CLAIM

The ornamental design for a merchandising display, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a merchandising display showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 2—2 of FIG. 1; and,

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.

The cut line shown in FIGS. 1 and 2 indicates that a particular width of the merchandising display is not being claimed.

The broken lines shown are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
