The ornamental design for a teardrop-shaped ornamentation,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

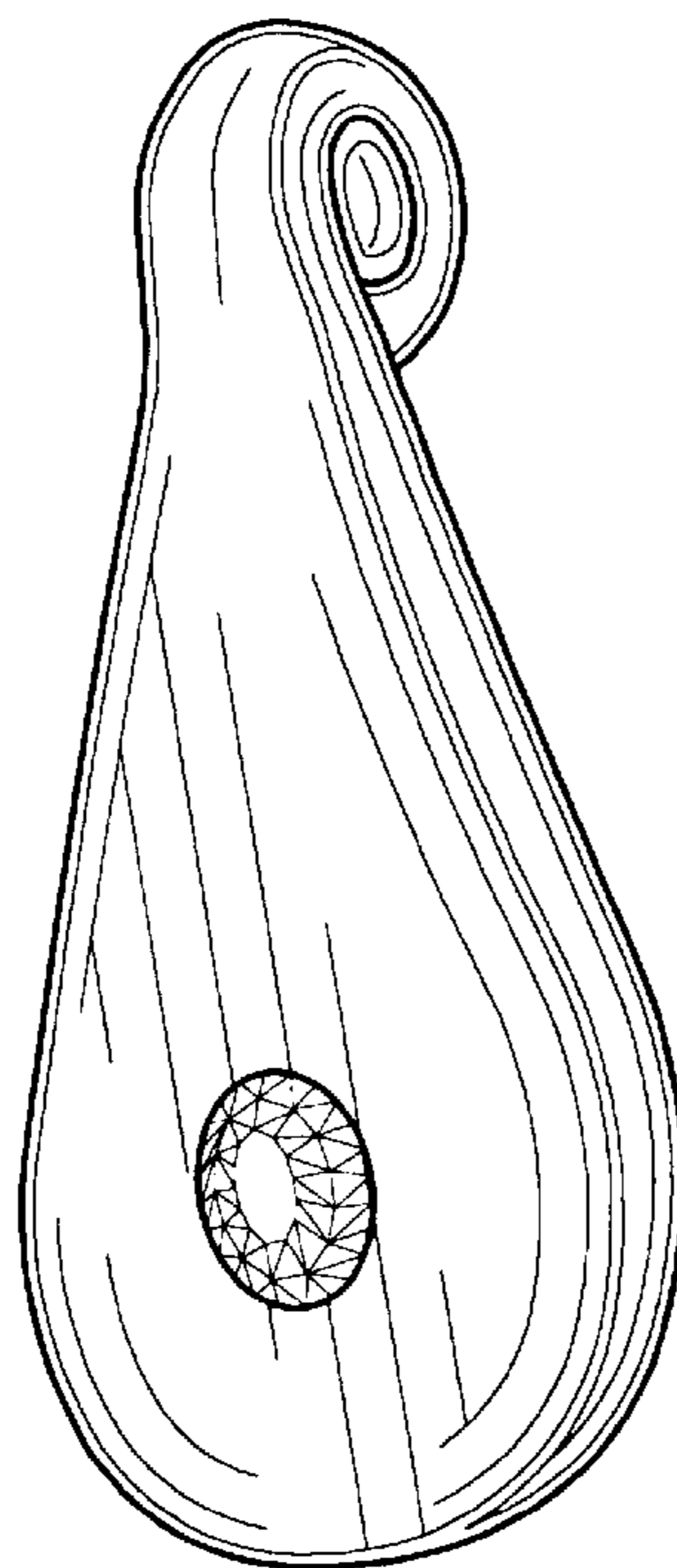

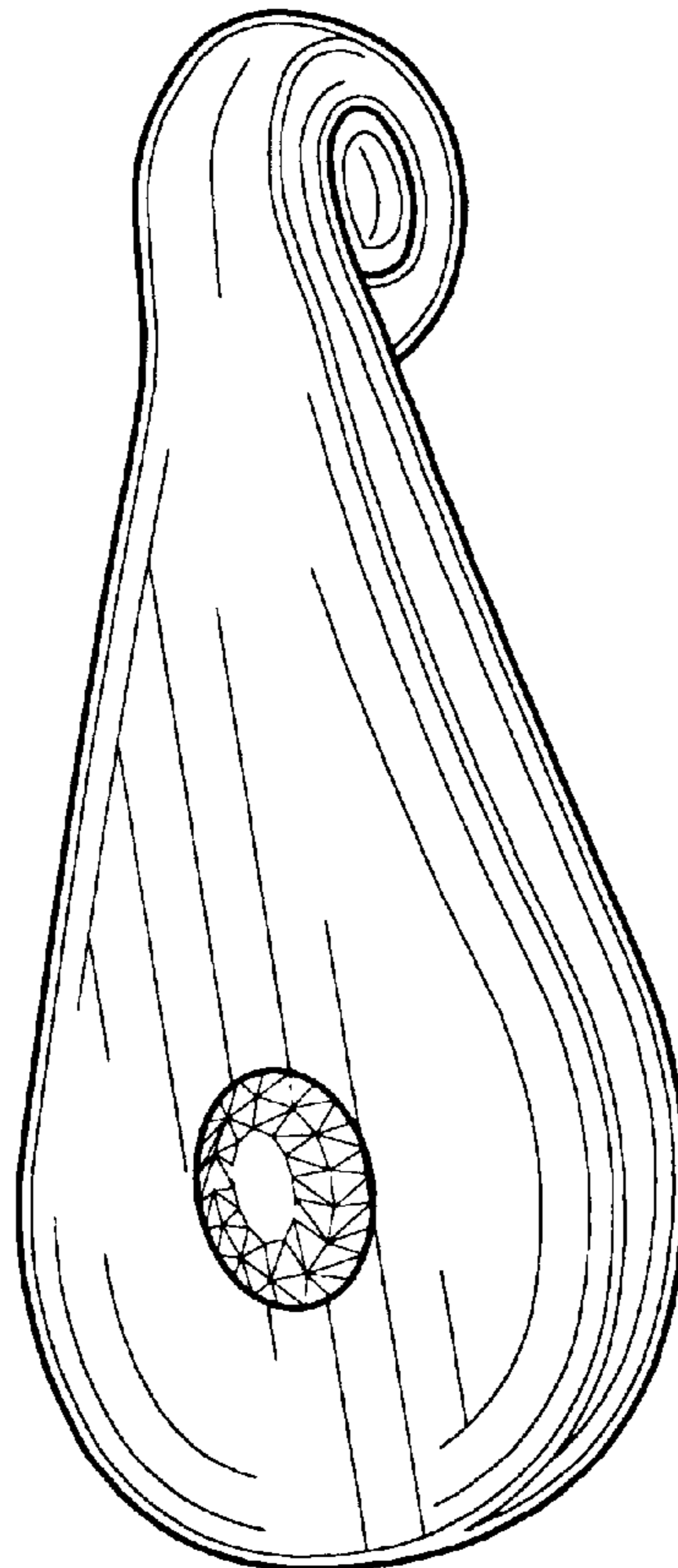

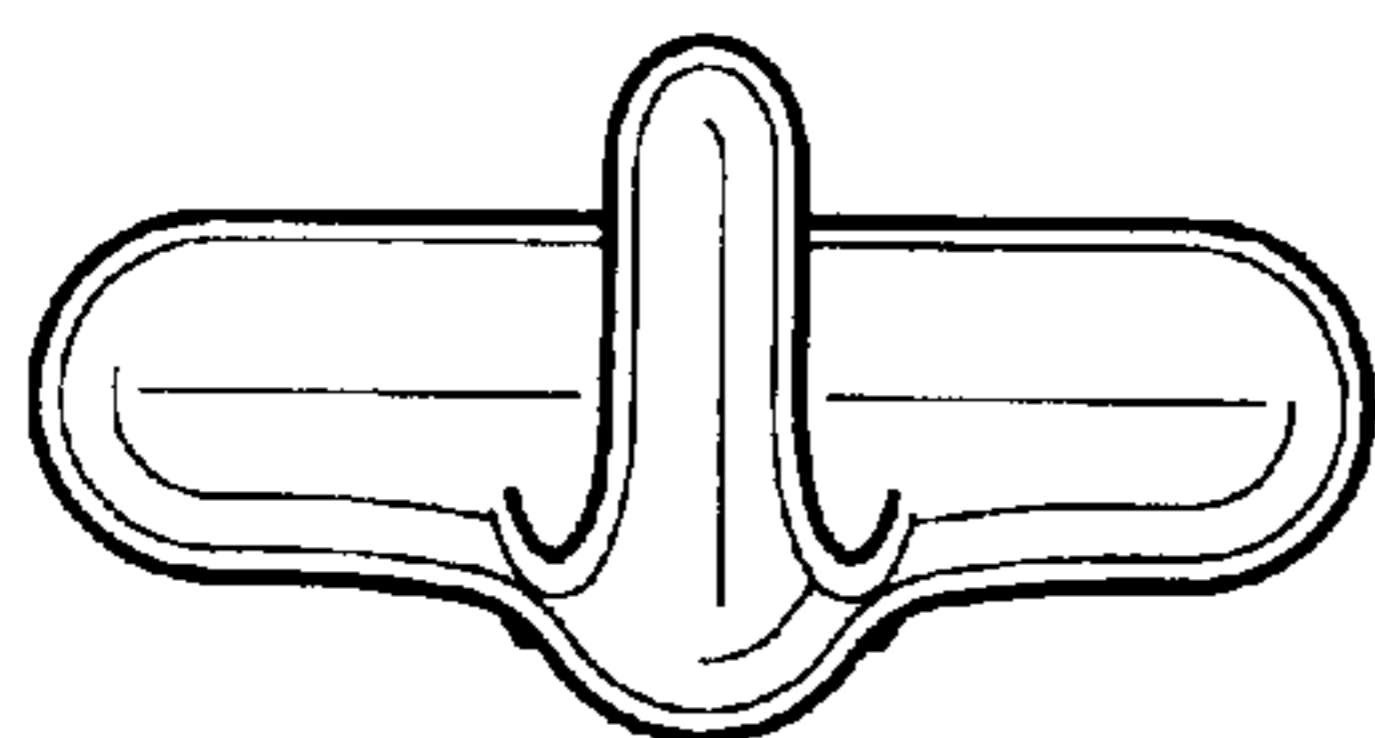

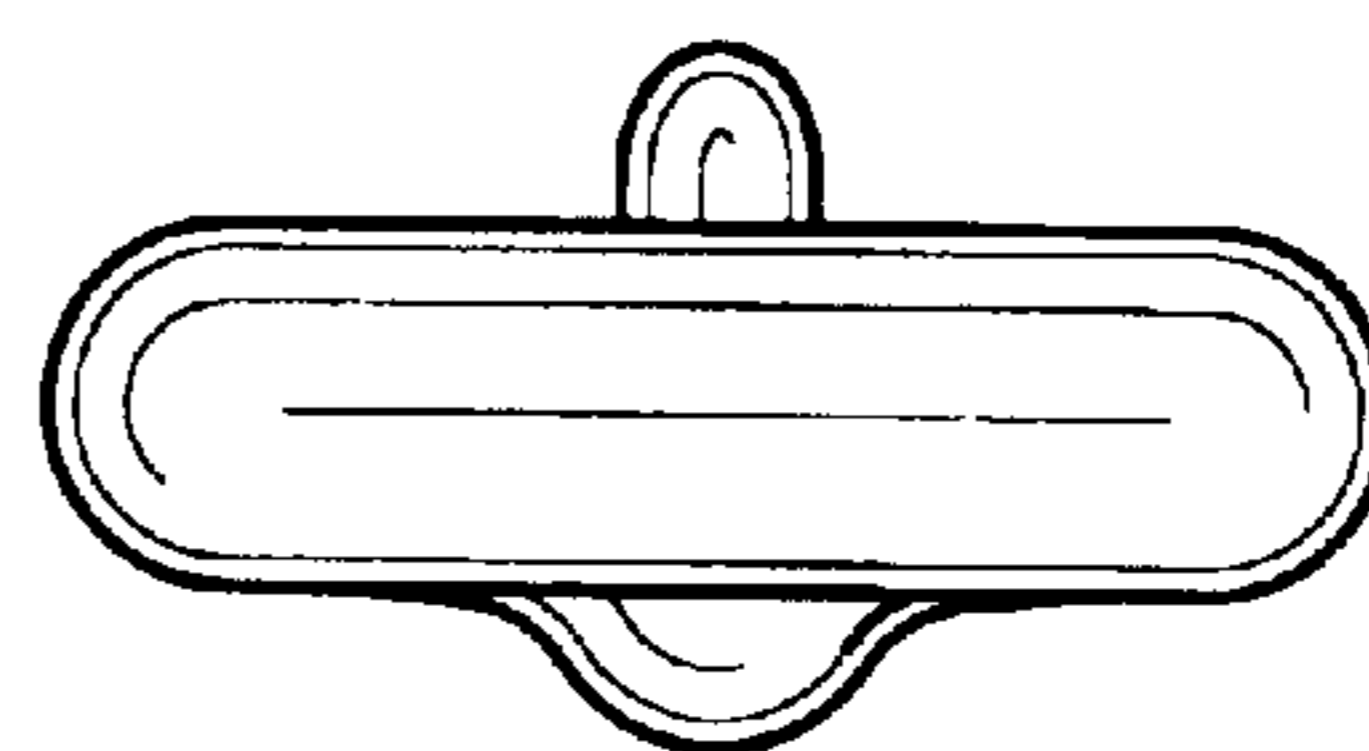

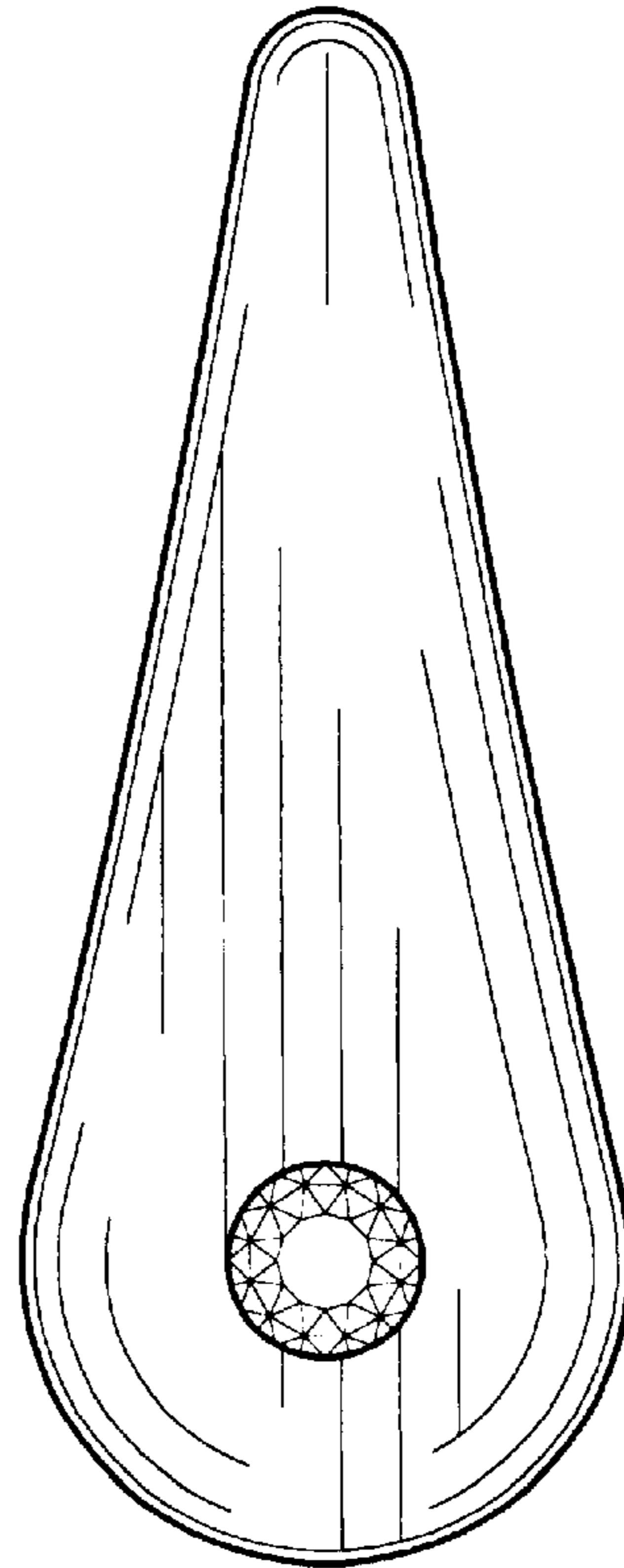

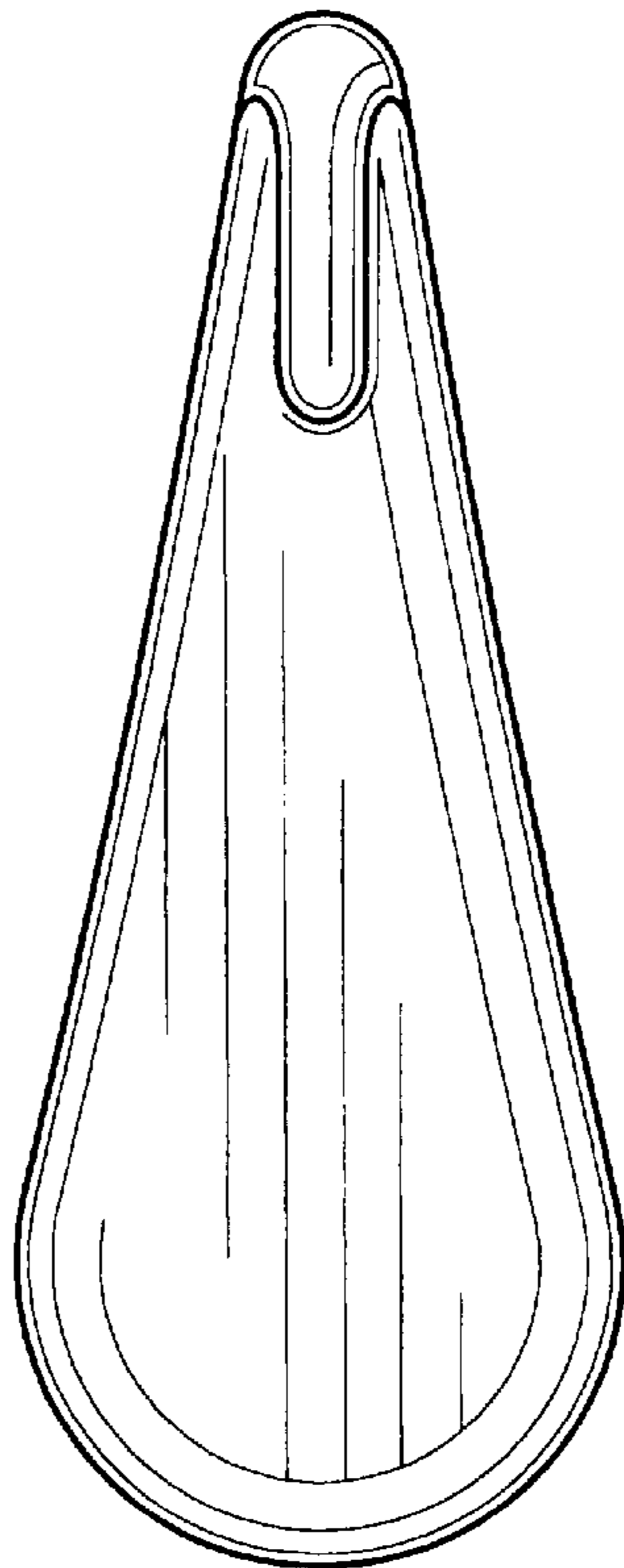

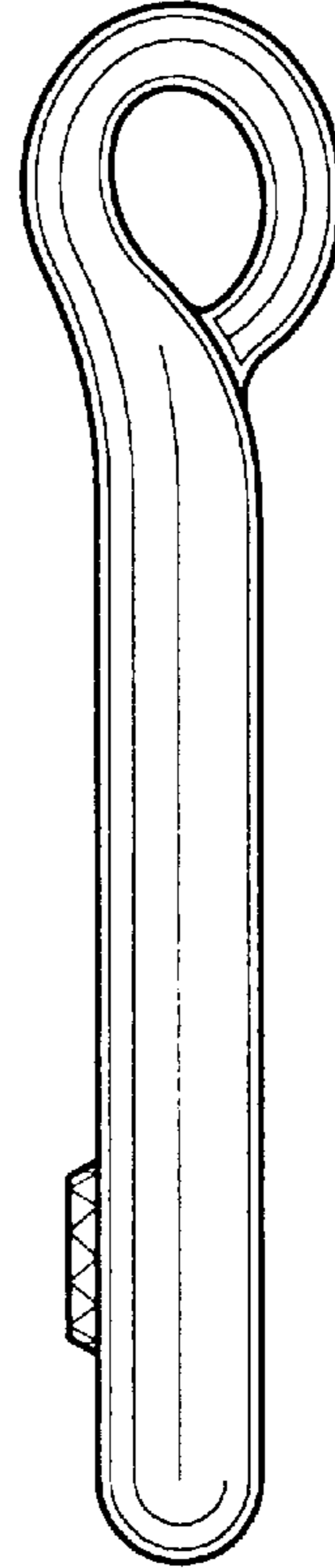

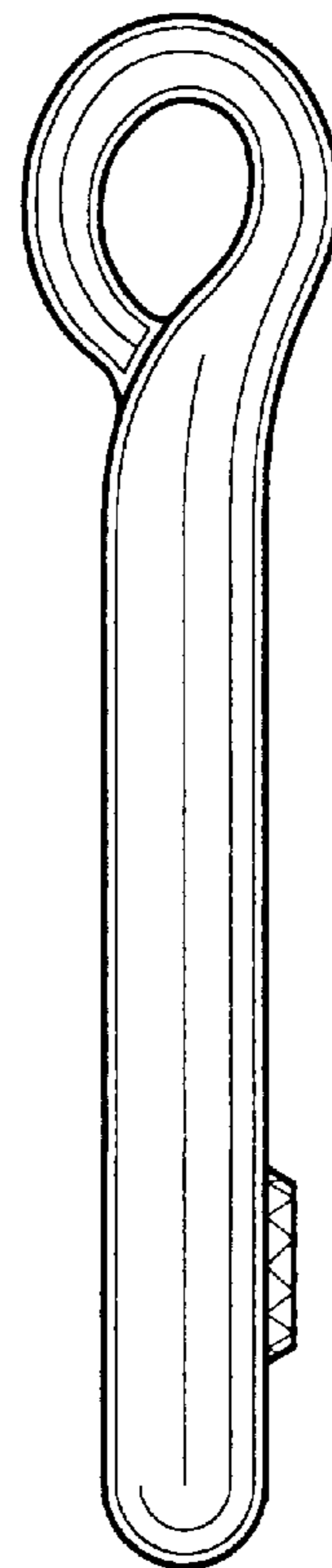

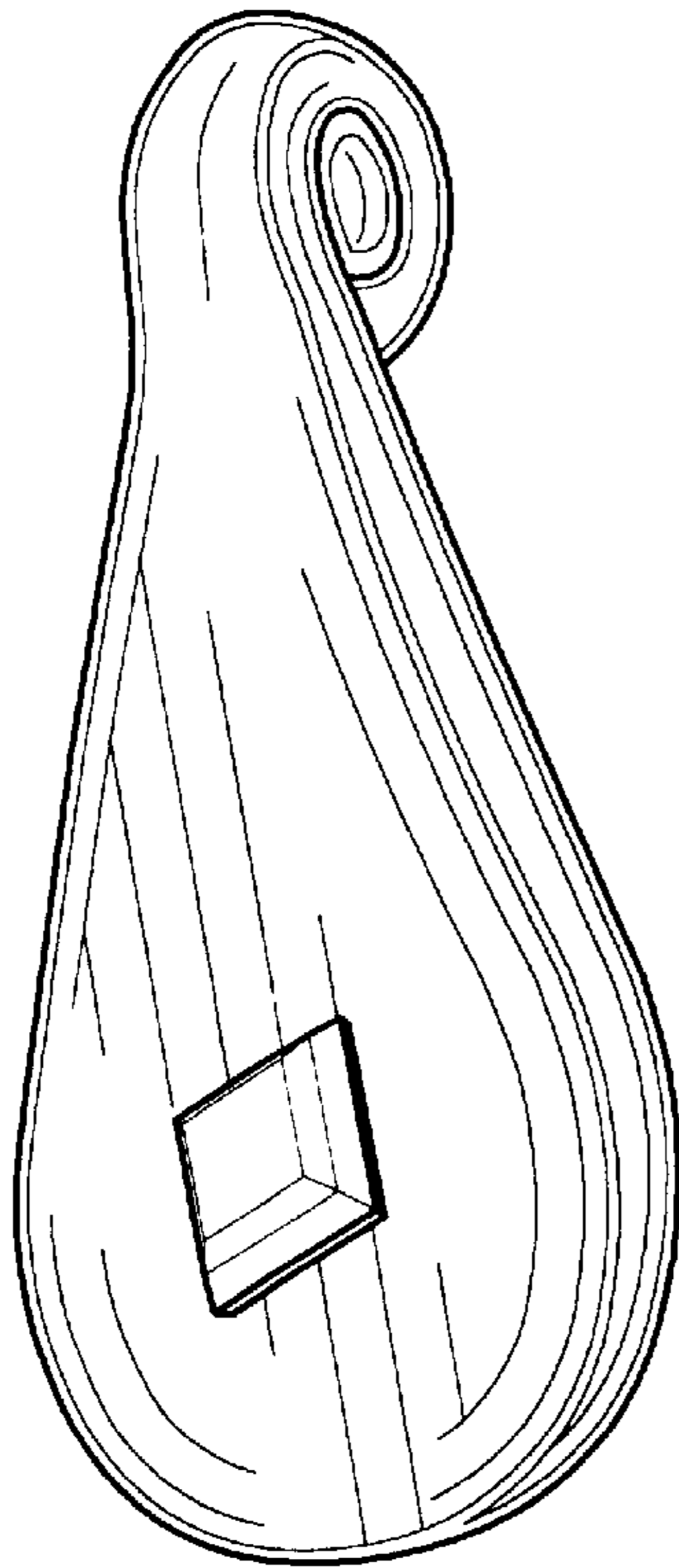

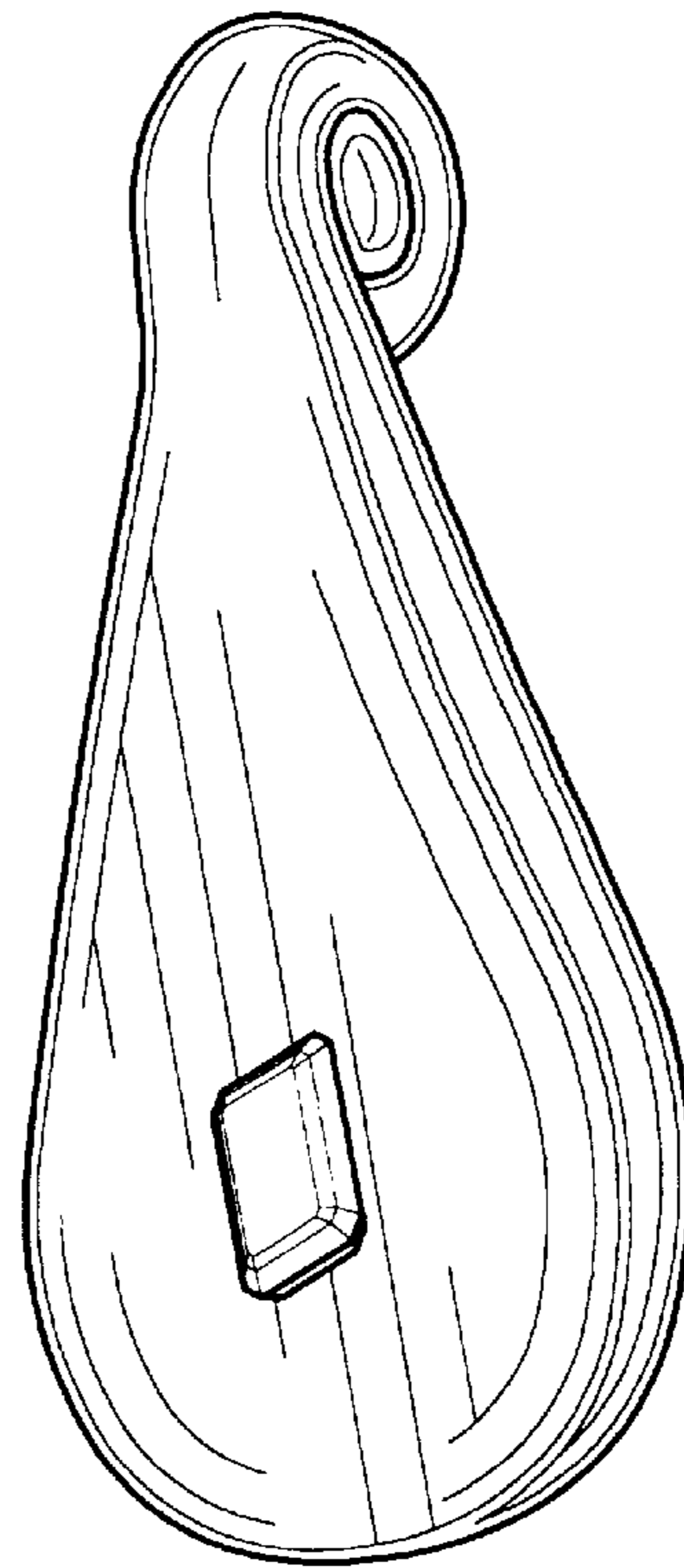

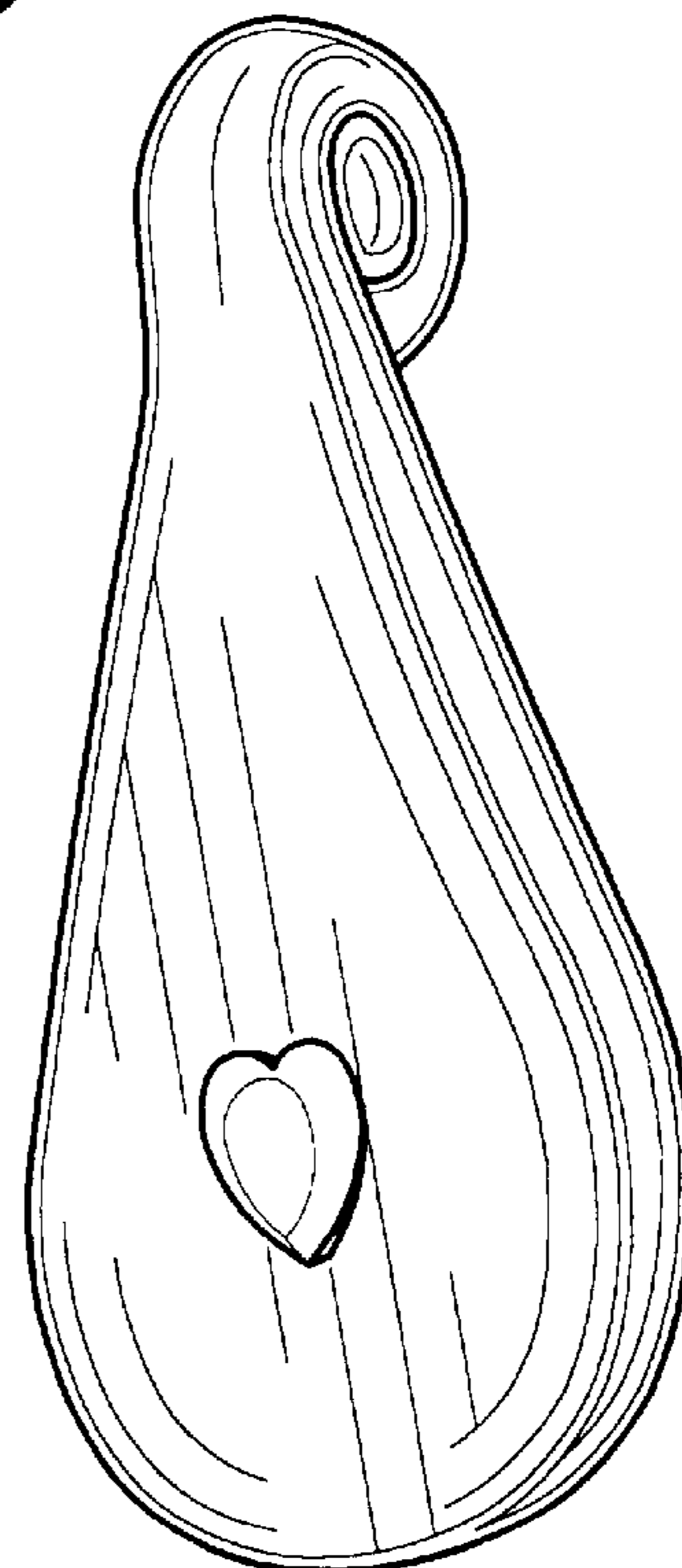

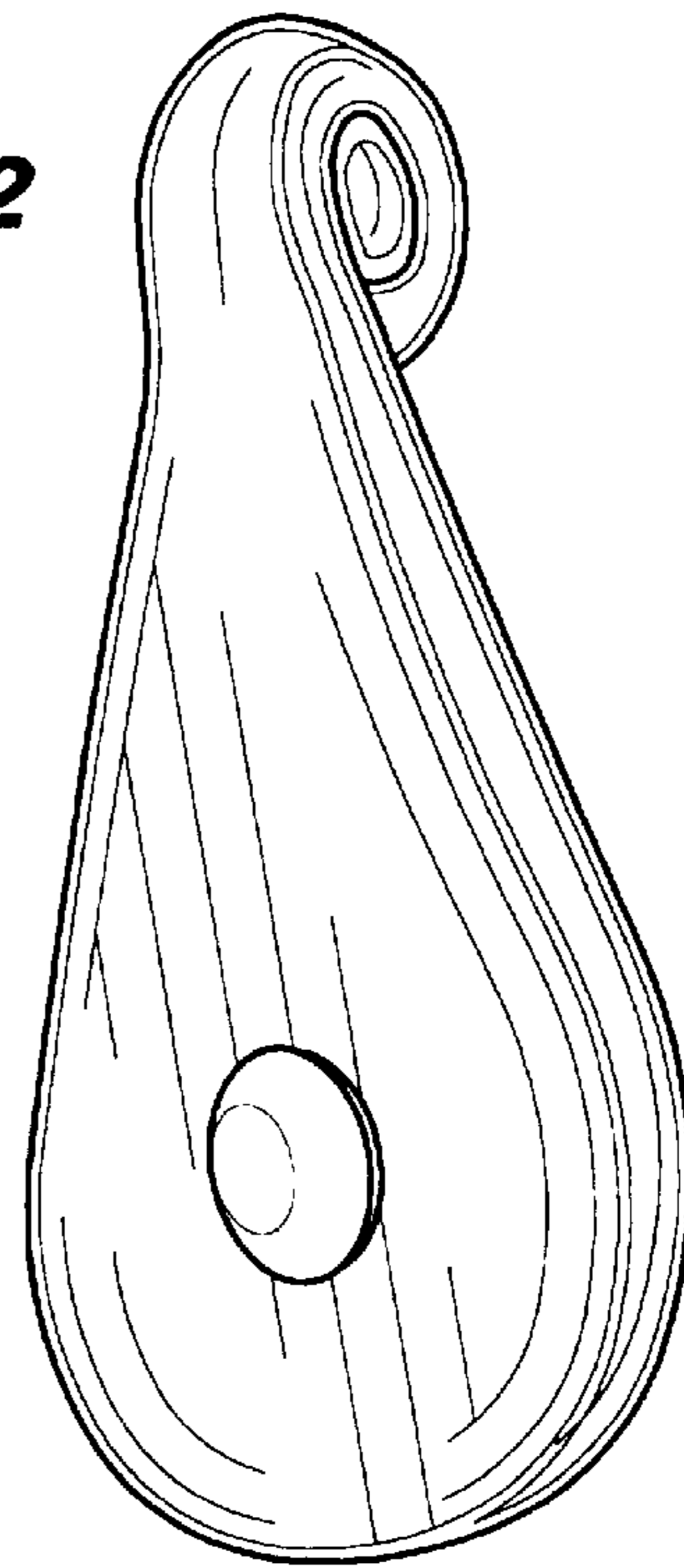
