(57) CLAIM

The ornamental design for the cap bill having double piping, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the cap bill according to a first embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the cap bill of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the cap bill of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a side view of the cap bill of FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged cross sectional detal view of the edge of the cap bill taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 3;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the cap bill according to a second embodiment of the present invention;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the cap bill according to a third embodiment of the present invention;


FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the cap bill according to a fourth embodiment of the present invention; and,

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of the cap bill according to a fifth embodiment of the present invention.

FIGS. 6–9 have the same appearance from the front, top, side and in cross section as FIGS. 2–5 respectively, the only difference being in the stipple shading representing colors. The edge shown in FIGS. 1–5 includes three different types of stipple shading representing three different colors. The edge shown in FIGS. 6, 7, and 9 includes two different types of stipple shading representing two different colors. The edge shown in FIG. 8 includes only one type of stipple shading representing one color.

The features shown in broken lines in the drawing figures are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.















