bail, the rear and side views being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

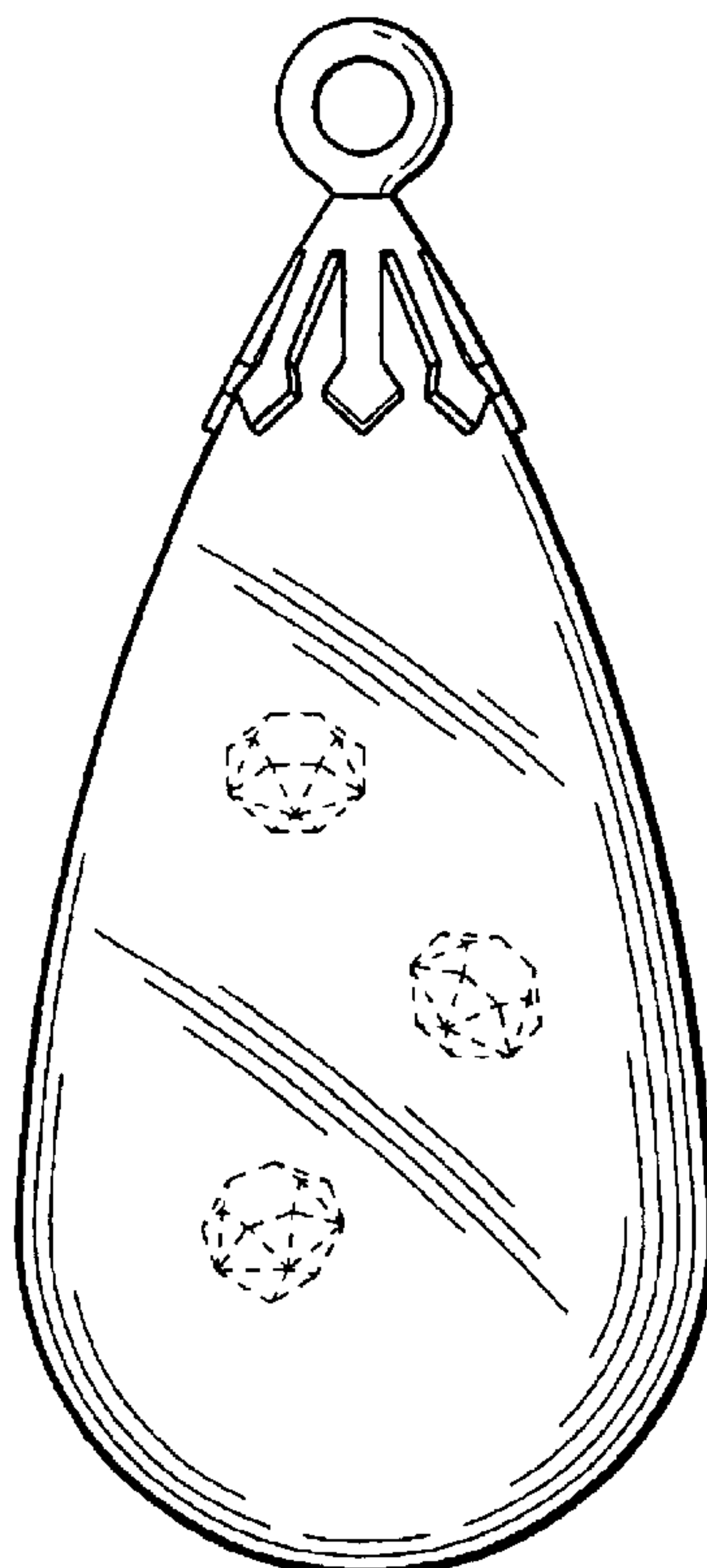
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of a floating gem jewelry

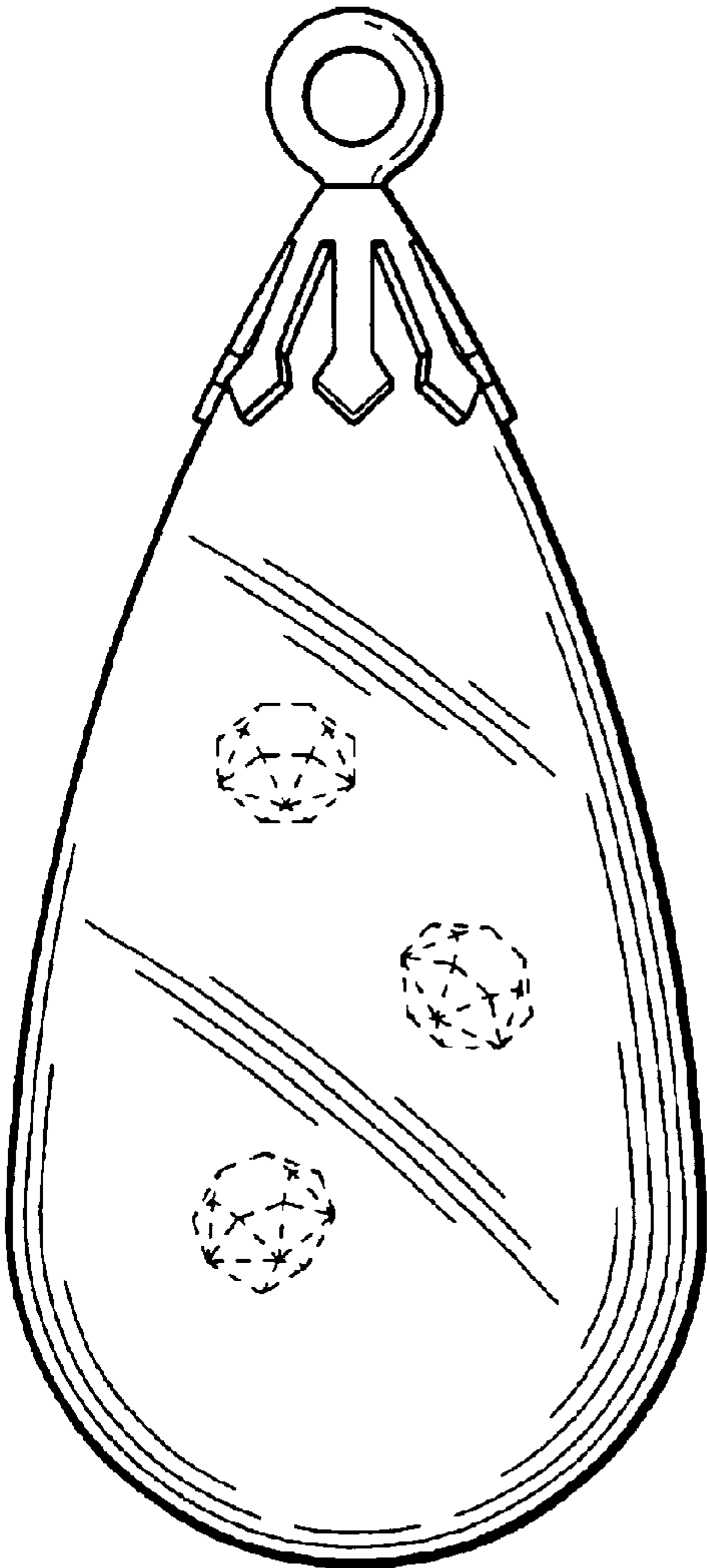

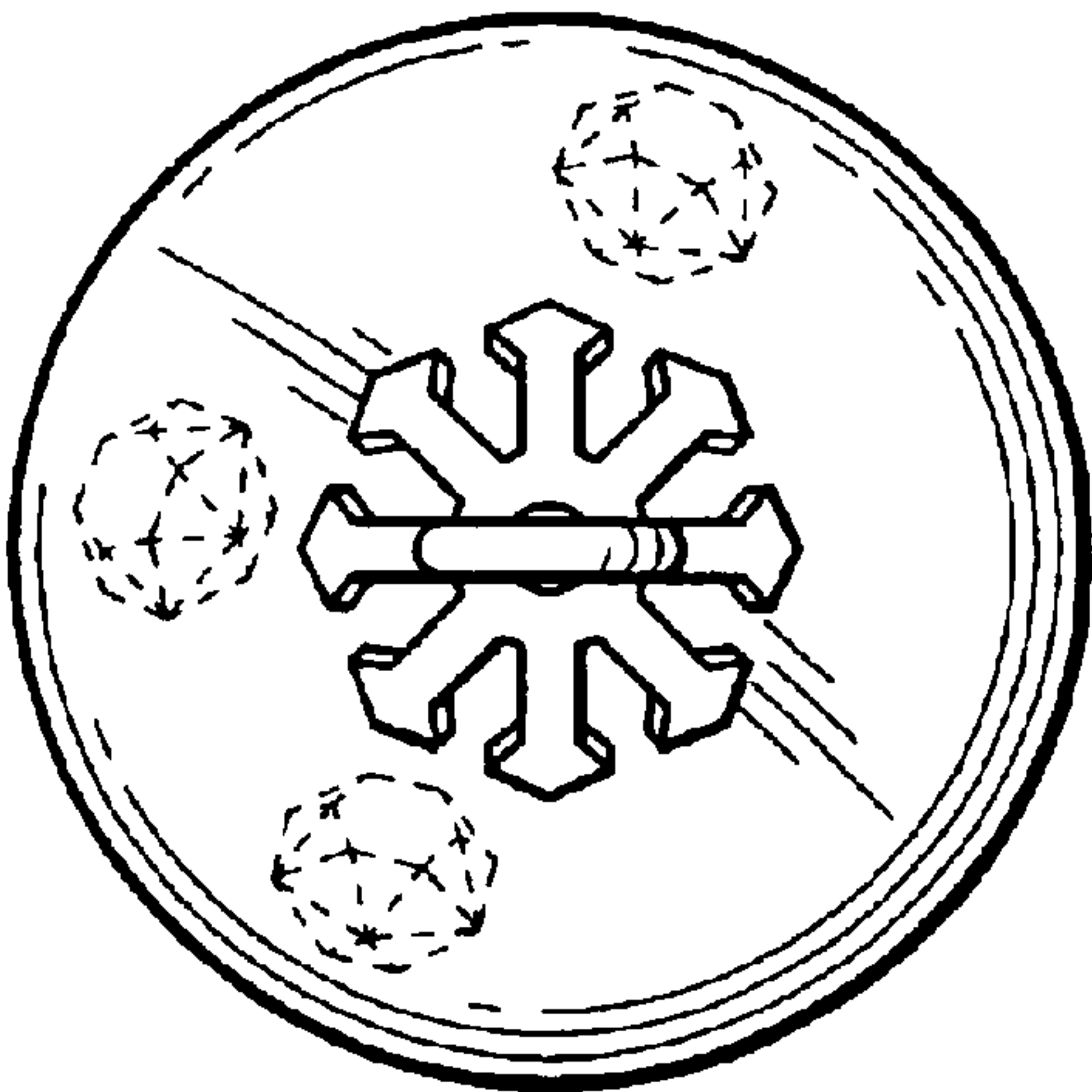

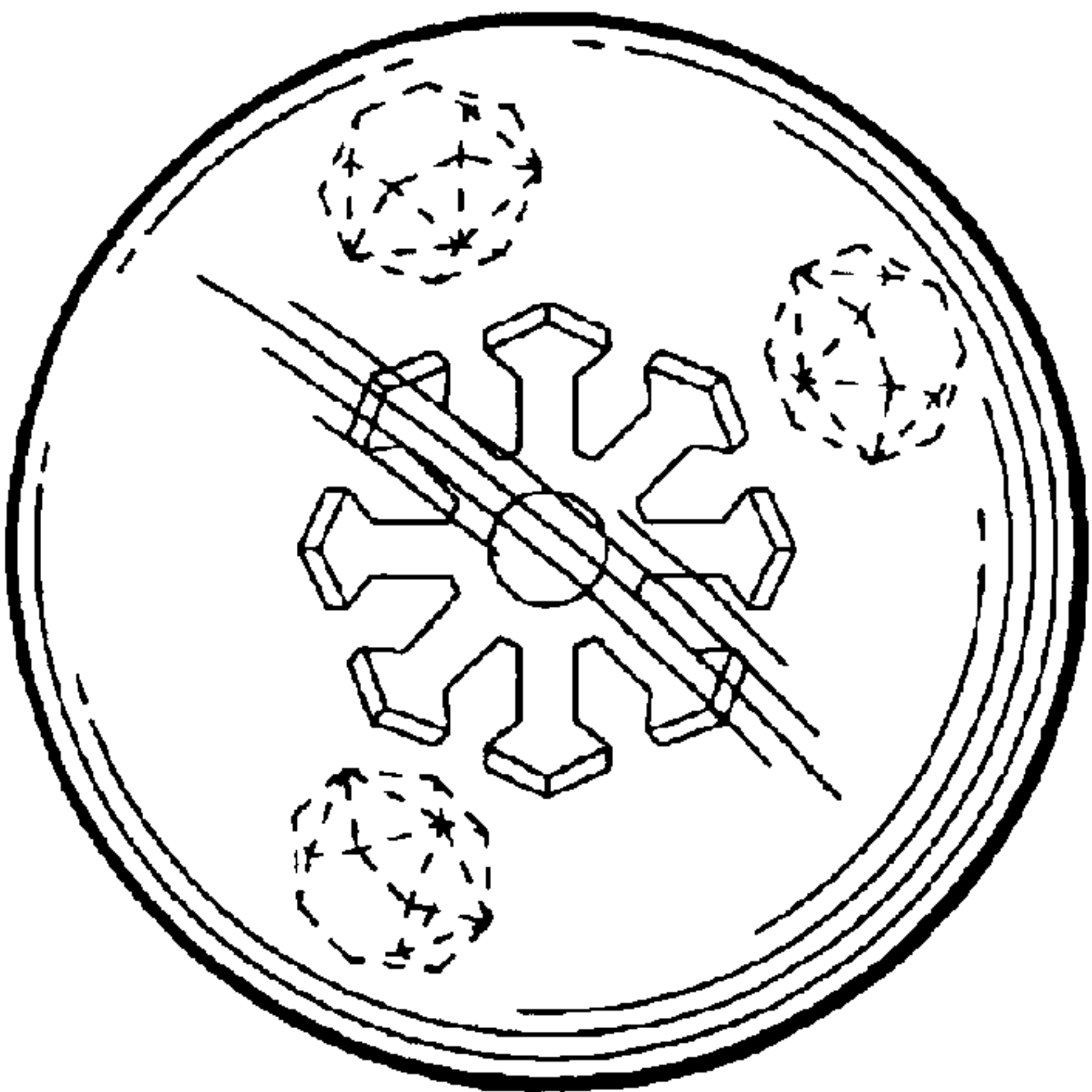

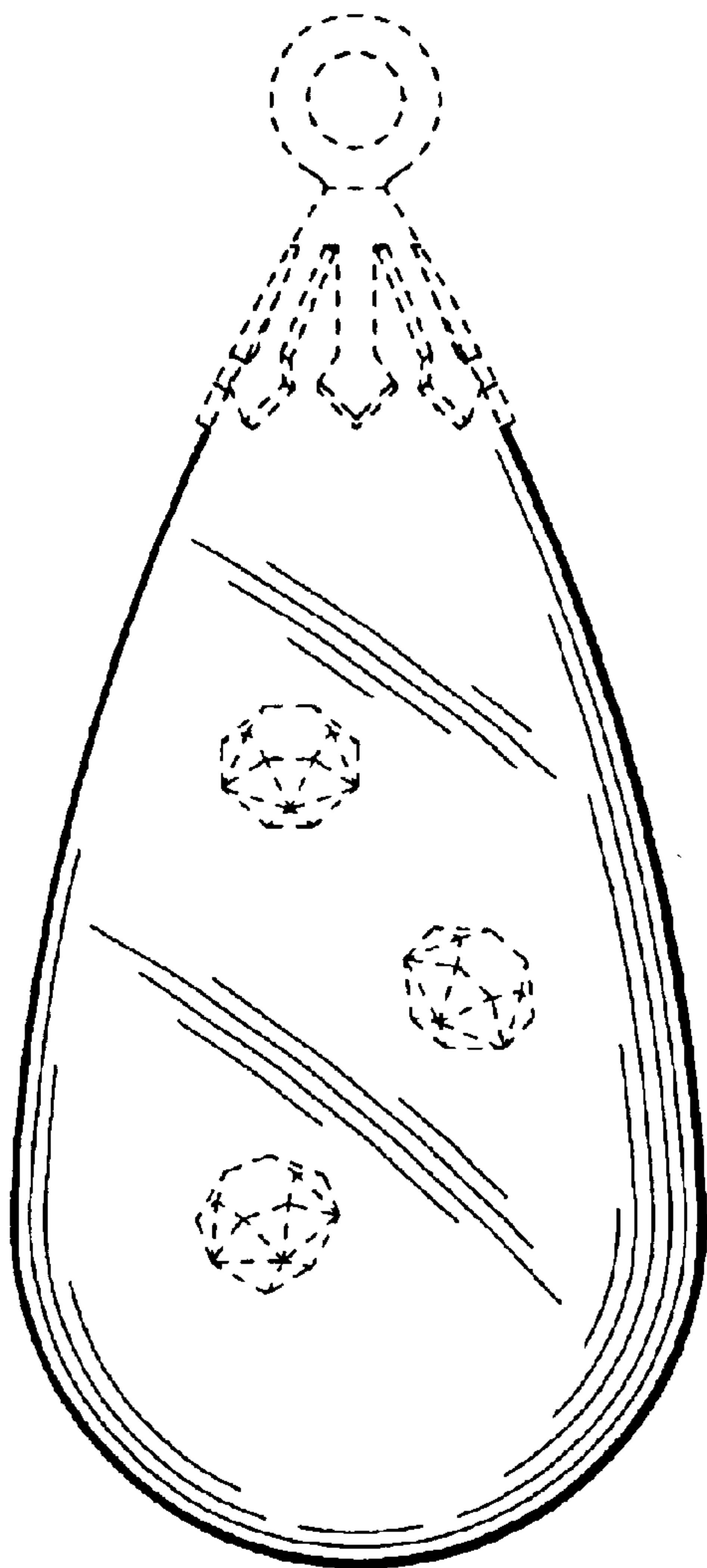

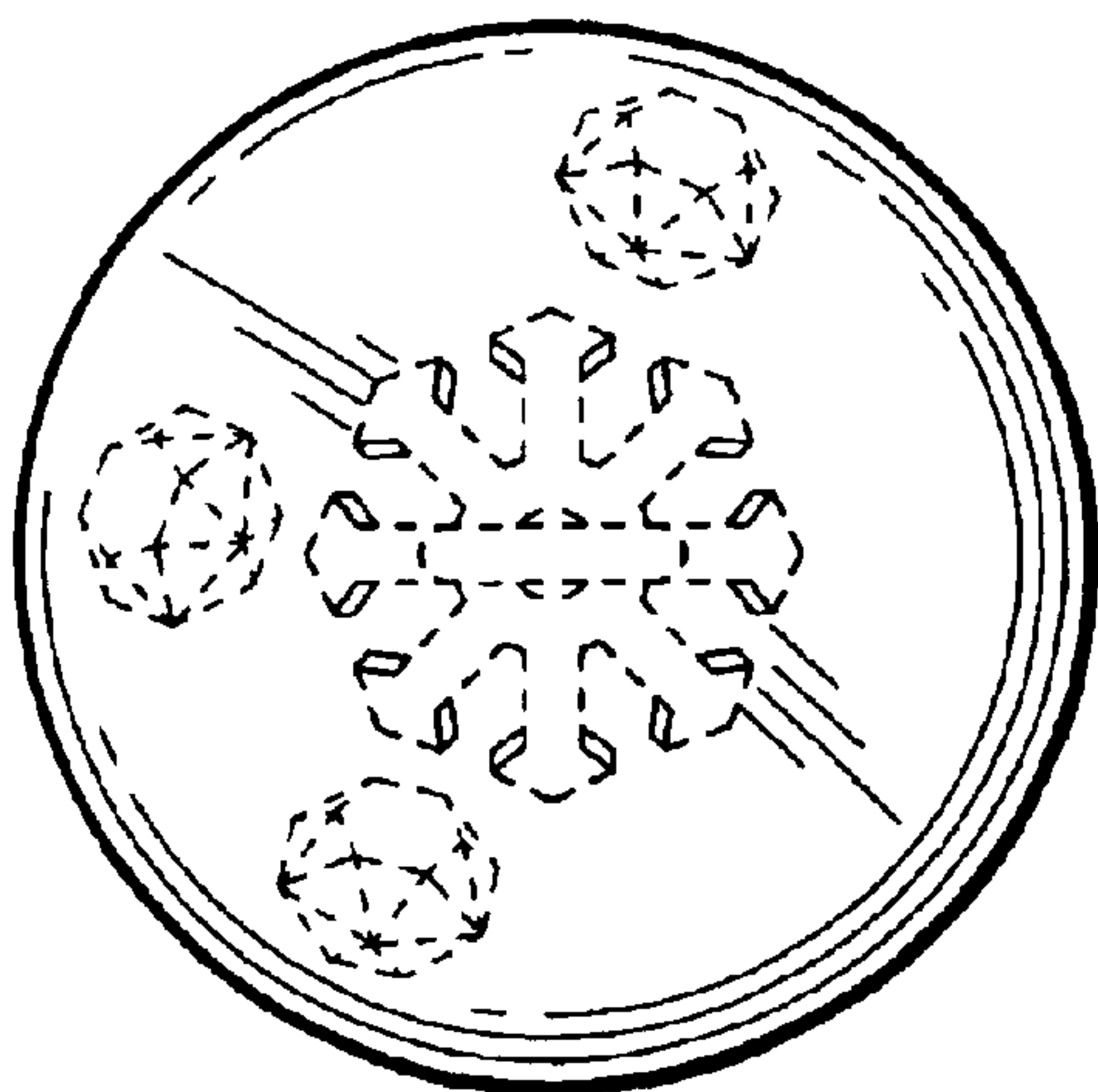

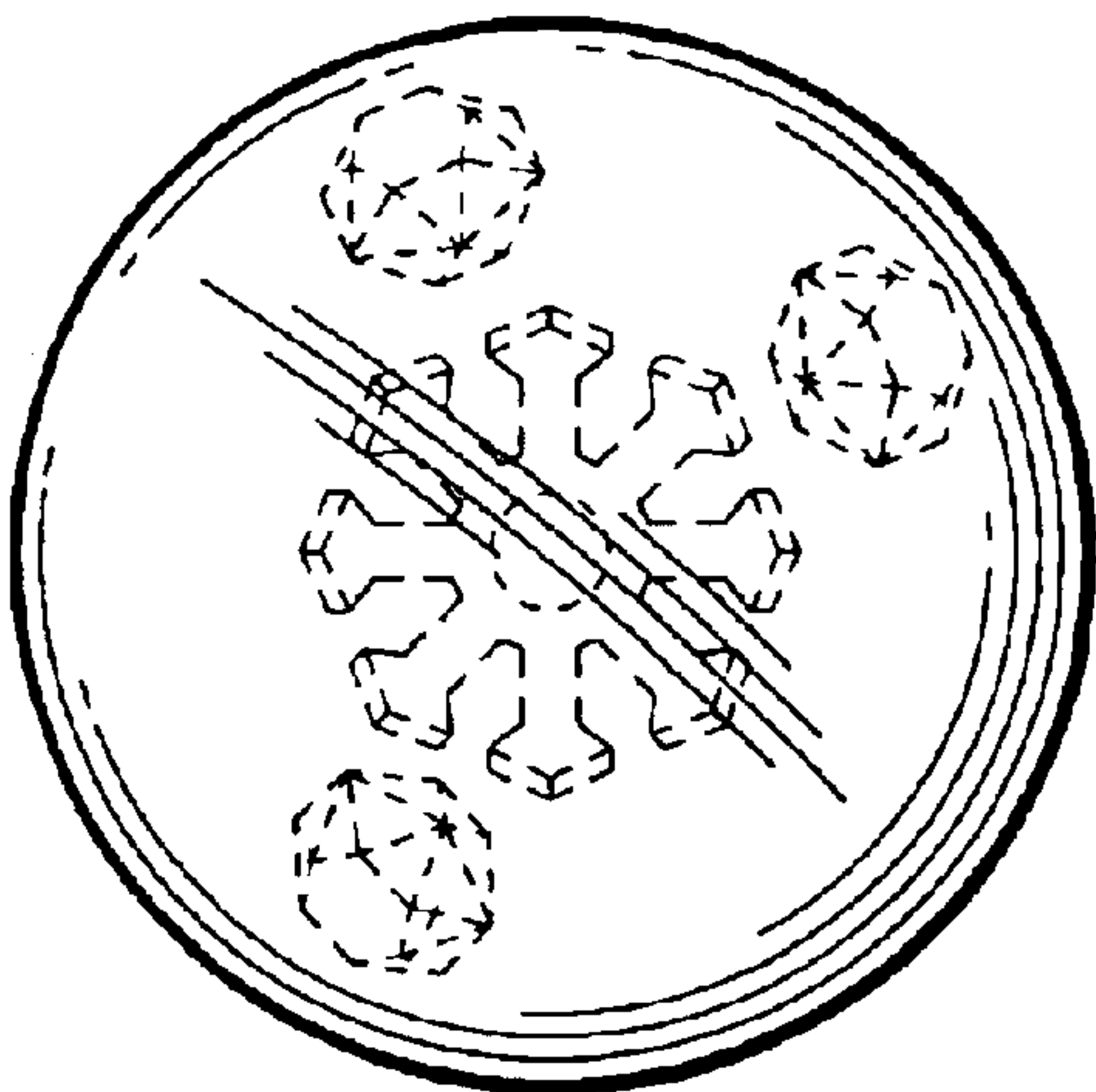
