(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design is for a roof tile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of the present invention showing the lower end of the tile in the front right foreground;

FIG. 2 is a lower end elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is an upper end elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view, of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the invention showing the lower end of the tile in the front right foreground; and

FIG. 9 is a lower end elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is an upper end elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

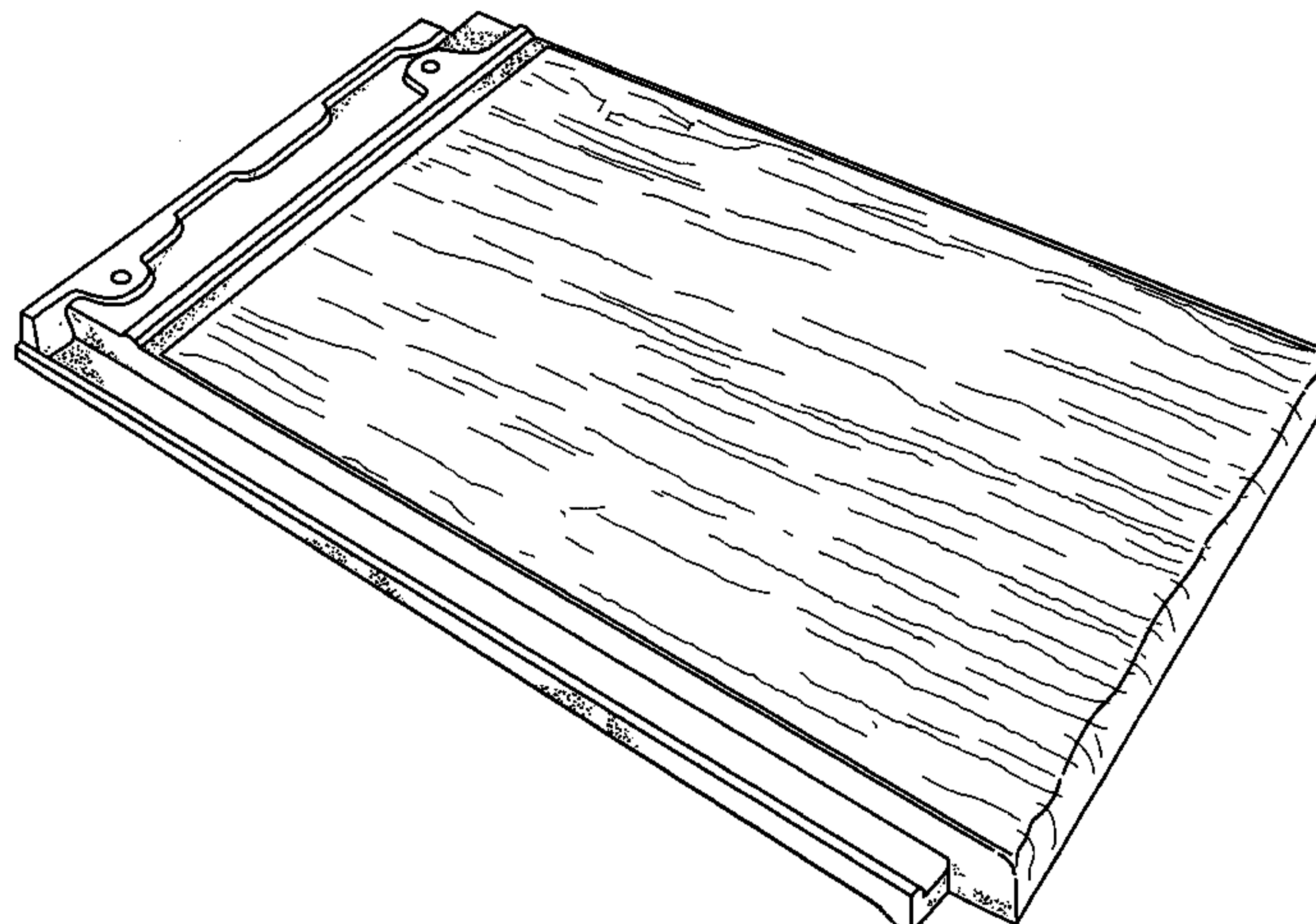
FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment of FIG. 8;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view, of the embodiment of FIG. 8.

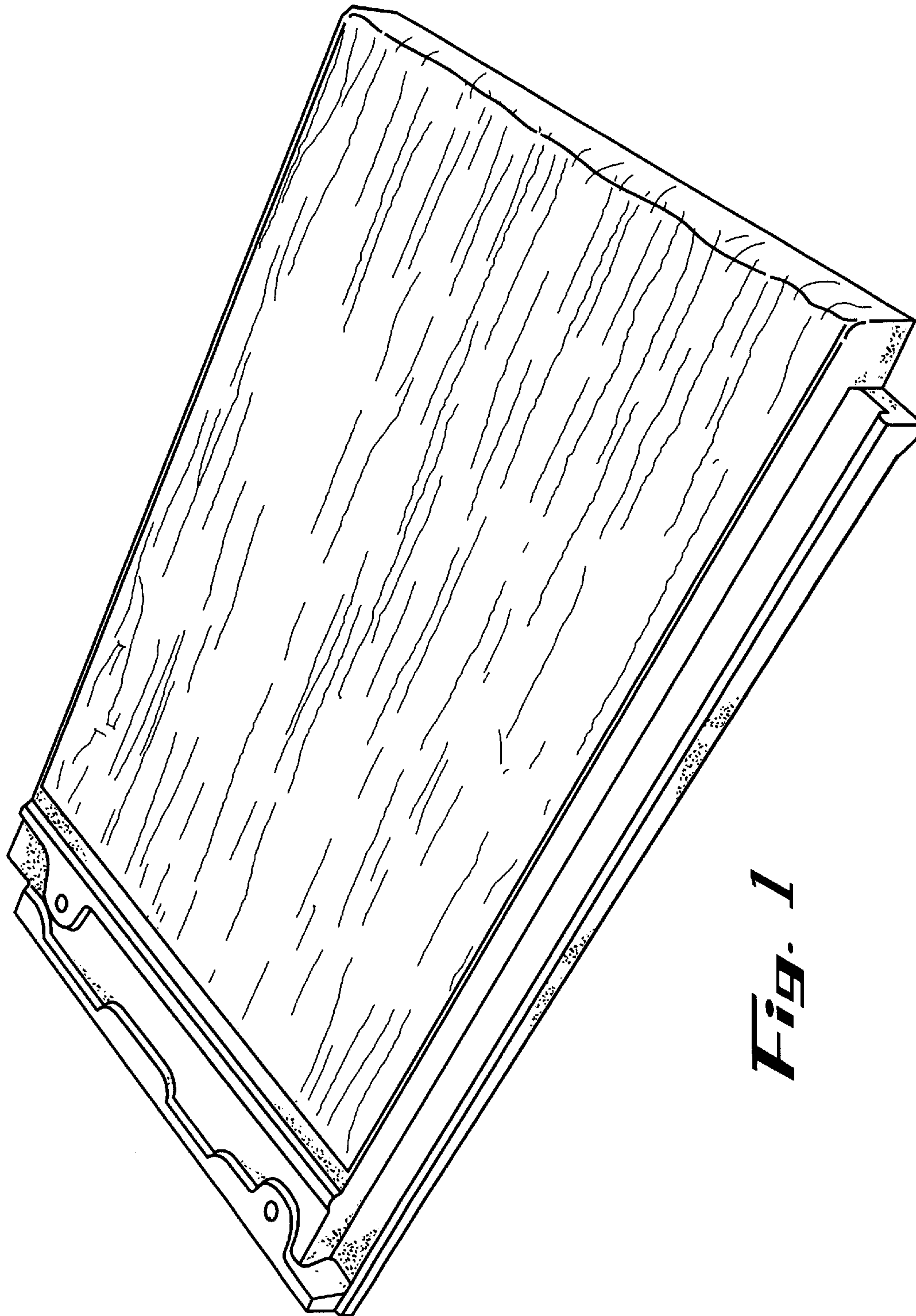

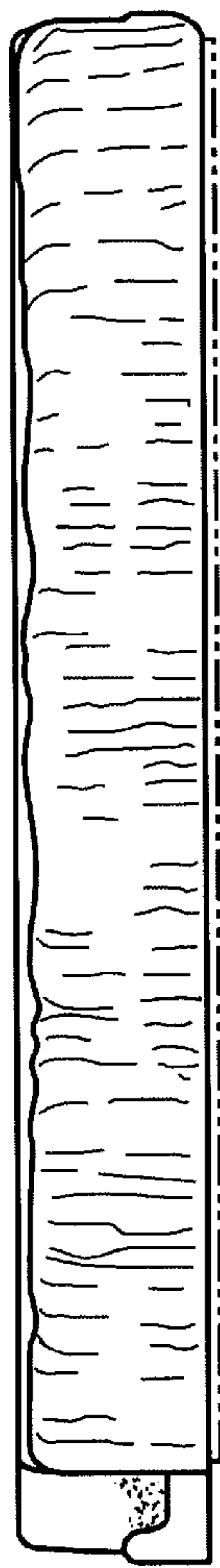

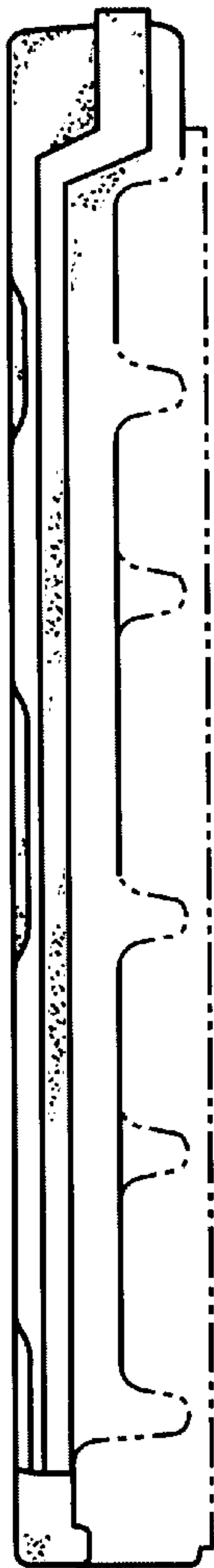

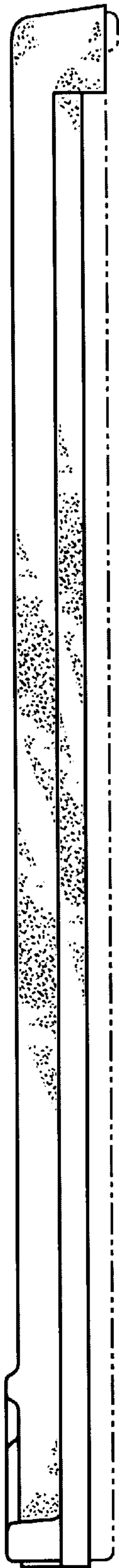

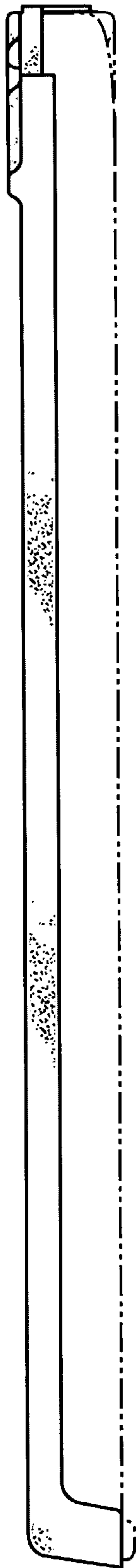

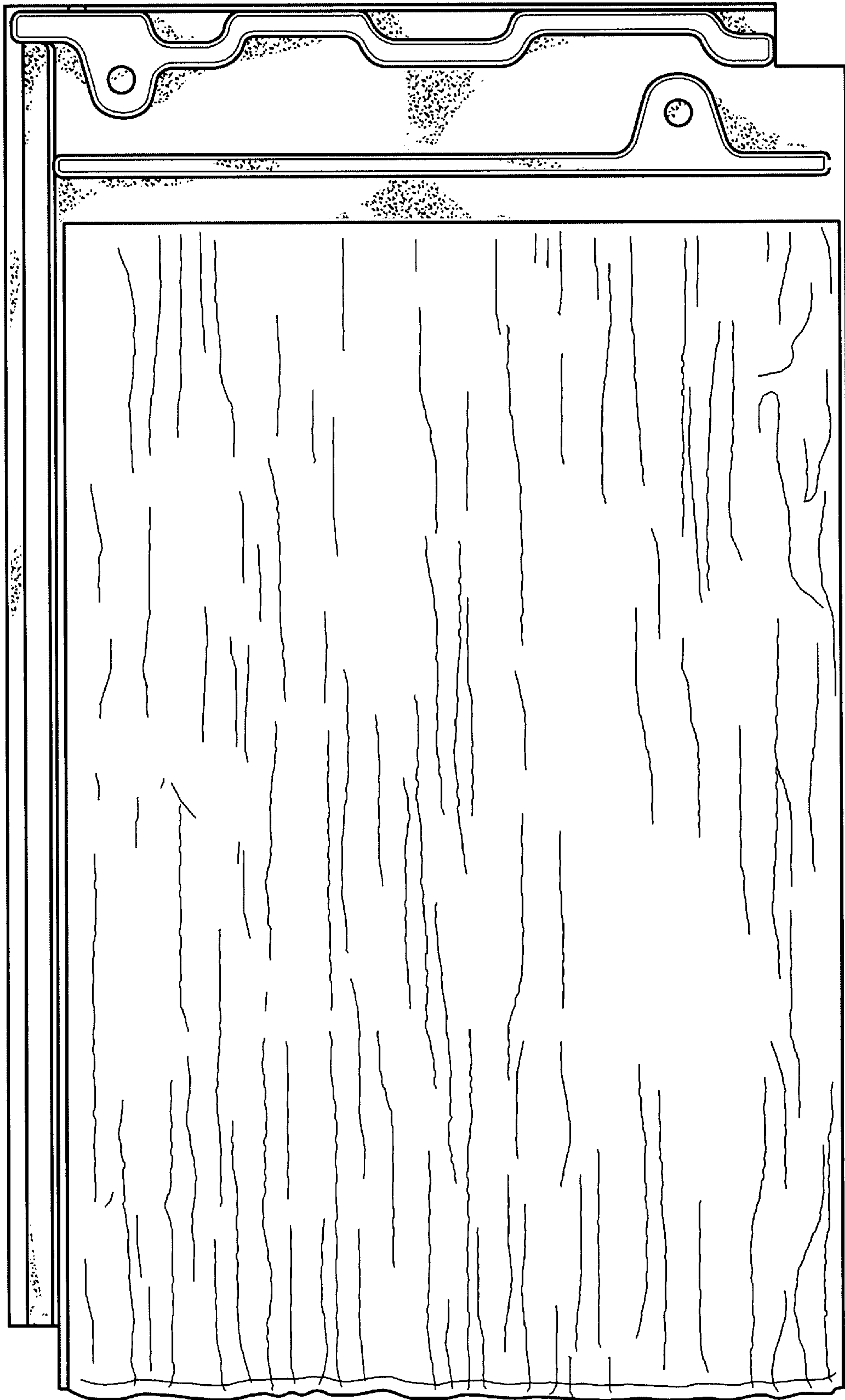

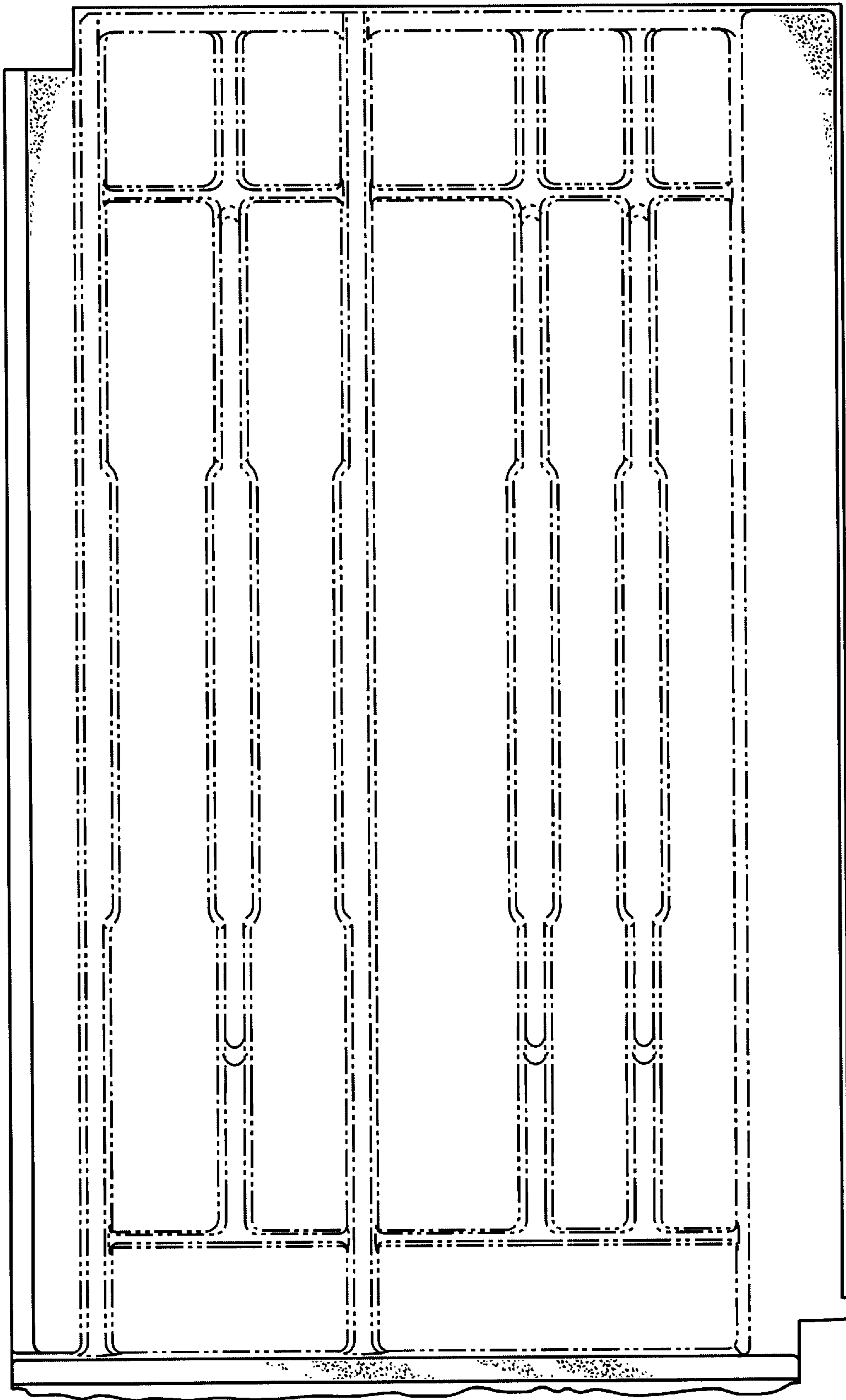

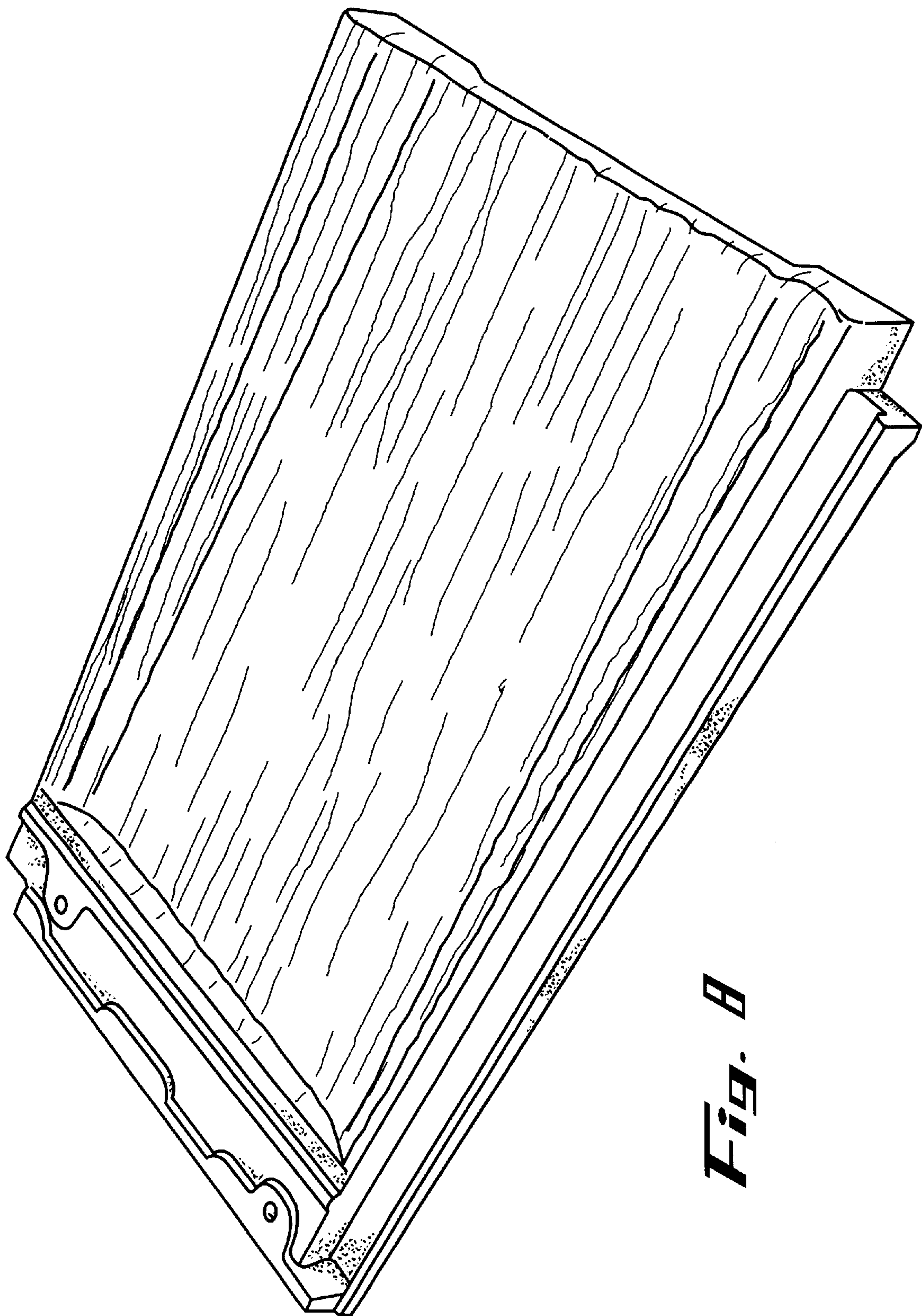

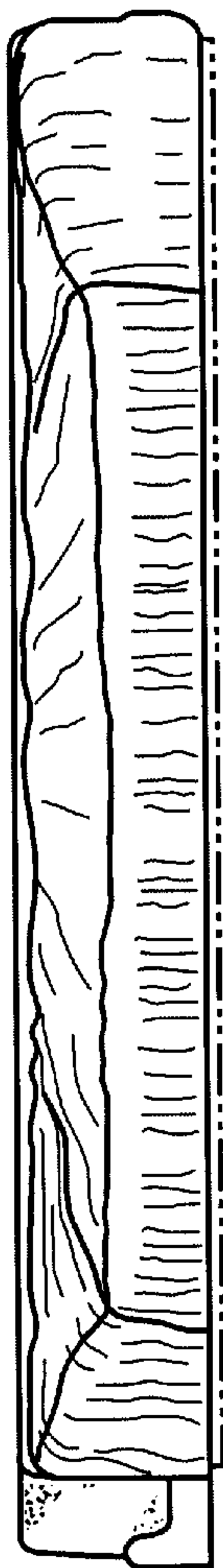

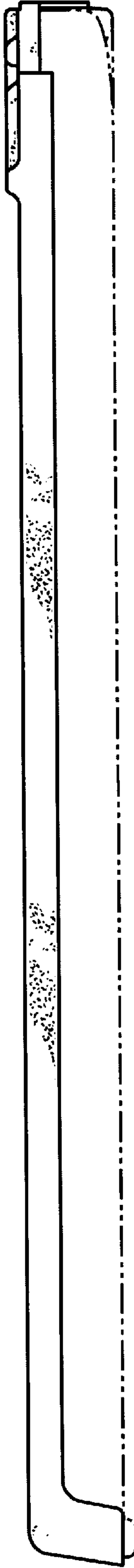

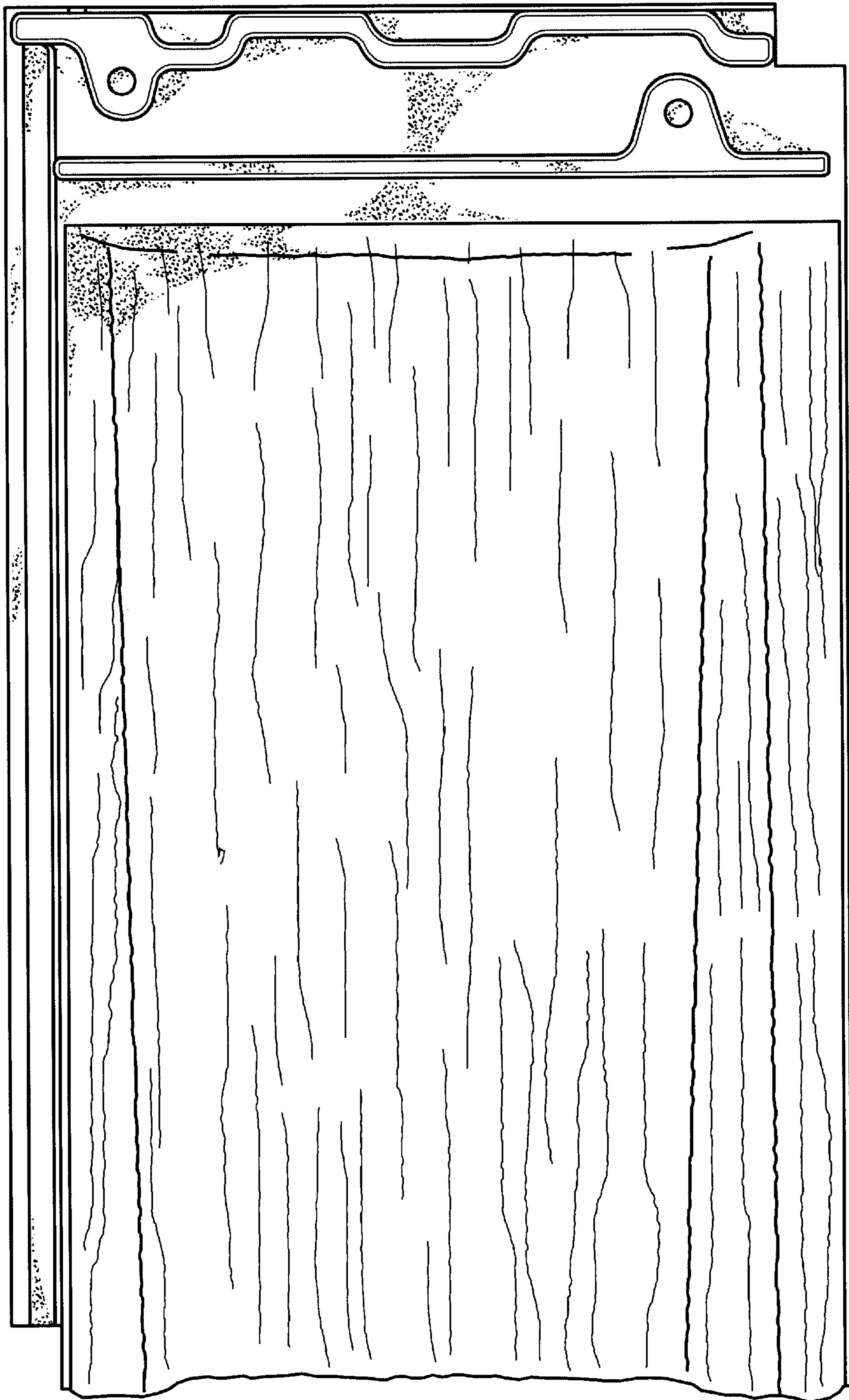

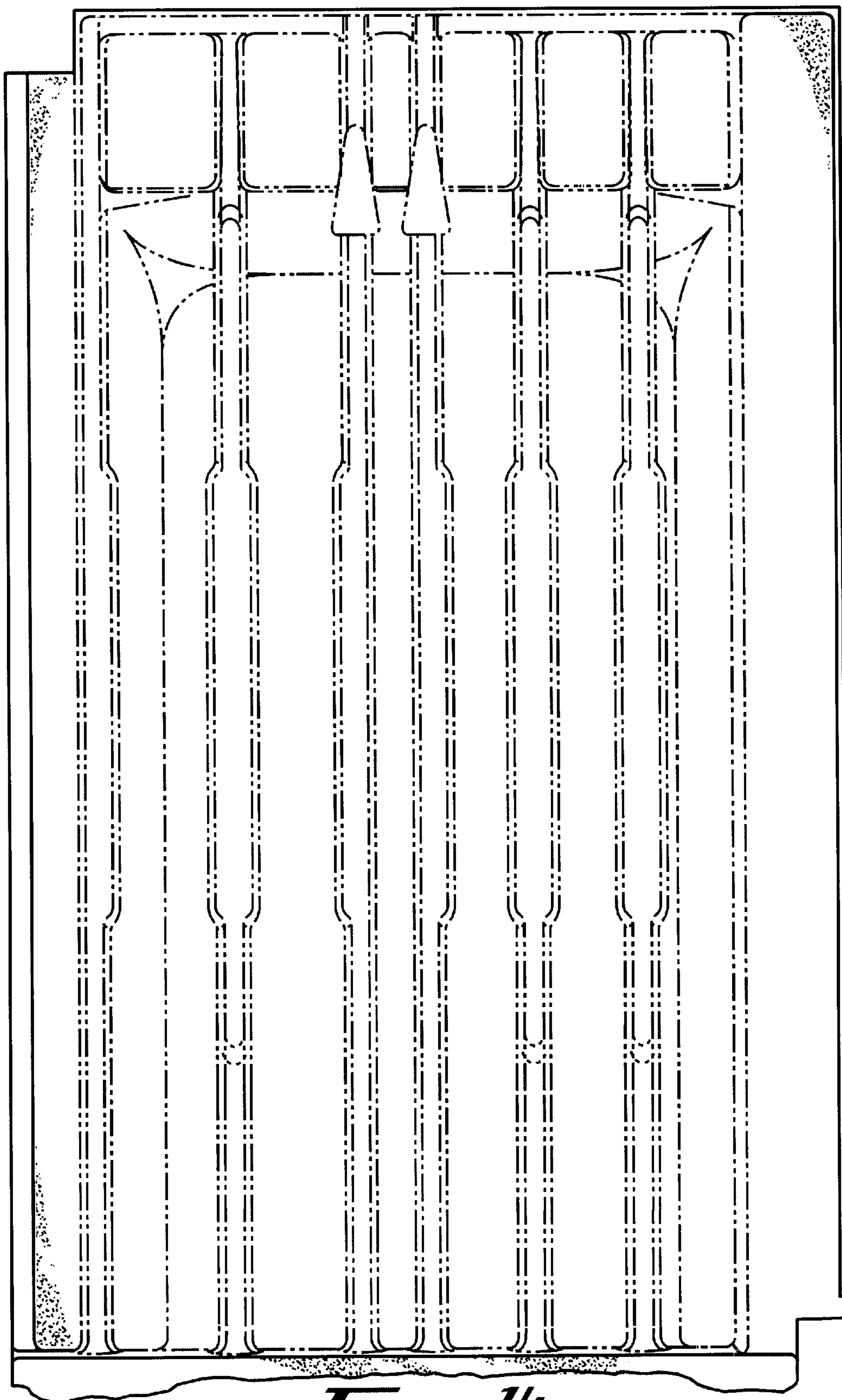
