FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a taco shell plate of the present  
invention;

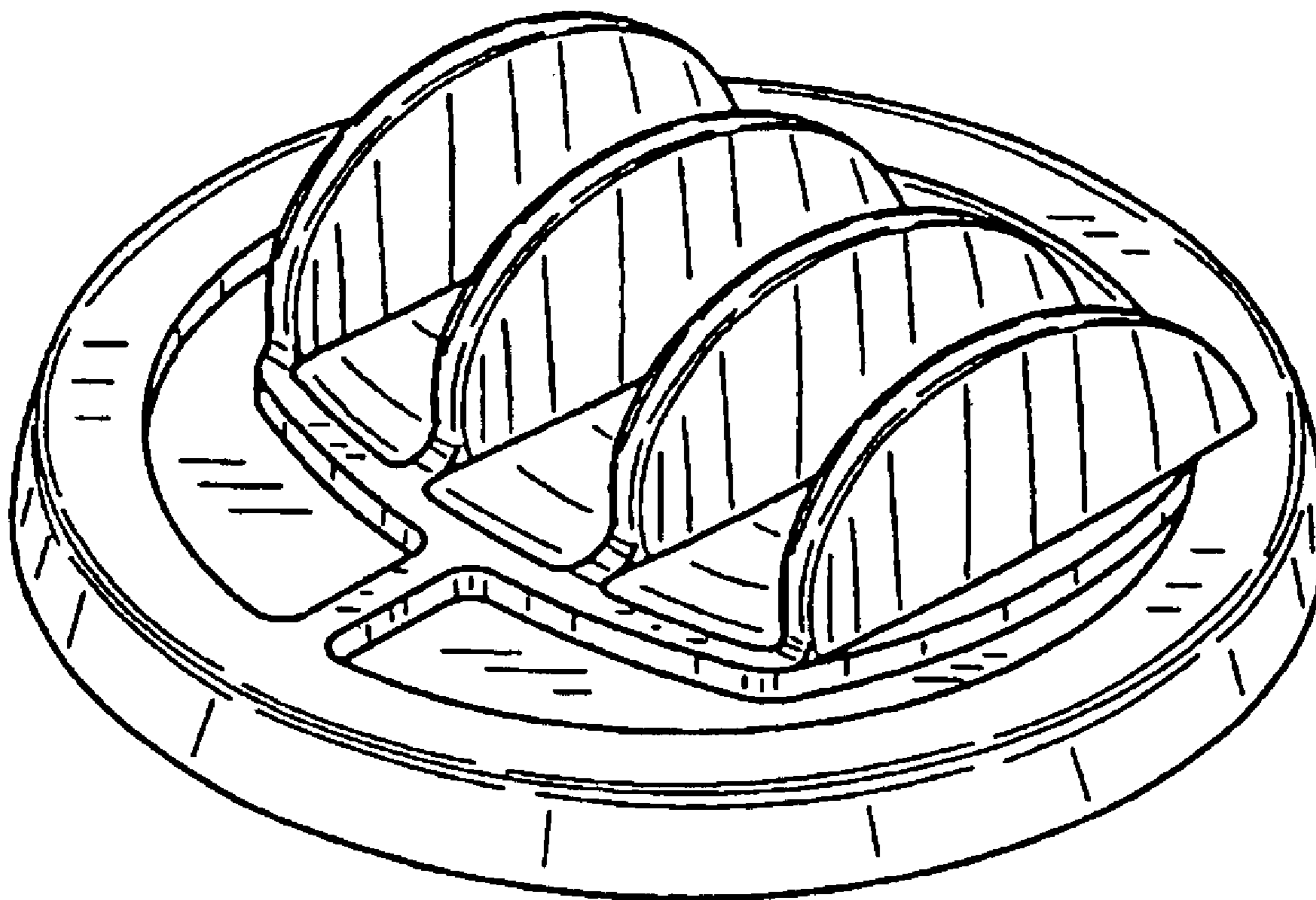
FIG. 2 is a side elevation view of the plate of FIG. 1;

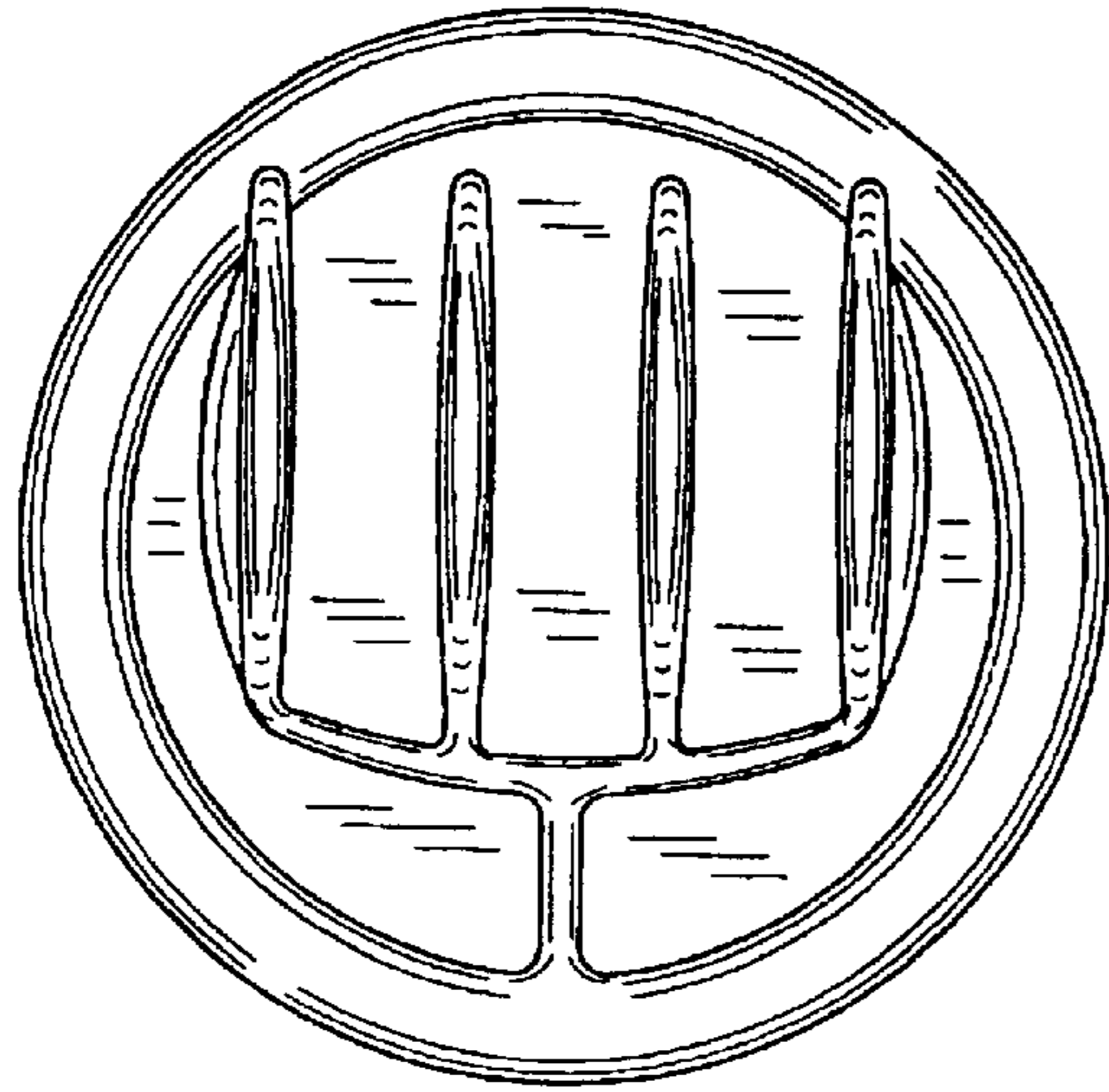

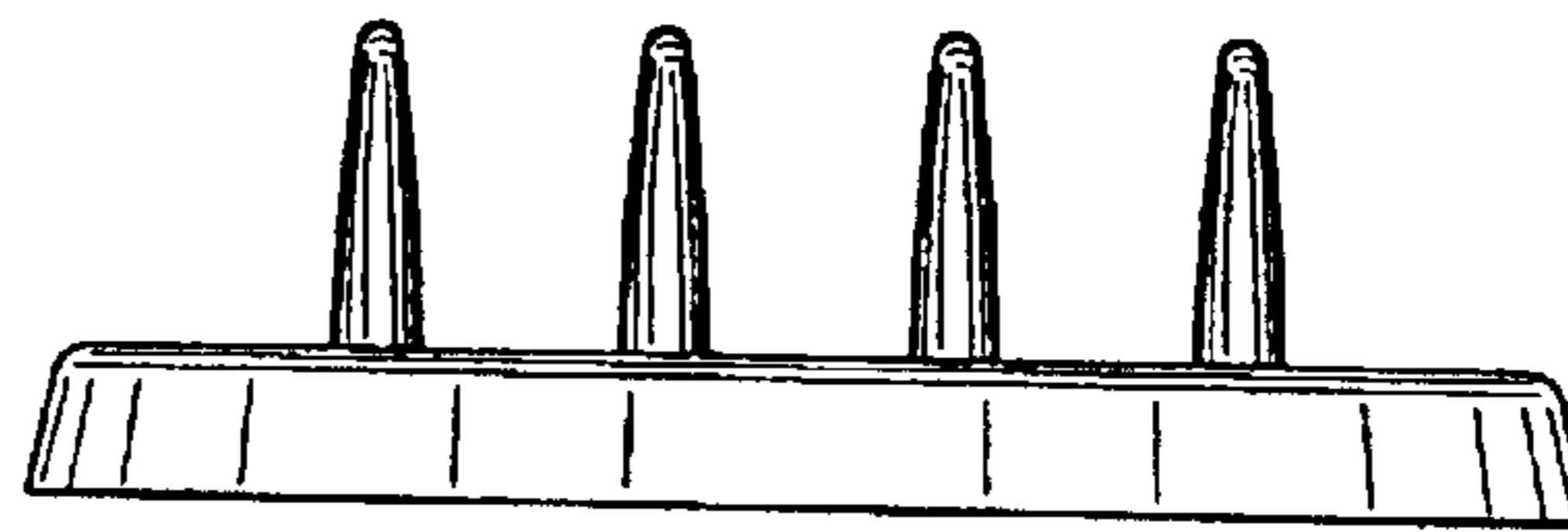

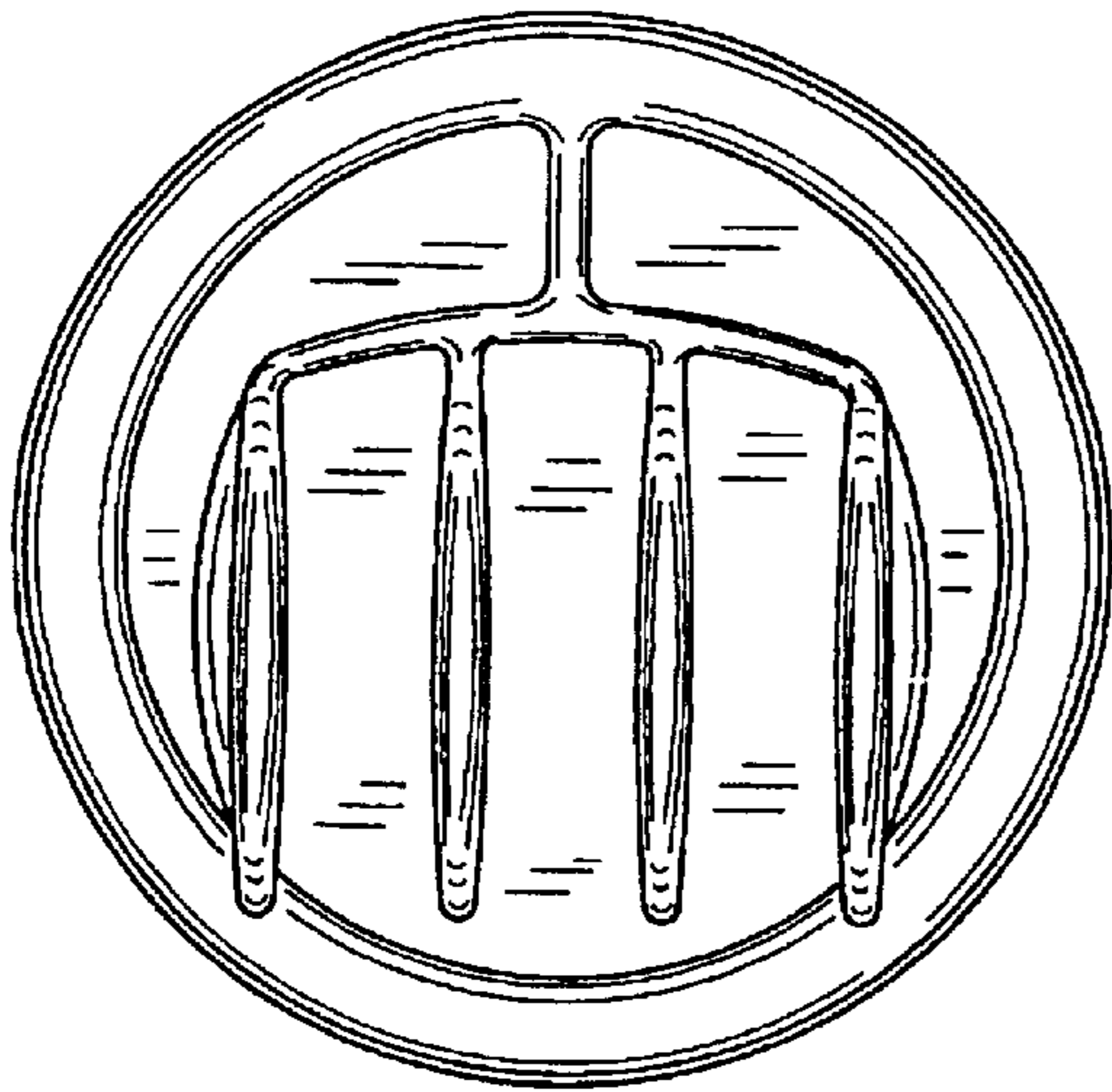

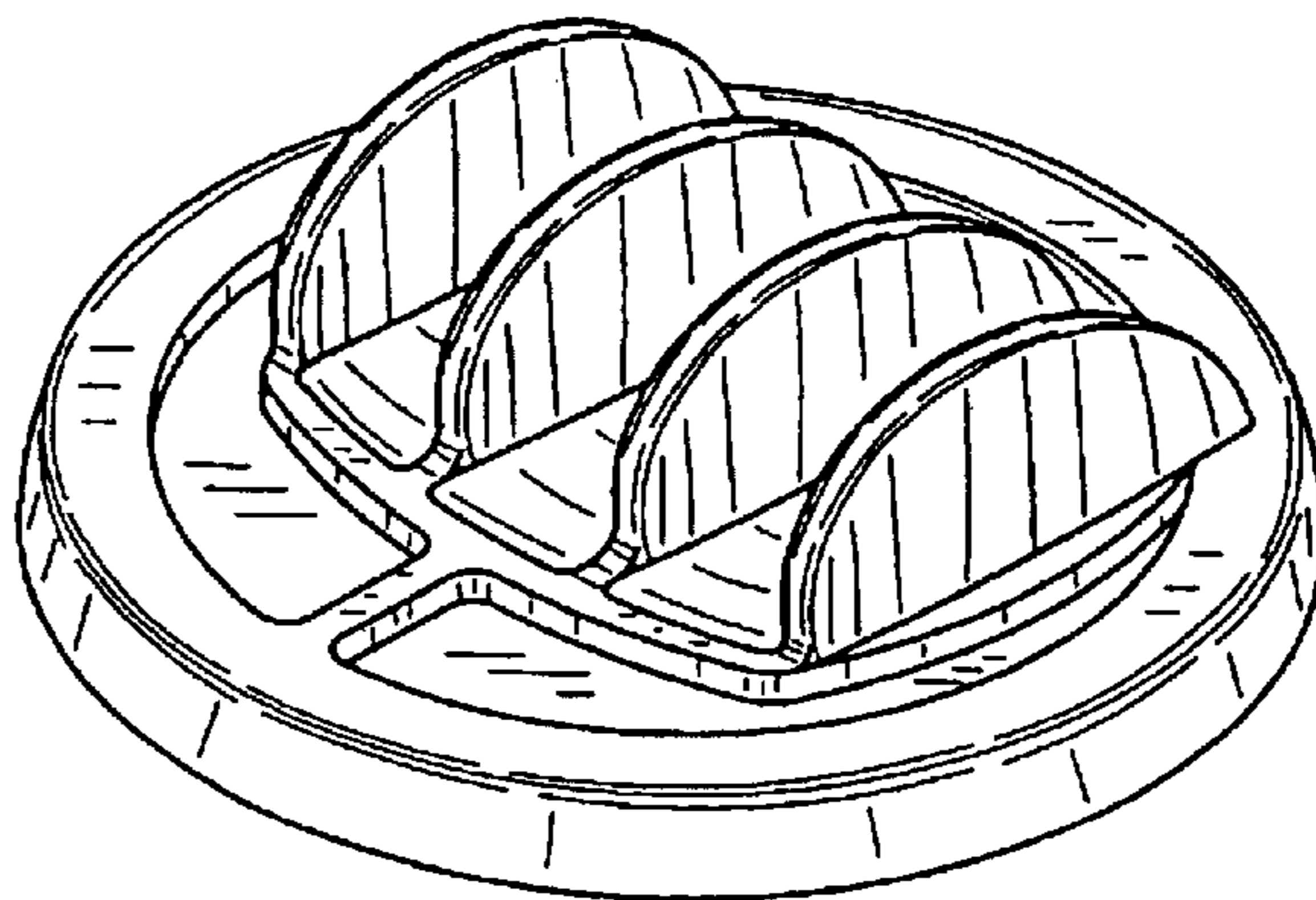
