FIG. 5 is an enlarged front elevation view thereof;

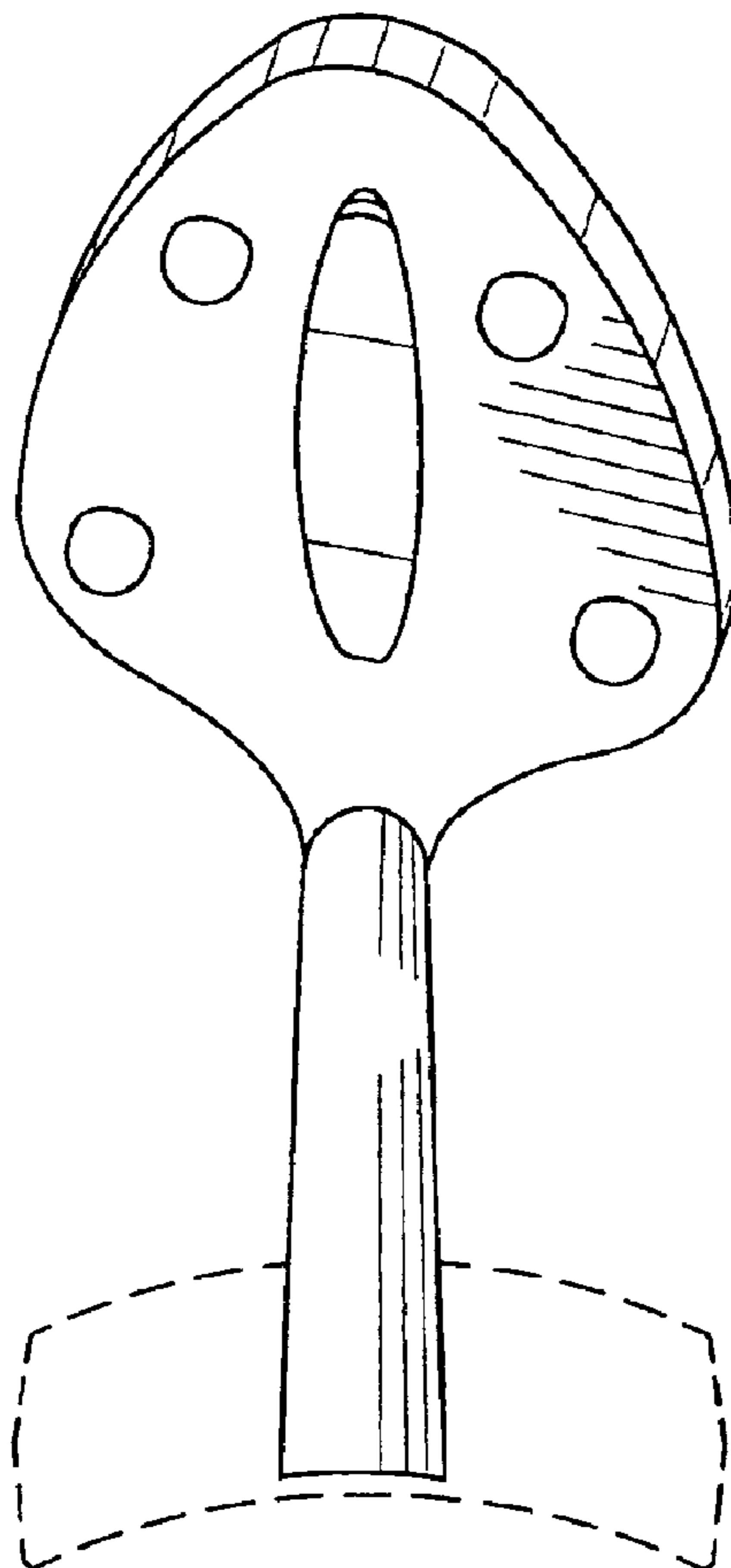
FIG. 6 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

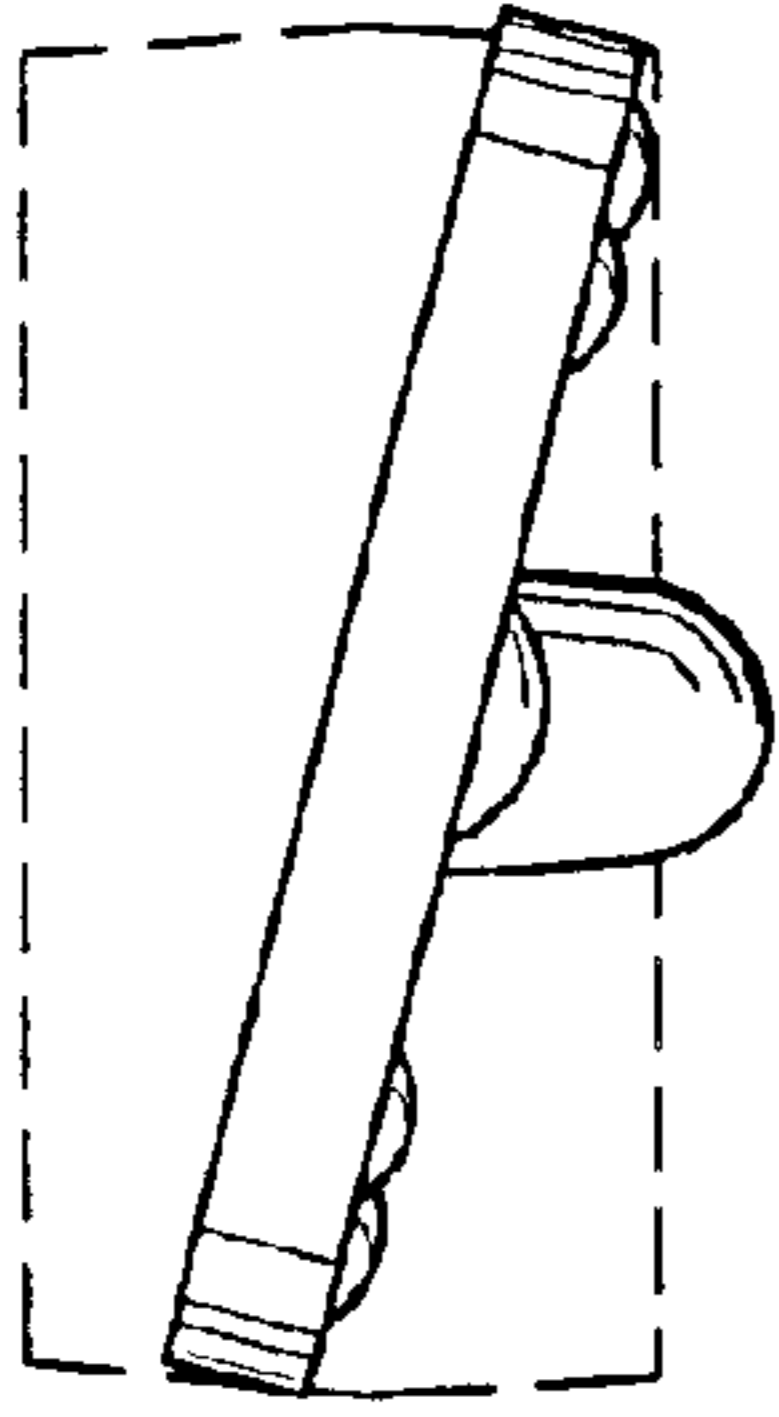

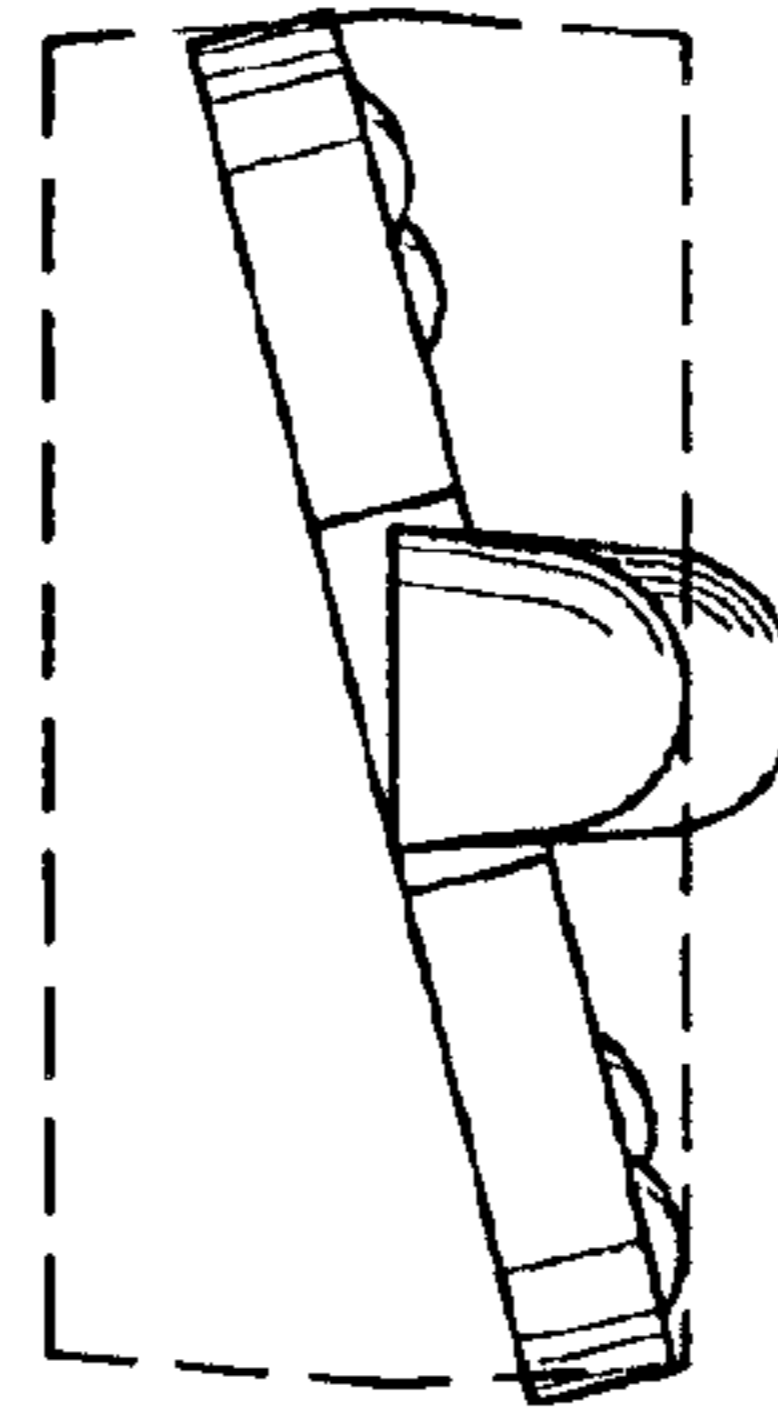

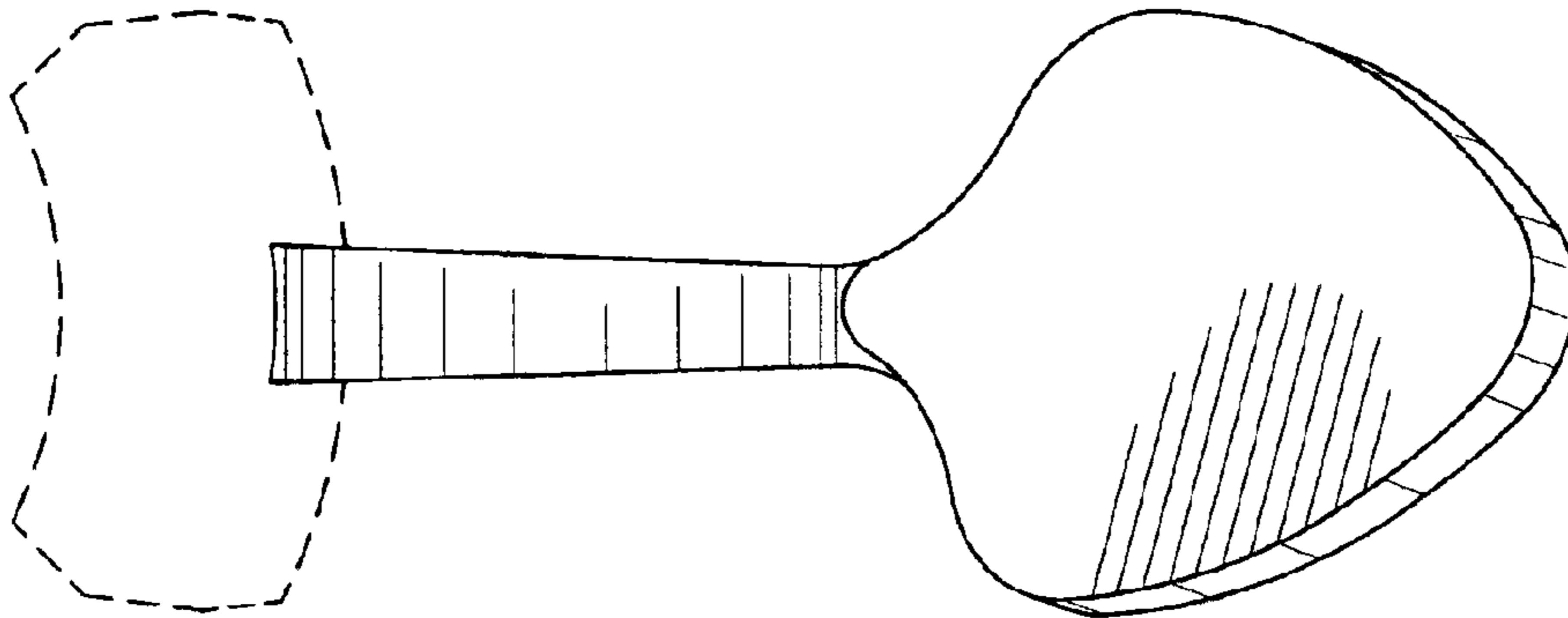

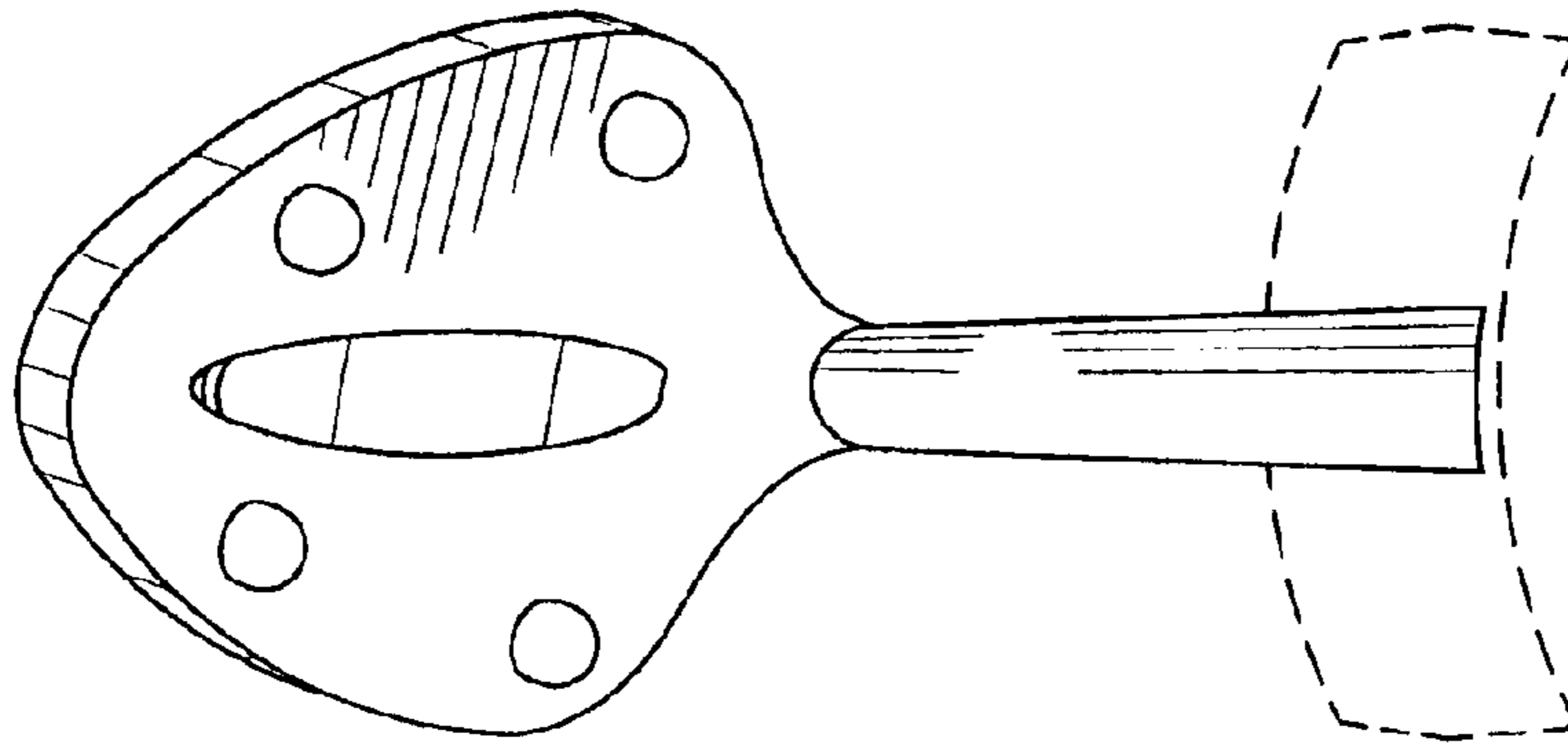

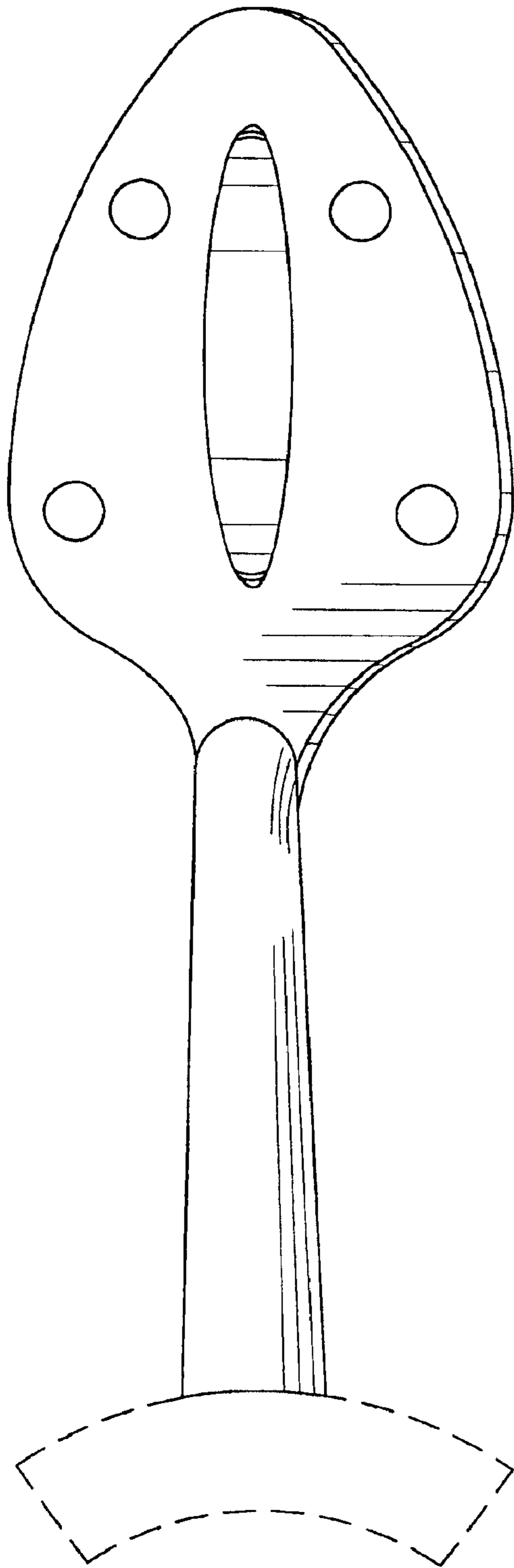

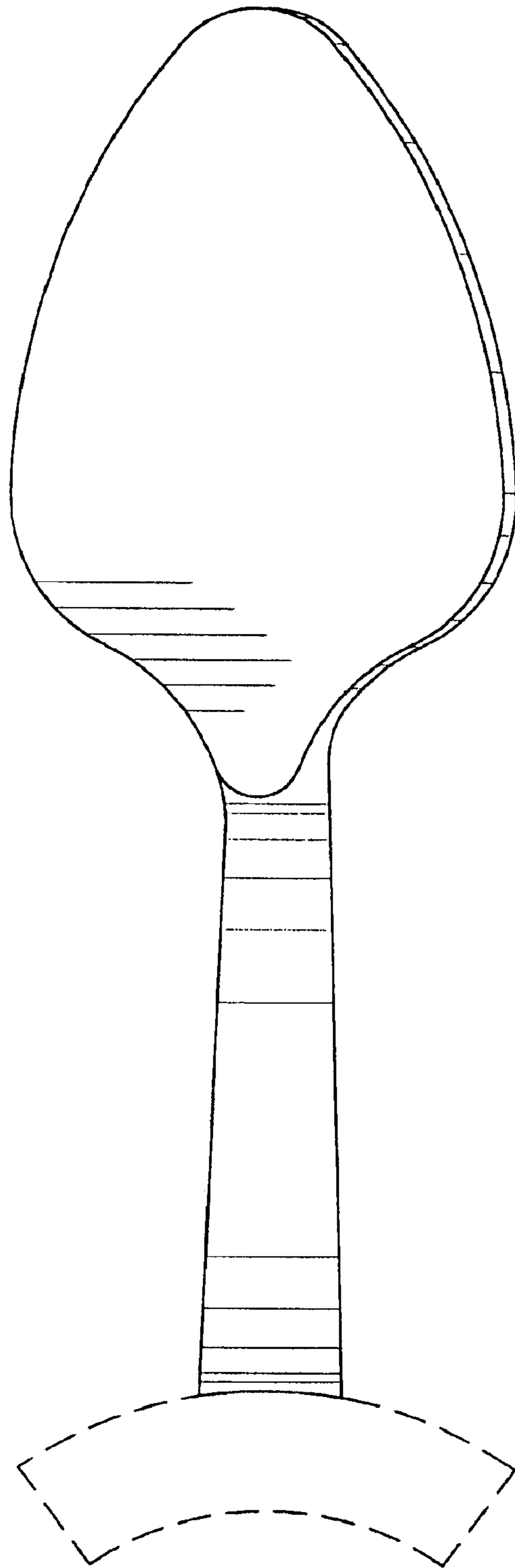

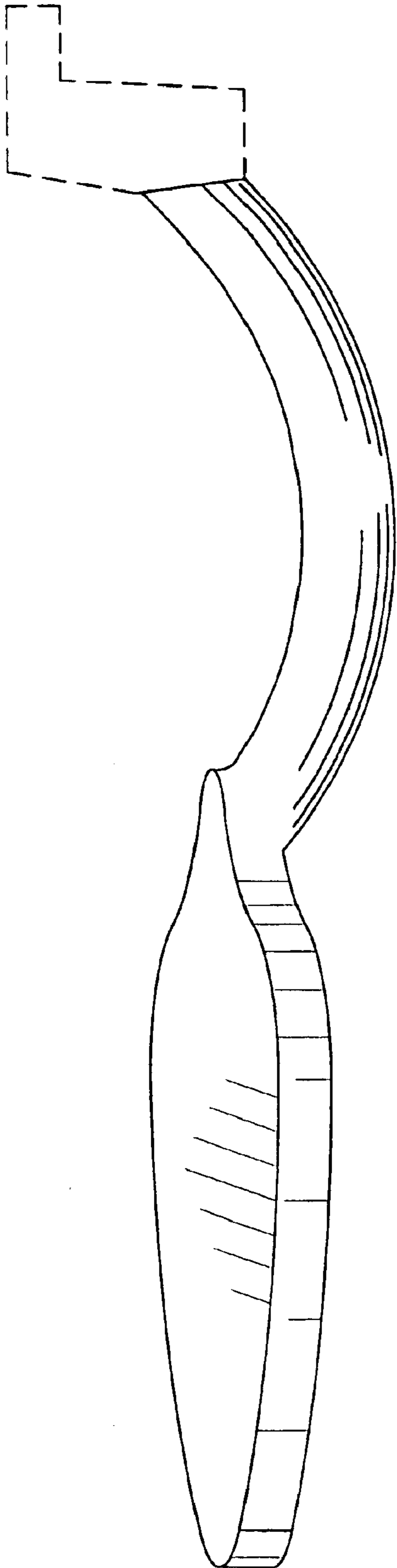

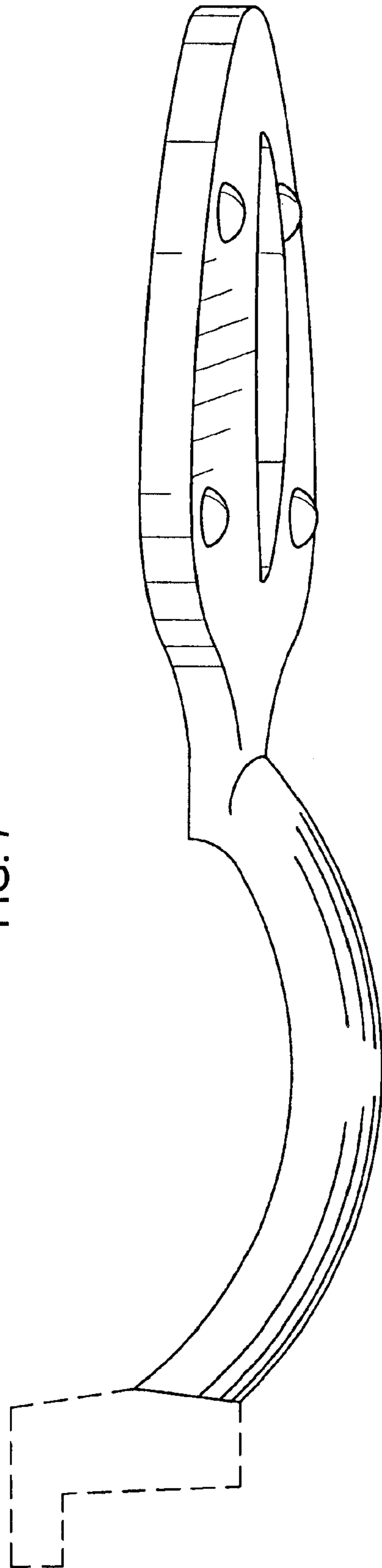
