FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

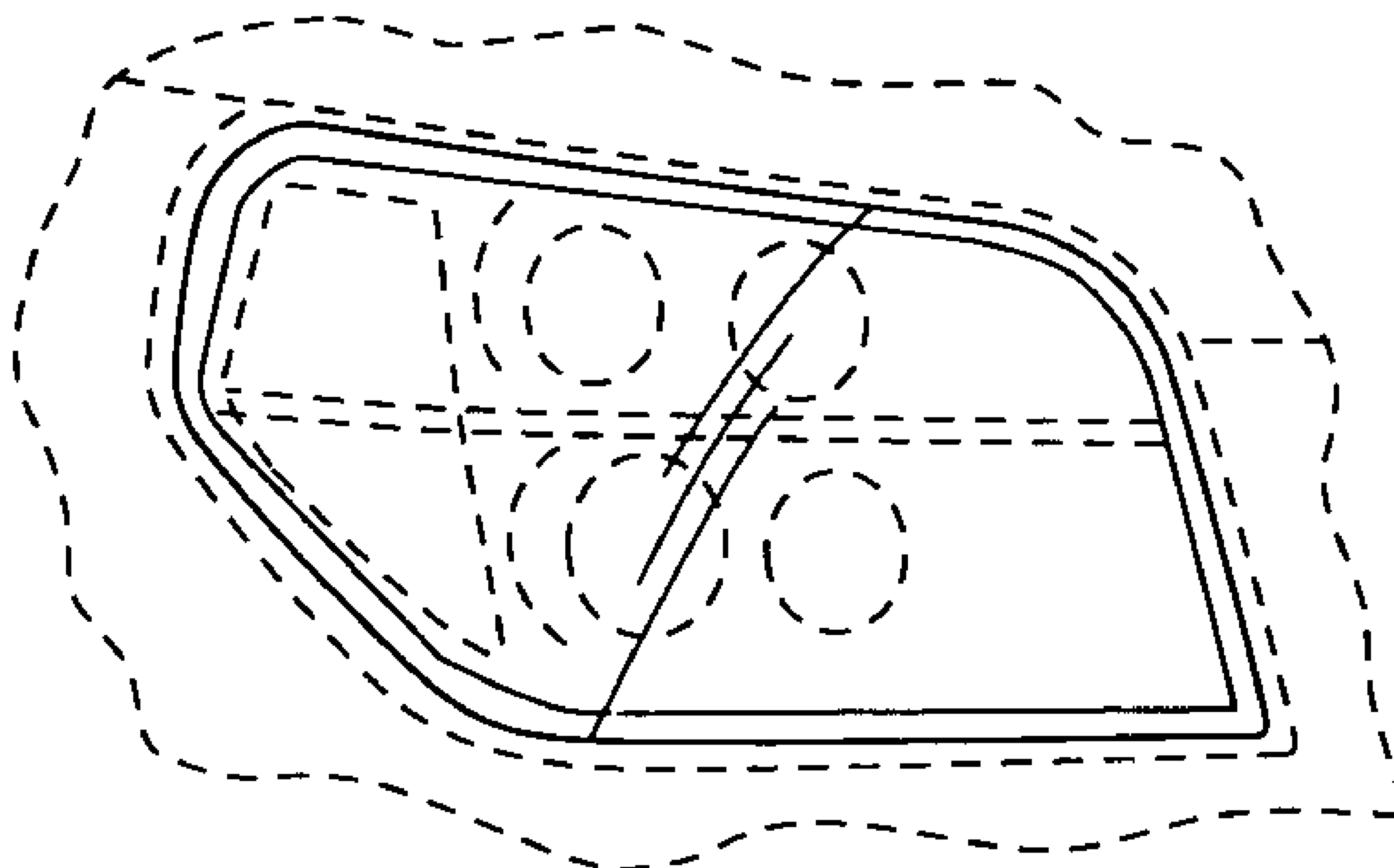
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of a left-handed version thereof;

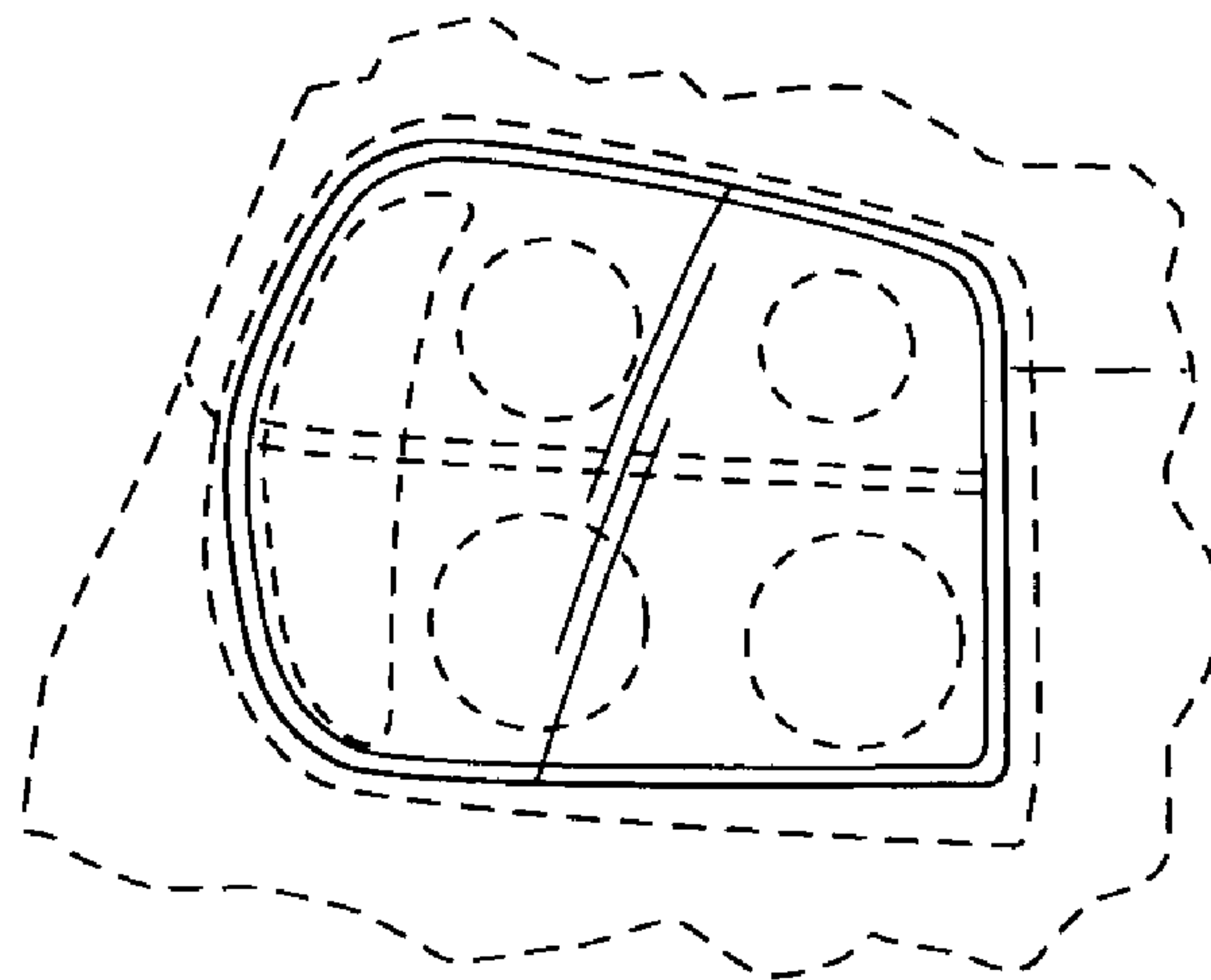

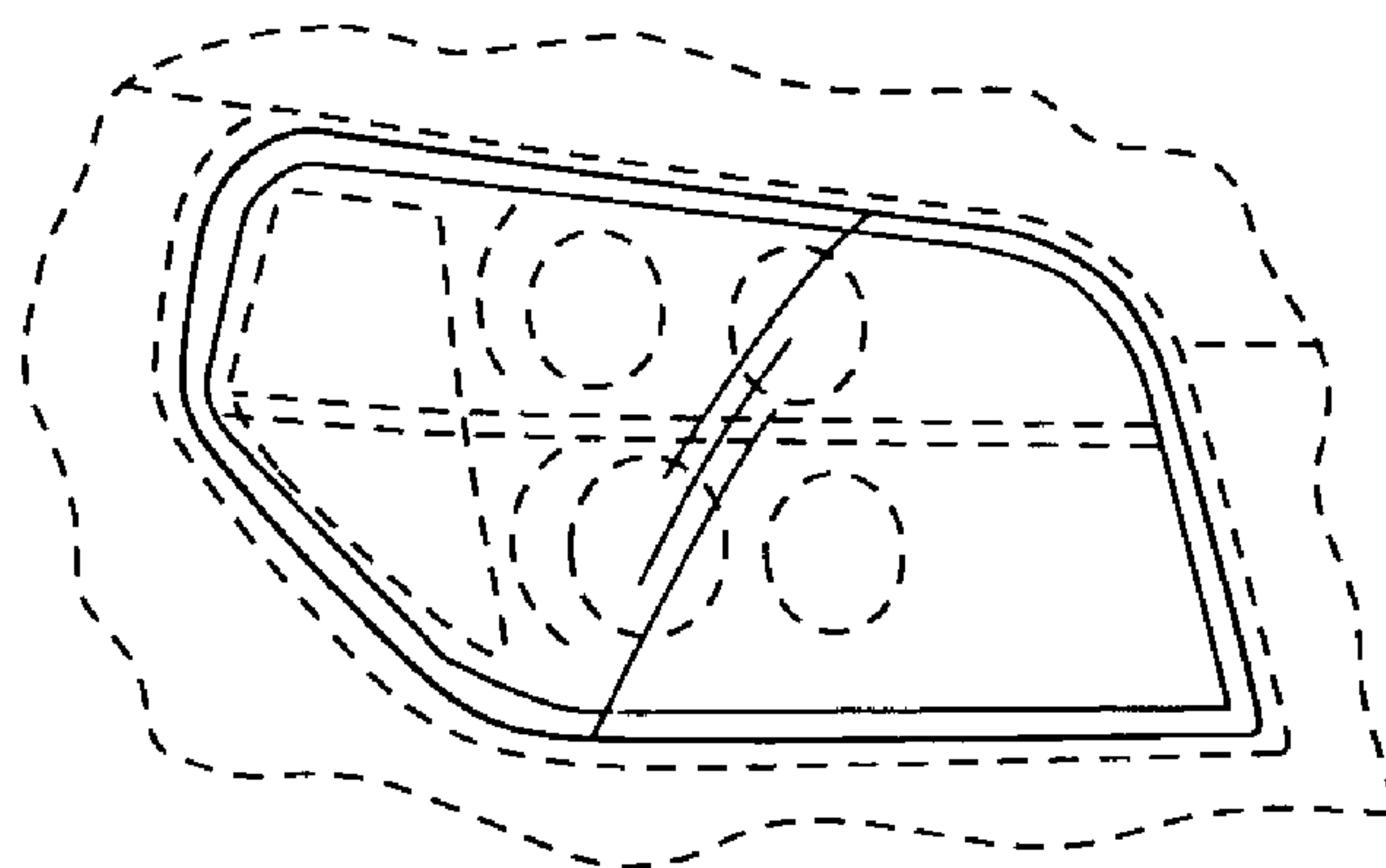

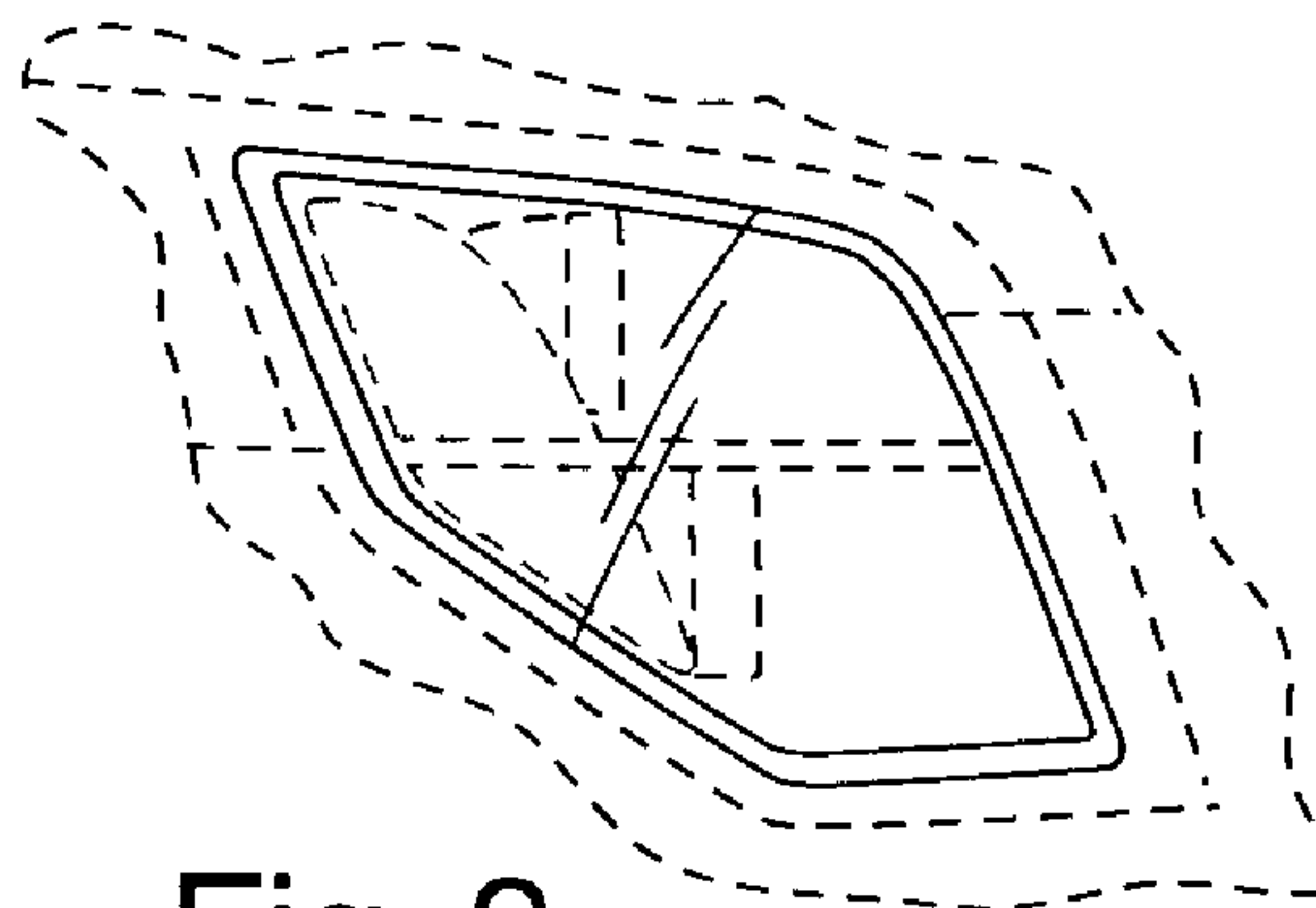

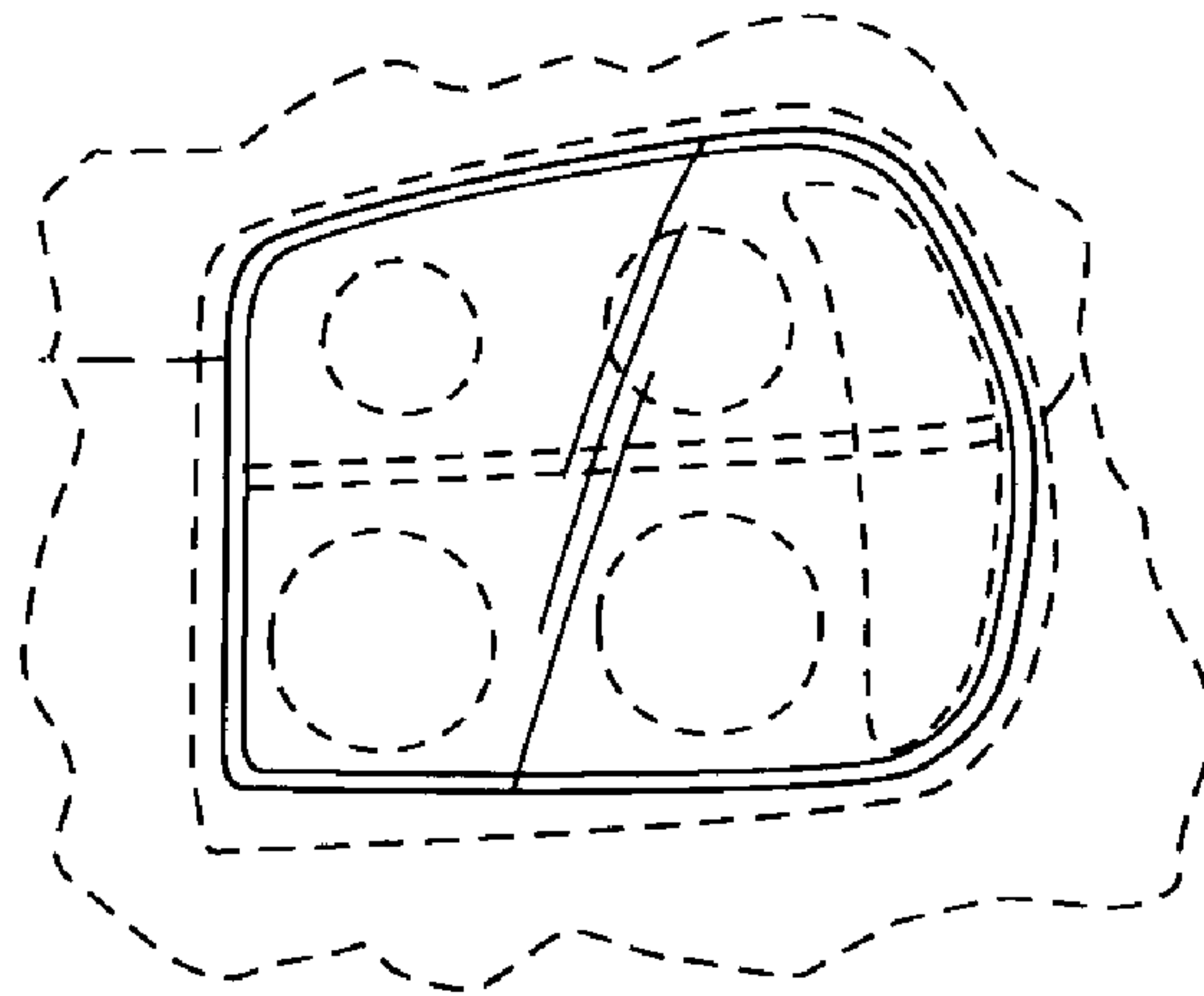

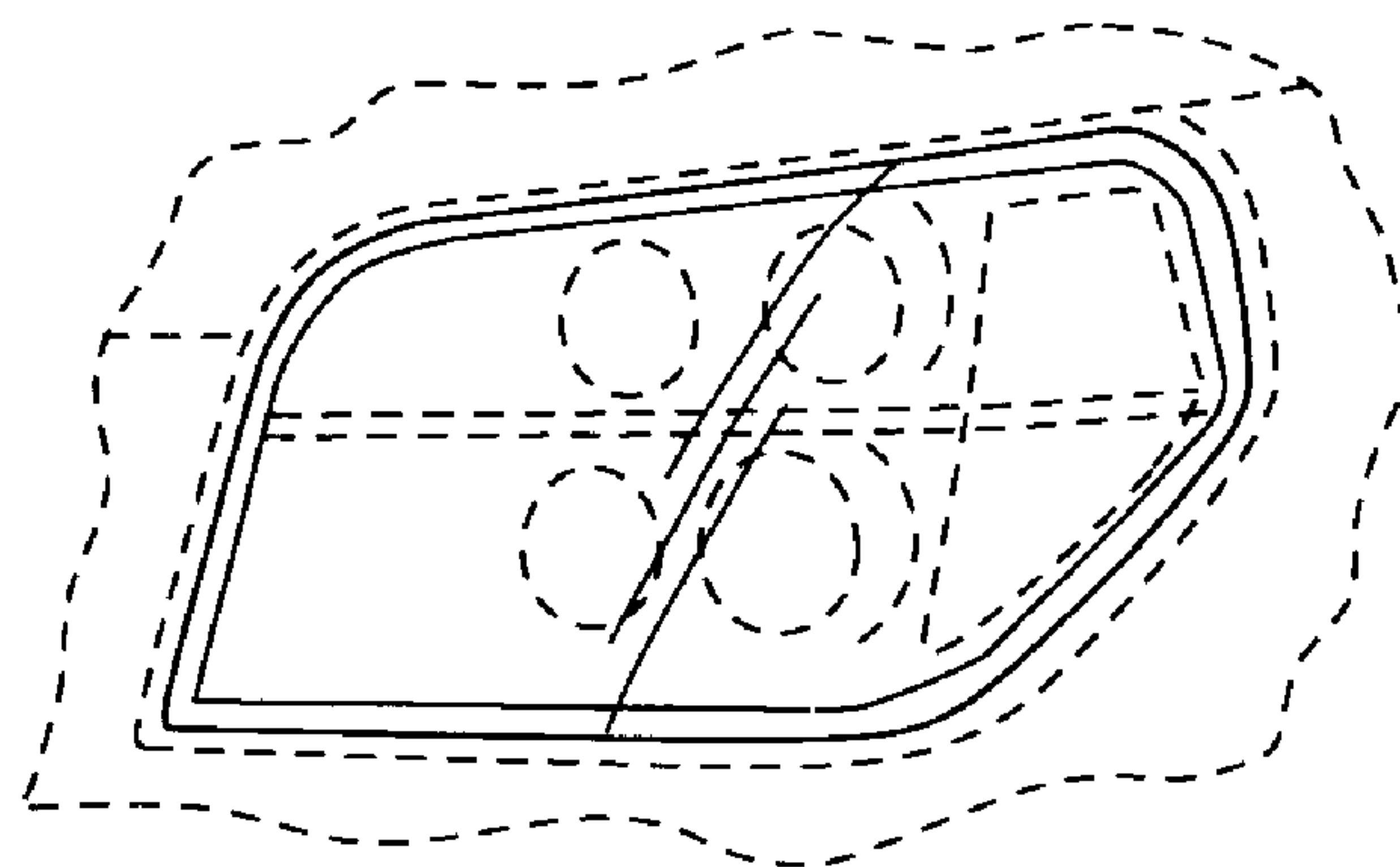

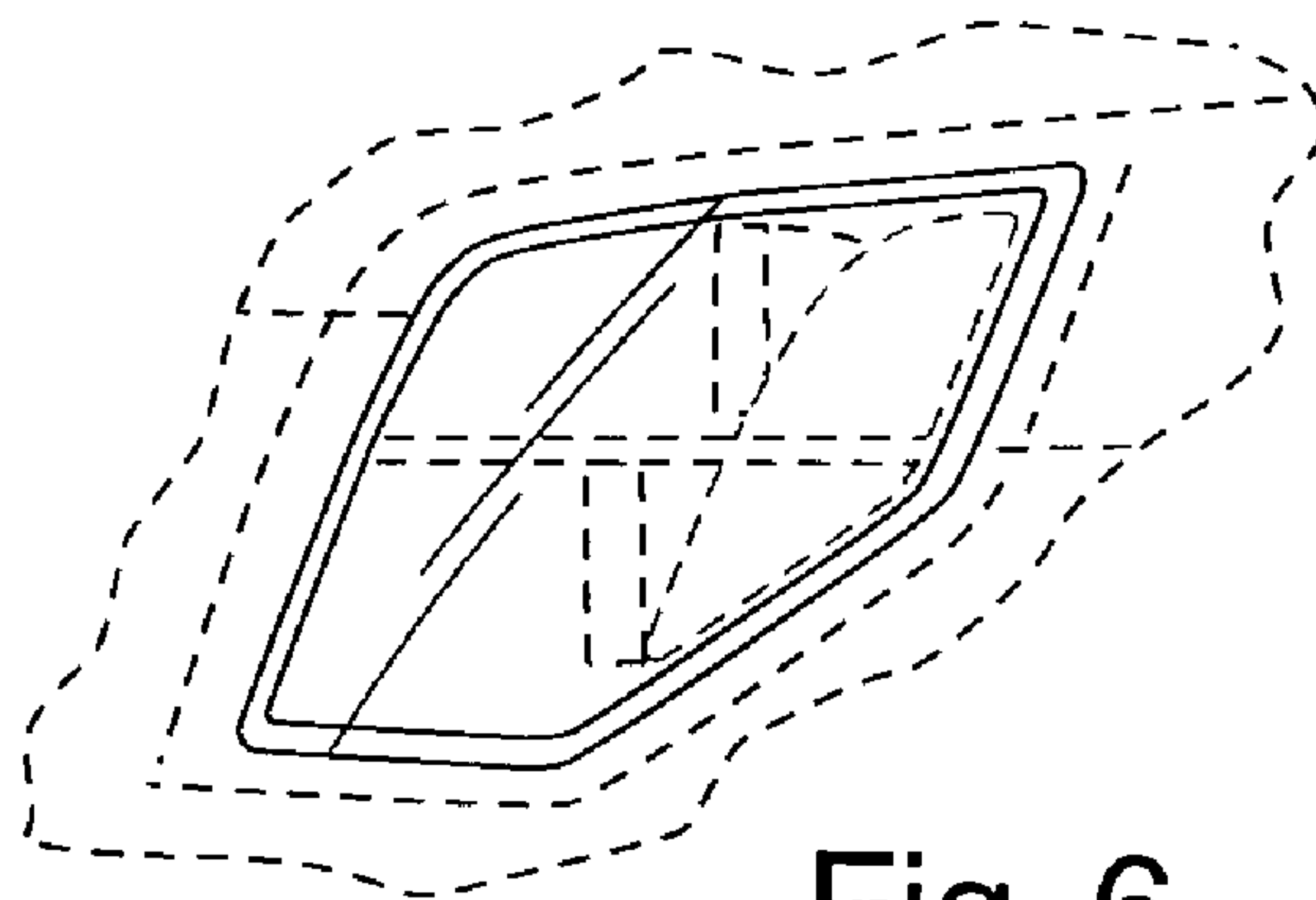
