FIG. 4 is a front view of the of the display of FIG. 1;

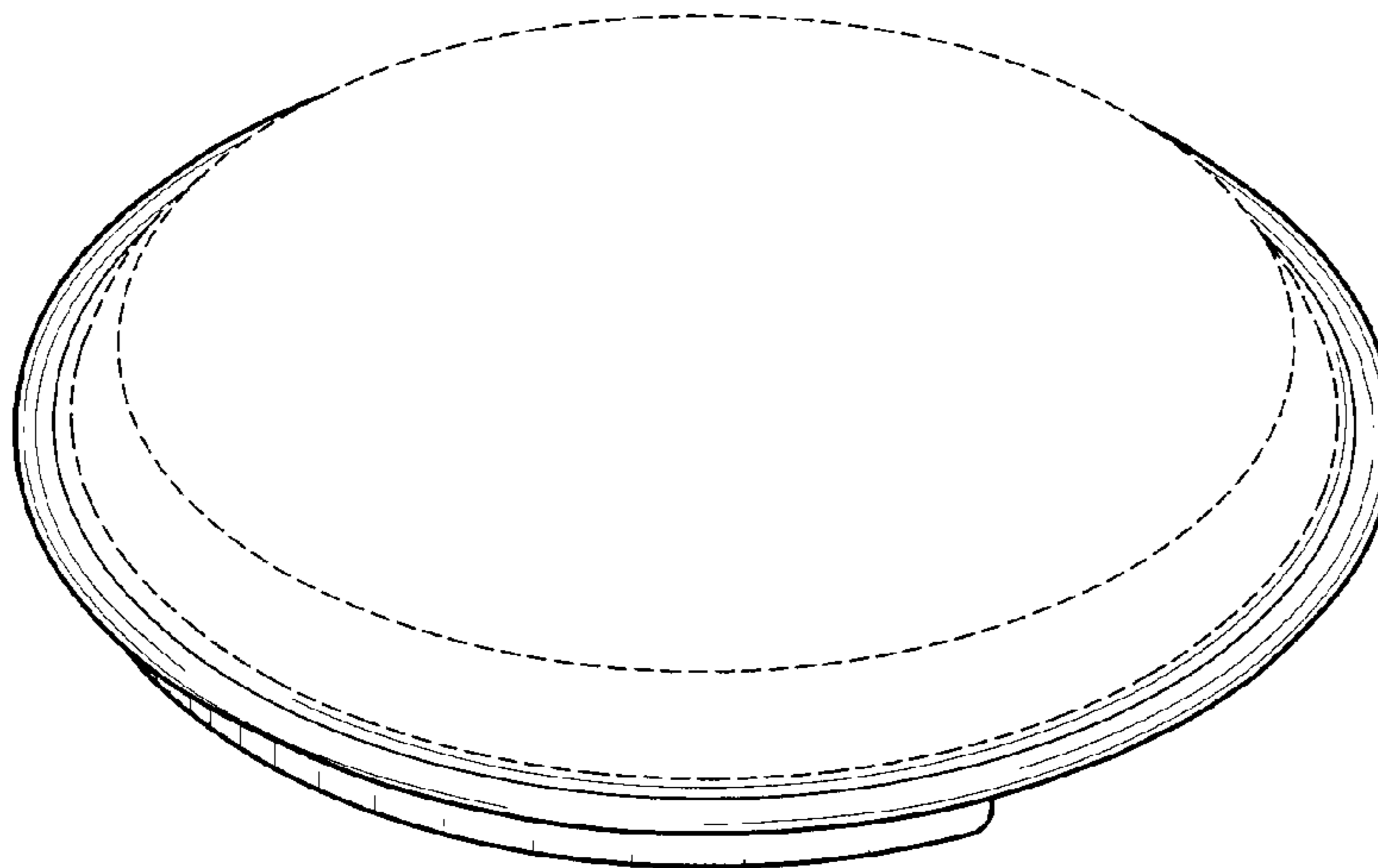
FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the display of FIG. 1;

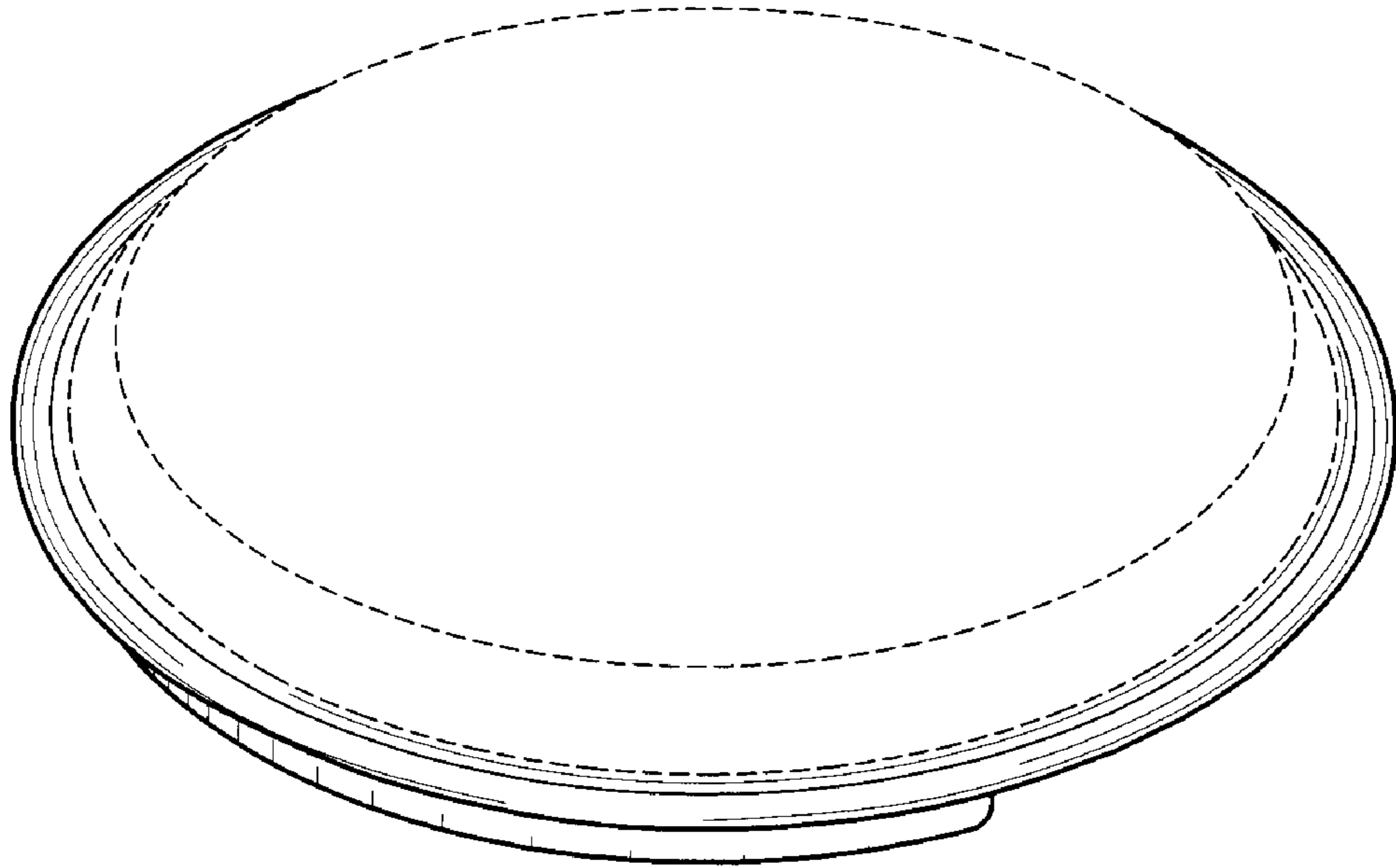

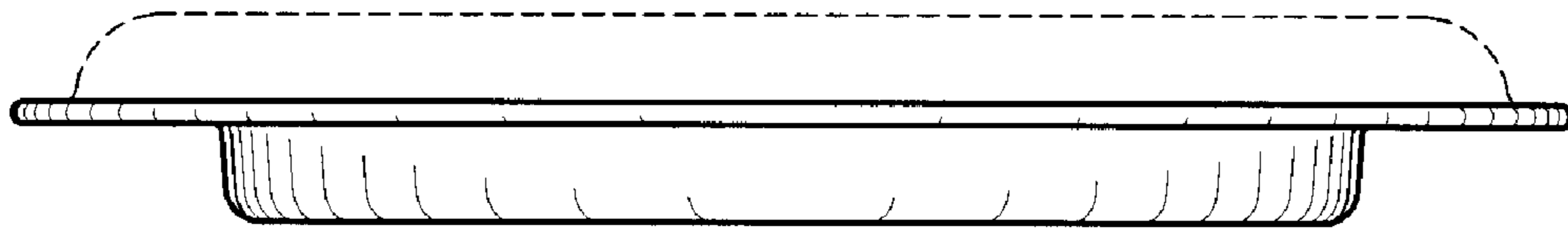

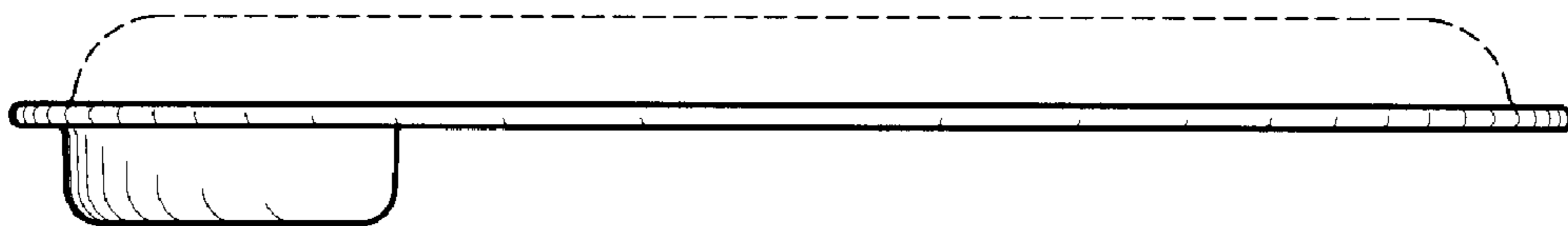

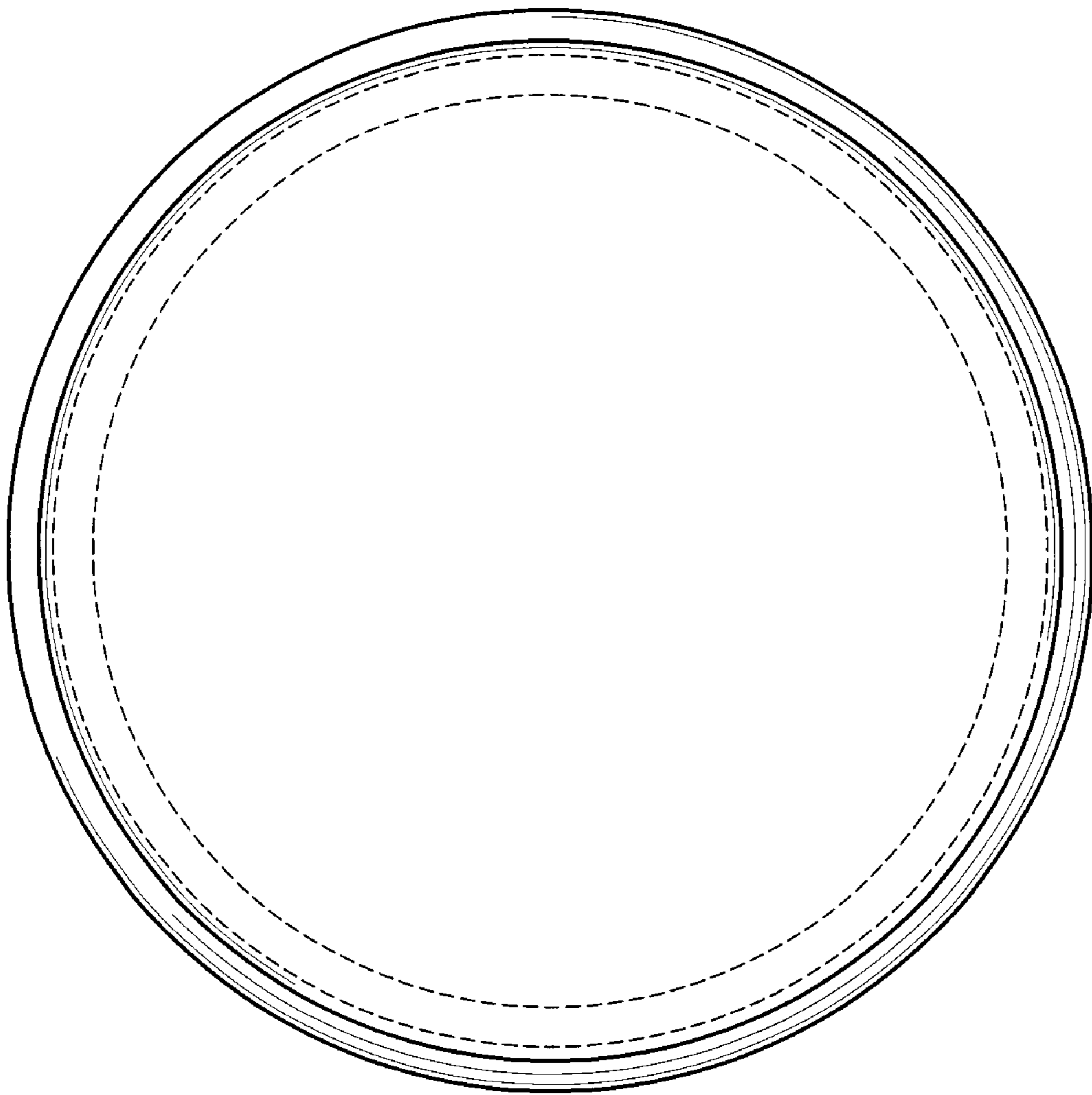

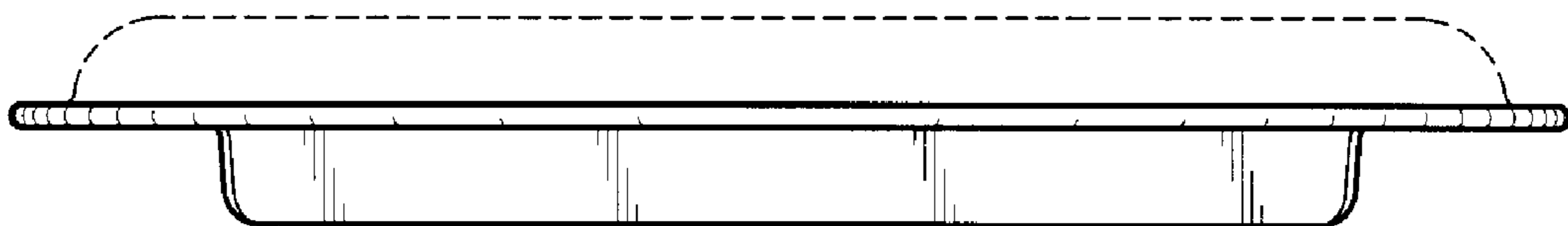

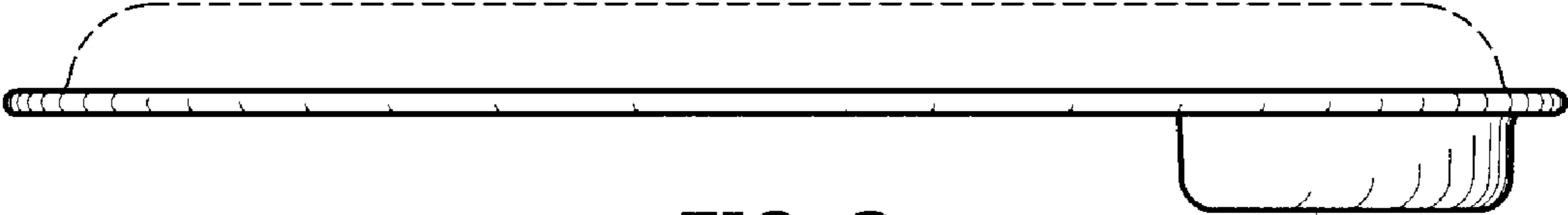

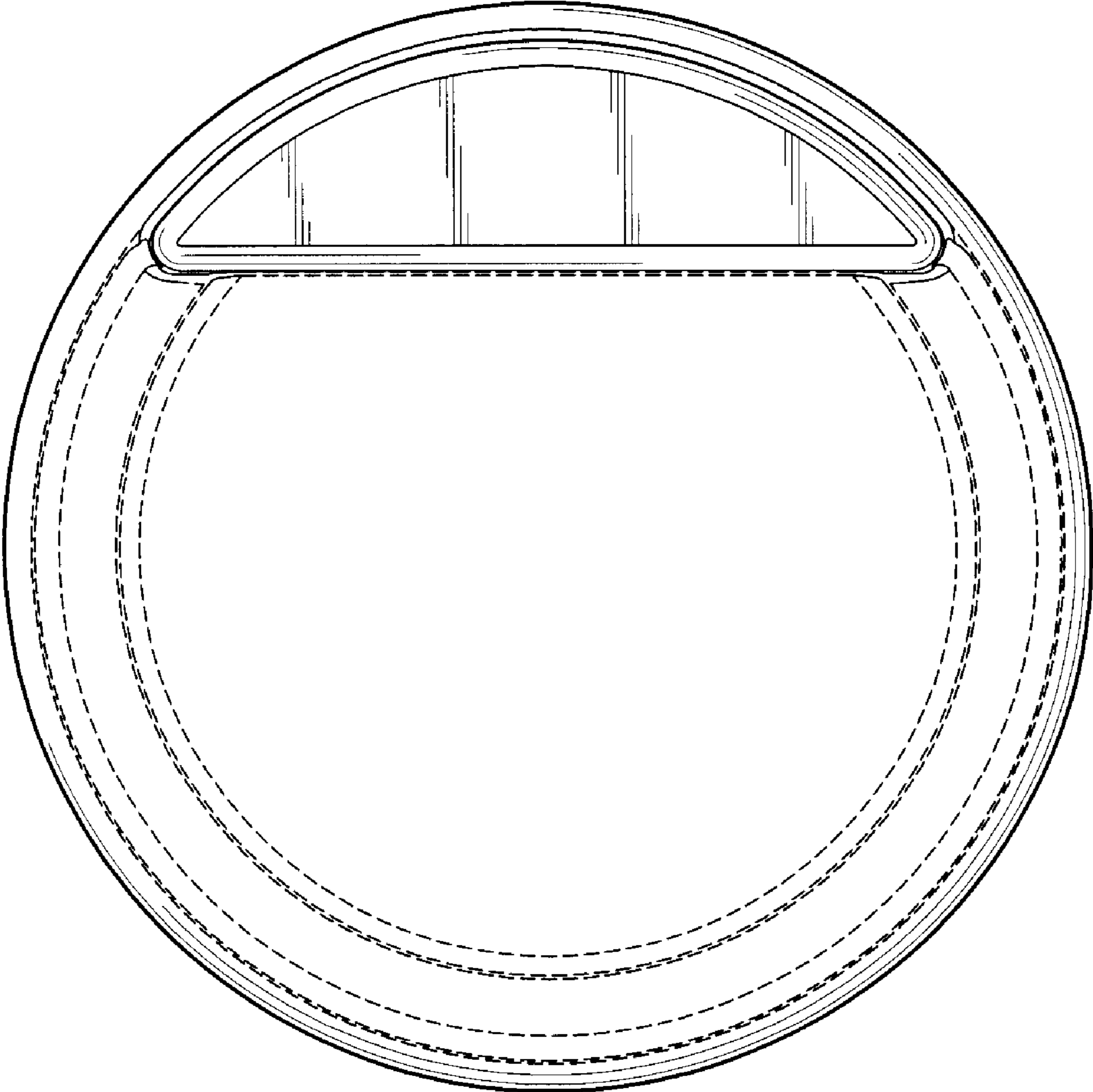
