described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair according to a first
embodiment of the invention.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of a chair thereof.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of a chair thereof.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of a chair thereof. The view
from the opposite side being a mirror image thereof.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a chair thereof.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a chair according to a second
embodiment of the invention.

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a chair thereof.

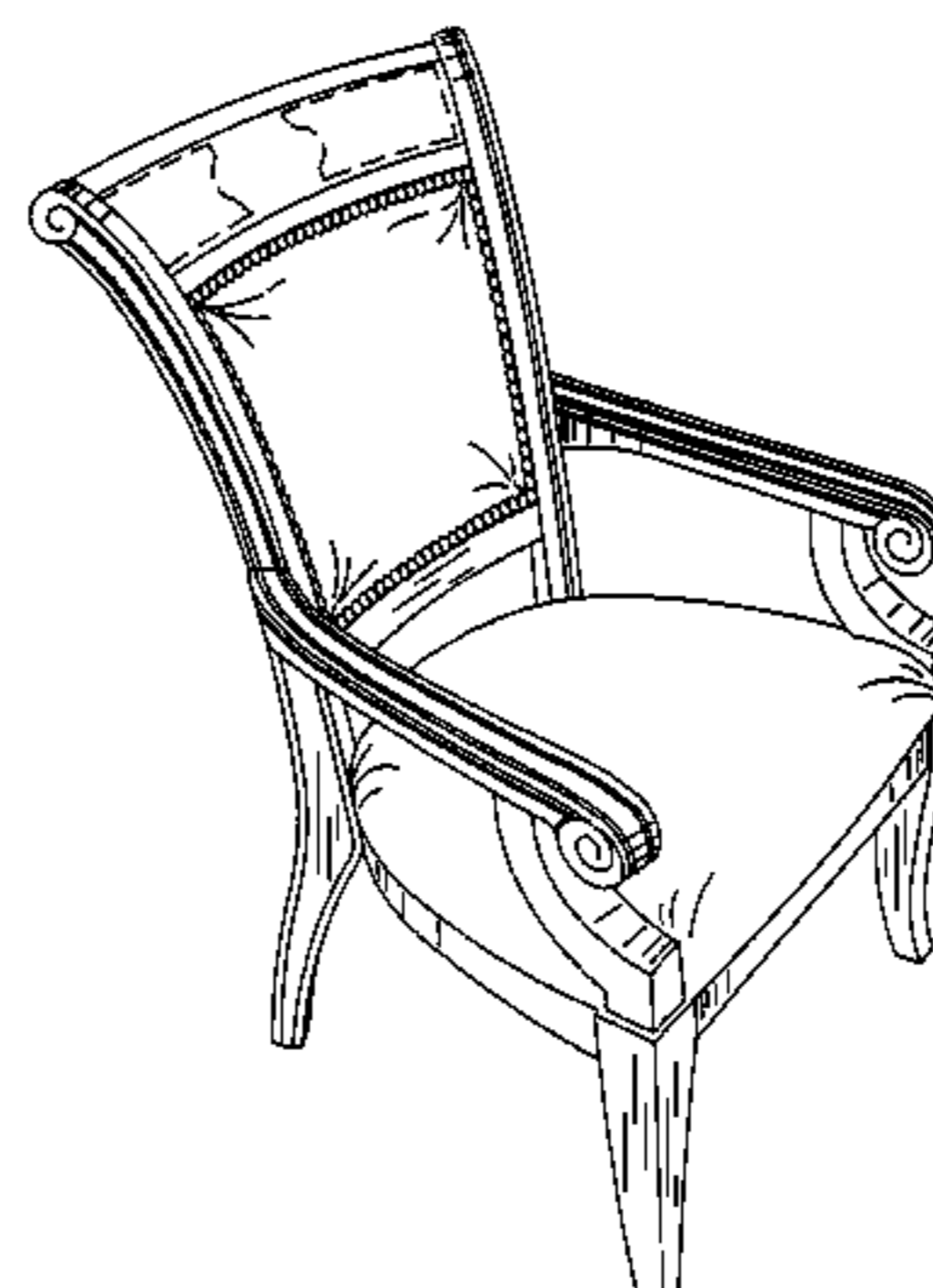
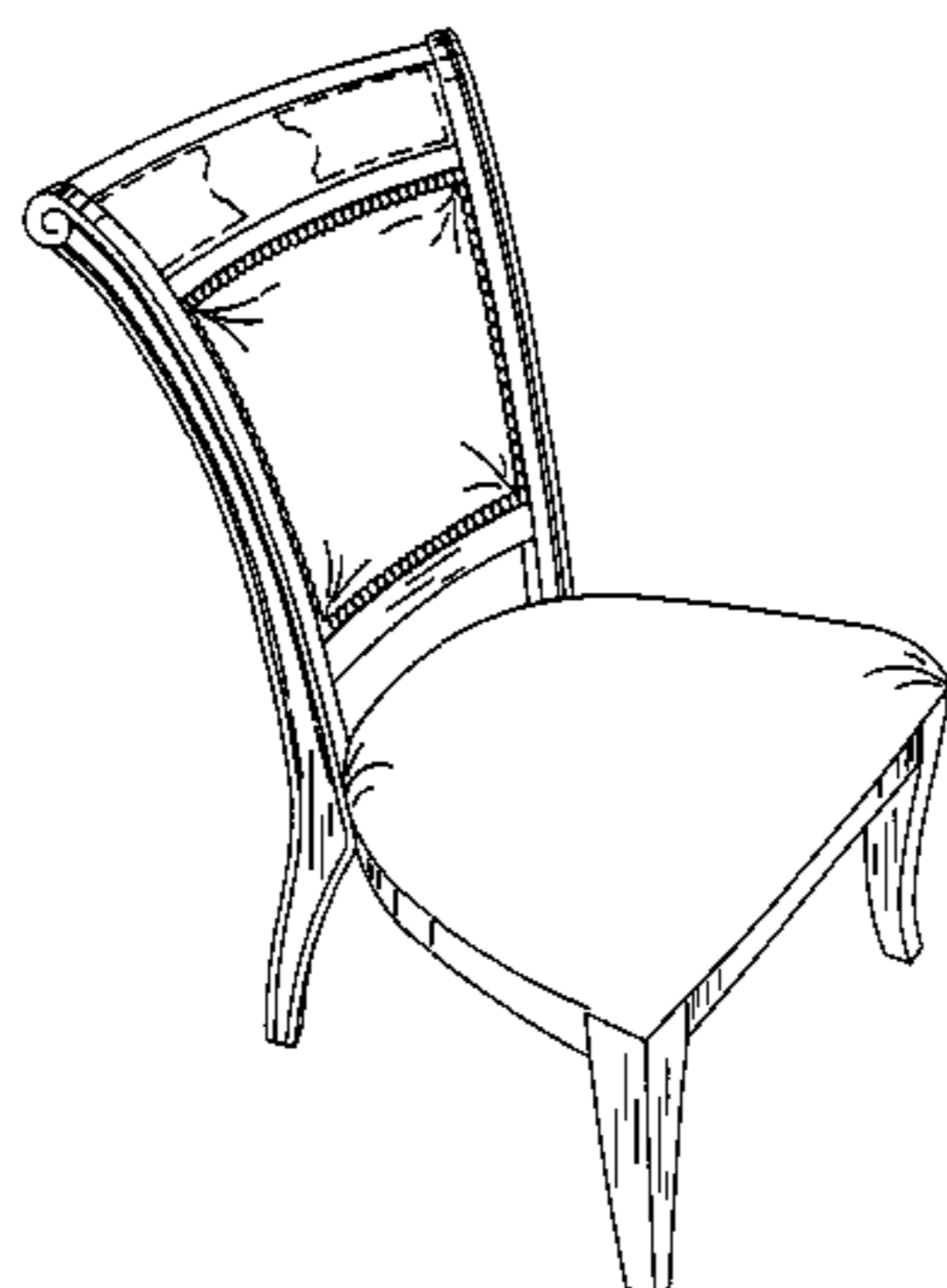
FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of a chair thereof.

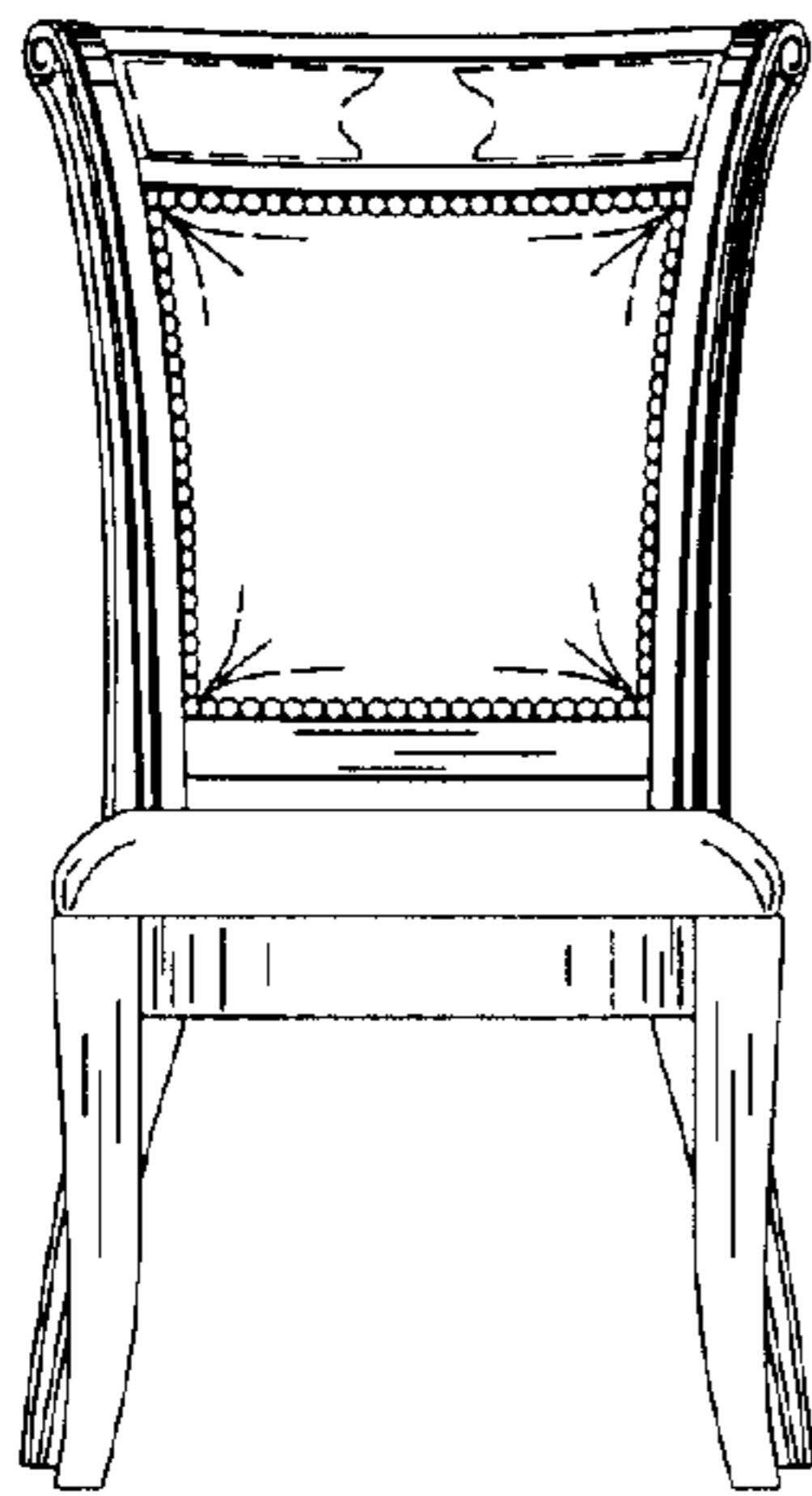

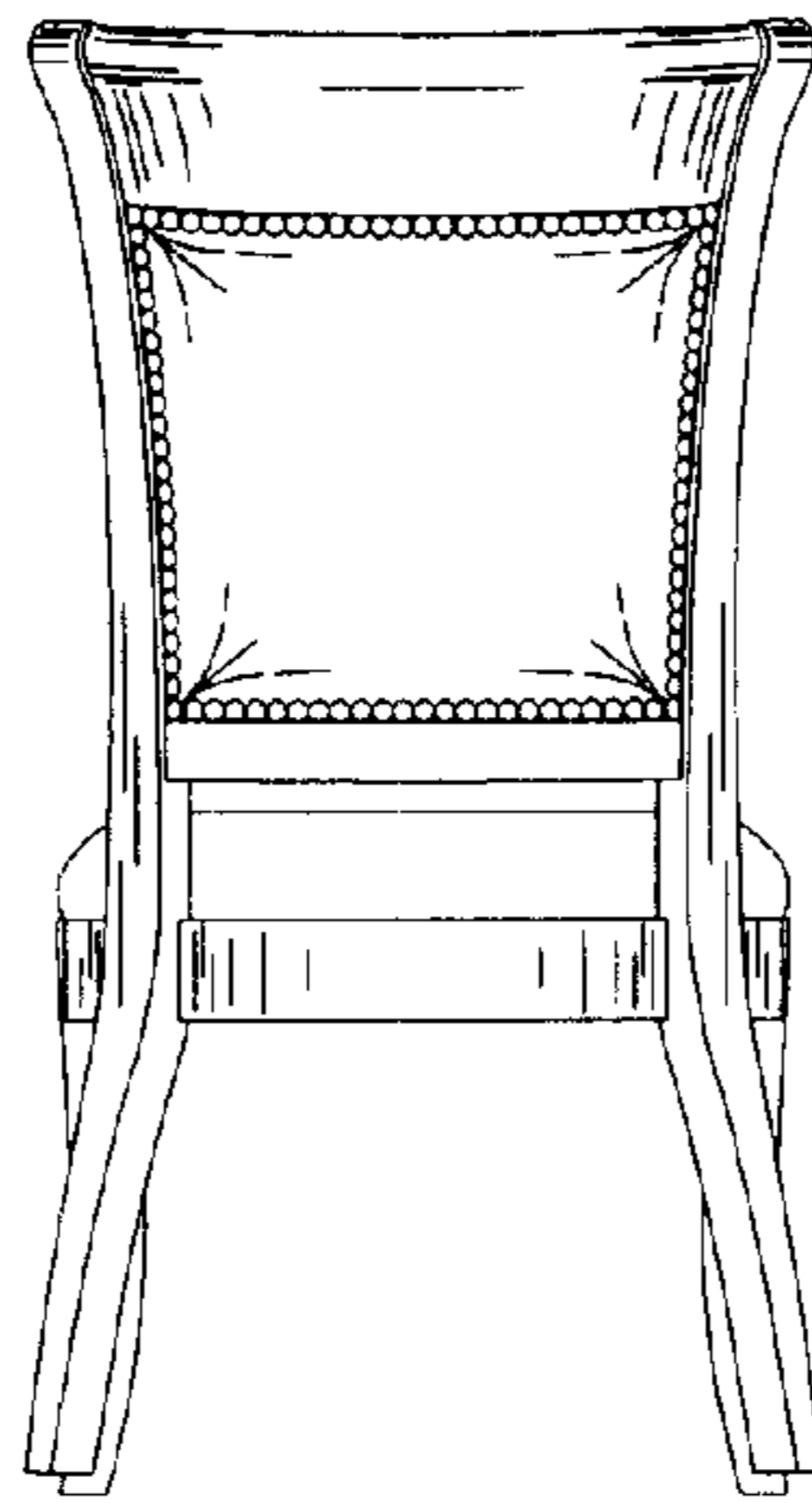

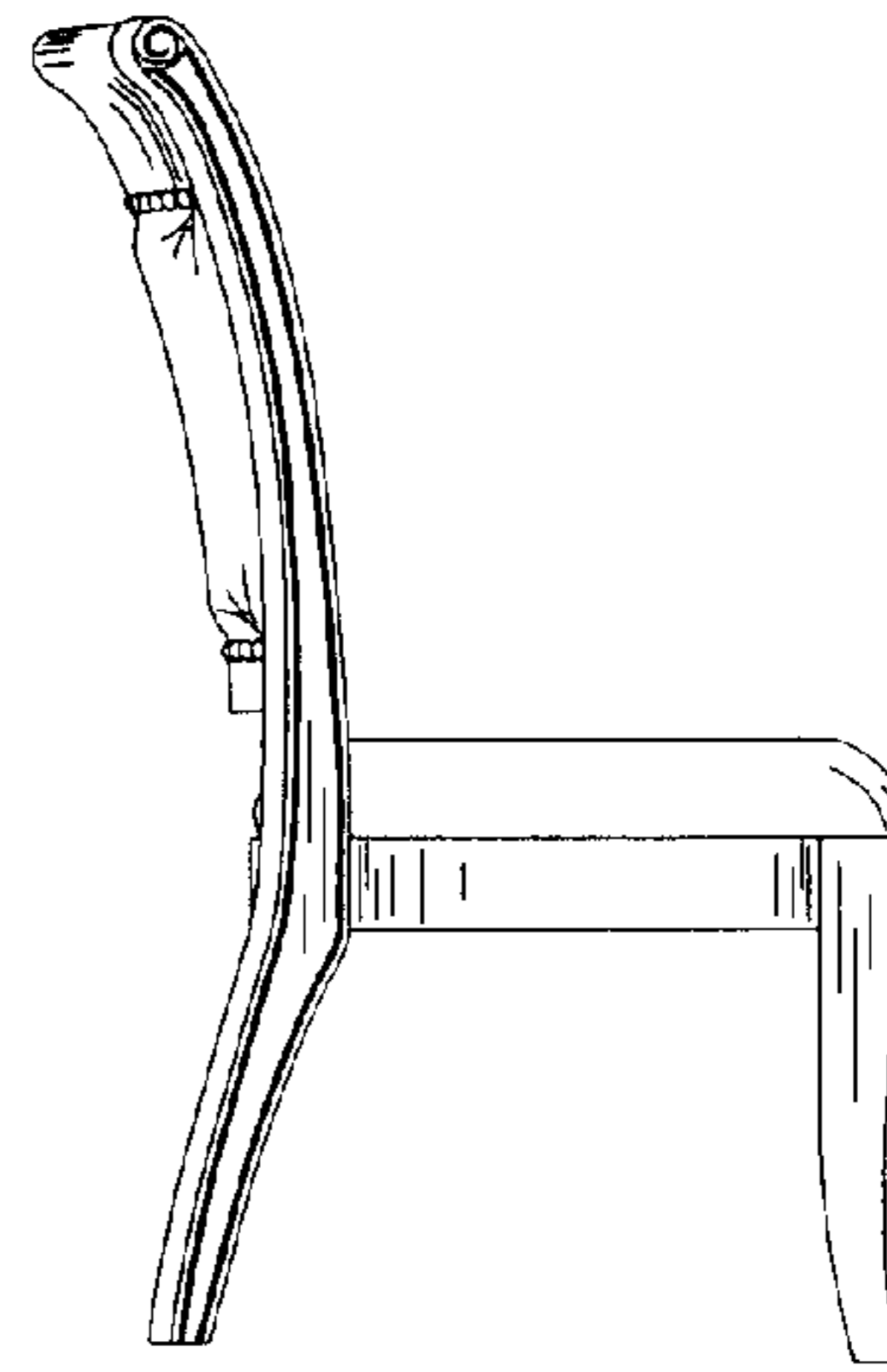

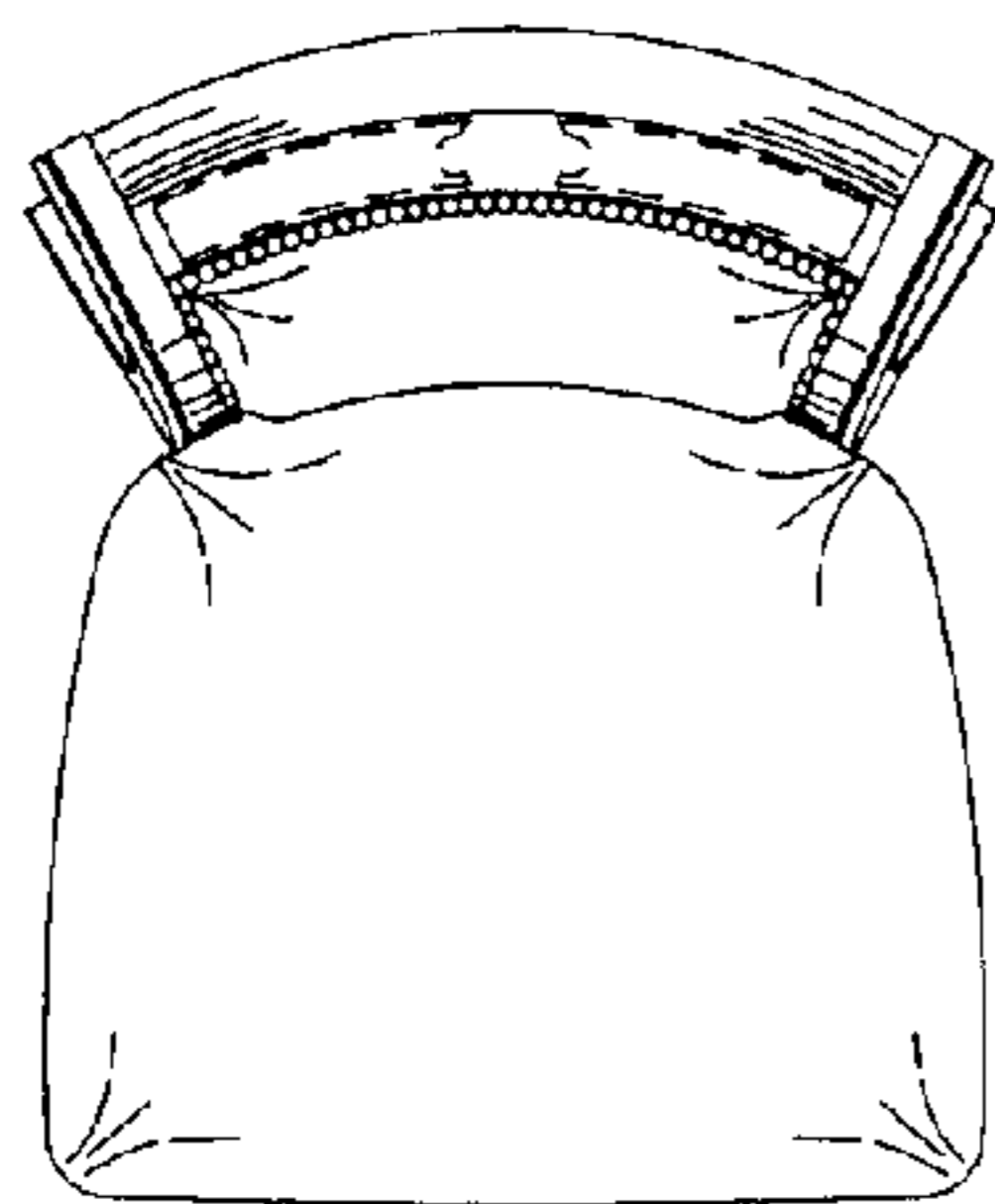

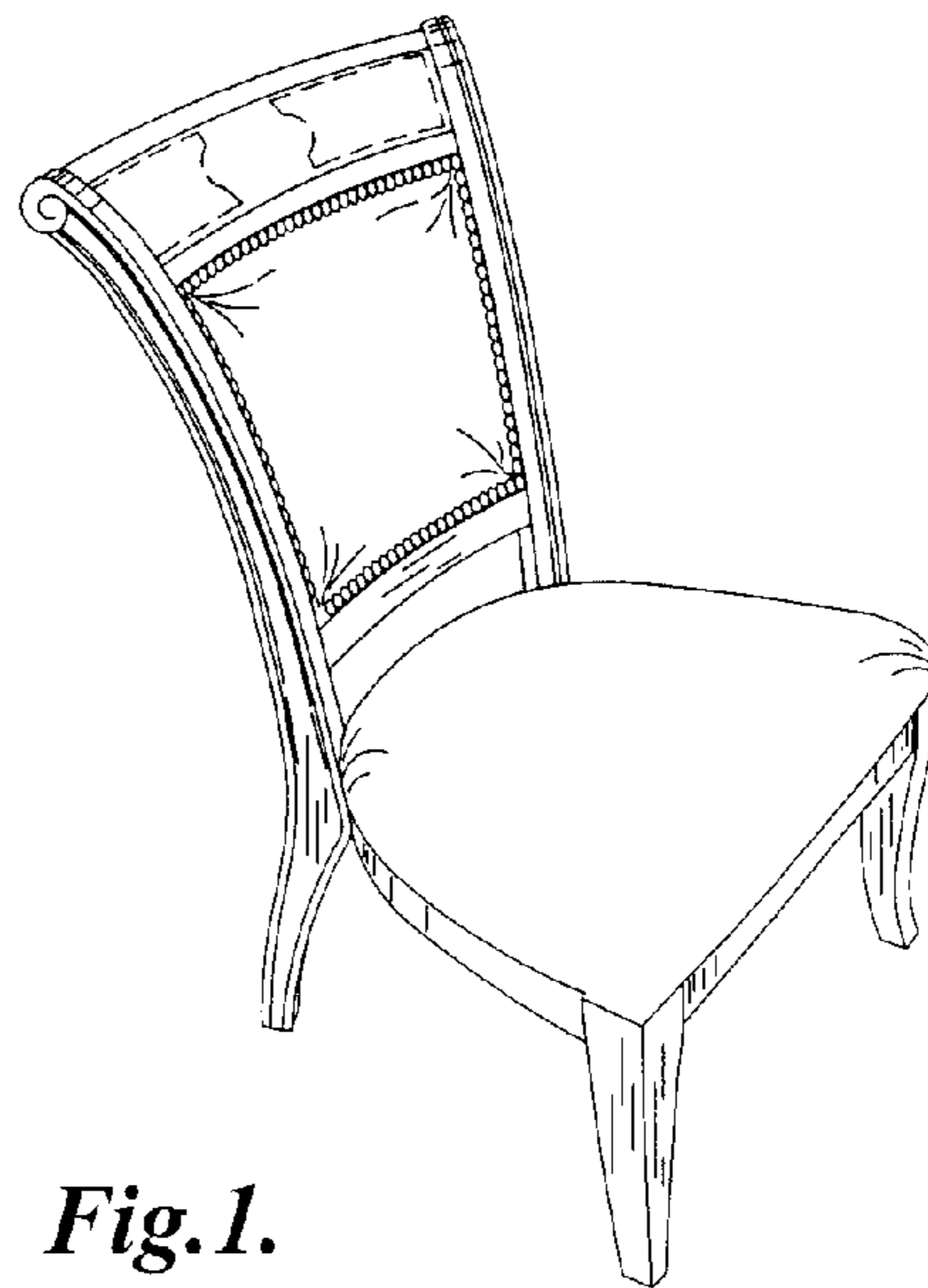

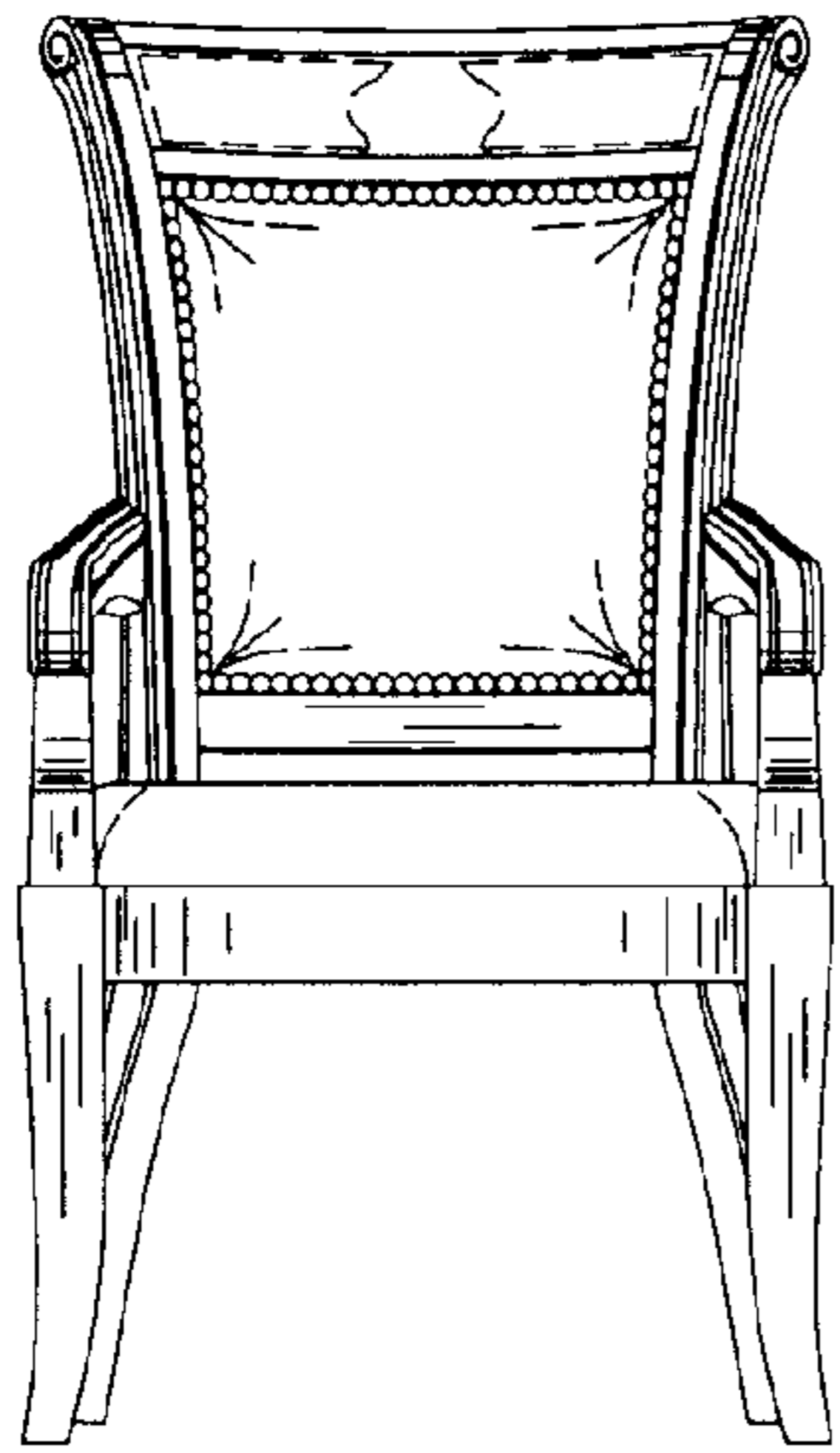

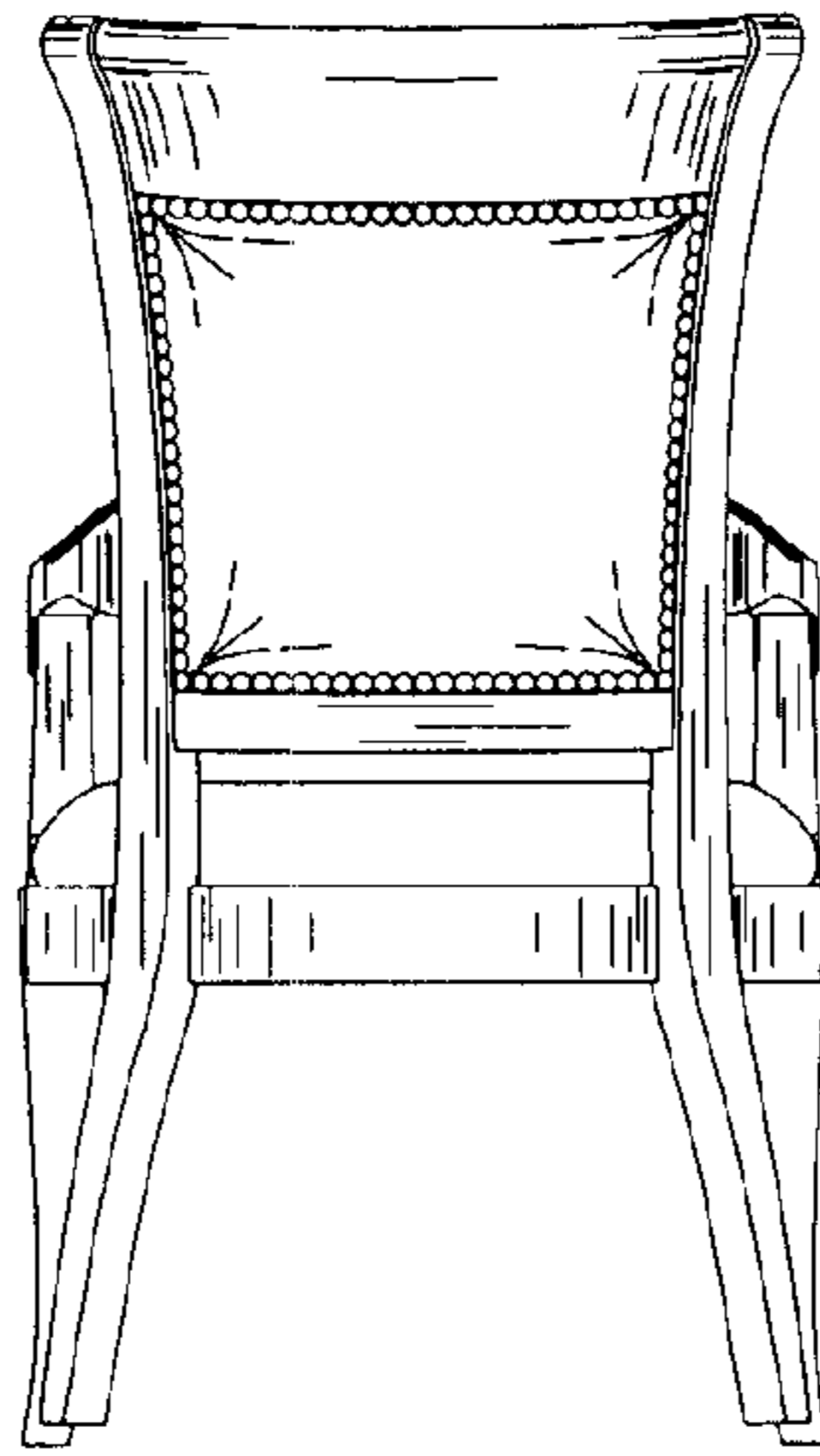

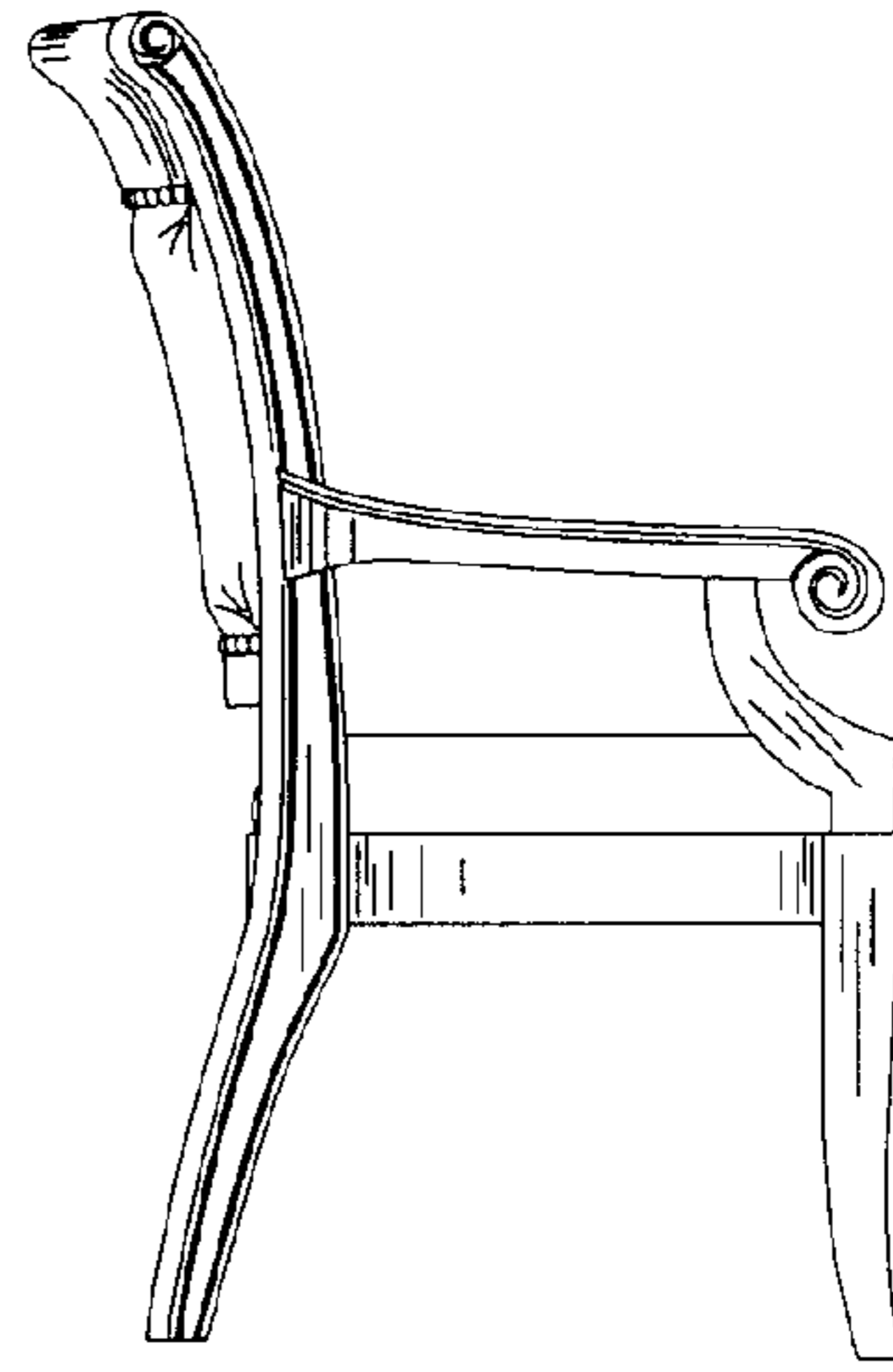

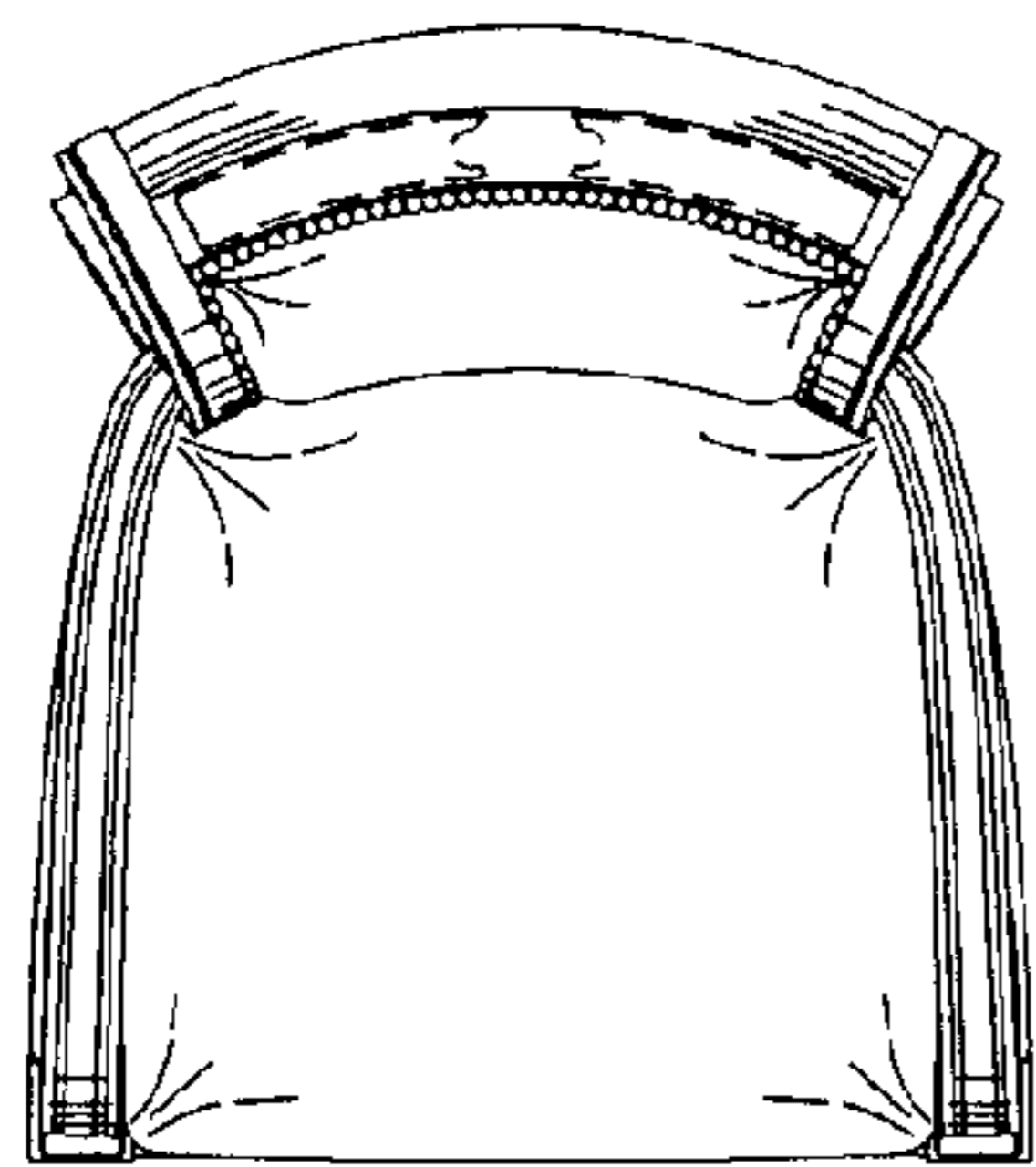

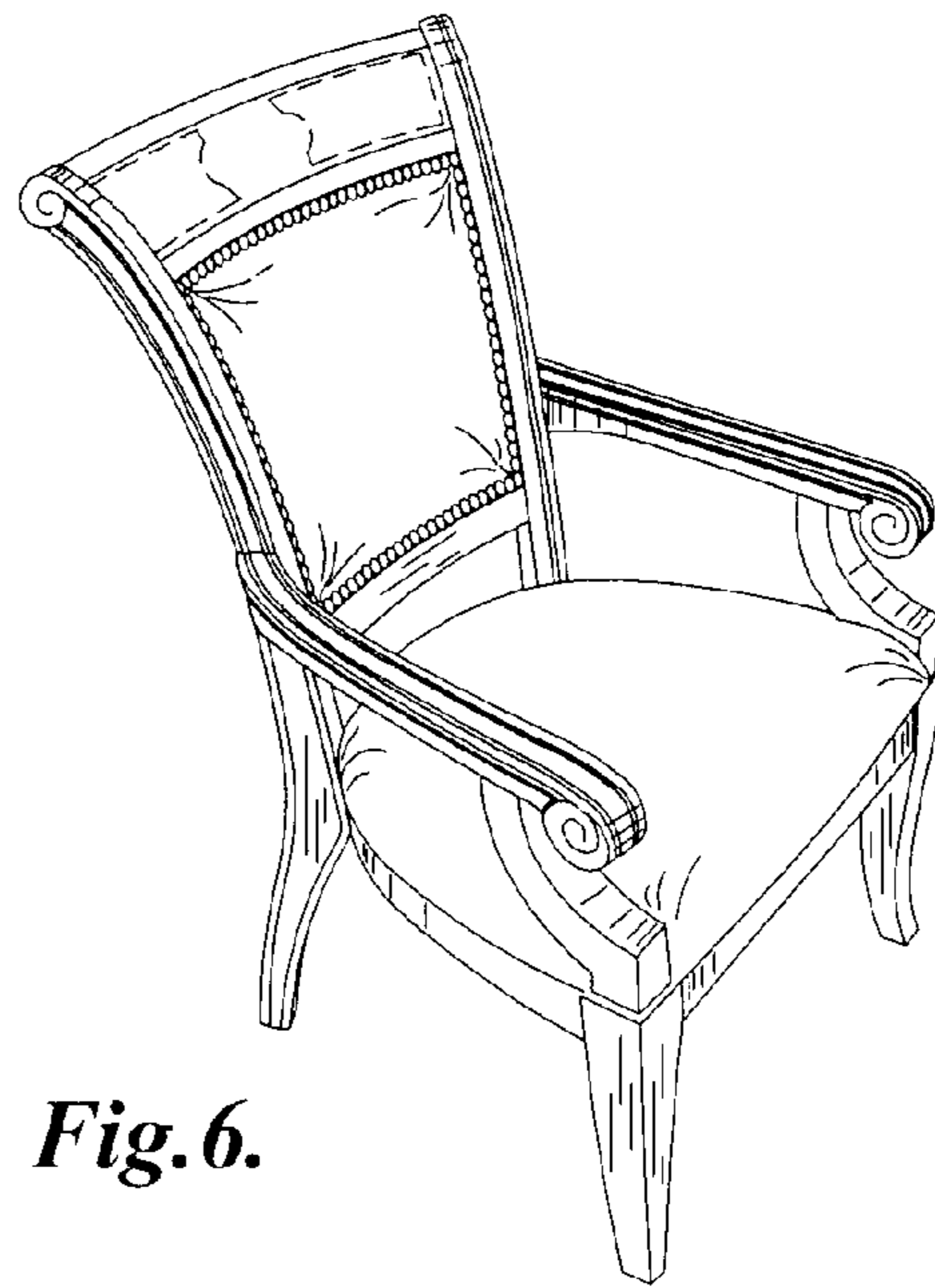
