(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a sofa, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of the sofa showing my design.

FIG. 2 is back view thereof;

FIG. 3 is top plan view thereof;

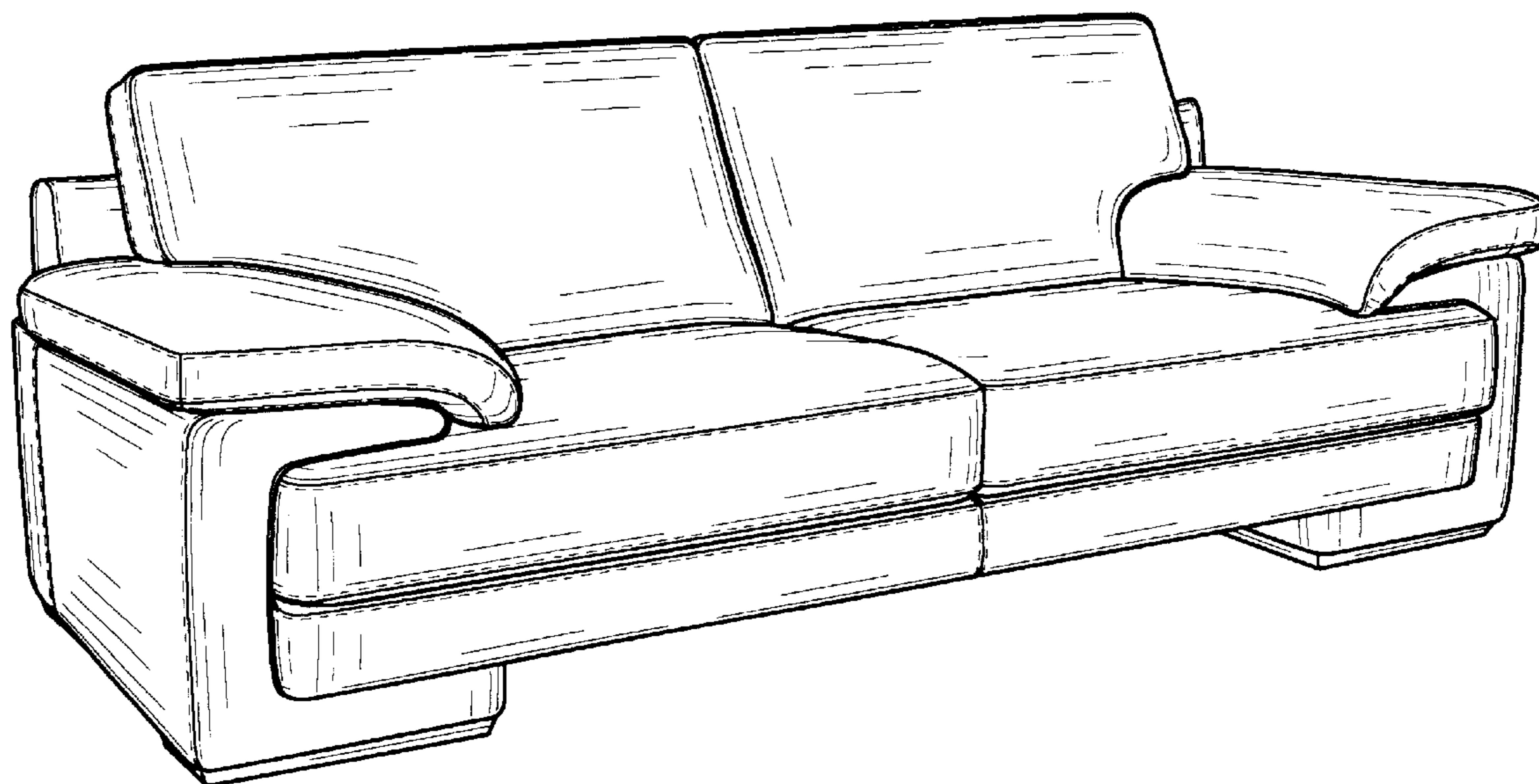
FIG. 4 is a front perspective view thereof;

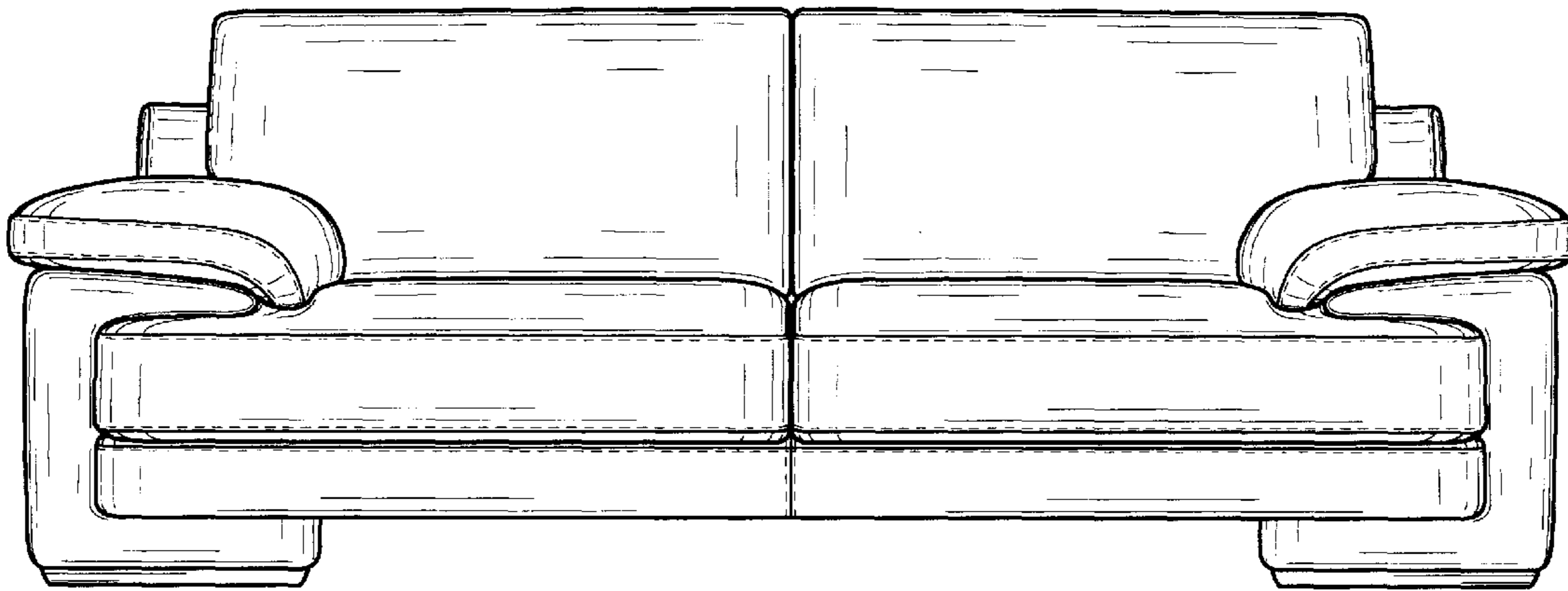

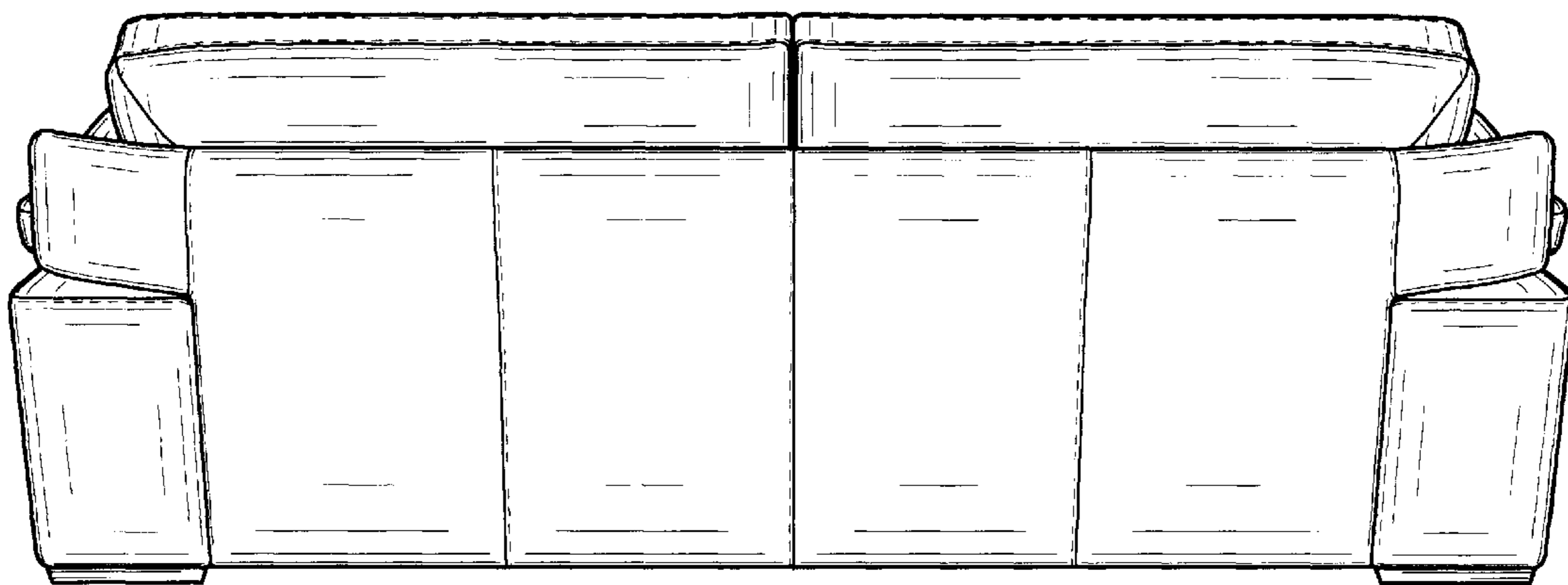

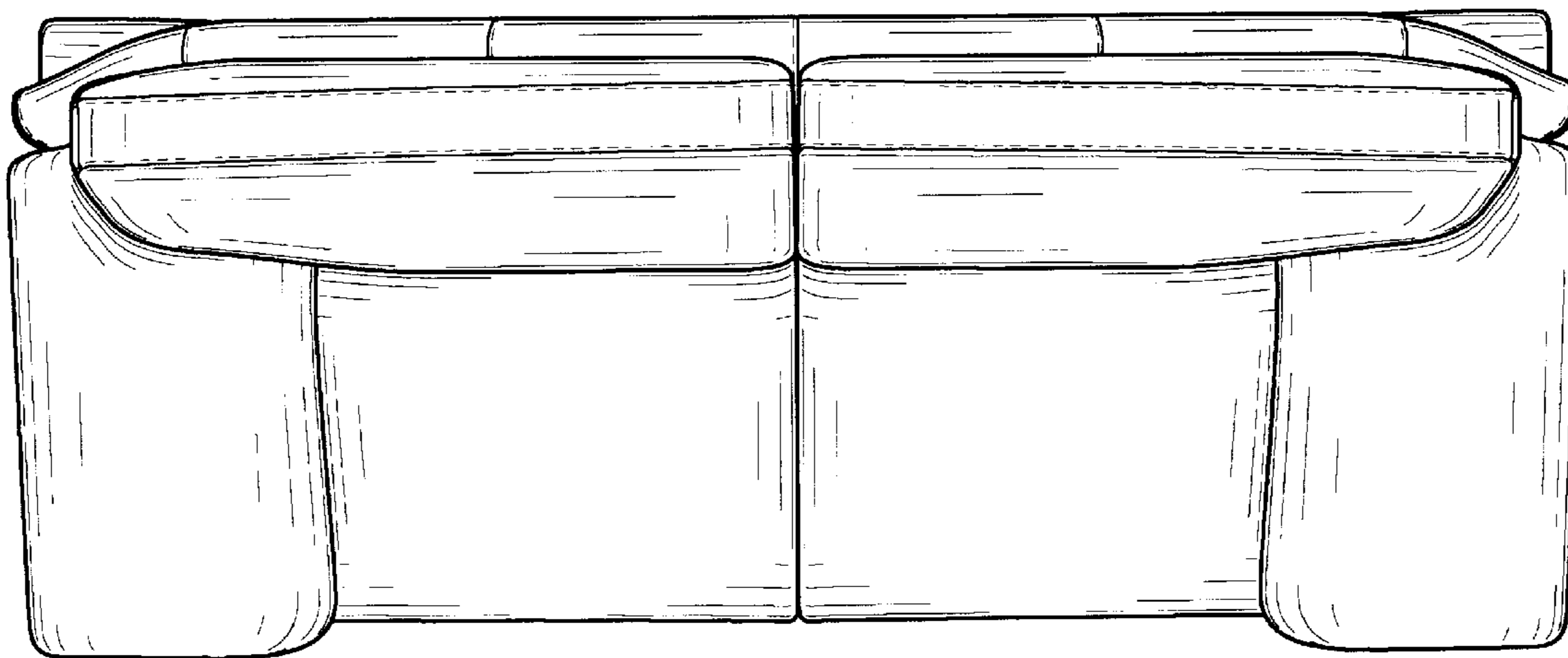

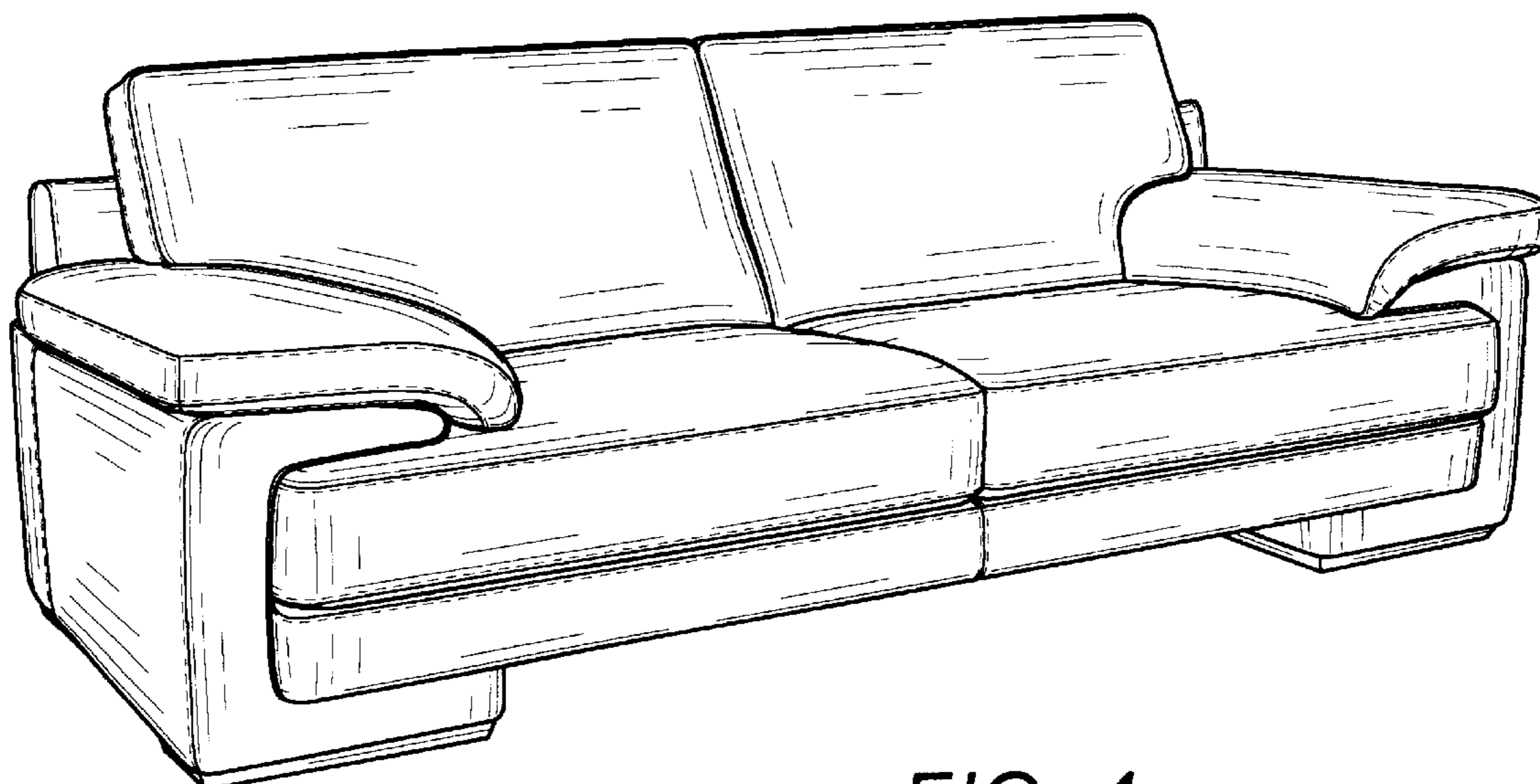

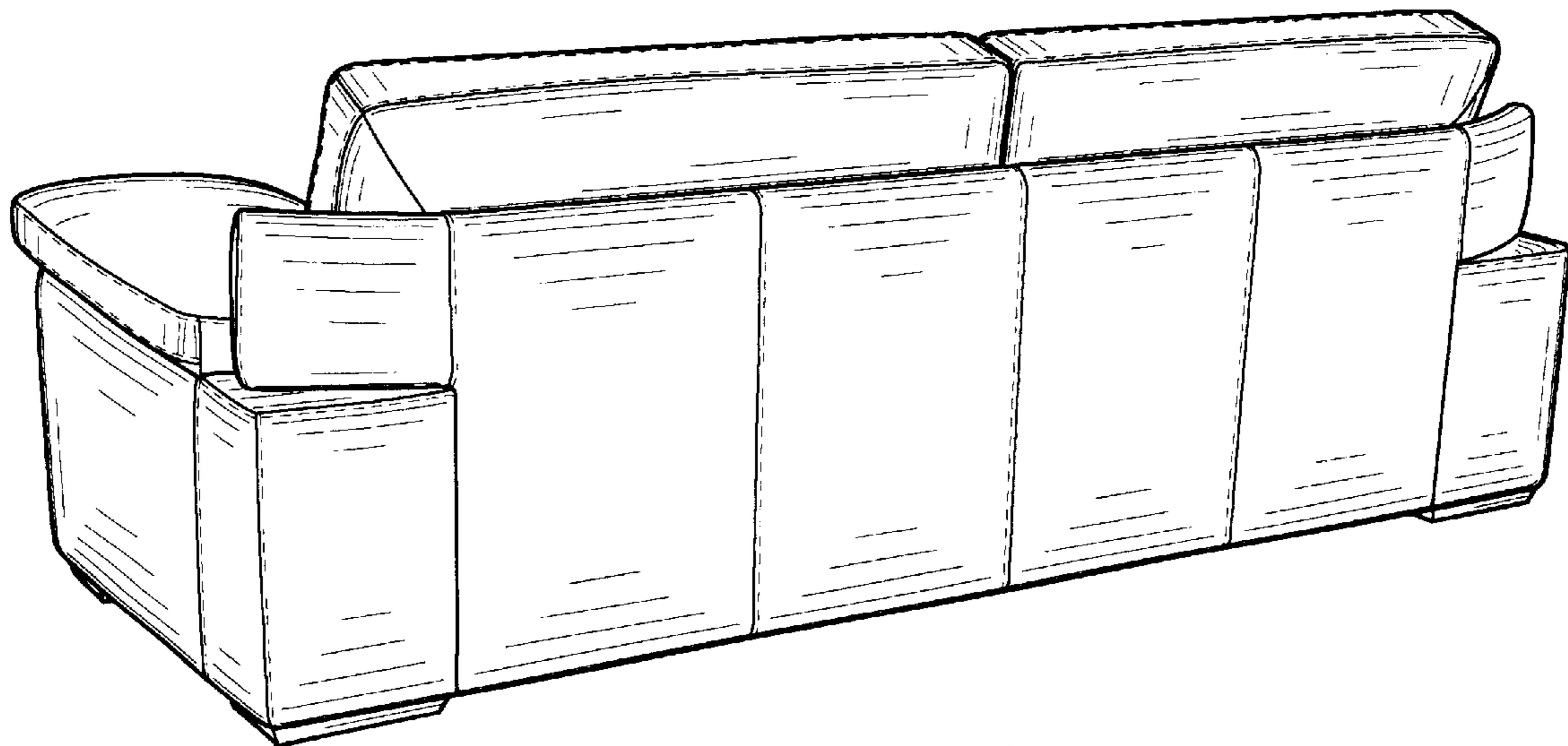

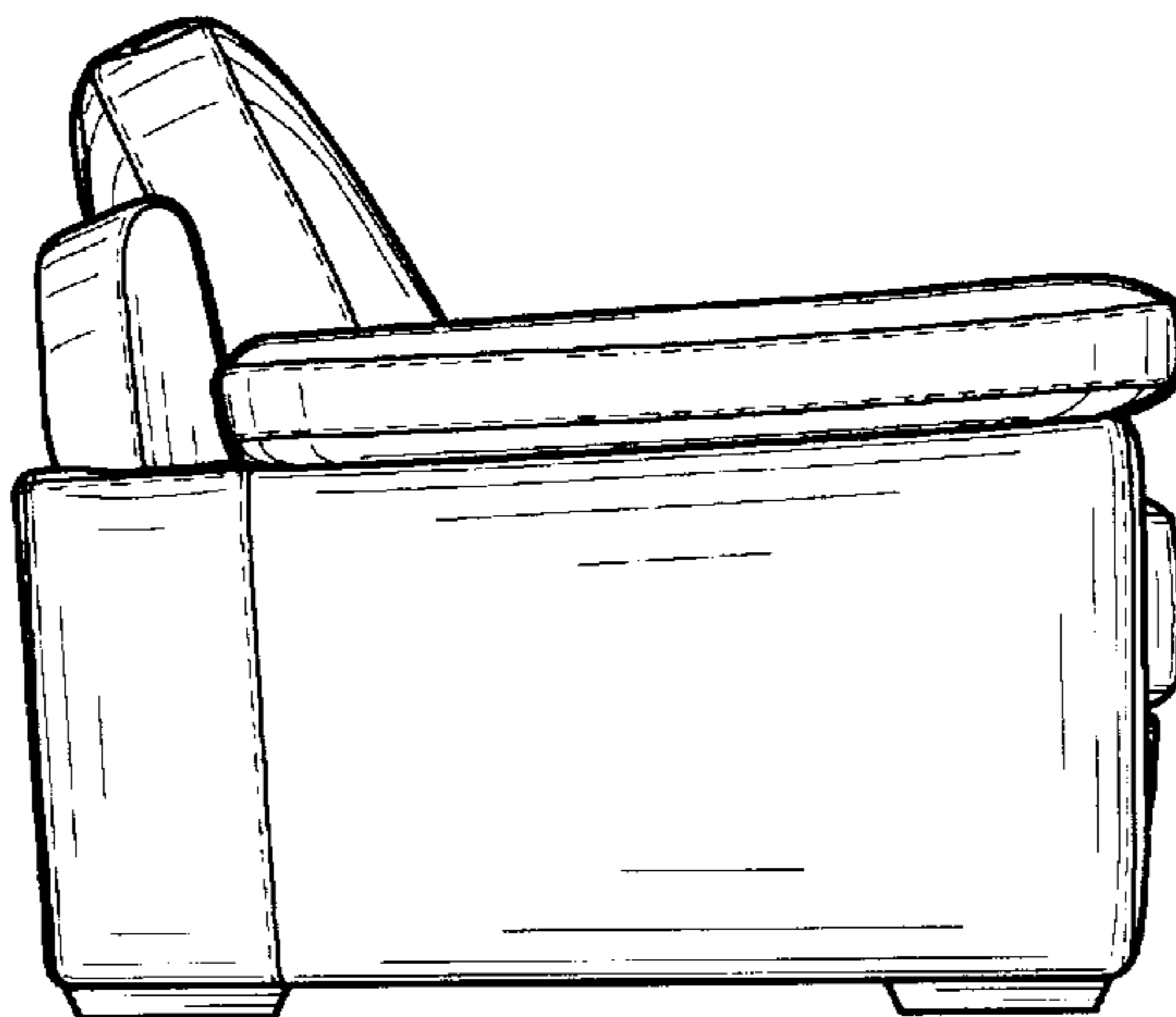
