DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken lines within the solid lines of the claimed design are shading illustrative of a design that may be incorporated within the boundaries of, but does not form a part of, the claimed design. 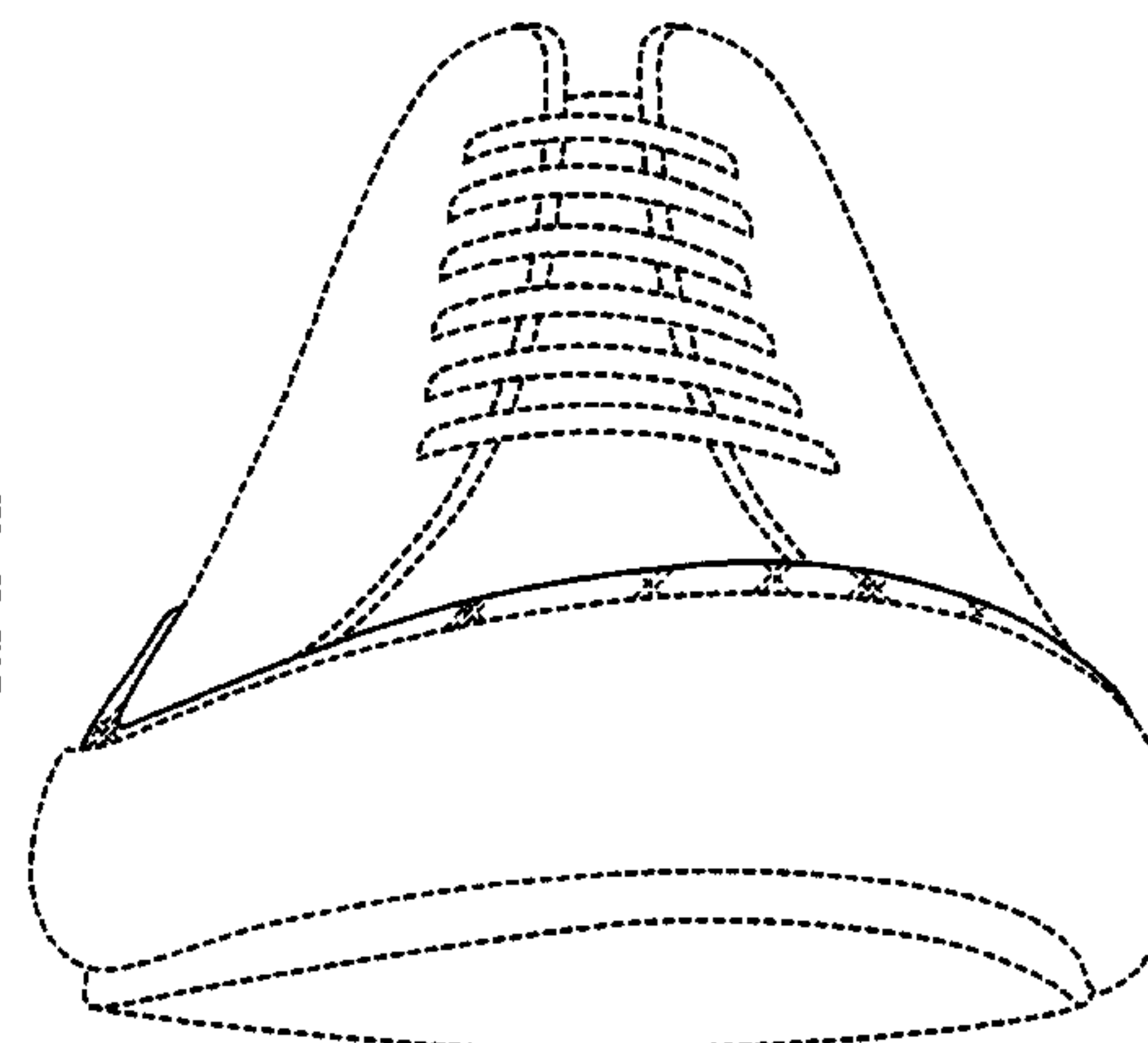
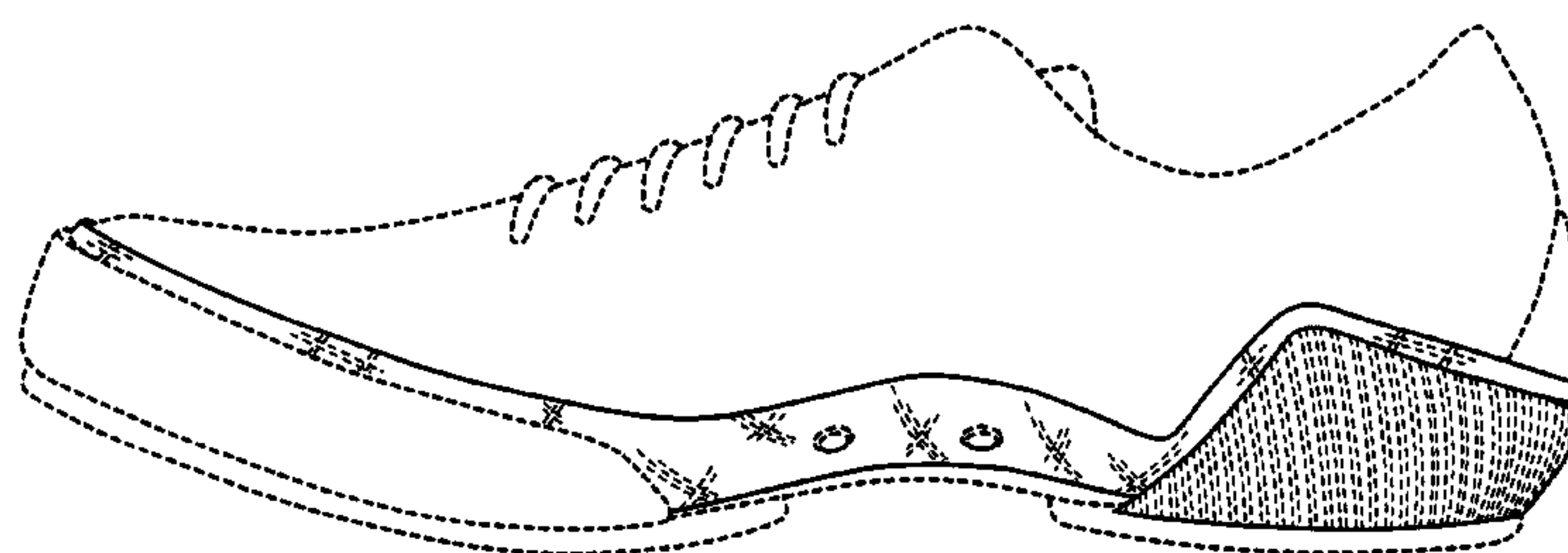

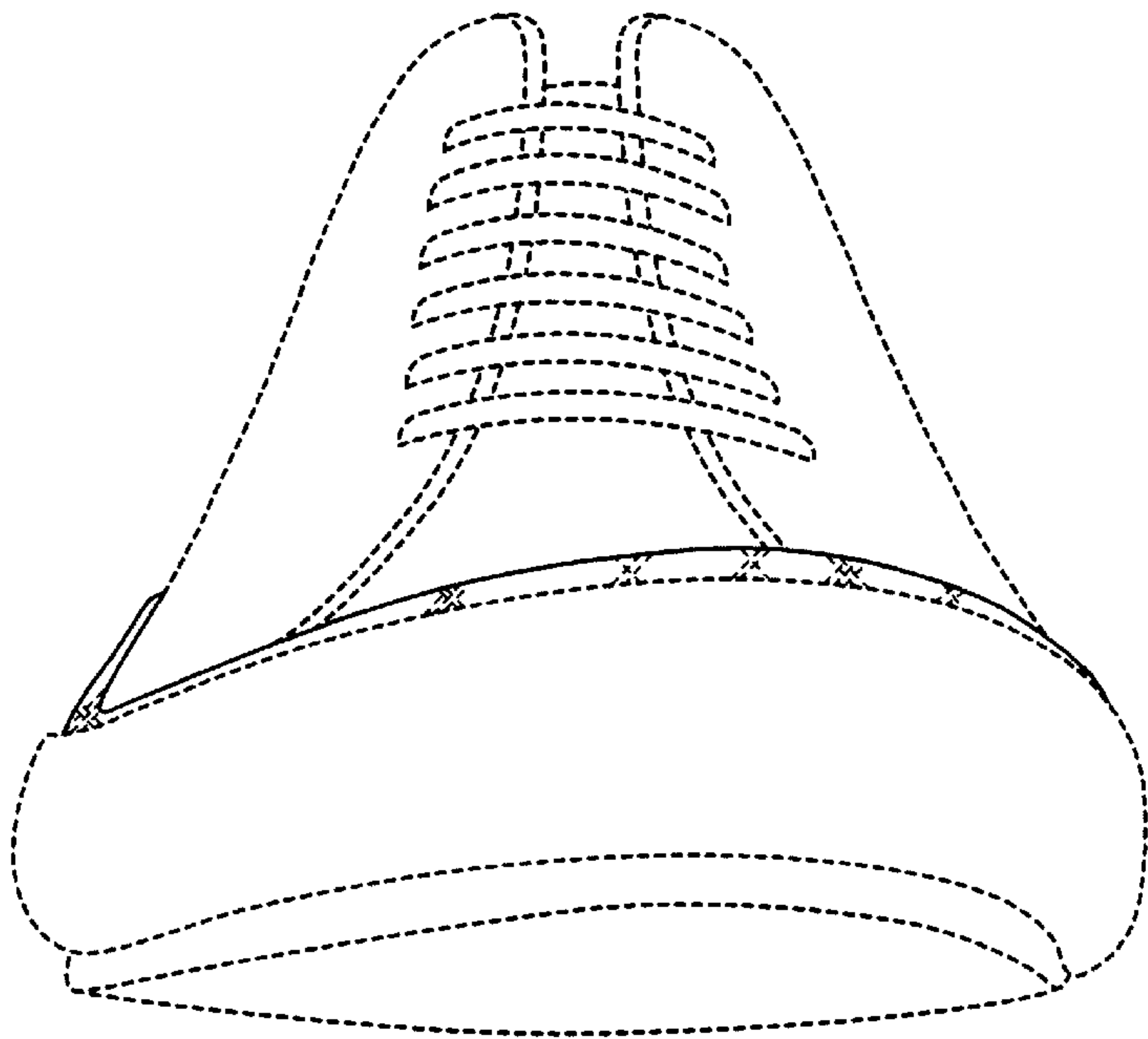

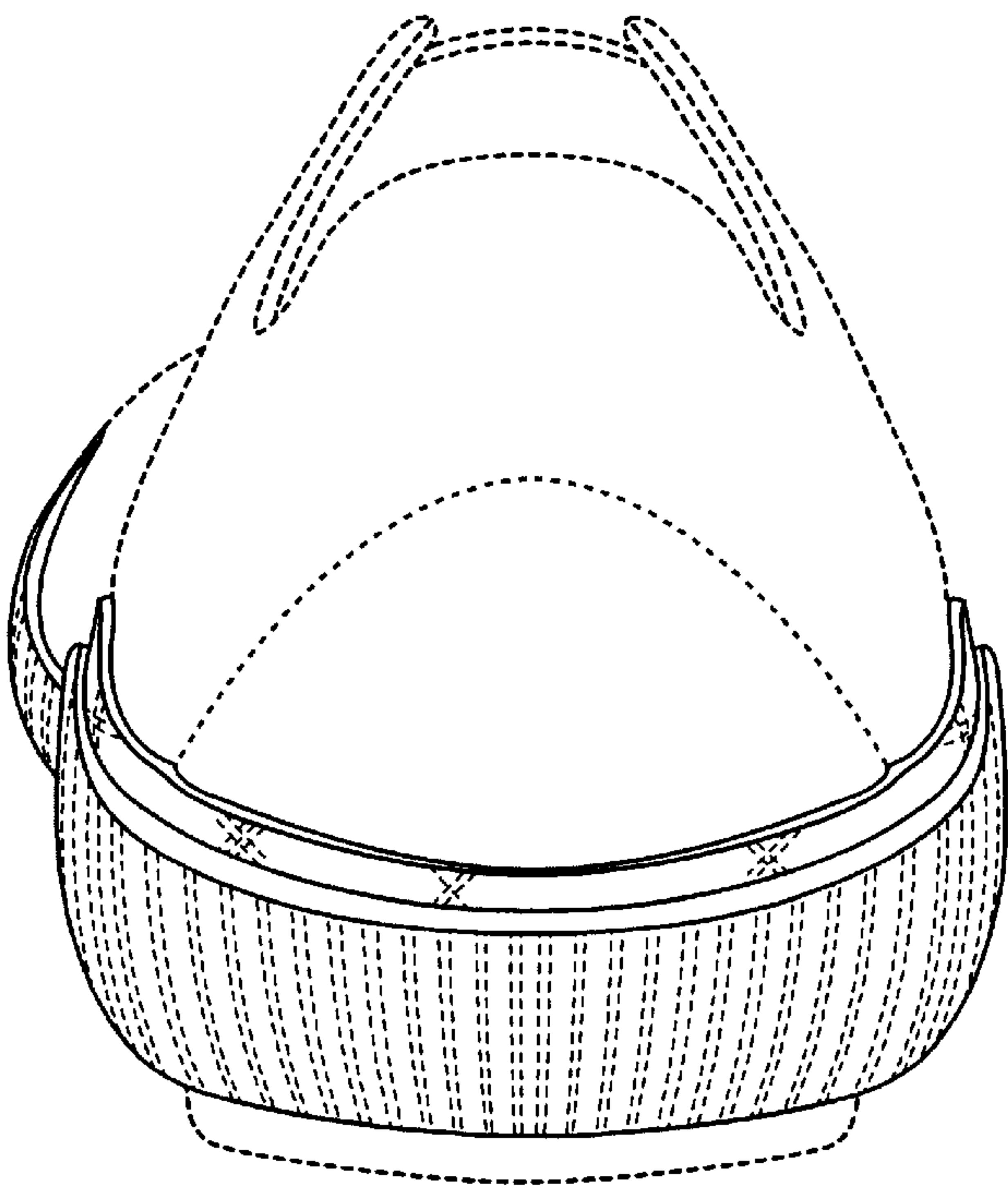
