(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for the carrier for holding personal items, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 illustrates a plan, front elevation and right elevation perspective view of a first embodiment of a carrier for holding personal items of my new design in an open position.

FIG. 11 illustrates a plan view thereof.

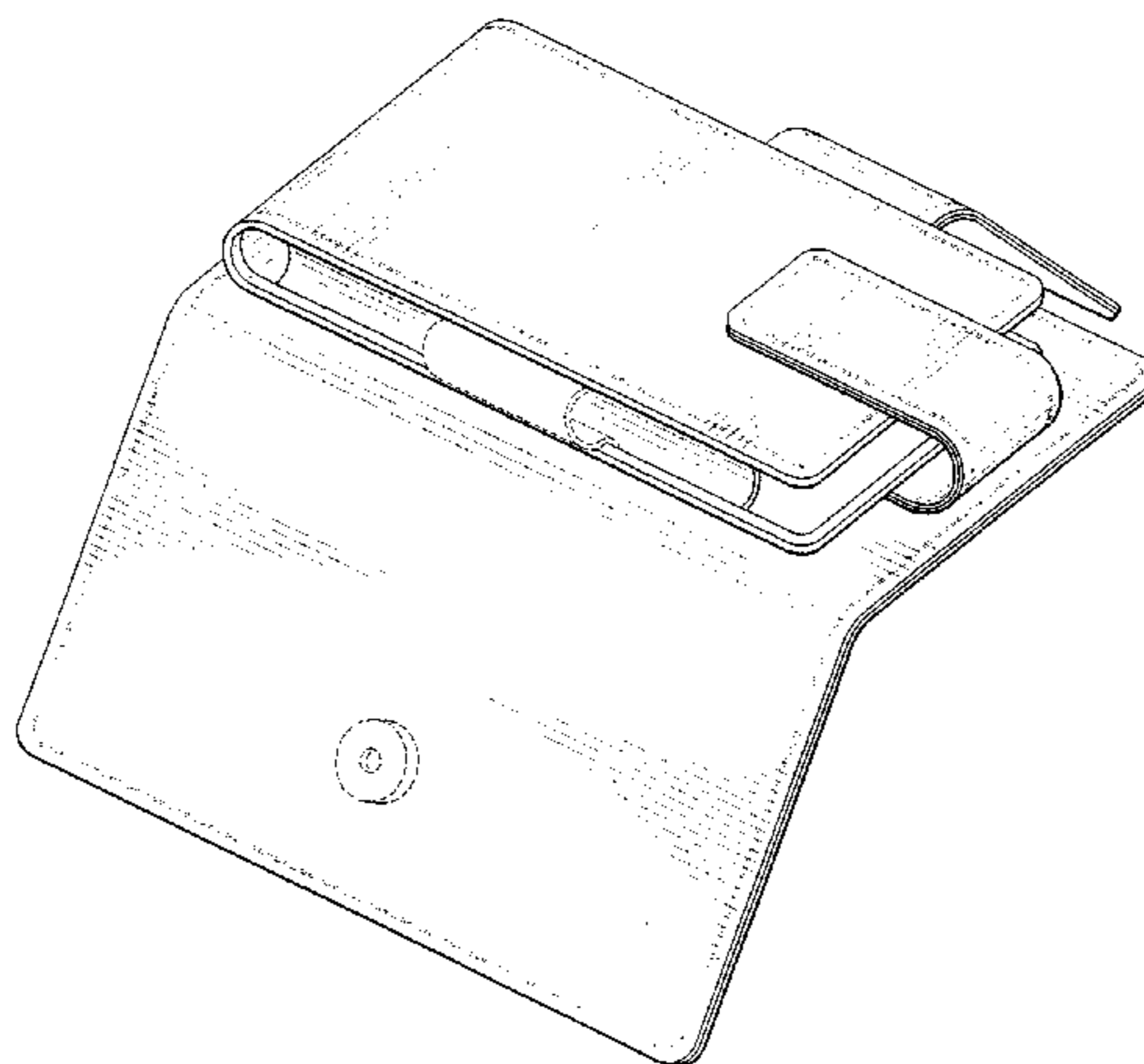
FIG. 12 illustrates a base view thereof.

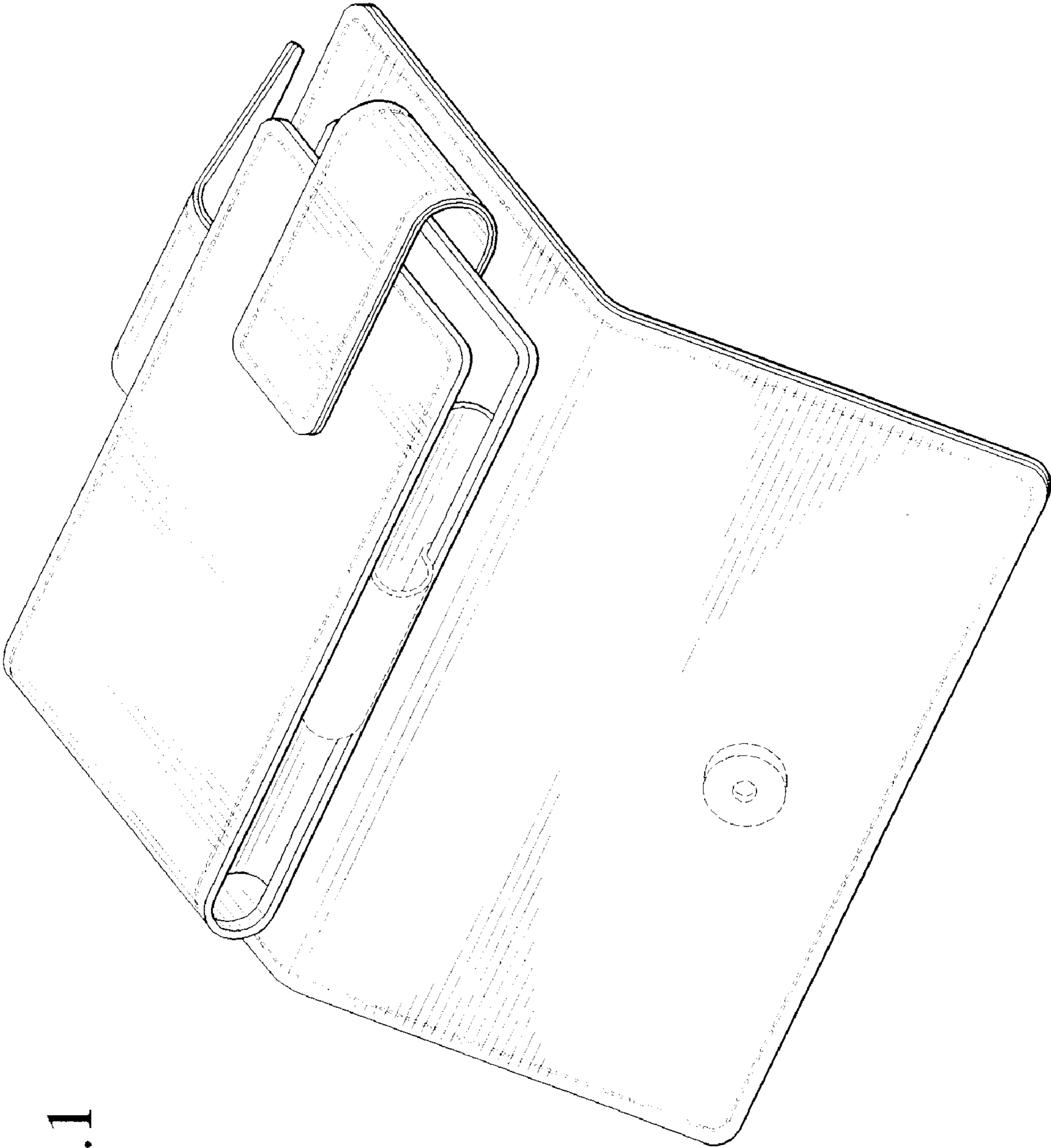

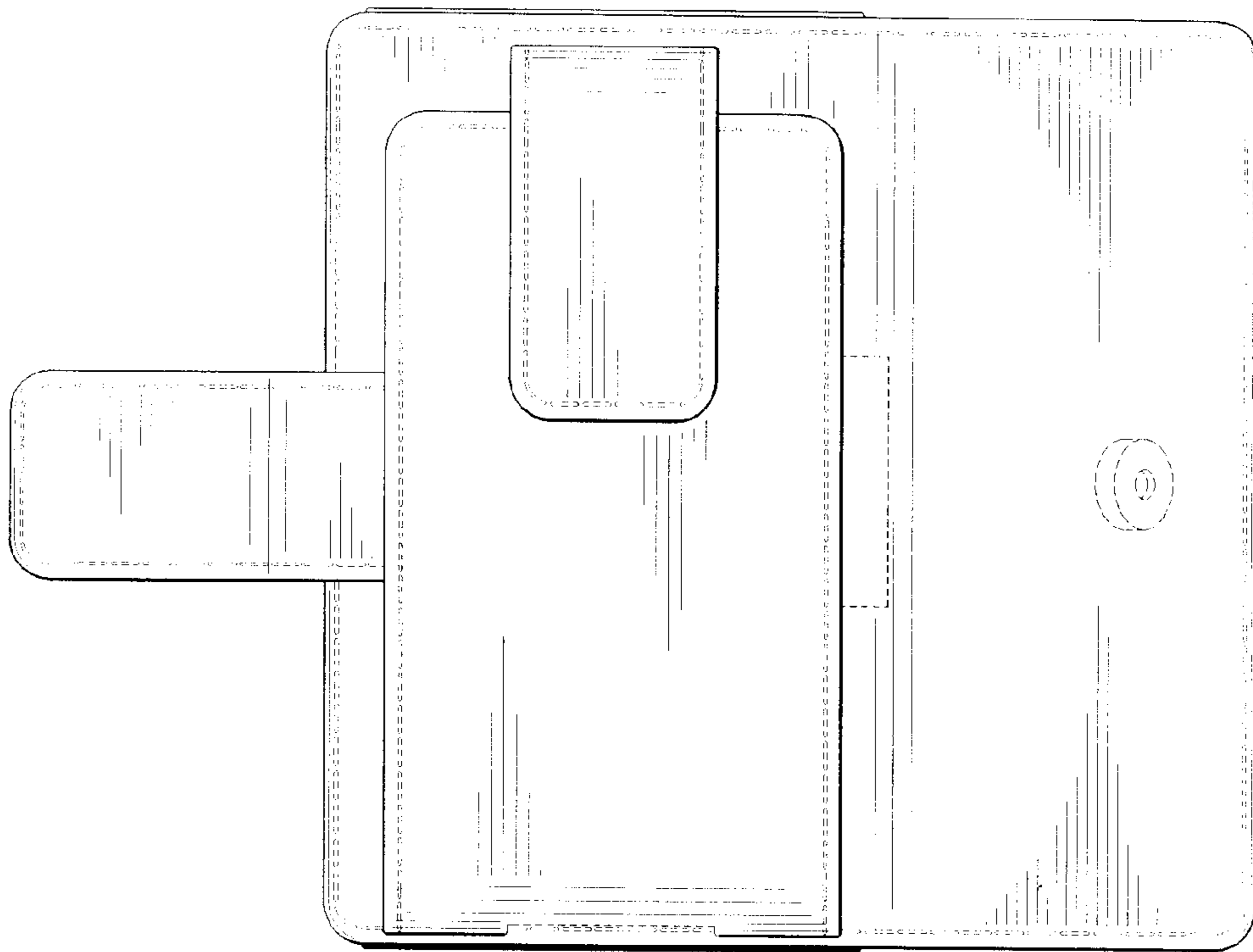

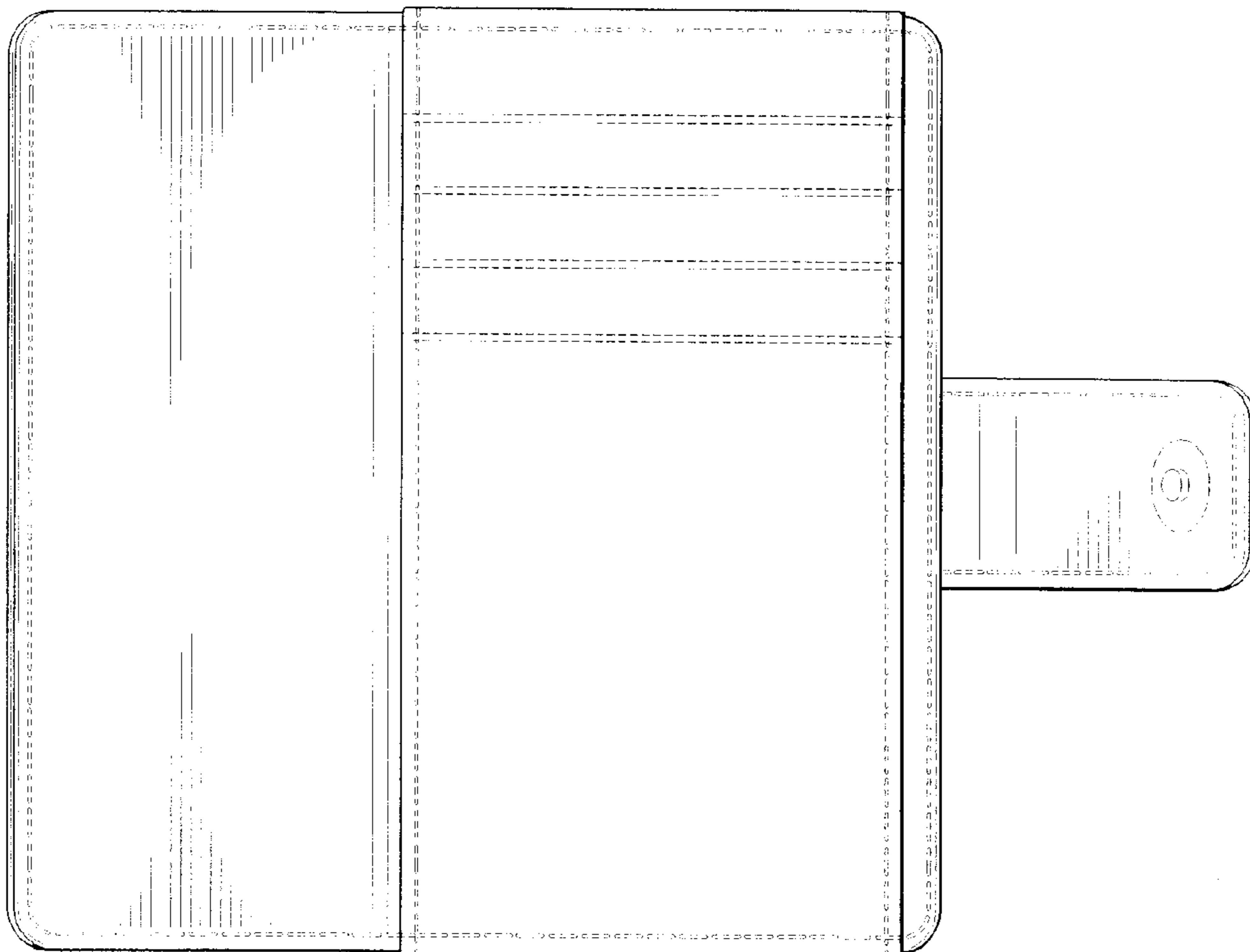

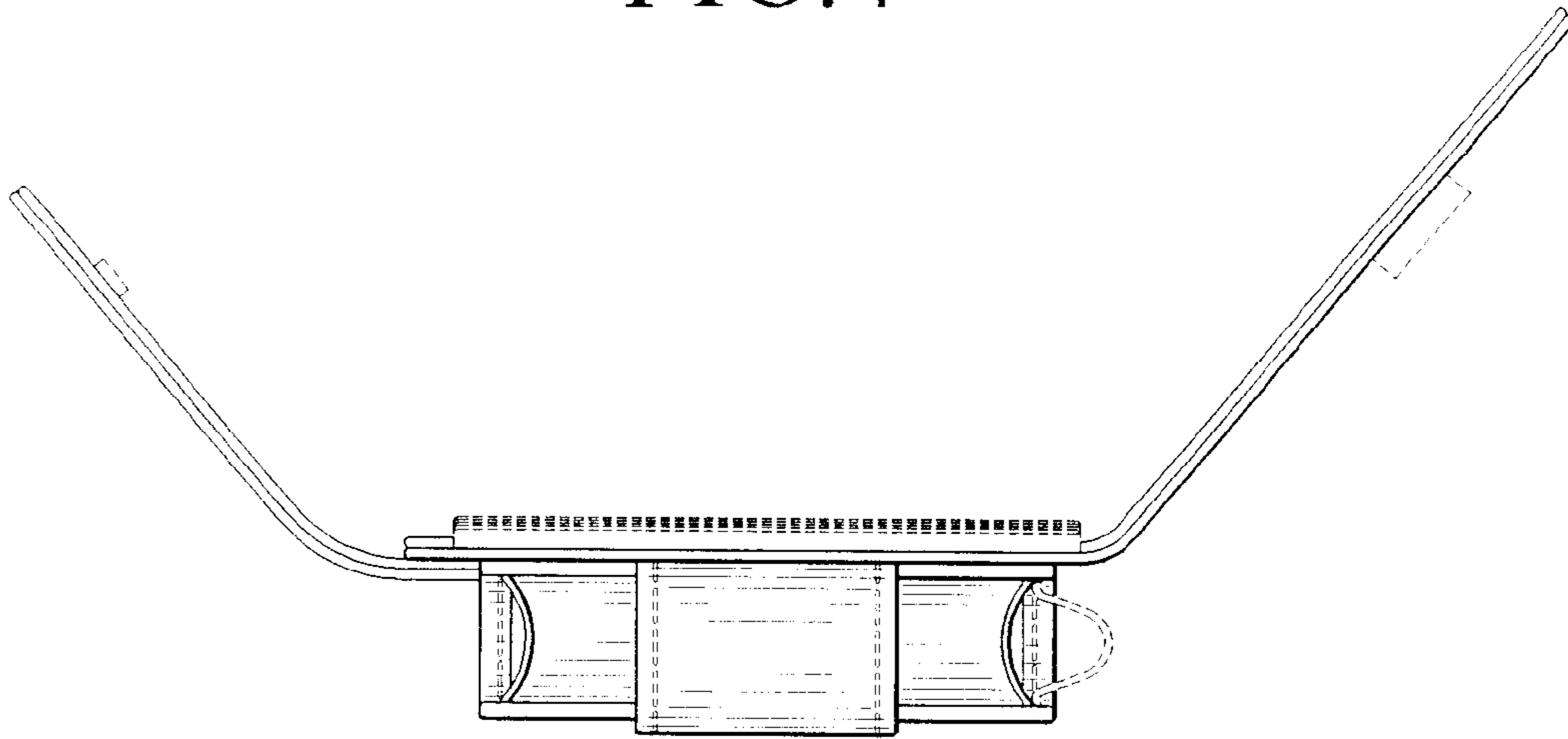

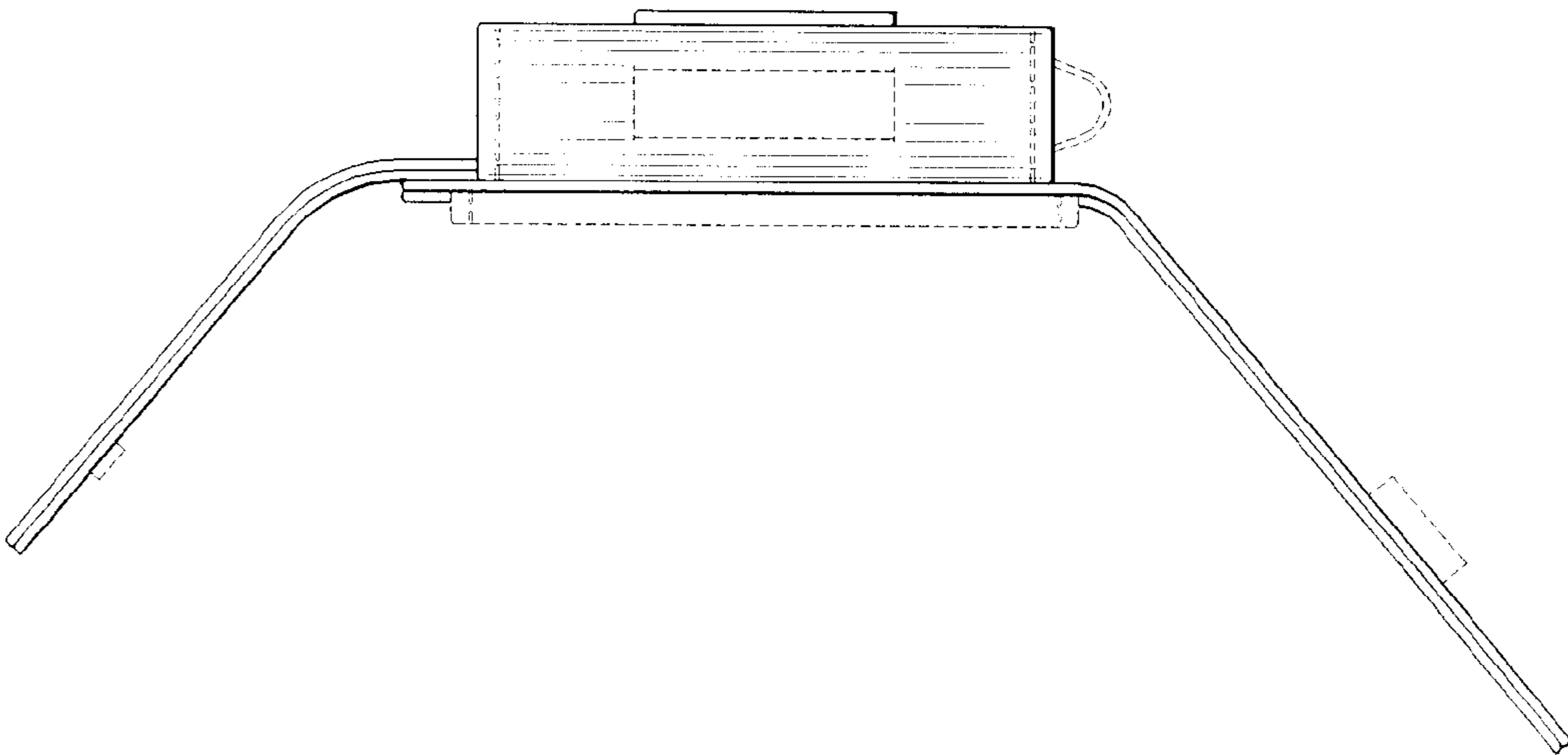

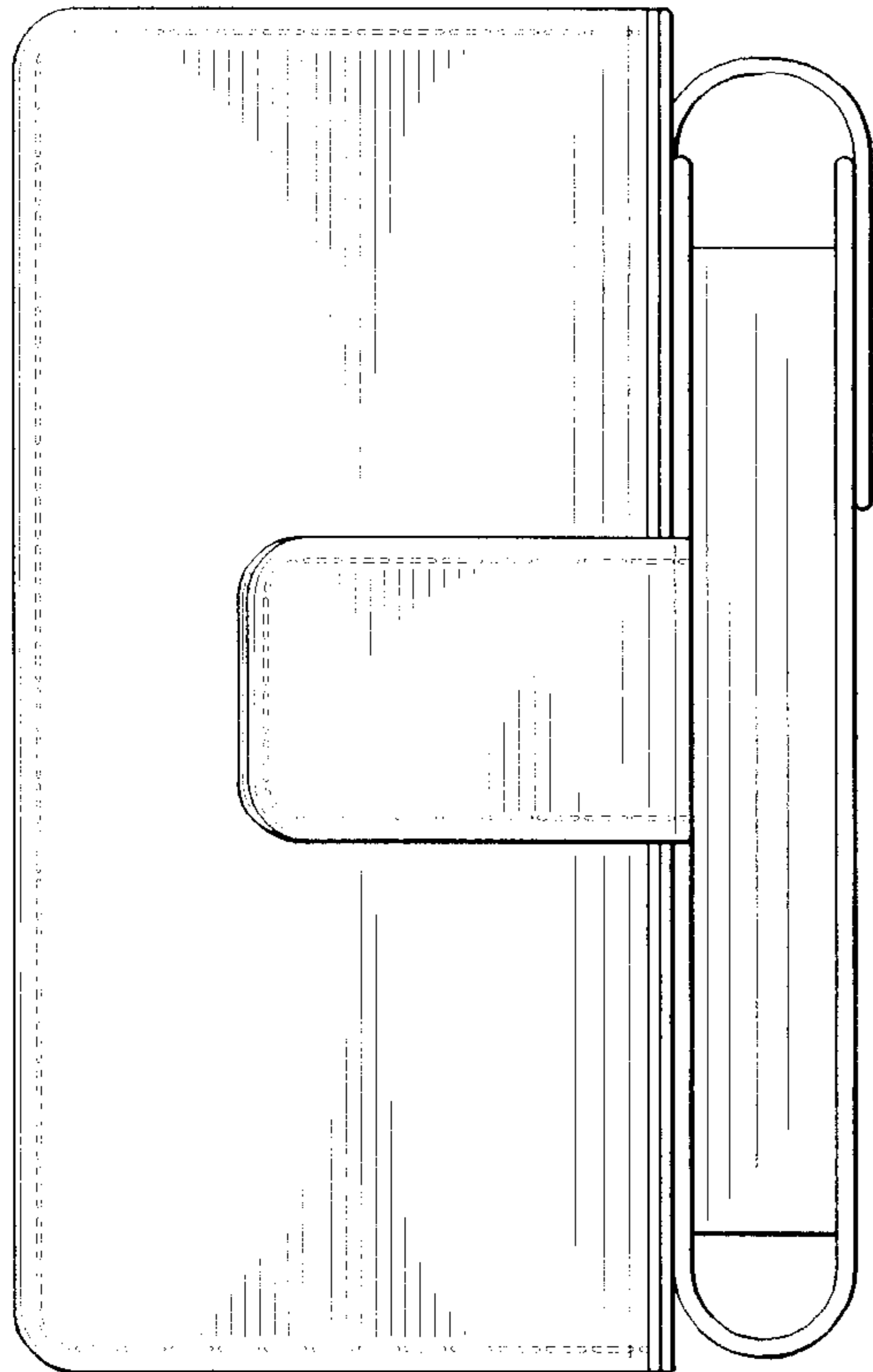
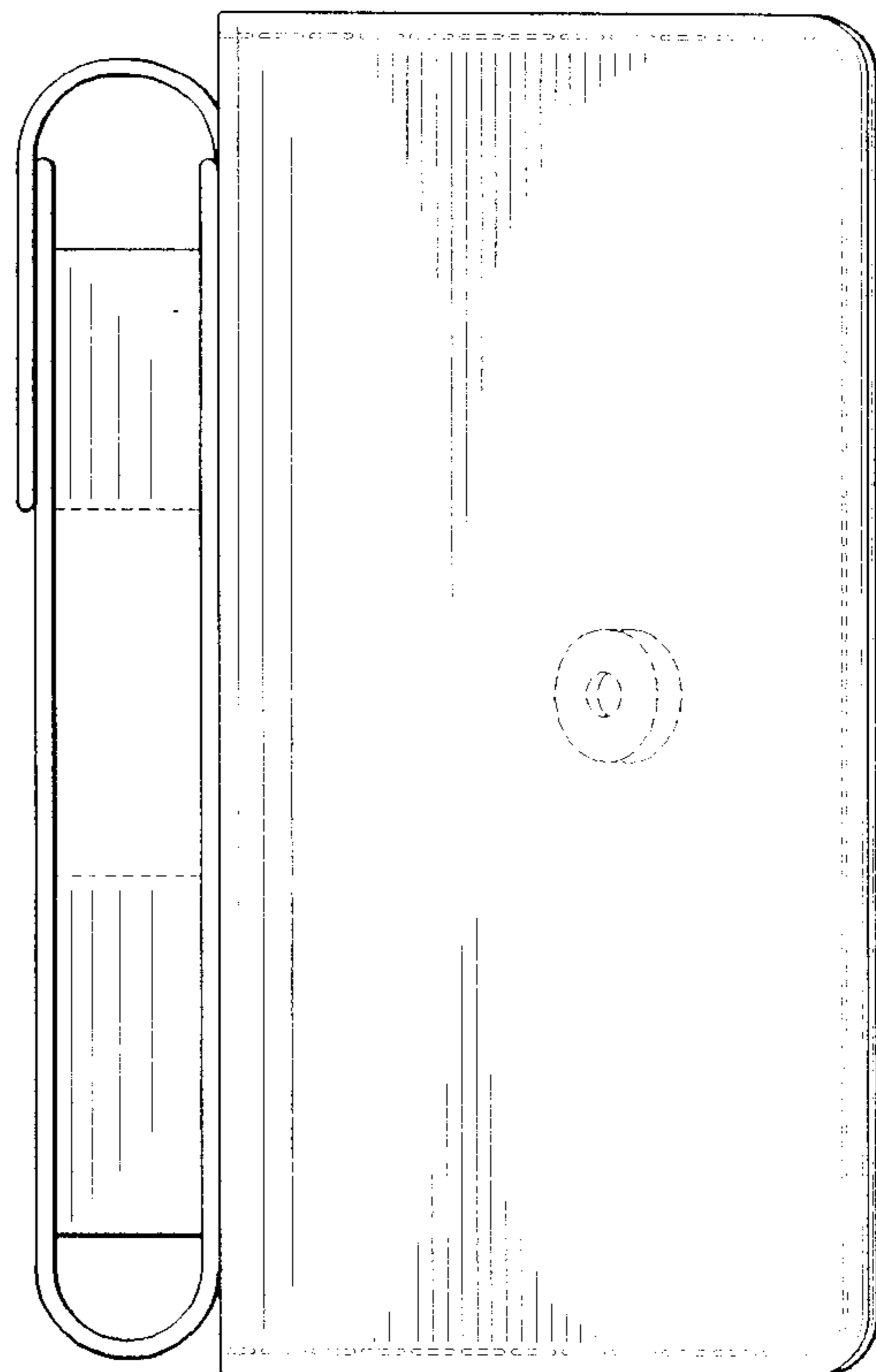

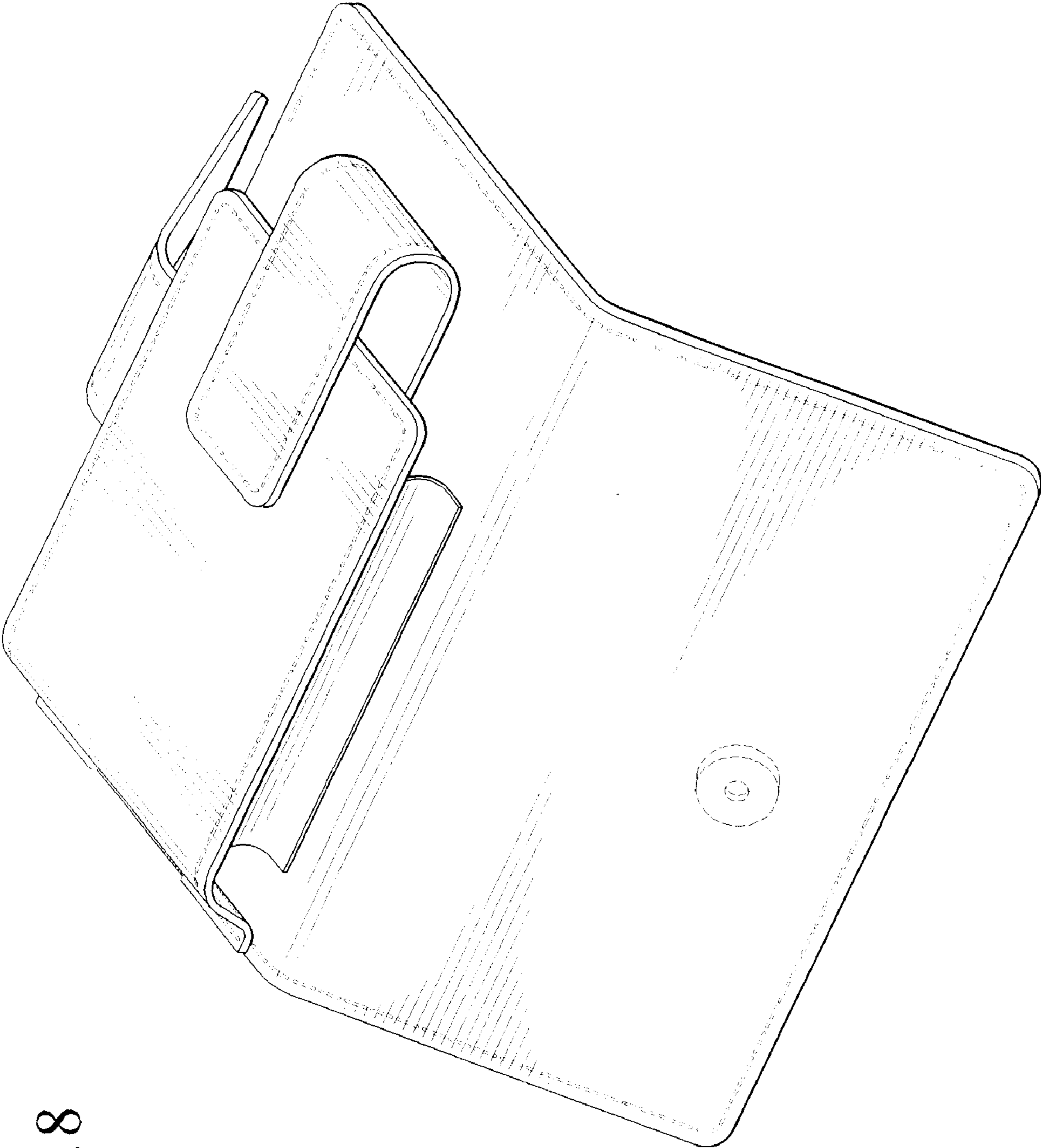

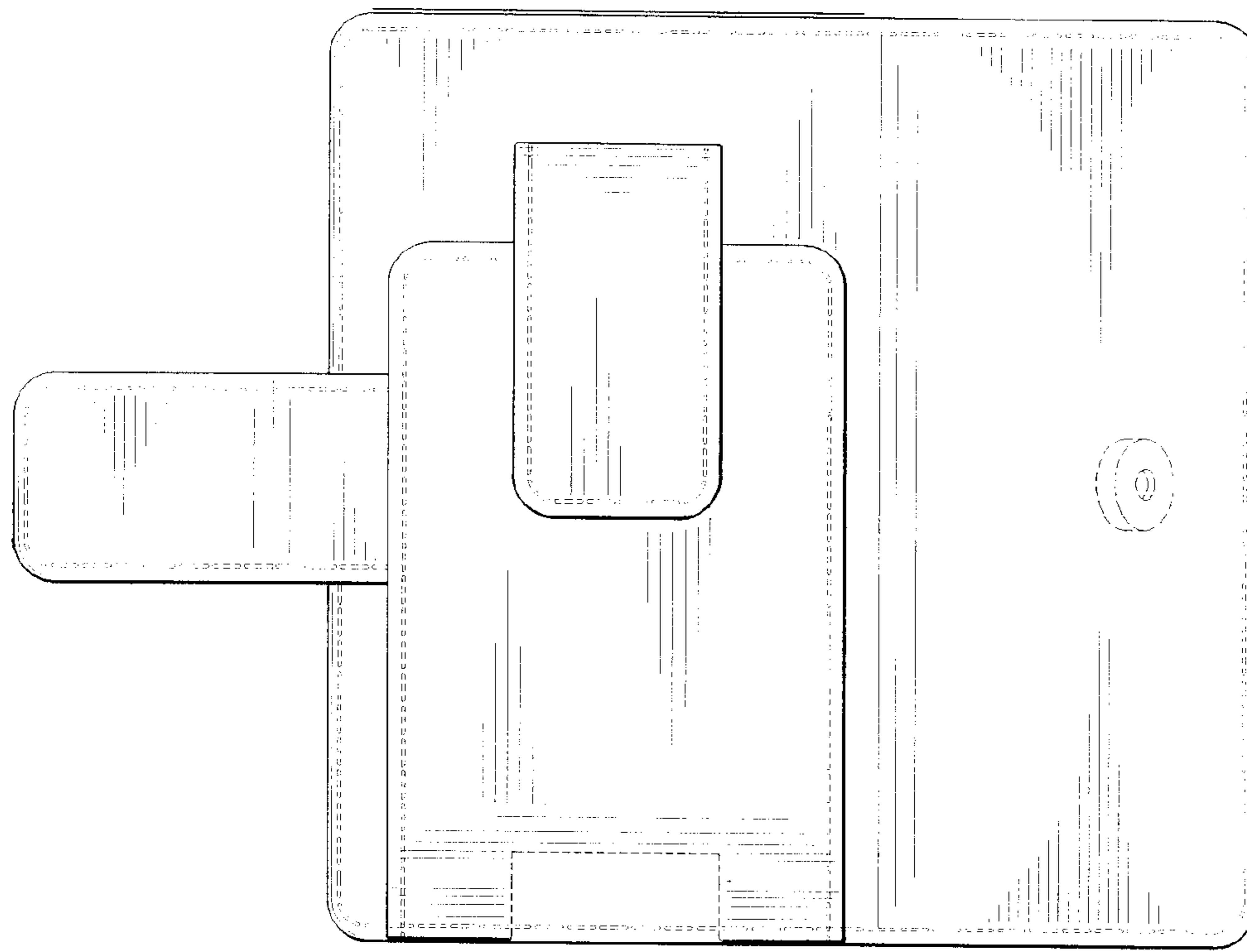

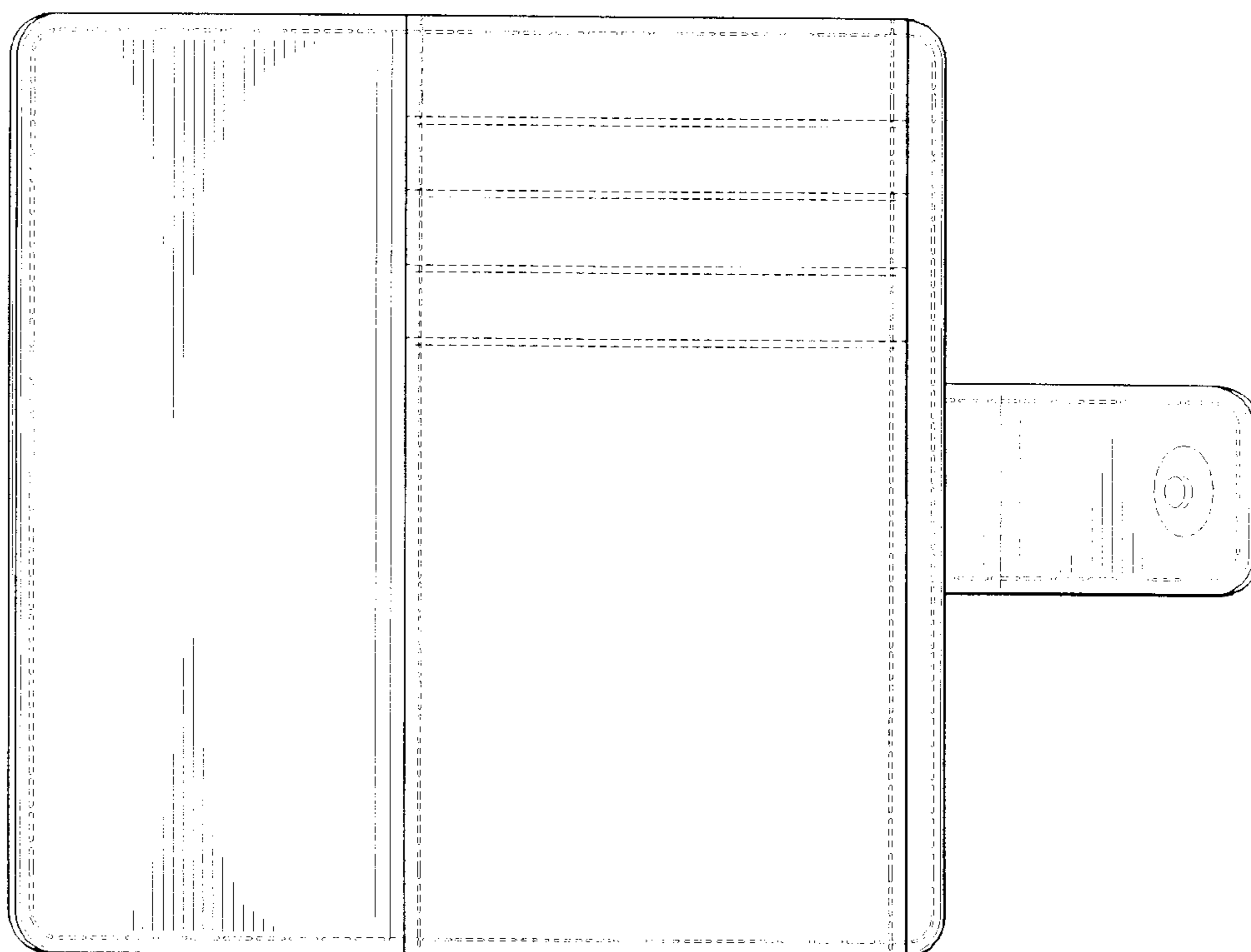

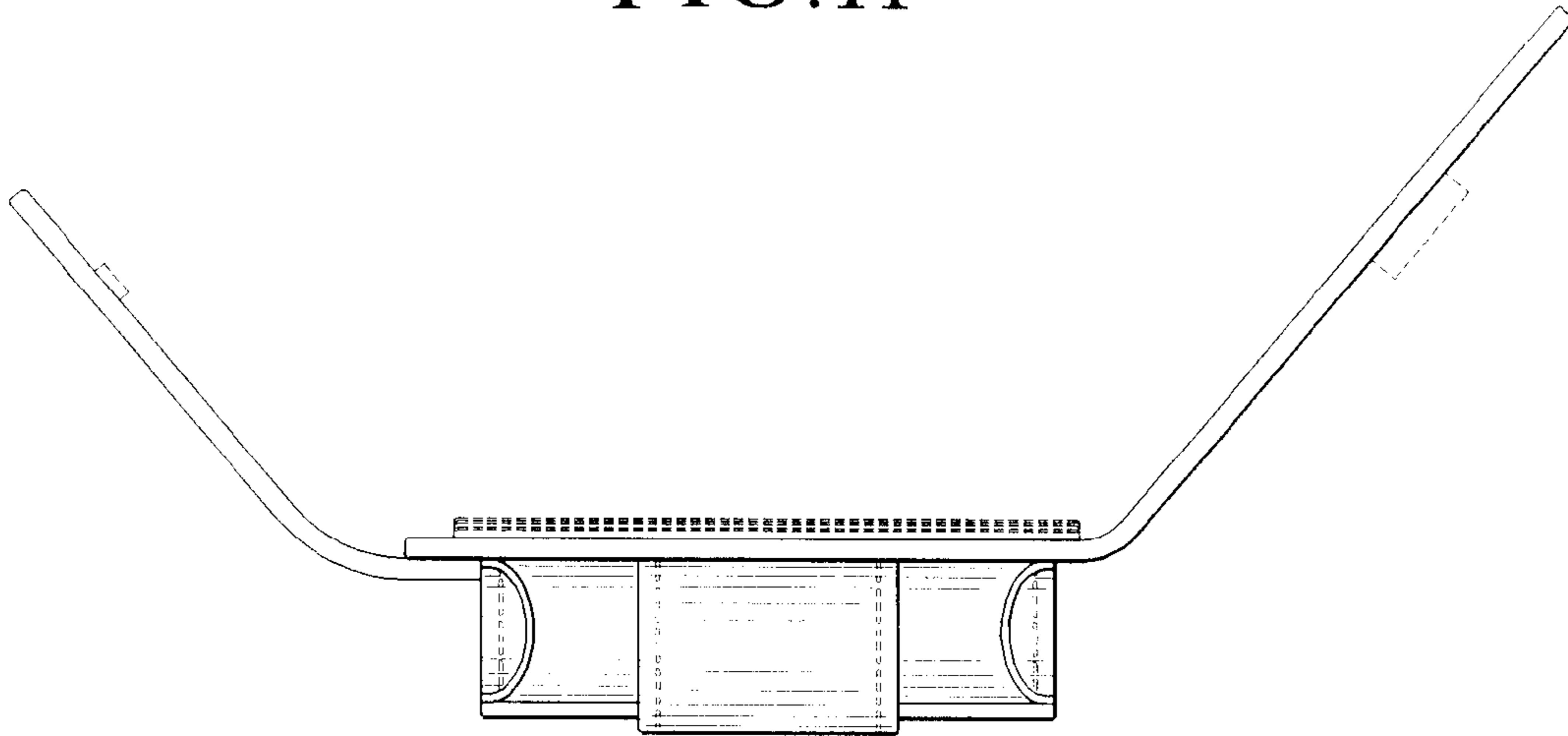

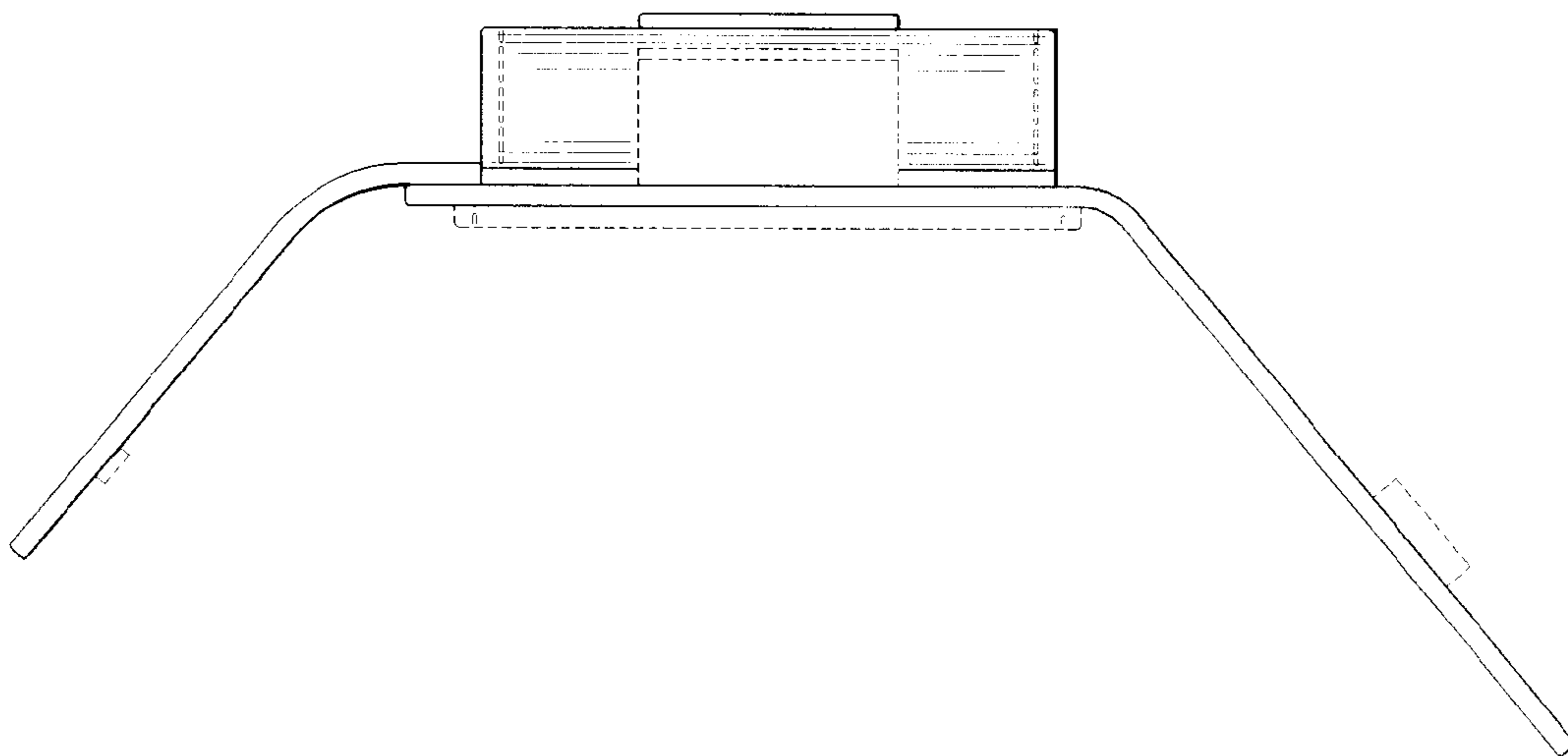

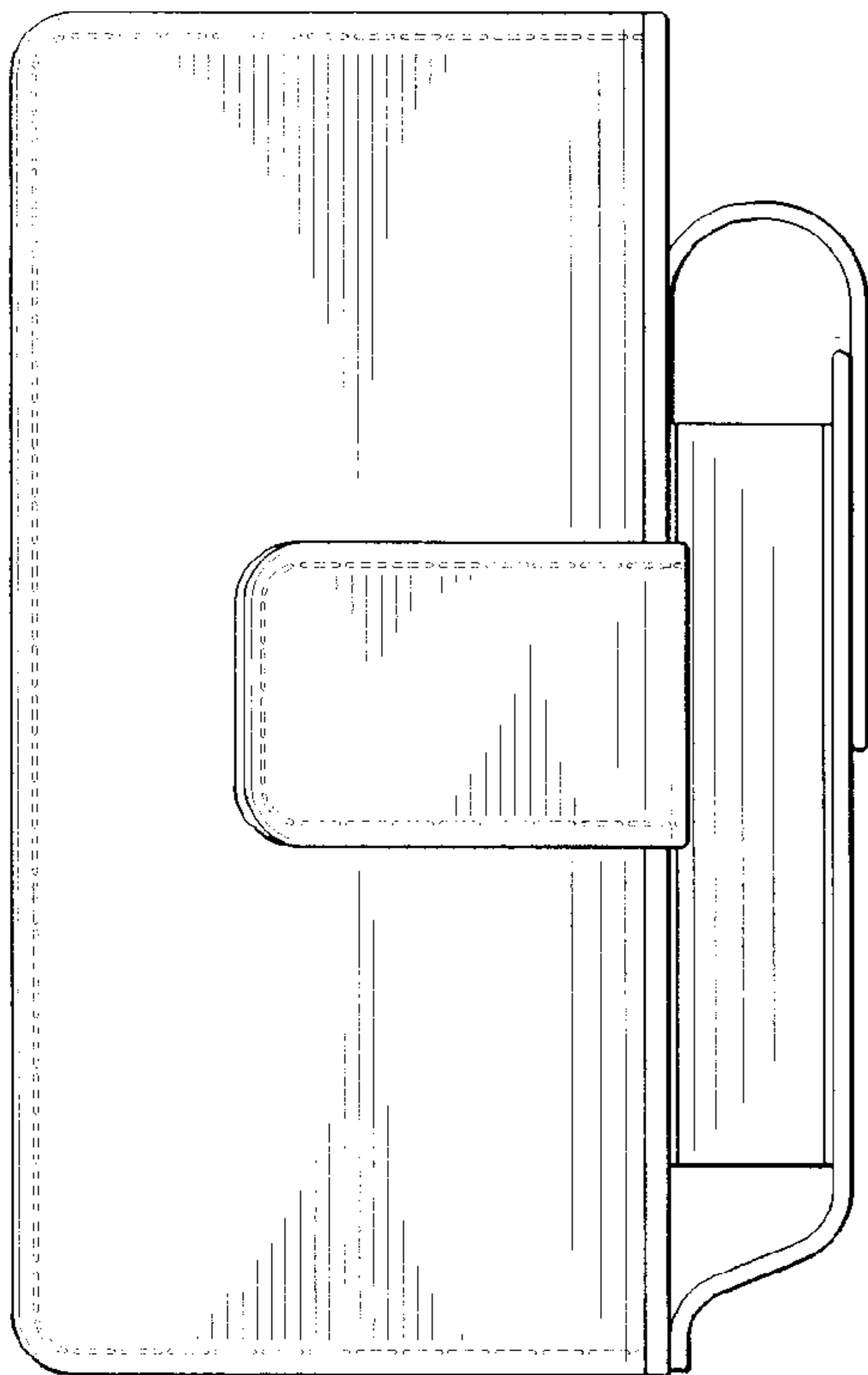
