FIG. 4 is a left side view of the plush figure air freshener device;

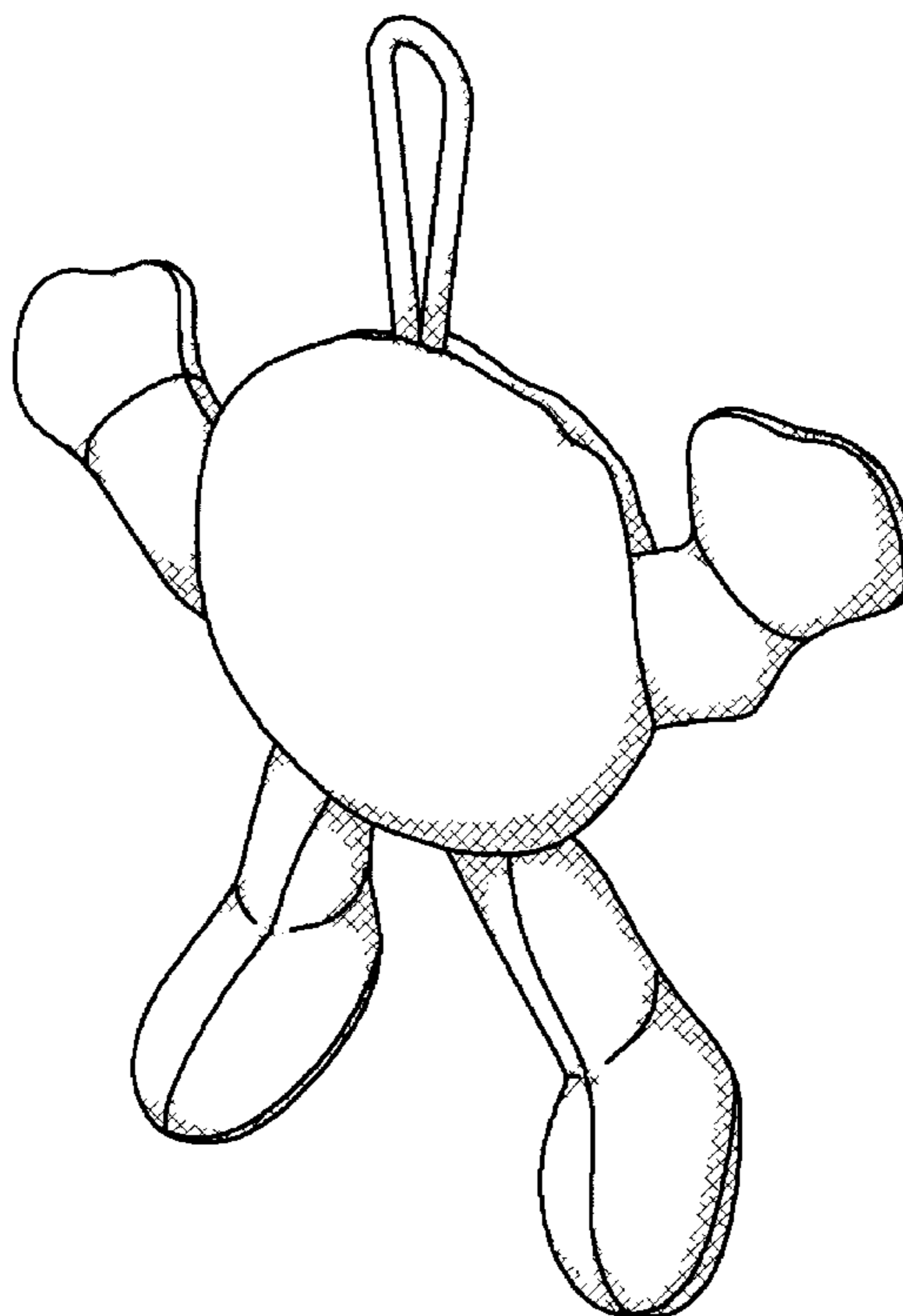
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the plush figure air freshener device;

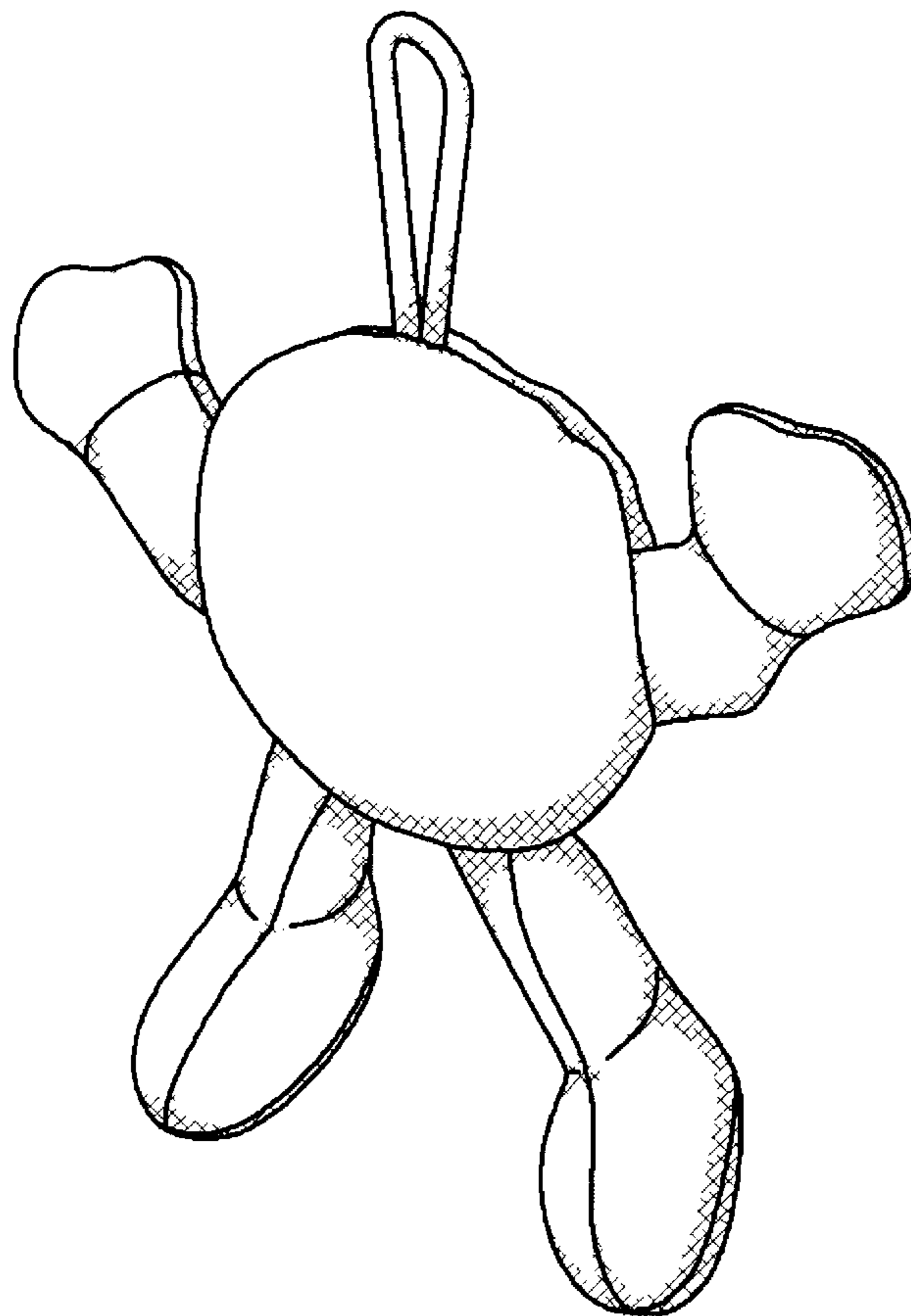
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the plush figure air freshener device; and,

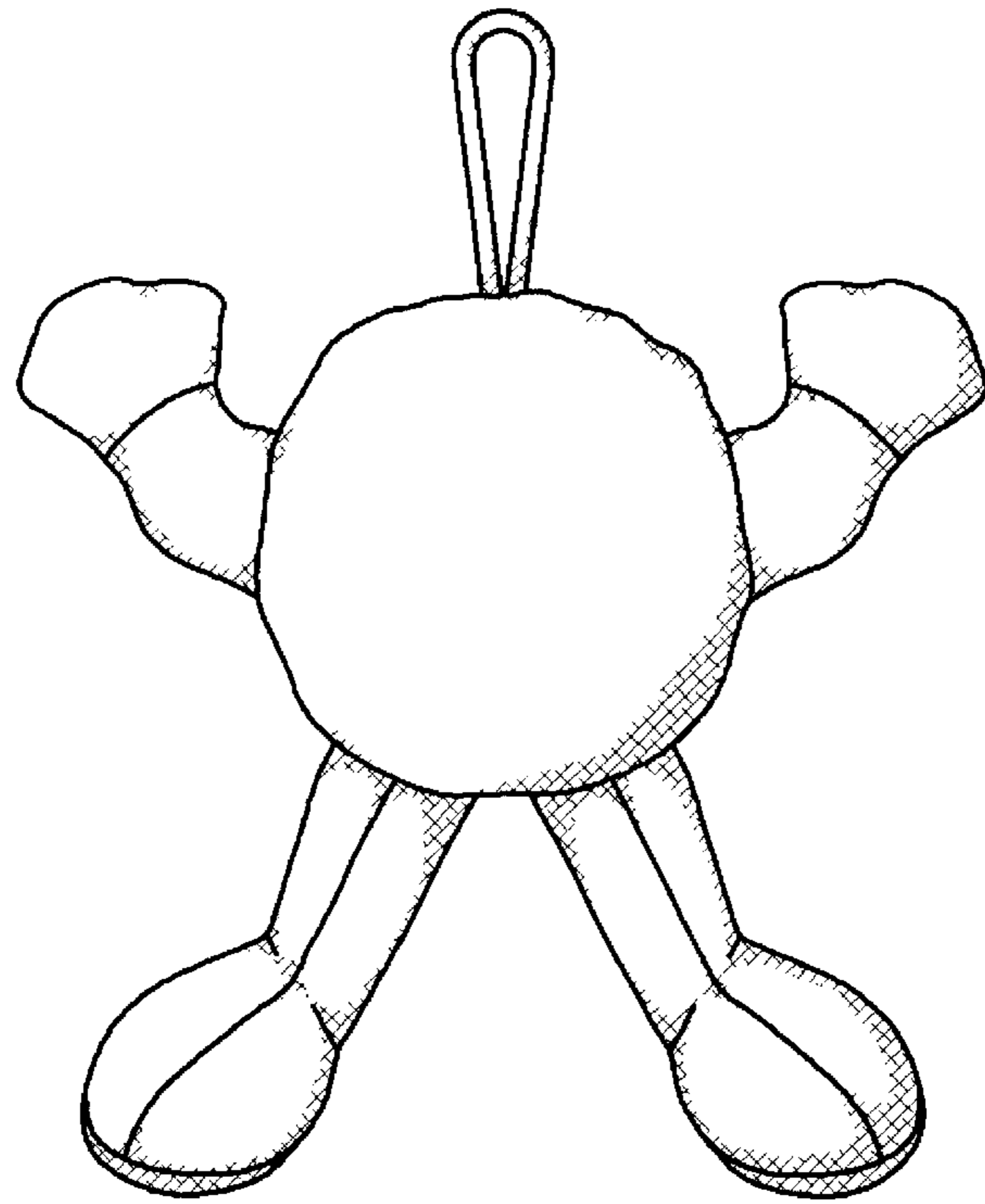

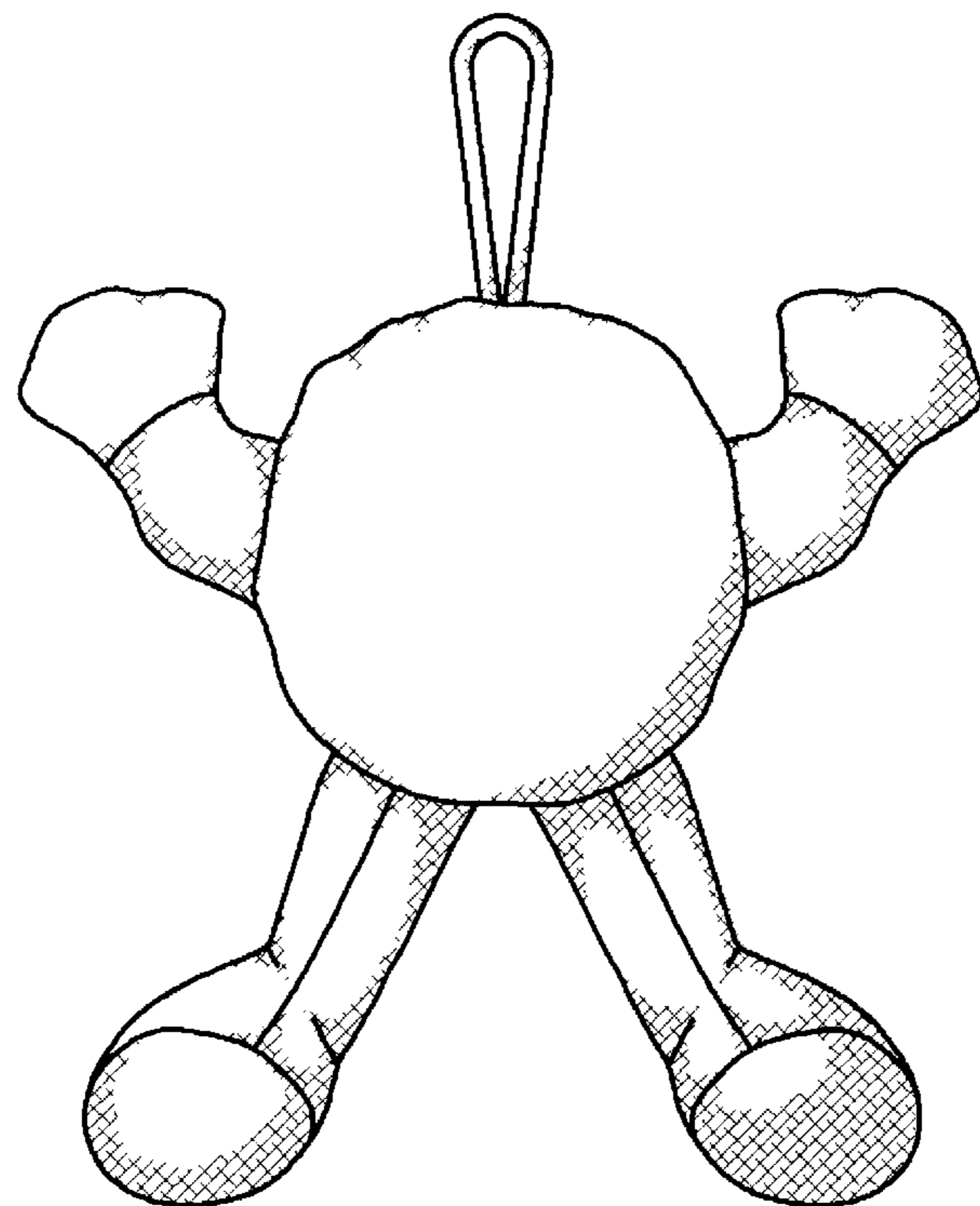

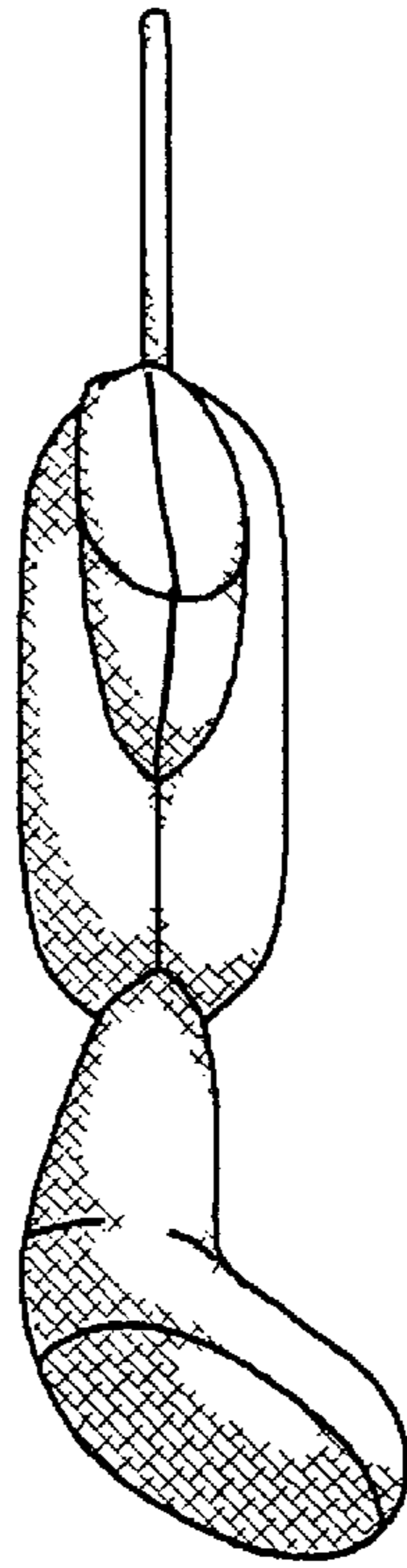

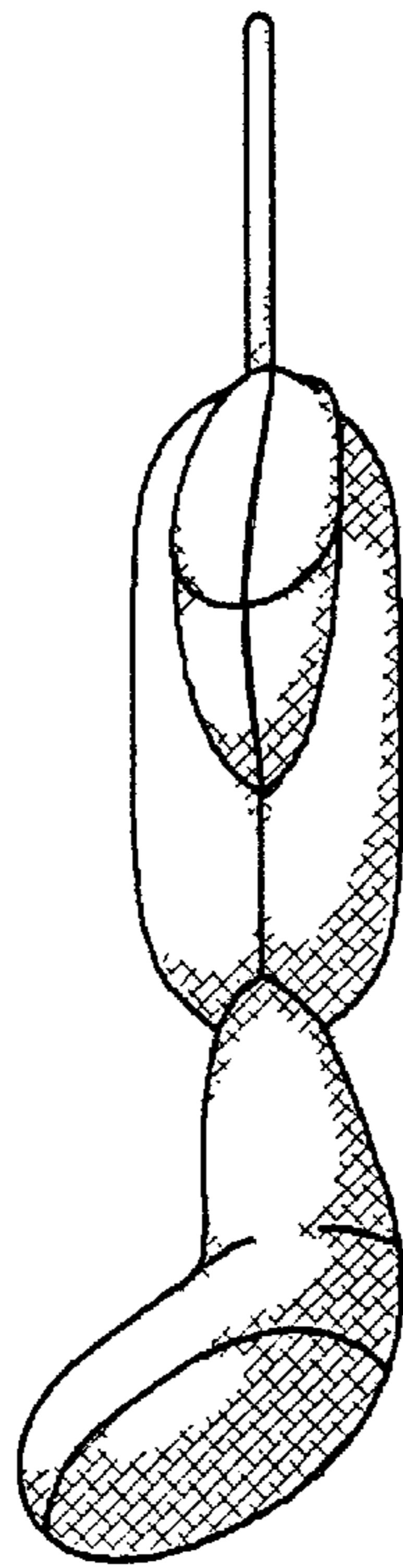
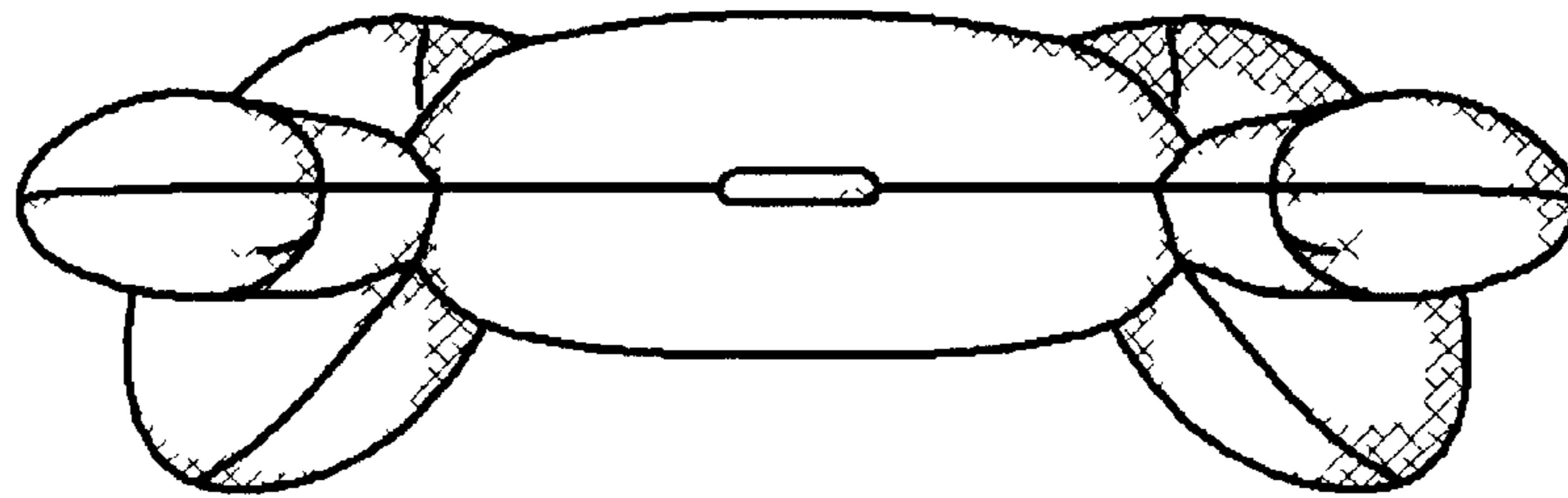
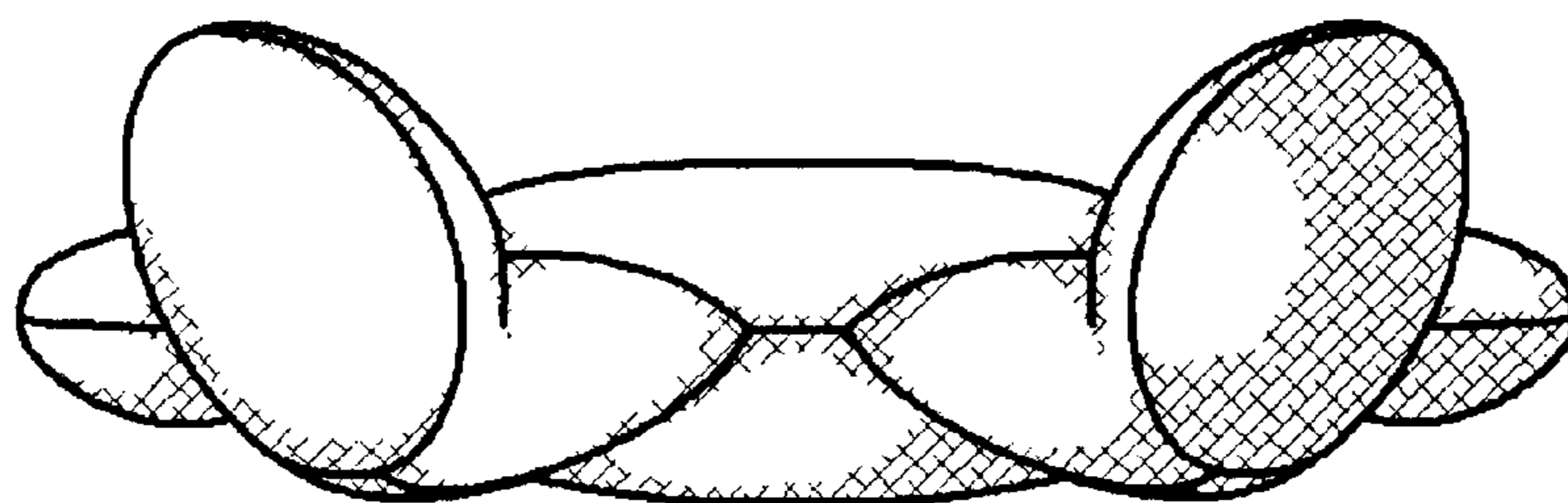
