(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handheld electronic device holder for exercise machines, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a handheld electronic device holder for exercise machines showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

FIG. 9 is a bottom perspective view thereof.

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view thereof.

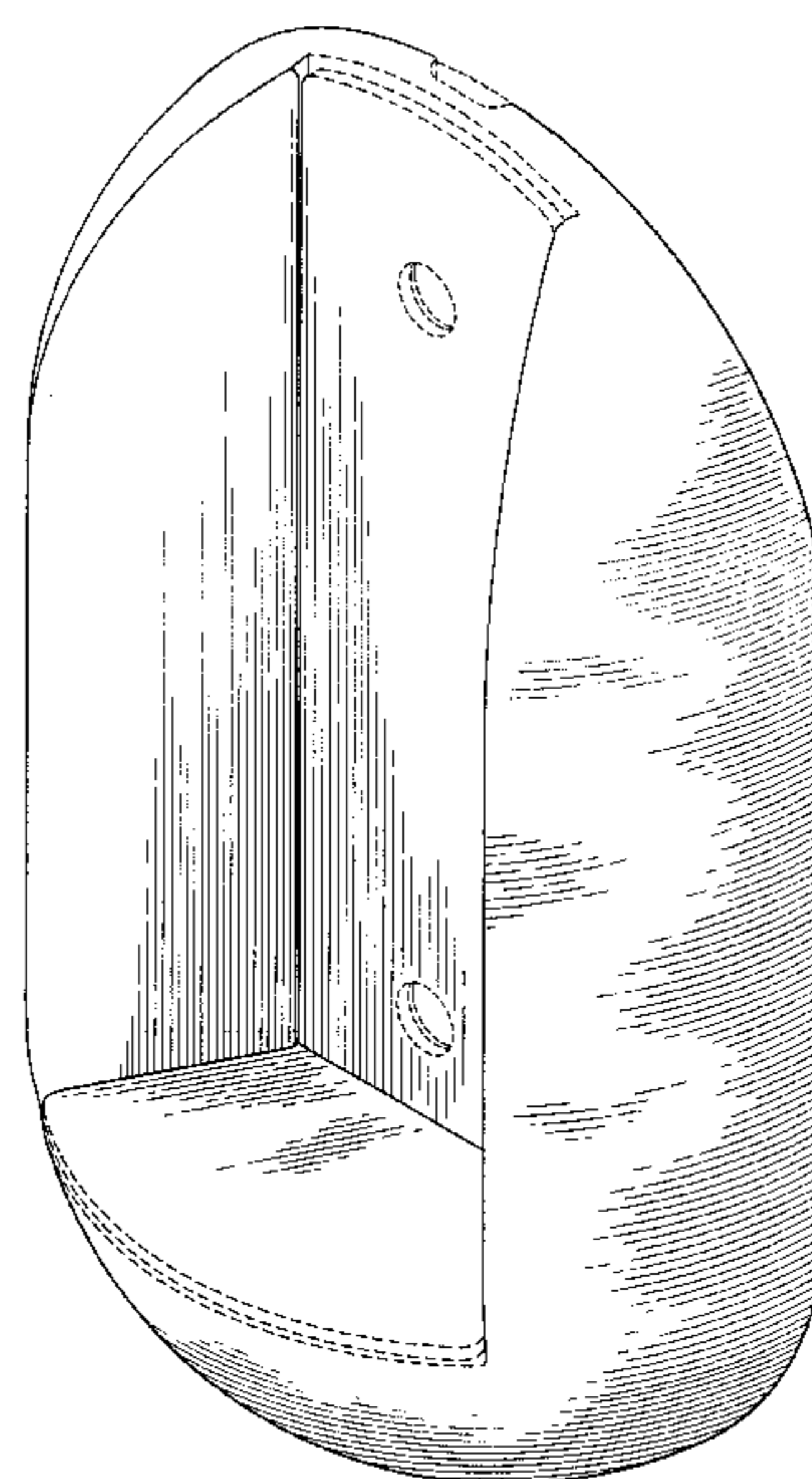
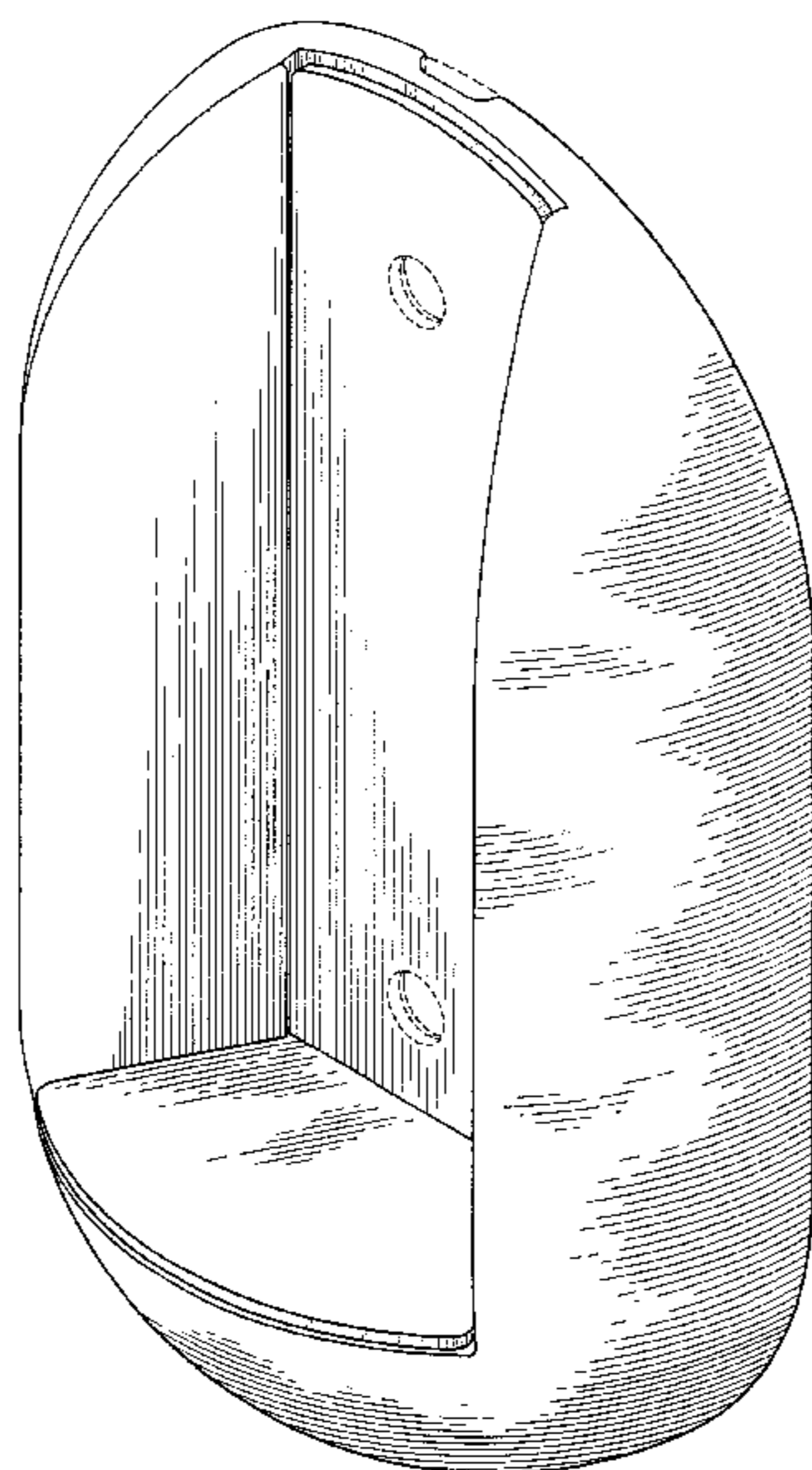
FIG. 12 is a front elevational view thereof.

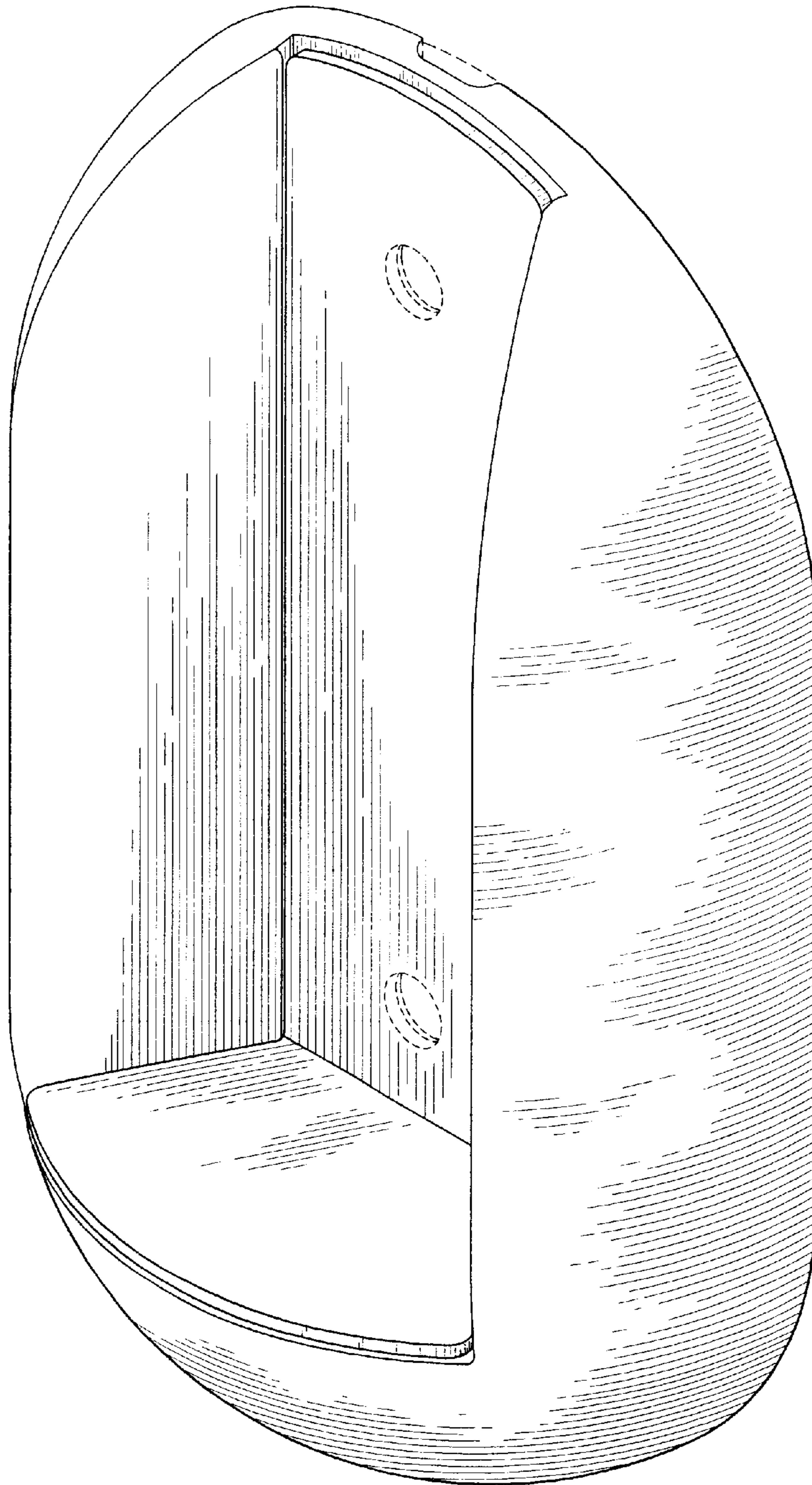

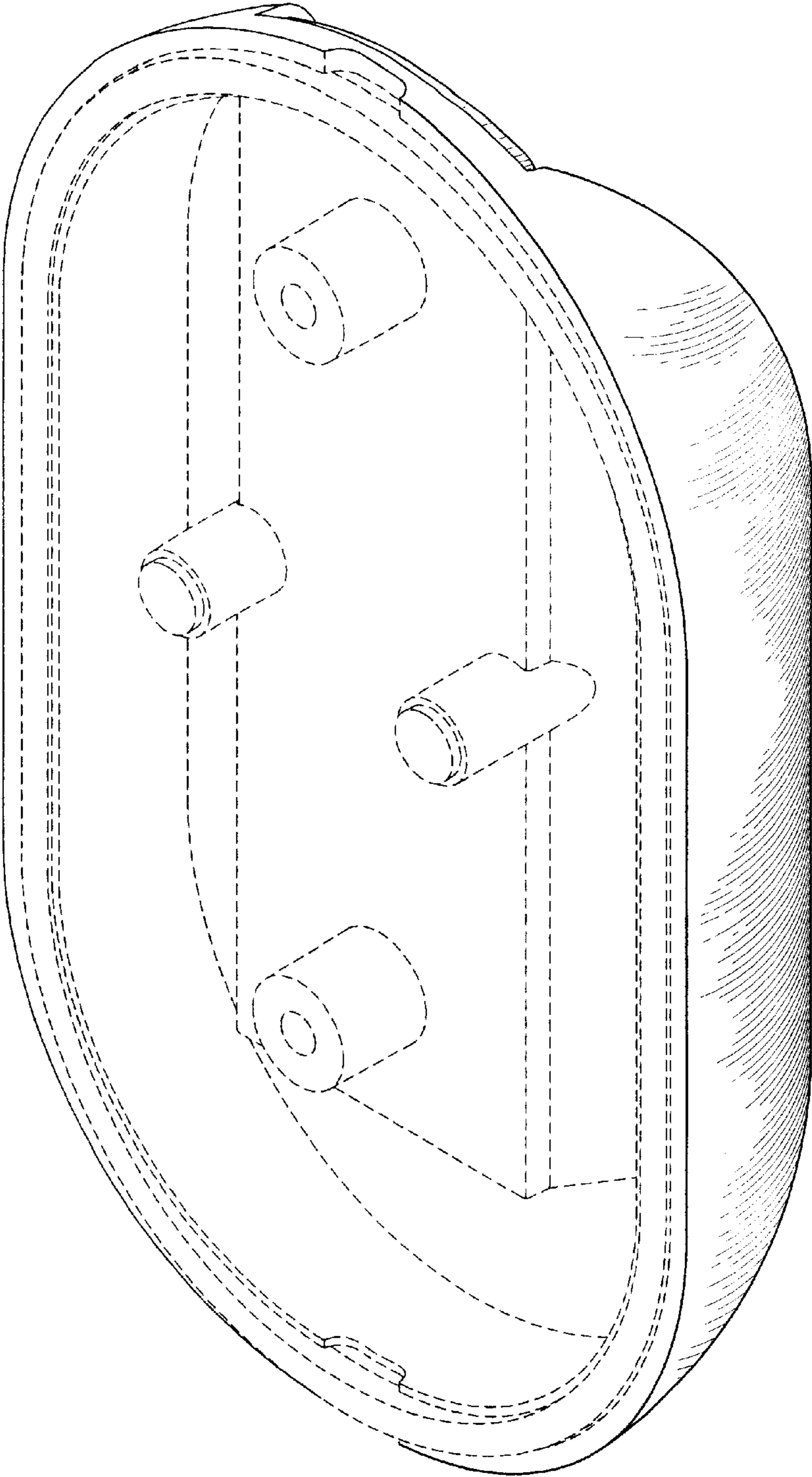

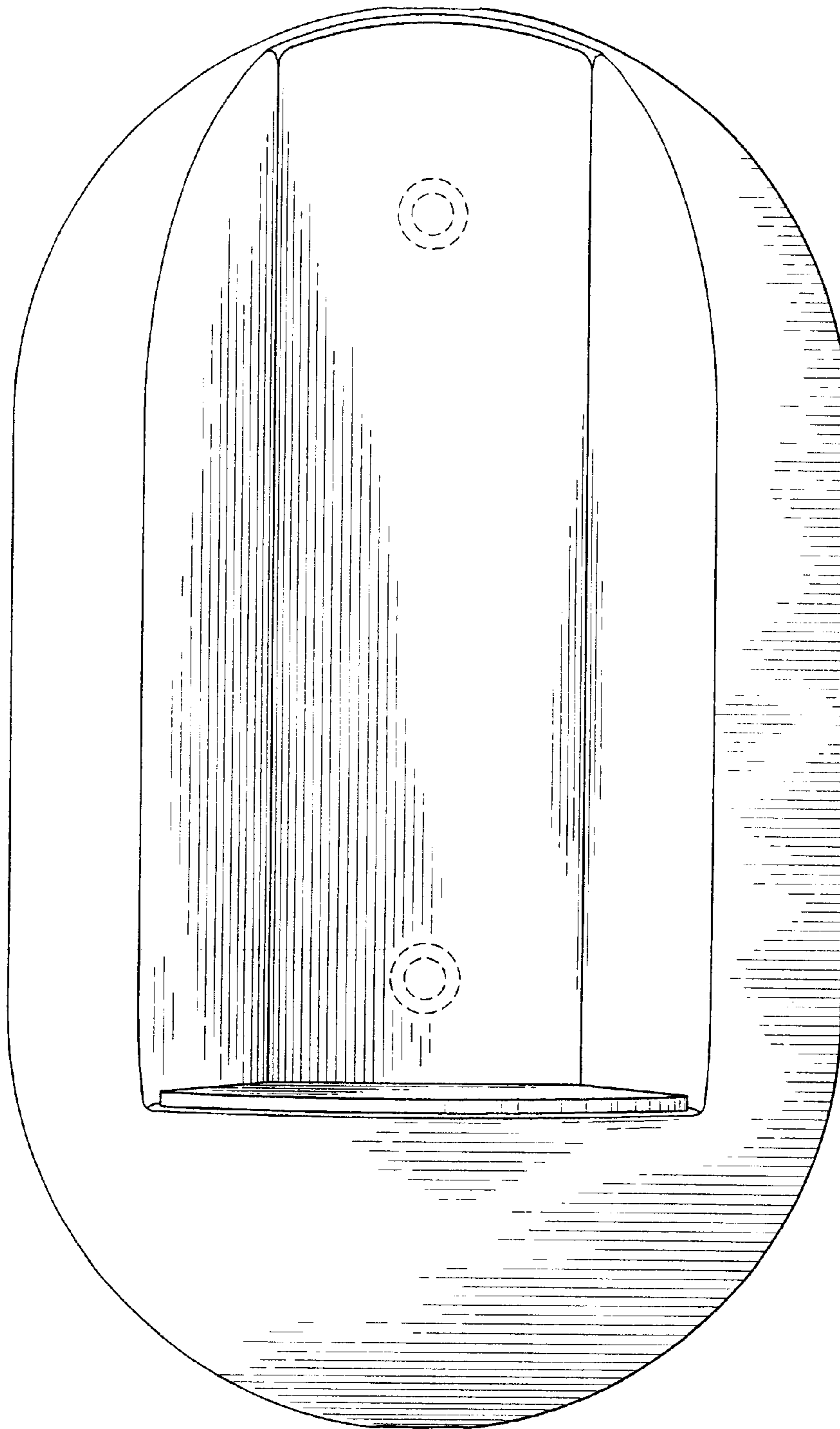

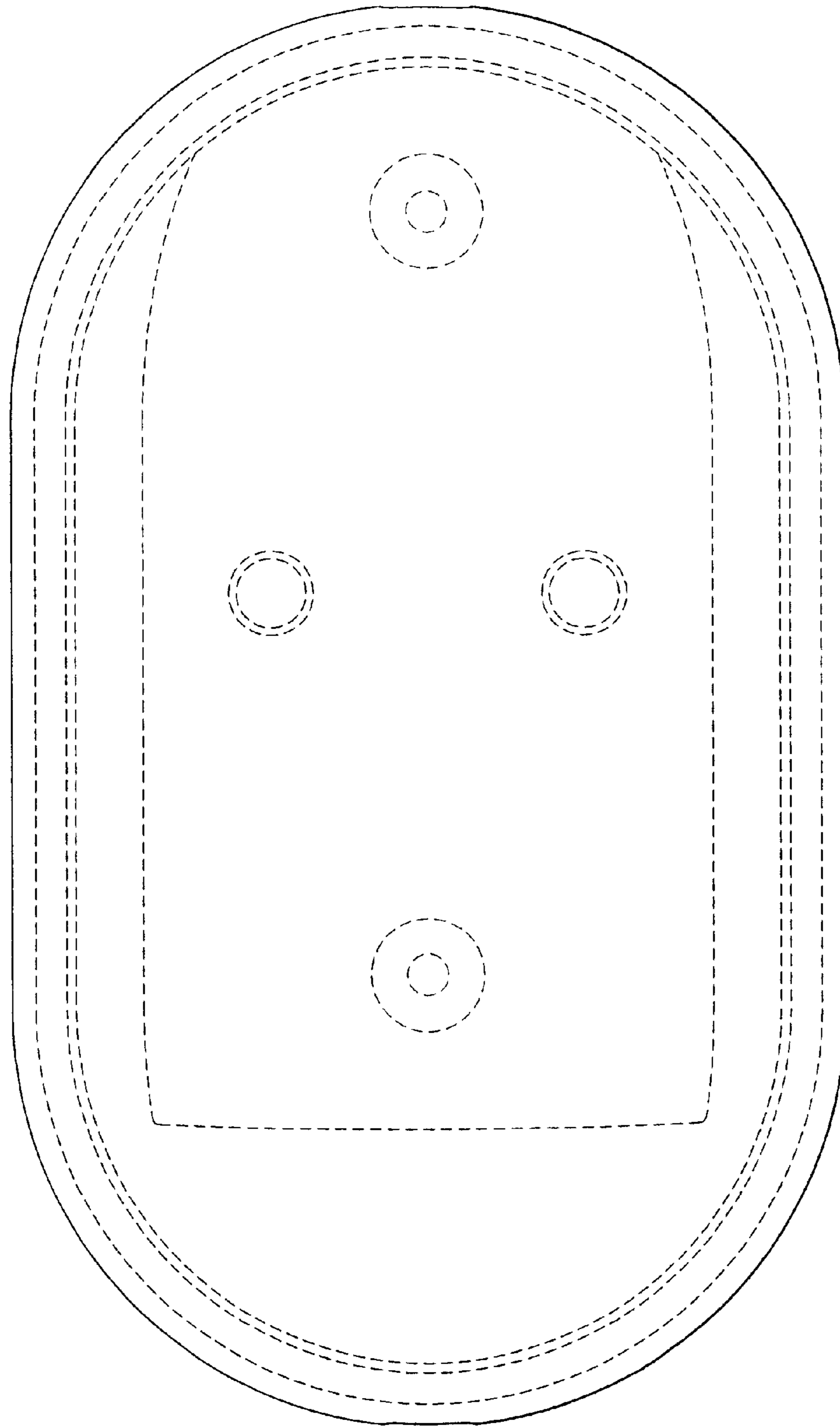

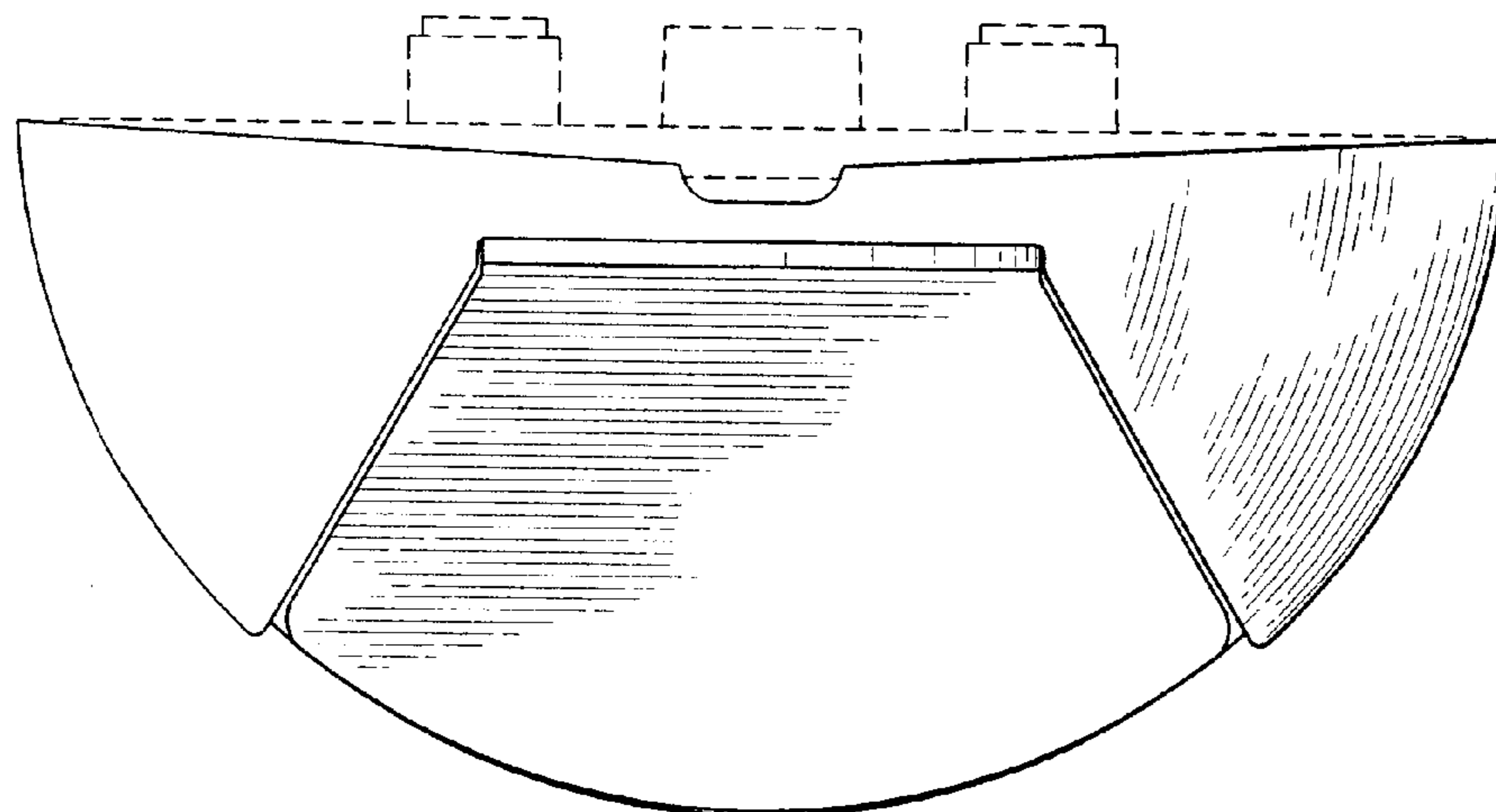

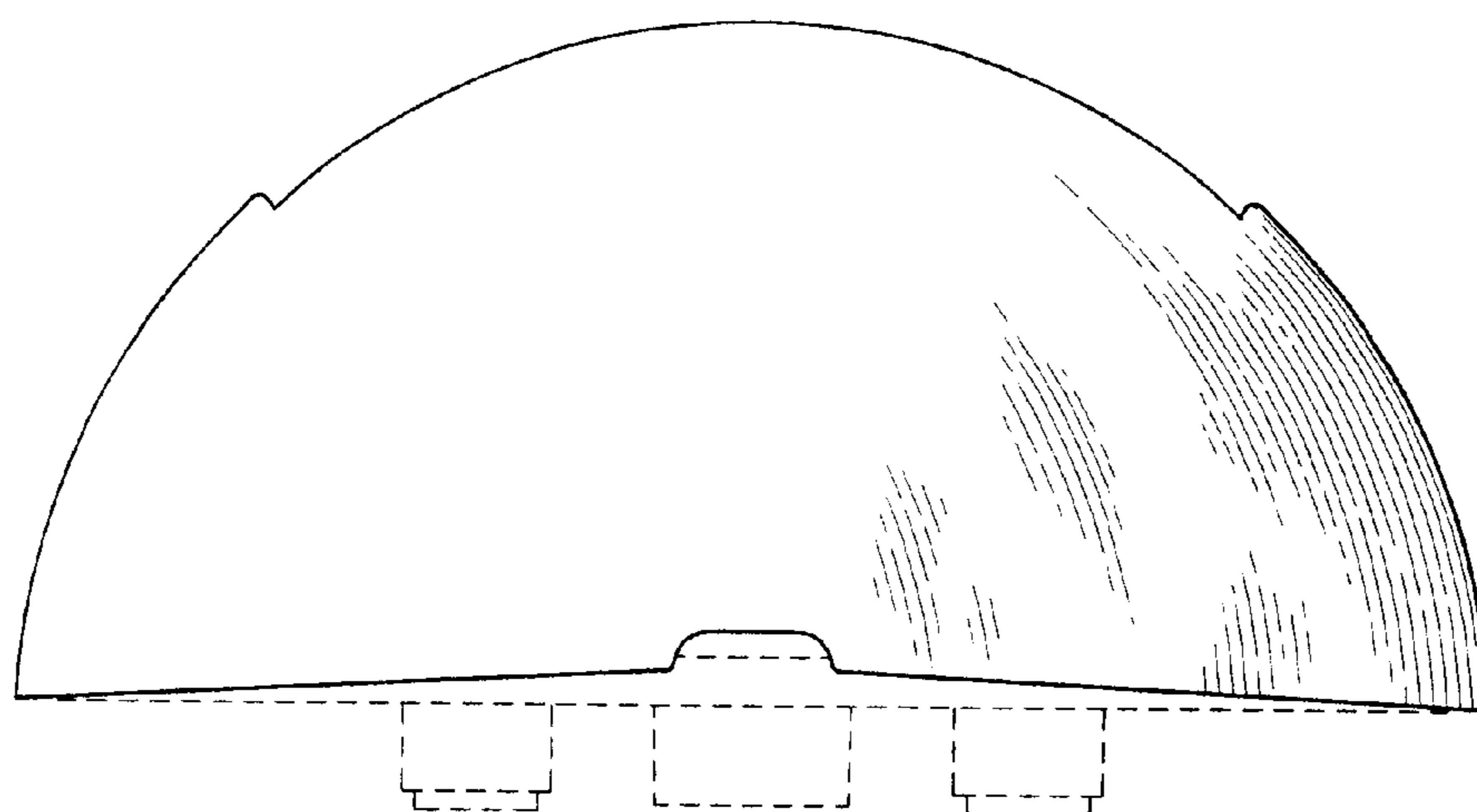

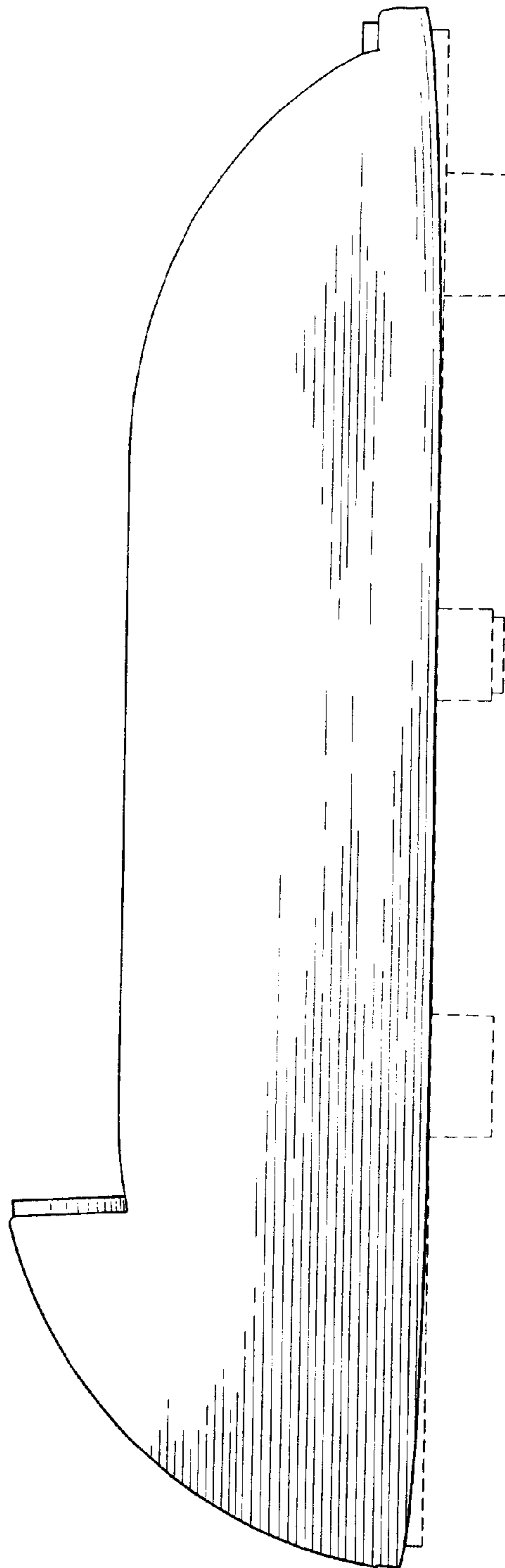

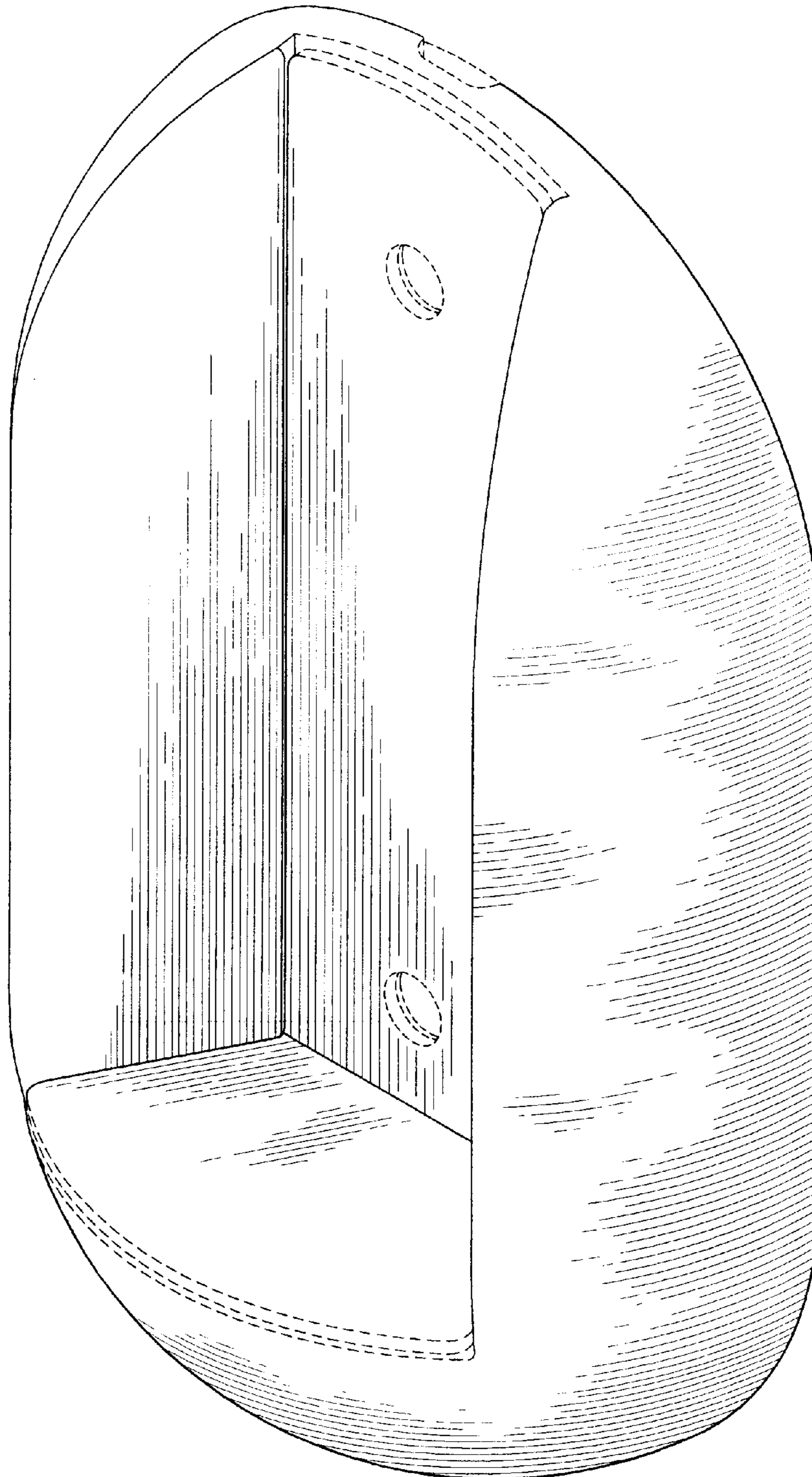

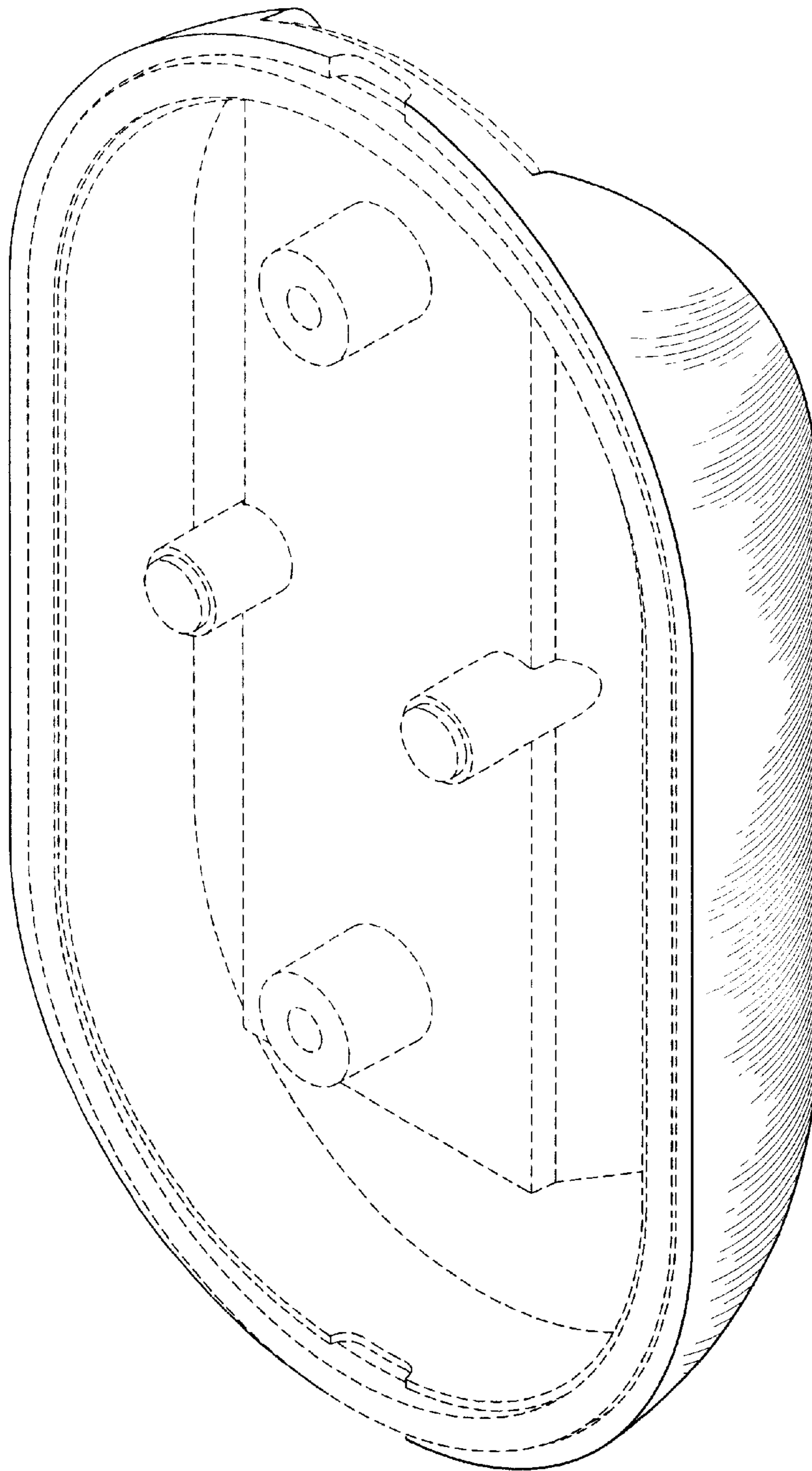

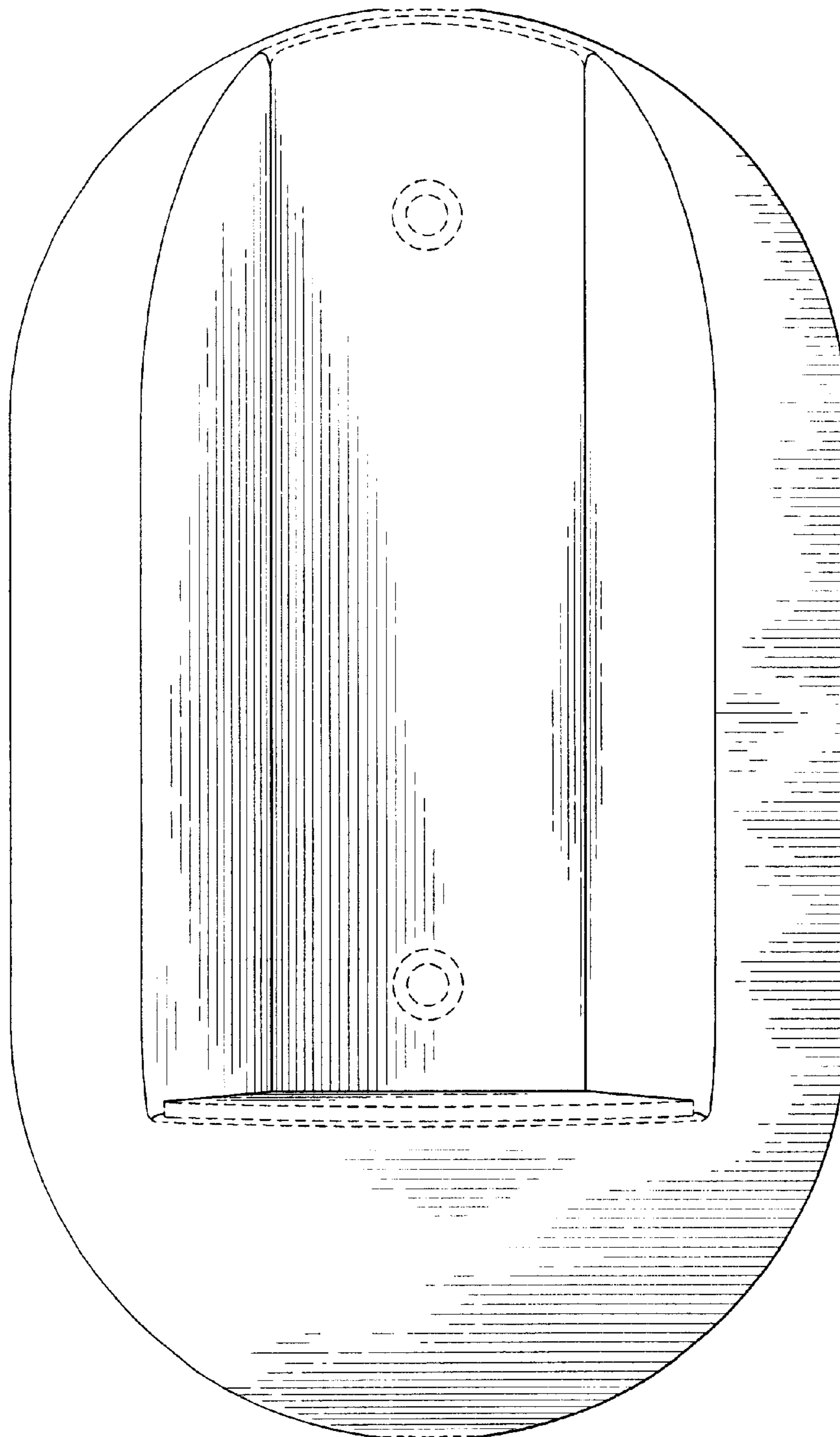

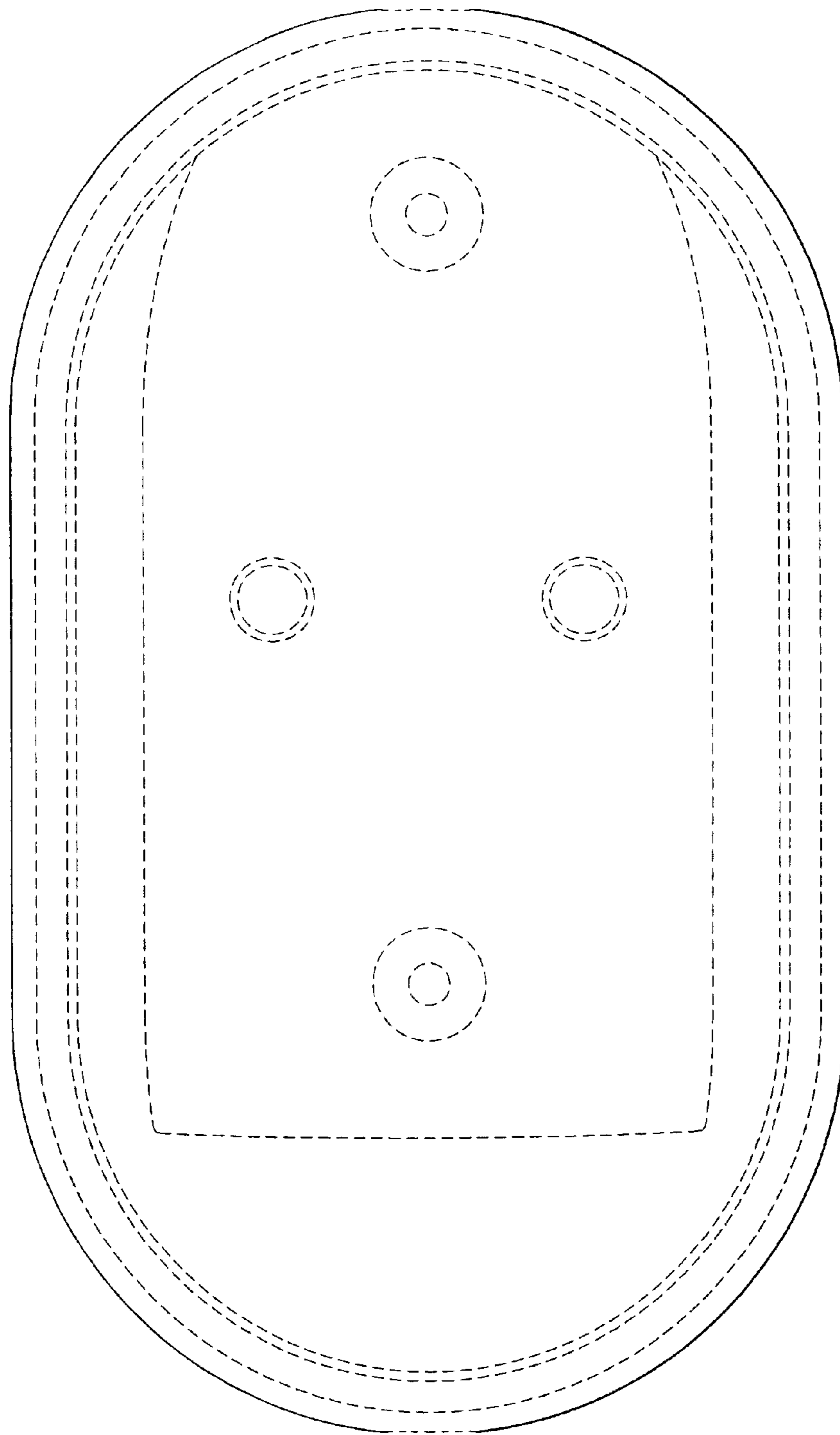

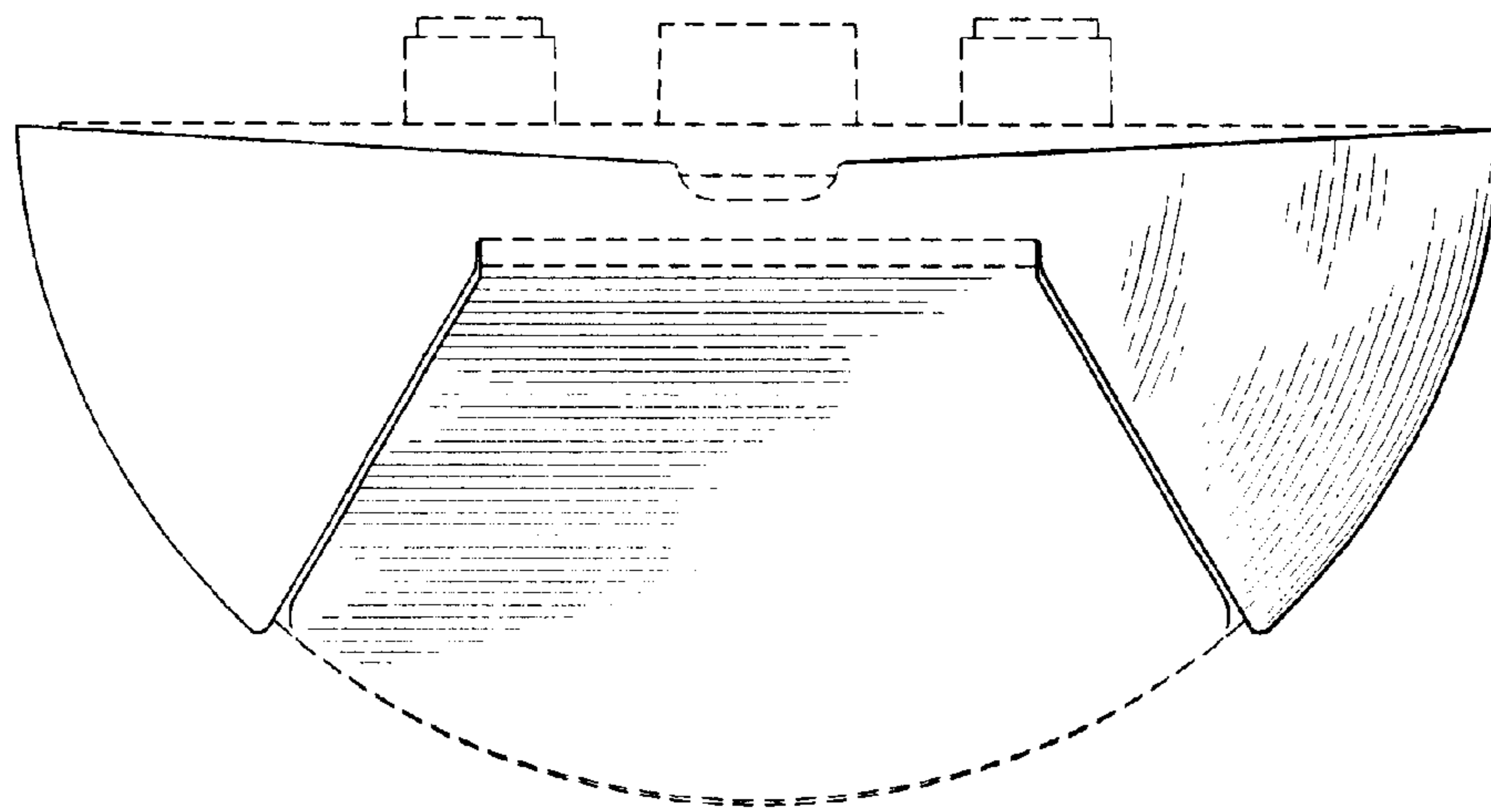

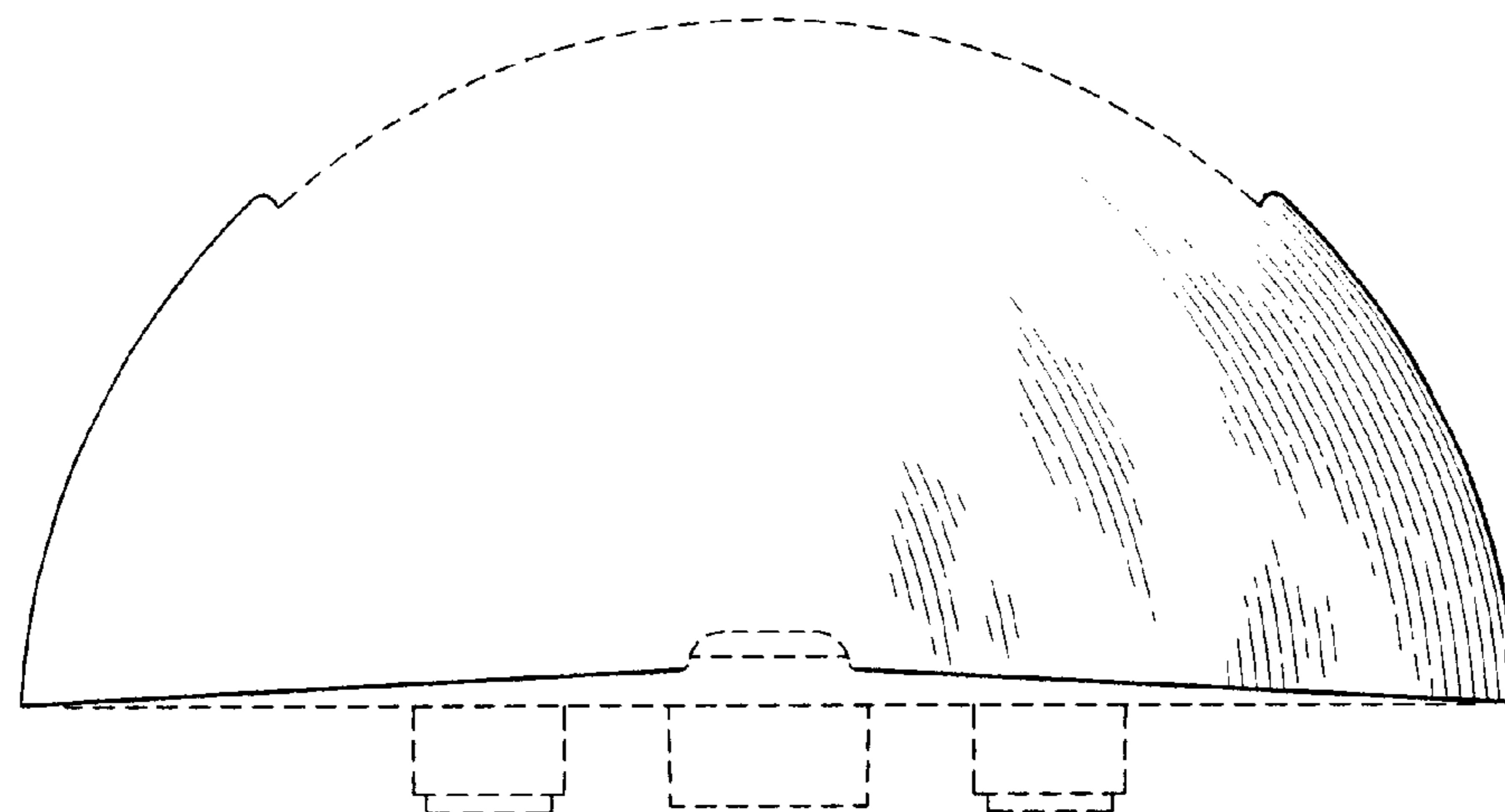

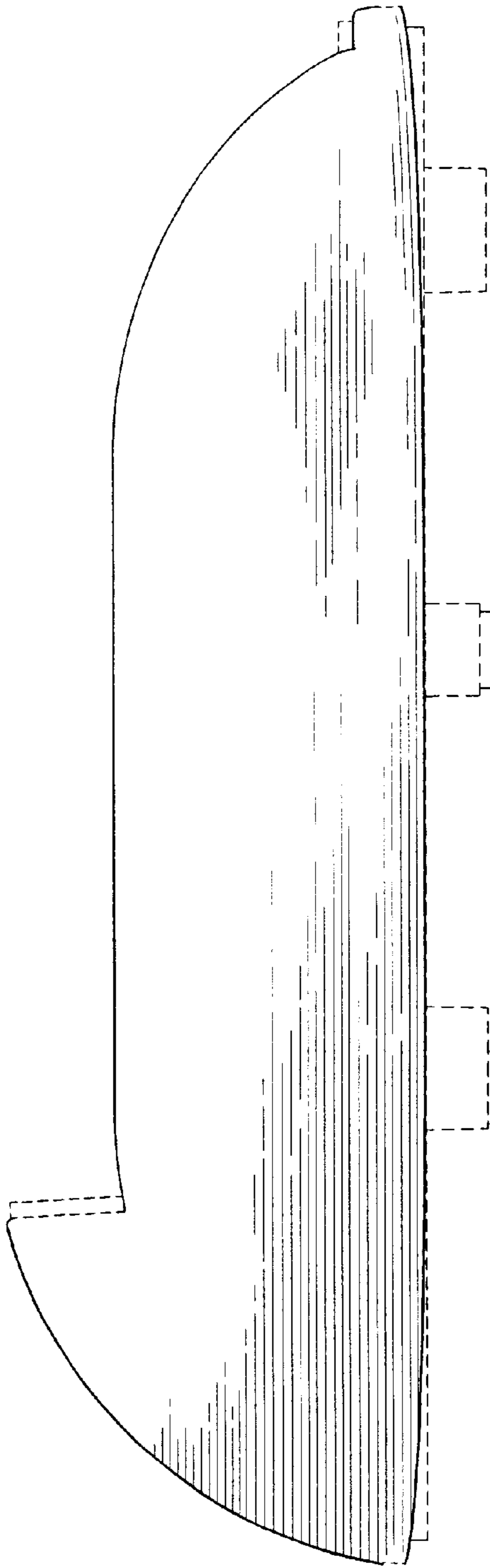
