FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of an insert for partition panel showing our new design;

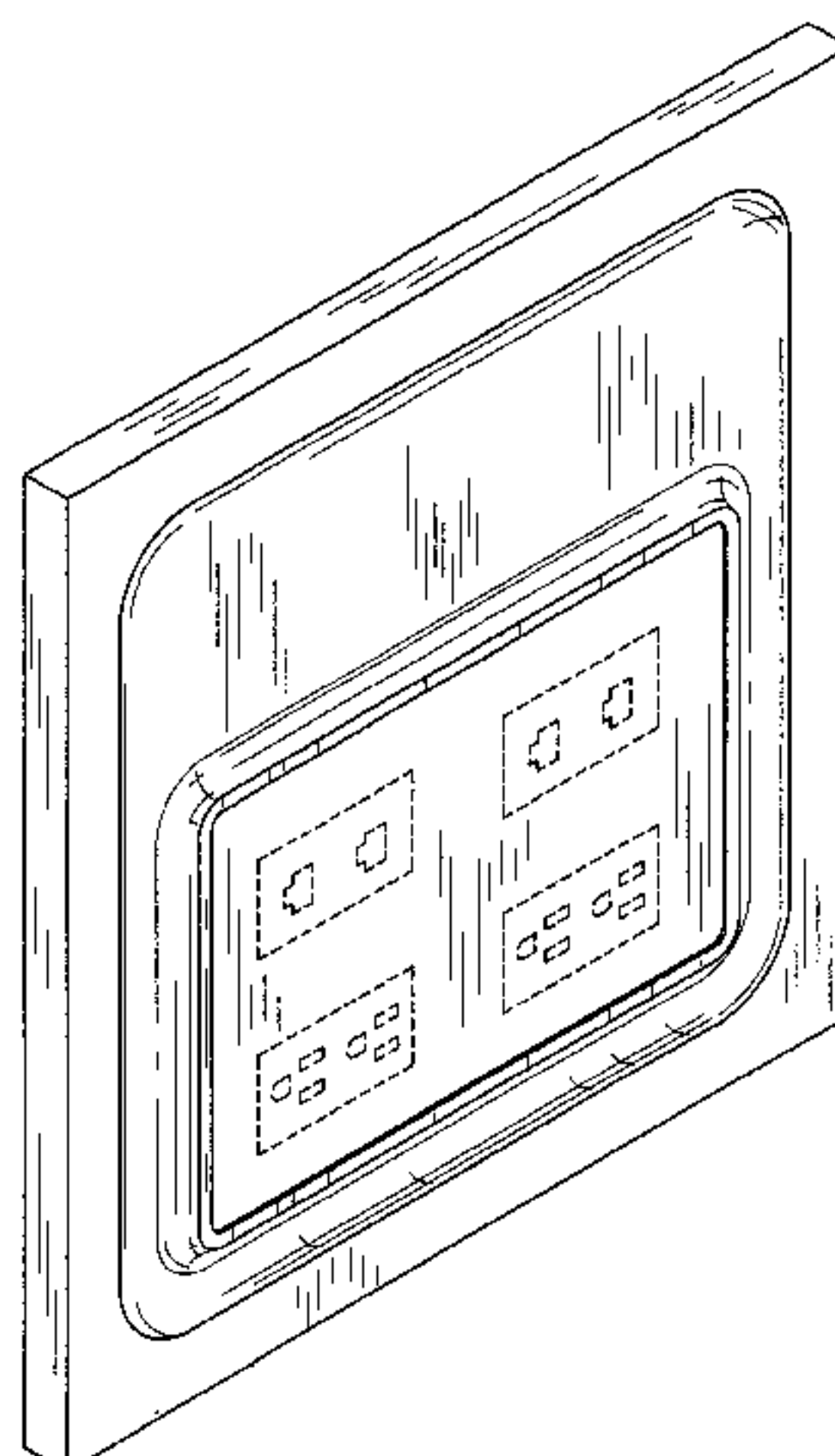
FIG. 10 is a front view thereof;

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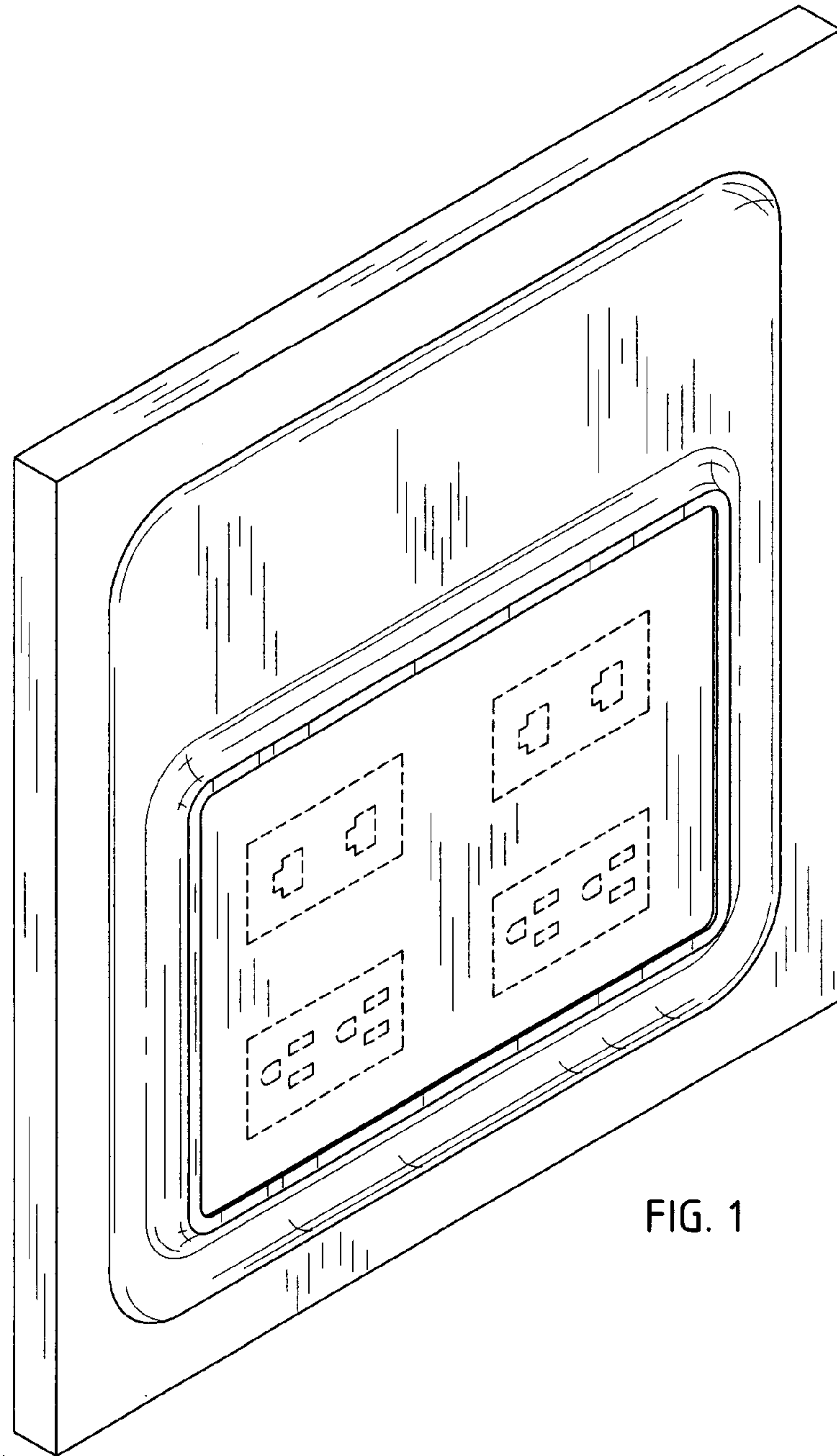

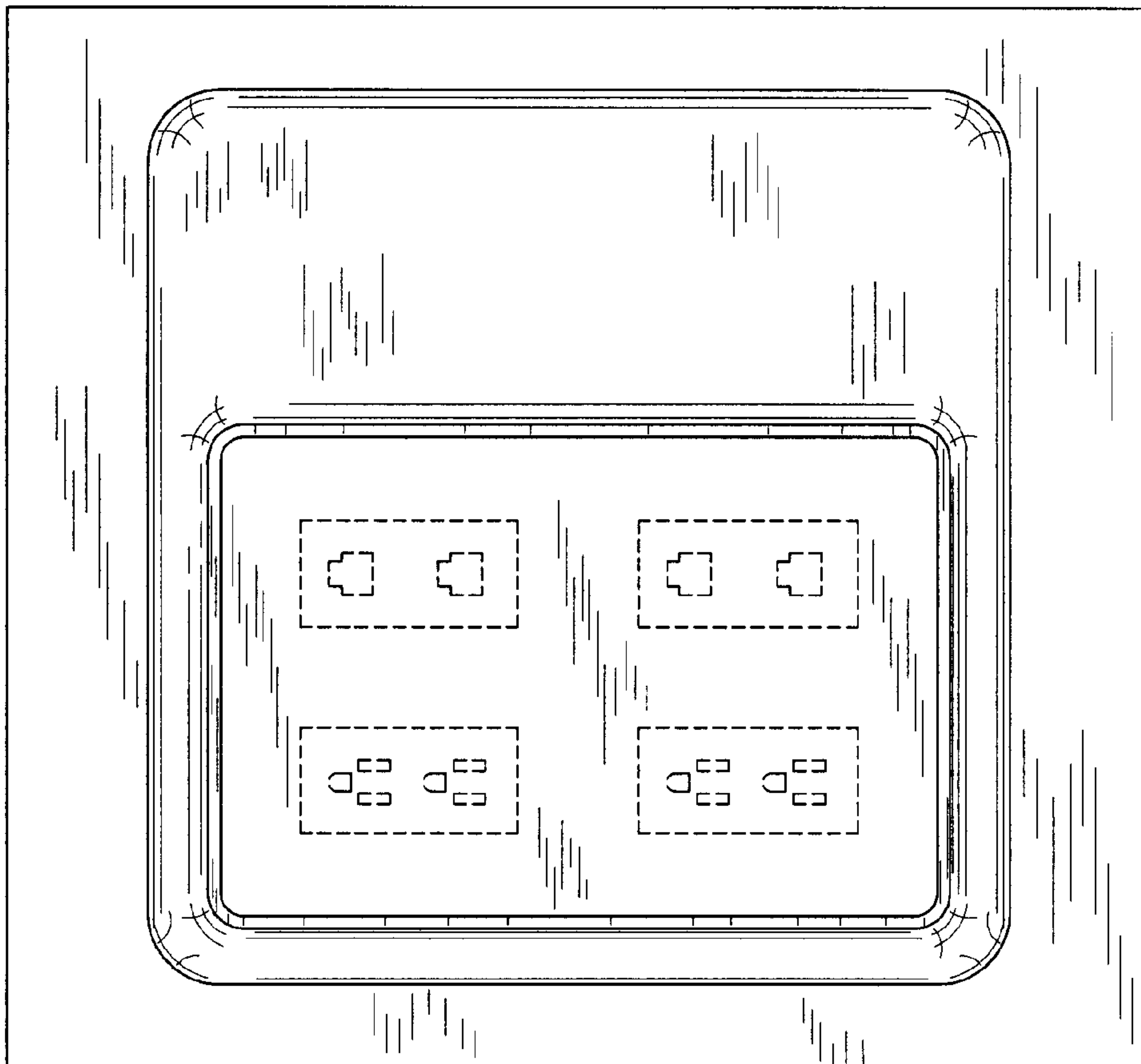

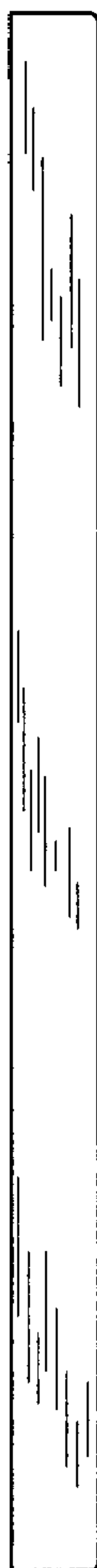

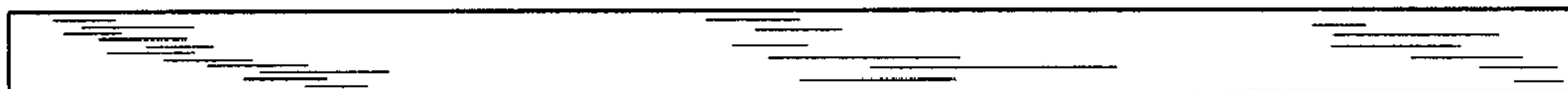

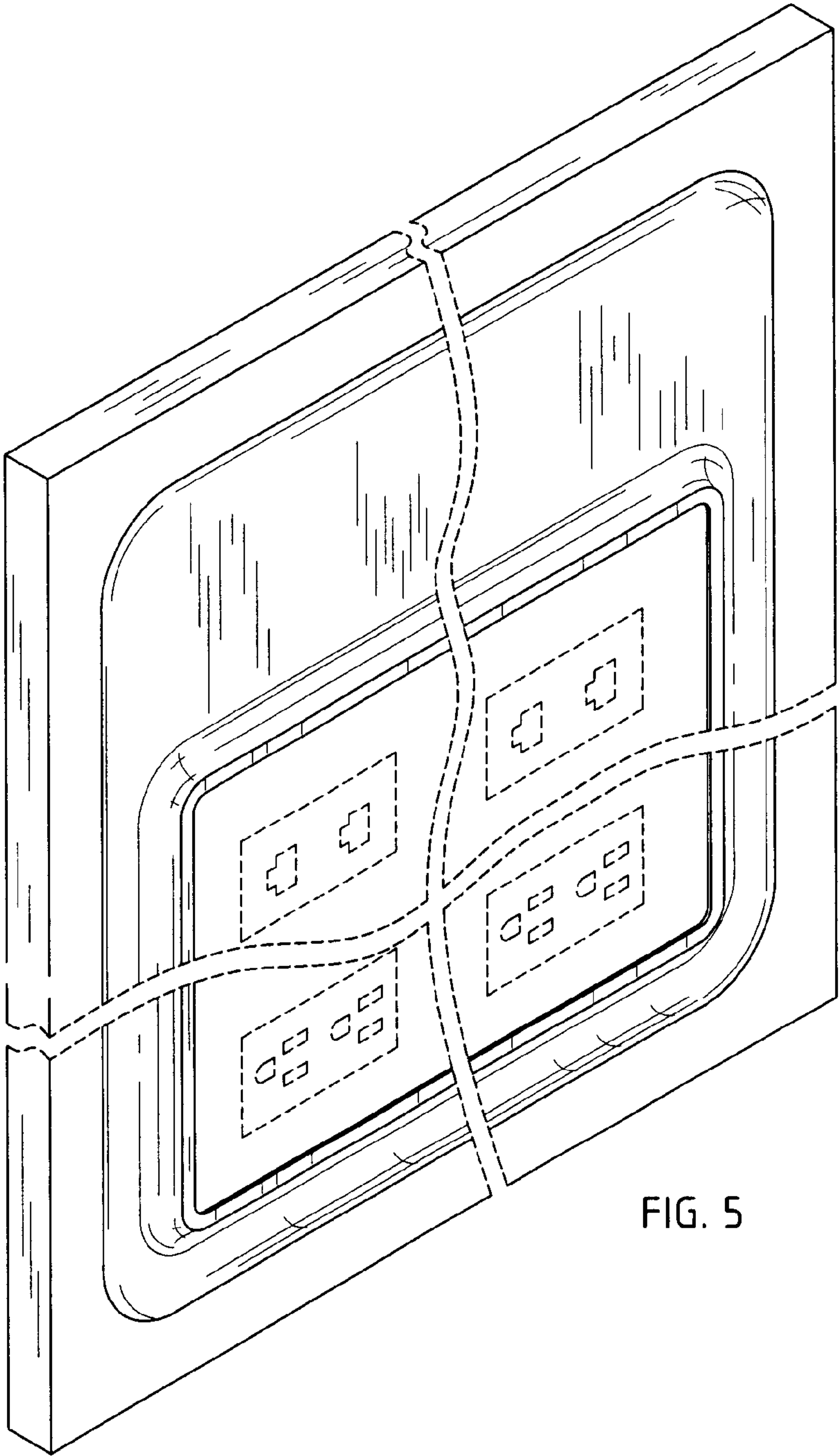

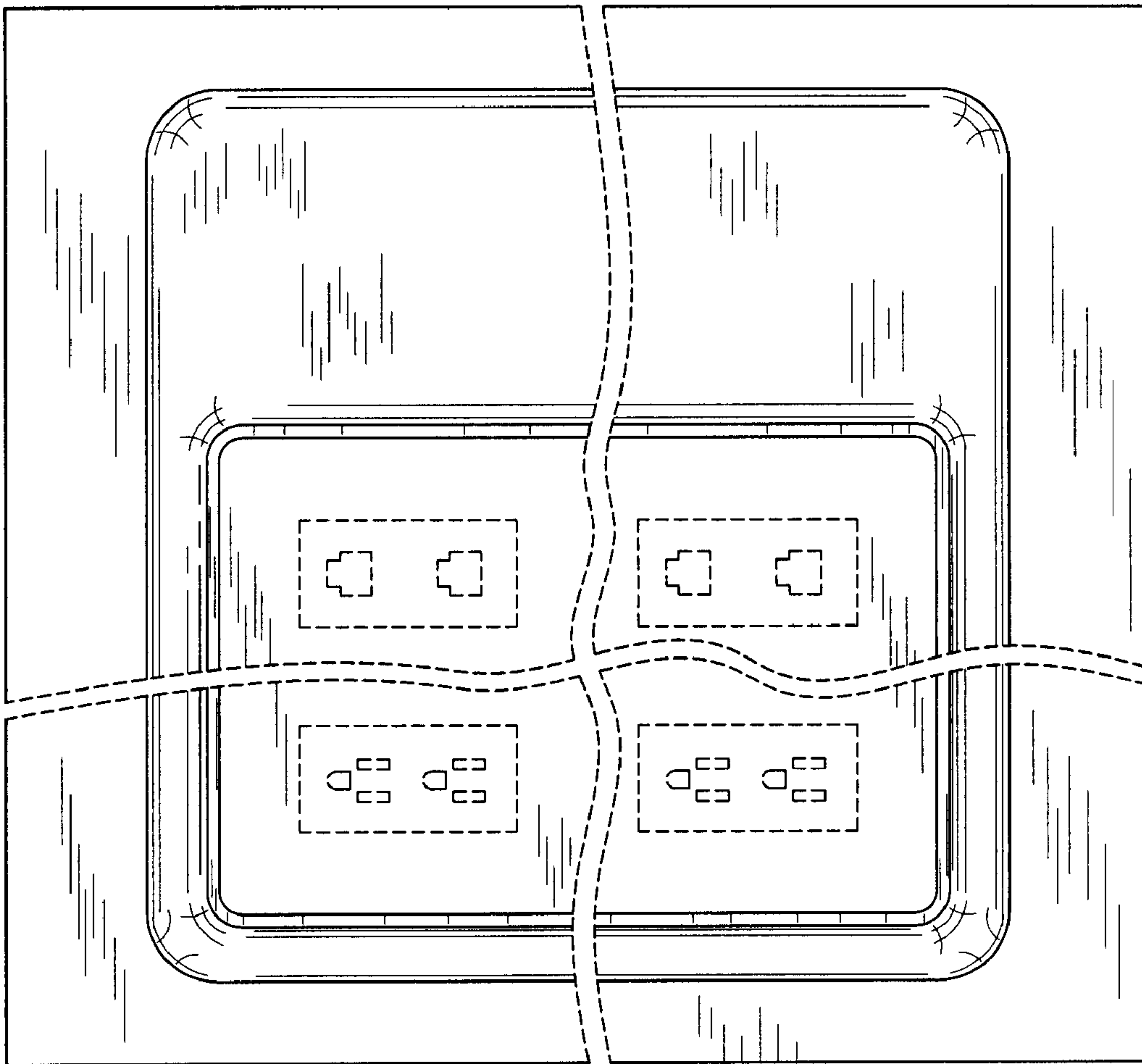

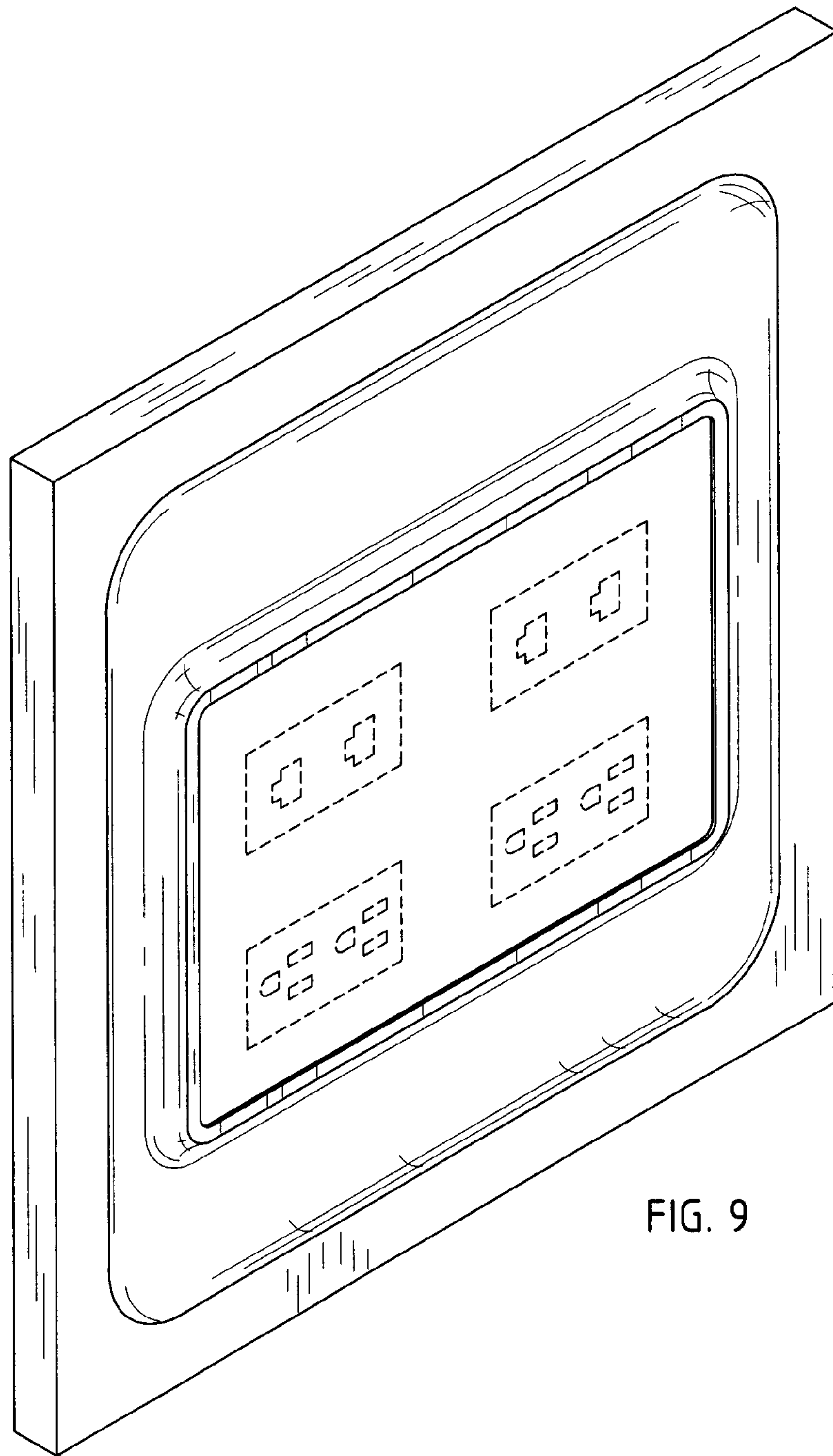

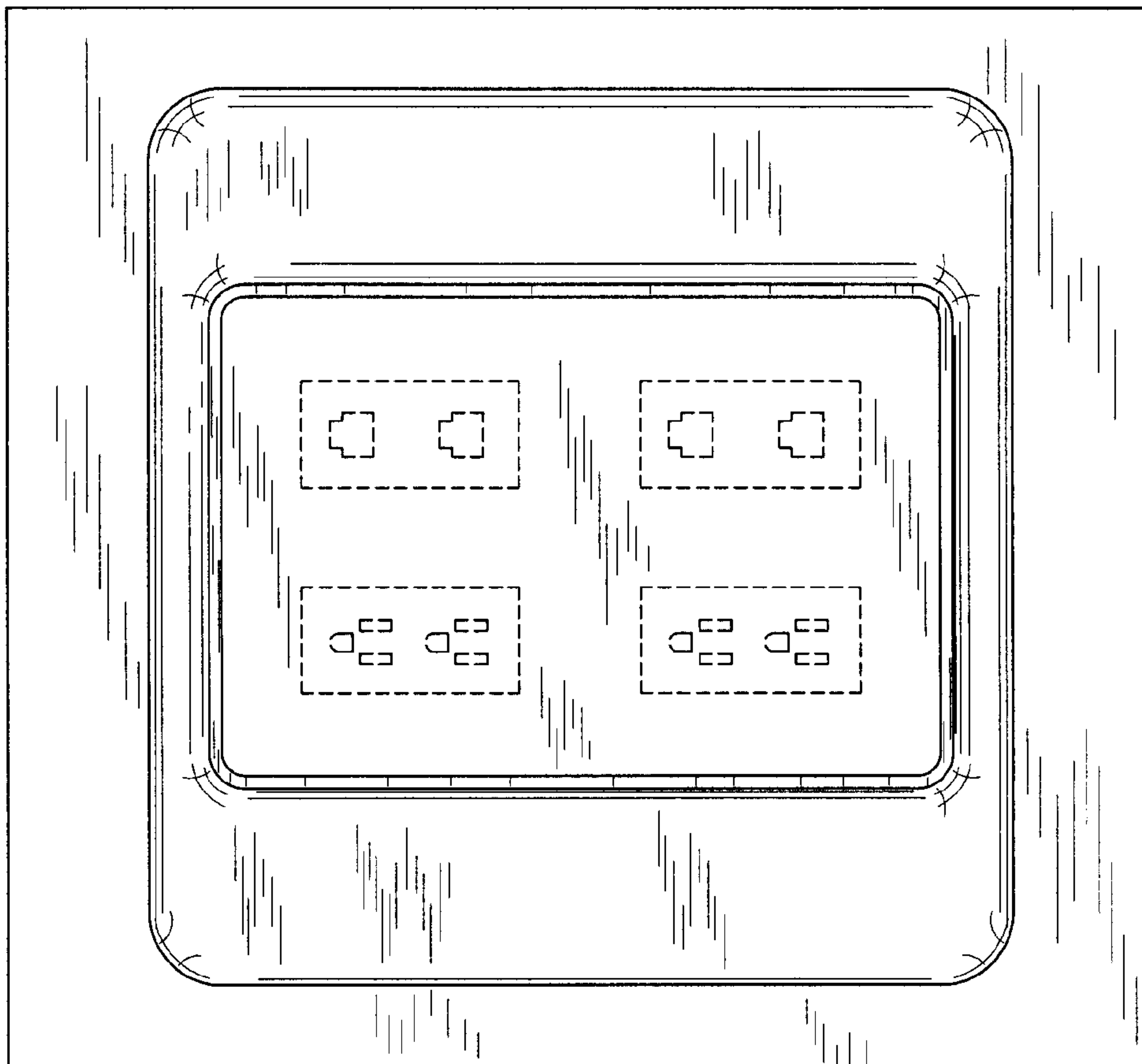

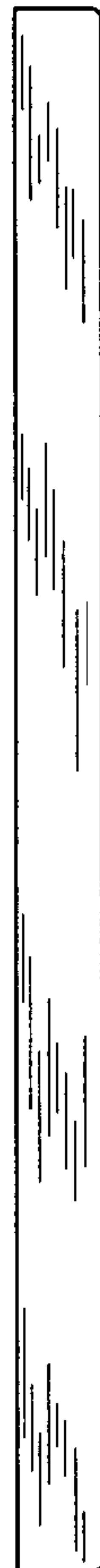

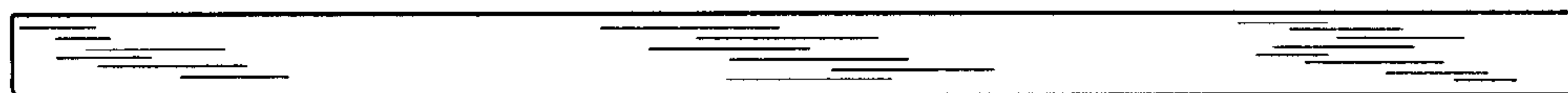
