(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an adjustable cap of an air freshener device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of an adjustable cap of an air freshener device showing our new design, in a first position affixed to an air freshener device;

FIG. 2 is an exploded perspective view thereof, showing the cap removed from the air freshener device;

FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view of the cap of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof, in a second position affixed to an air freshener device; and,

FIG. 5 is a side view thereof.

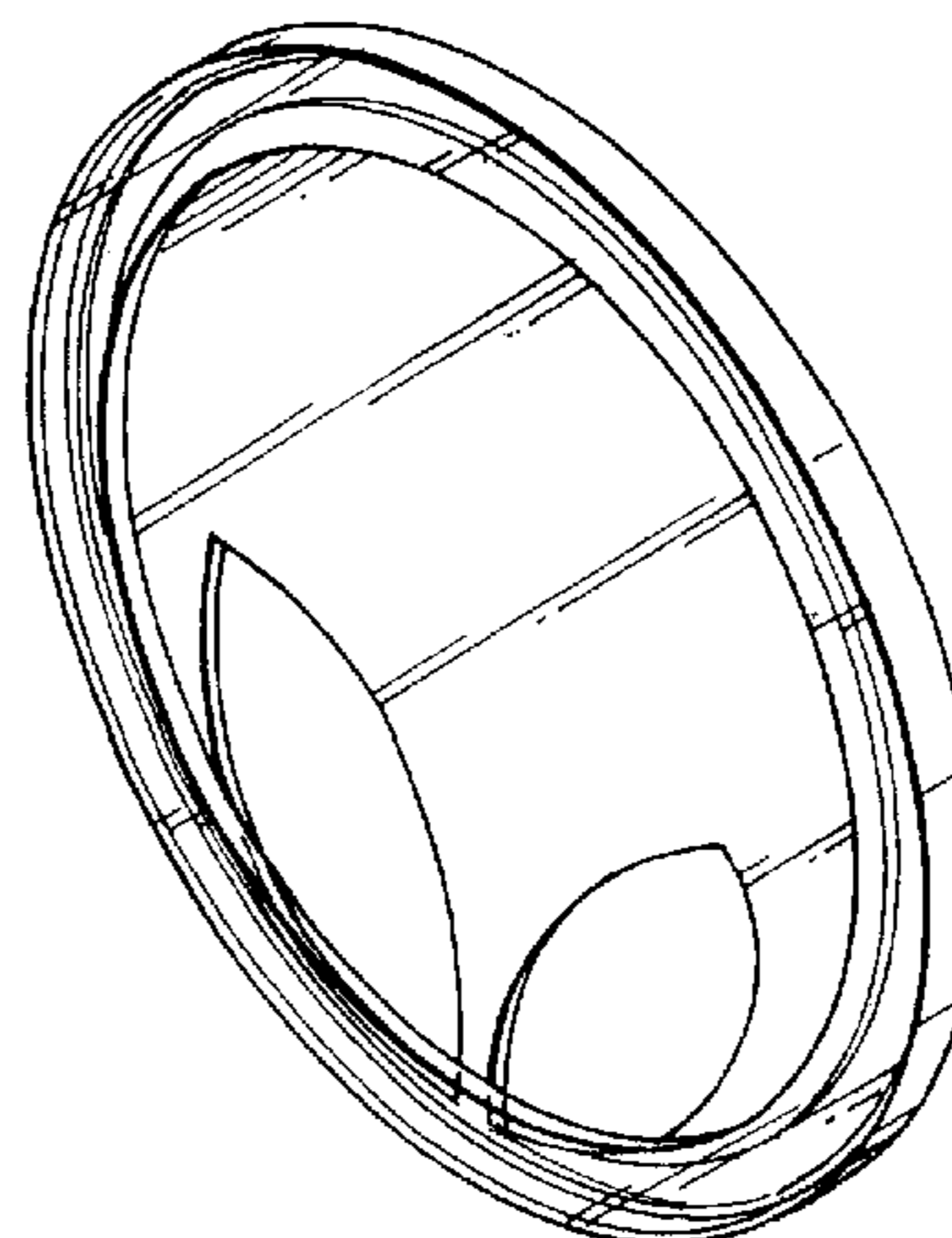
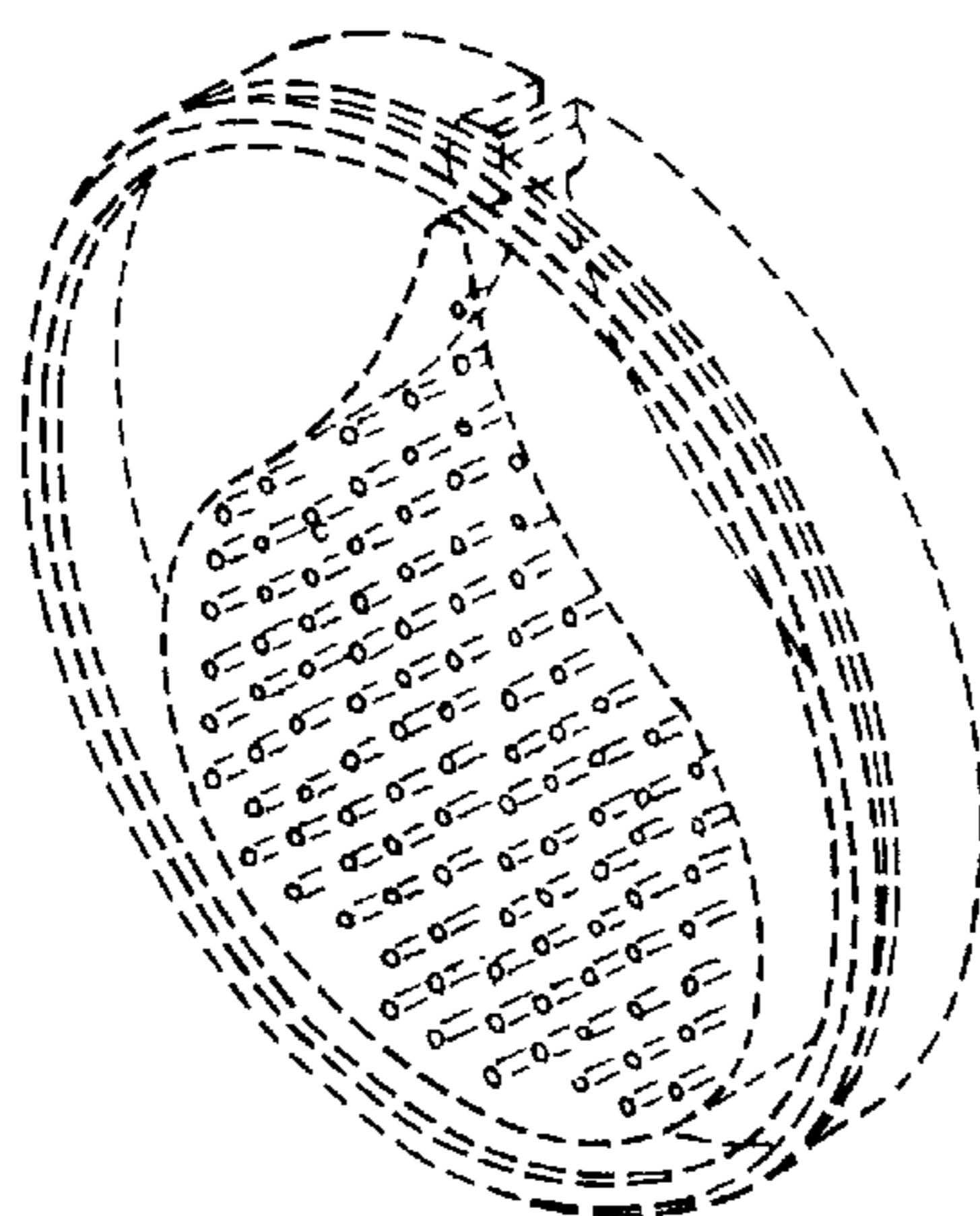

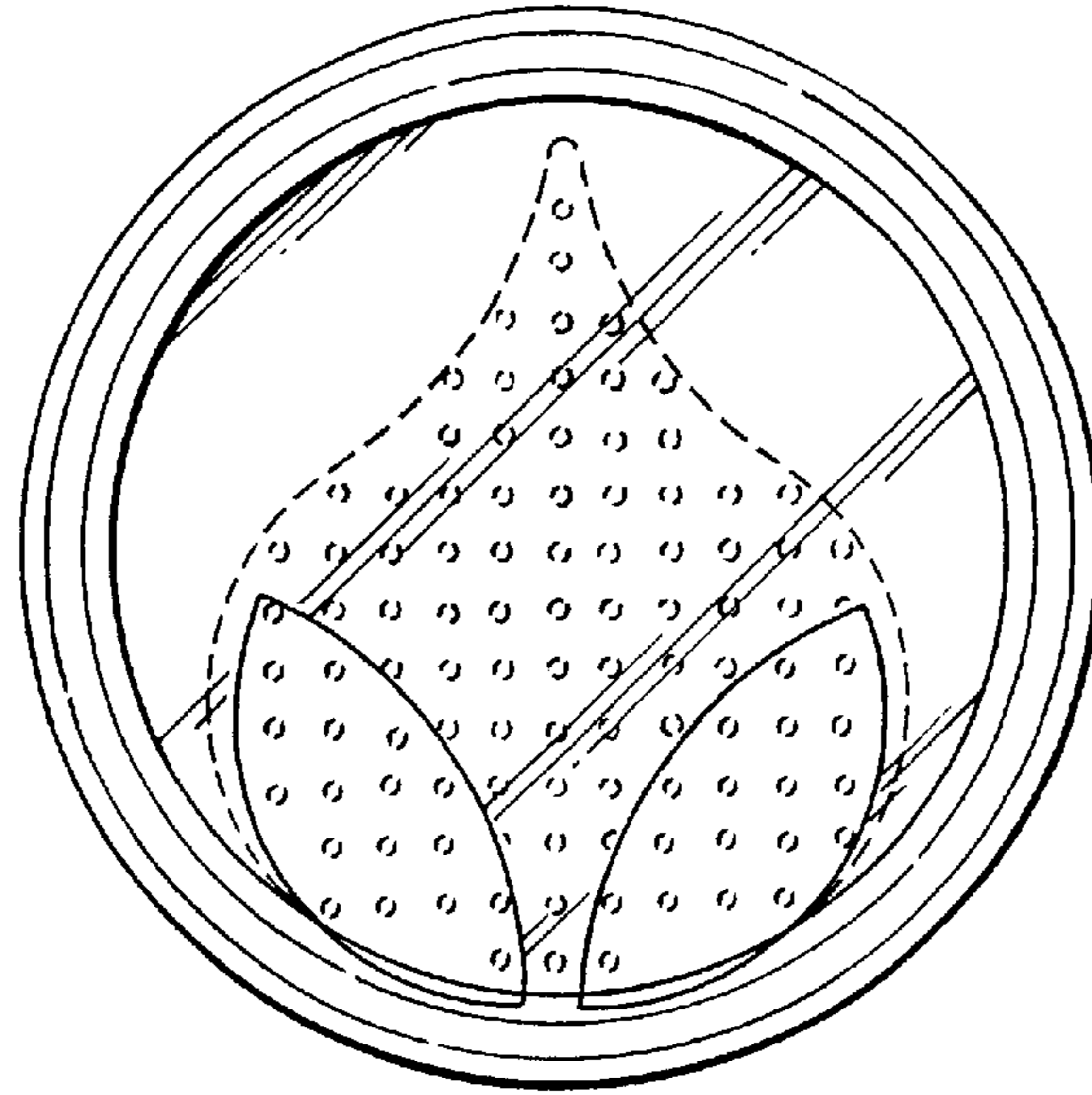

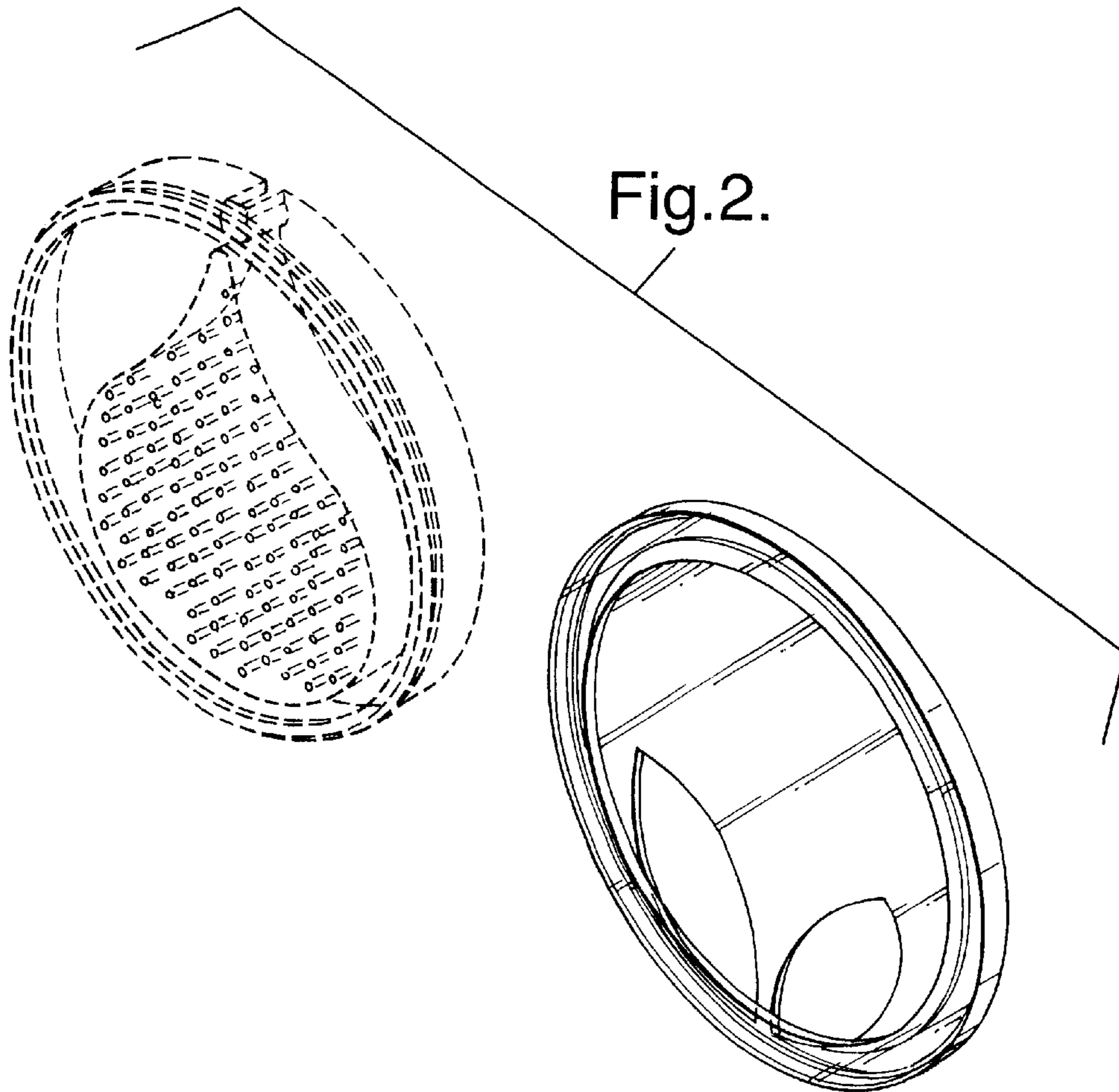

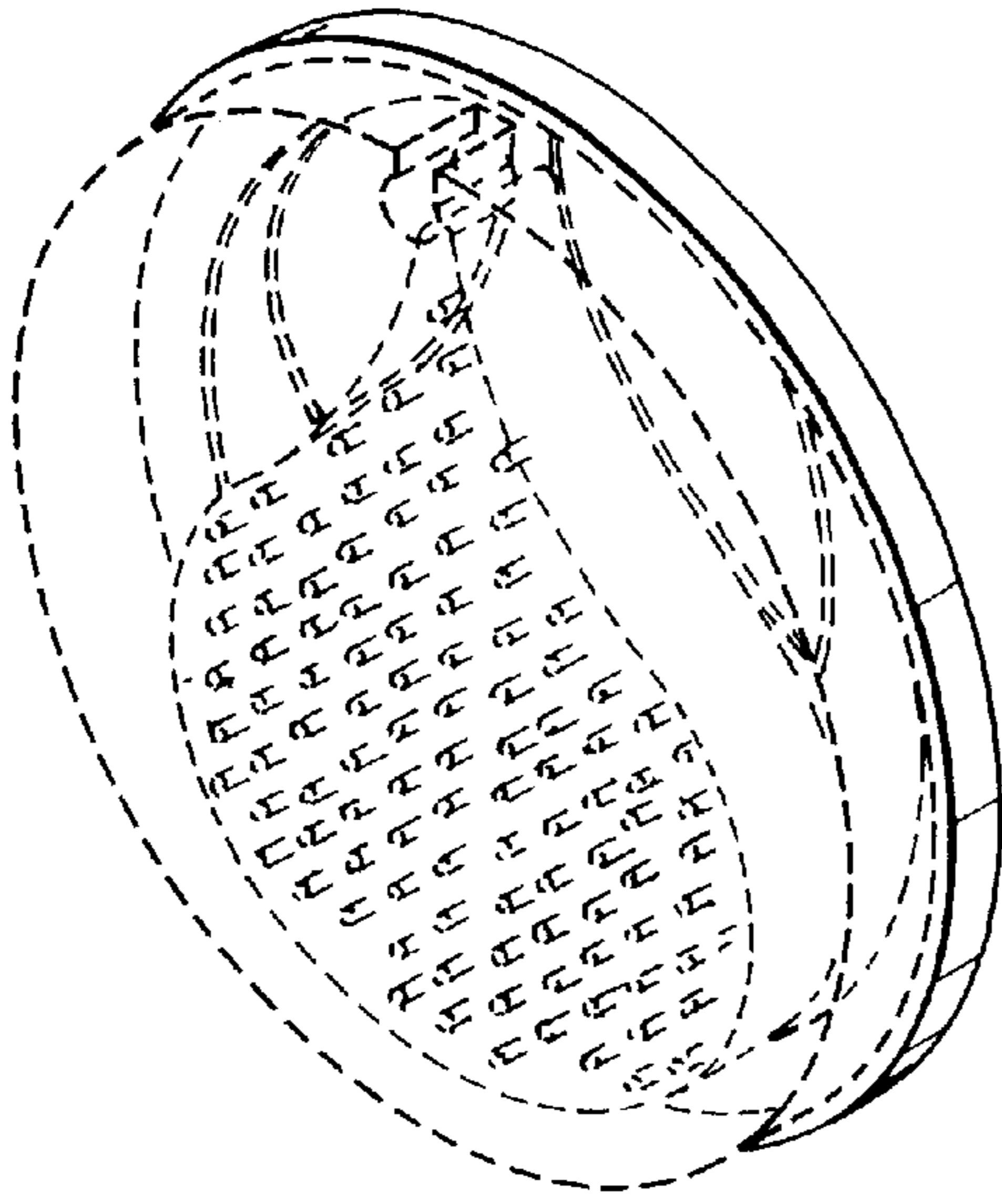

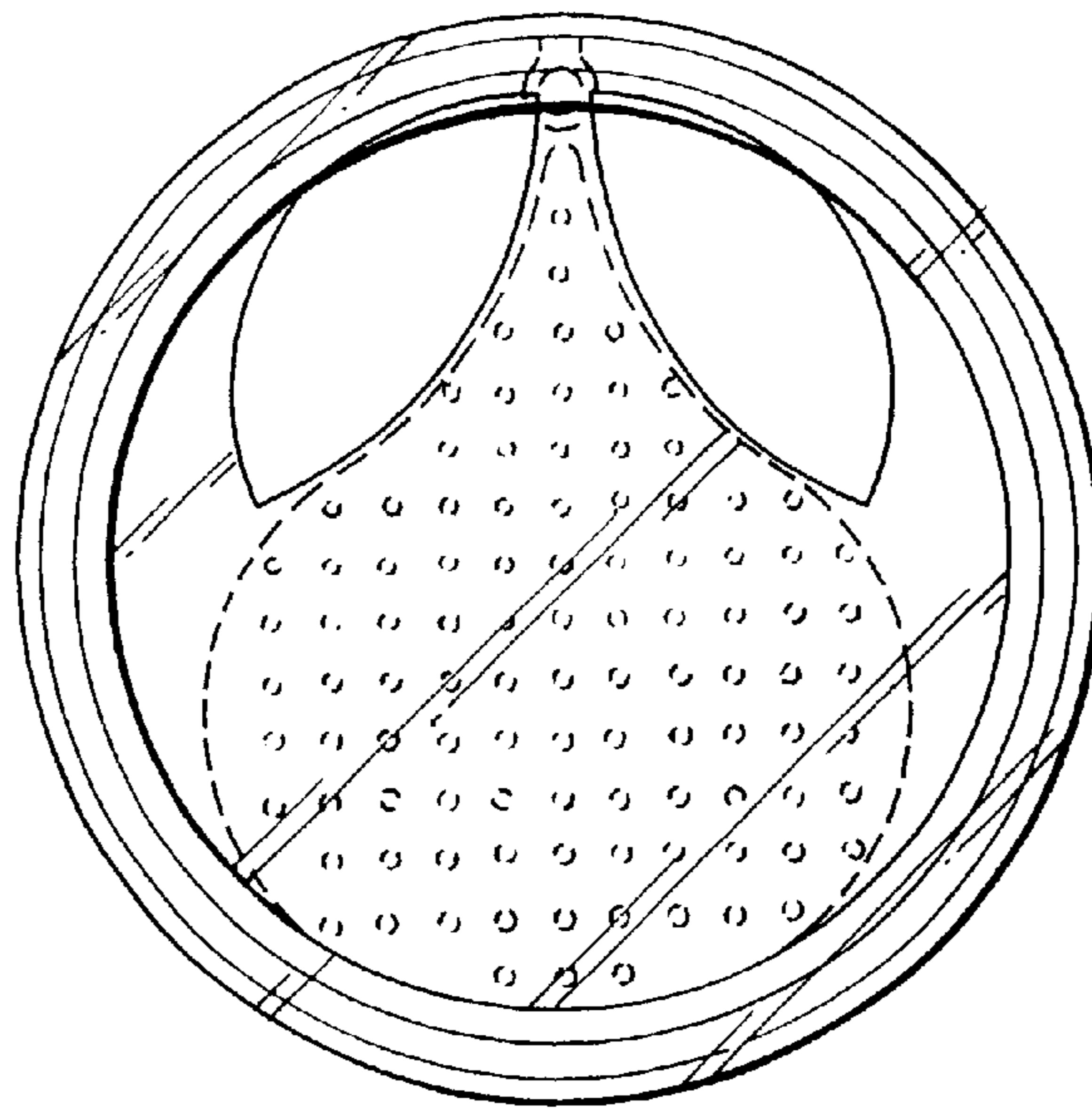
