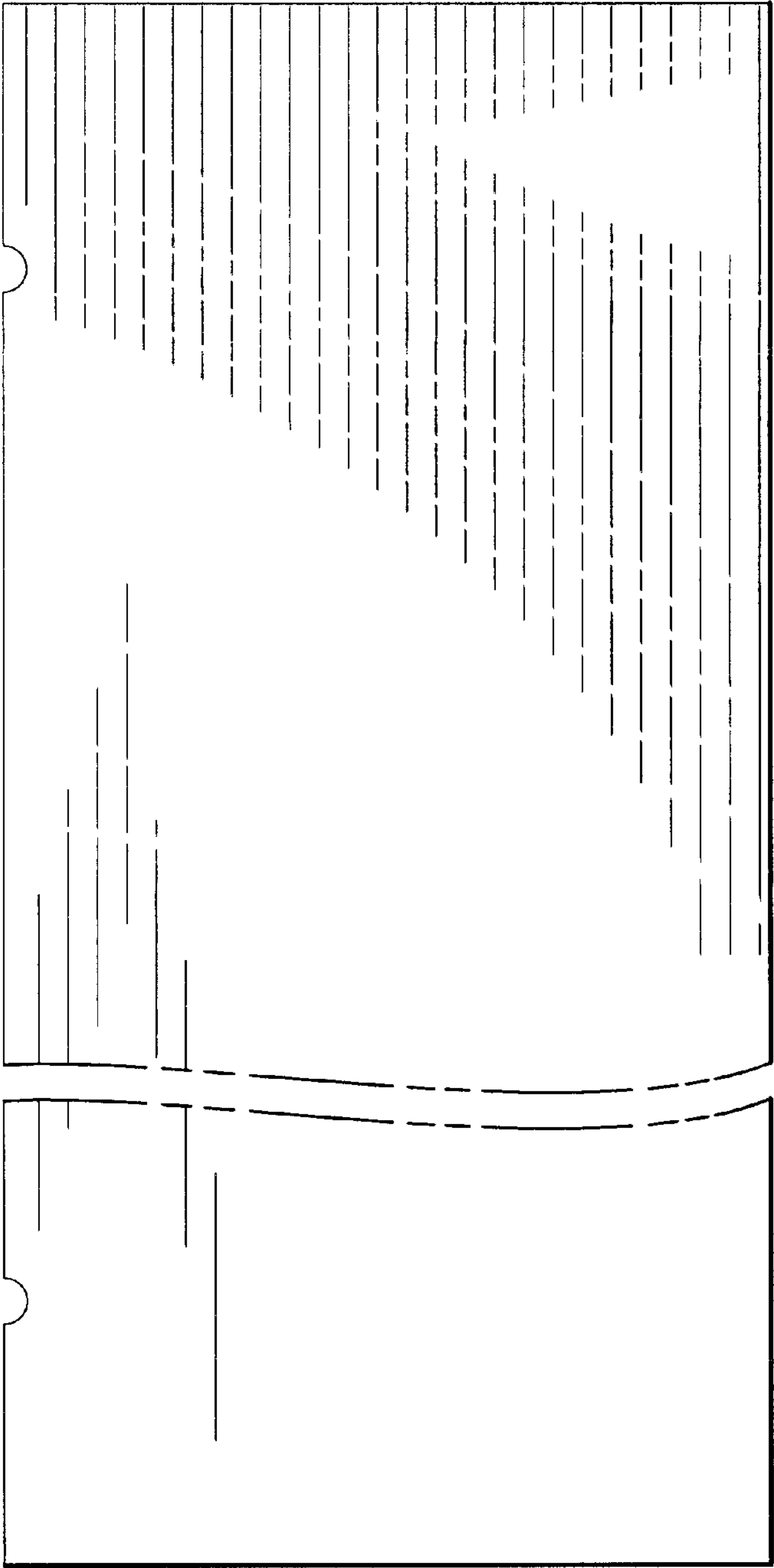
