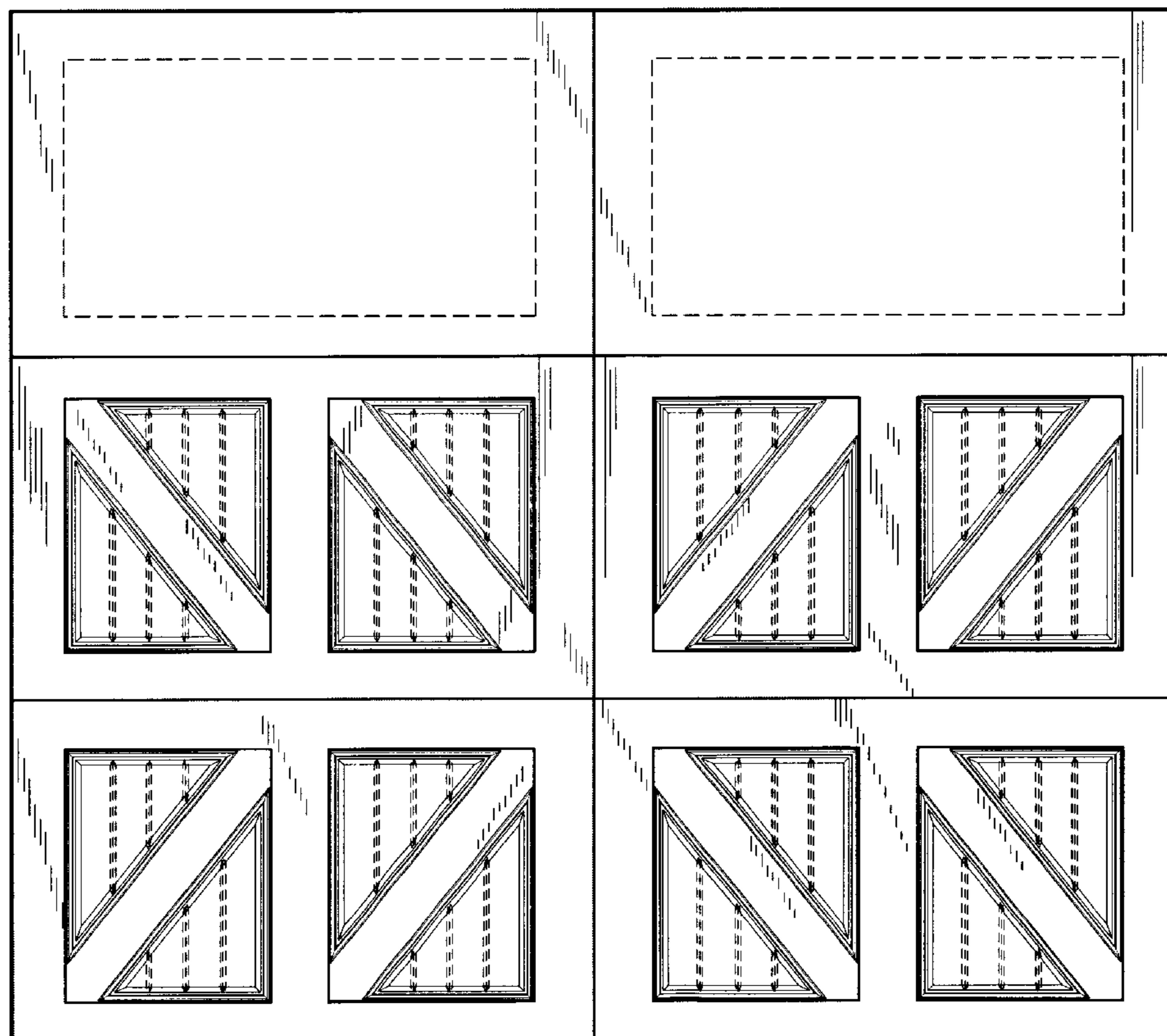
The broken lines depicting various ornamental and functional elements of the doors and door sections represent environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design.

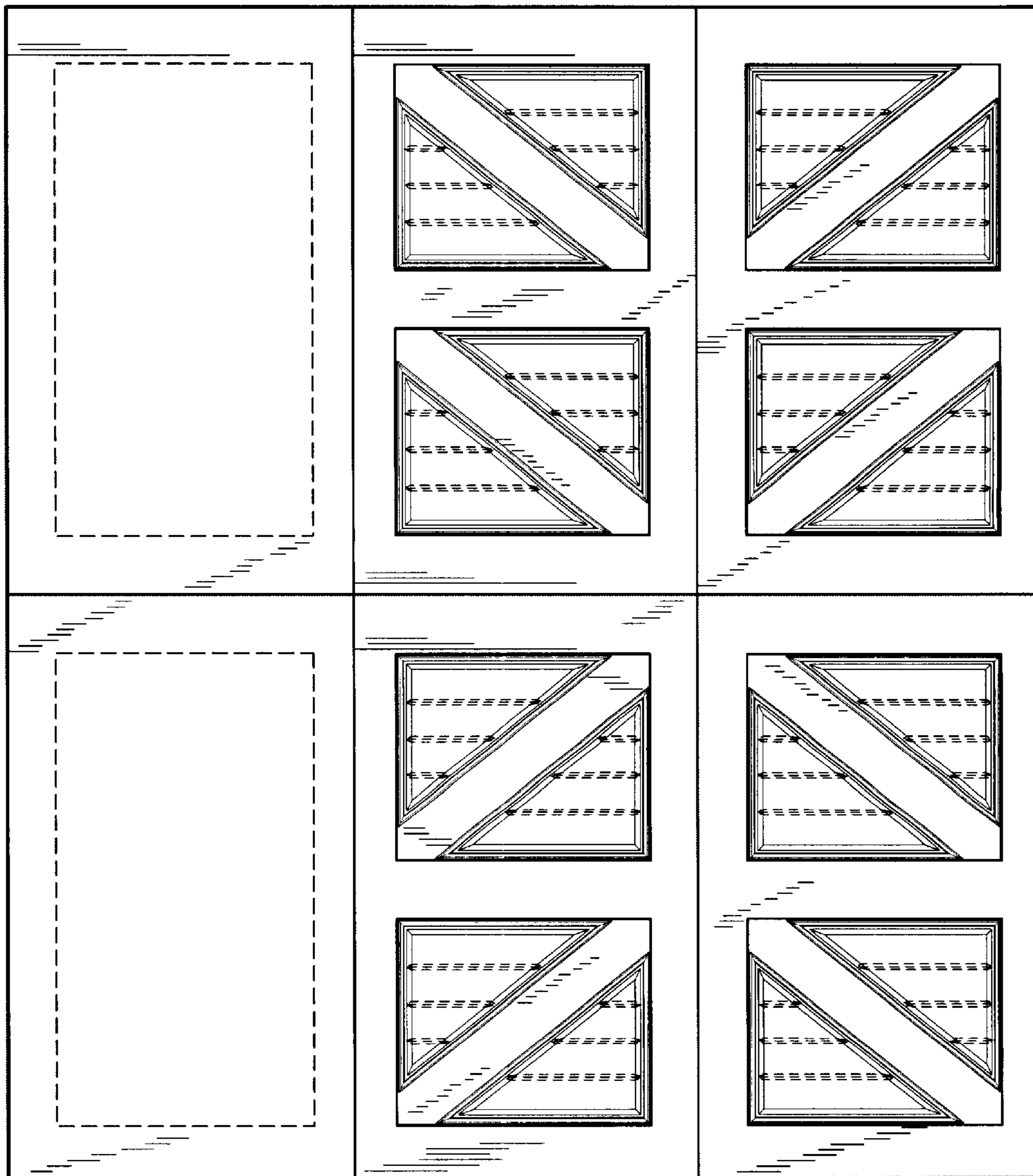

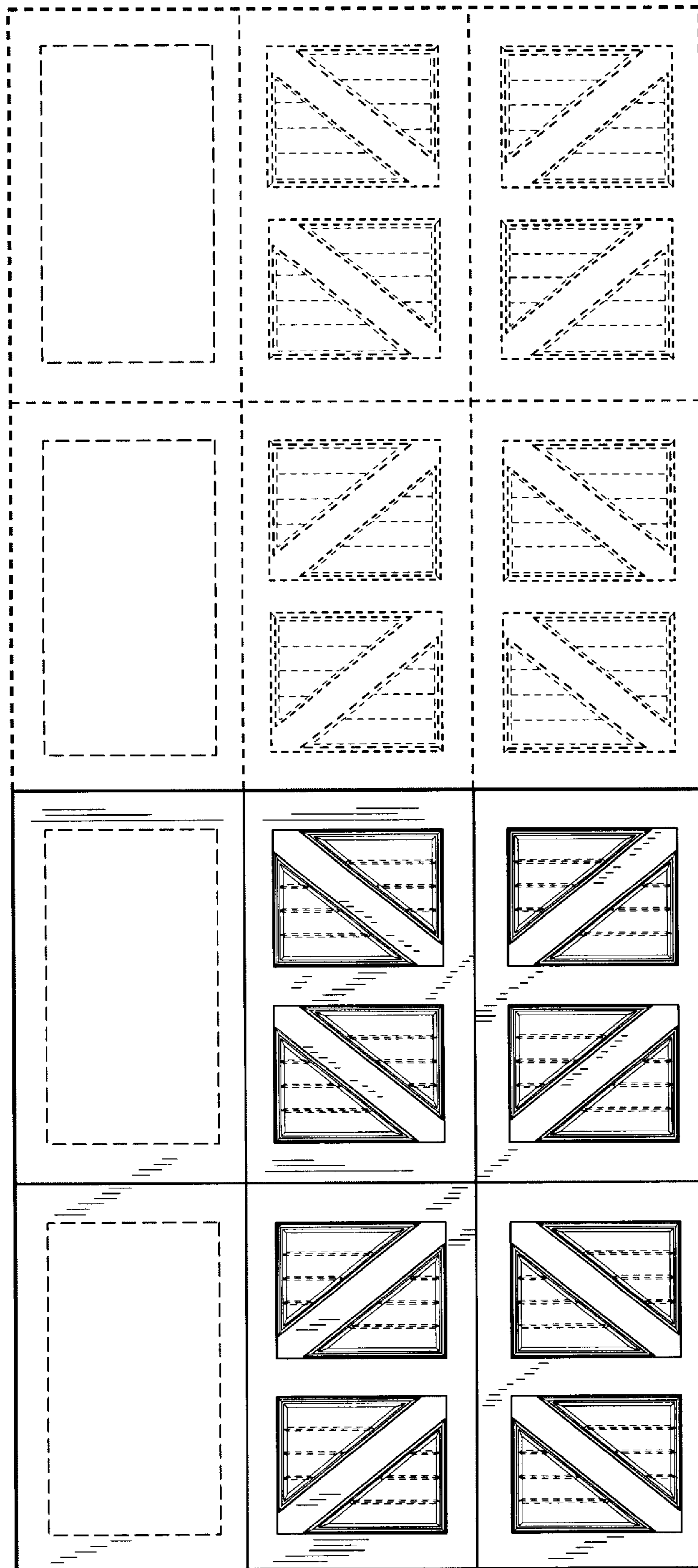
