DESCRIPTION

FIG. 3 is a left side view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

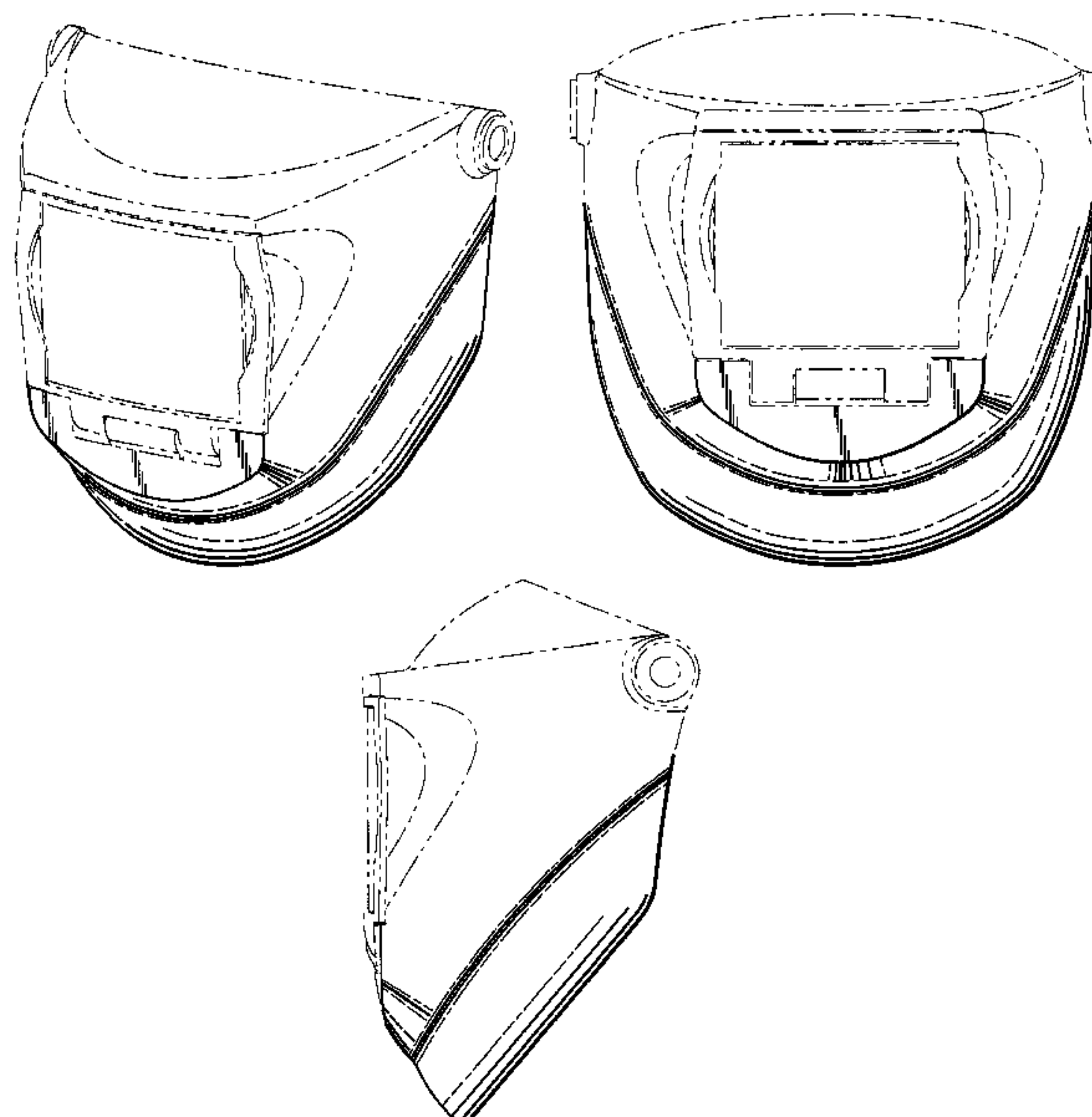
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof;

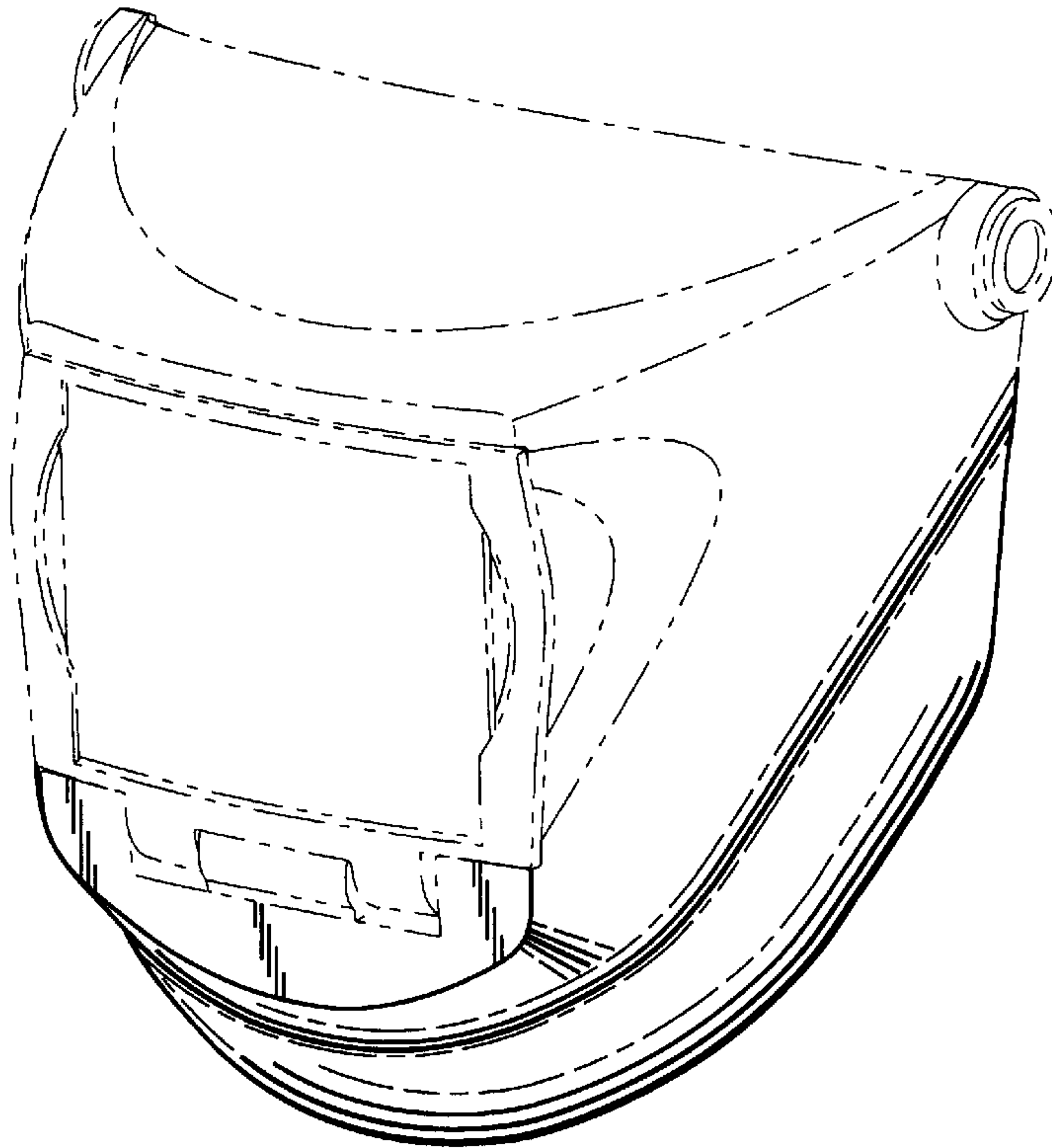

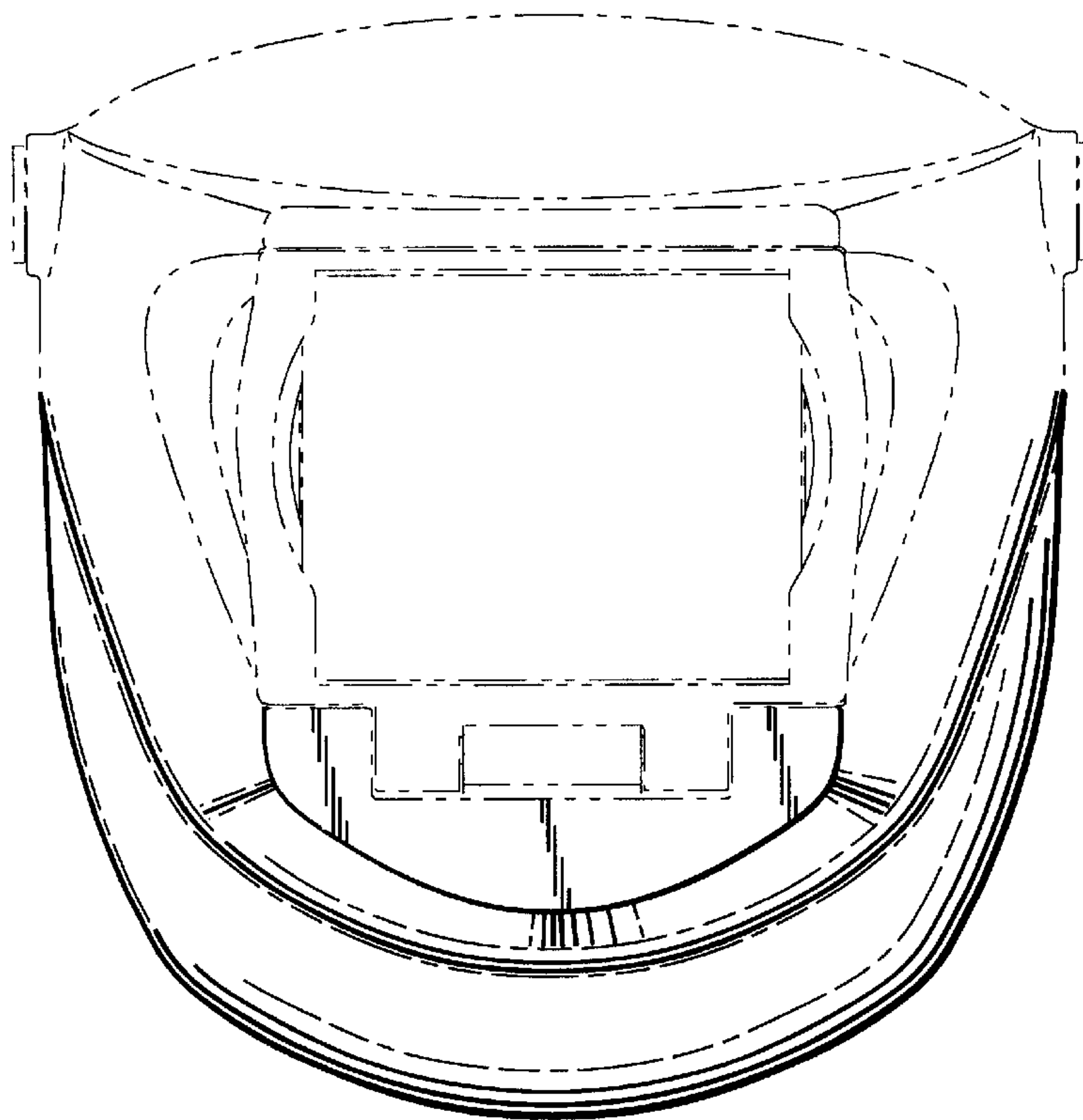

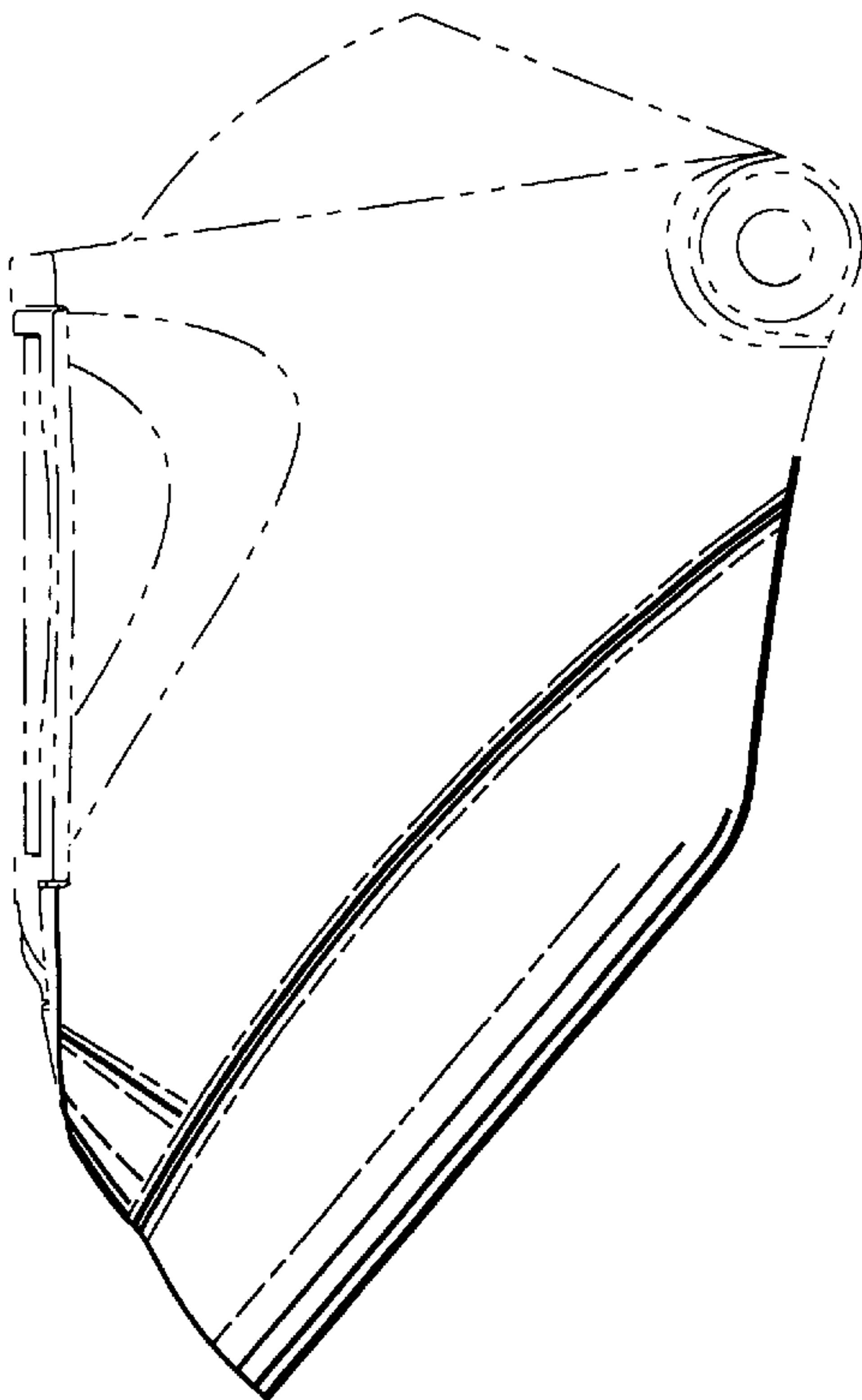

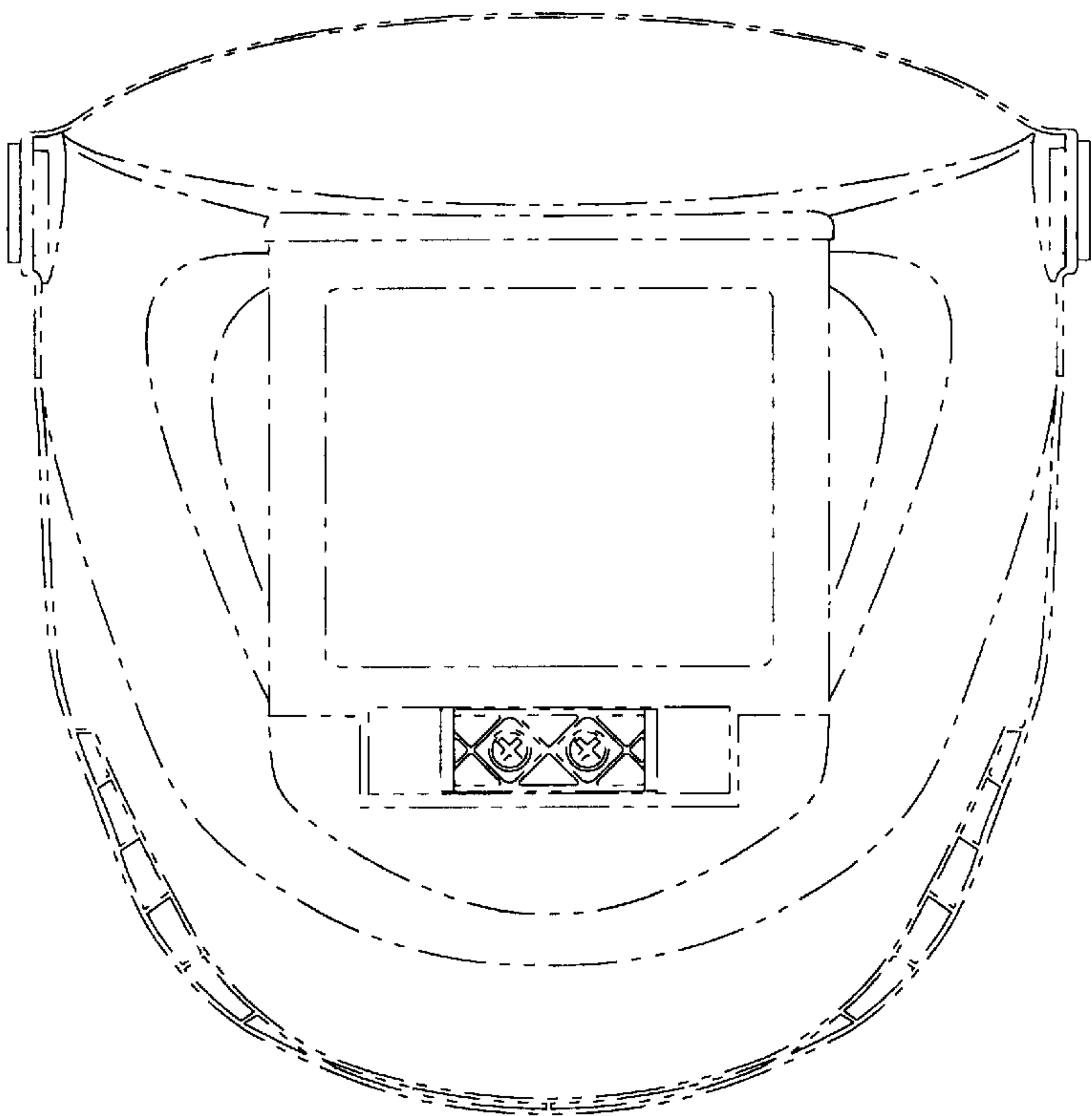

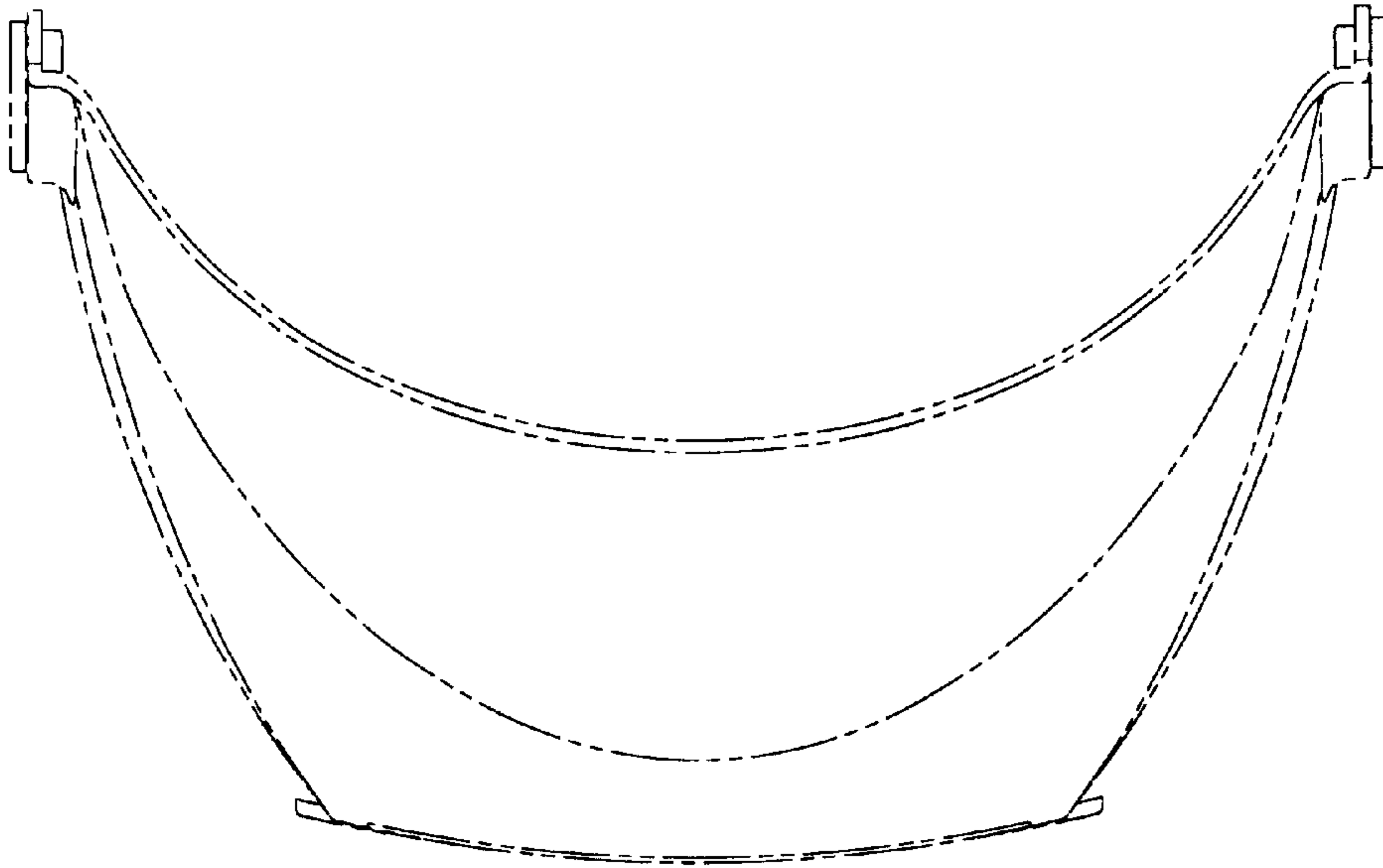

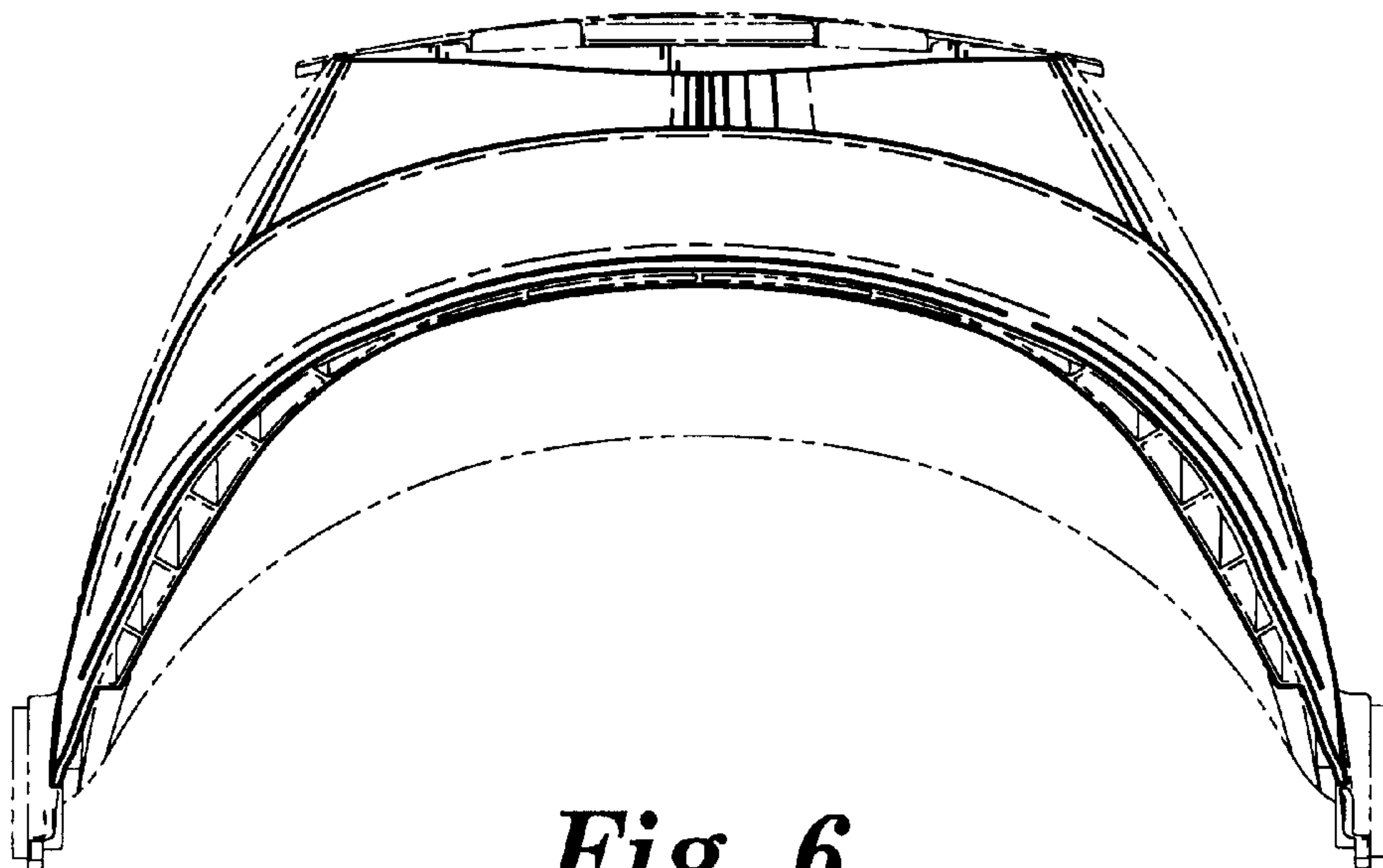
