FIG. 2 is a front view of the portion of the electrical component shown in FIG. 1.

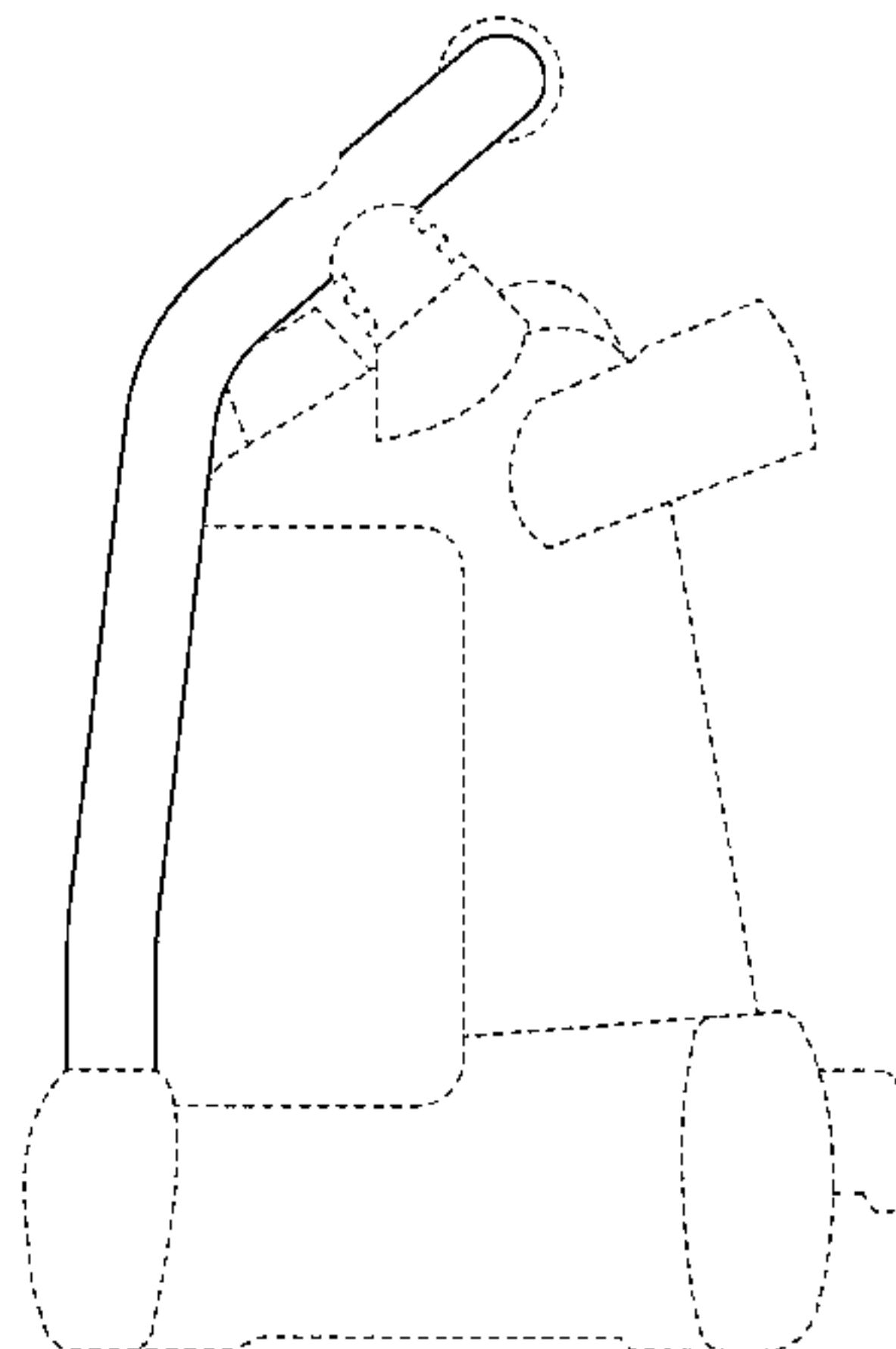

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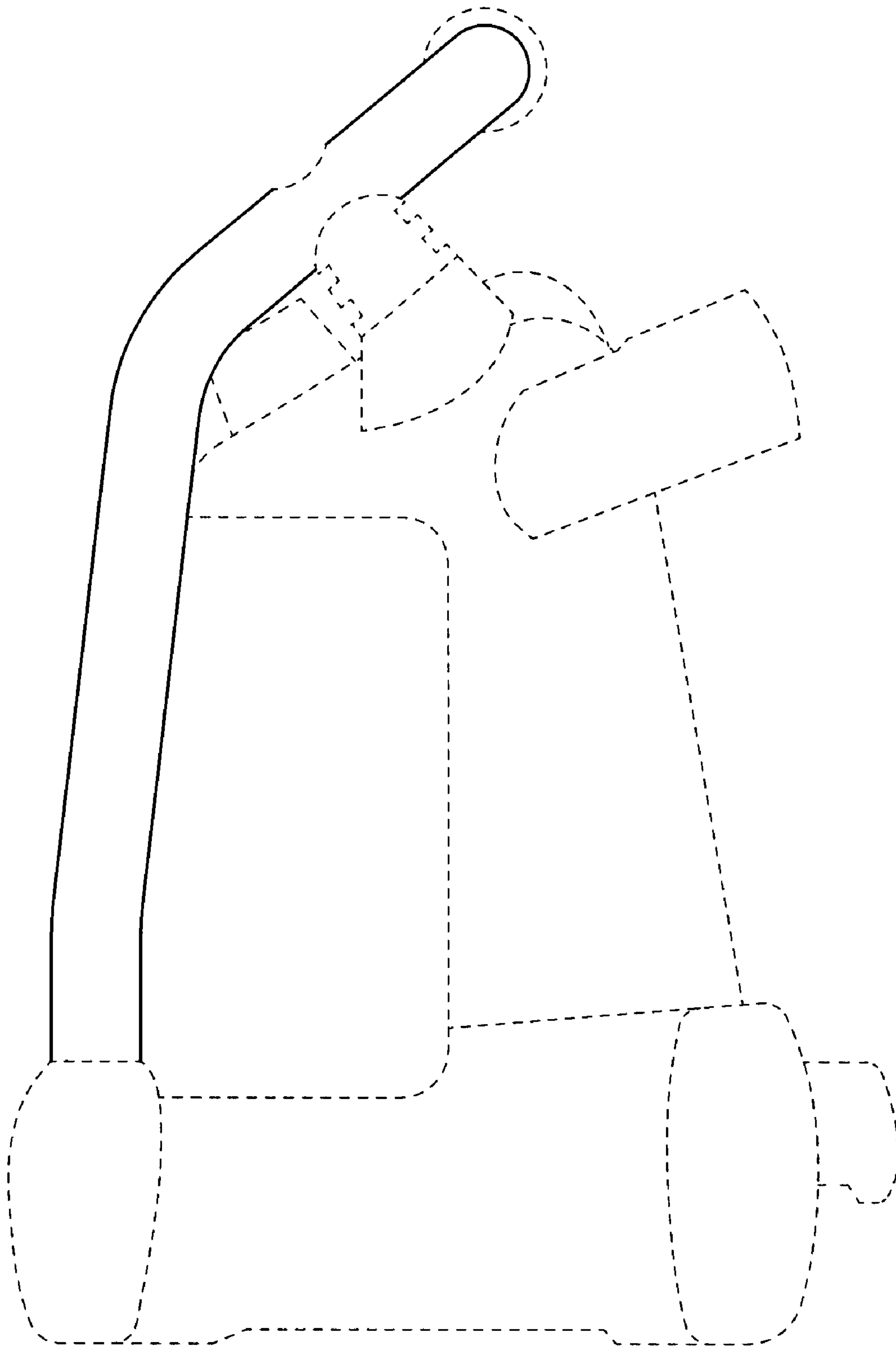

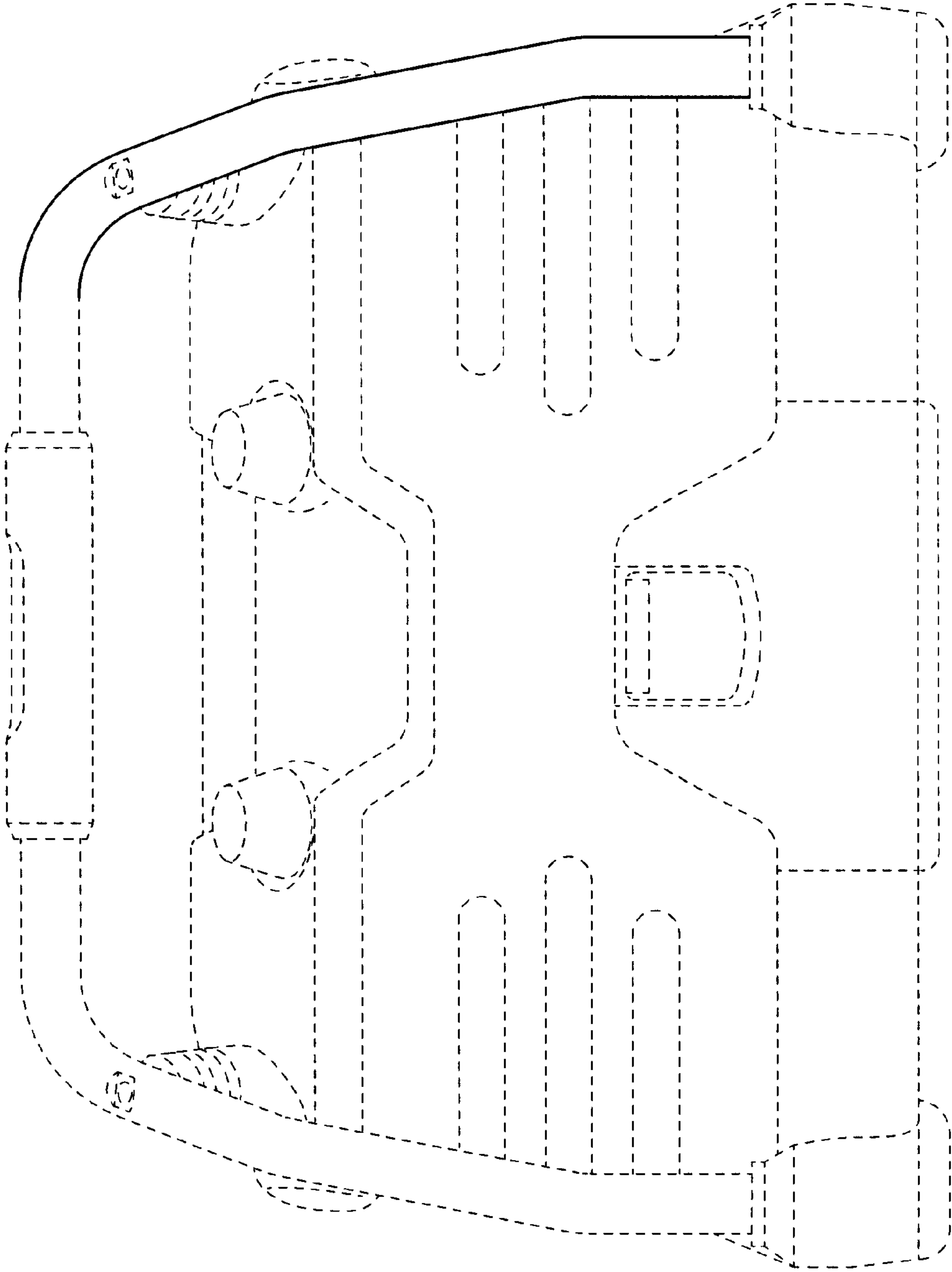
