We claim the ornamental design for a base portion for a radio, as shown and described.

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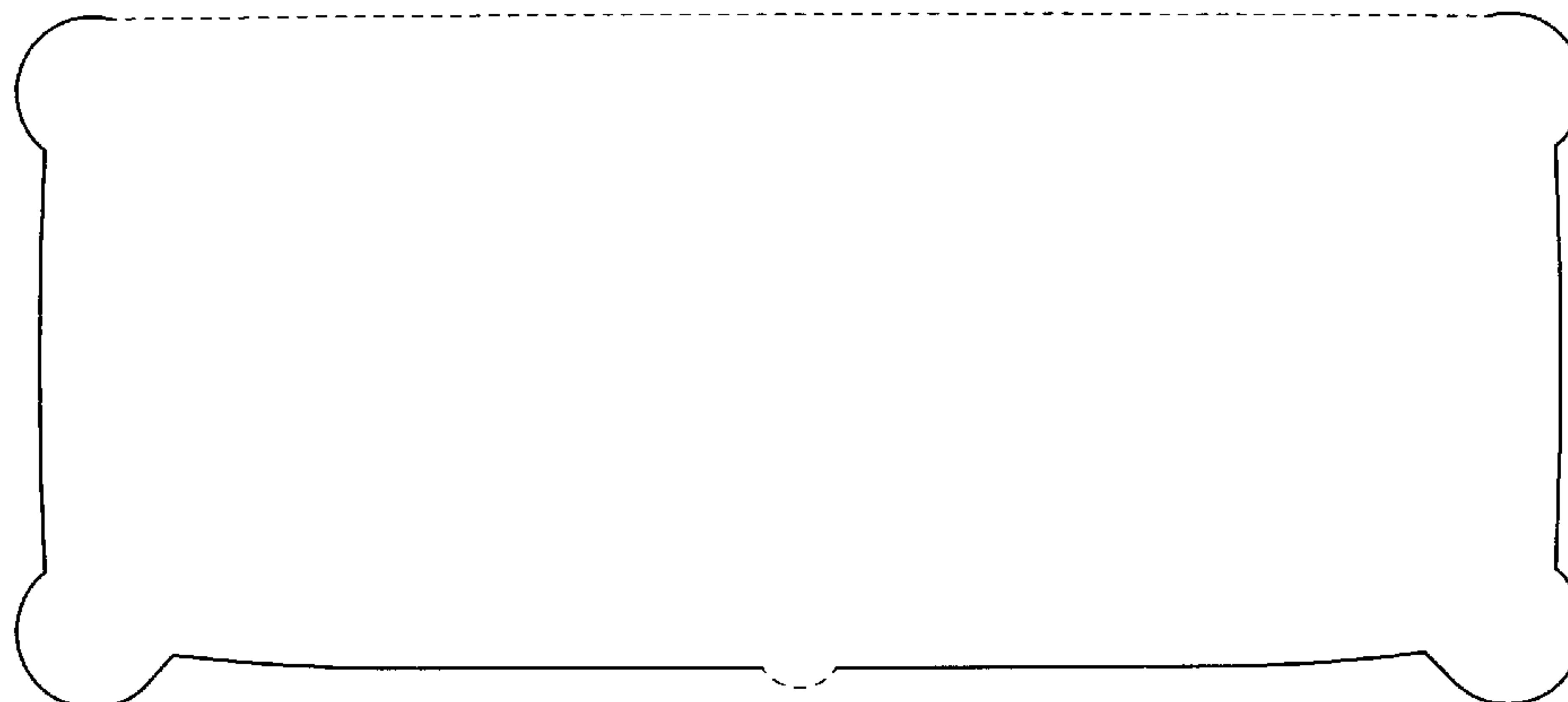
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DESCRIPTION

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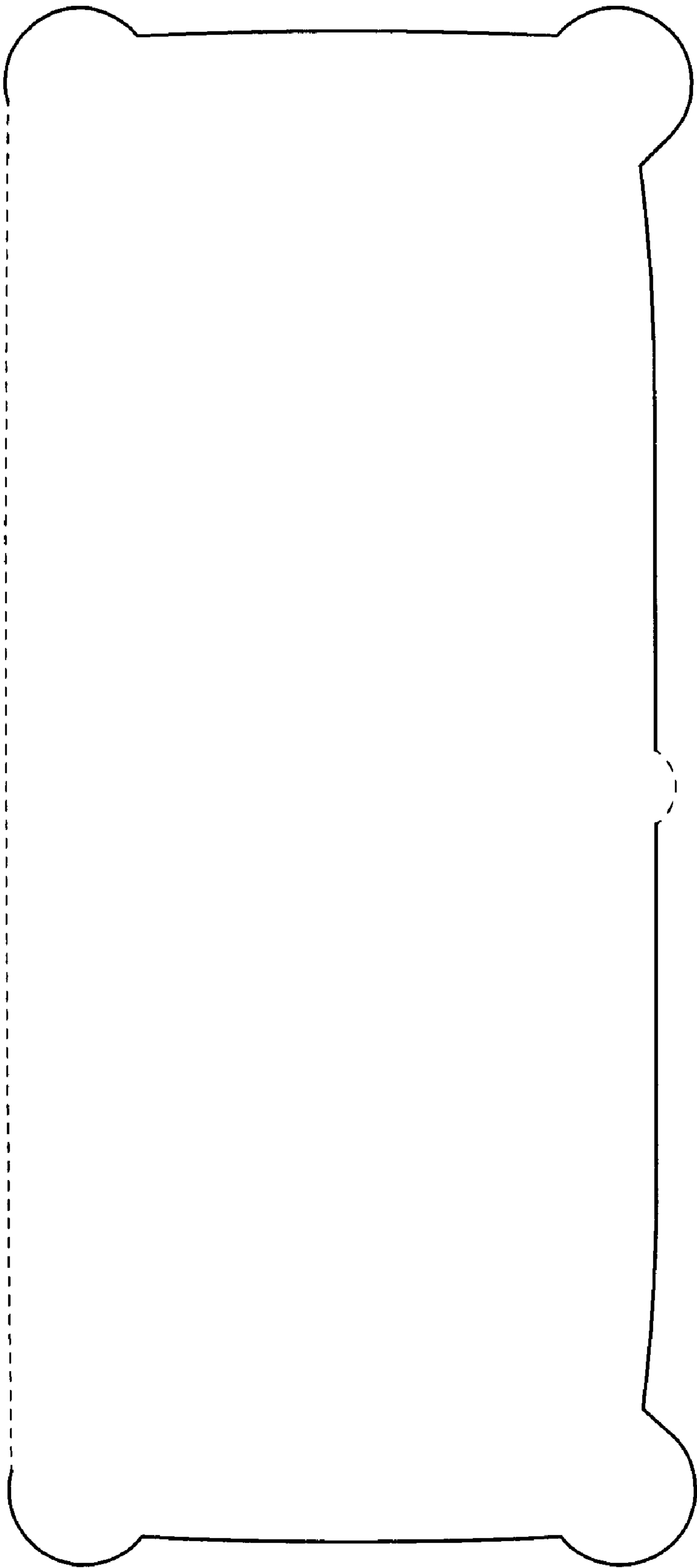
