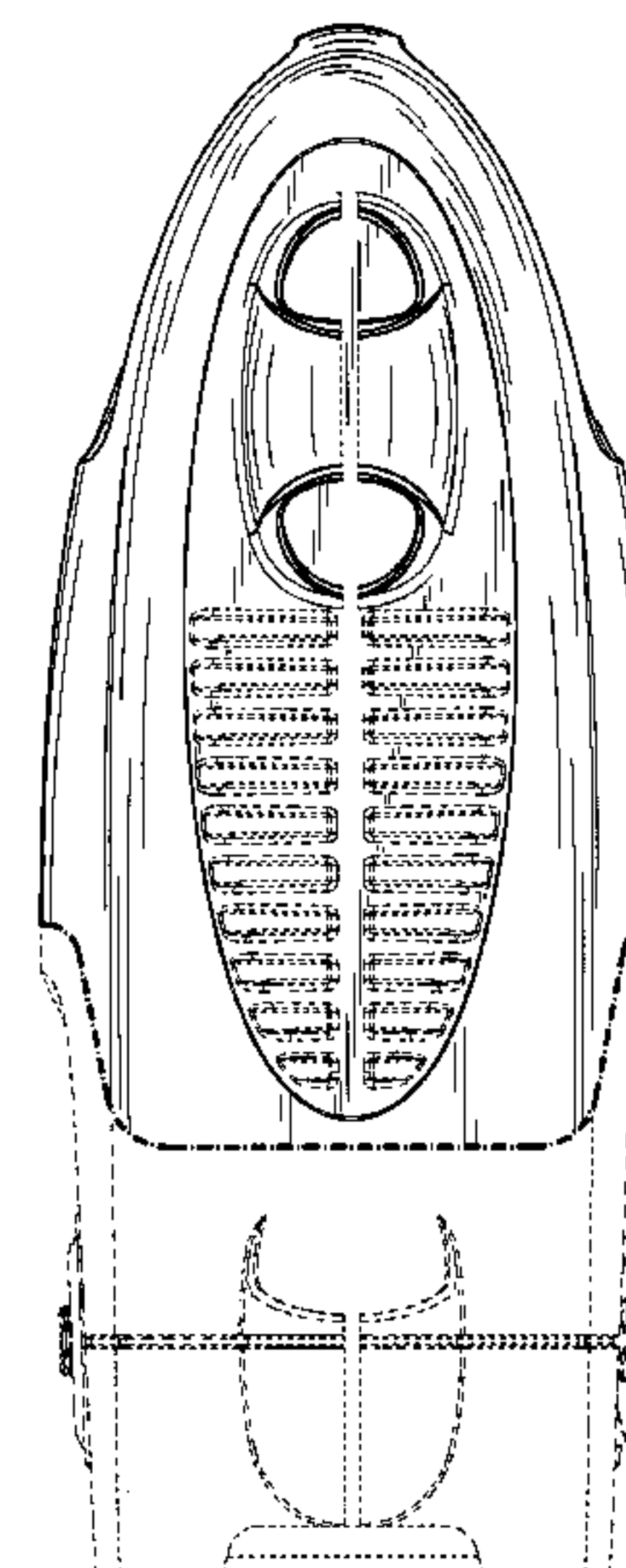
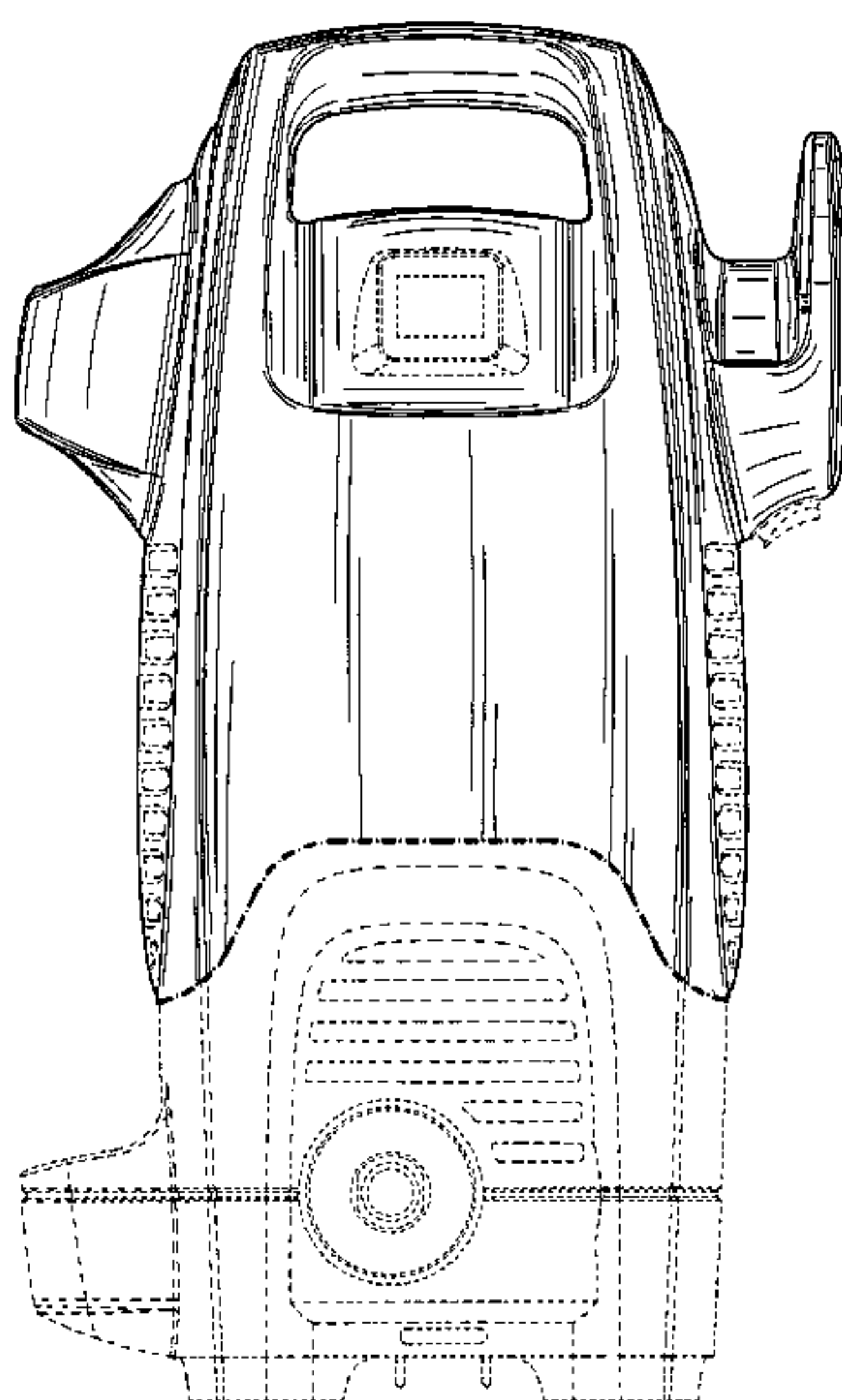
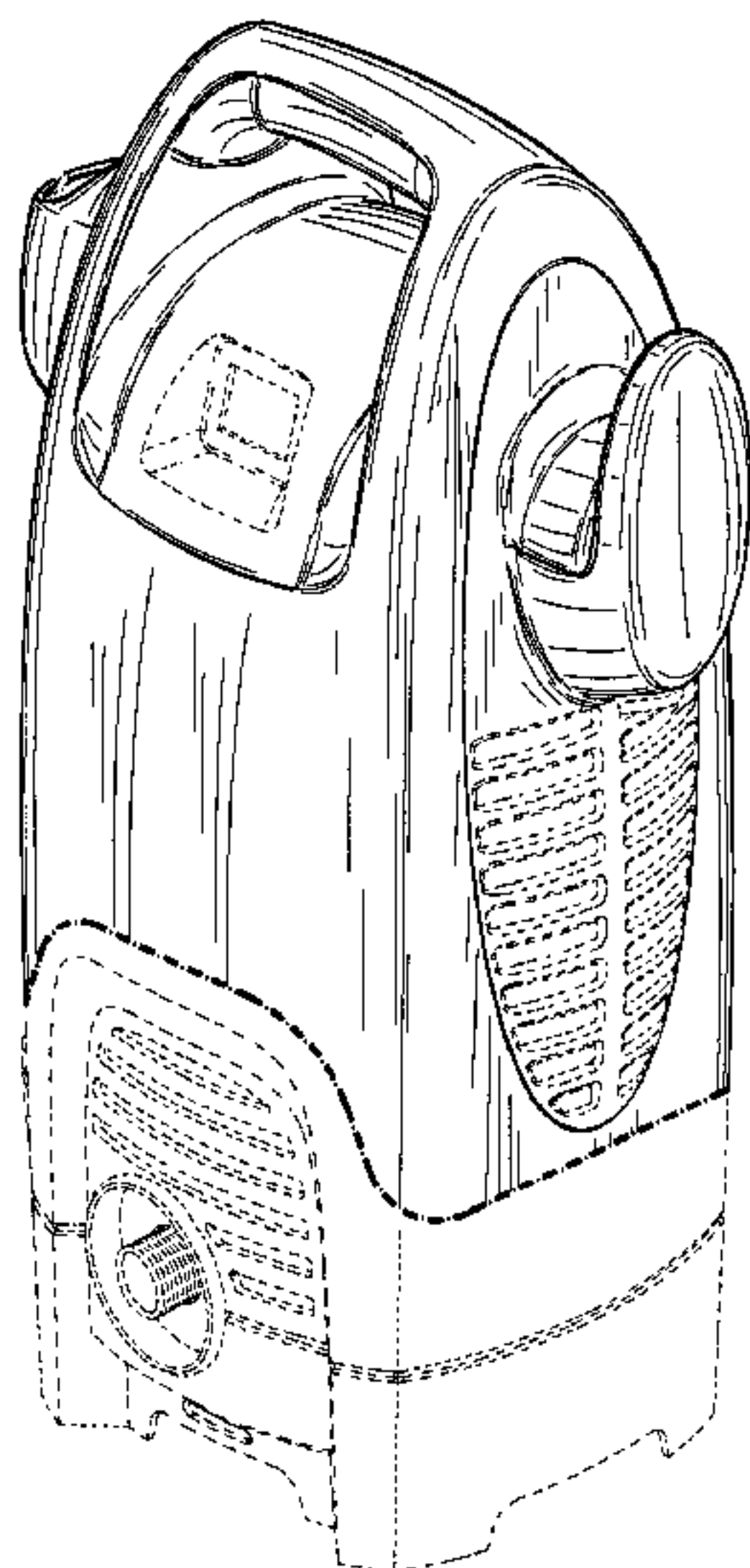
We claim the ornamental design for a pressure washer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pressure washer embodying the ornamental design of the present invention; FIG. 2 is another perspective view of the pressure washer; FIG. 3 is a front view of the pressure washer; FIG. 4 is a rear view of the pressure washer; FIG. 5 is a side view of the pressure washer; FIG. 6 is an opposite side view of the pressure washer; and, FIG. 7 is a top view of the pressure washer.

The broken lines in FIGS. 1-7 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. More specifically, dashed broken lines indicate unclaimed features. A dot-dash broken line, shown with heavier weight than the dashed broken lines and extending fully around the pressure washer, defines a lower boundary of the claimed design.

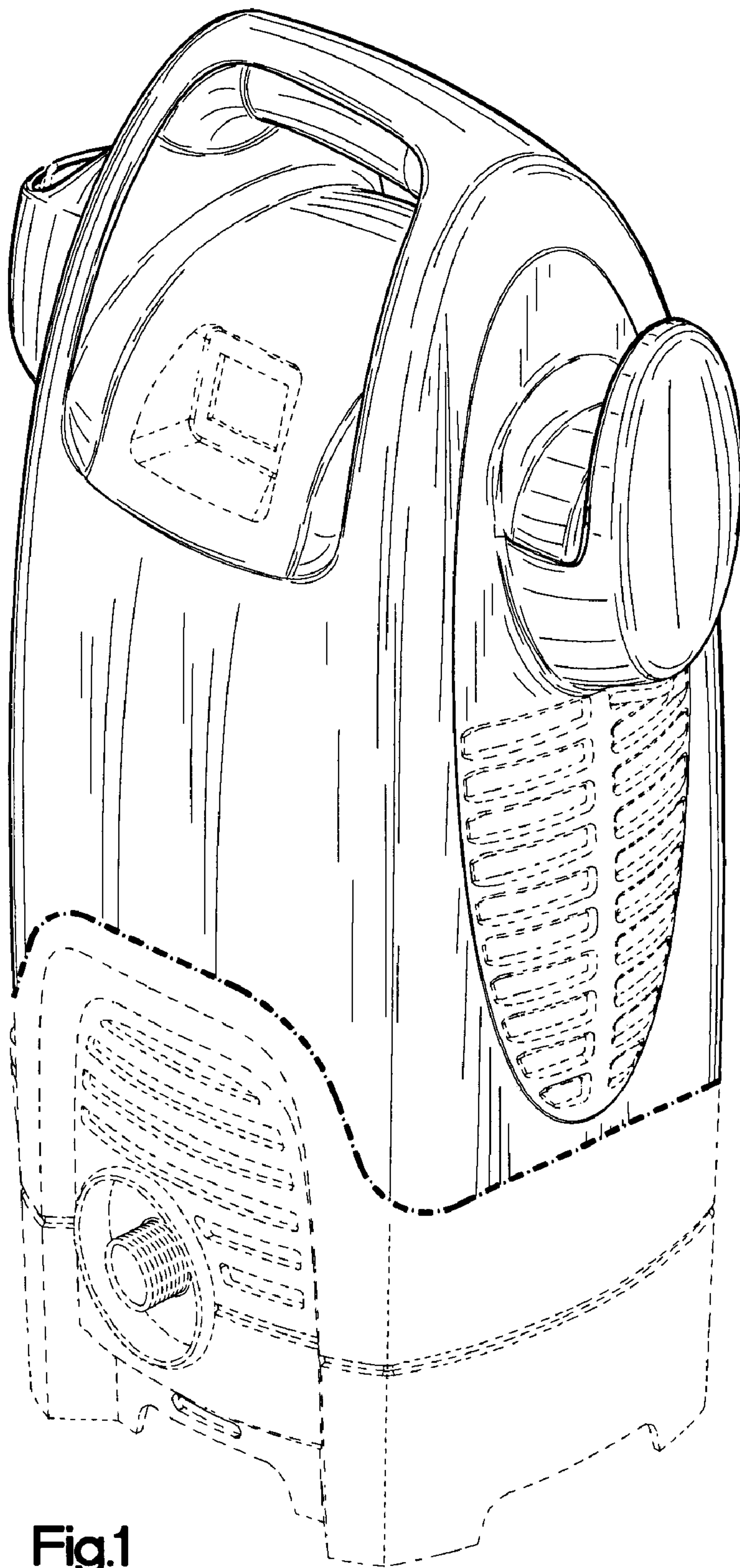

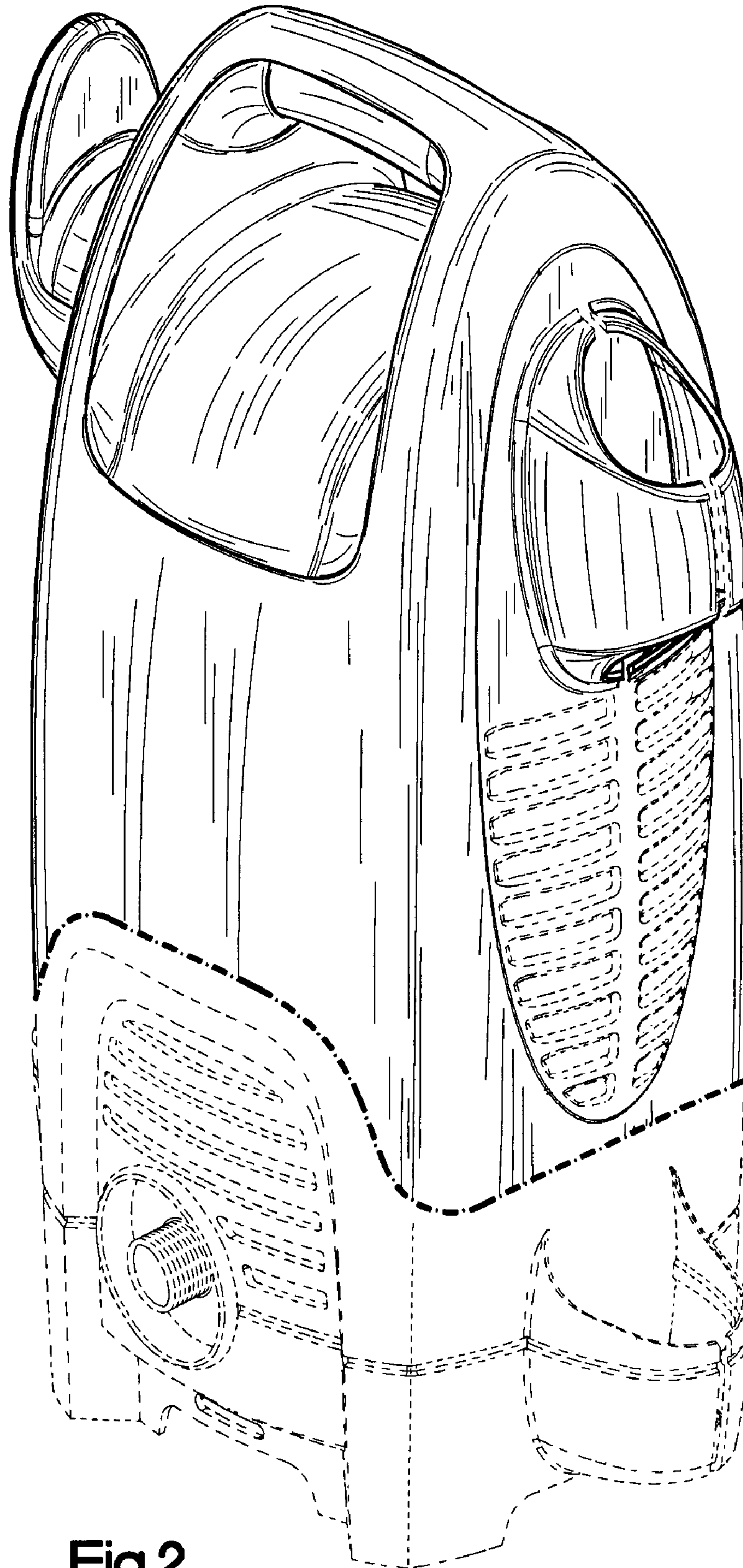

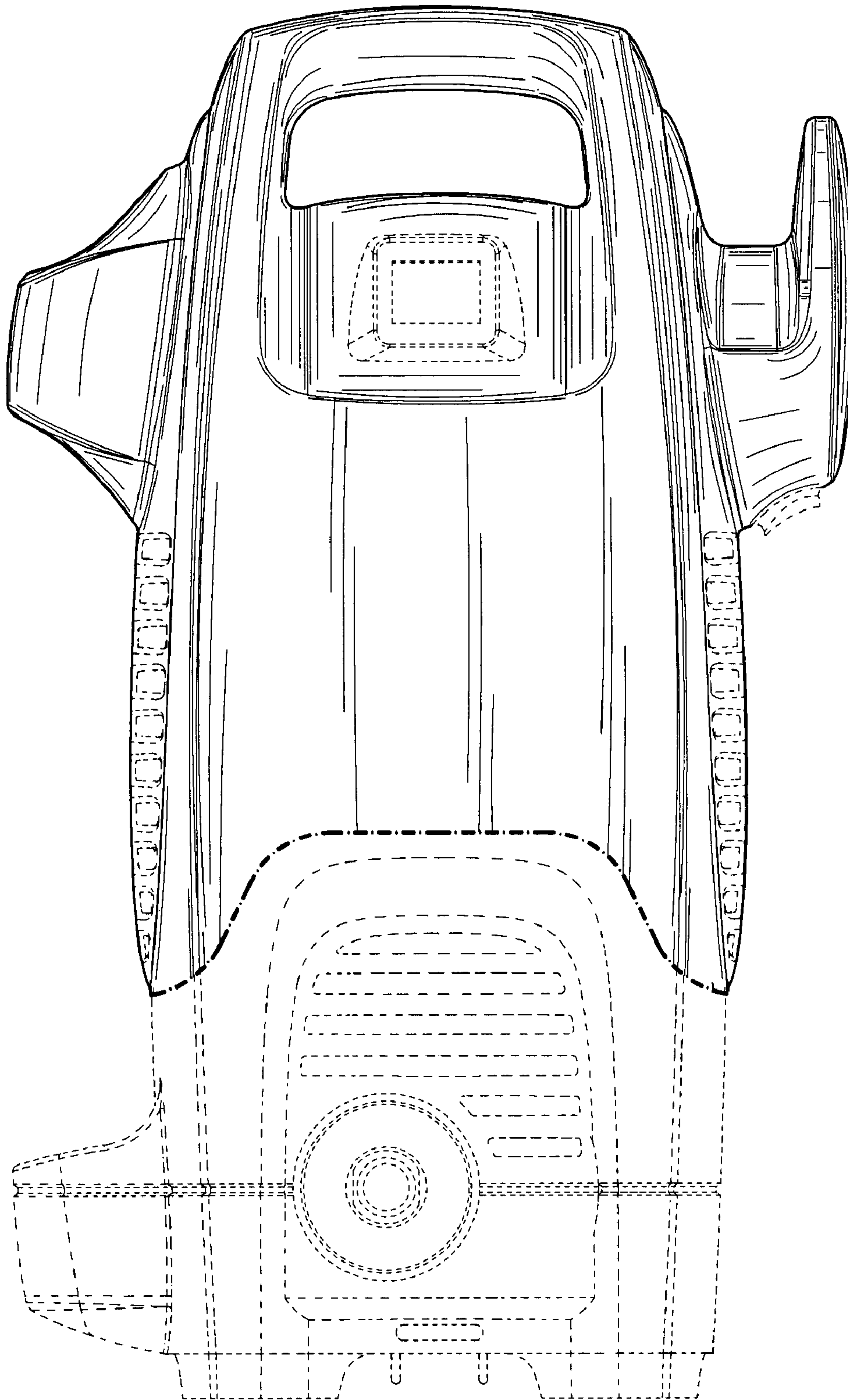

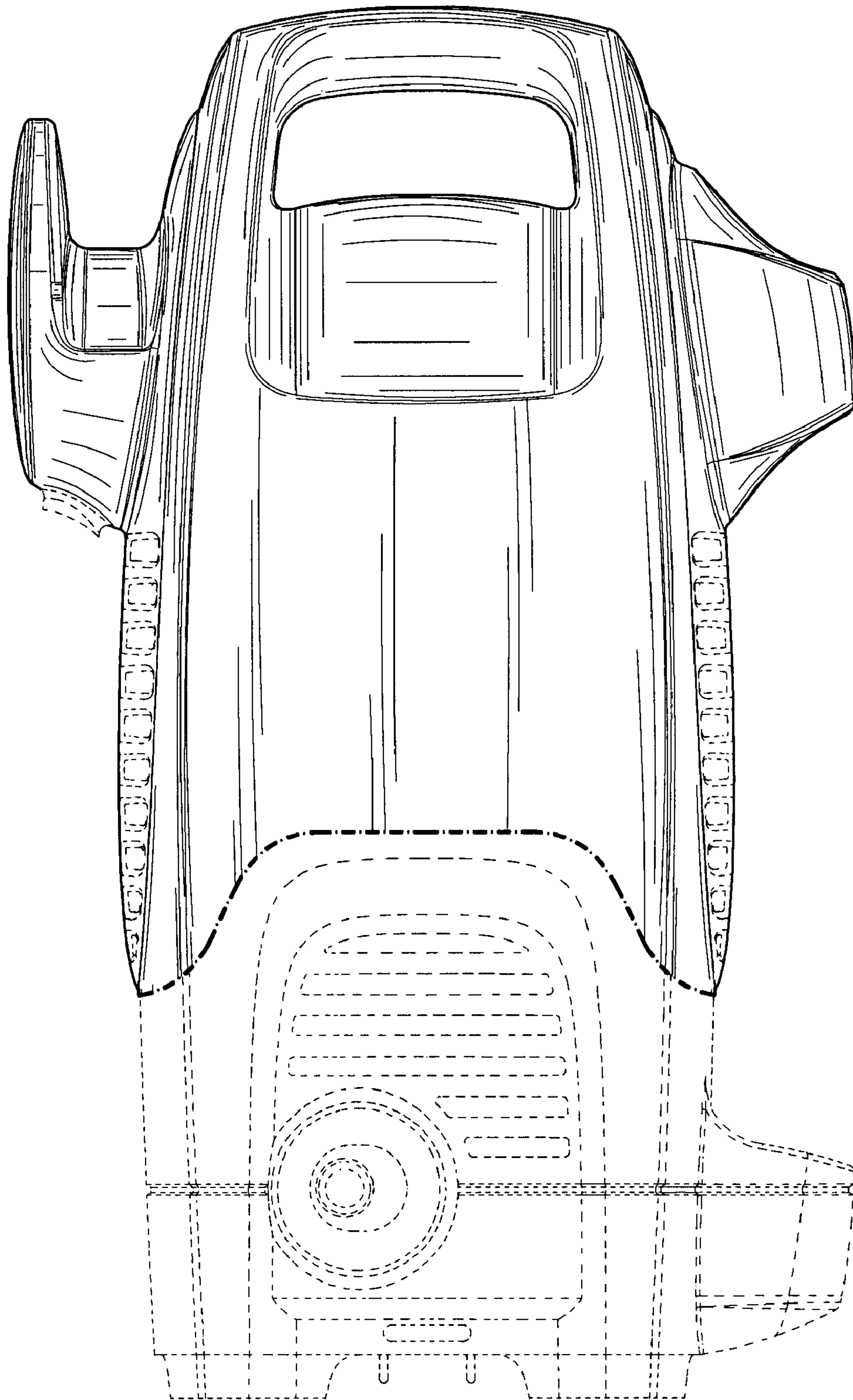

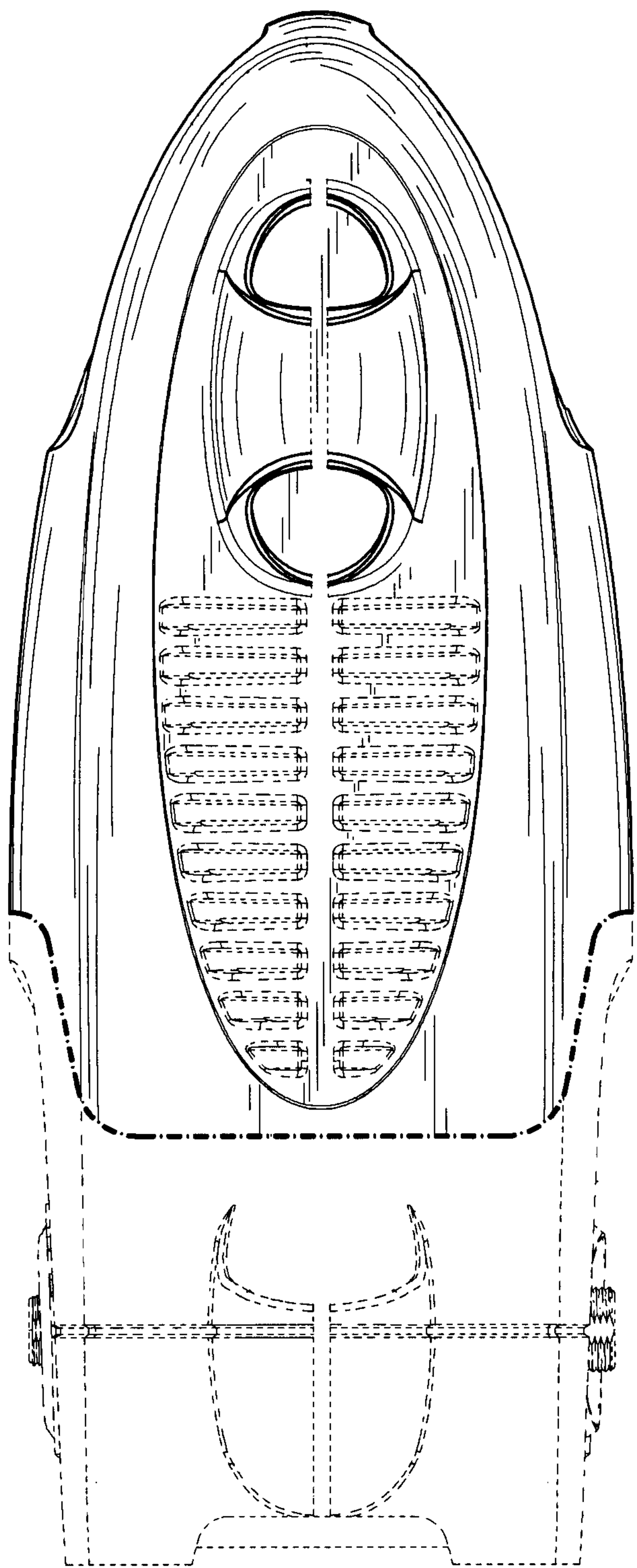

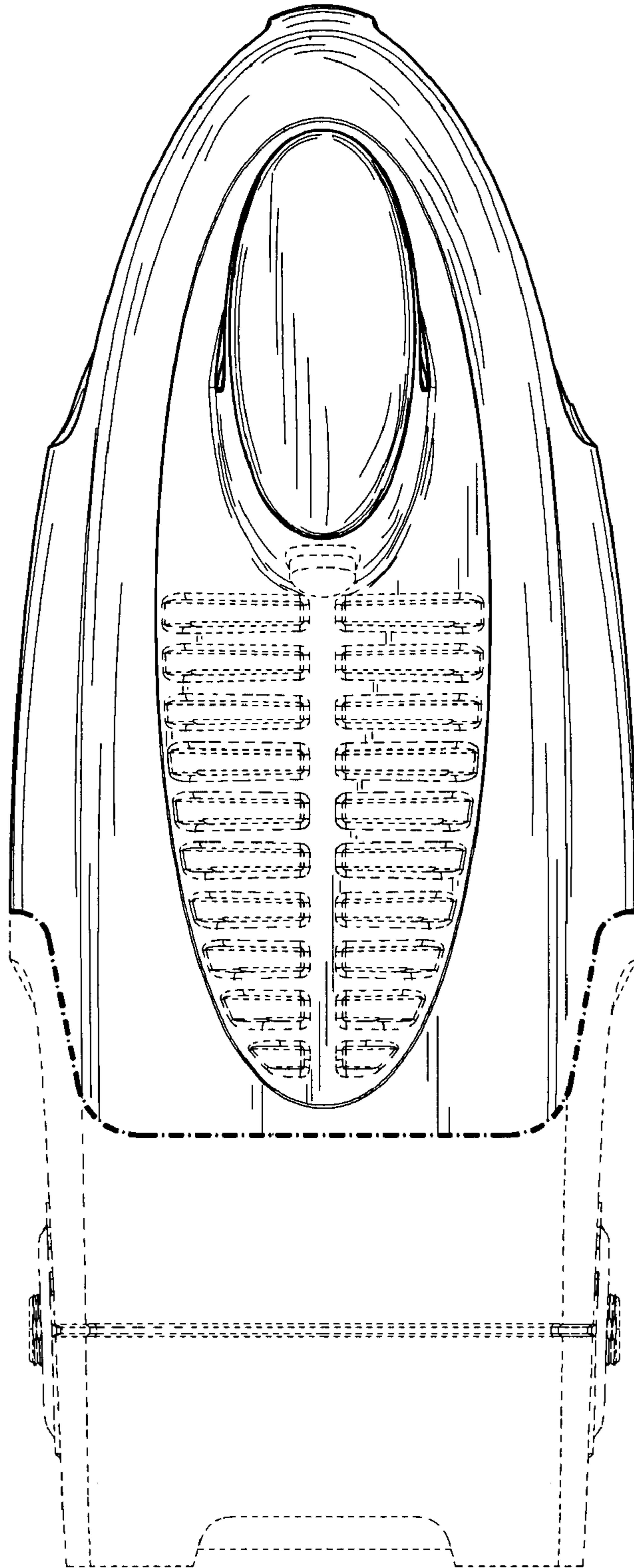

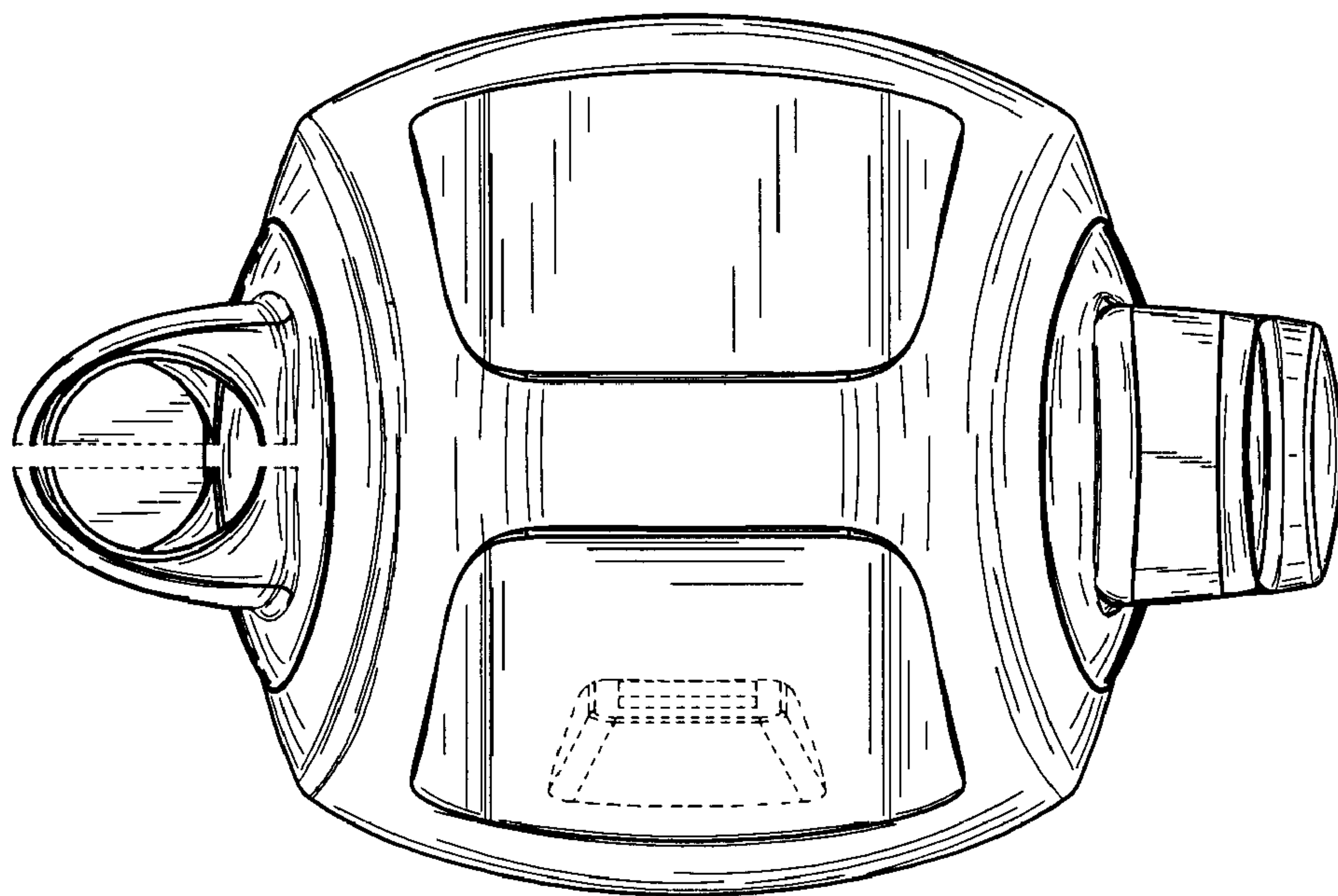
