The ornamental design for a low profile tap with grip tabs, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tap, with connective tubing, cap surface texture, and directive arrows shown in phantom lines.

FIG. 2 is a top view of the tap shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the tap shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a right side view of the tap shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a left side view of the tap shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a front view of the tap shown in FIG. 1; and,

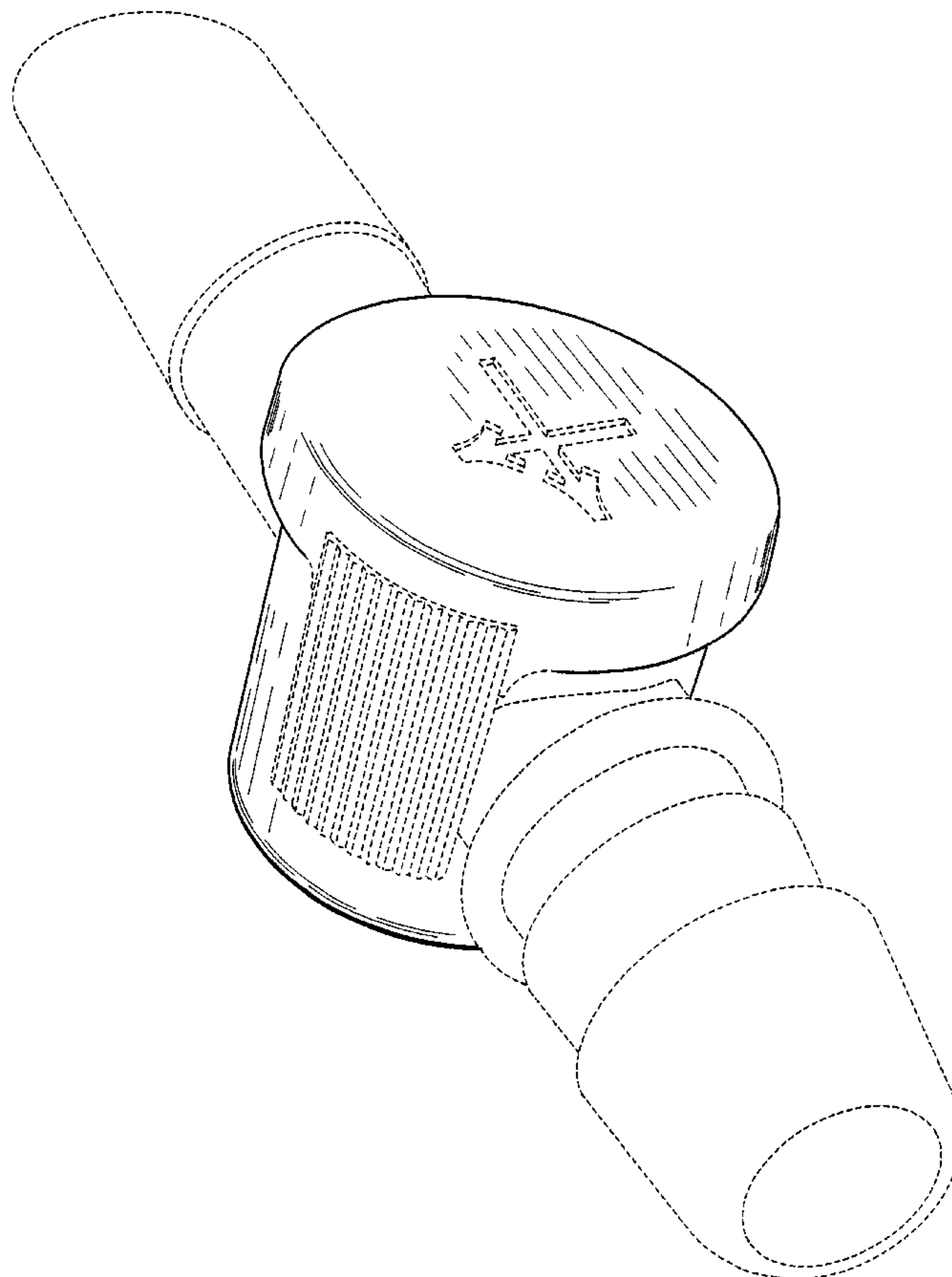
FIG. 7 is a back view of the tap shown in FIG. 1.

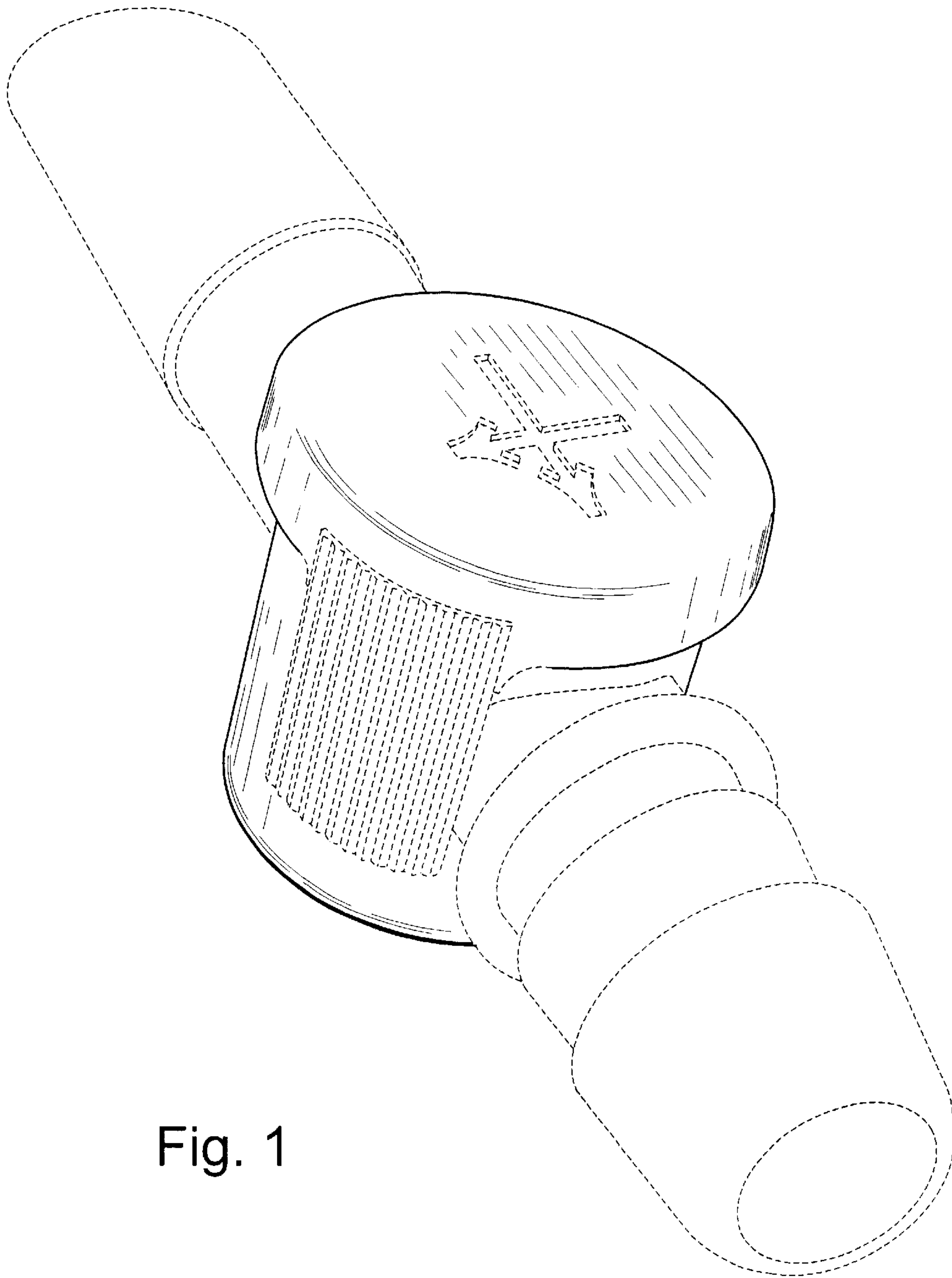

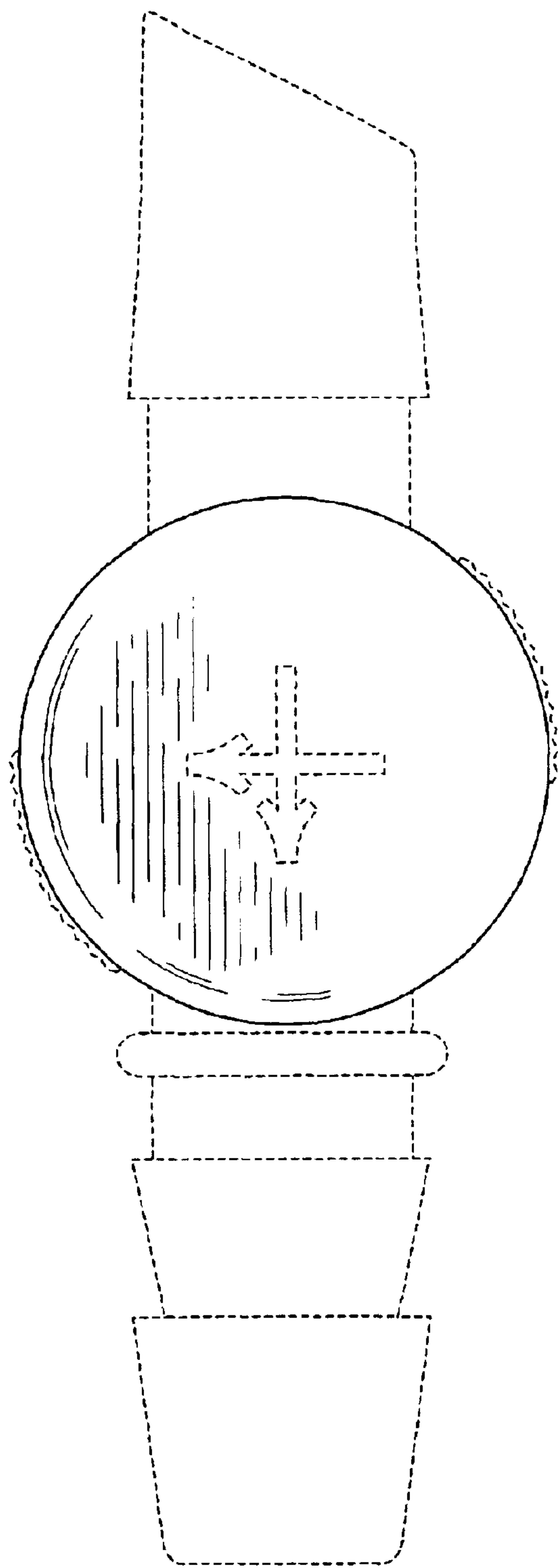

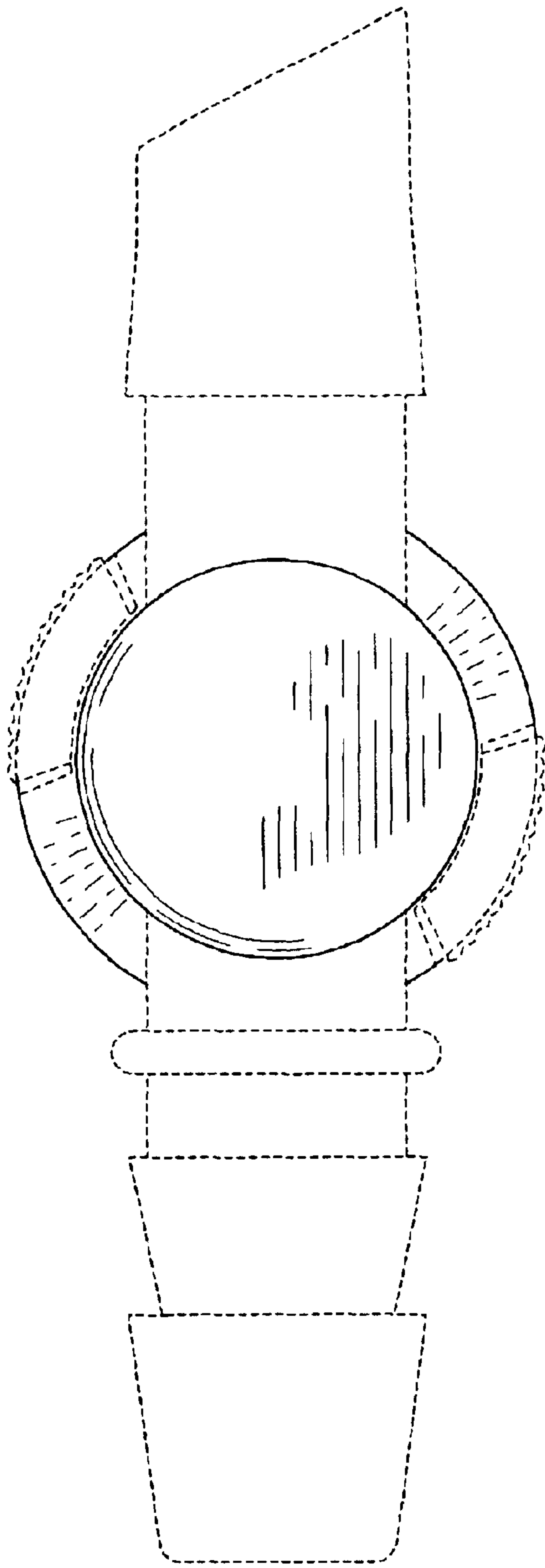

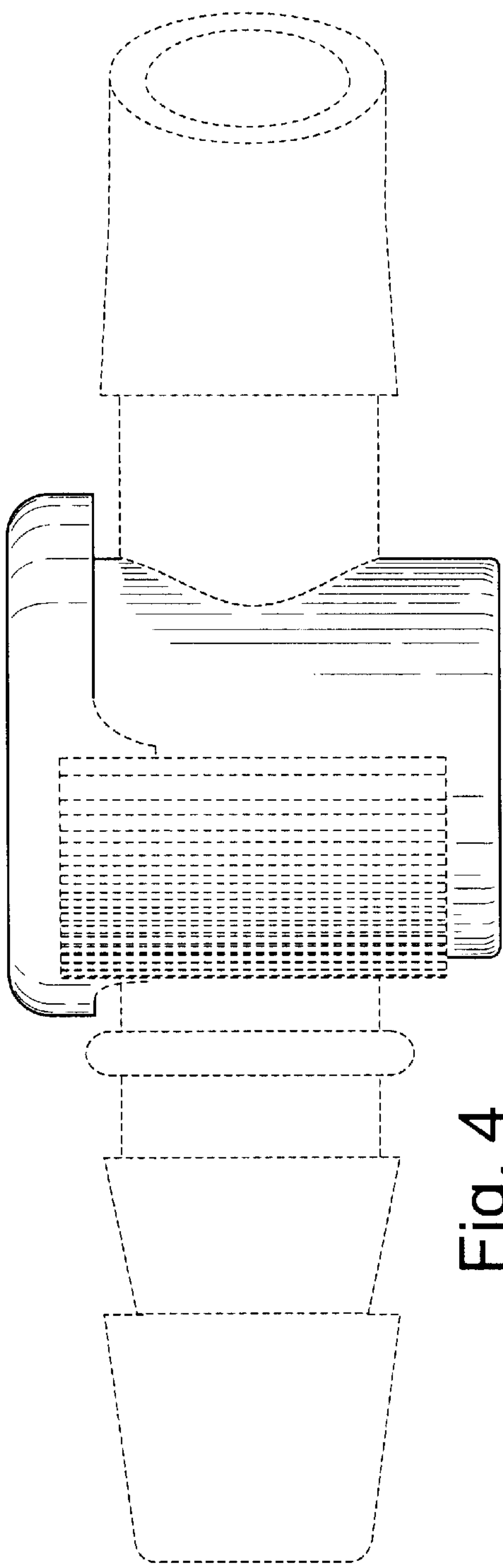

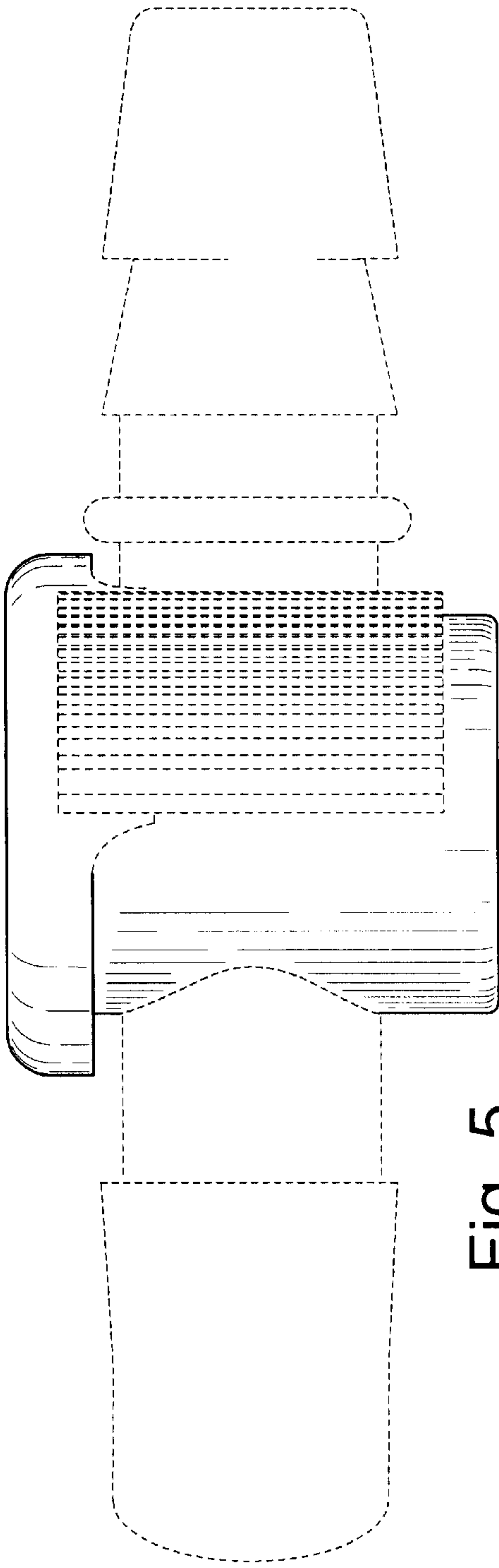

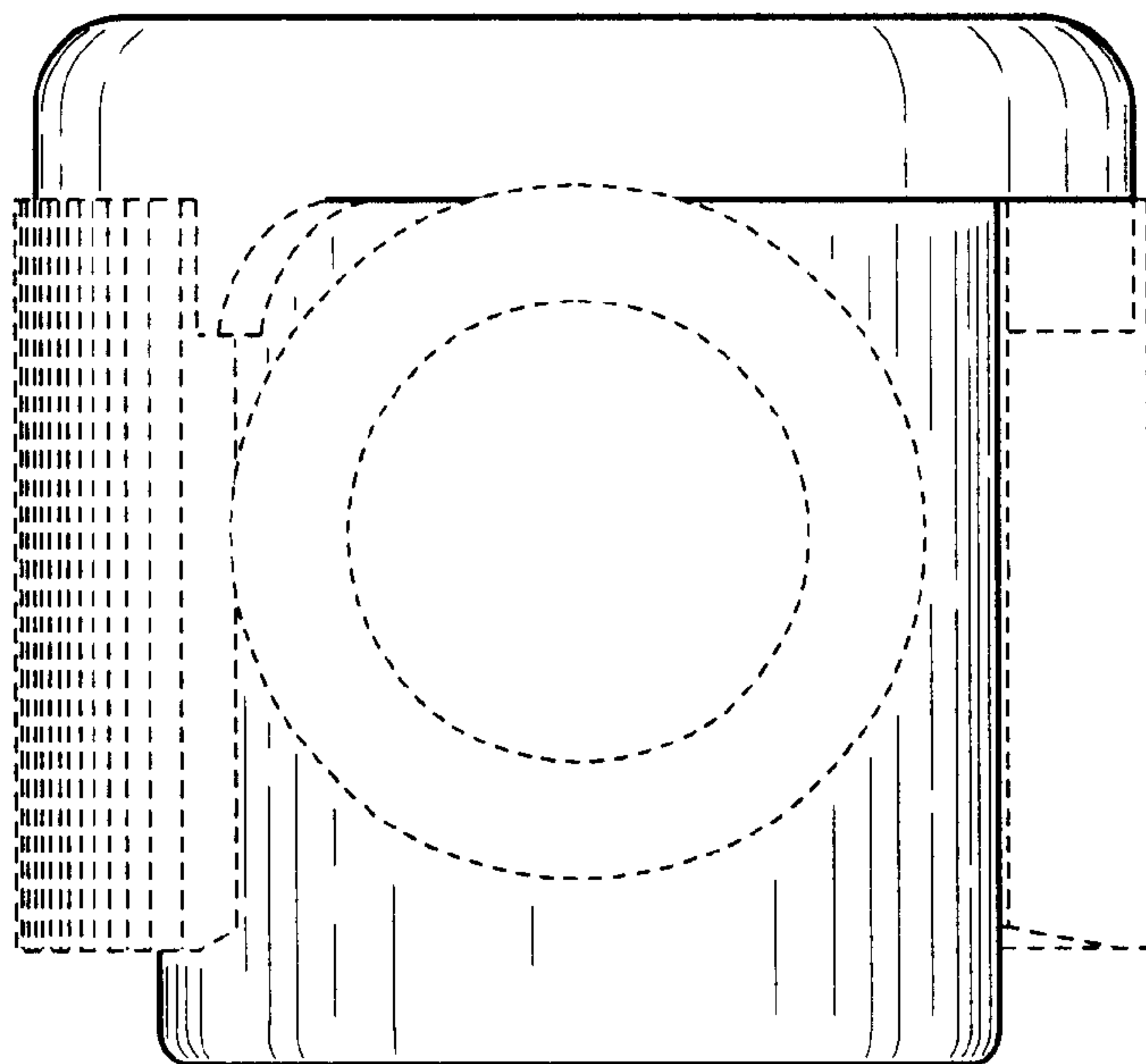

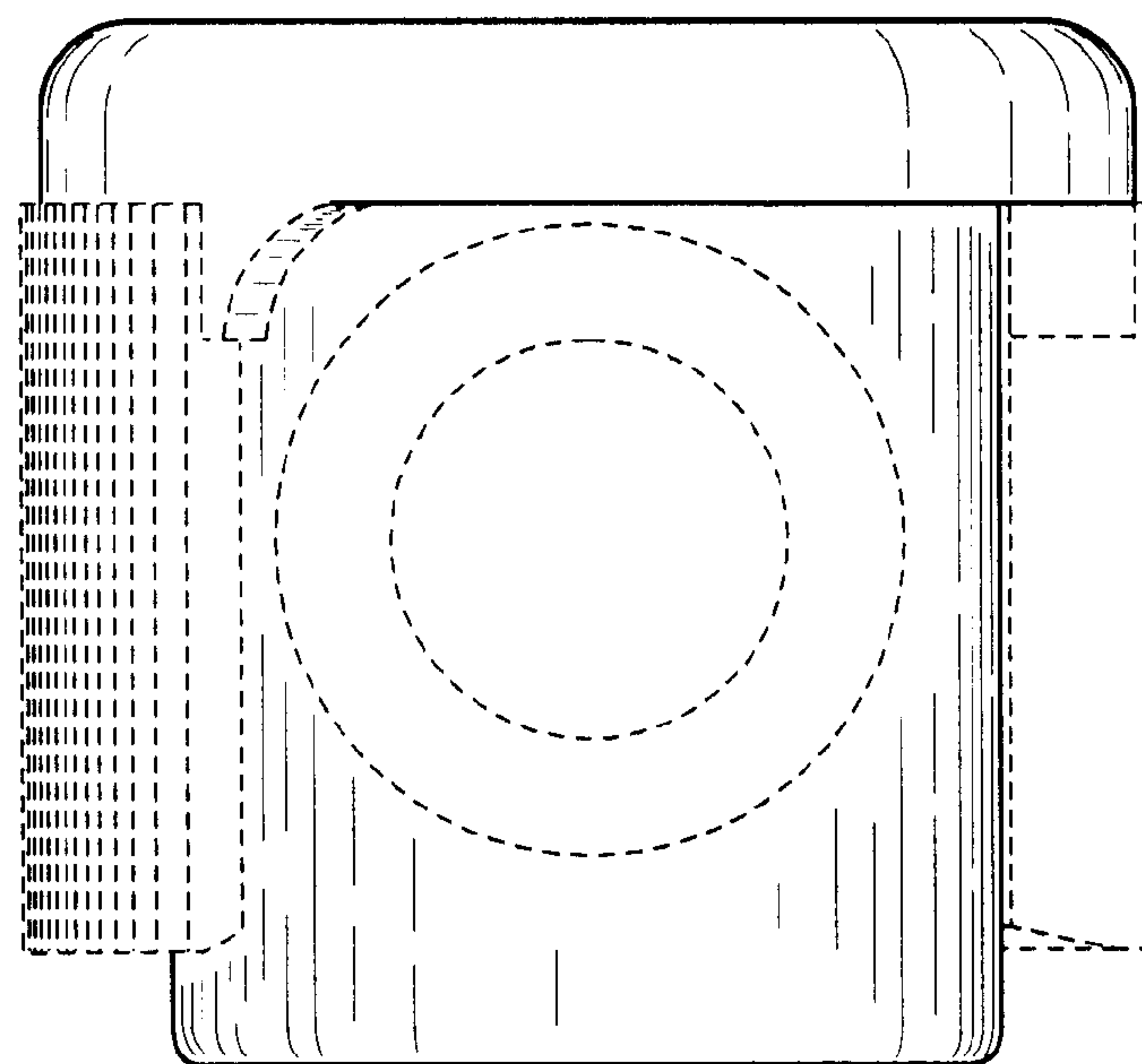
