The ornamental design for a surface configuration of a front bumper for a vehicle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

This application is related to the following co-pending application, of the inventor, filed on even date herewith: Application Ser. No. 29/222,963, entitled "Surface Configuration of a Vehicle, Toy, and/or Other Replicas".

FIG. 1 is a right perspective view of a first embodiment of a surface configuration of a front bumper for a vehicle according to my novel design, the left perspective view being mirror symmetrical;

FIG. 2 is a right side view of the first embodiment of the surface configuration of a front bumper for a vehicle according to my novel design, the left side view being mirror symmetrical;


FIG. 3 is a front view of the first embodiment of the surface configuration of a front bumper for a vehicle according to my novel design;











