(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cell phone lanyard, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top view of the cell phone lanyard.

FIG. 2 is a first side view of the cell phone lanyard of the present invention.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the cell phone lanyard of the present invention, the front view and the rear view of the cell phone lanyard being identical.

FIG. 4 is a second side view of the cell phone lanyard of the present invention.

FIG. 5 is a bottom view of the cell phone lanyard of the present invention; and,

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the cell phone lanyard of the present invention in place upon a wearer.

The broken line showing of a cell phone and a person in FIG. 6 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

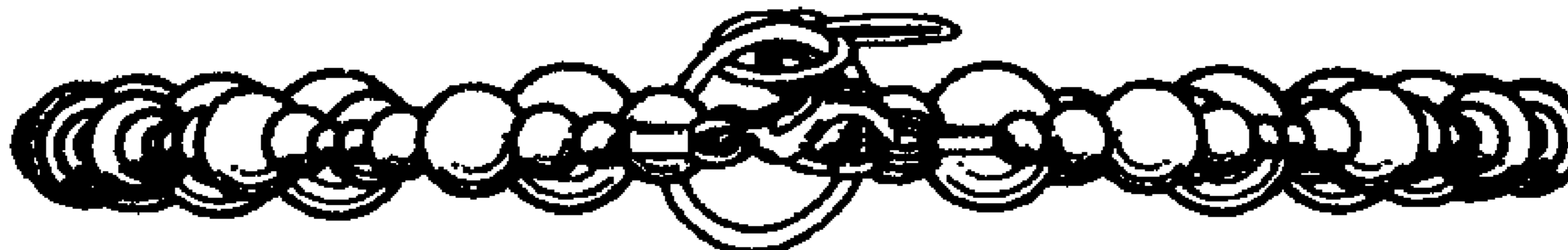

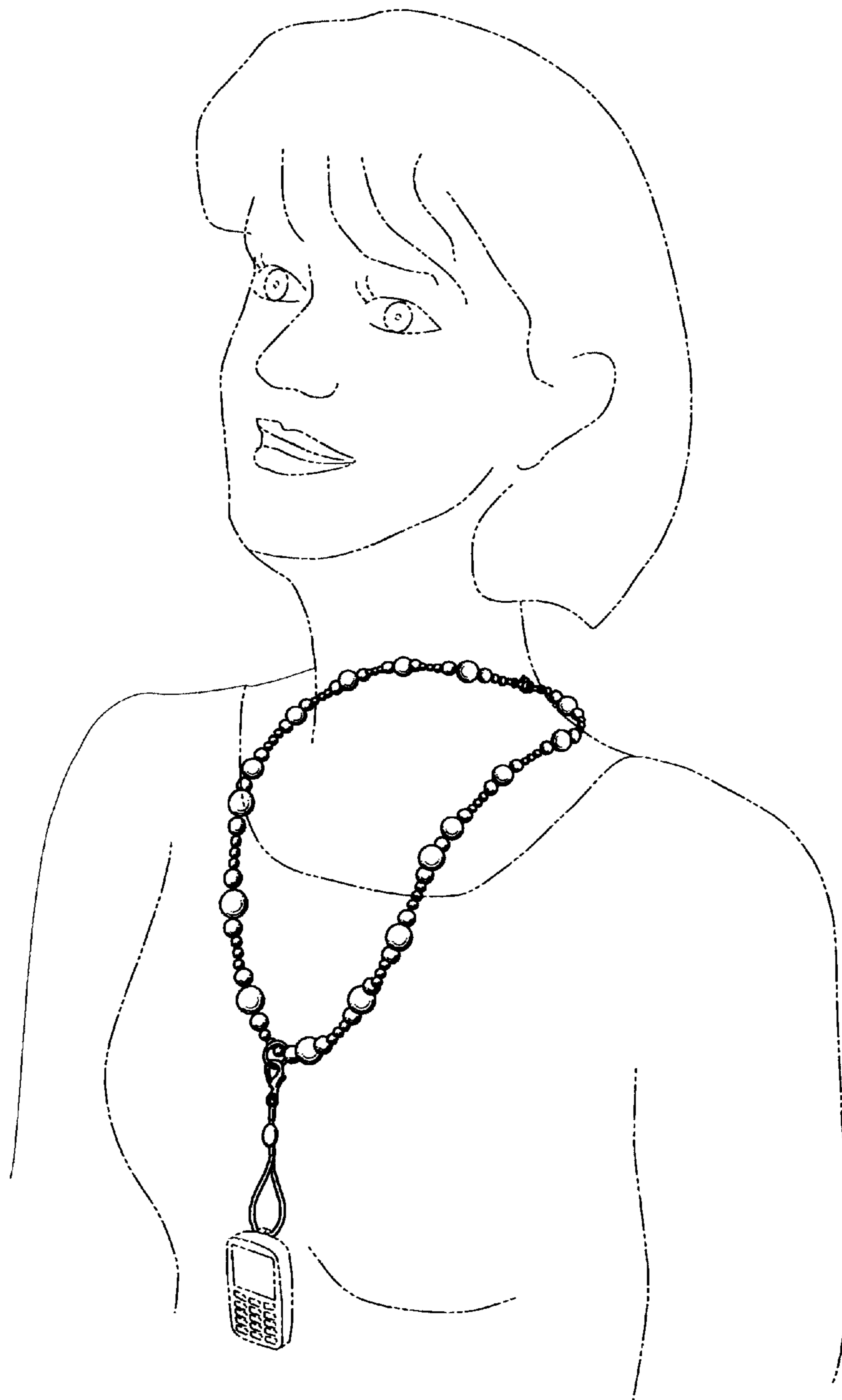
