FIG. 6 is a top view thereof.

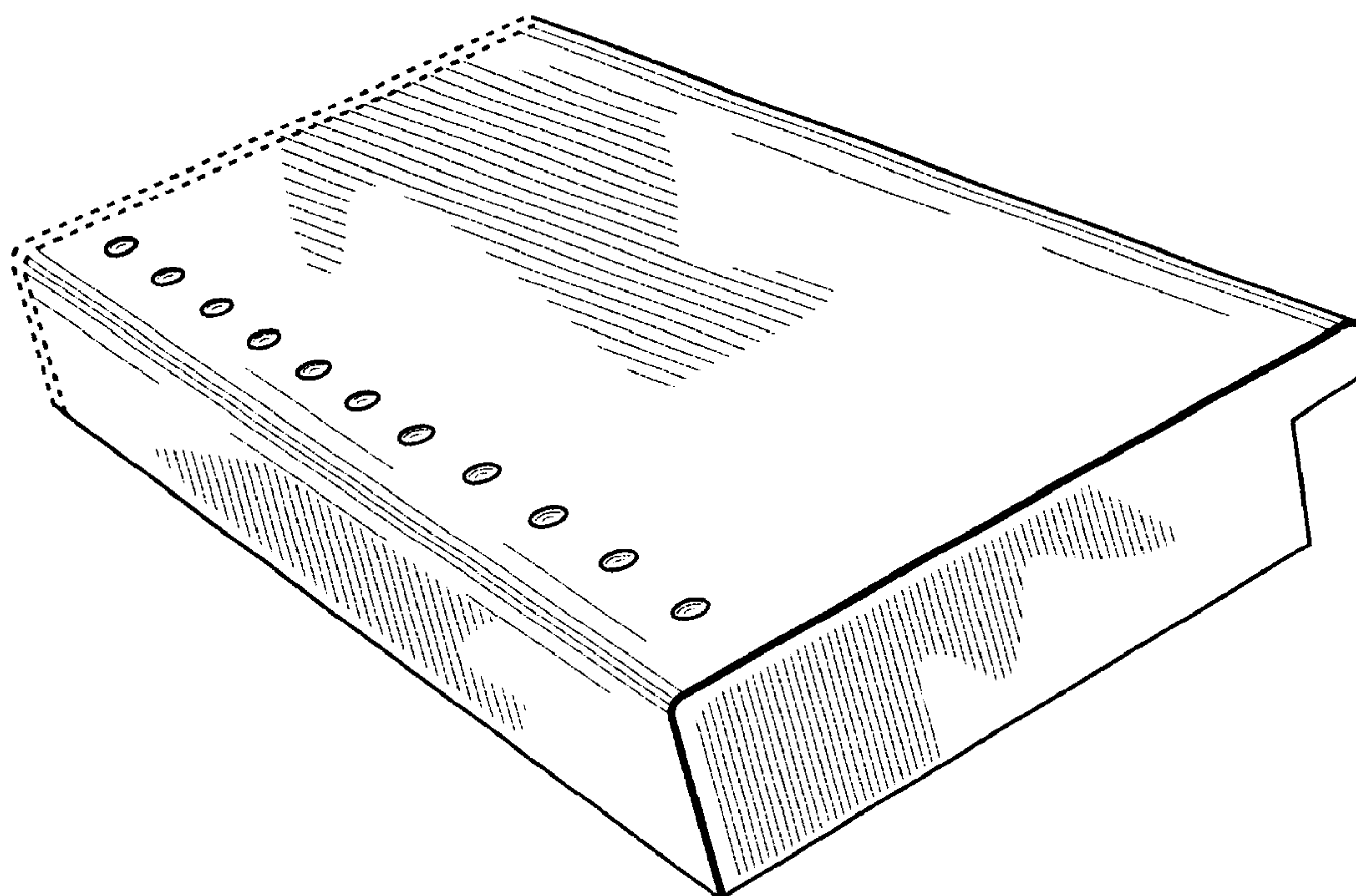
The double broken lines indicate that the molding continues indeterminately in the direction depicted.

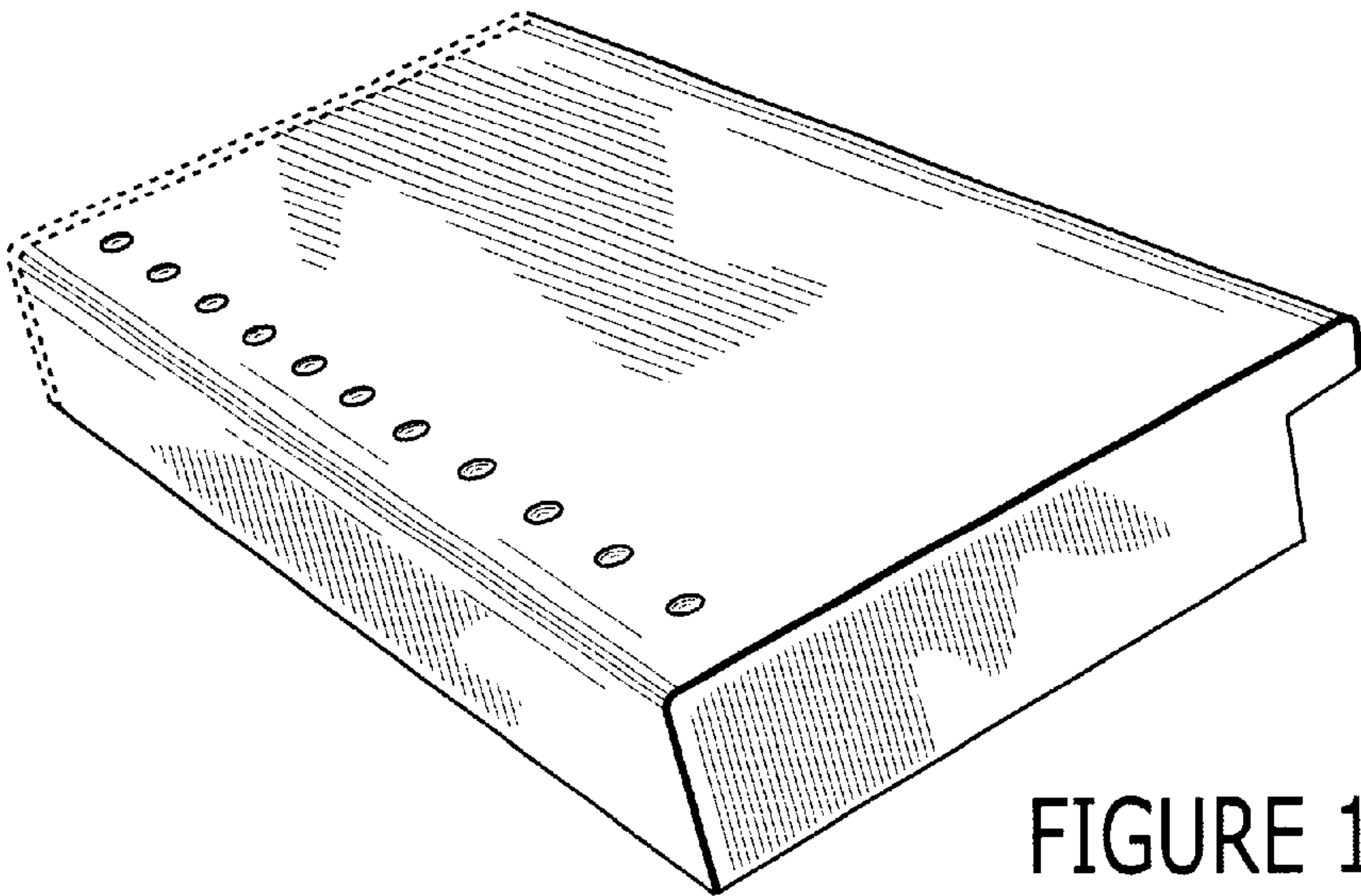

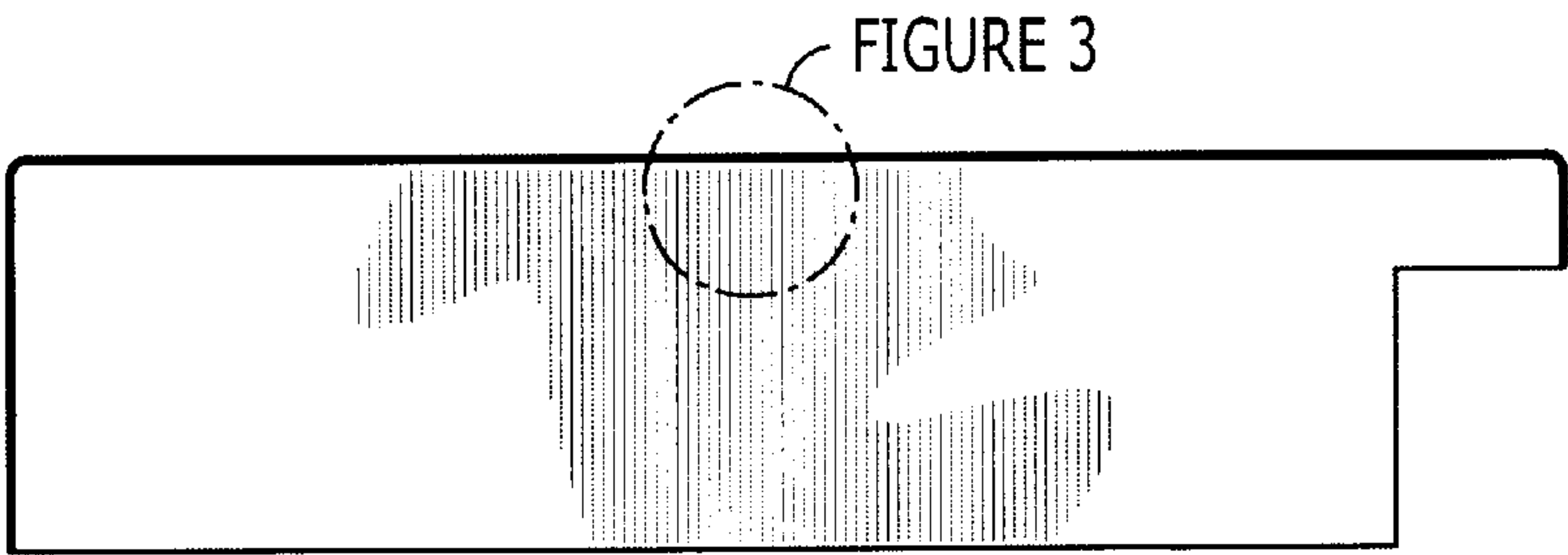

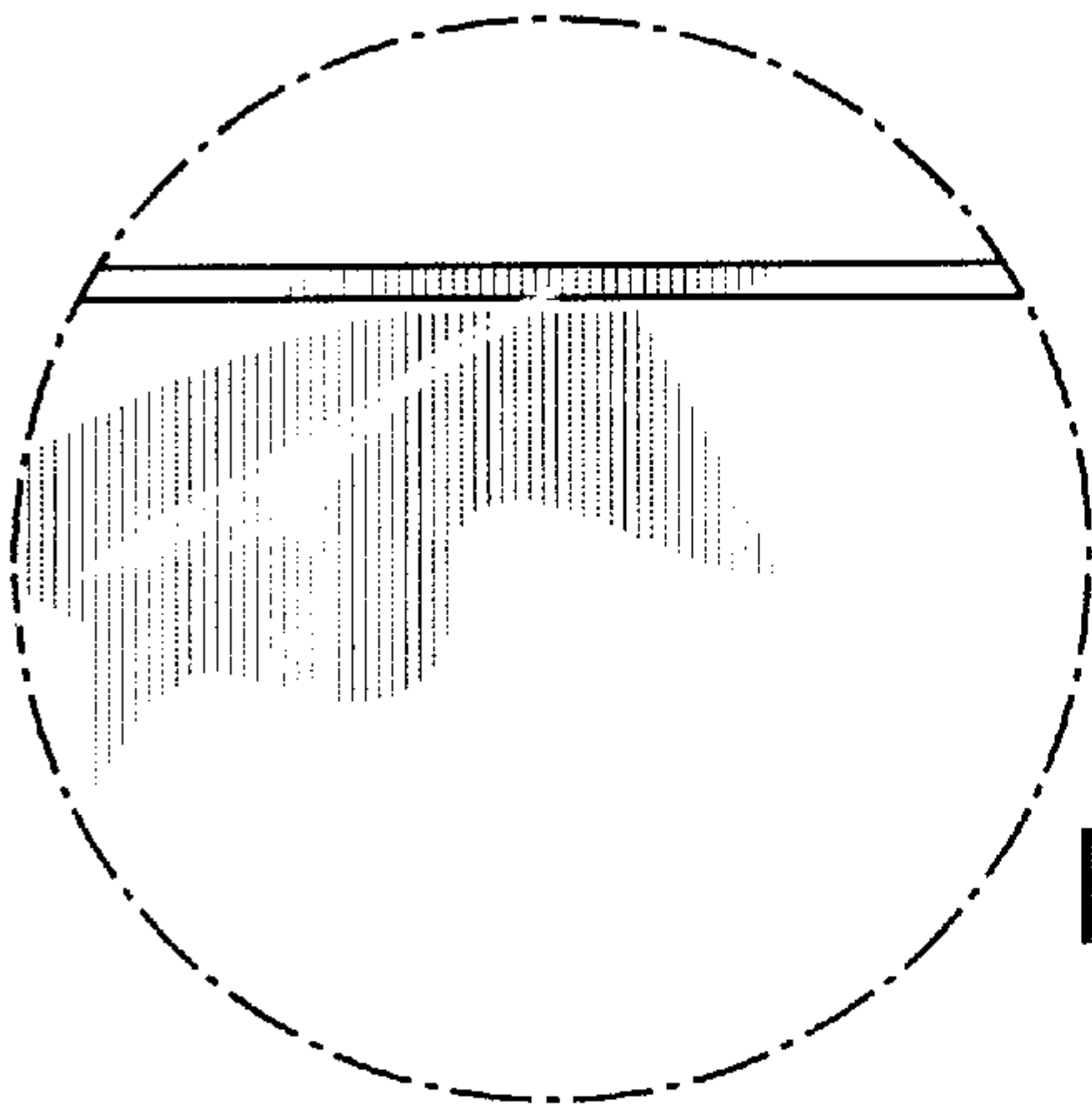

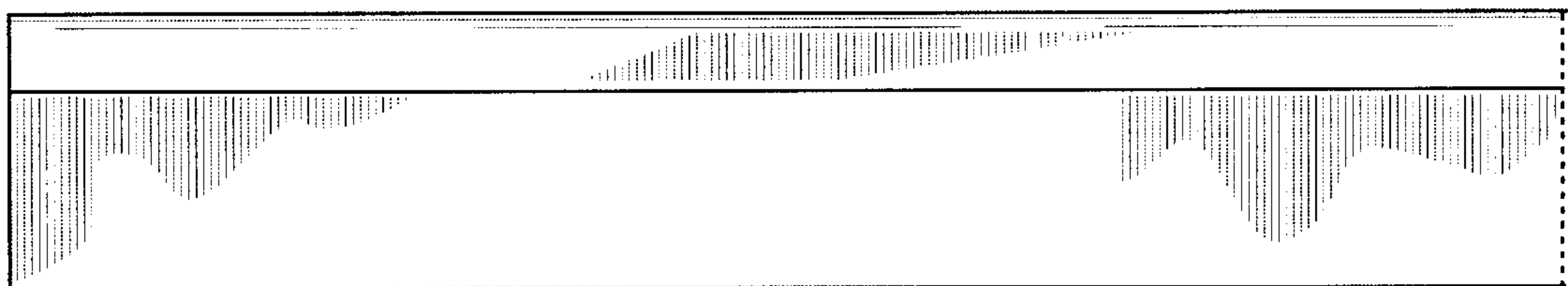

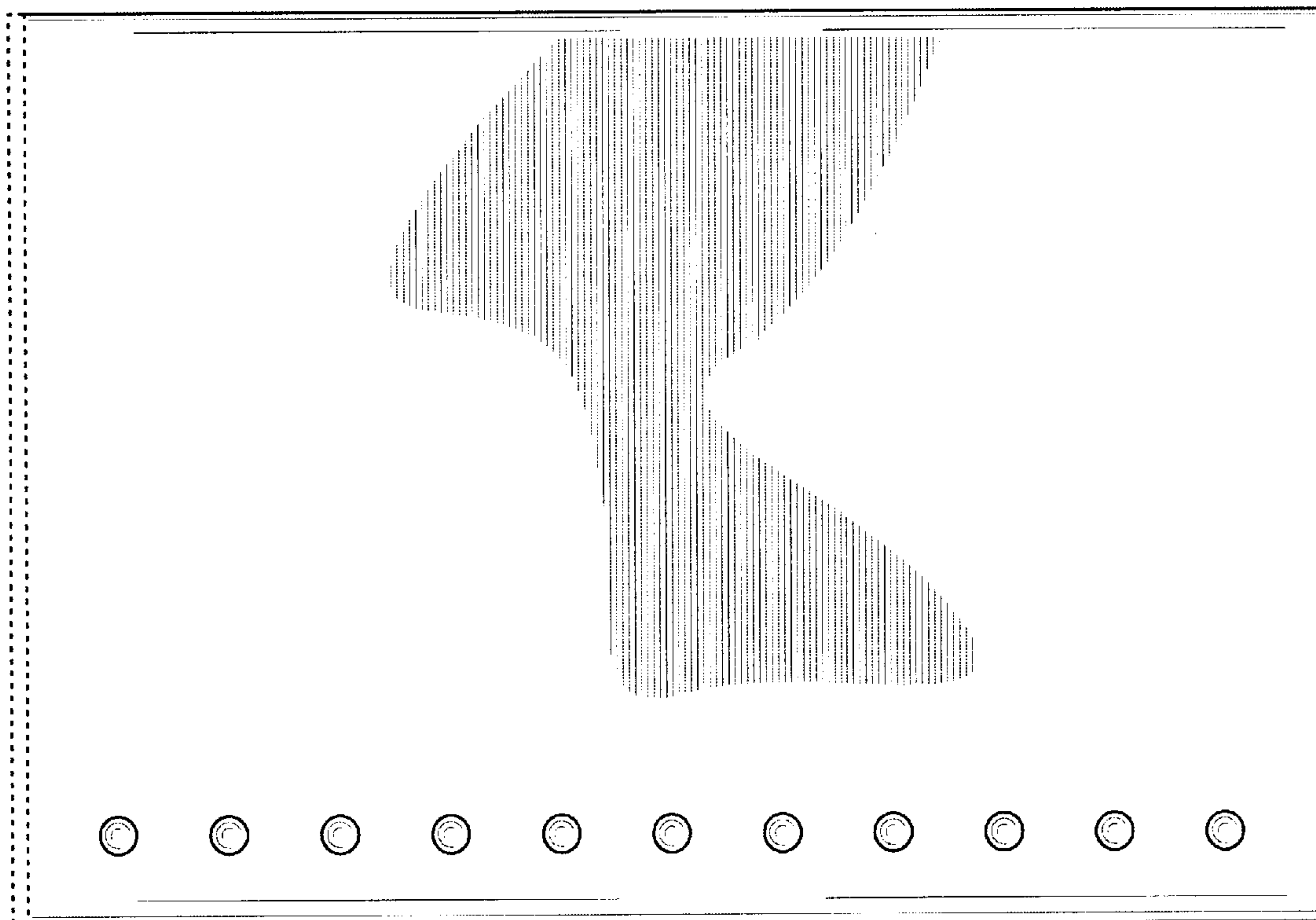
