DESCRIPTION

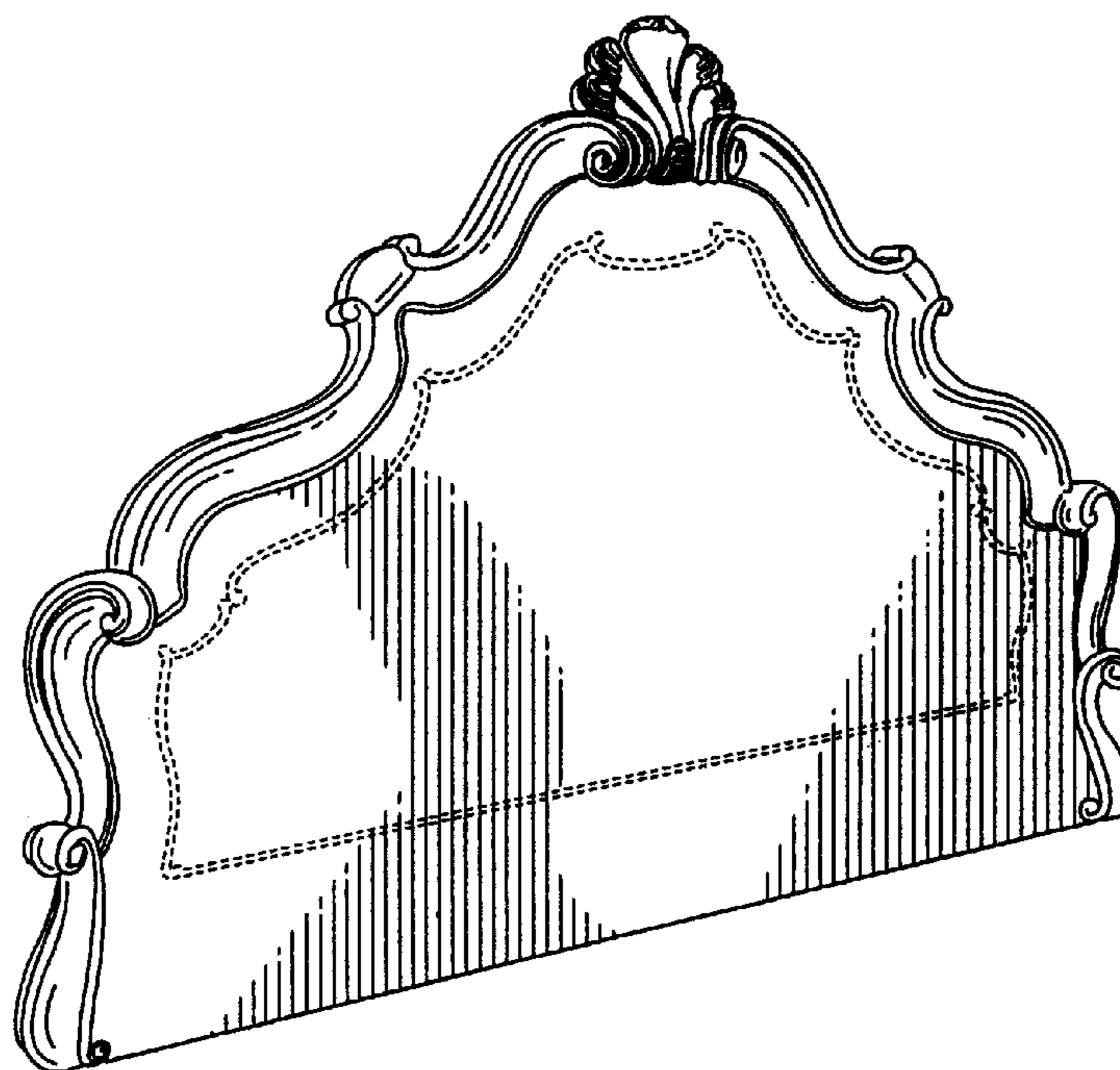
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a headboard showing my new design;

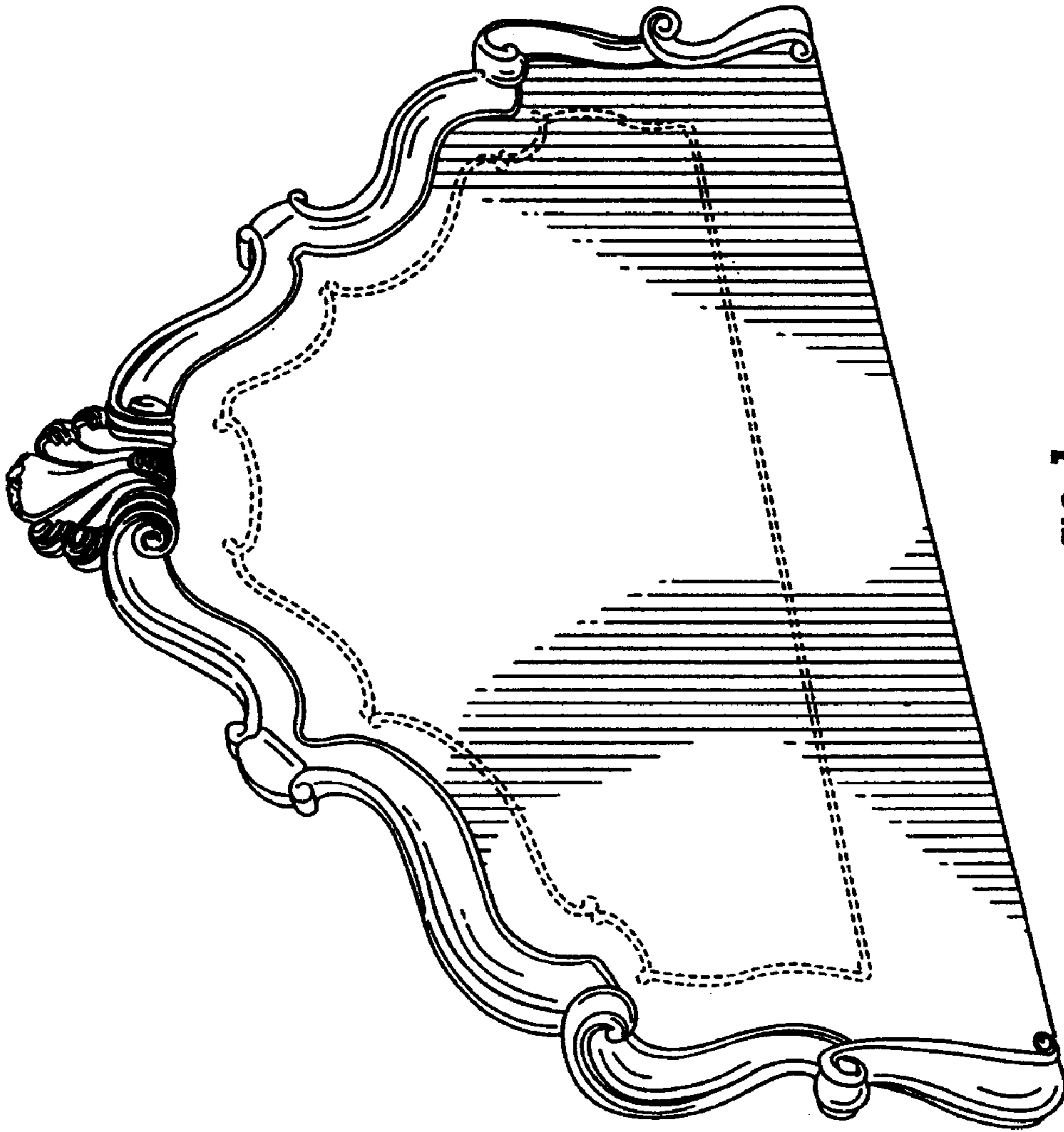

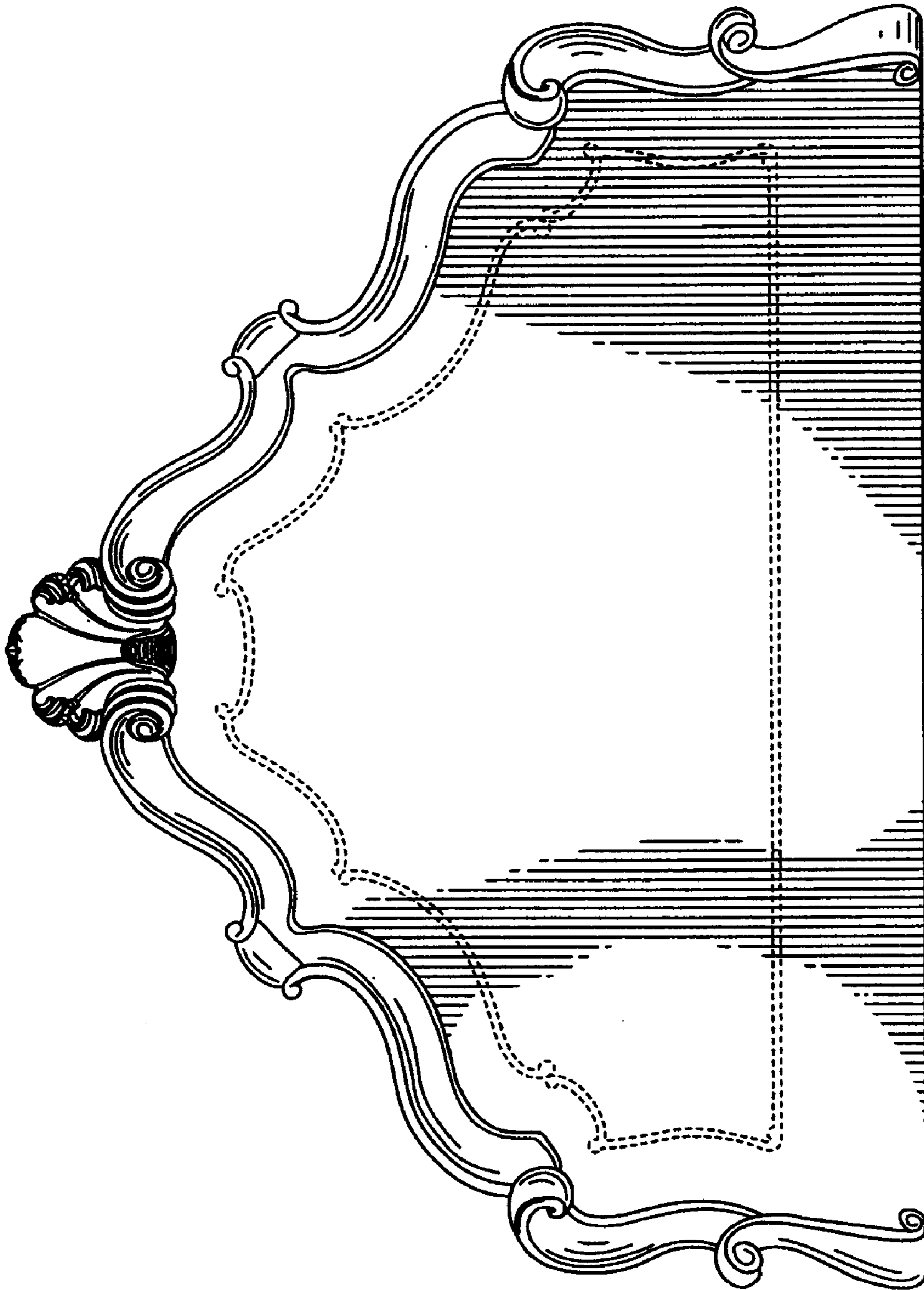
