(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for animated electroluminescent sign, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view showing the design with the transparent cover on;

FIG. 2 is a front exploded view of the design showing the transparent cover removed from the base;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the design with the transparent cover on the base;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the design with the transparent cover on the base;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the design with the transparent cover on the base;

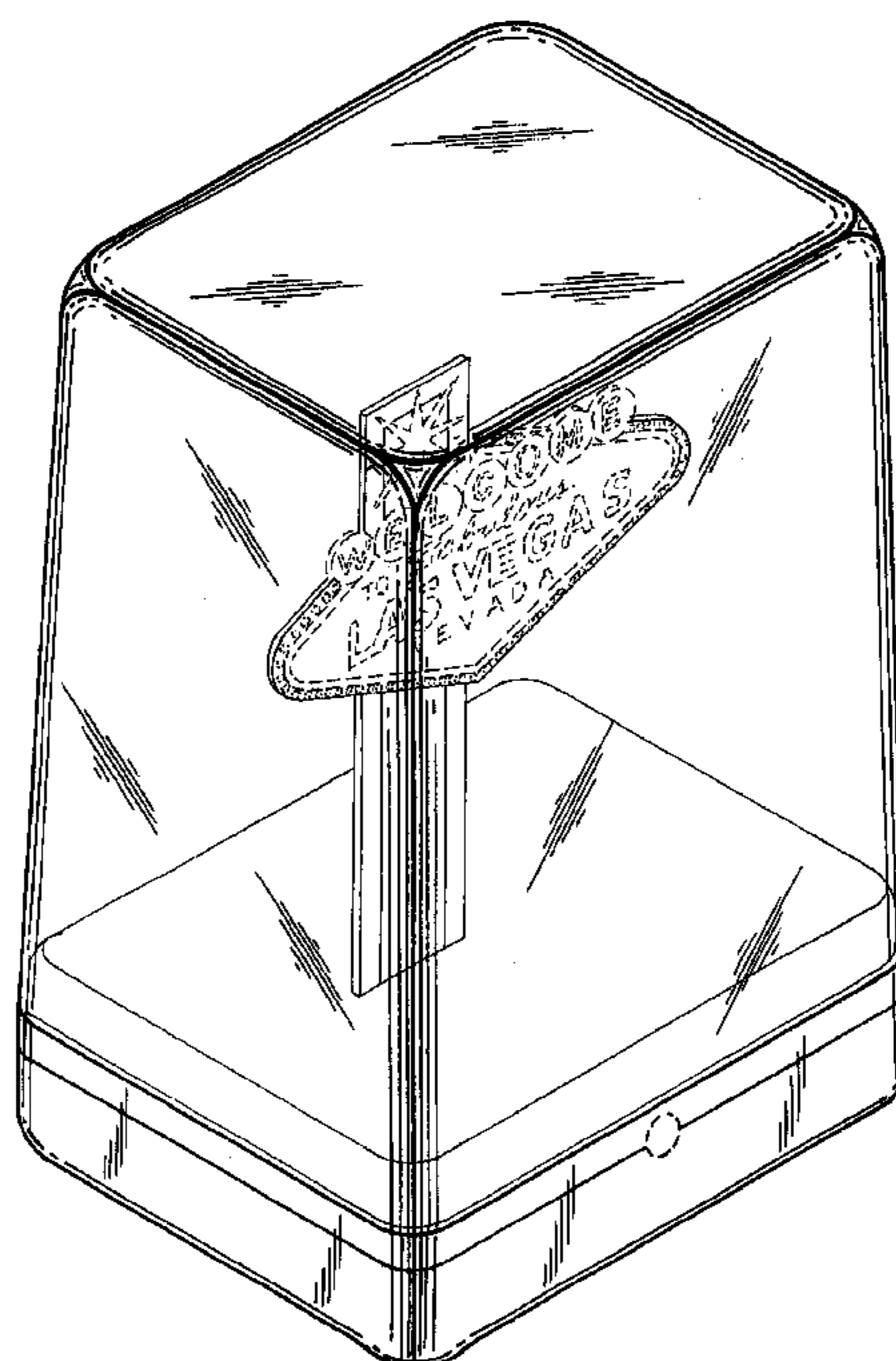
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of the design with the transparent cover on the base;

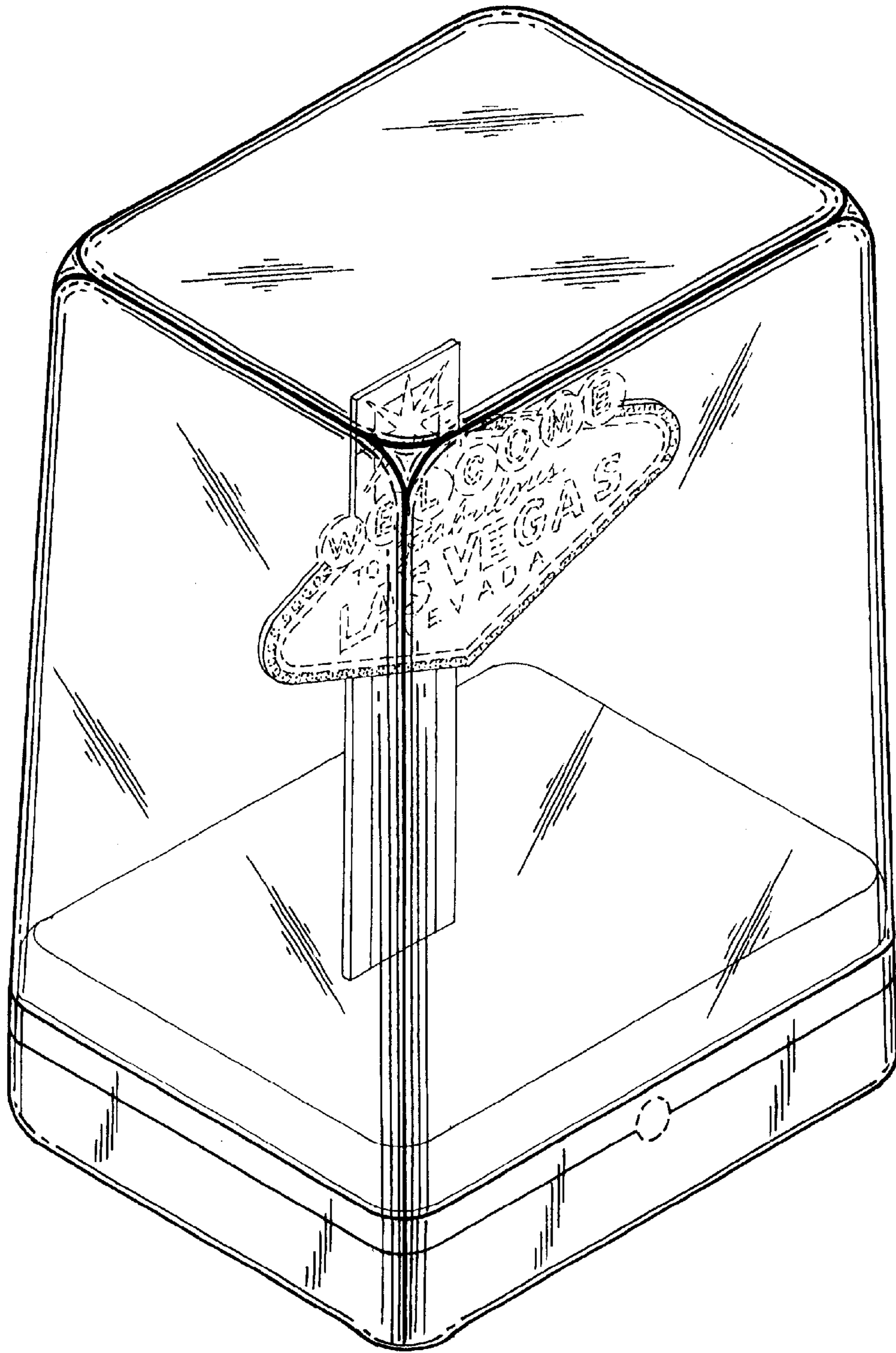

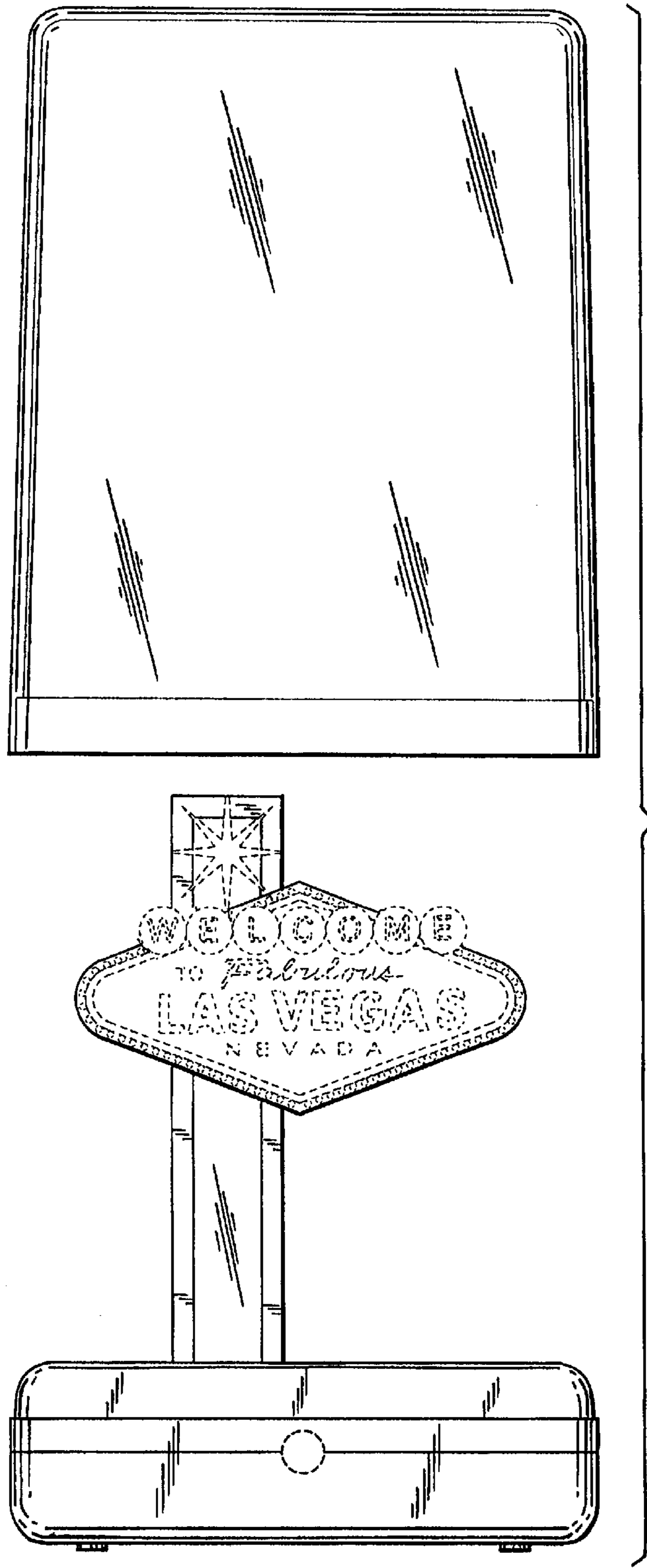

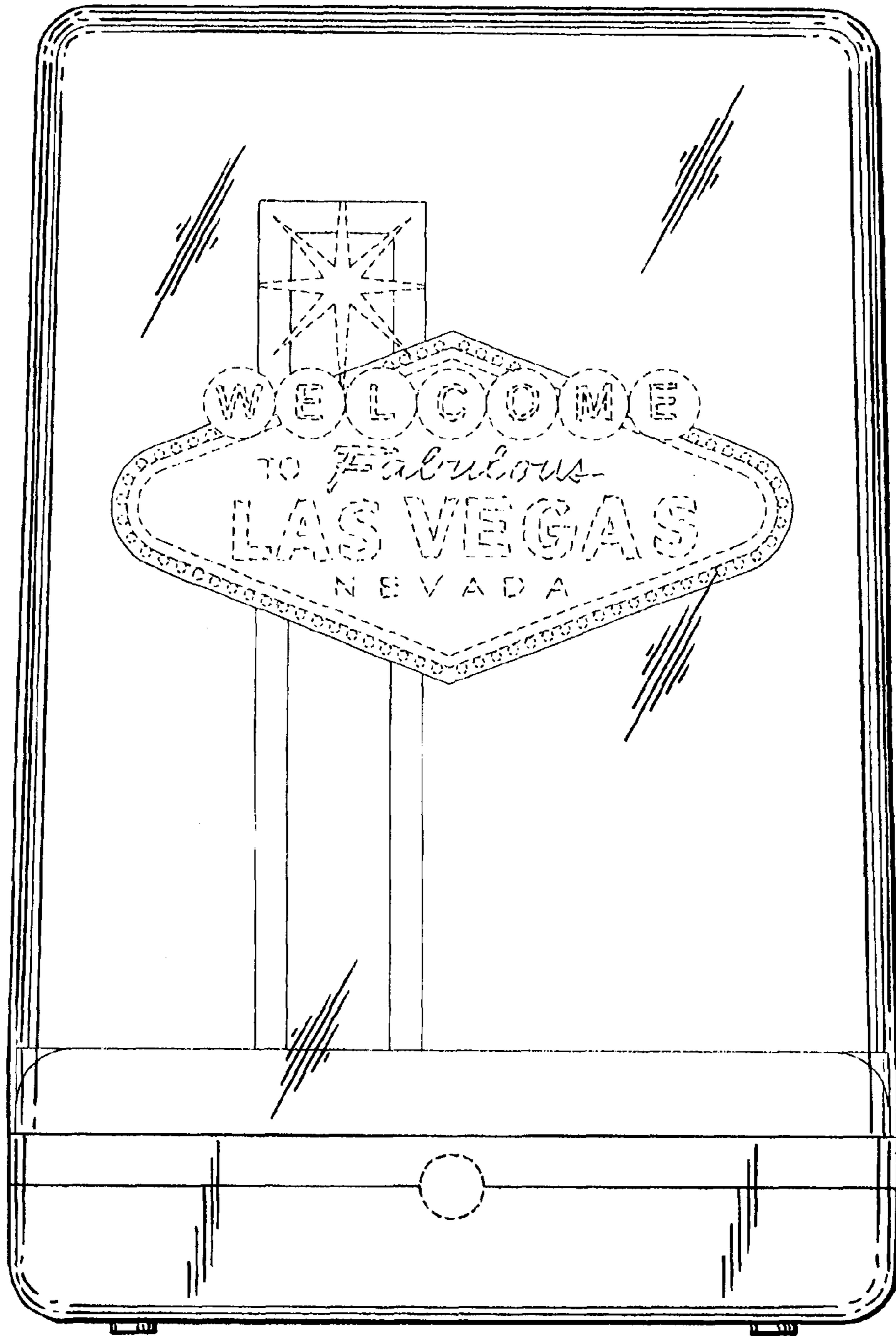

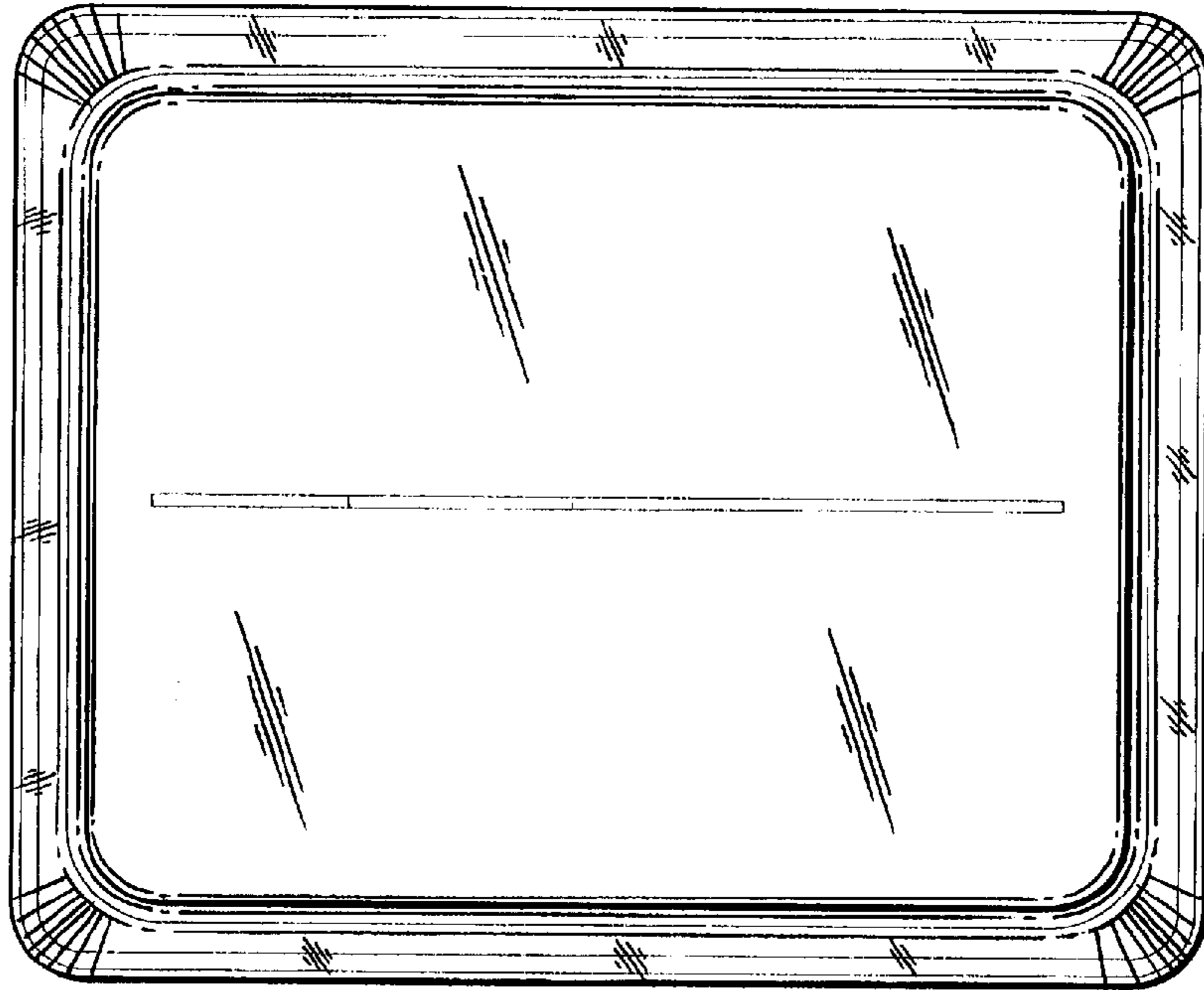

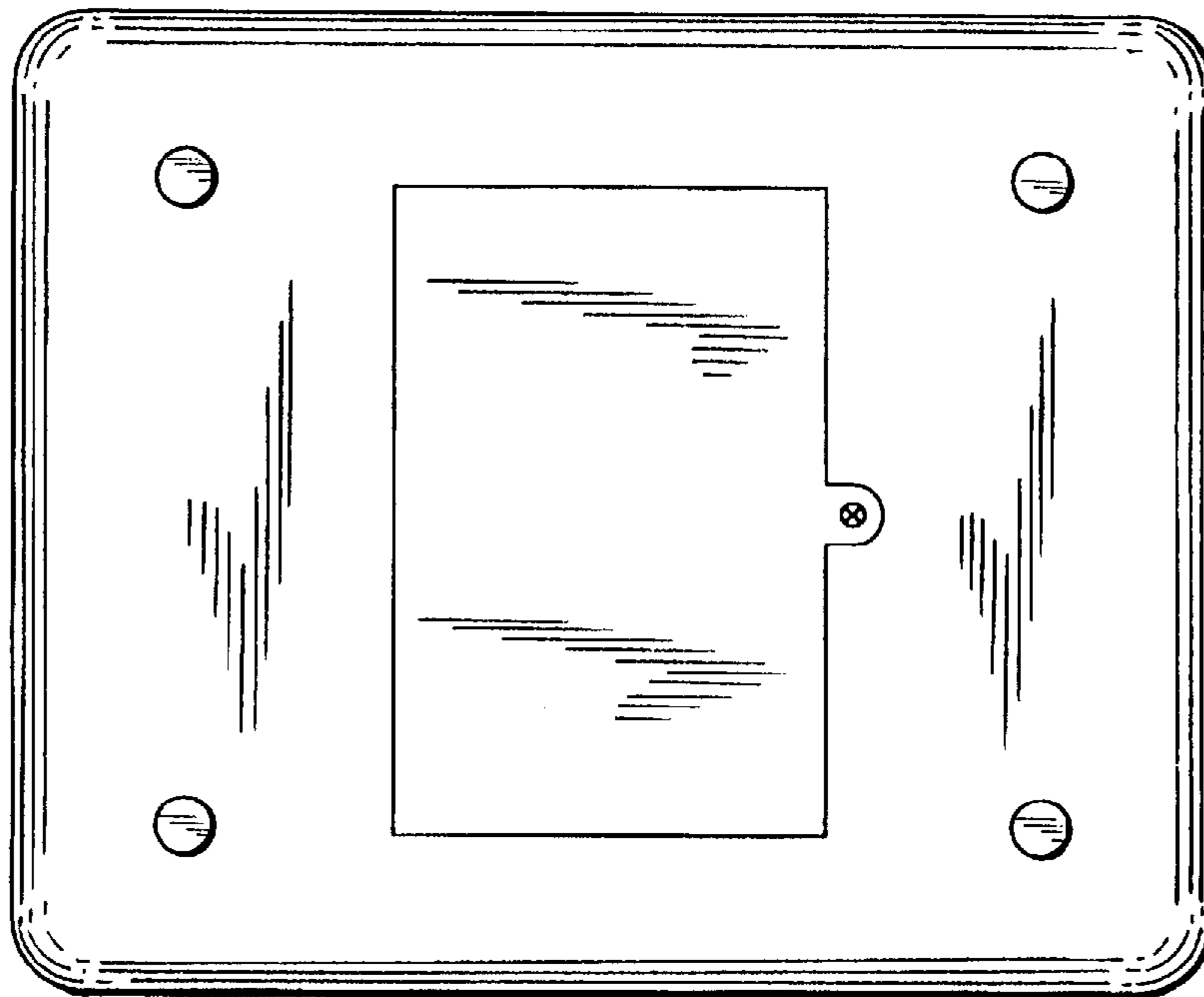

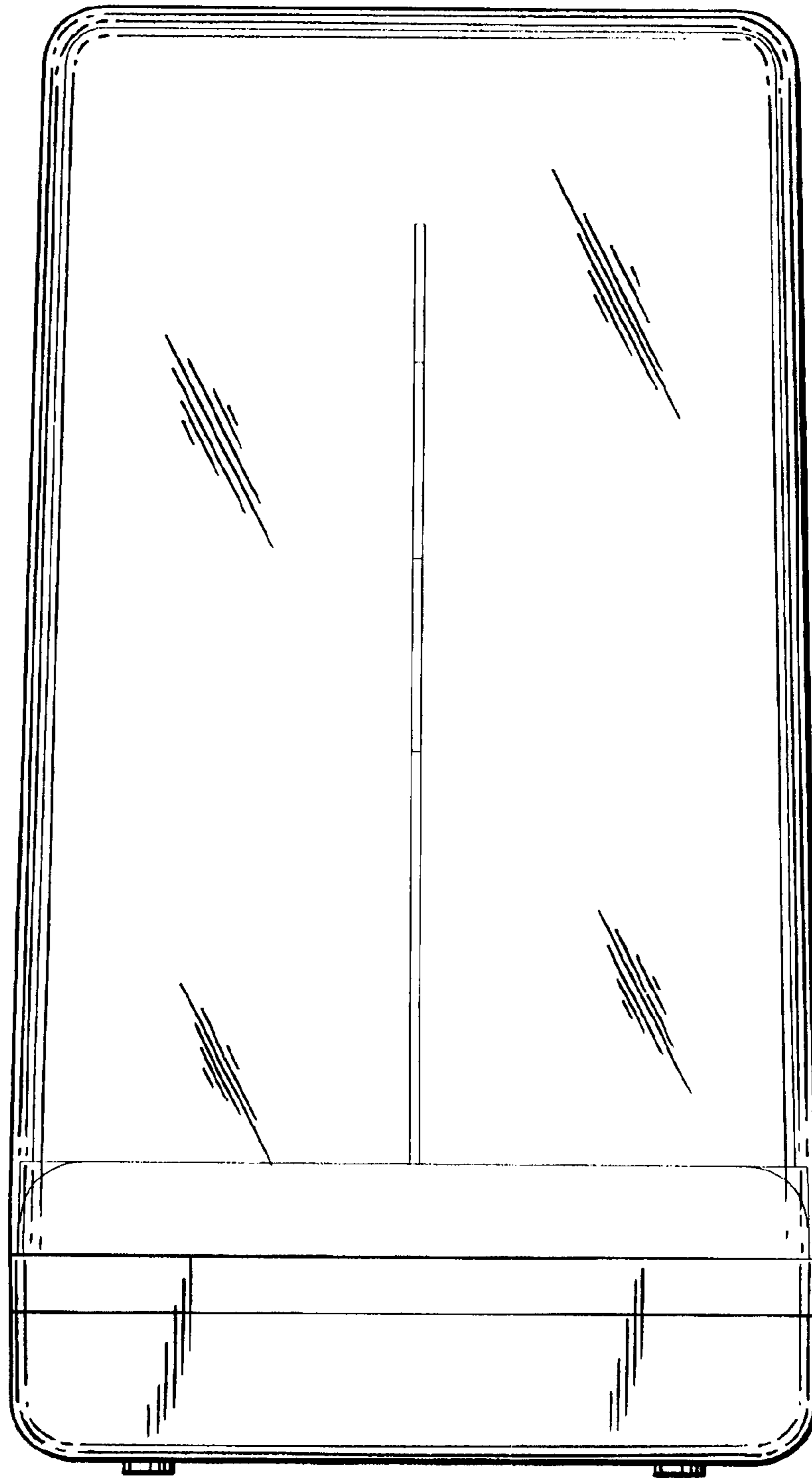

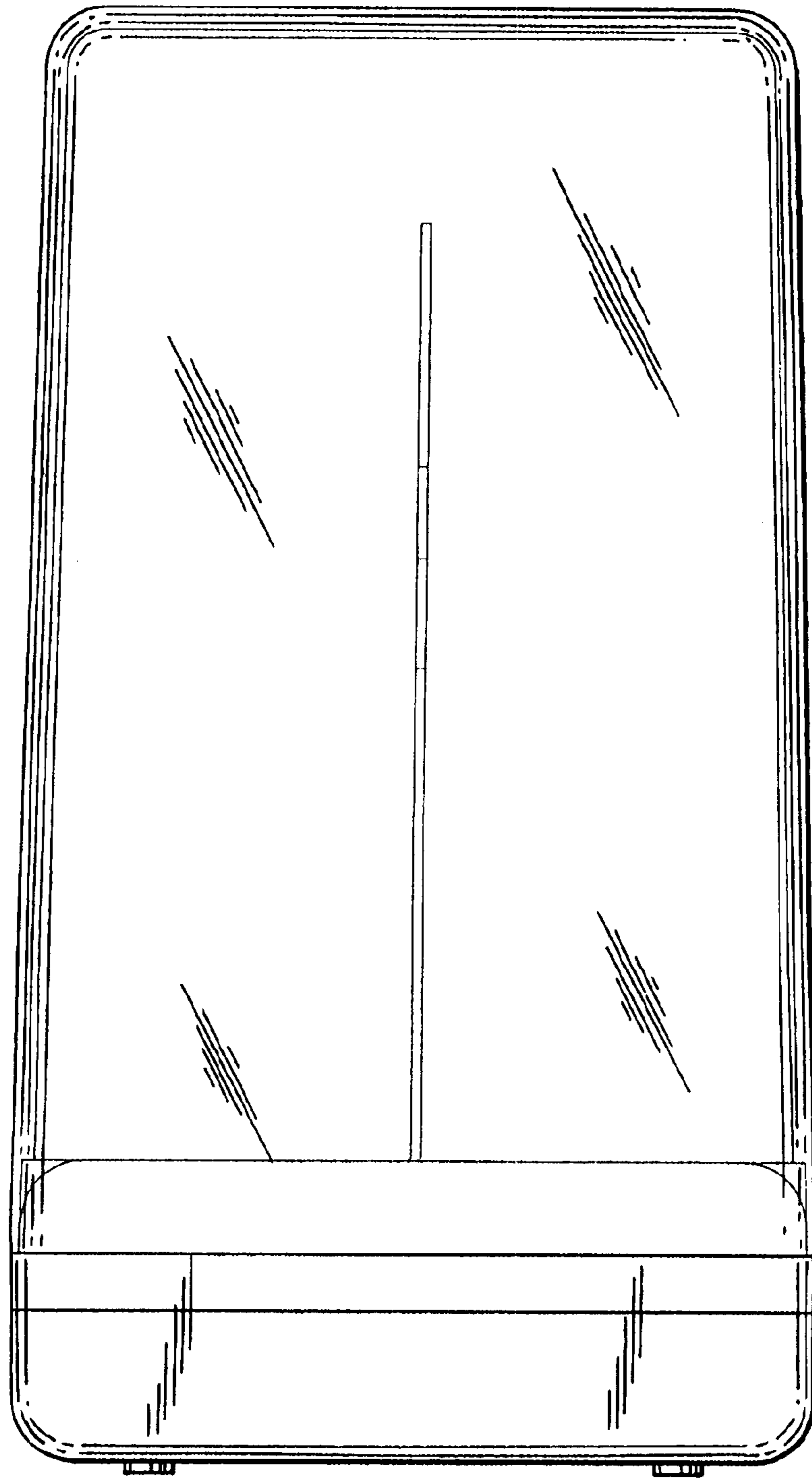

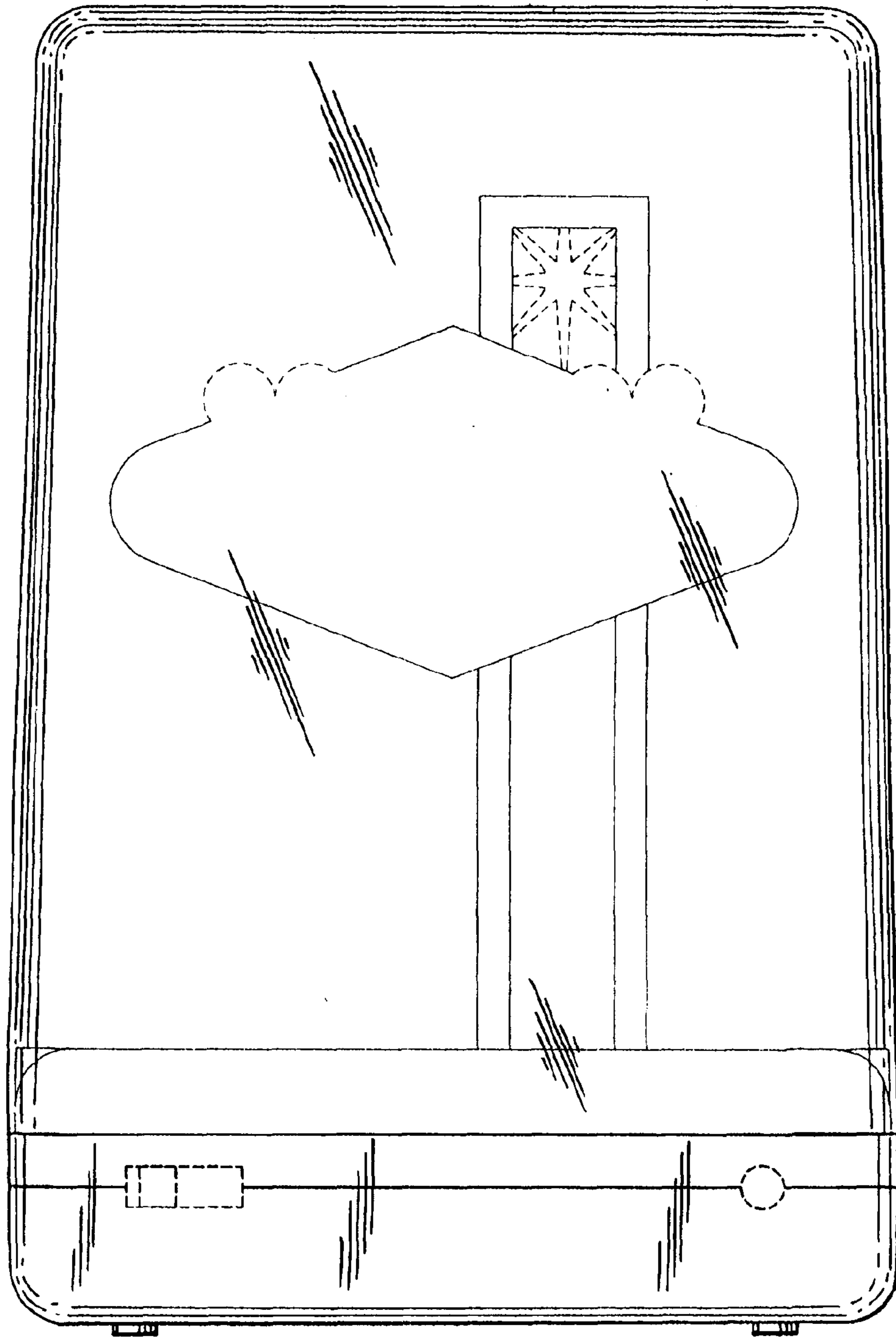
